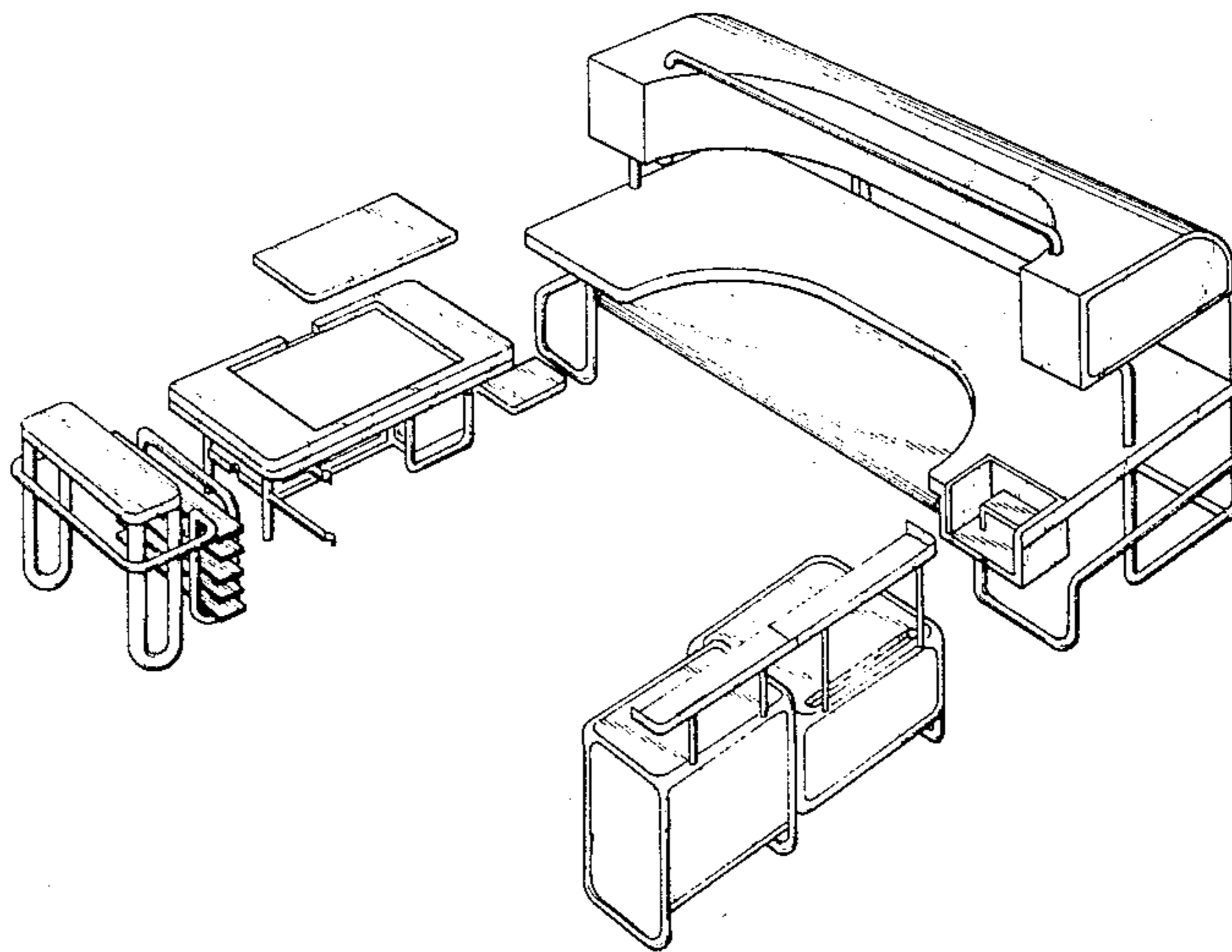

FIG. 7 is an exploded perspective view thereof.



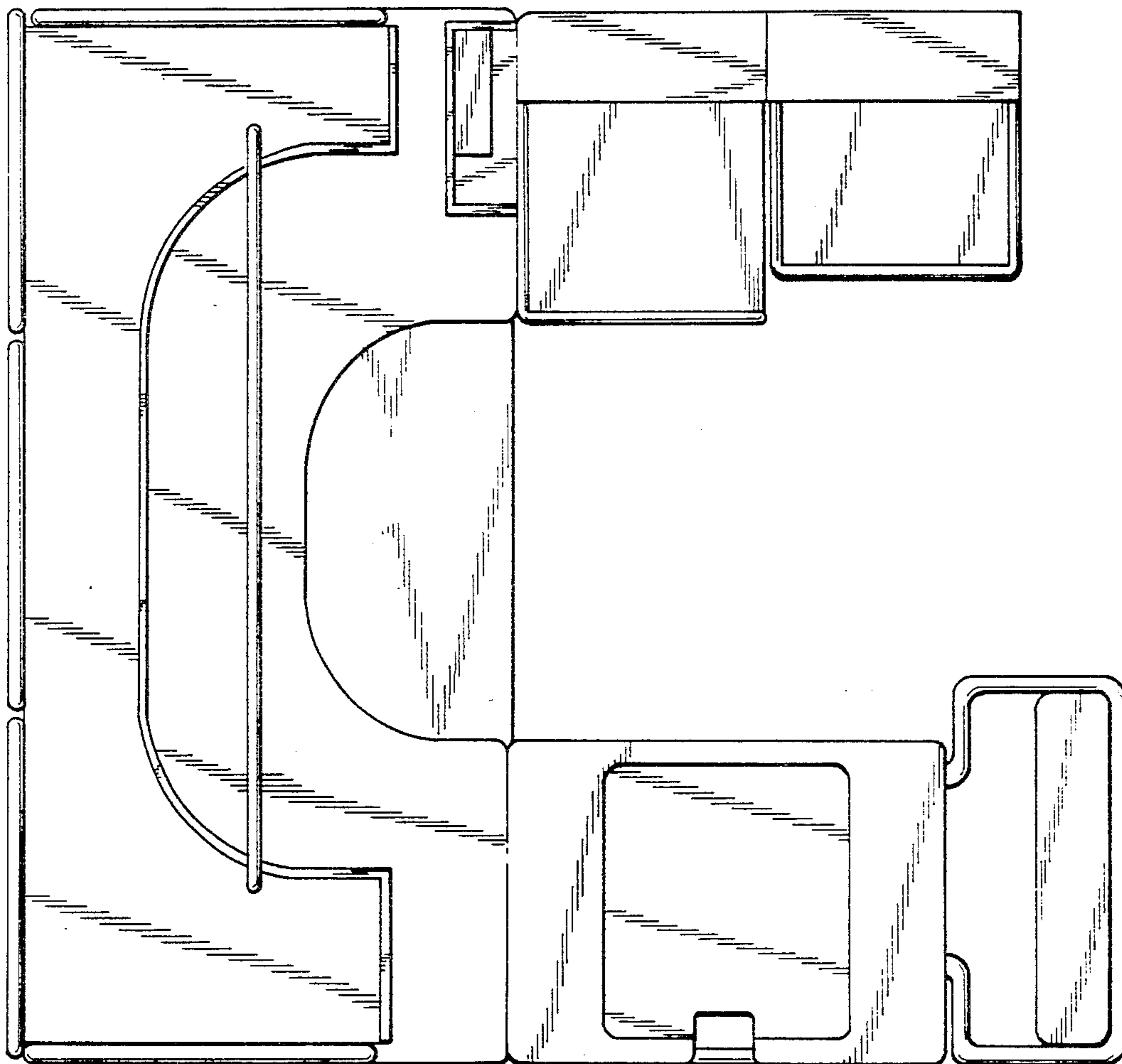

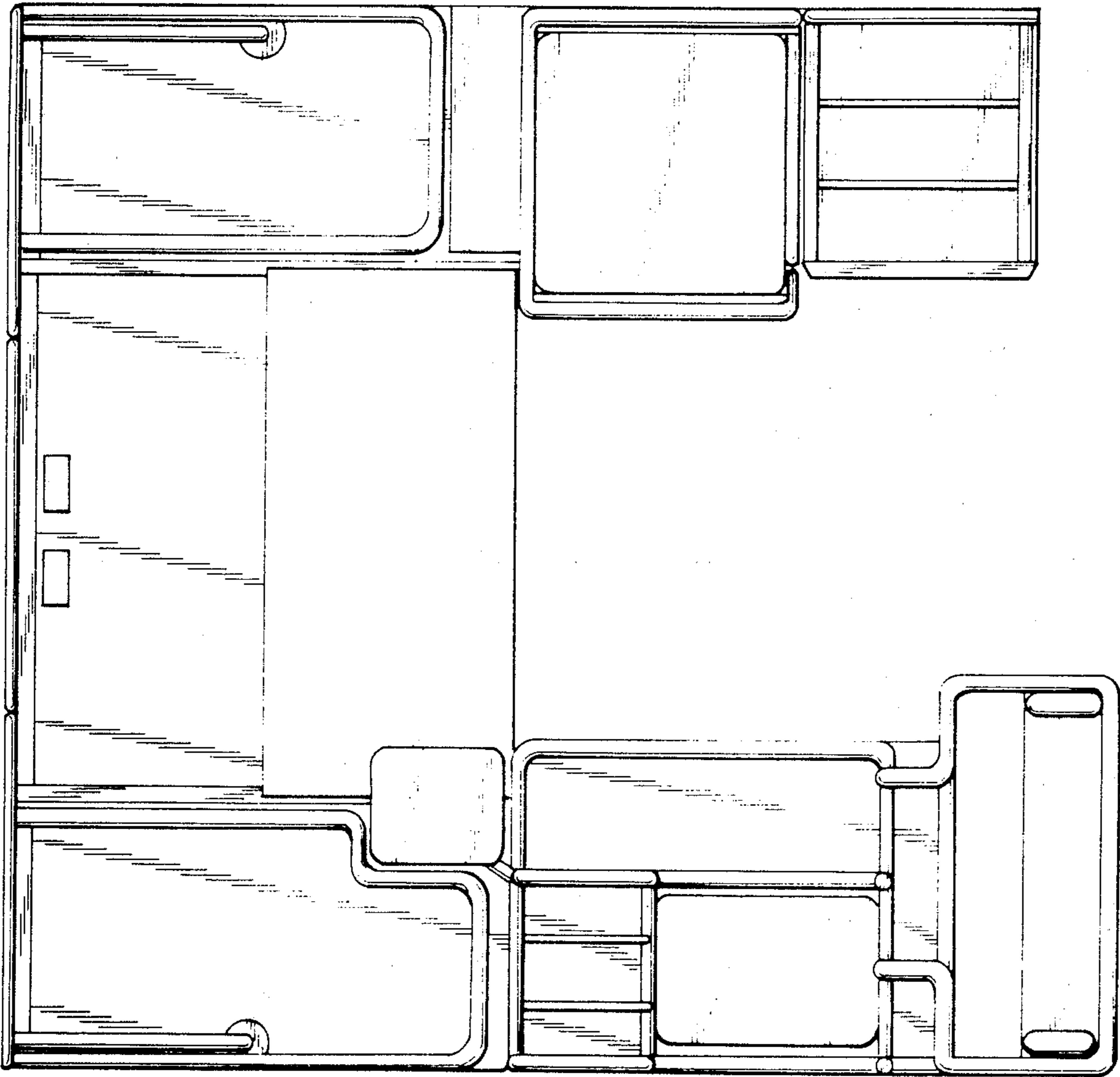

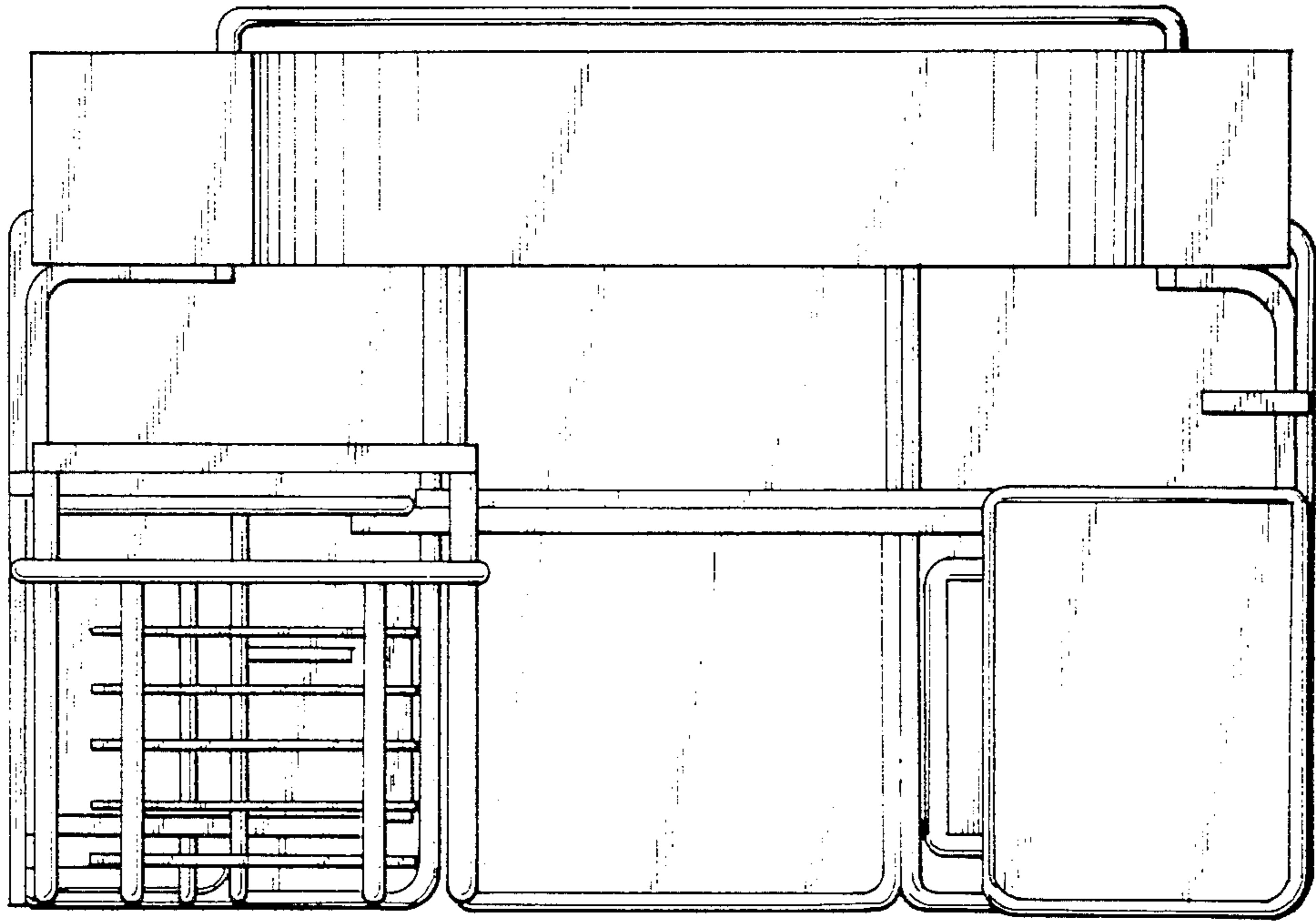

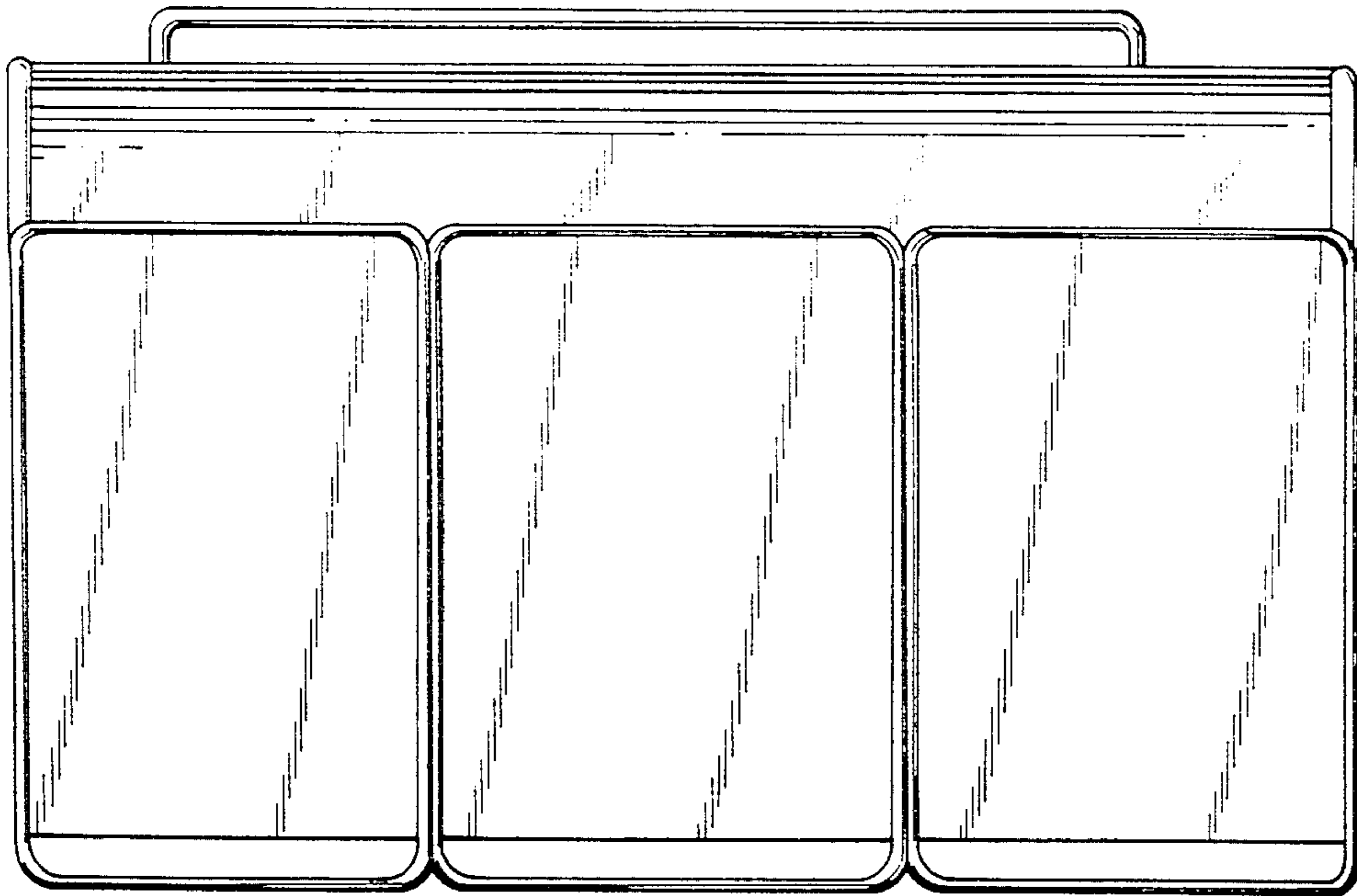

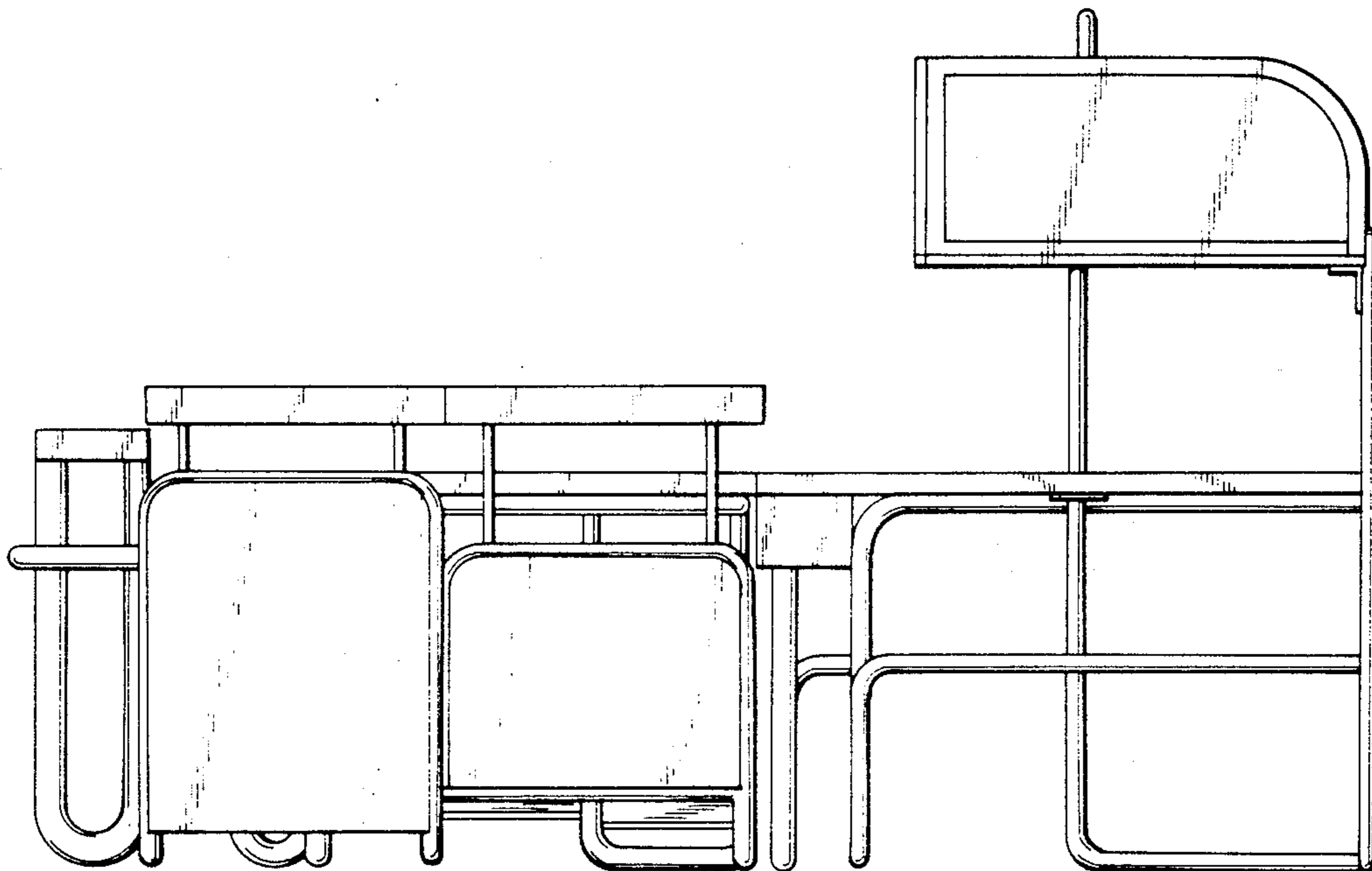

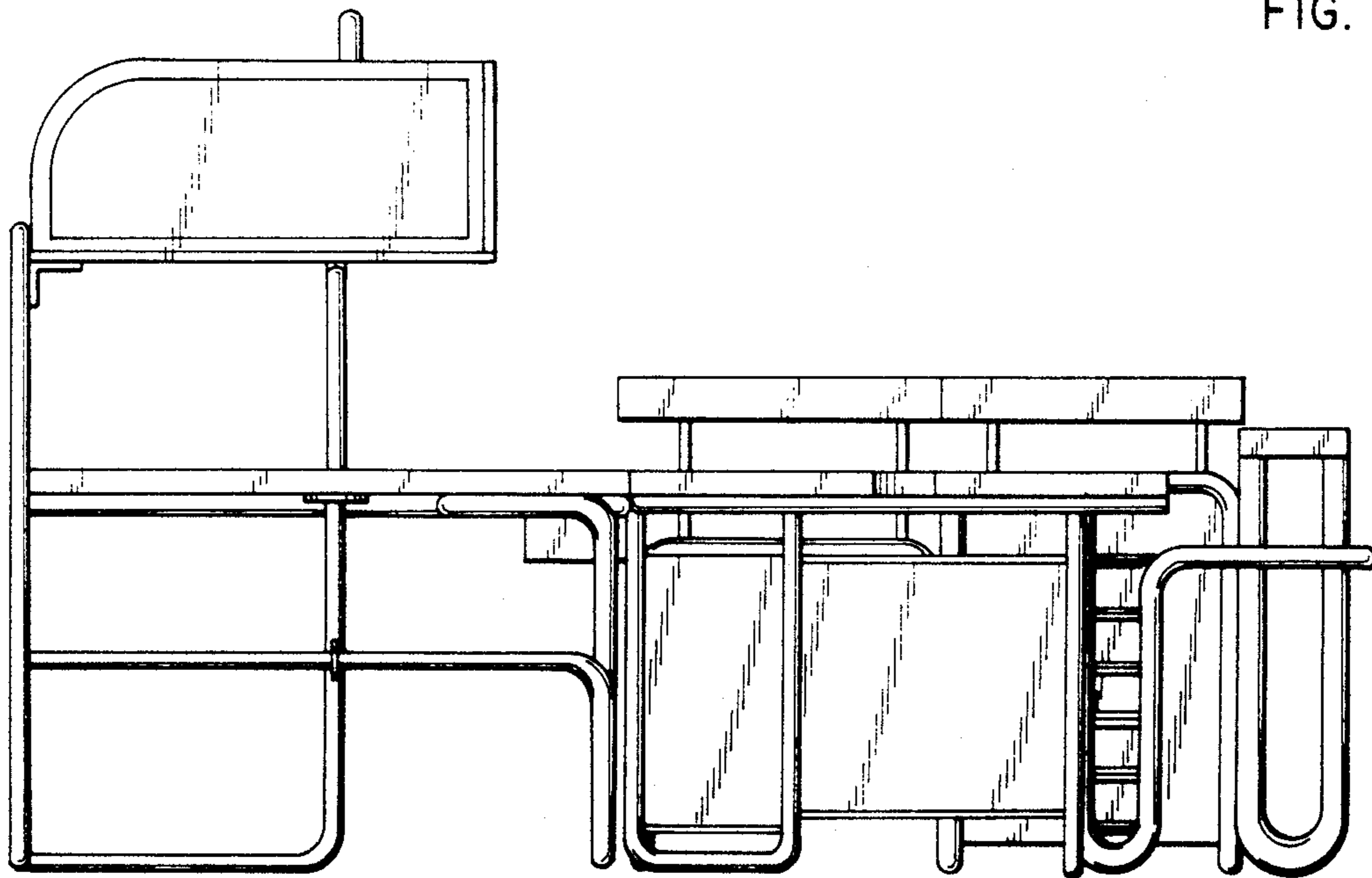

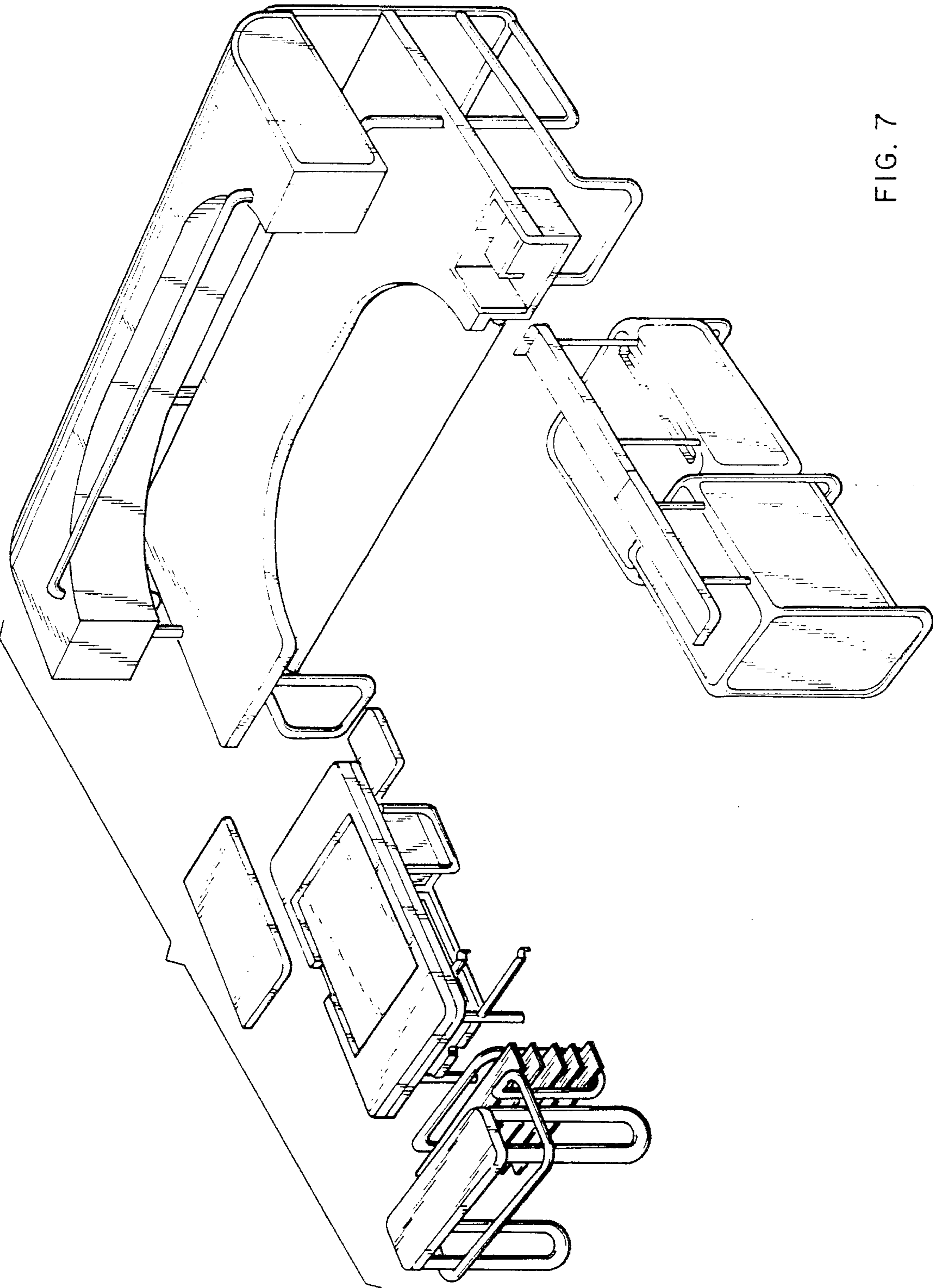
