DESCRIPTION

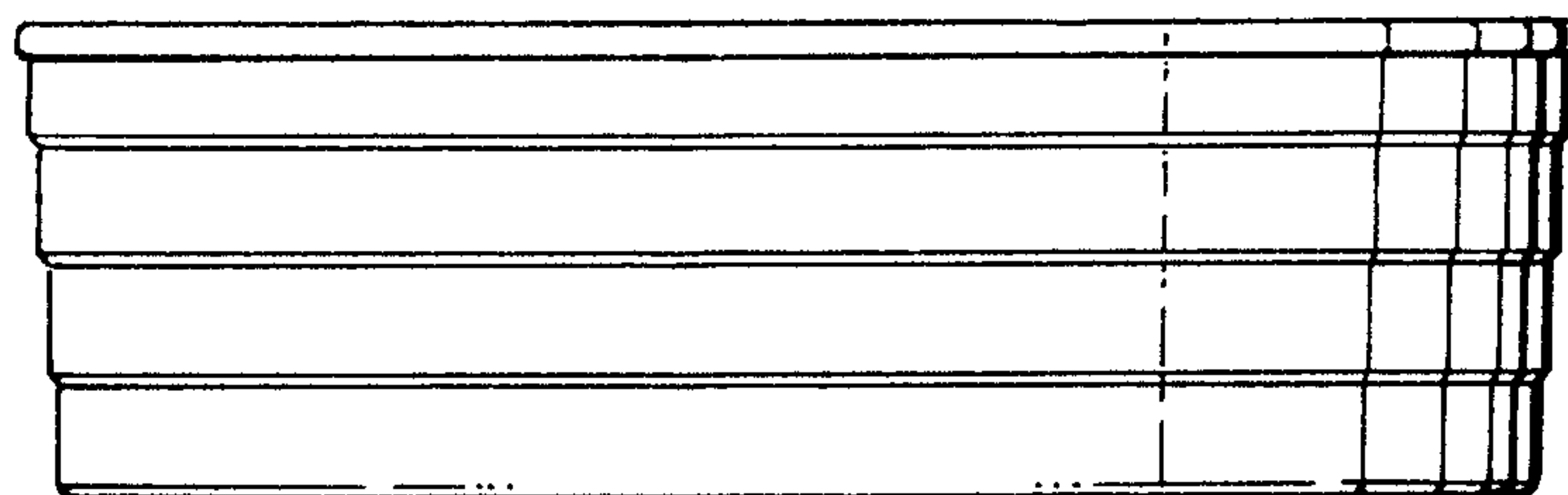
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a combined tray and lid showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is an end elevational view, the opposite end being the same in appearance.



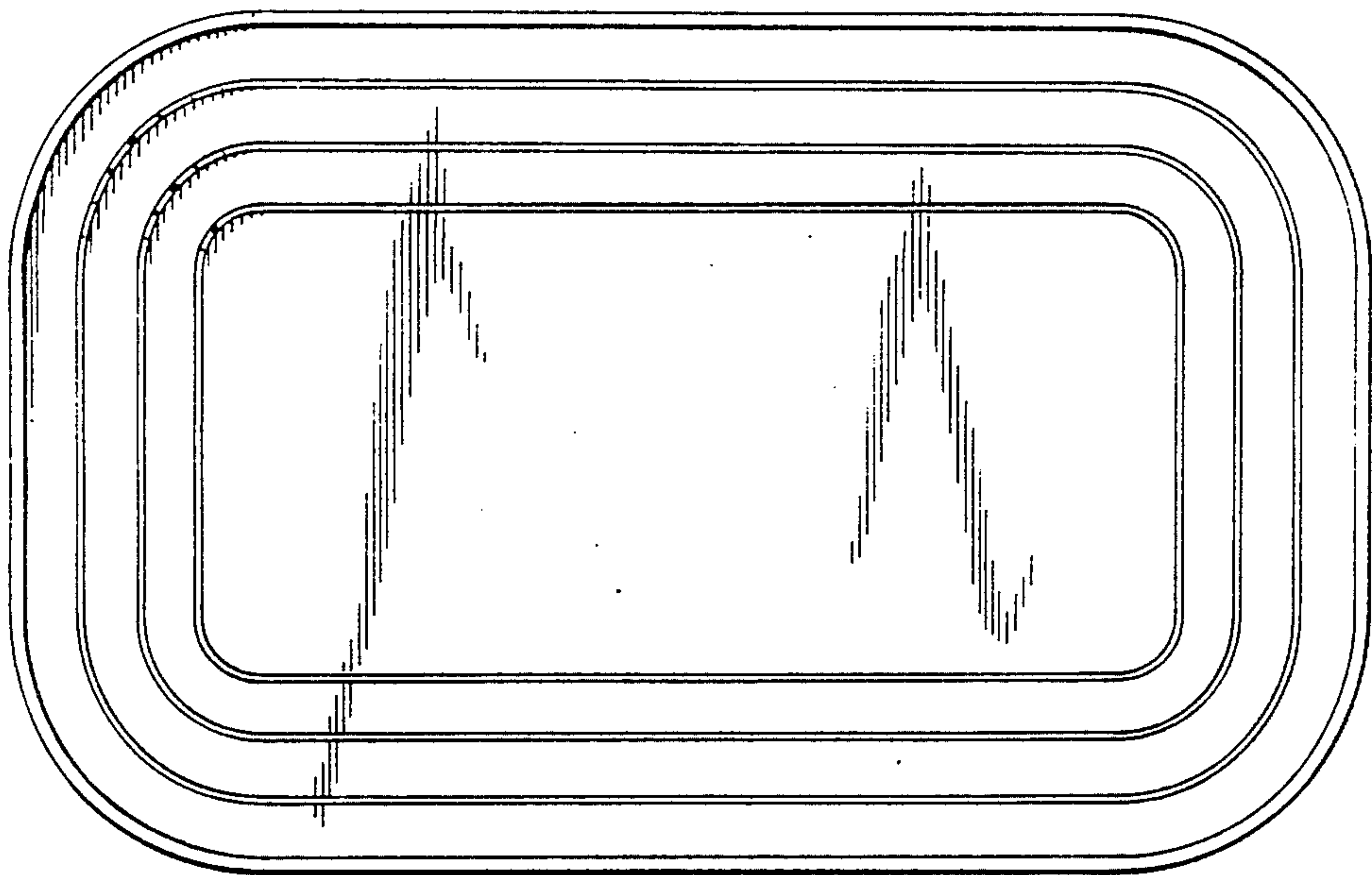

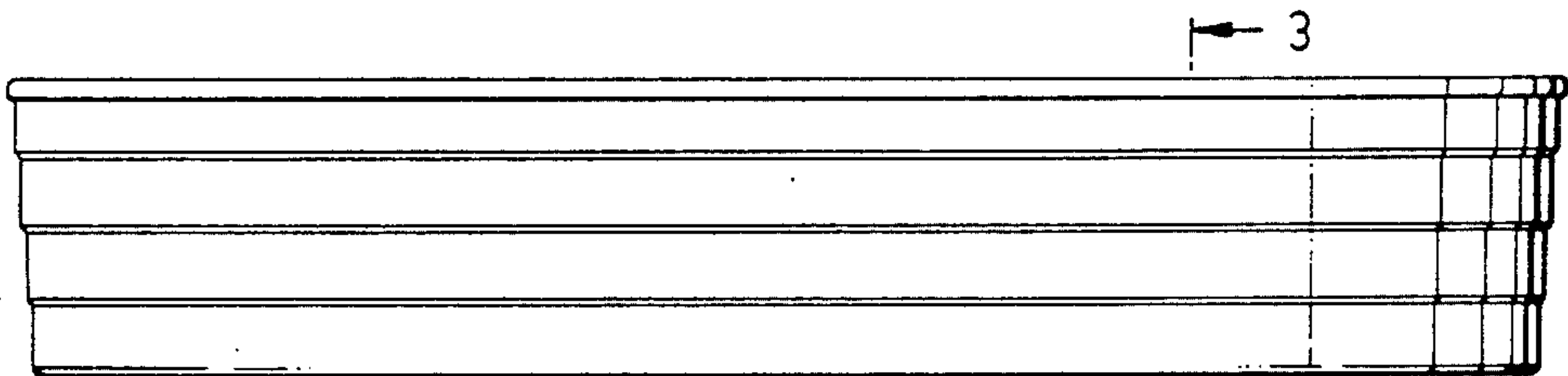

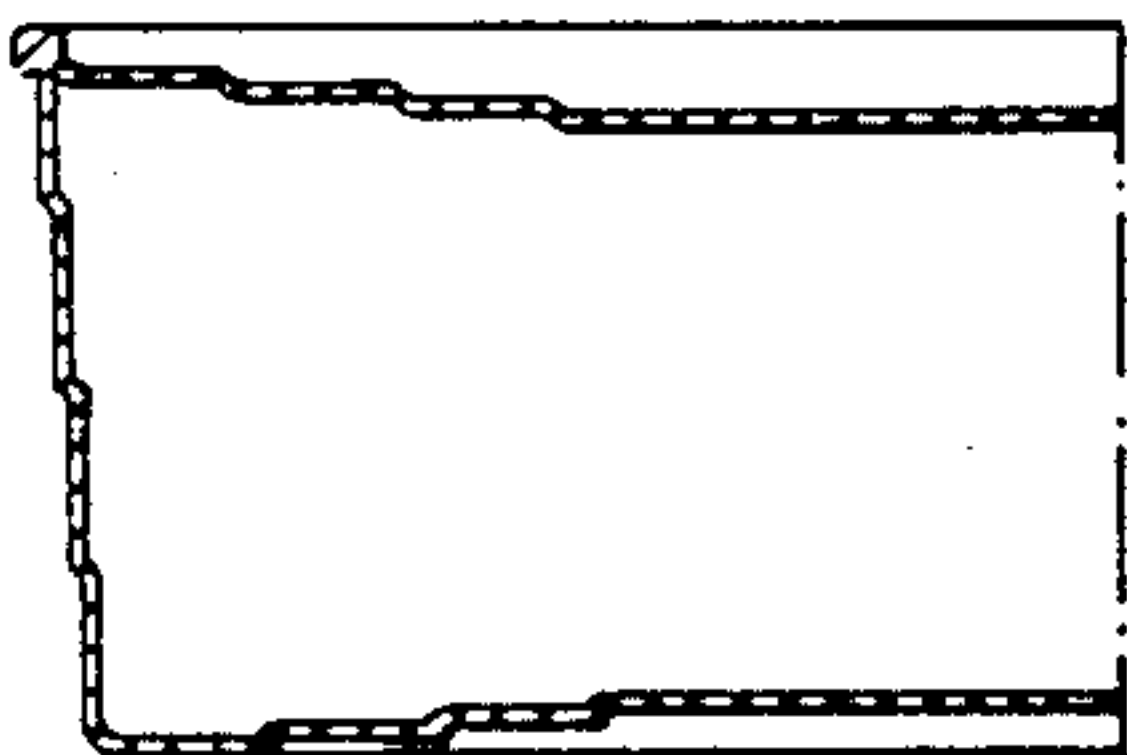

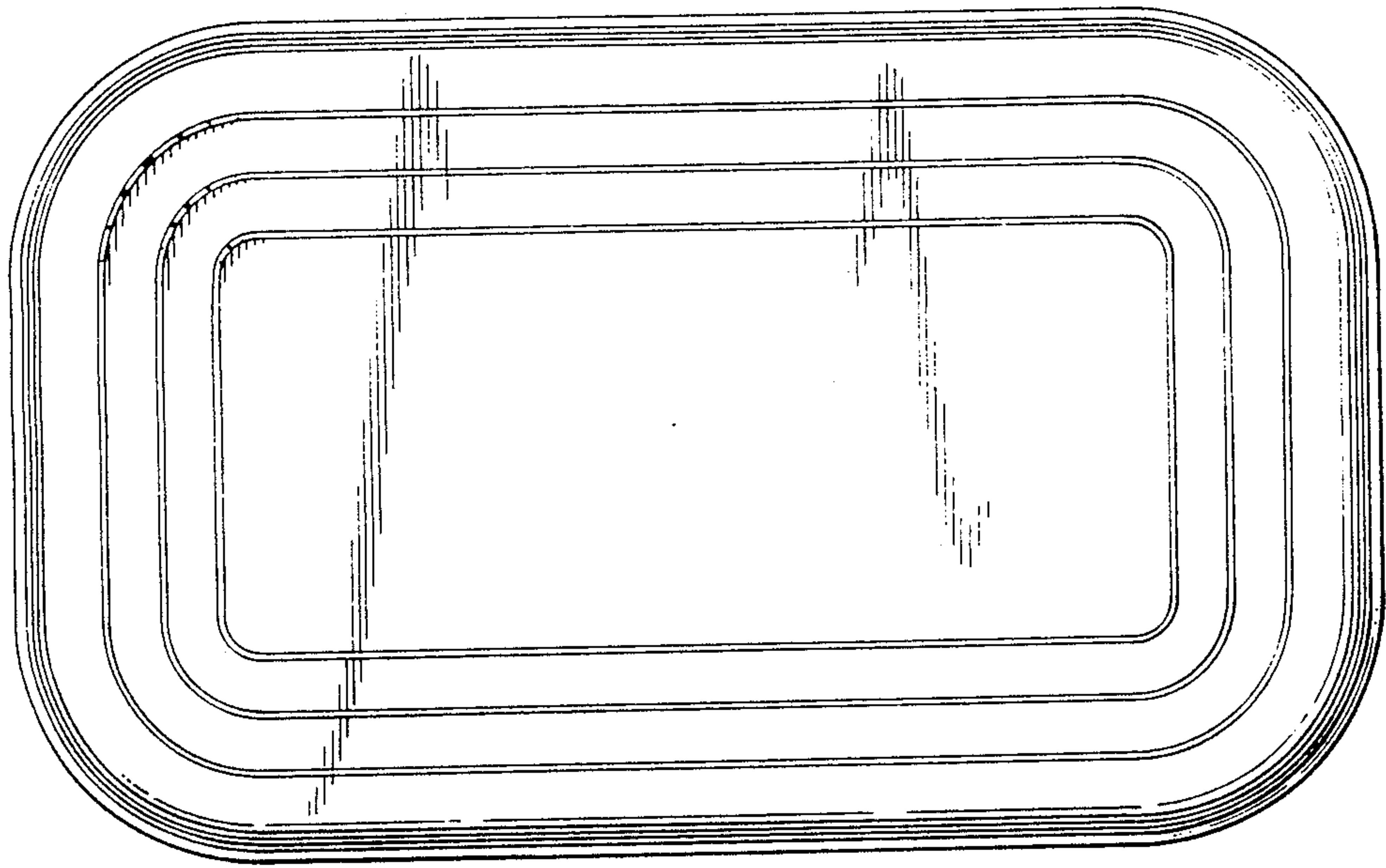

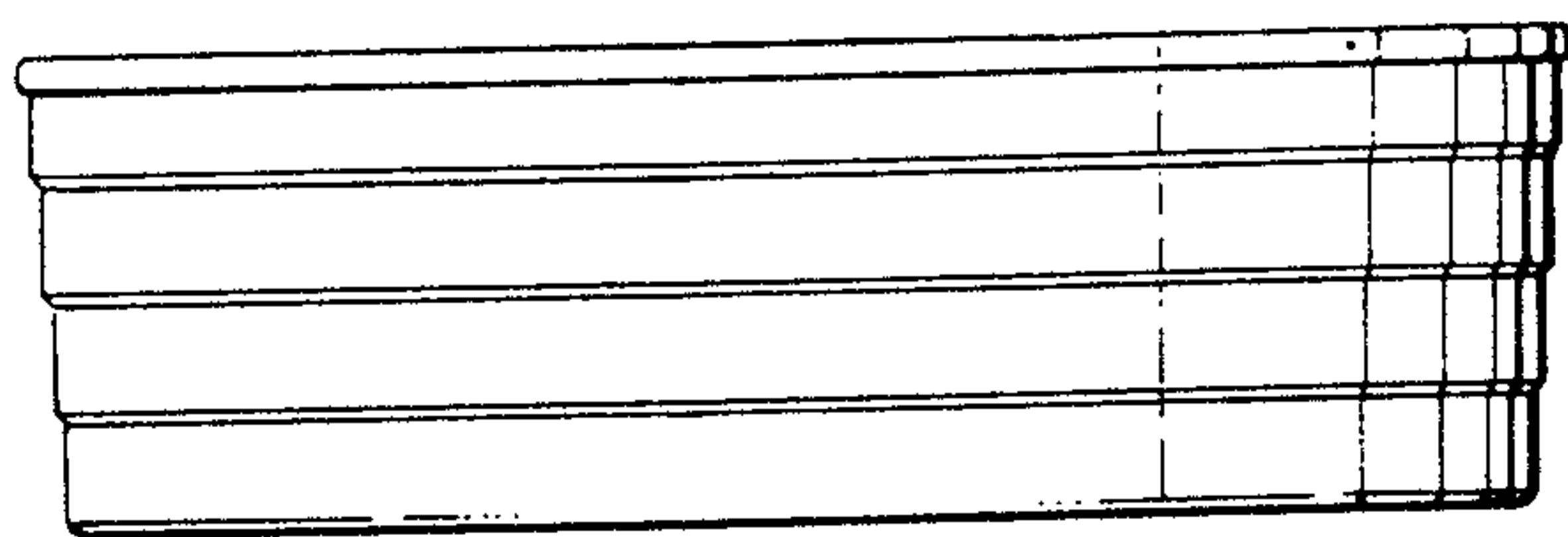
