DESCRIPTION

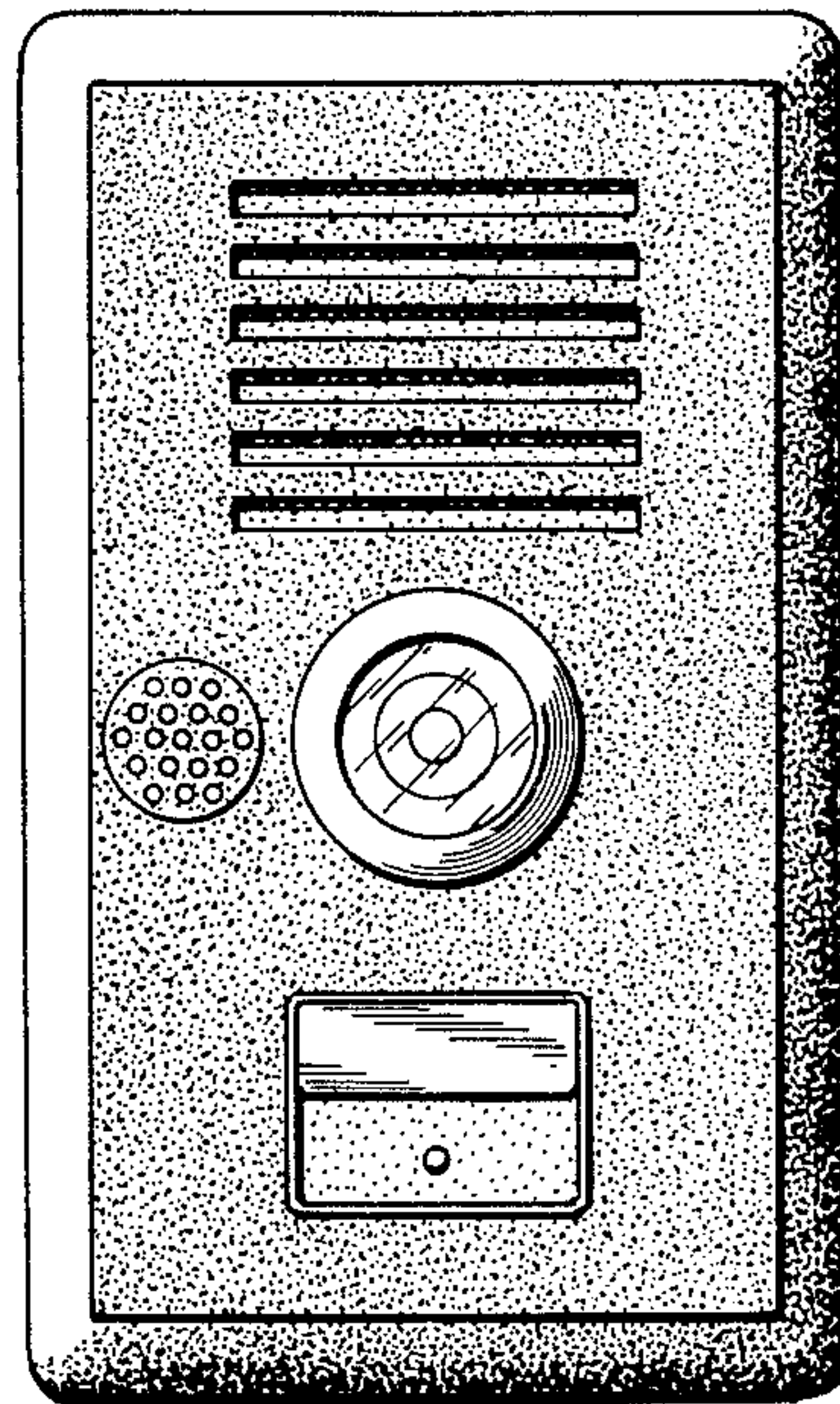
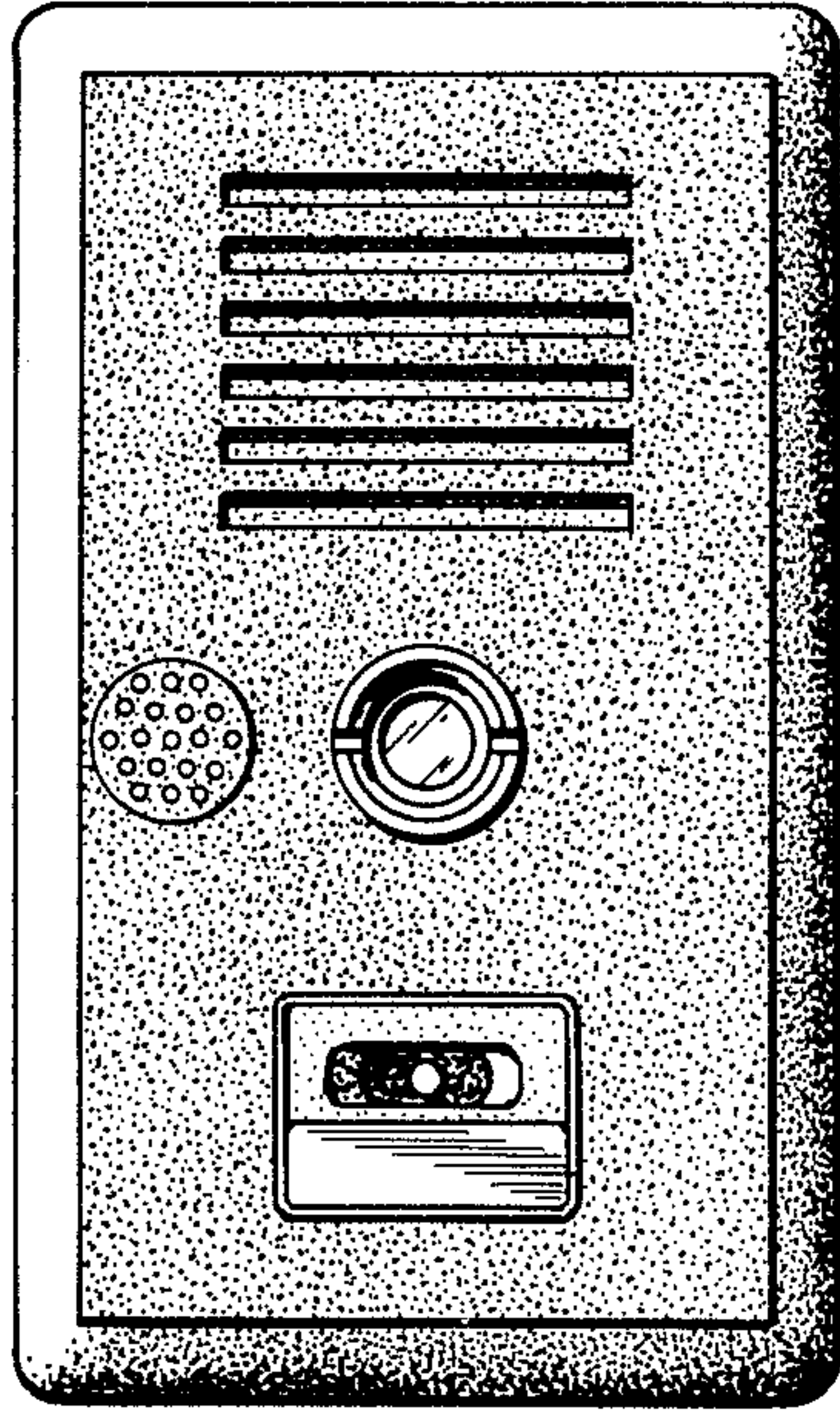
FIG. 1 is a rear elevational view of a combined door viewer and two-way intercom unit showing my new design.

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.



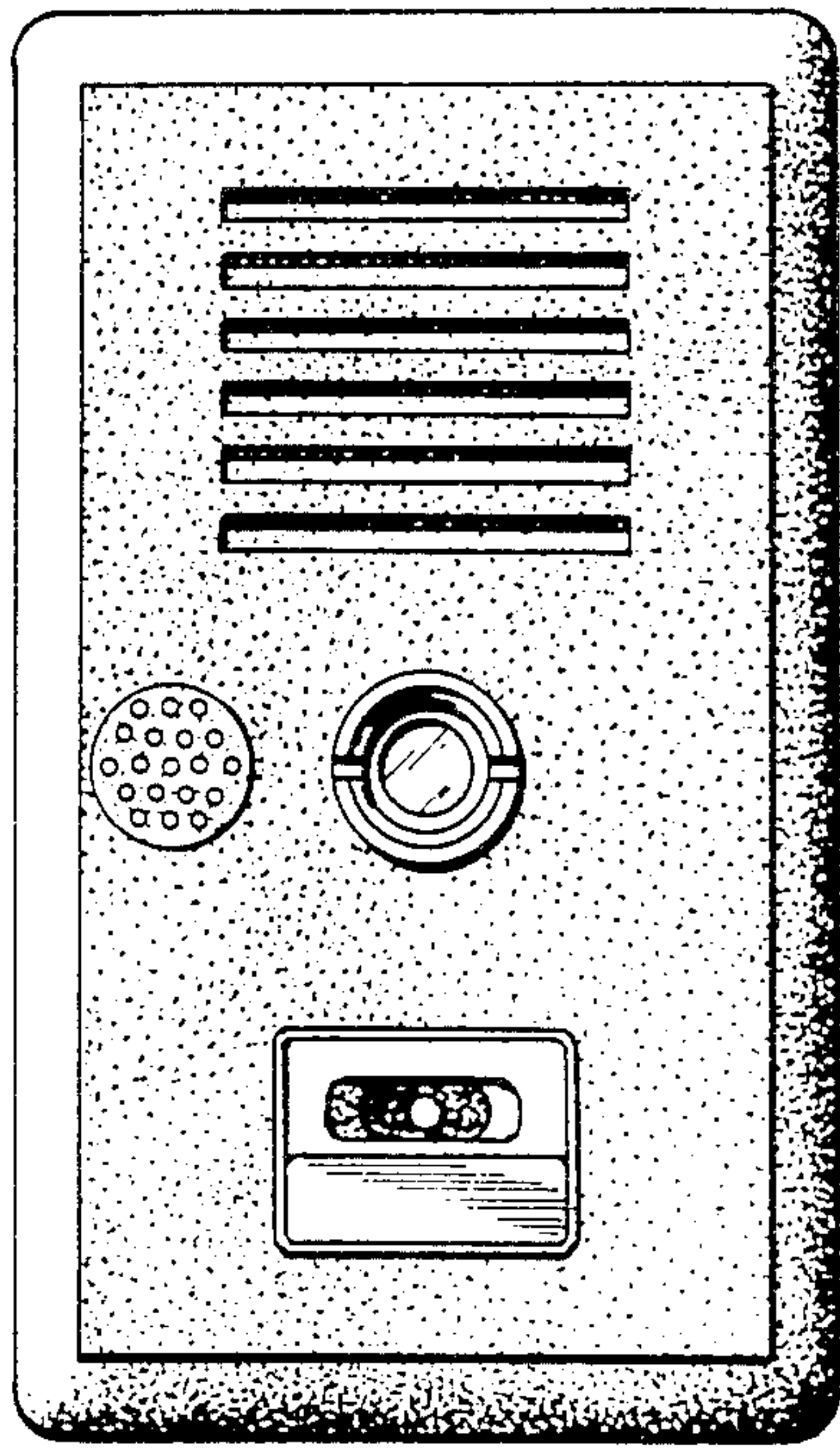

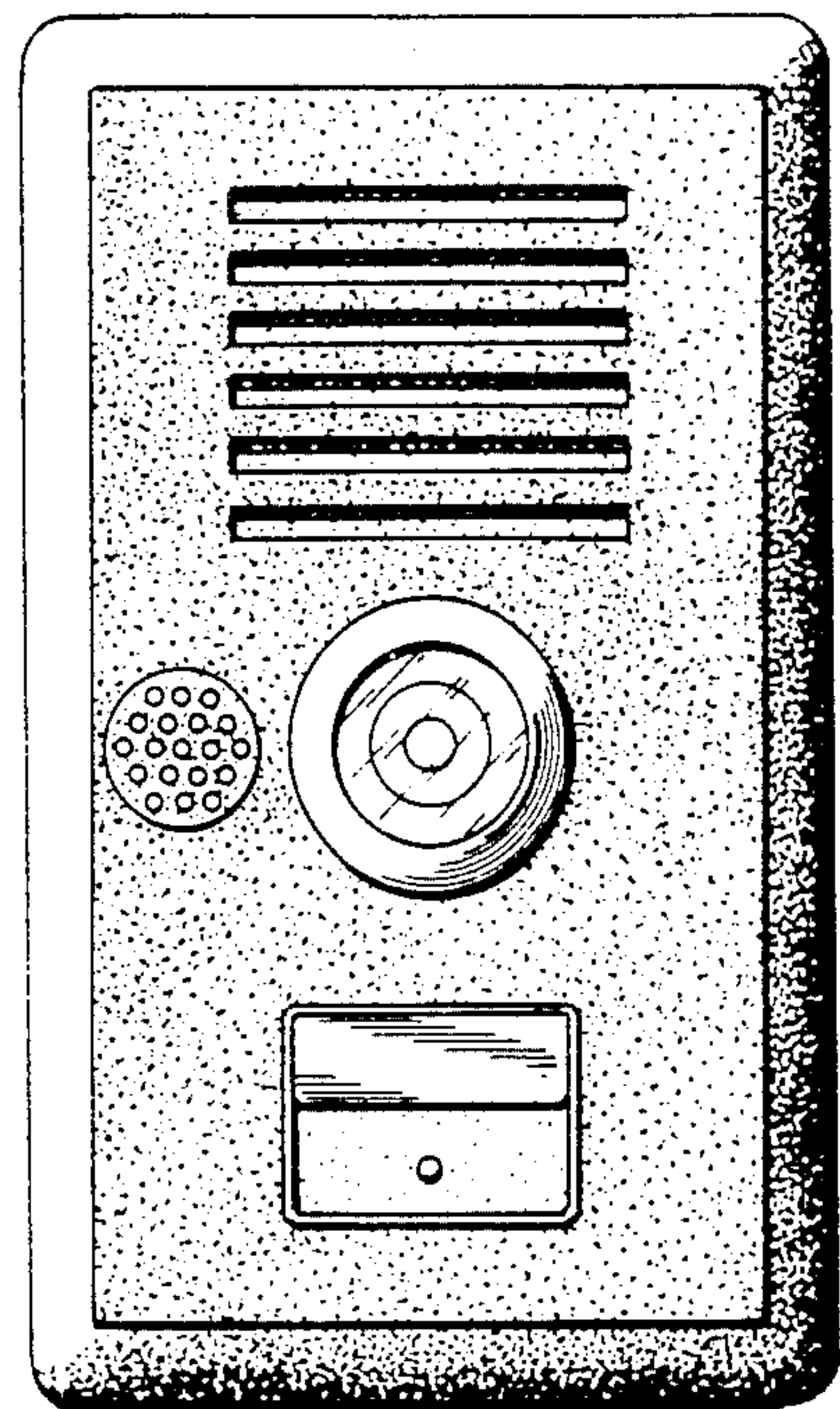

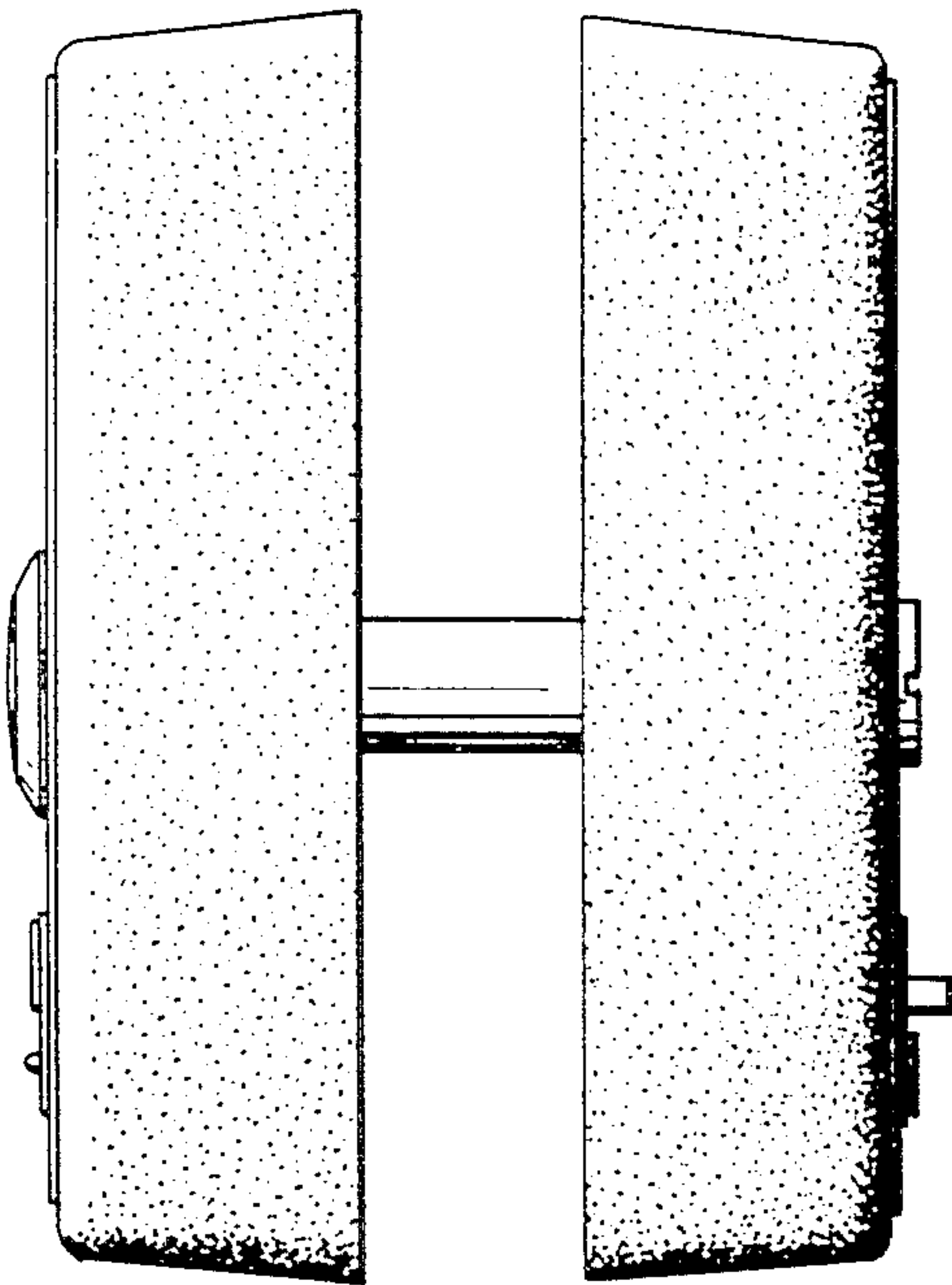

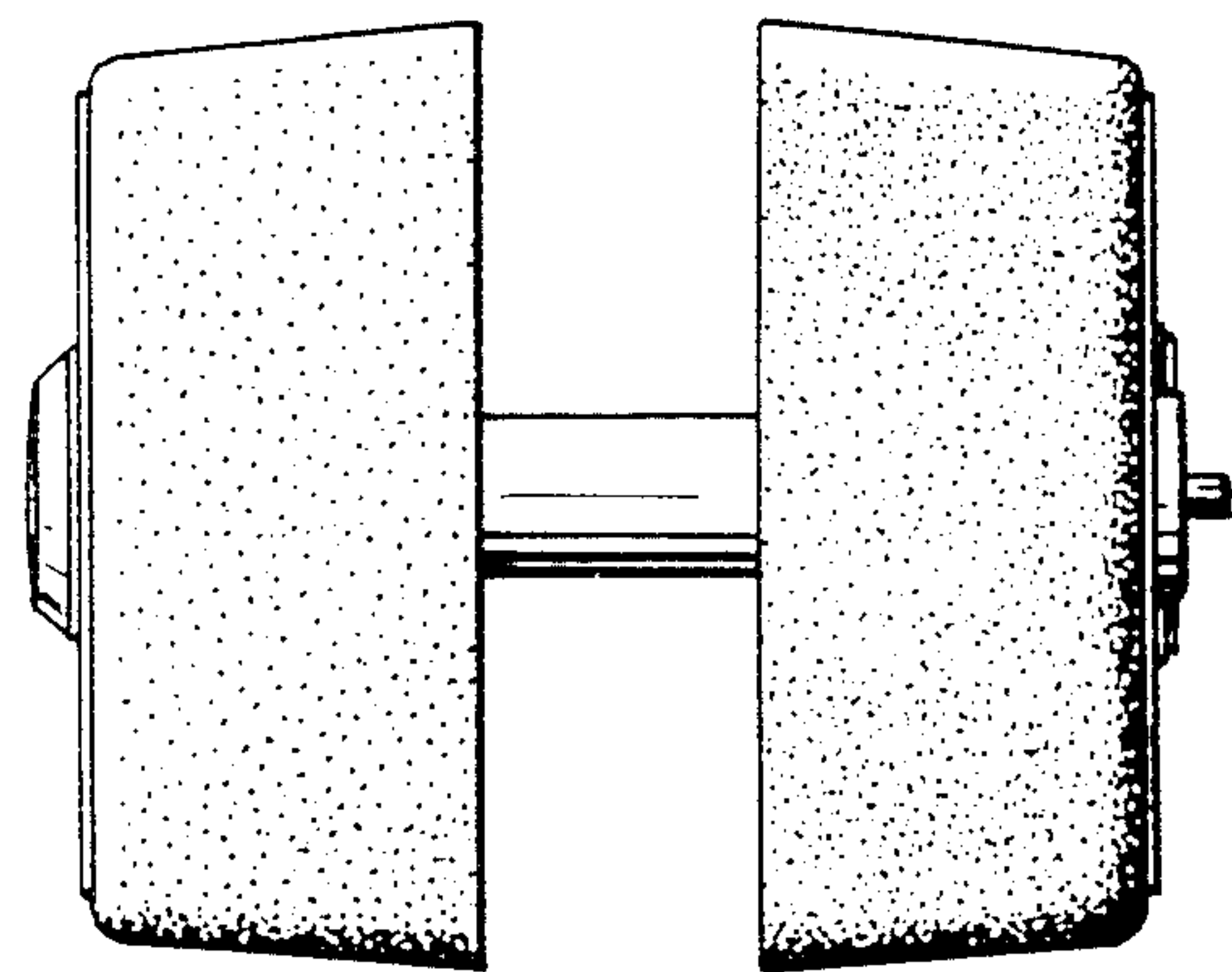

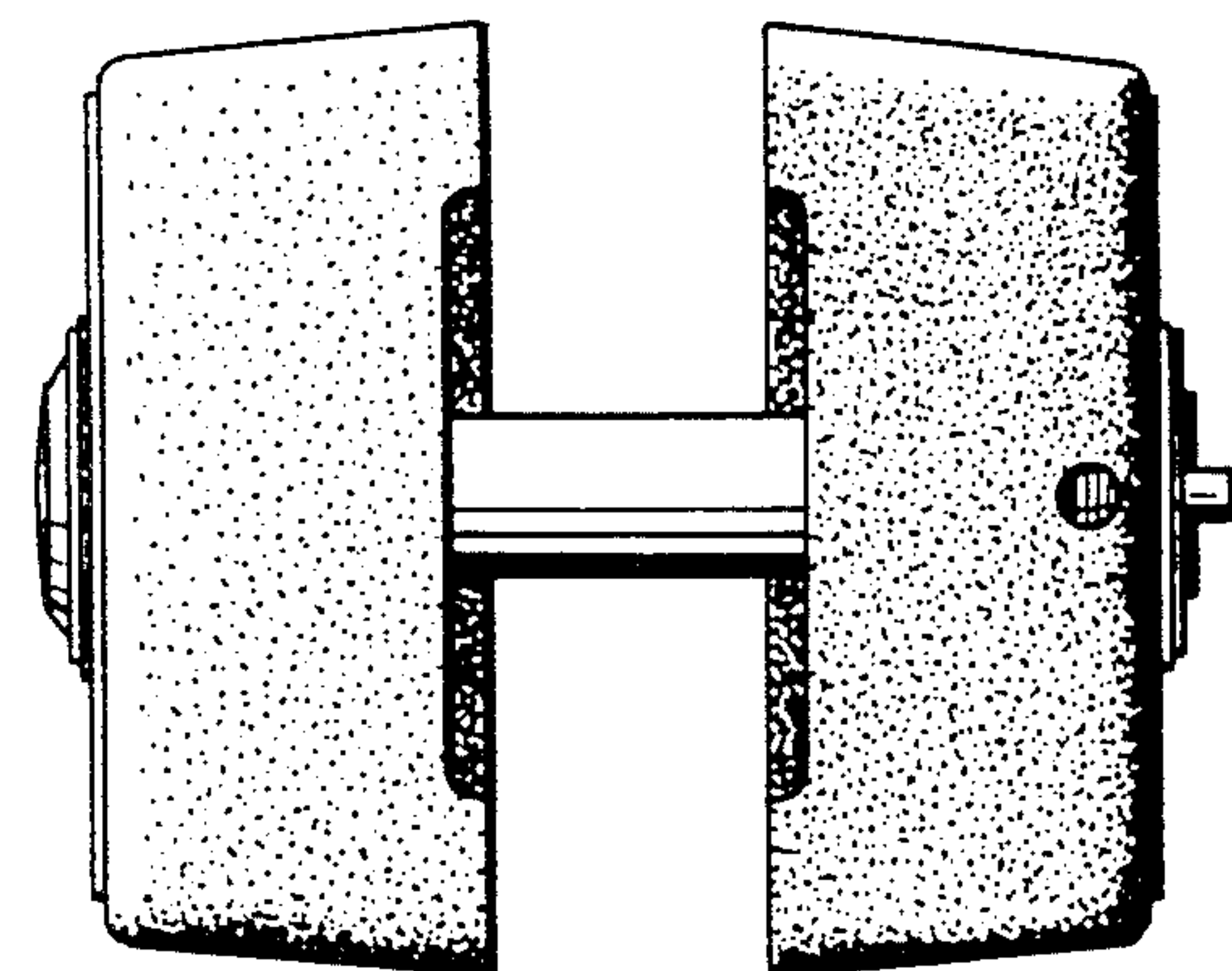
