FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a commode chair showing our new design.

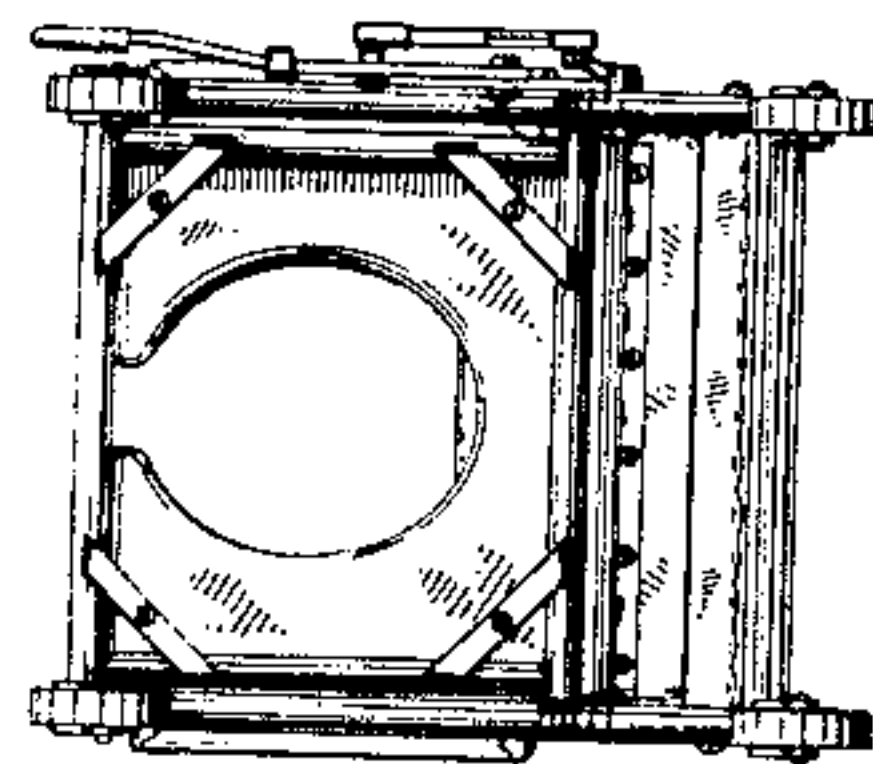
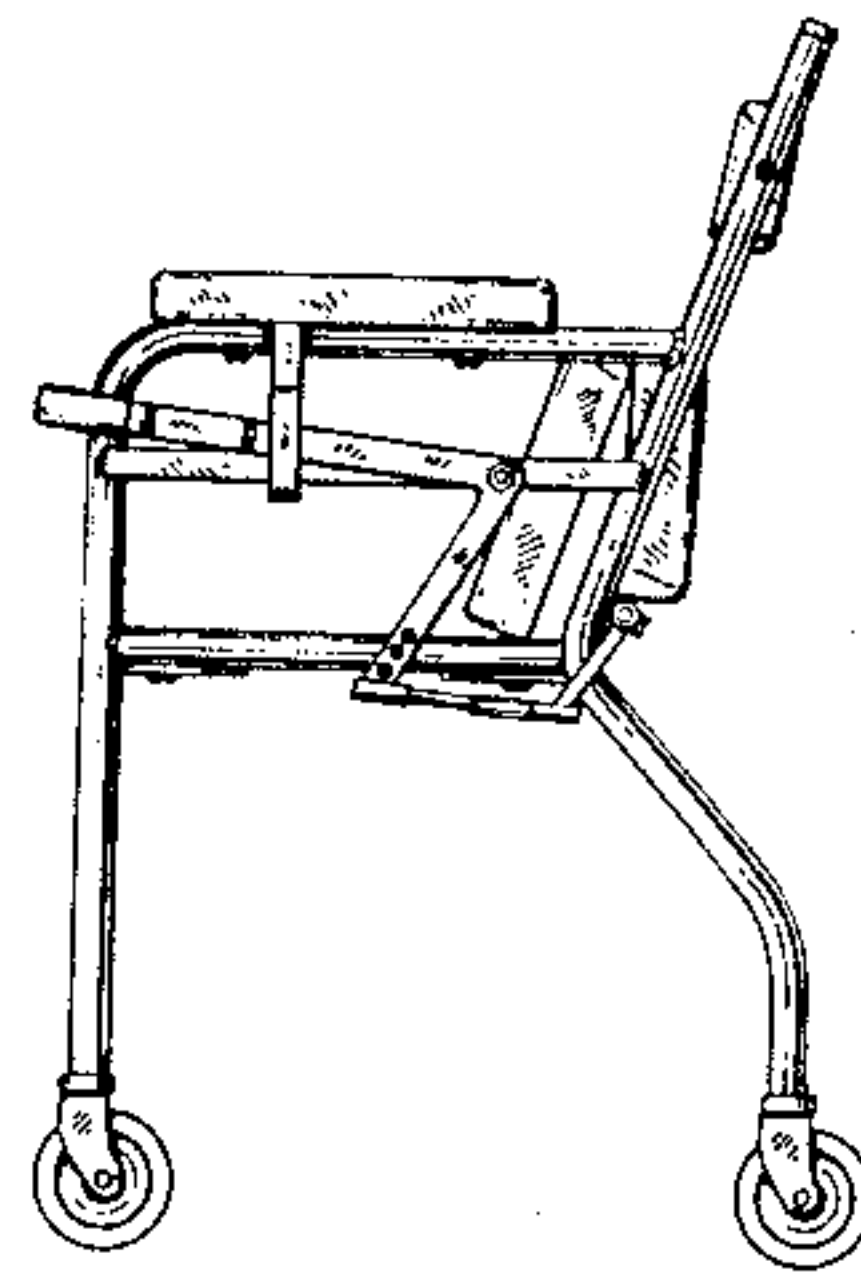
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof.

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



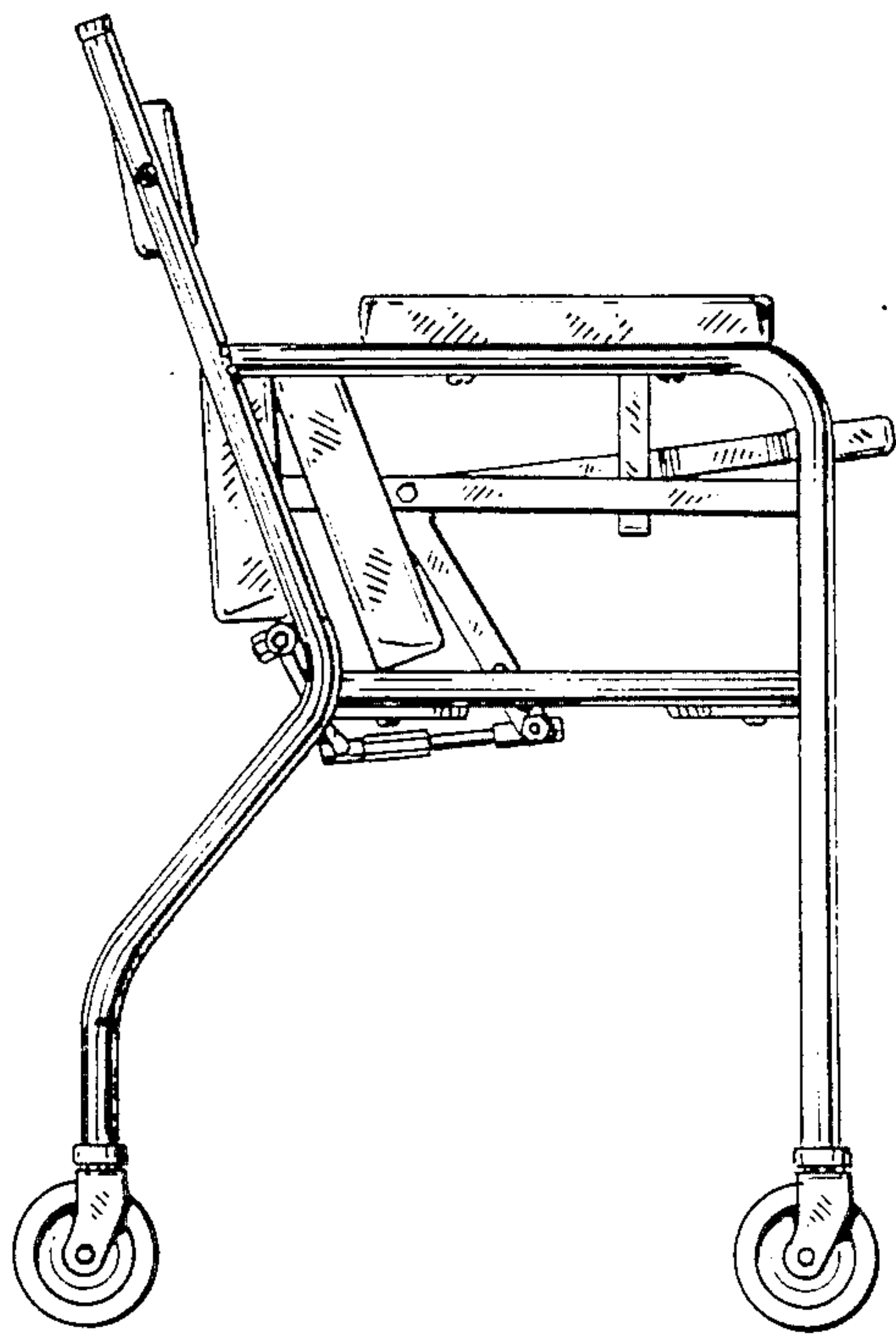

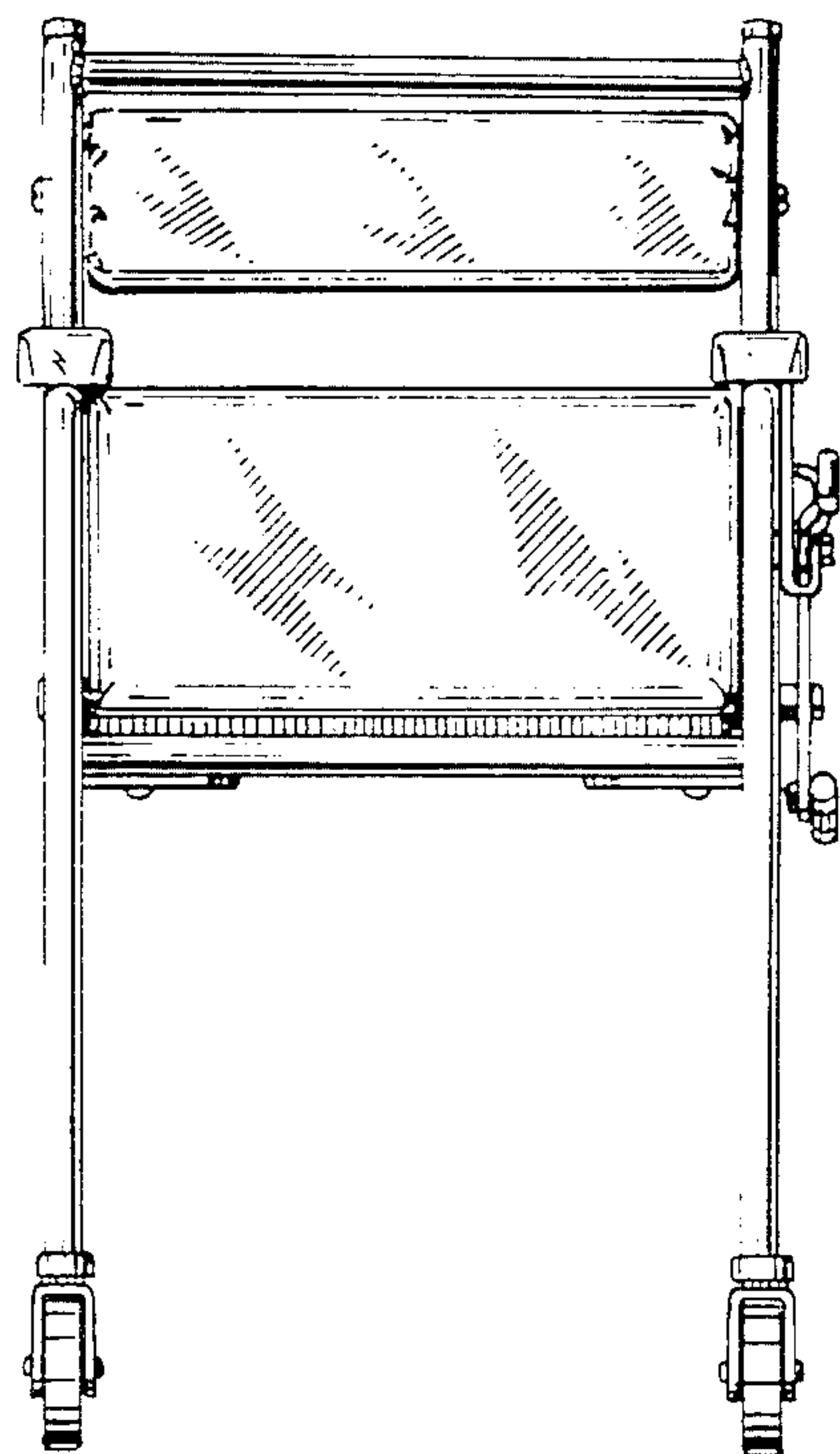

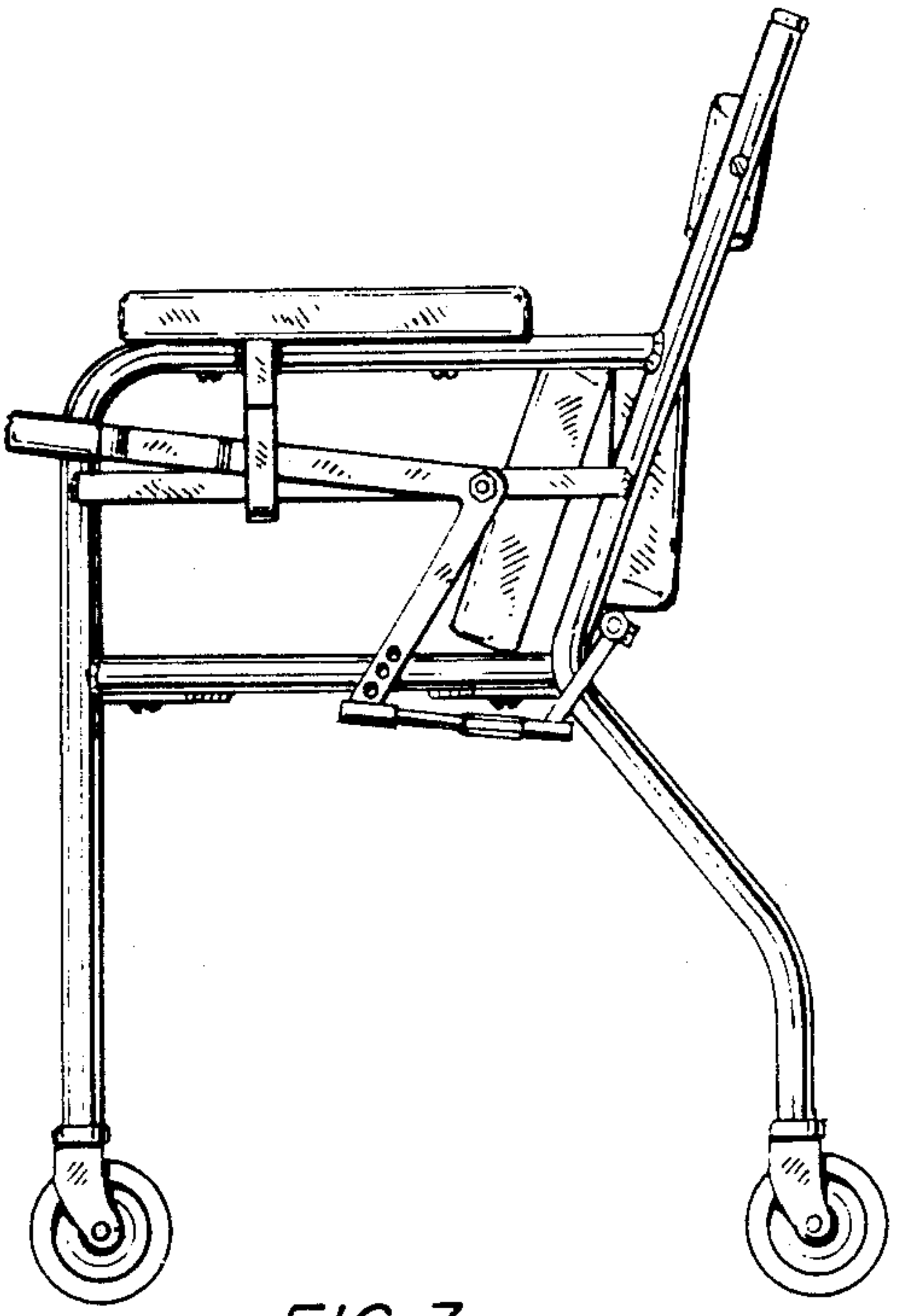

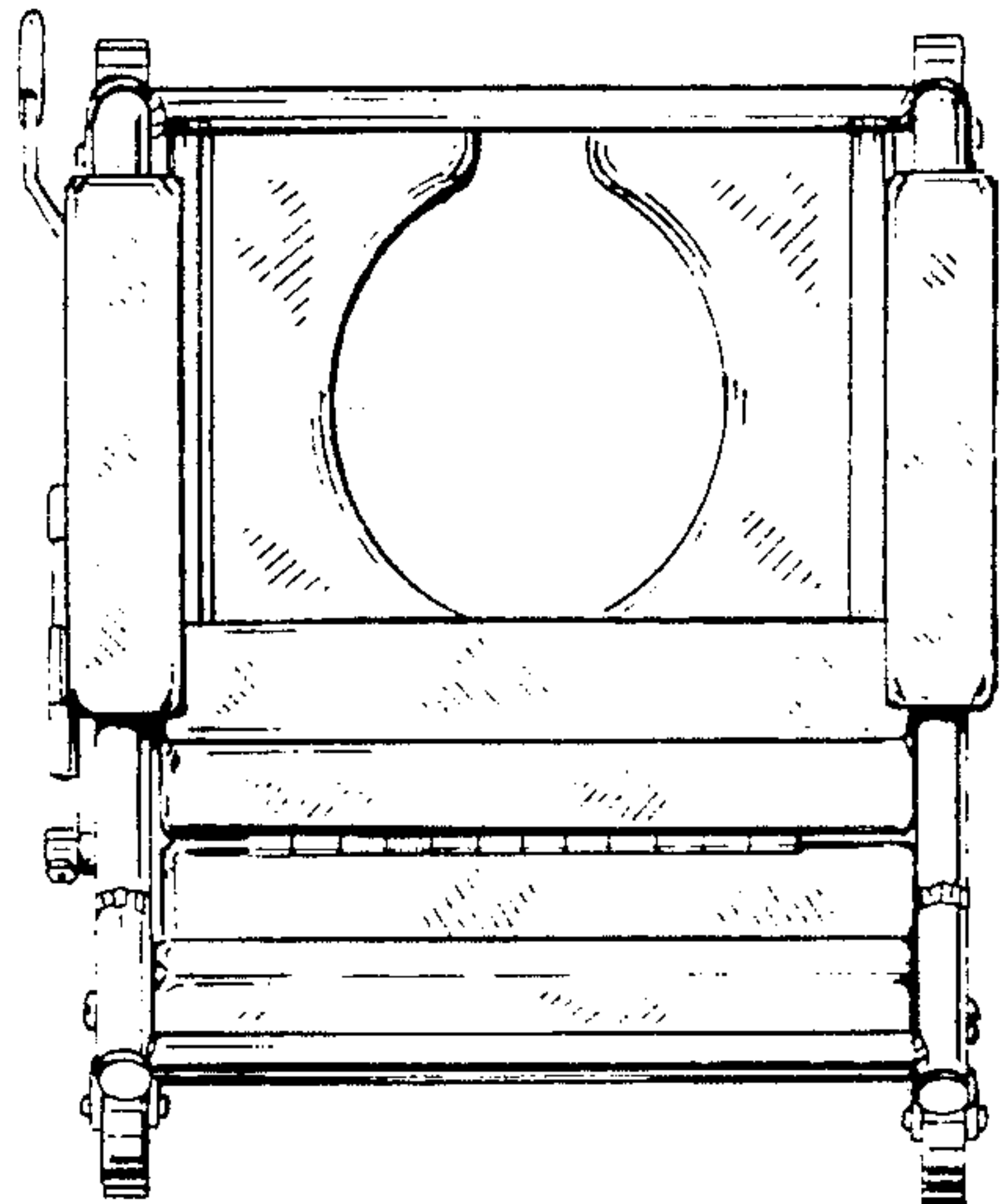

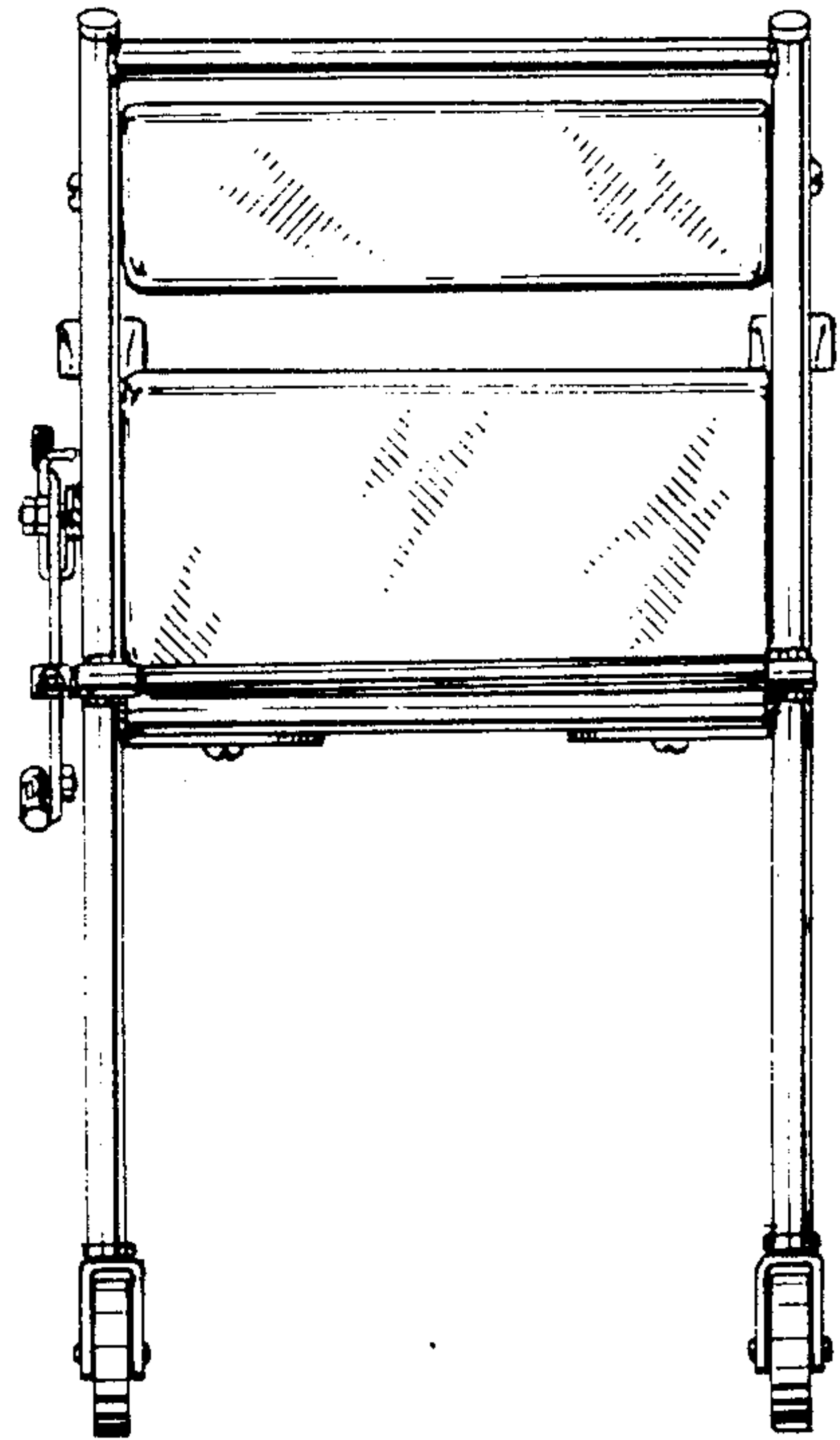

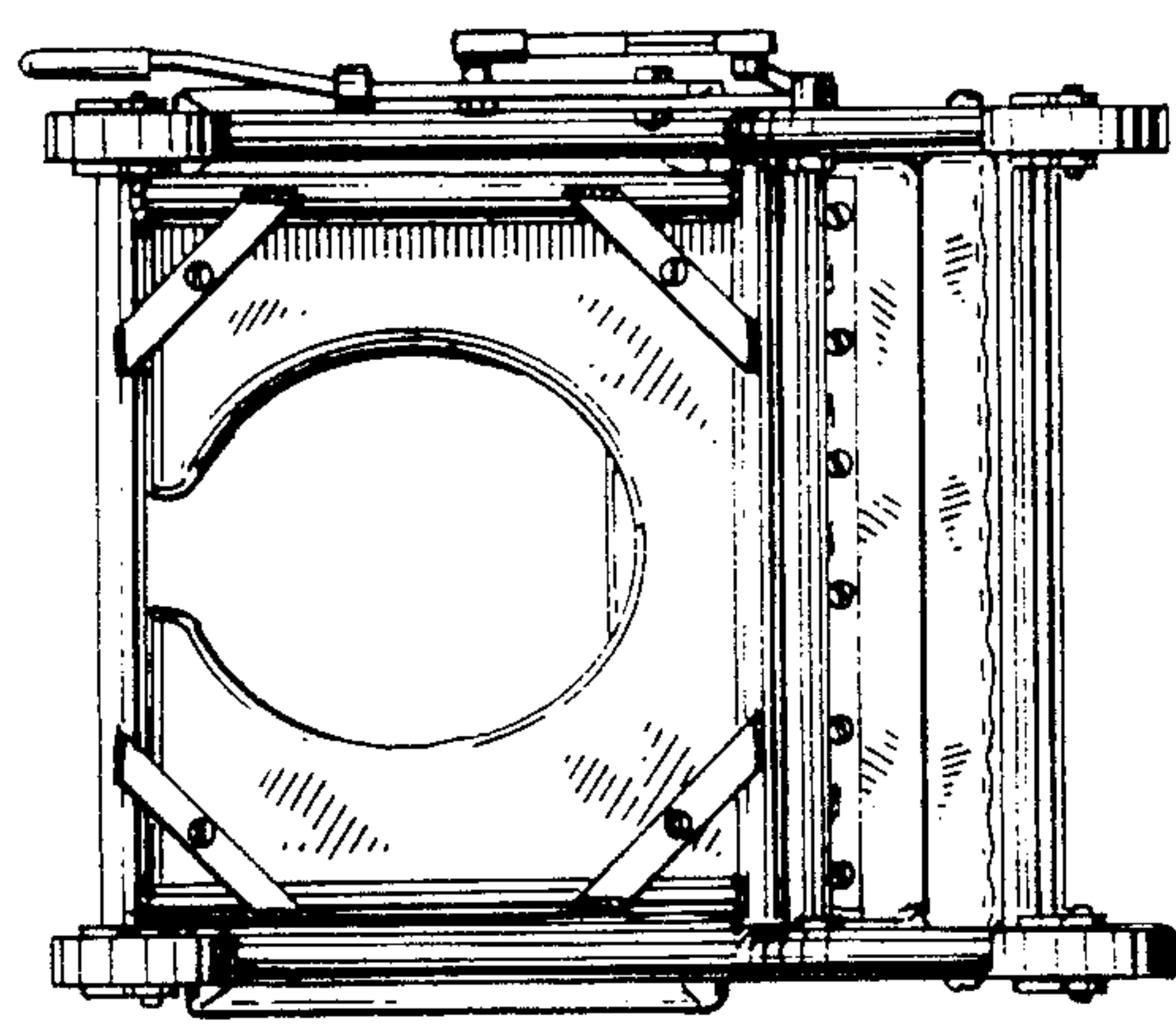
