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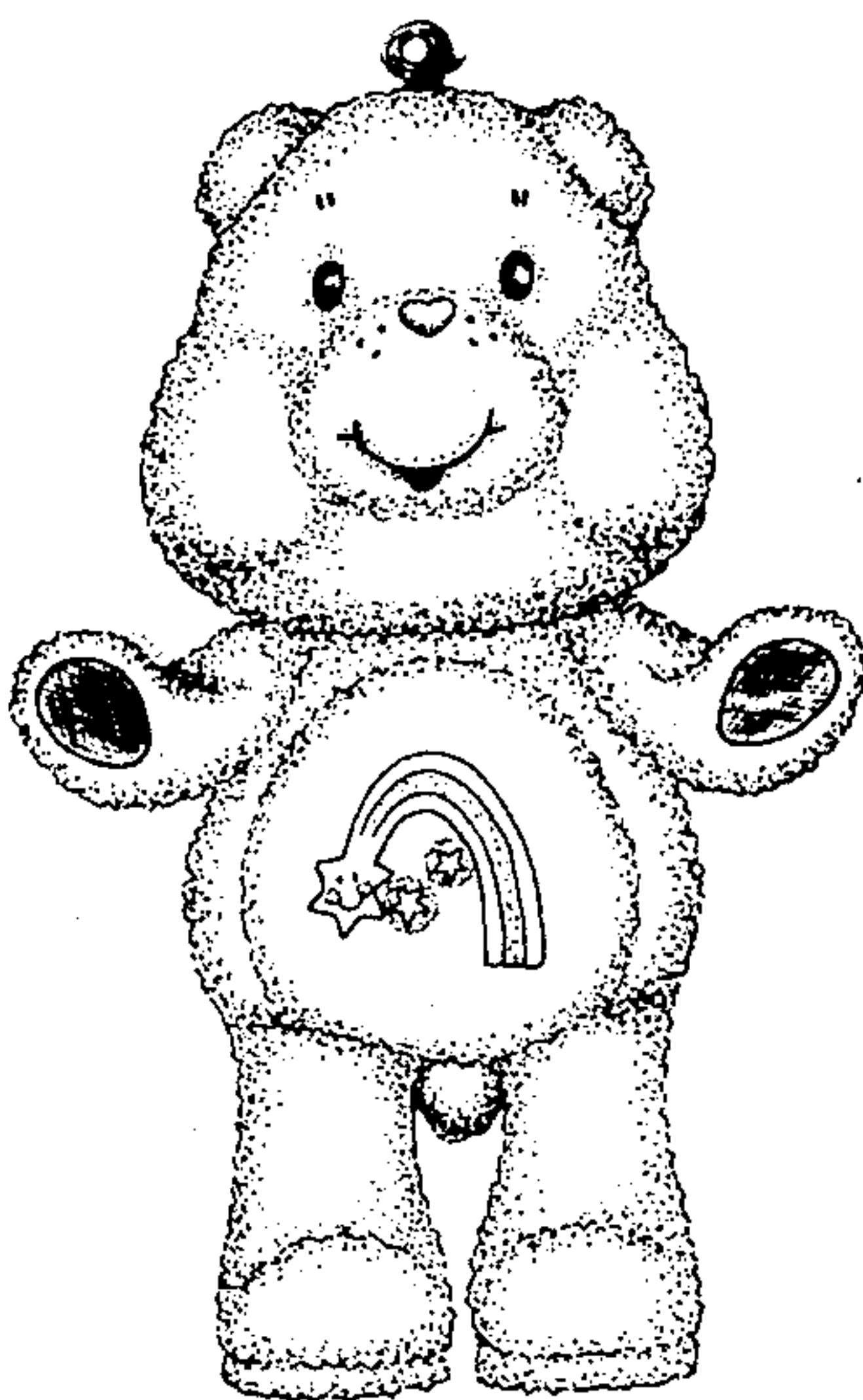
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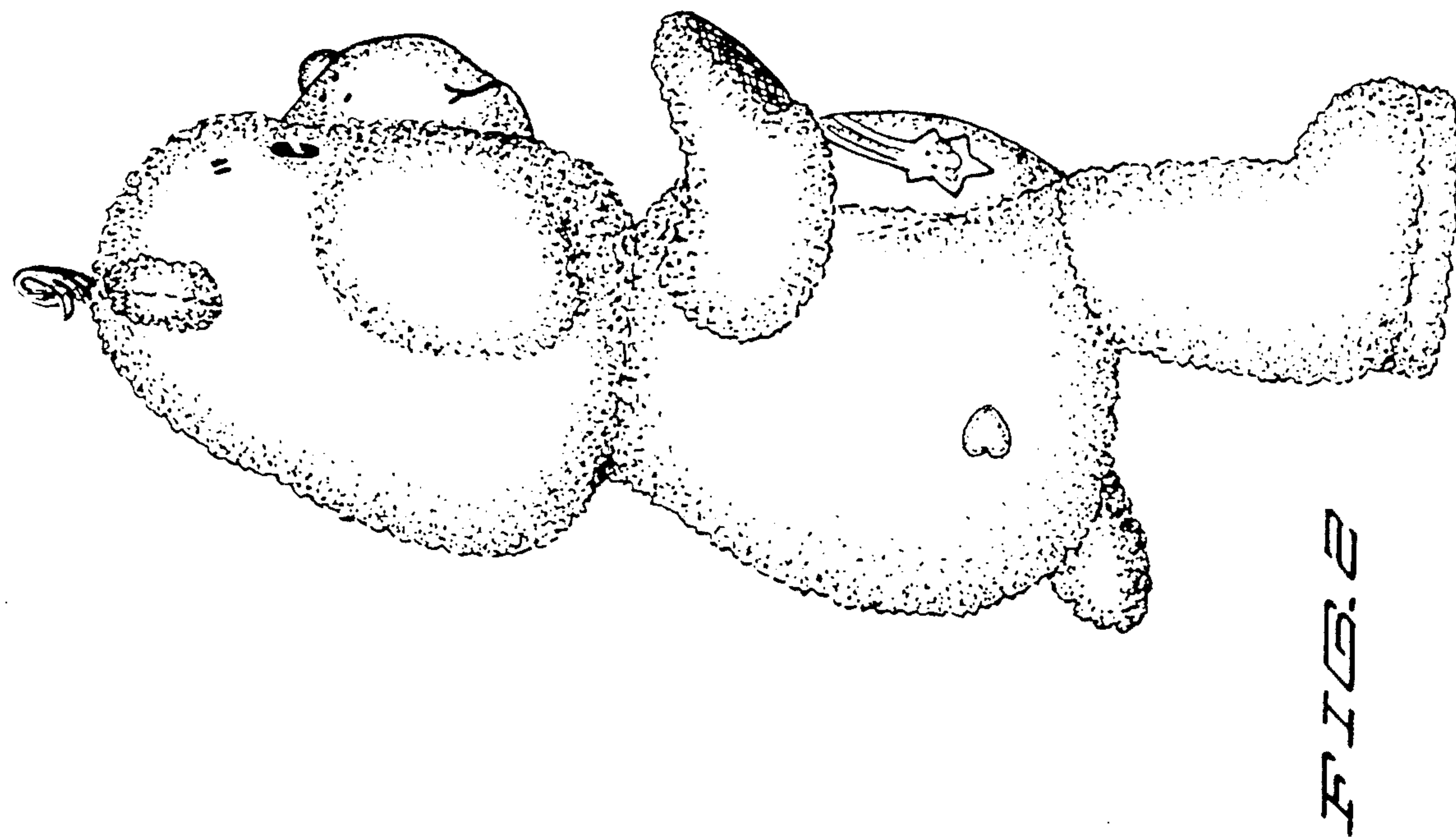
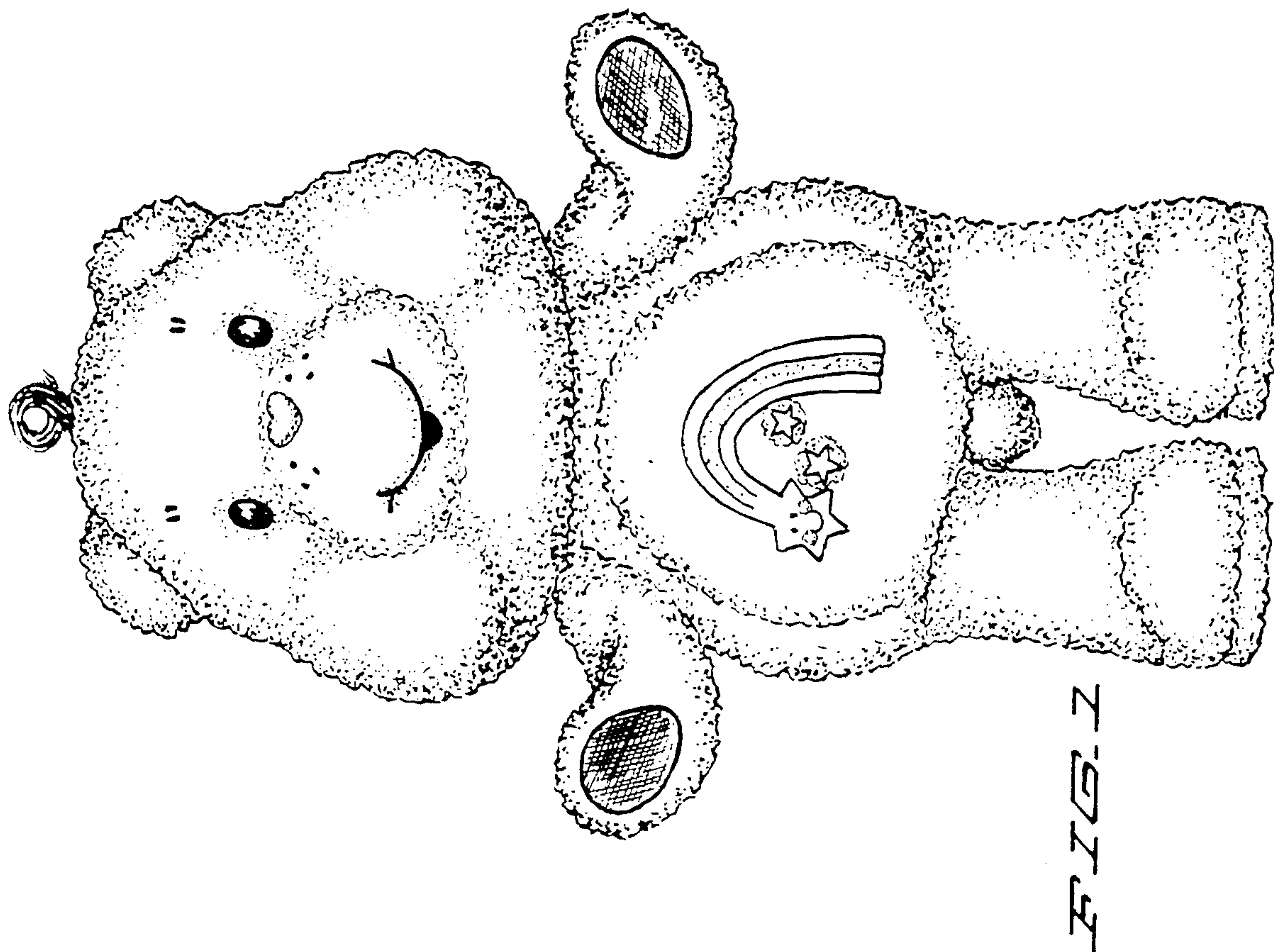
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a toy bear figure
illustrating our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.





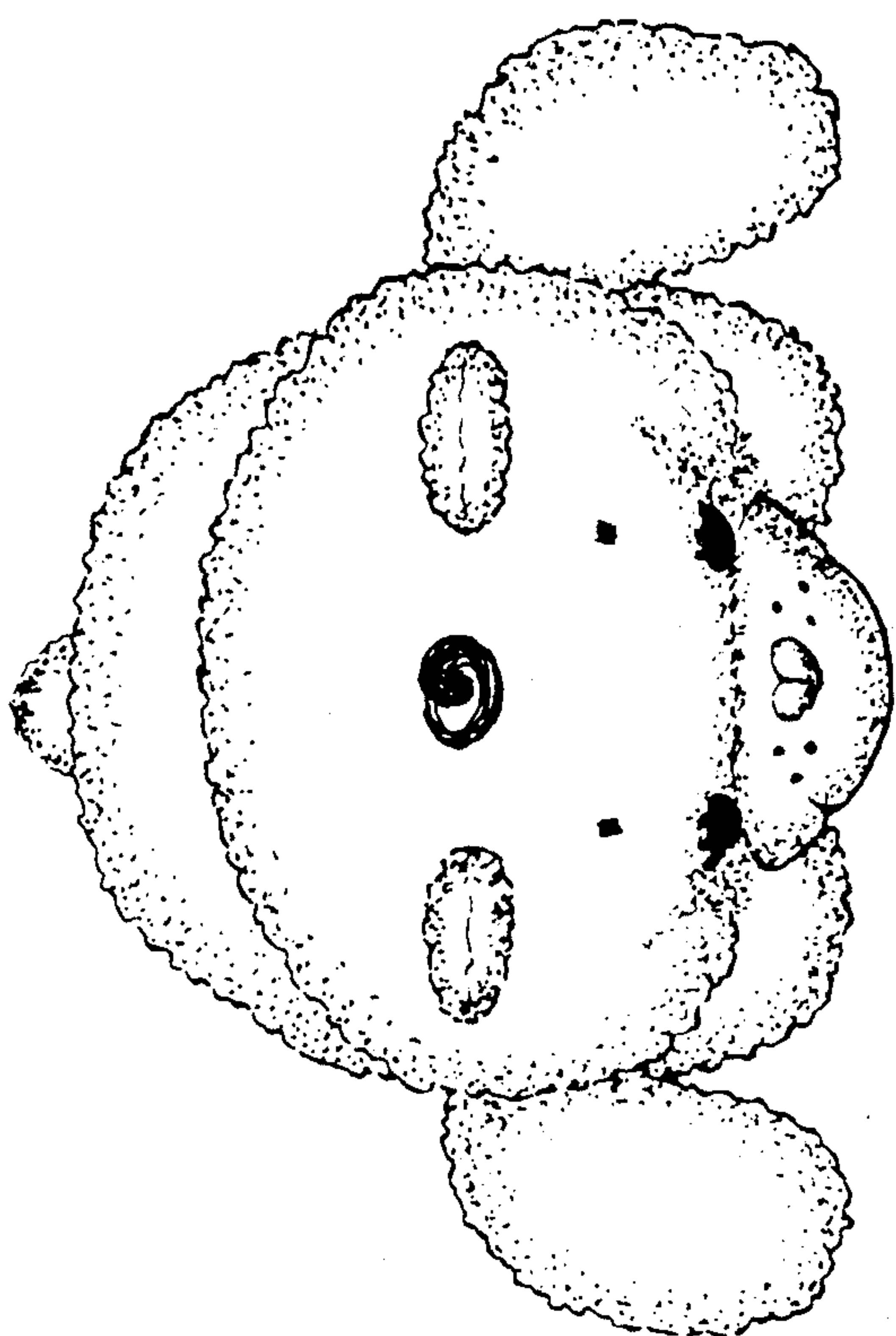

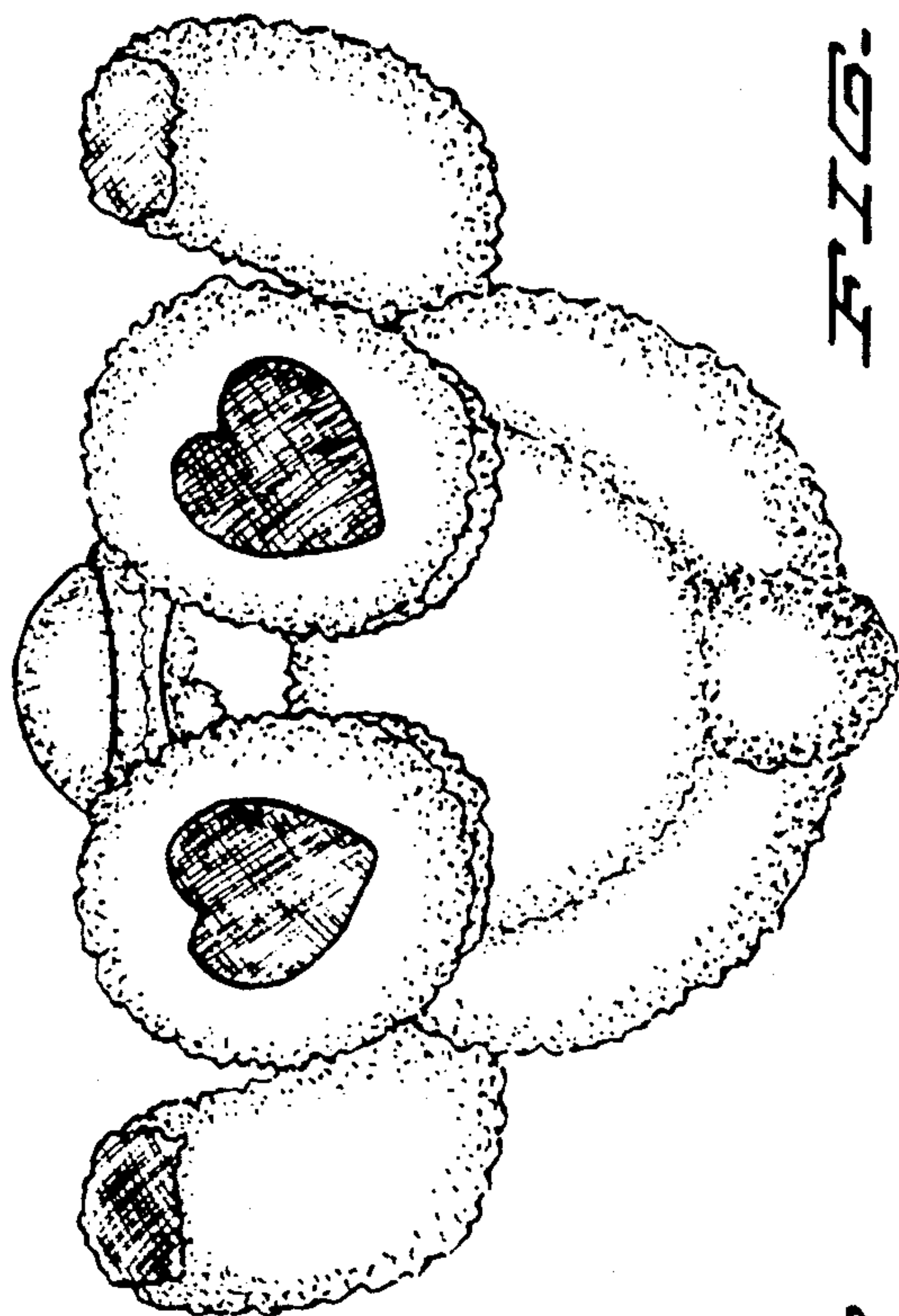

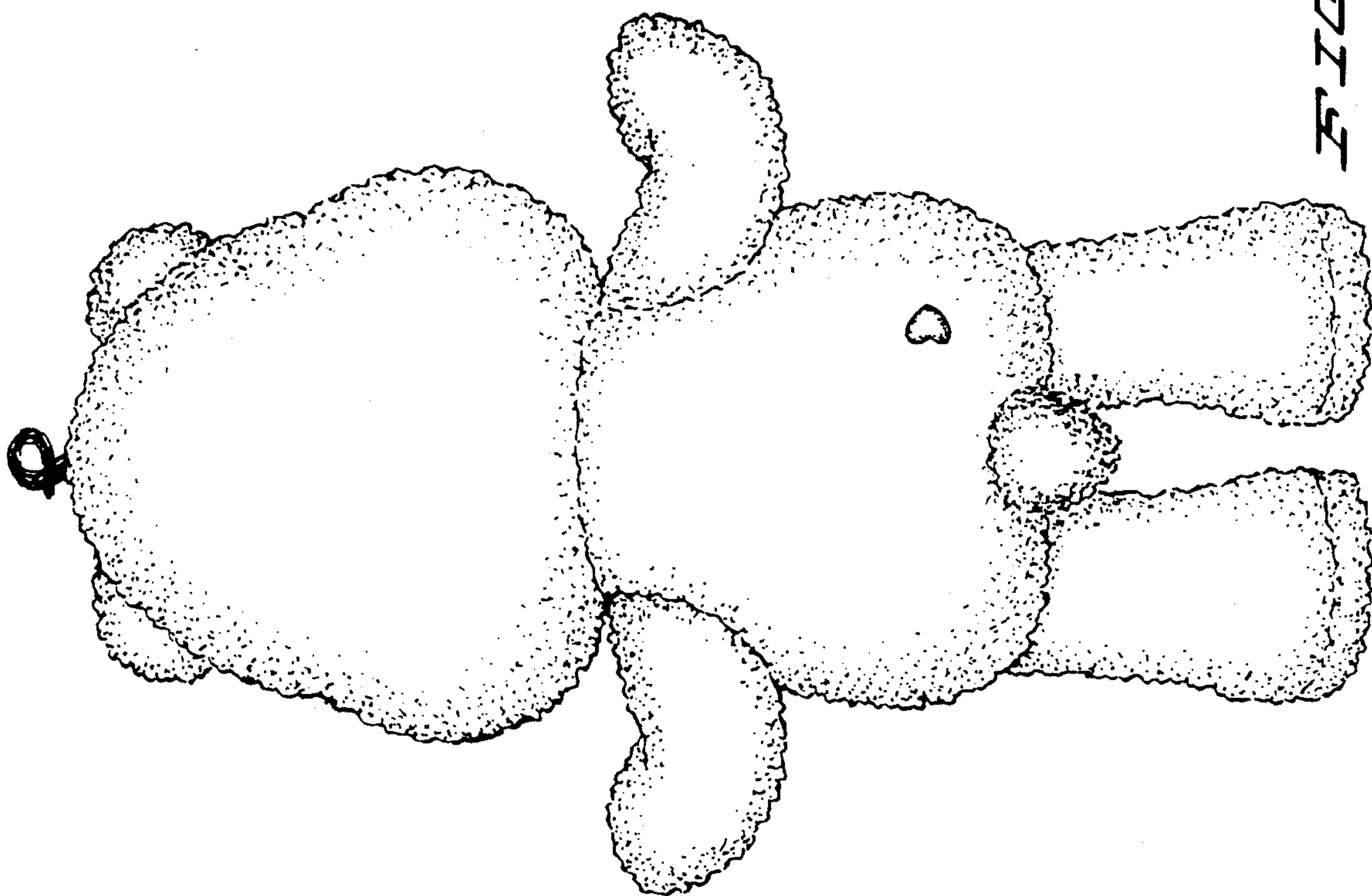
