The ornamental design for a combination sunglasses and 3-D glasses, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combination sunglasses and 3-D glasses showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof with the temples shown in an alternate position for illustrative purposes only;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof with the lenses shown in an alternate position;
 FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

 FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 8 is a top view thereof; and
 FIG. 9 is a bottom view thereof.

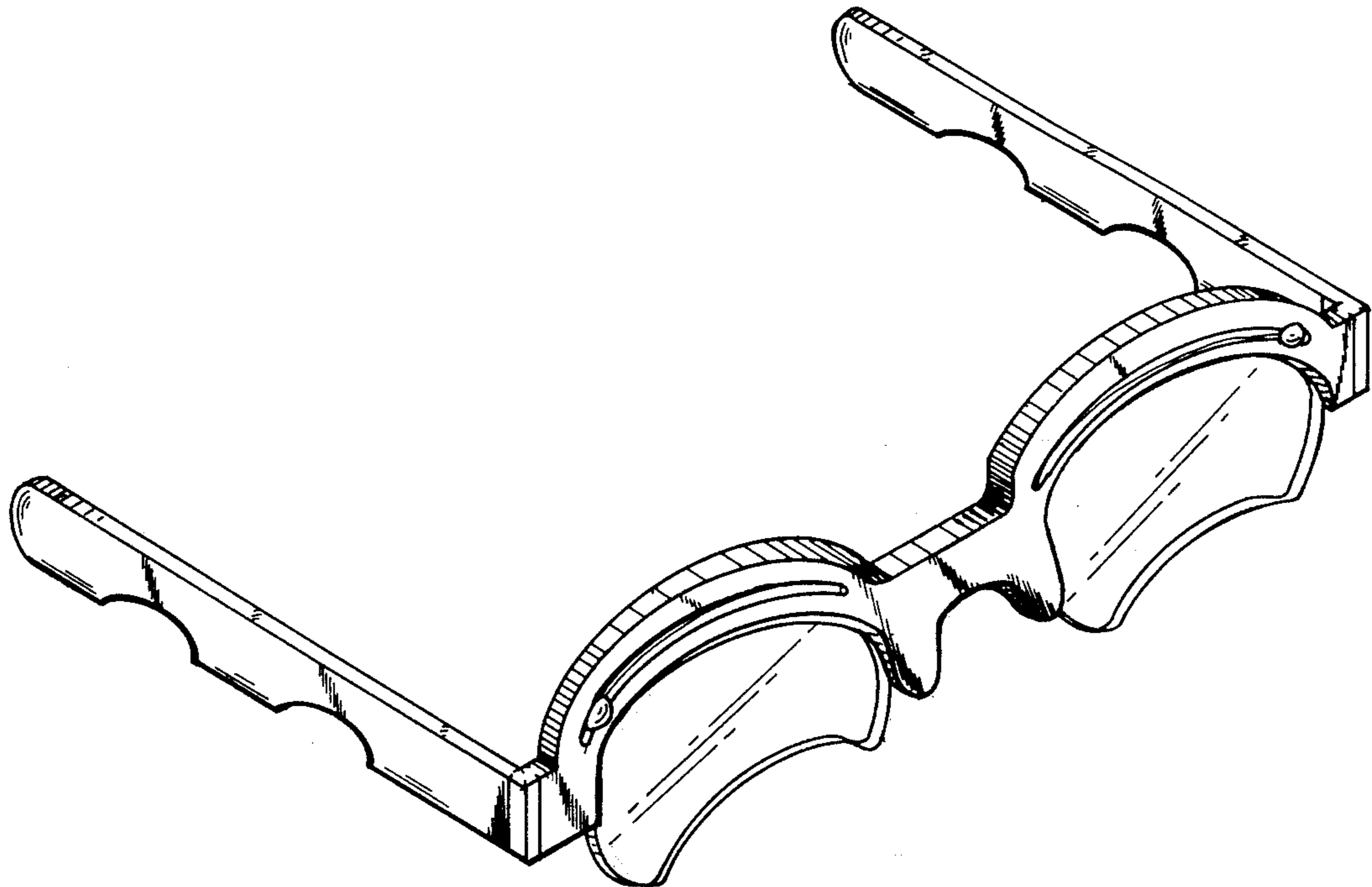

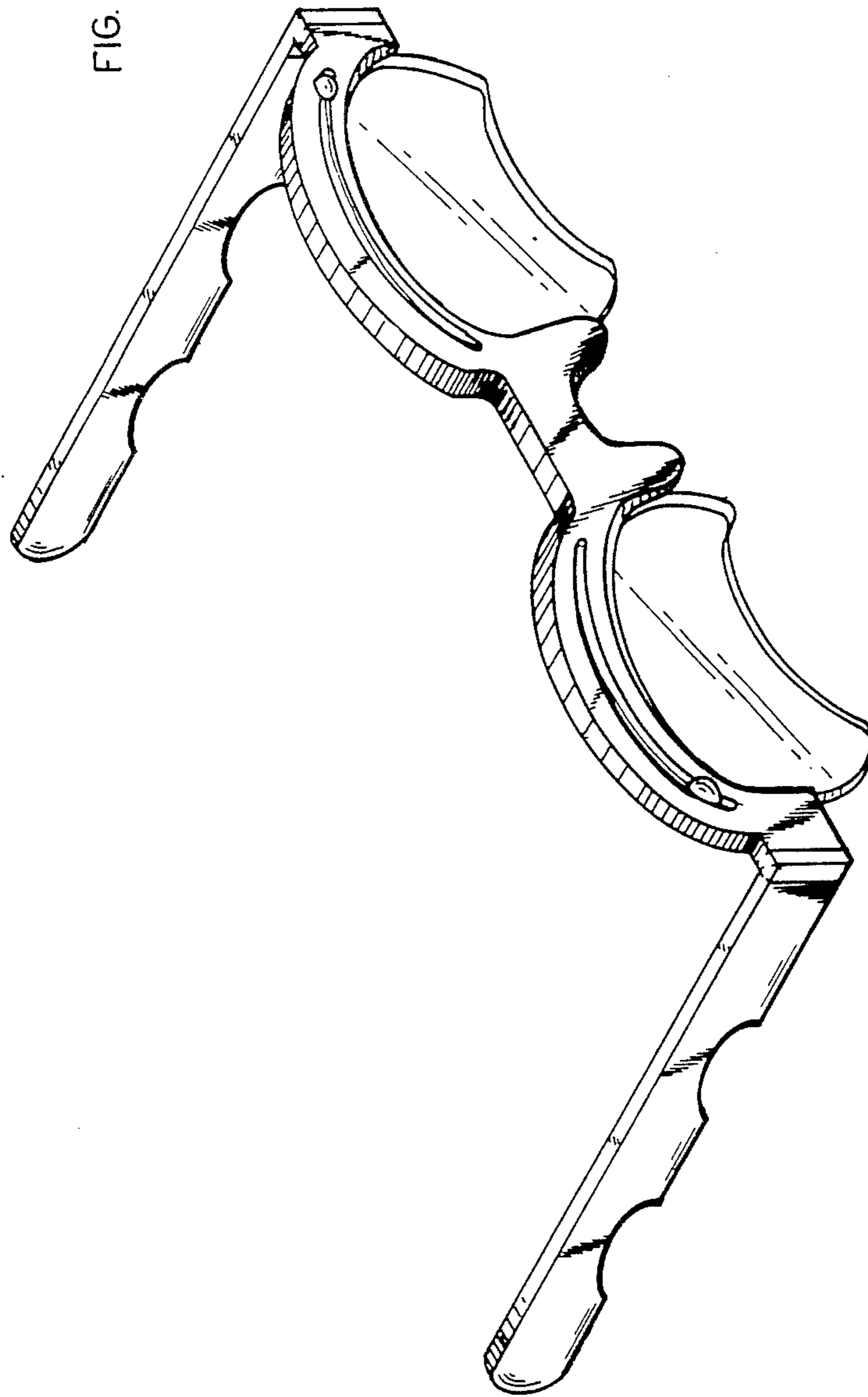

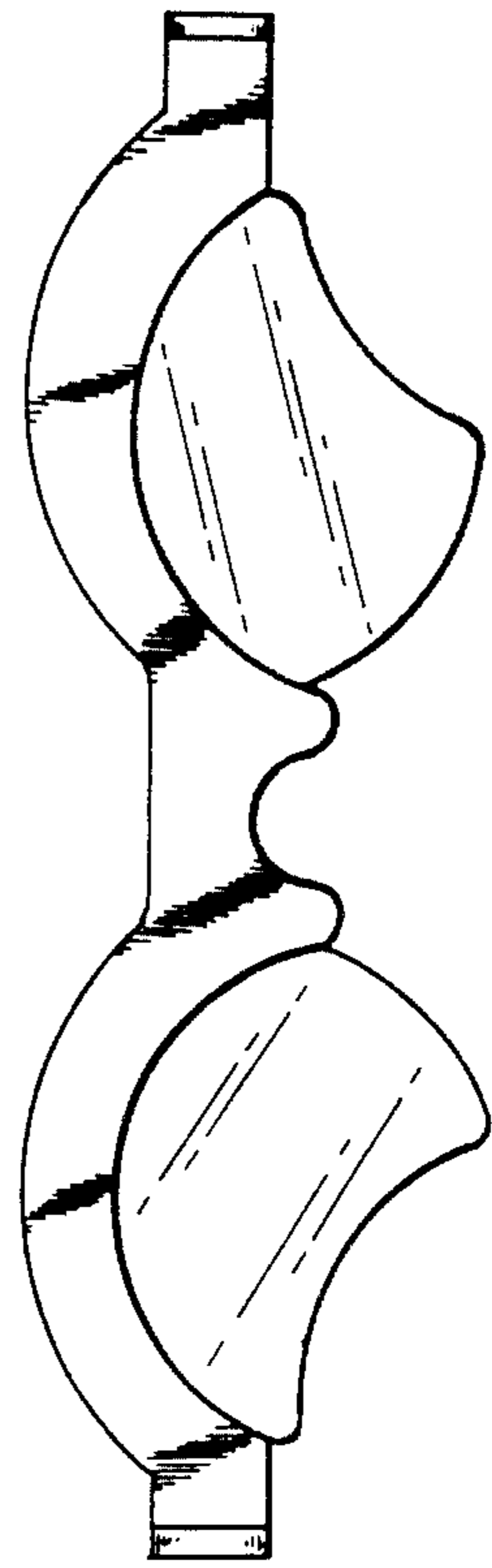

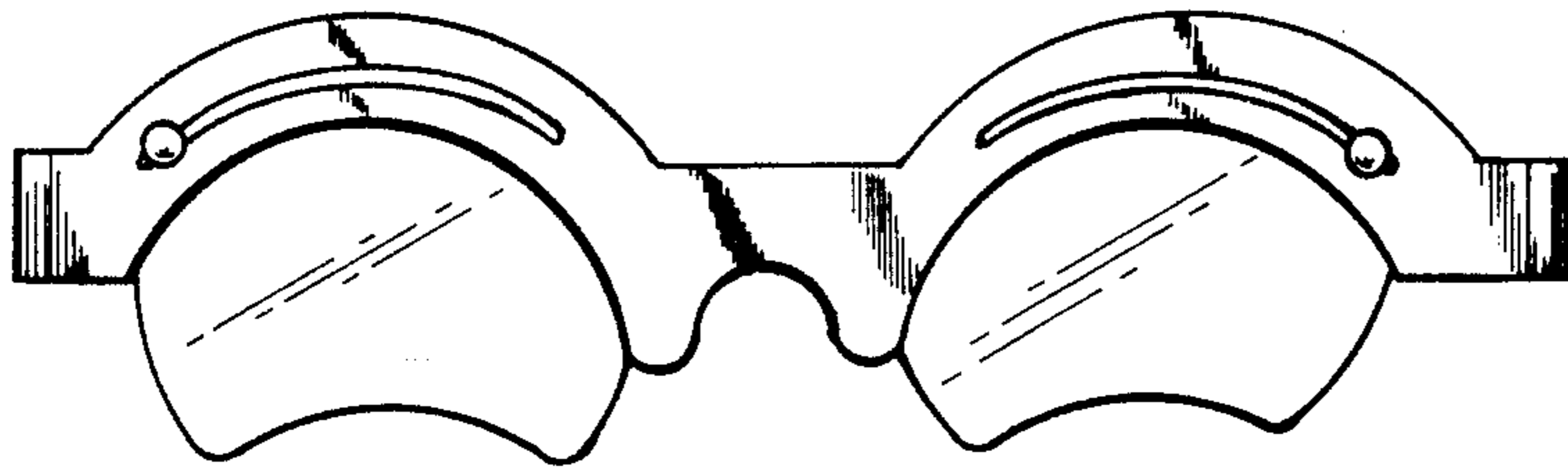

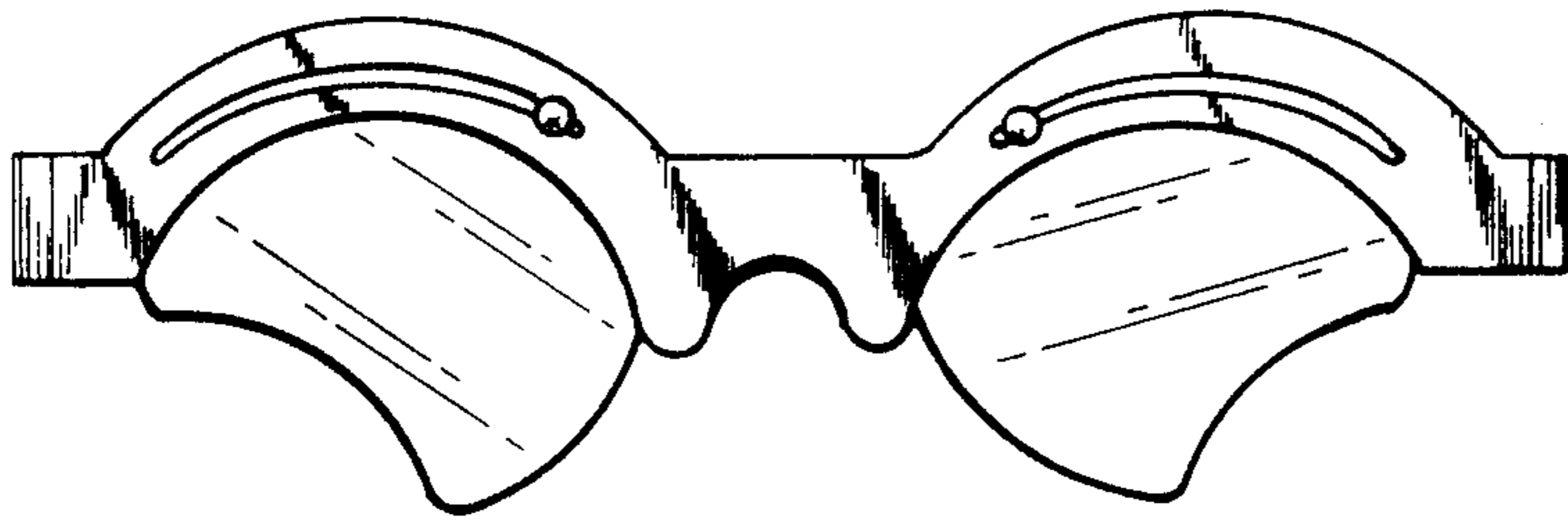

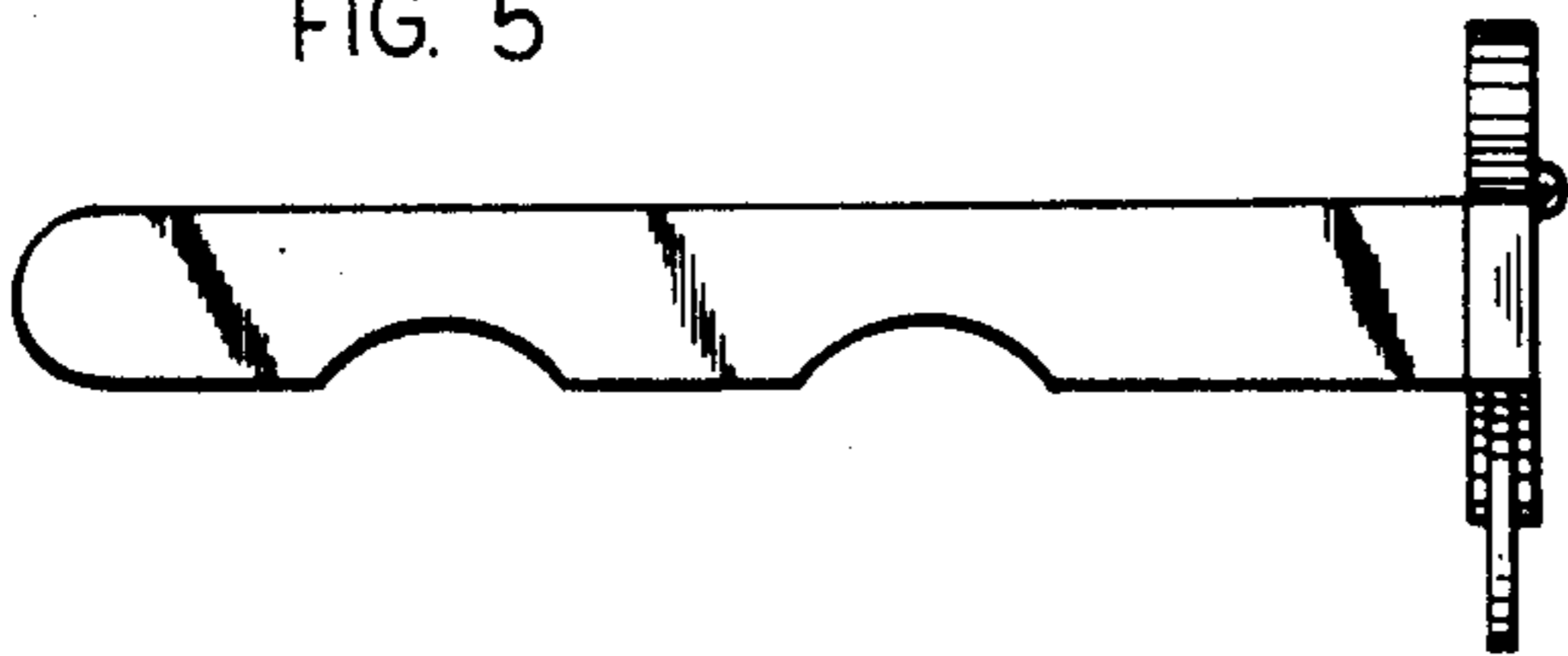

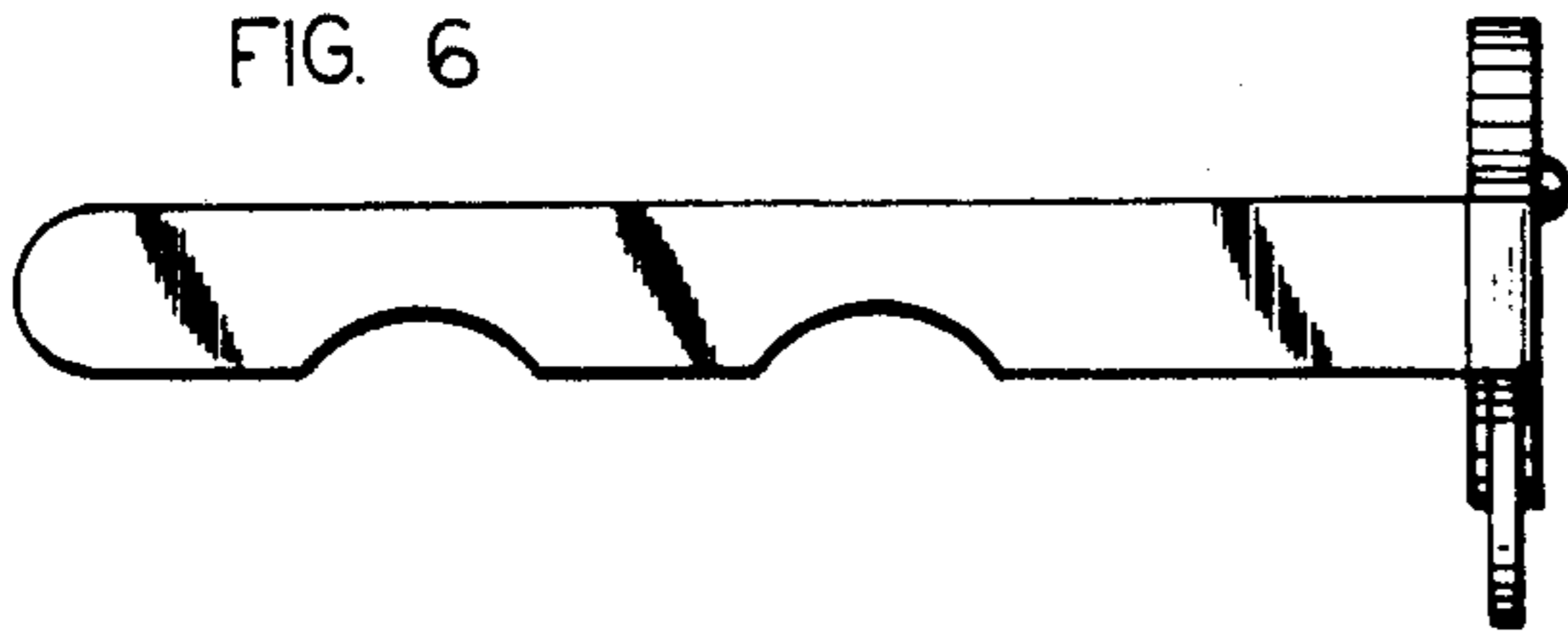

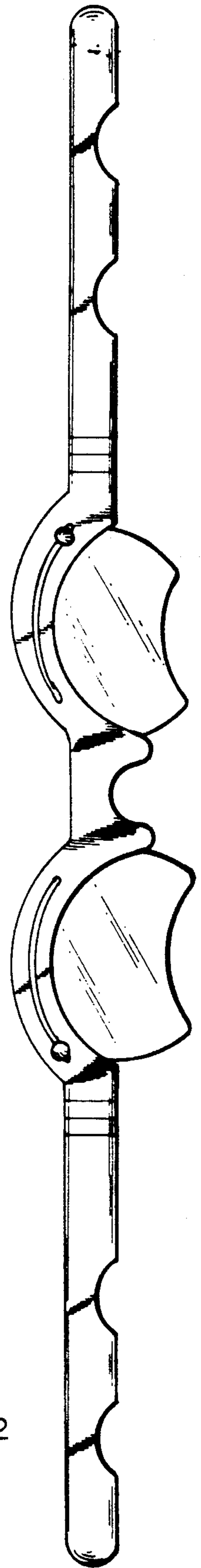

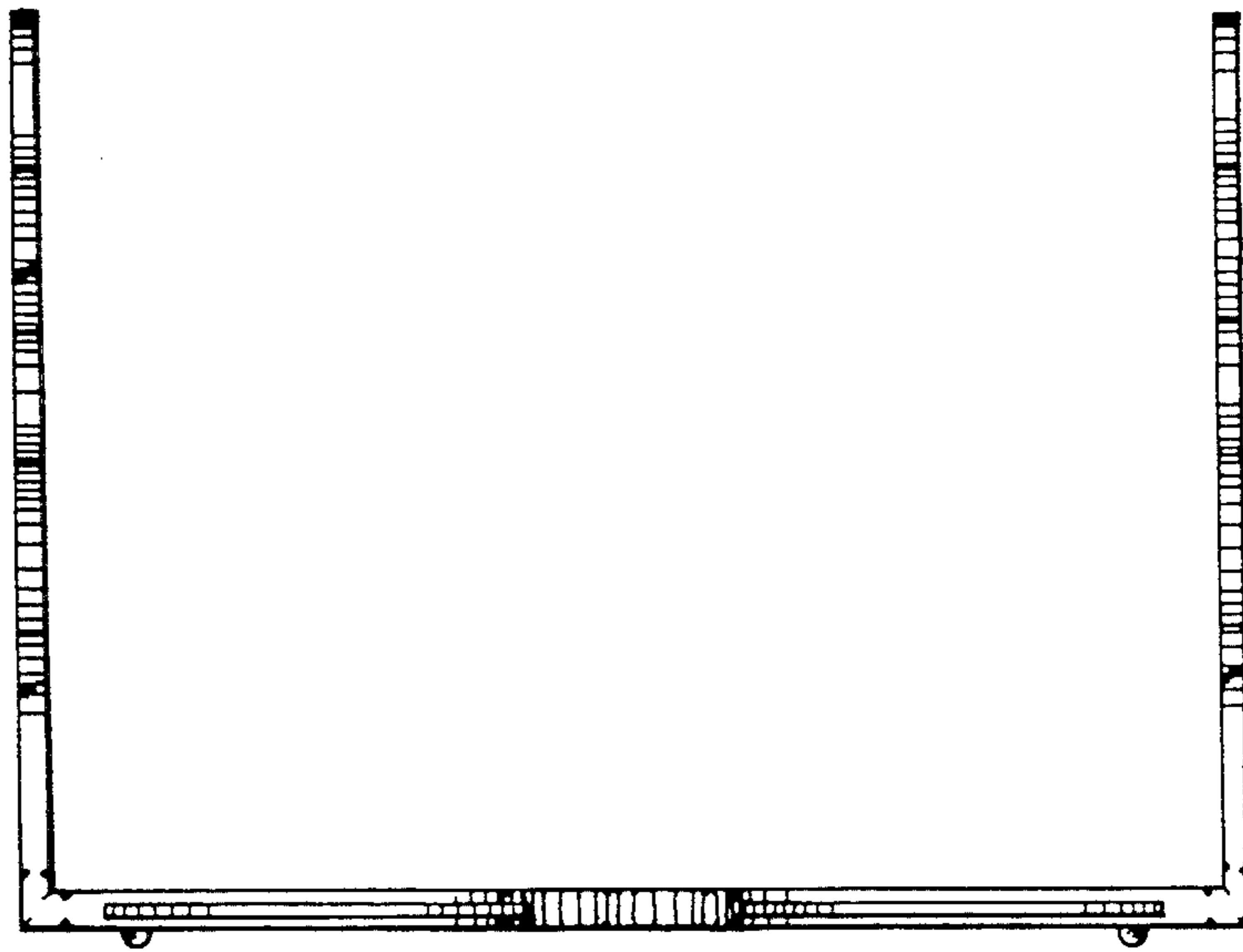
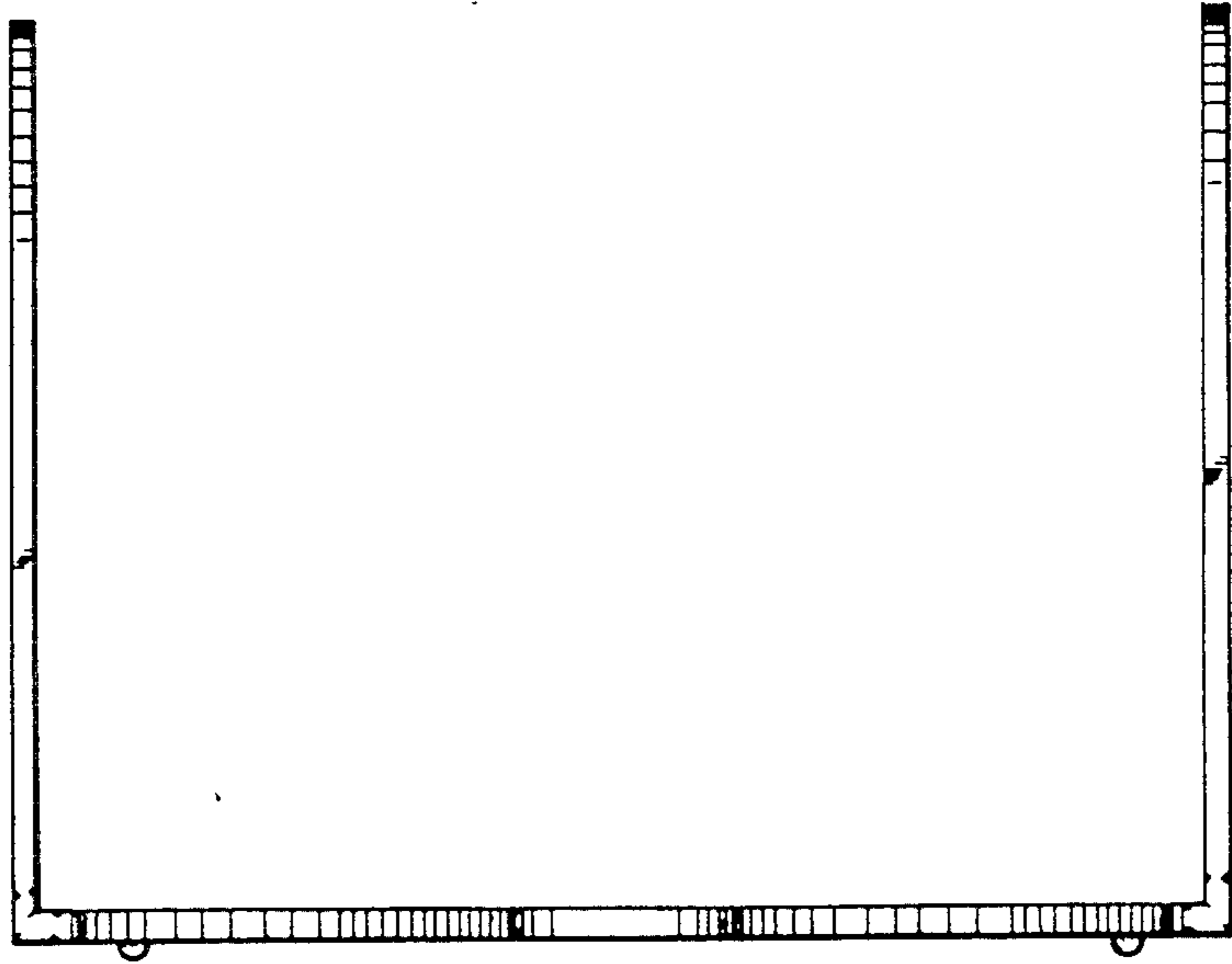
