FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a facsimile trans-
ceiver showing my new design;

structure and forming no part of the claimed design.

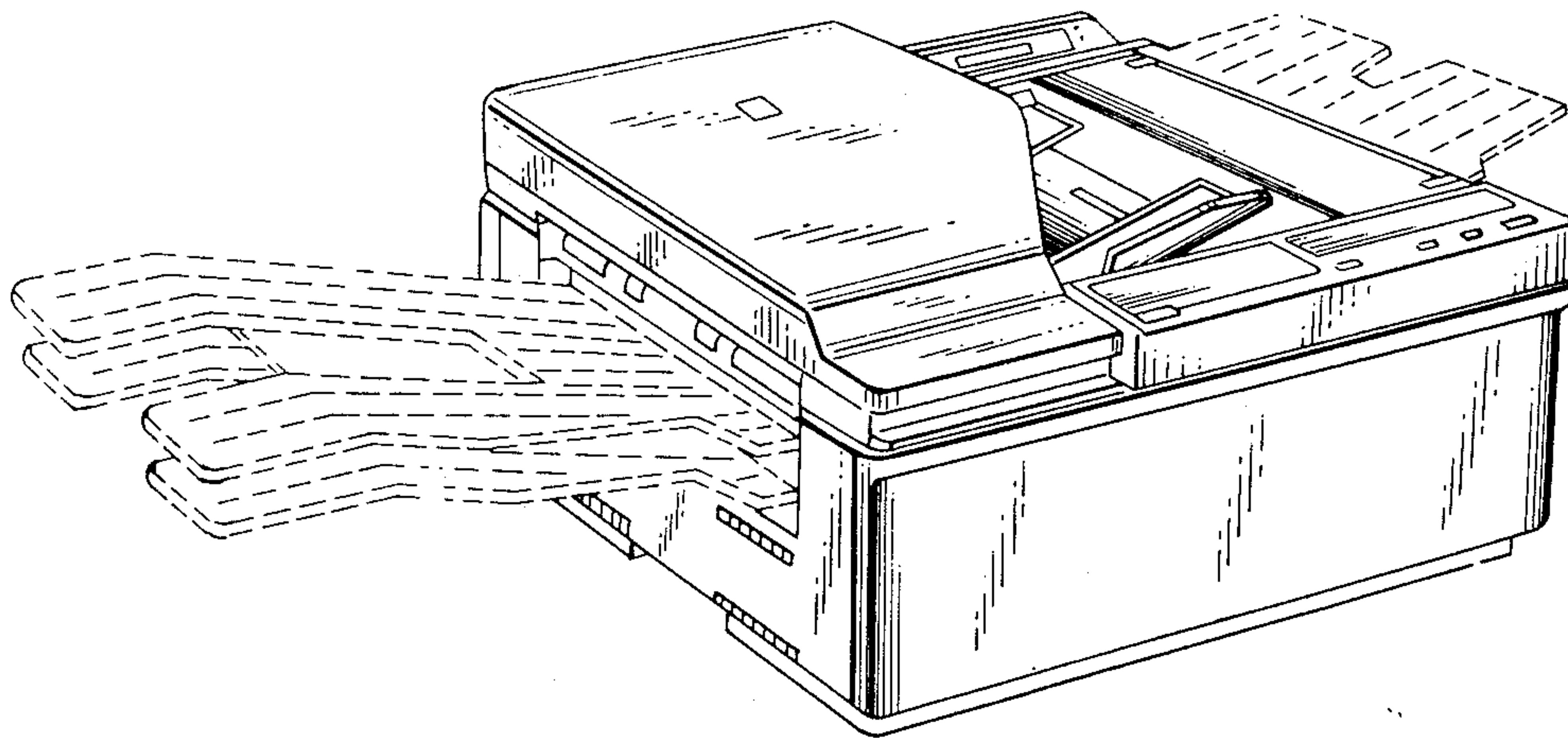

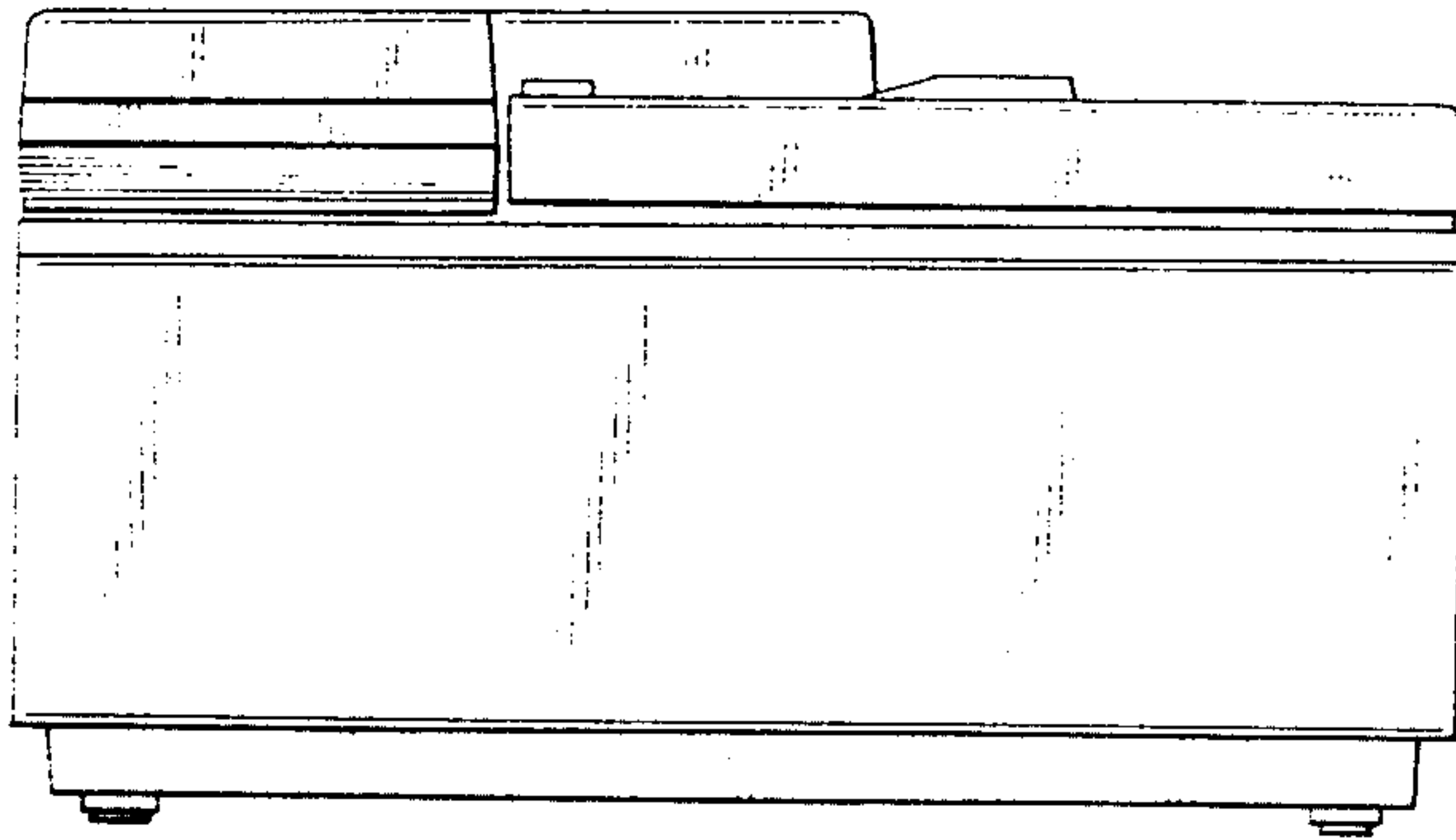

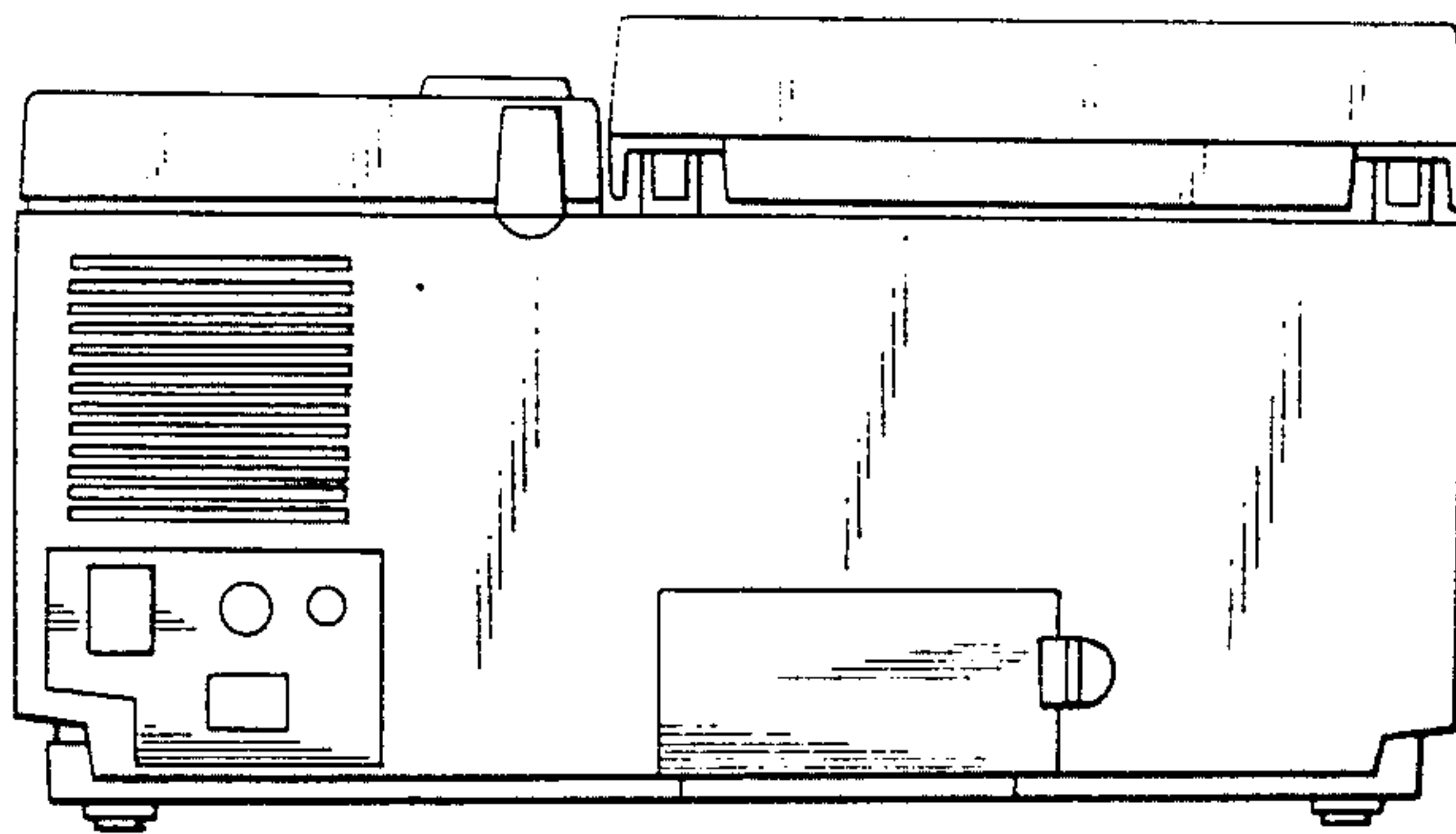

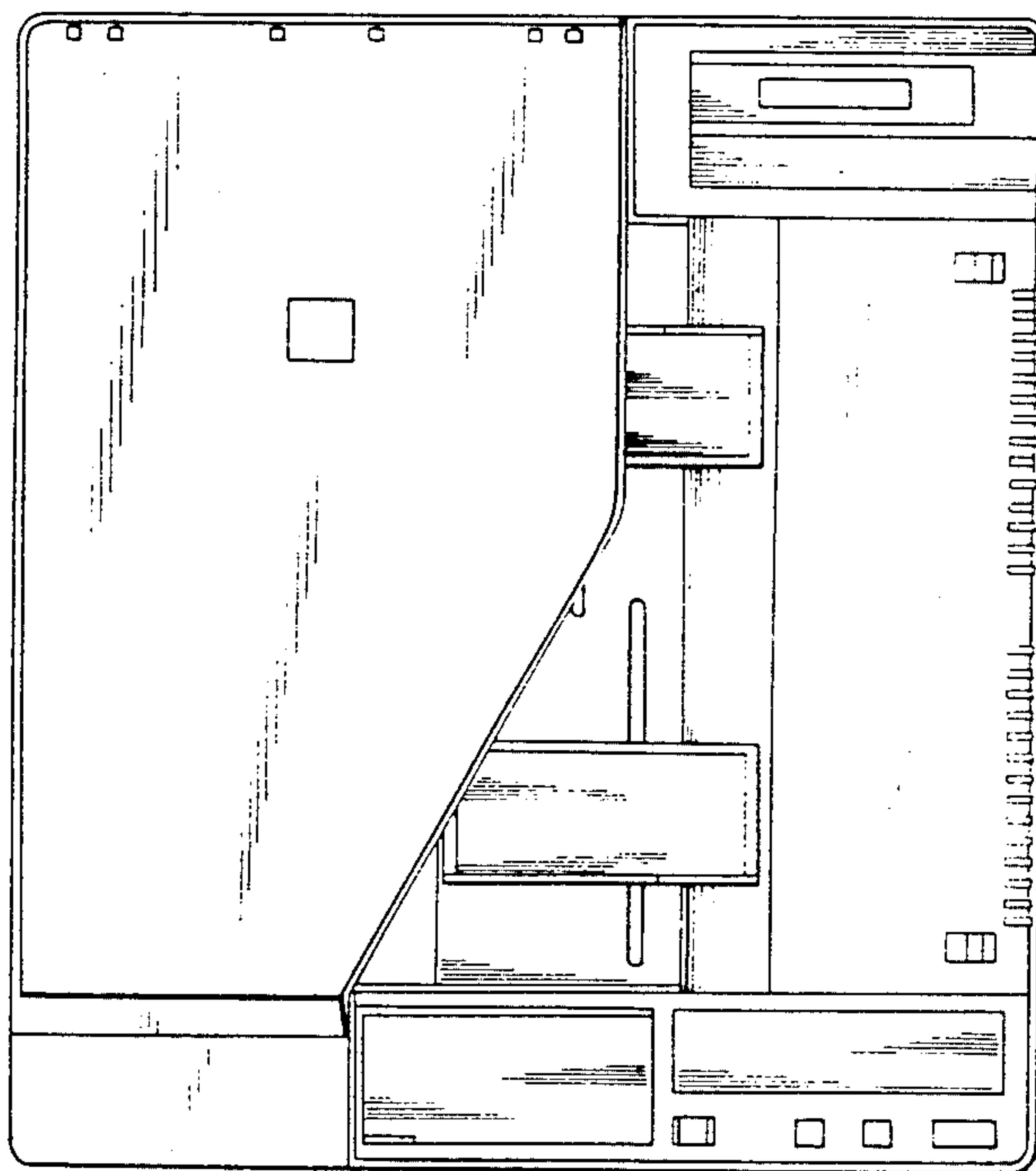

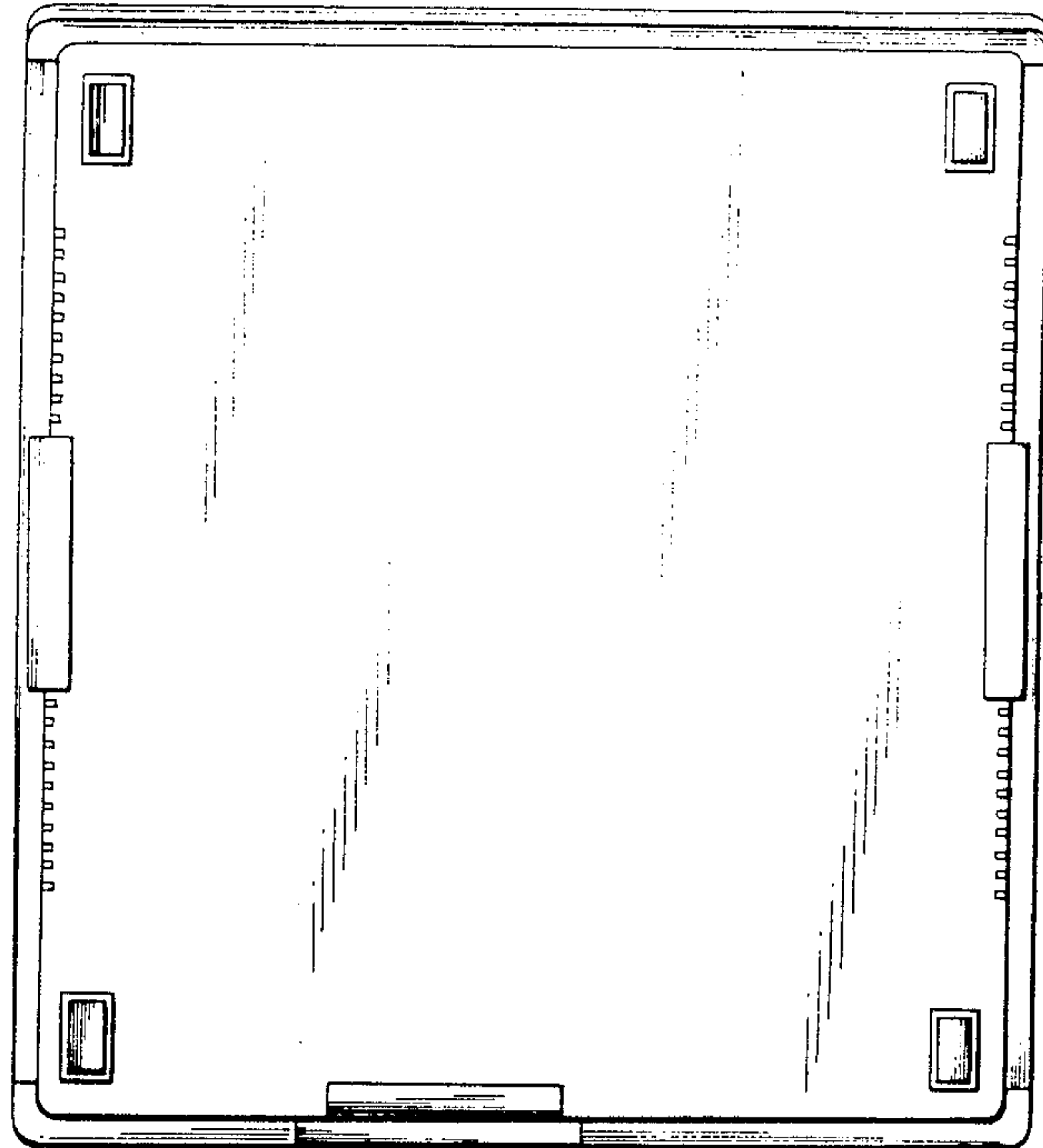

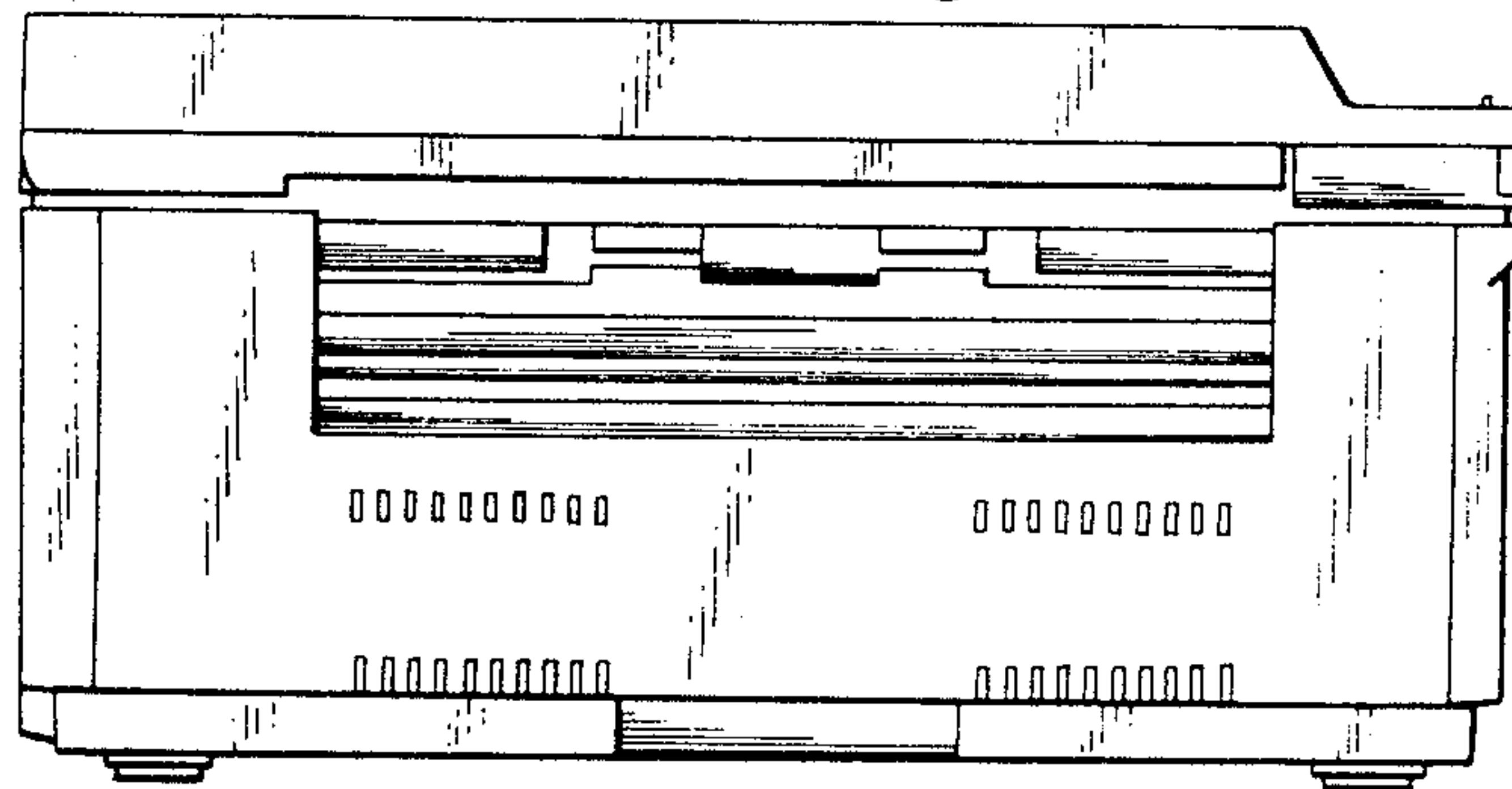

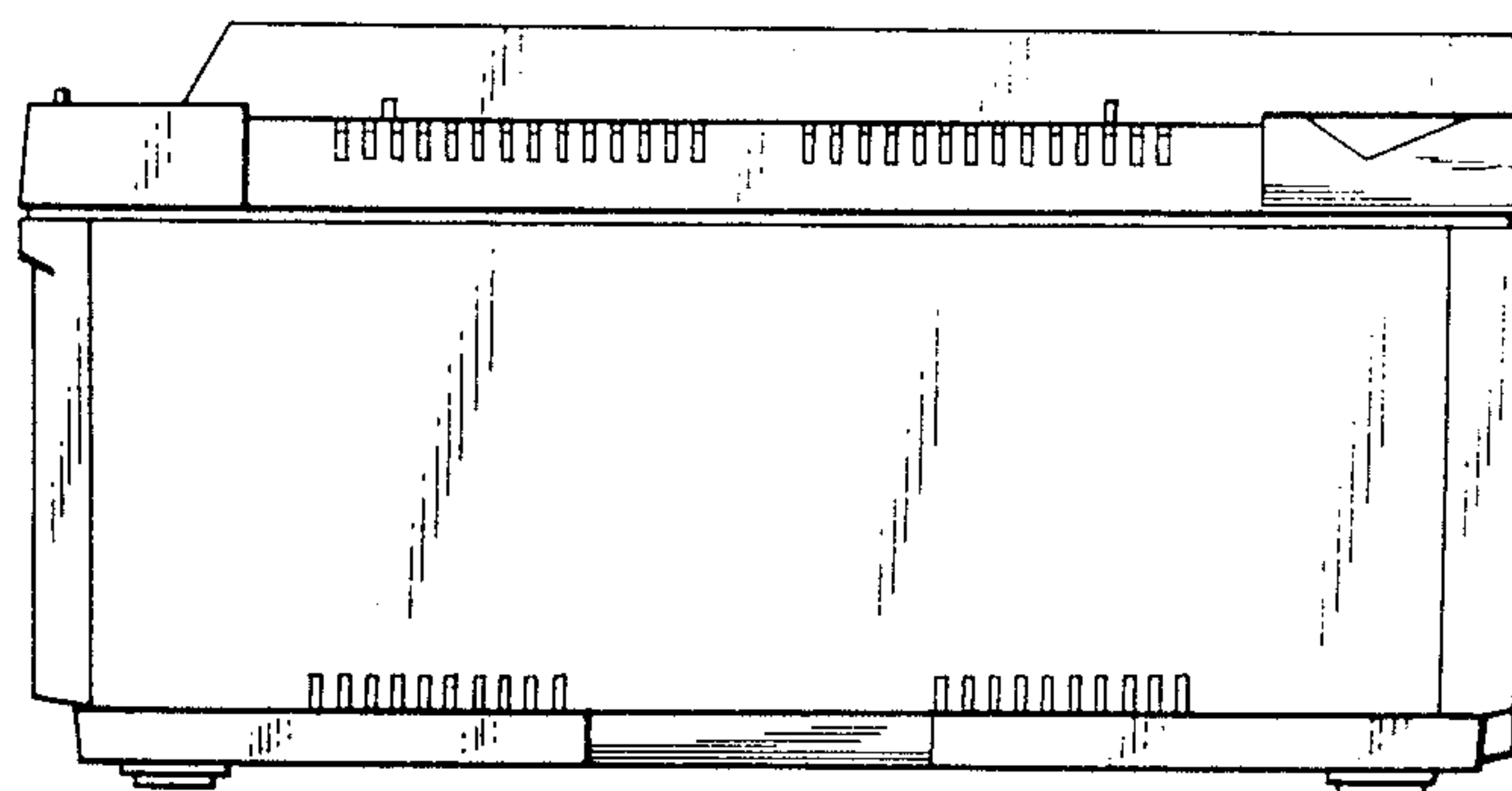
