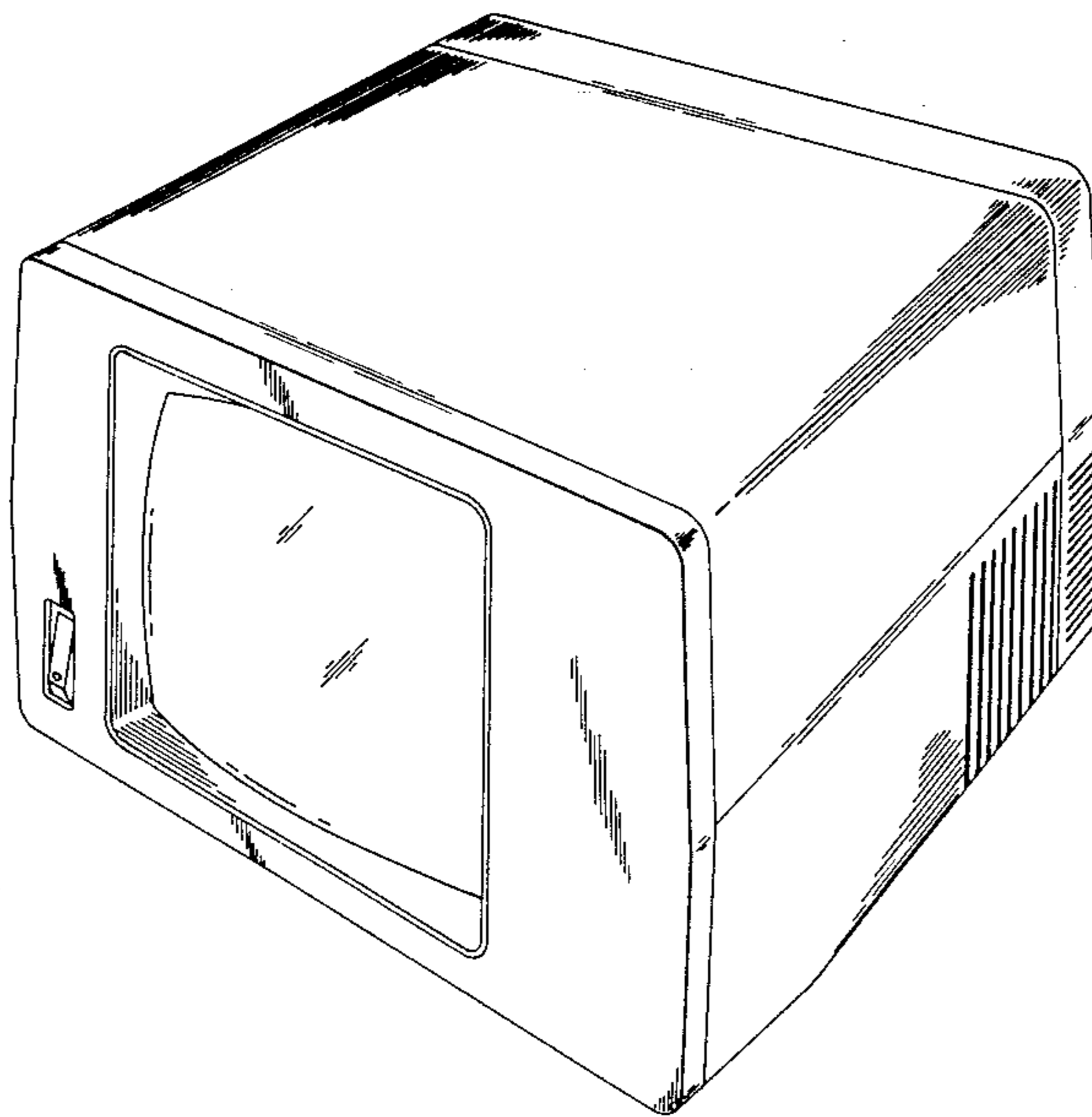

FIG. 5 is a bottom, front perspective view thereof.



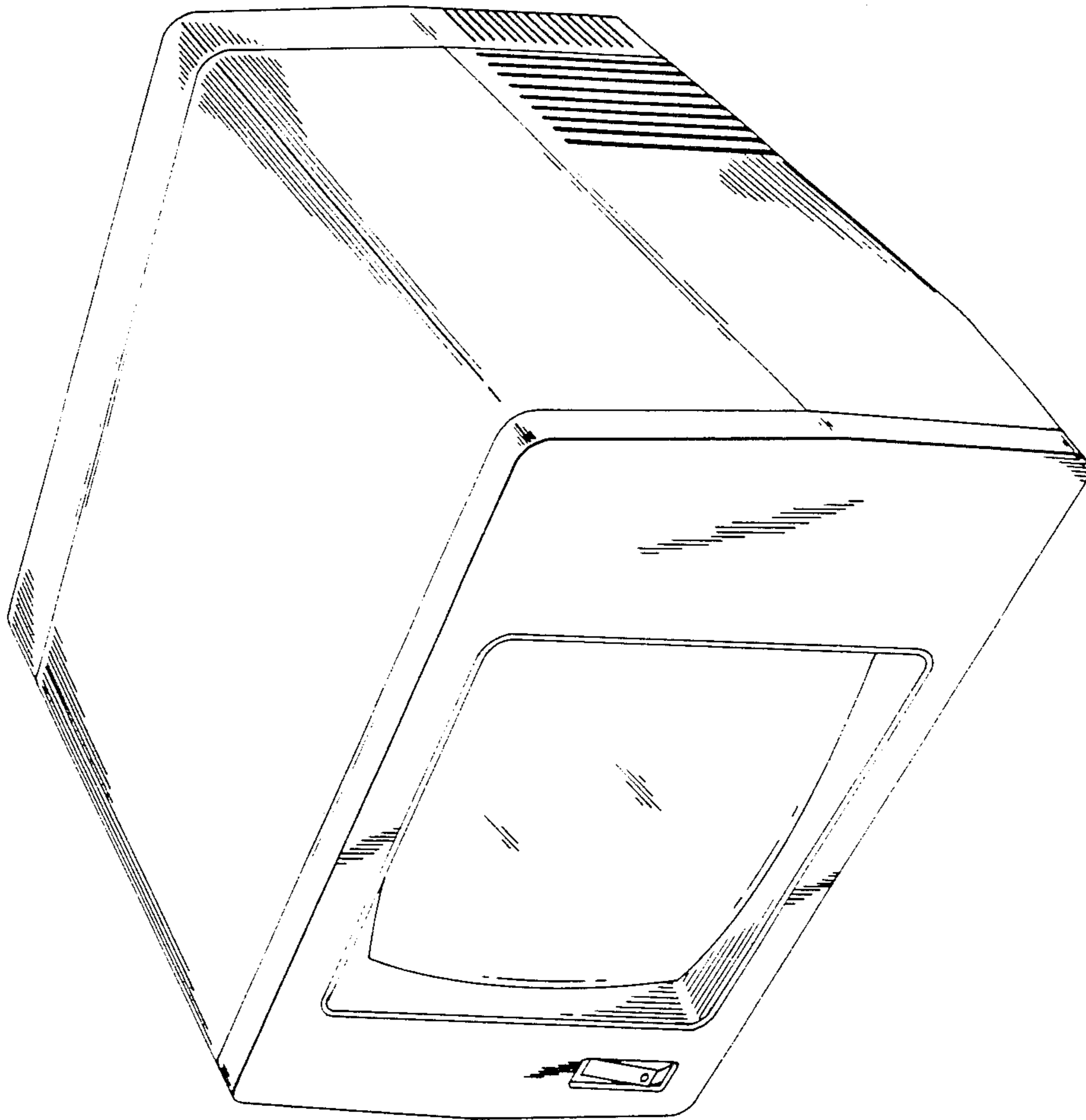

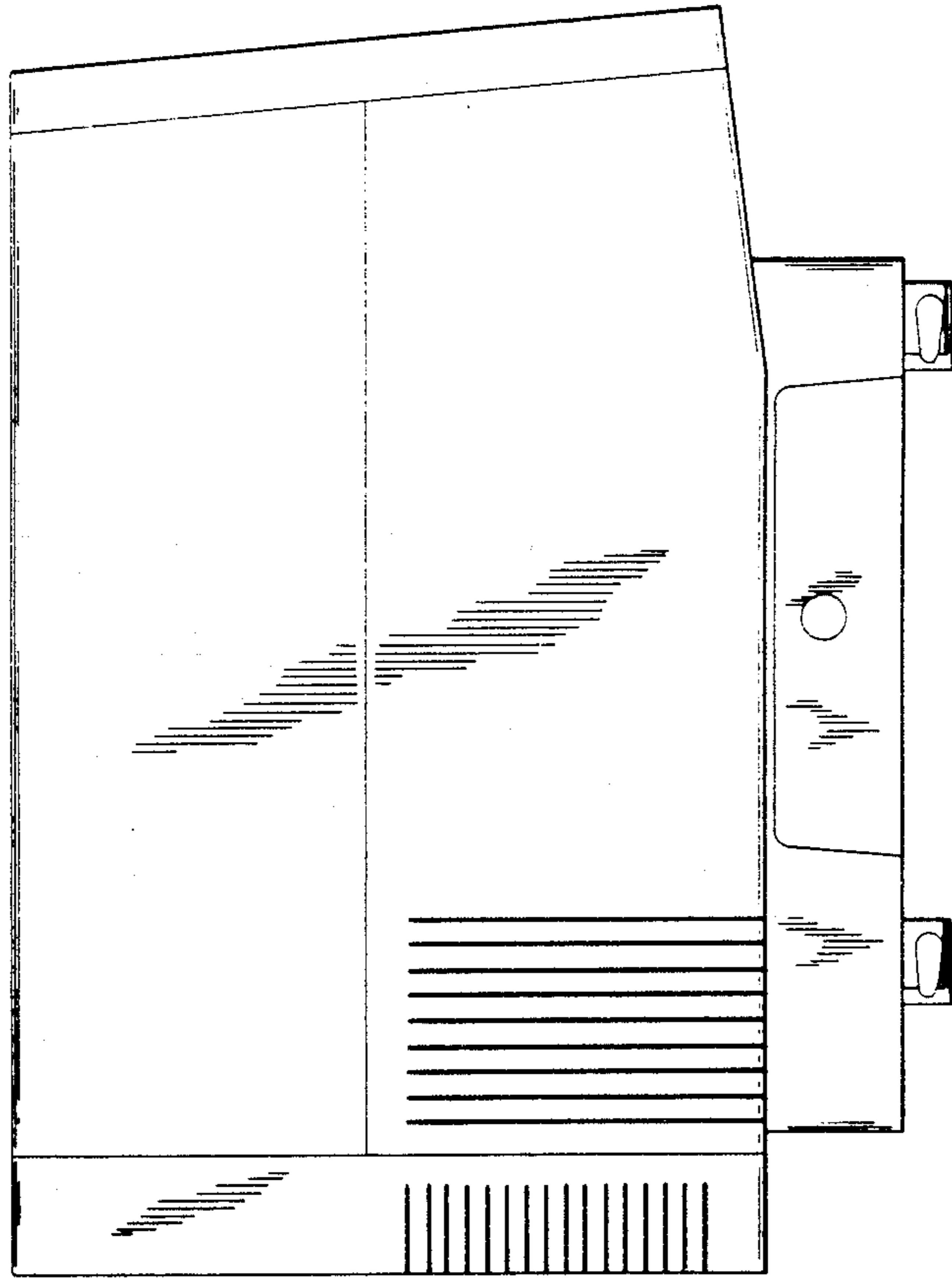

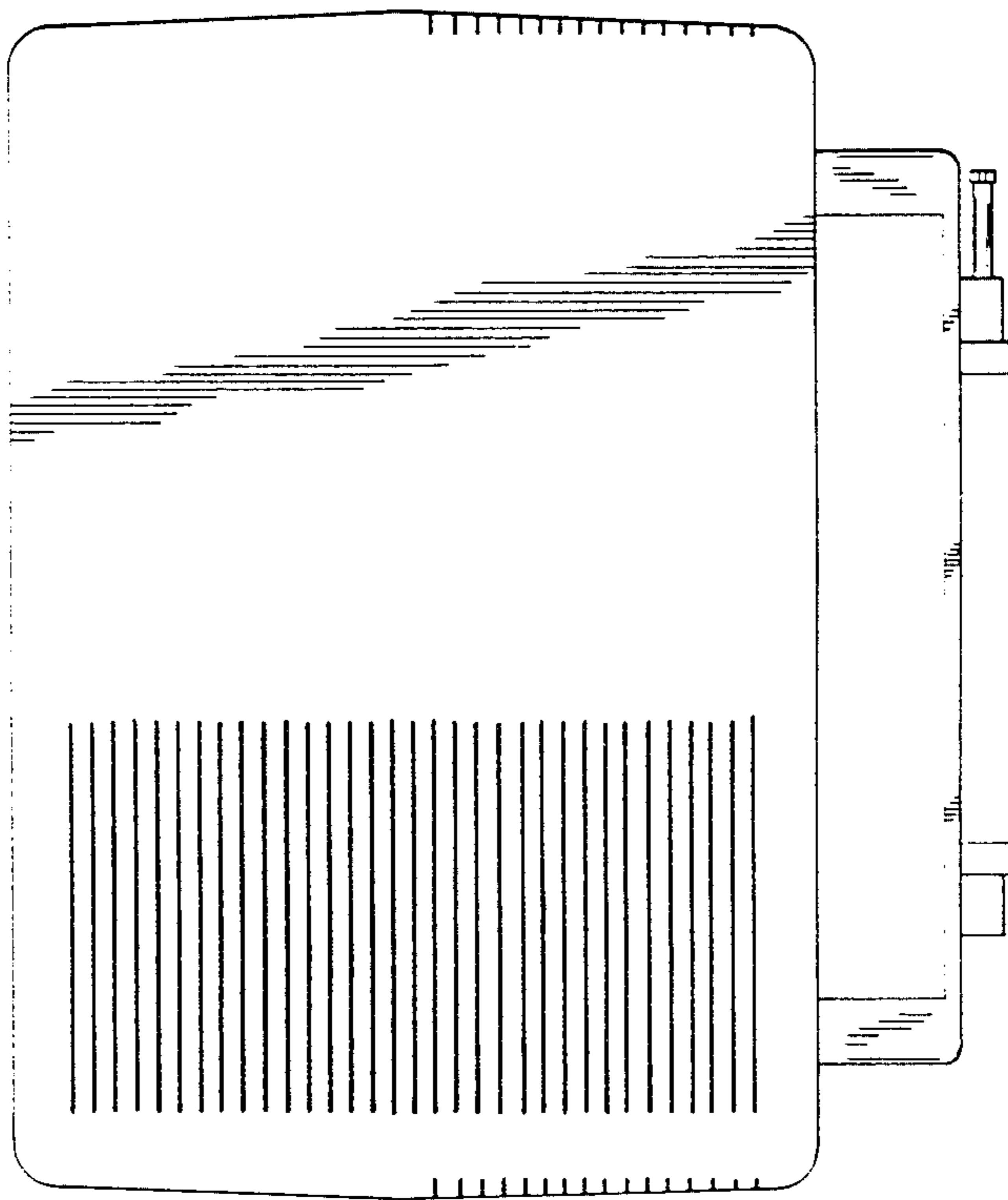
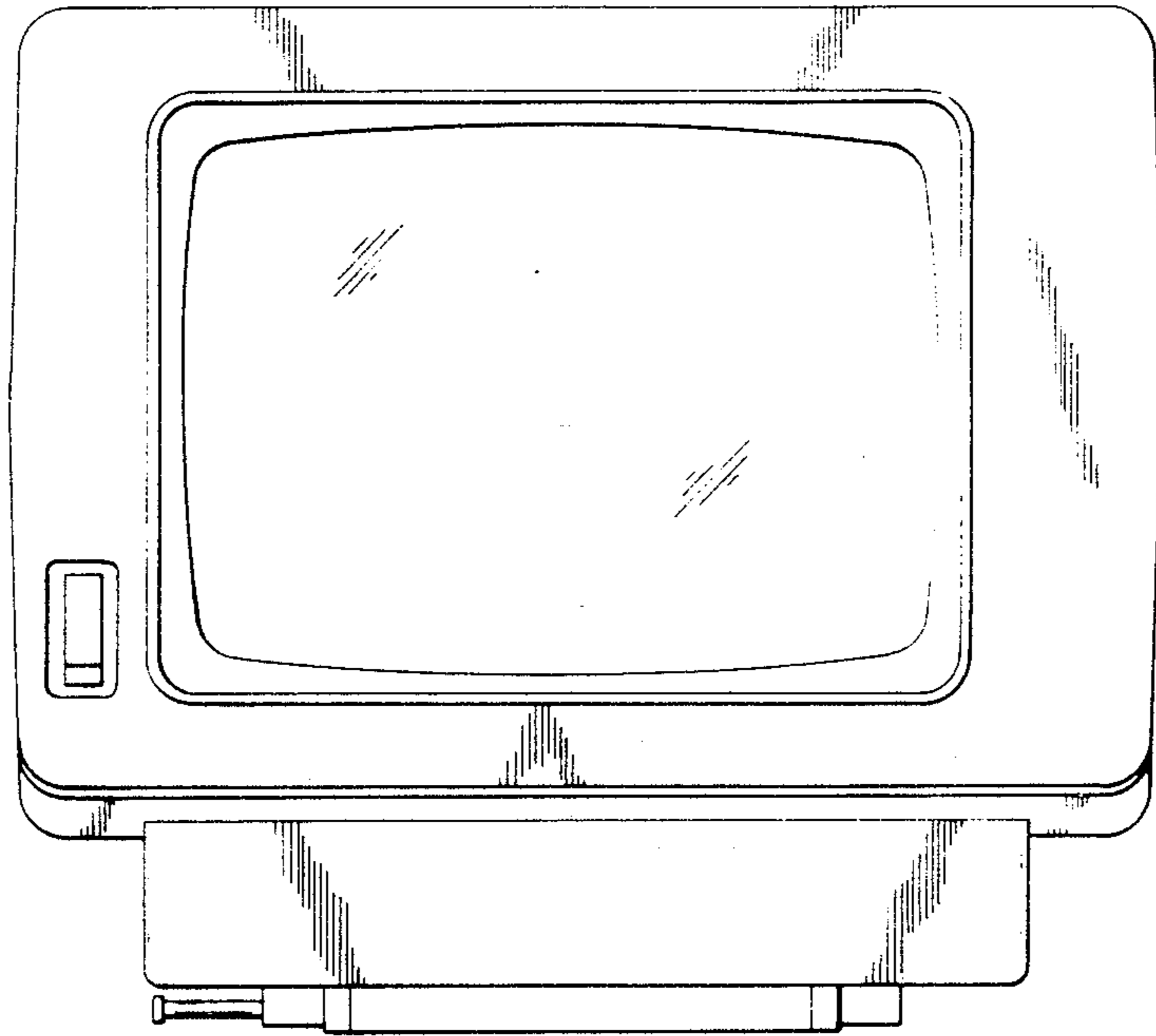

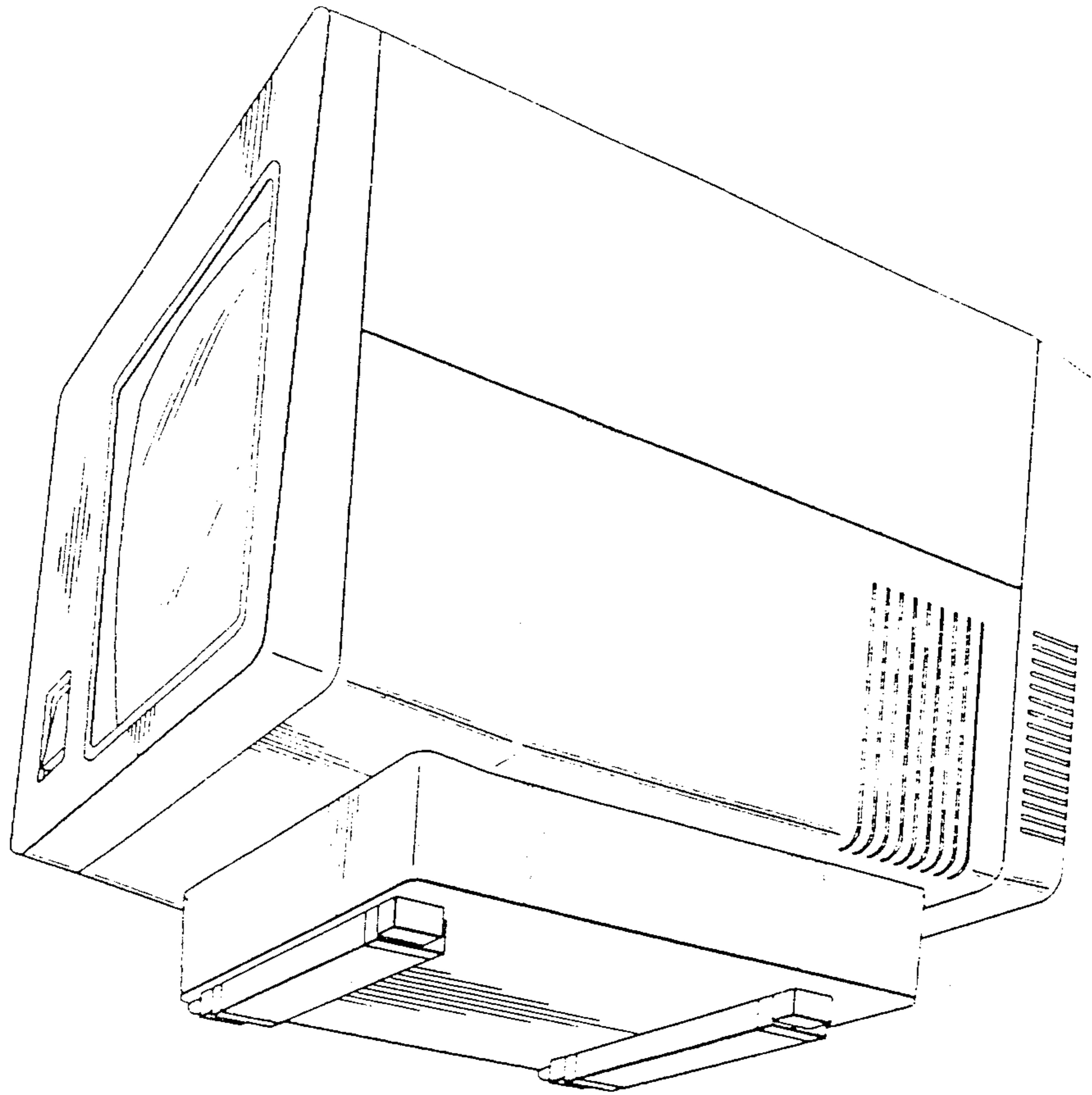
