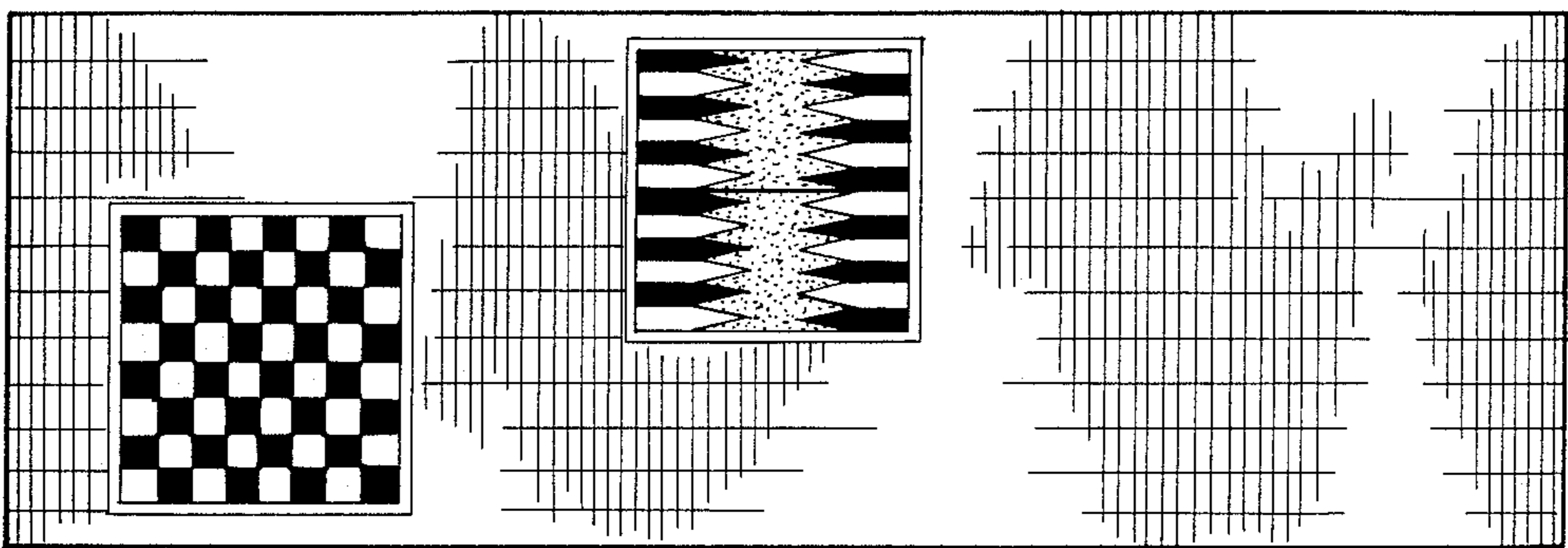

The bottom is a conventional grass weave.



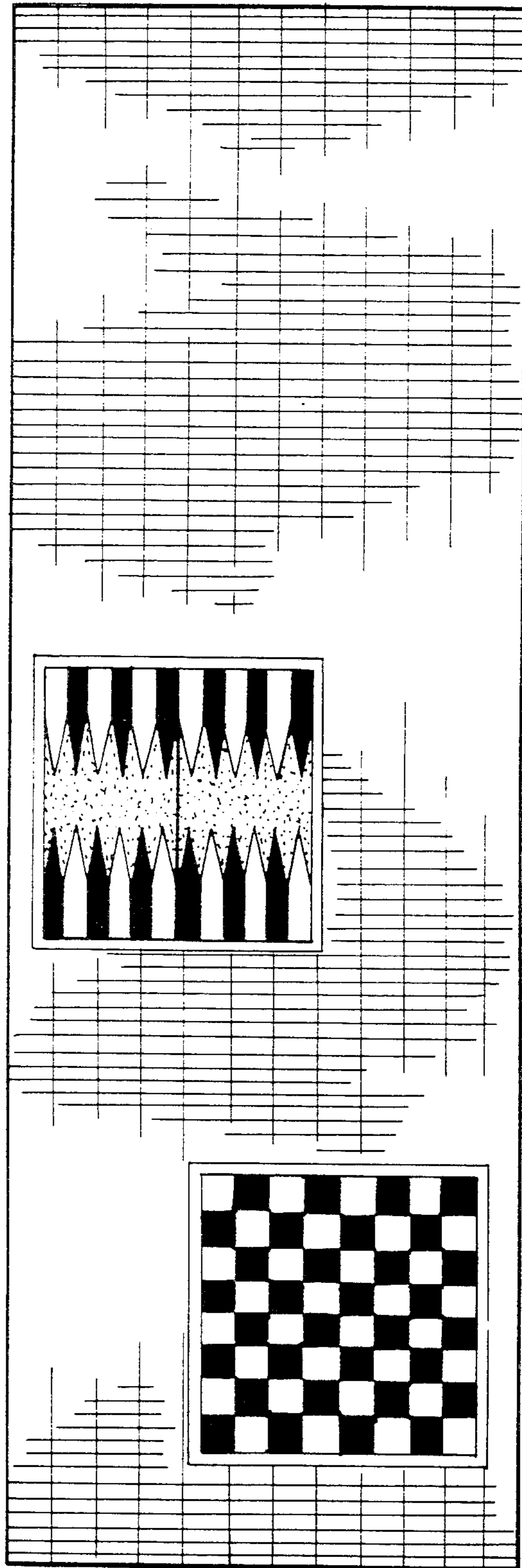


FIG. 1
