DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, perspective view of a display case for cutlery merchandise or the like showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof.

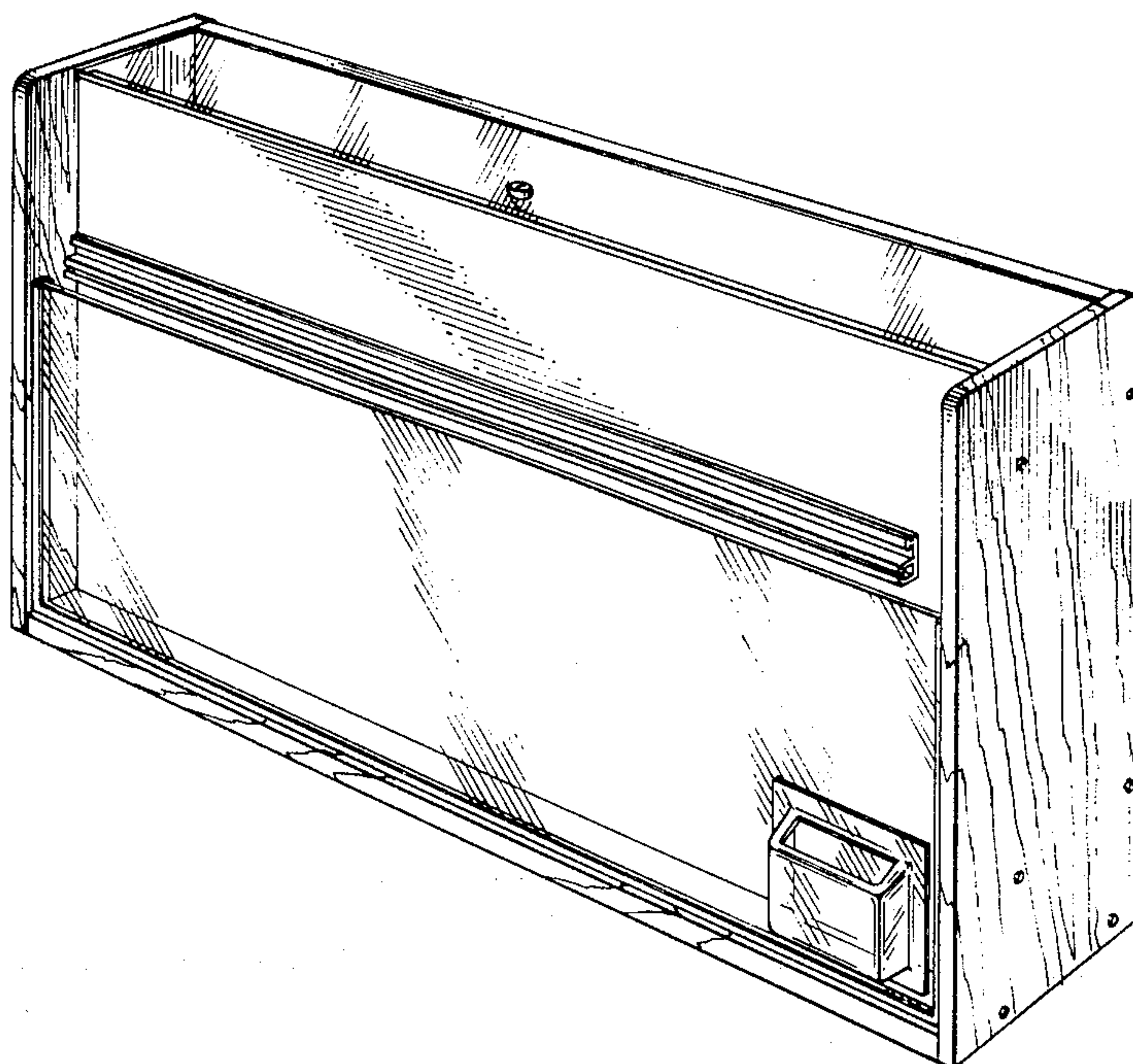

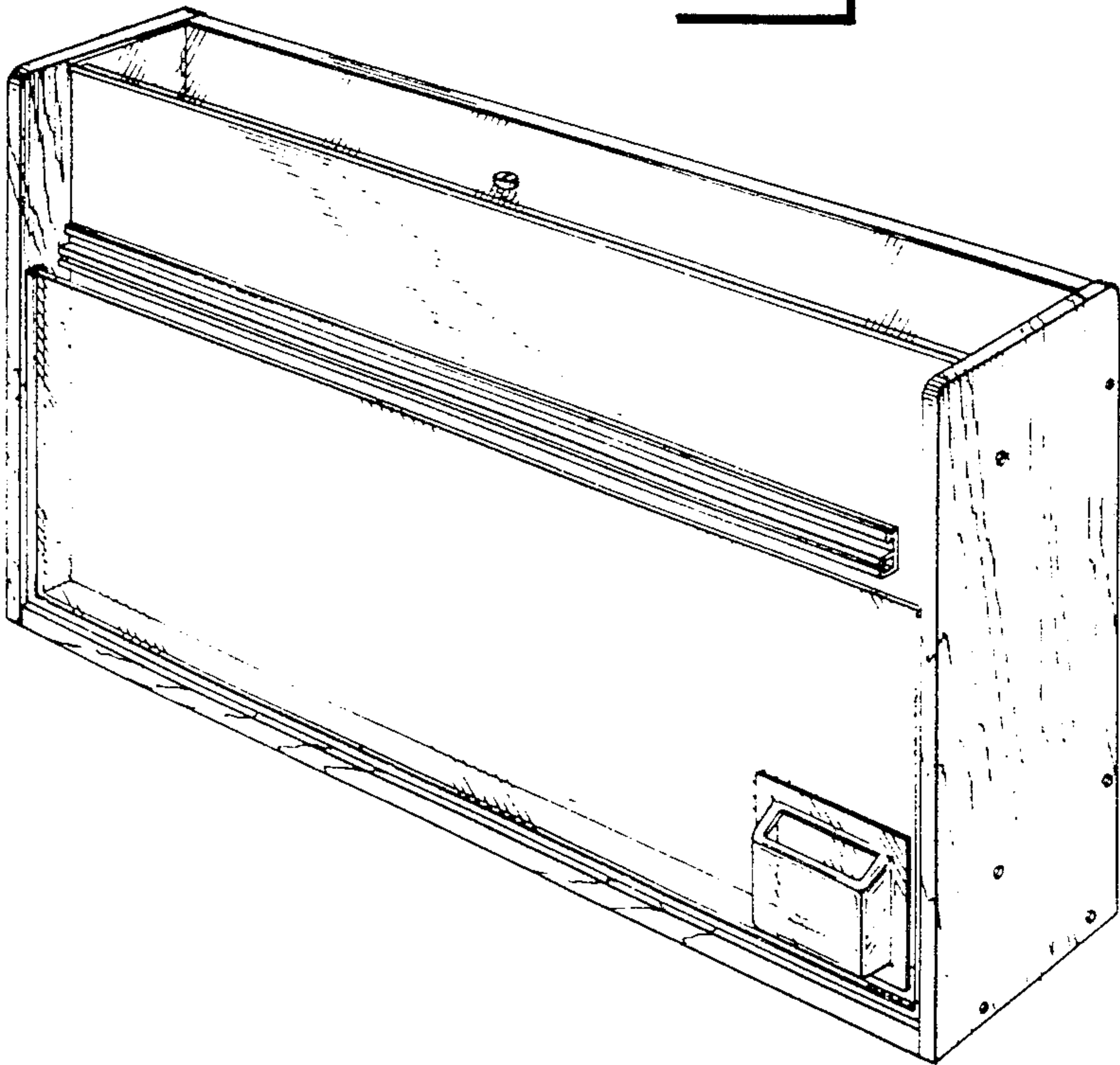

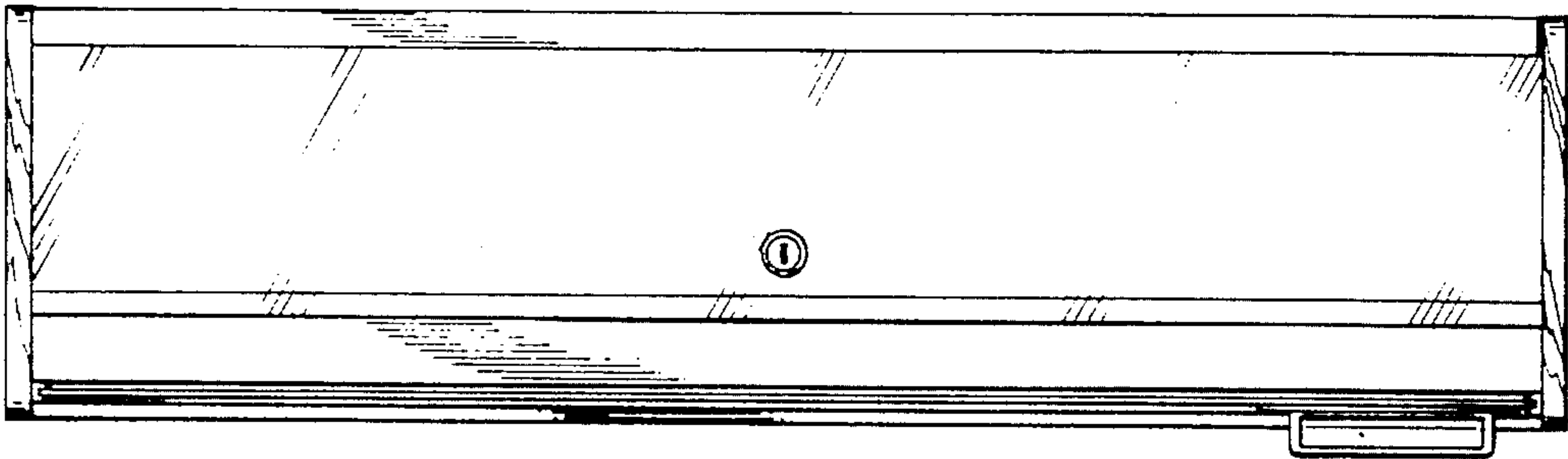

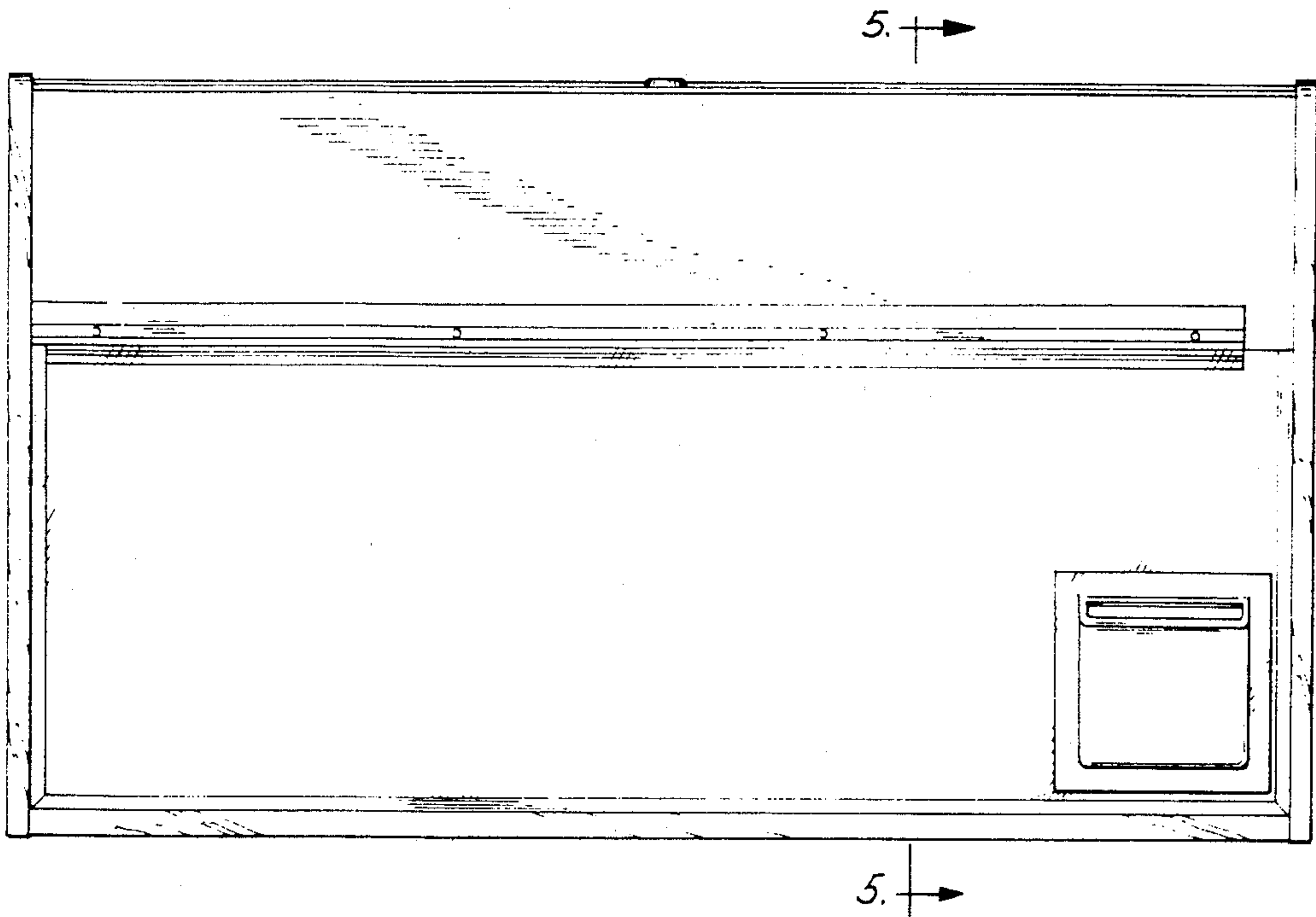

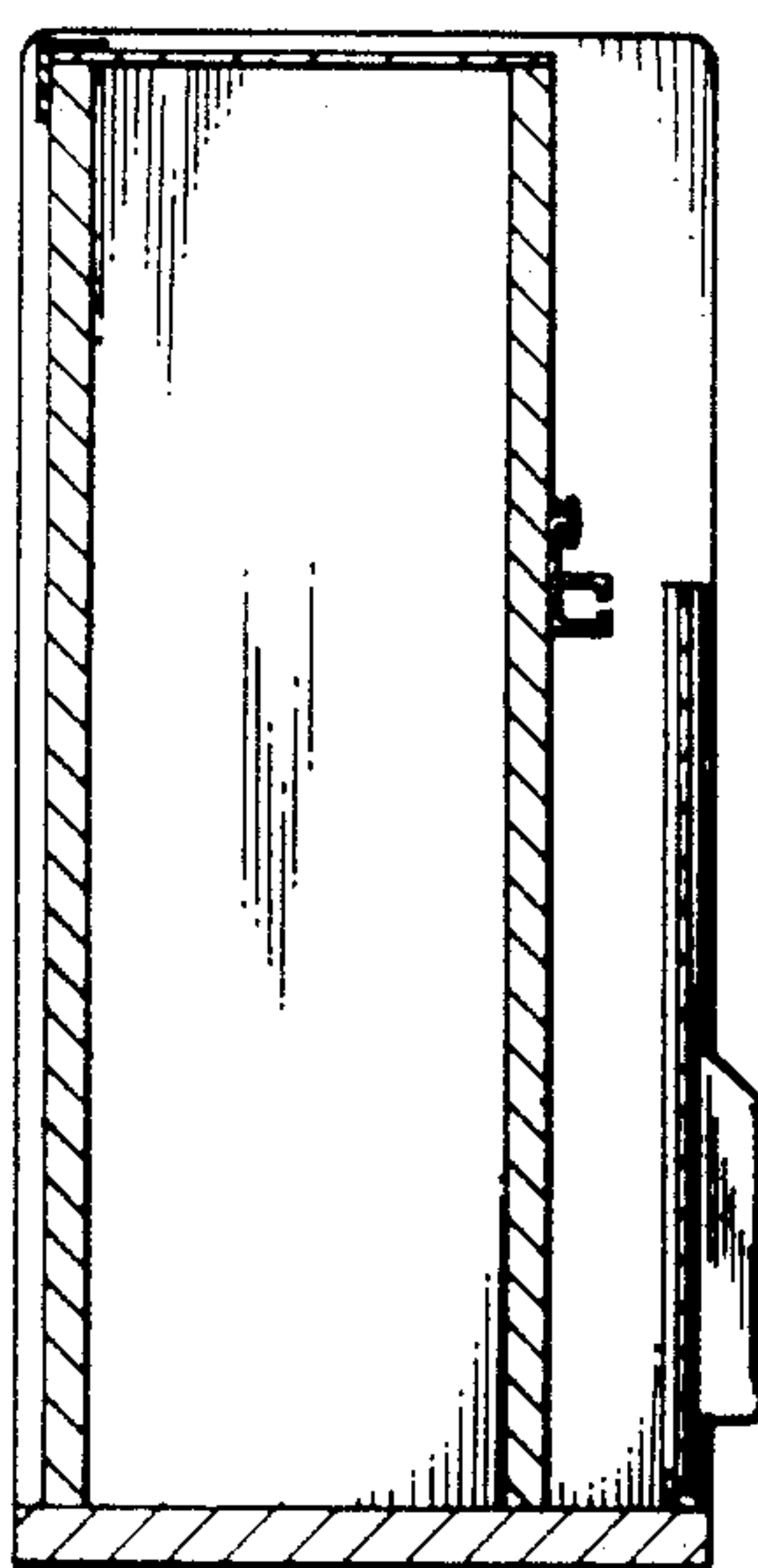

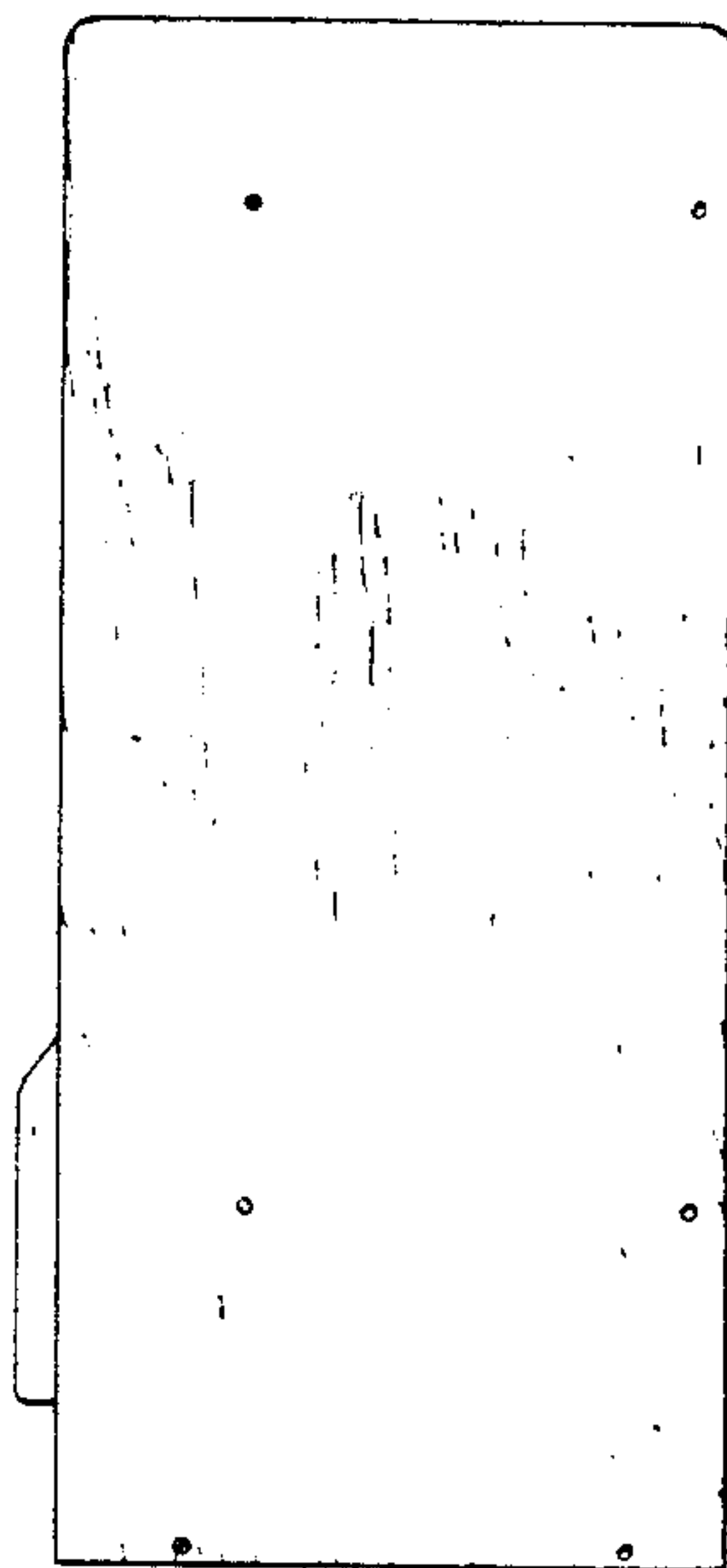
