[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a carton blank, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

The FIGURE is a plan view of the carton blank showing our new design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof. The blank is of conventional thickness. The lighter dot and dash lines represent fold lines and the heavy dash lines represent perforations in the carton blank.
