FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side elevational view being a mirror image thereof.

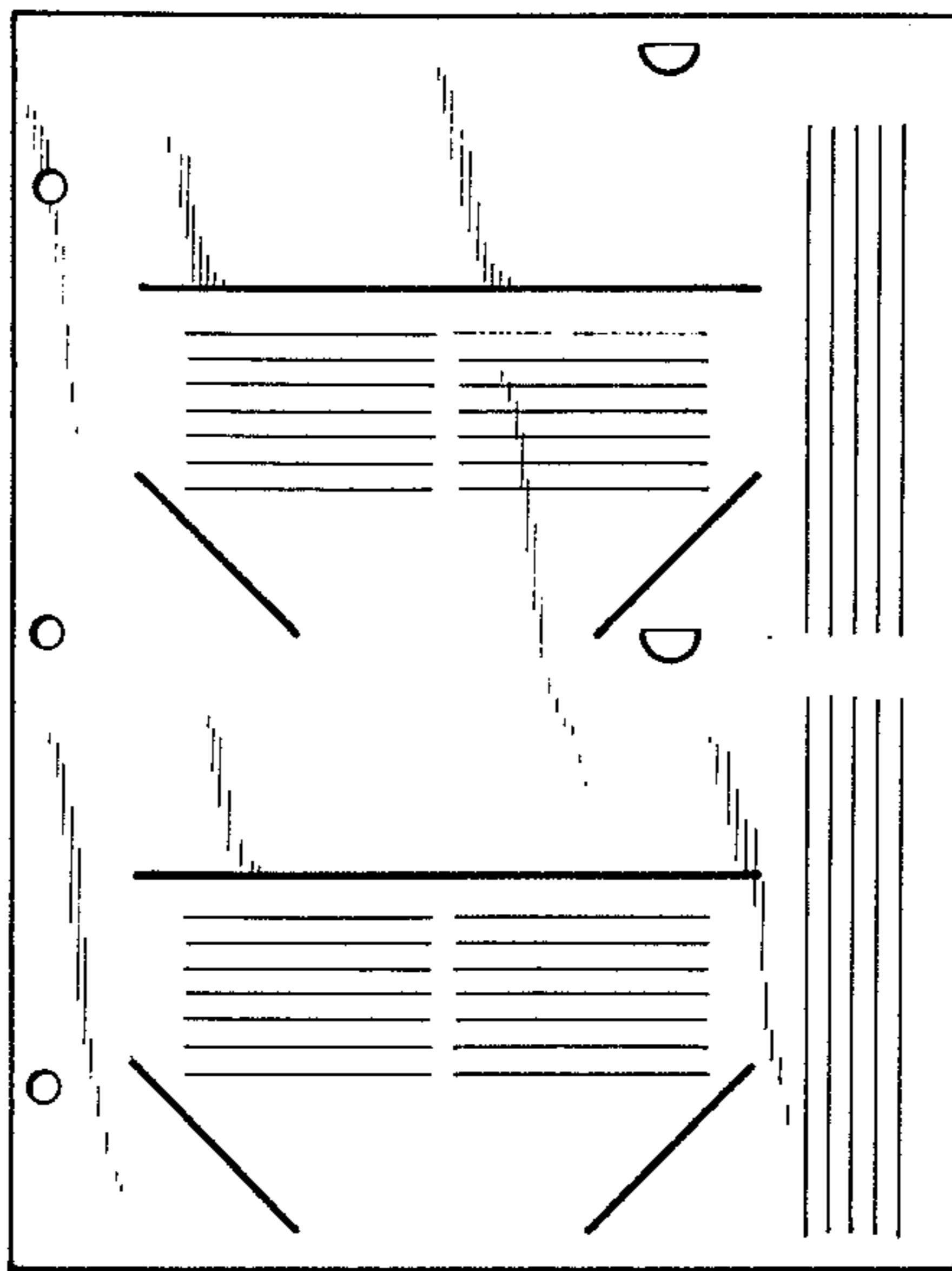

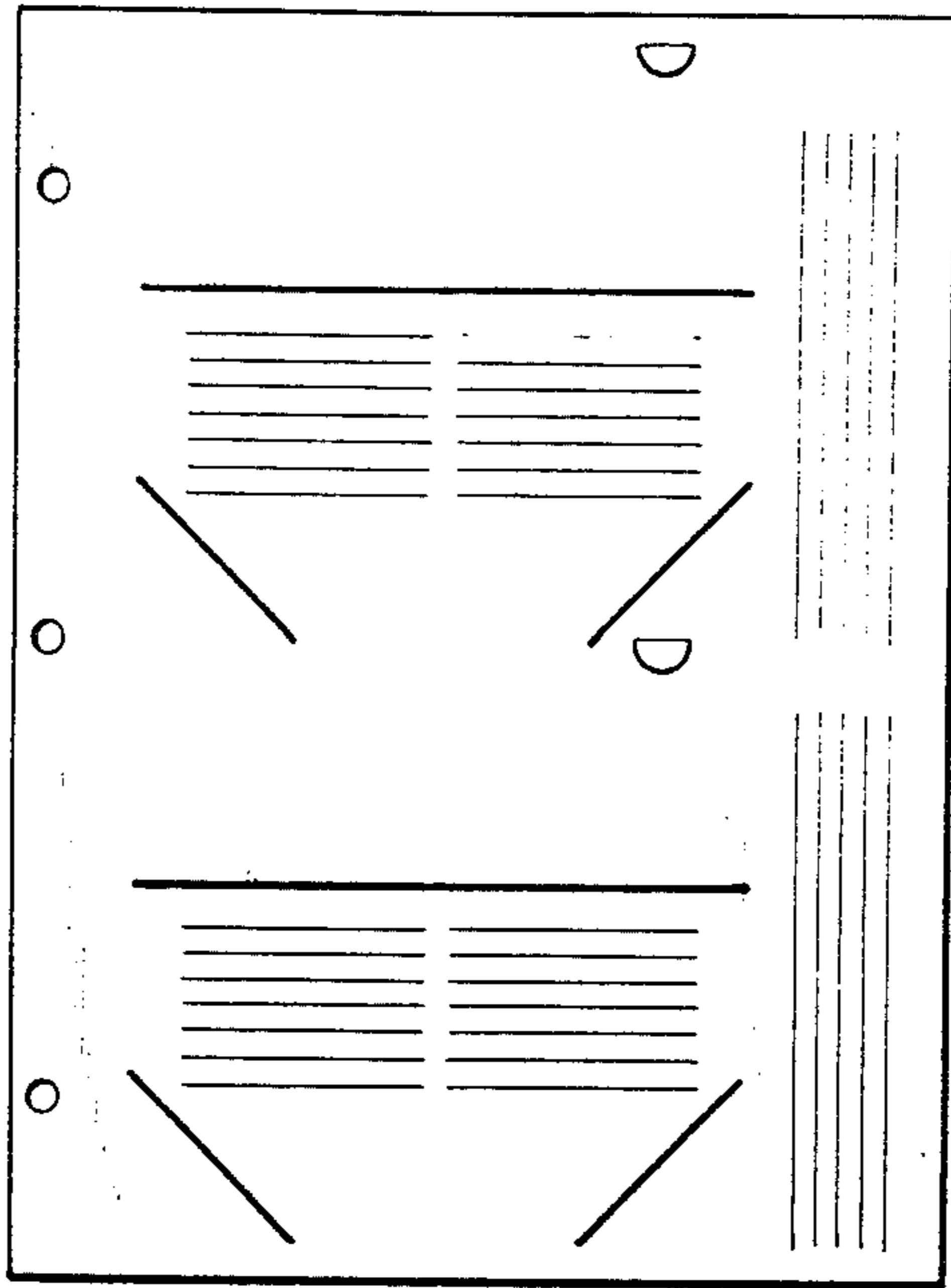

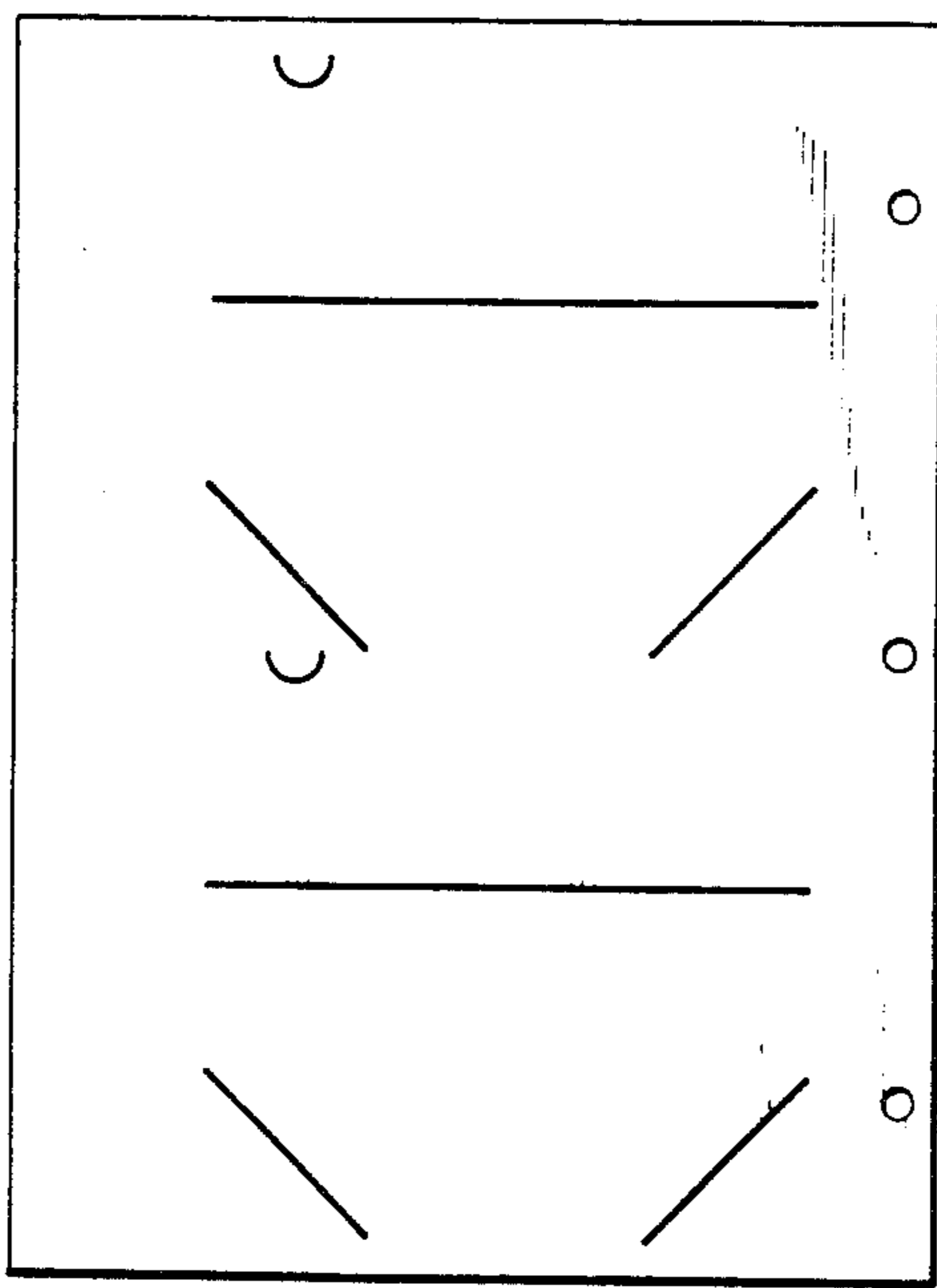
