FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side view being the same.

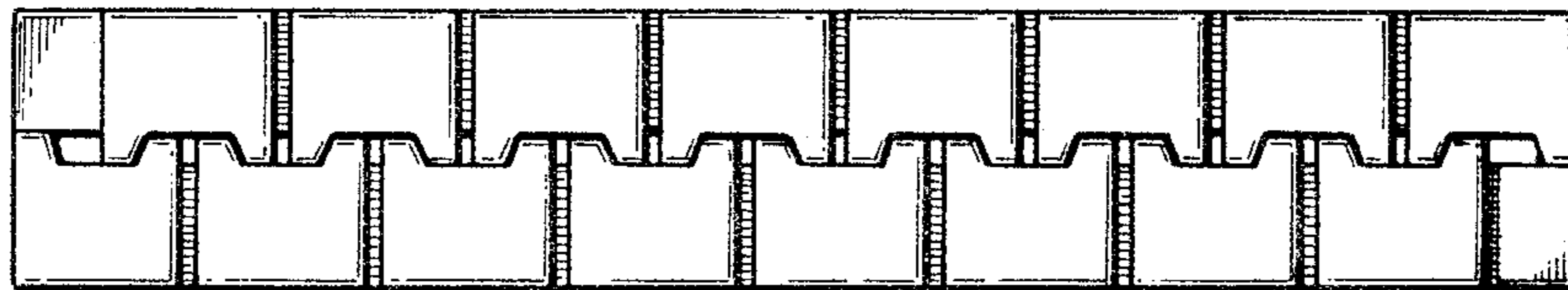

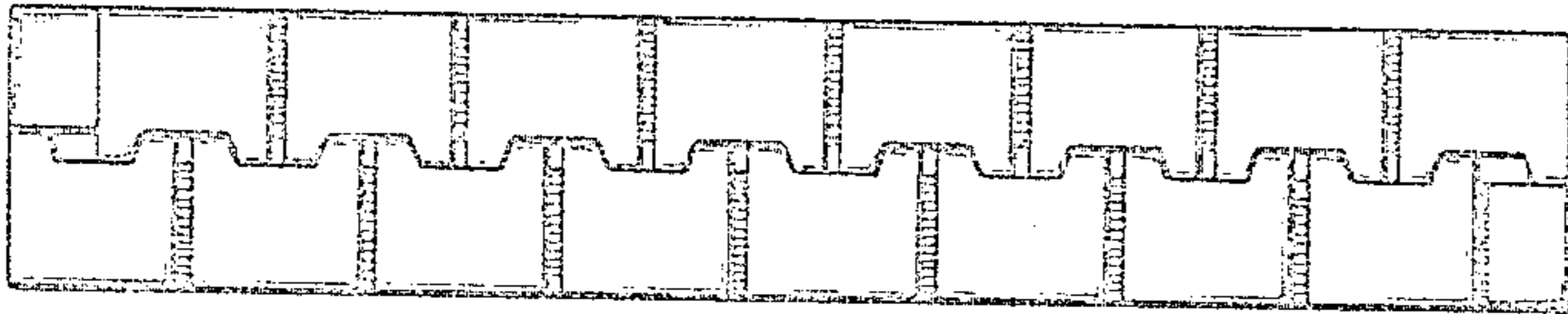
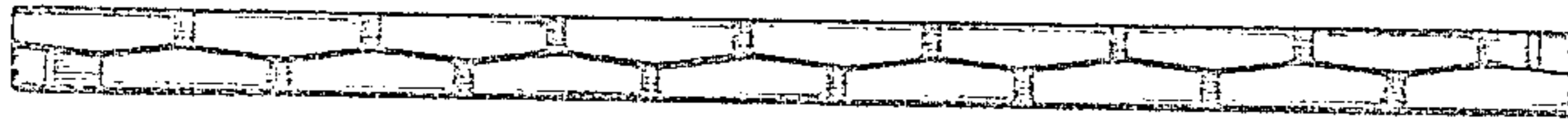
