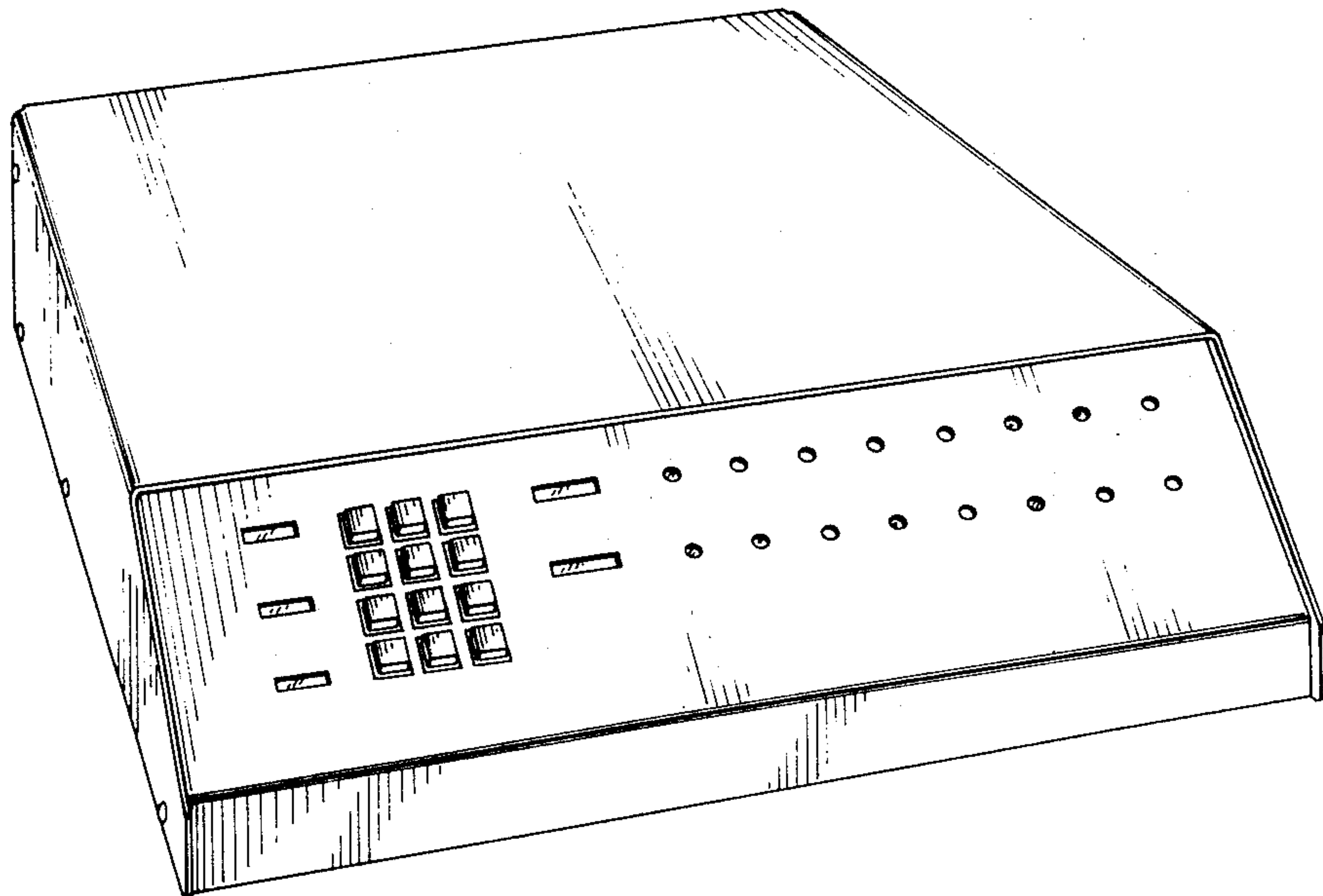

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of an automobile telephone apparatus showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



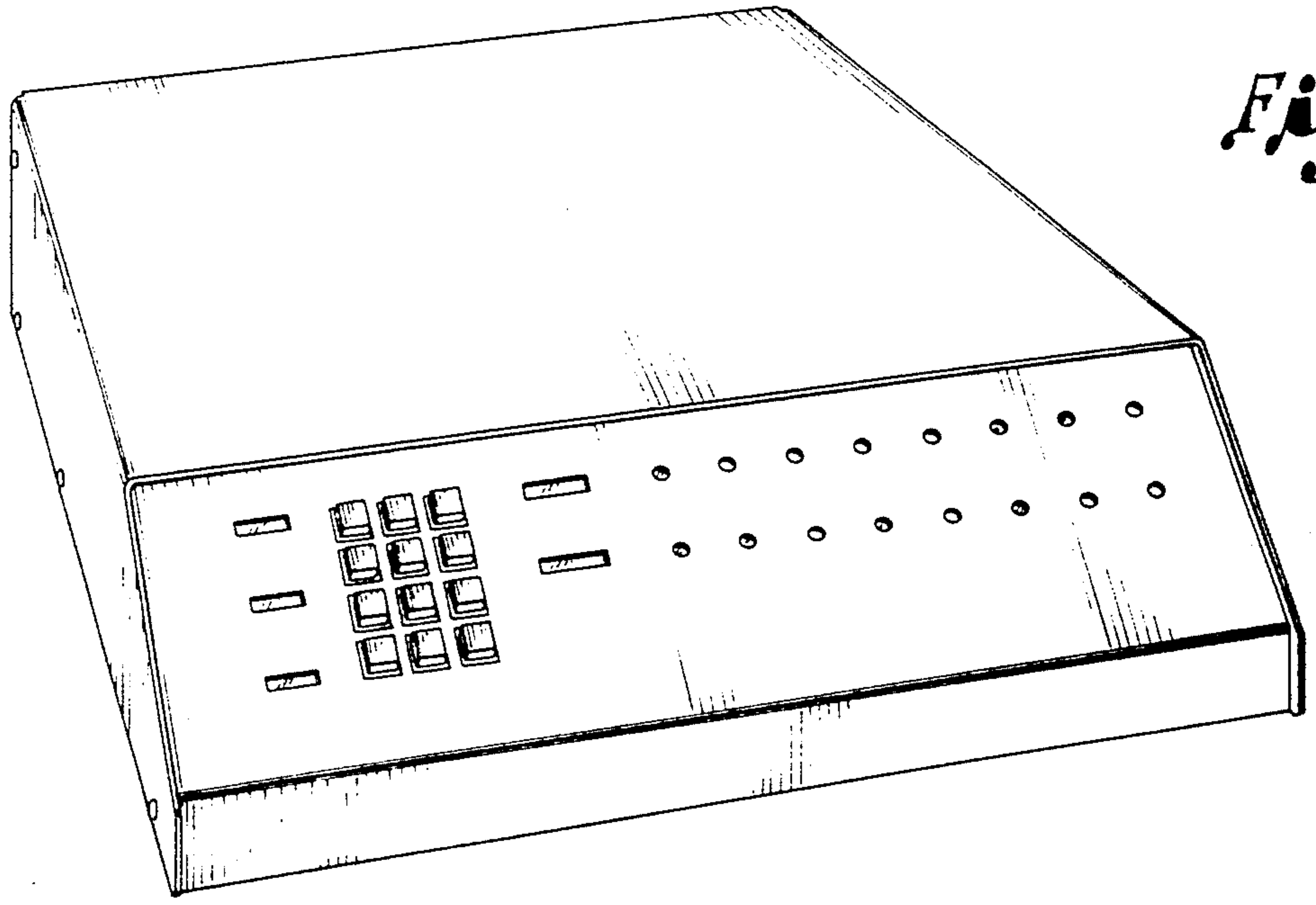

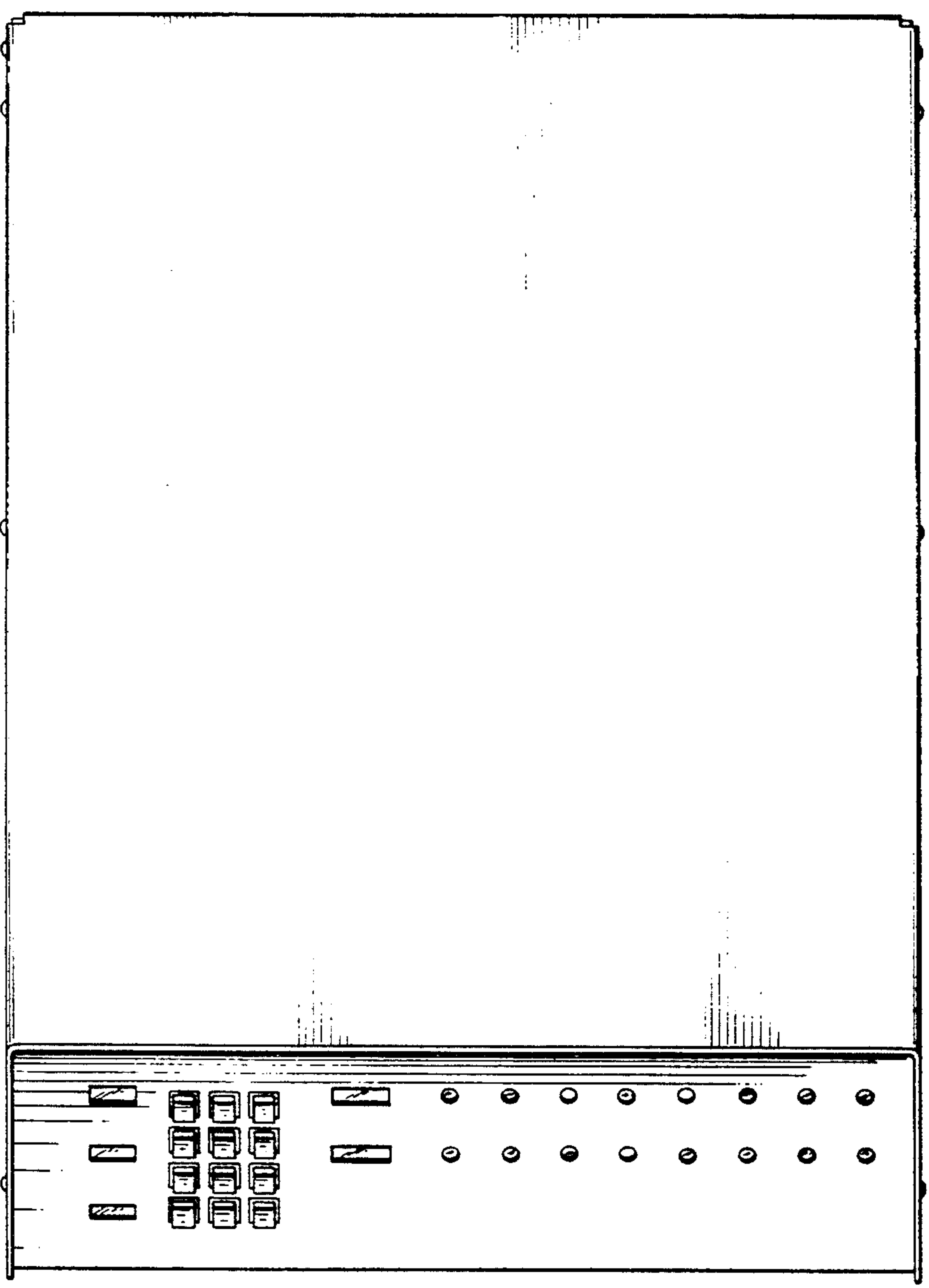

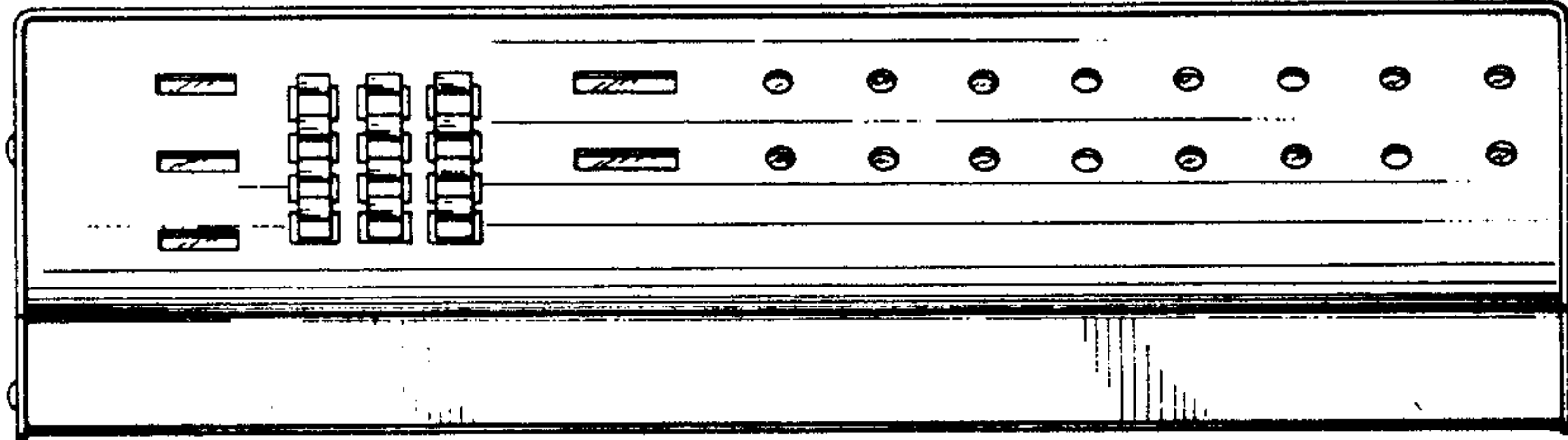

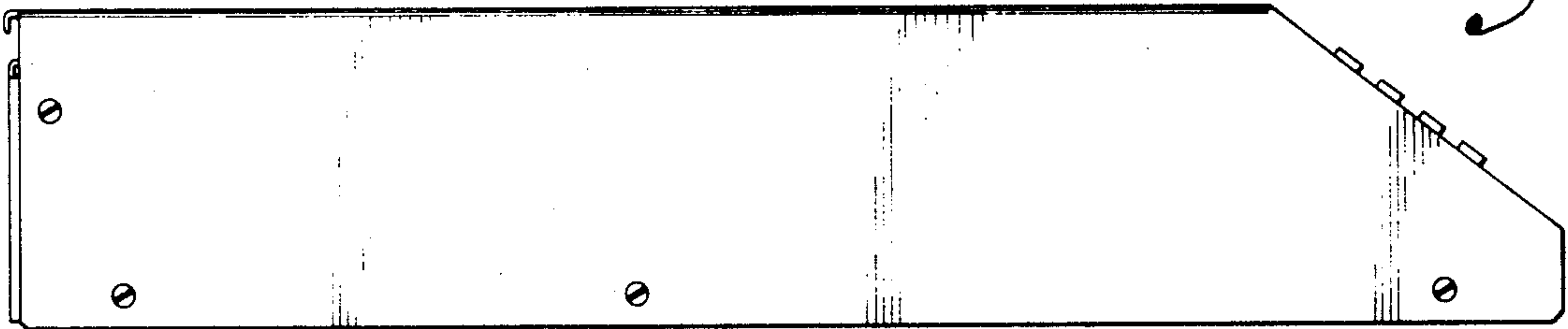
