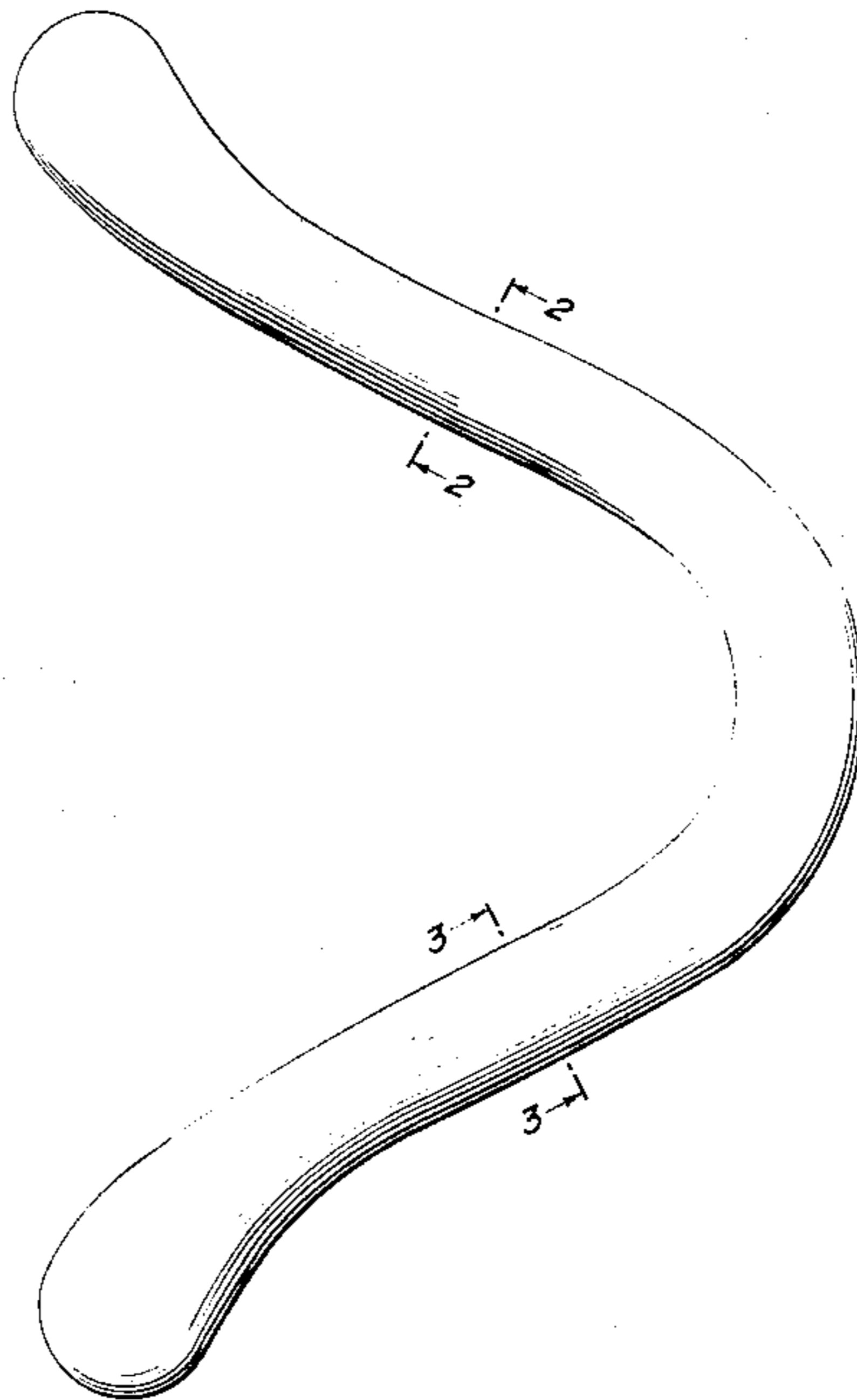

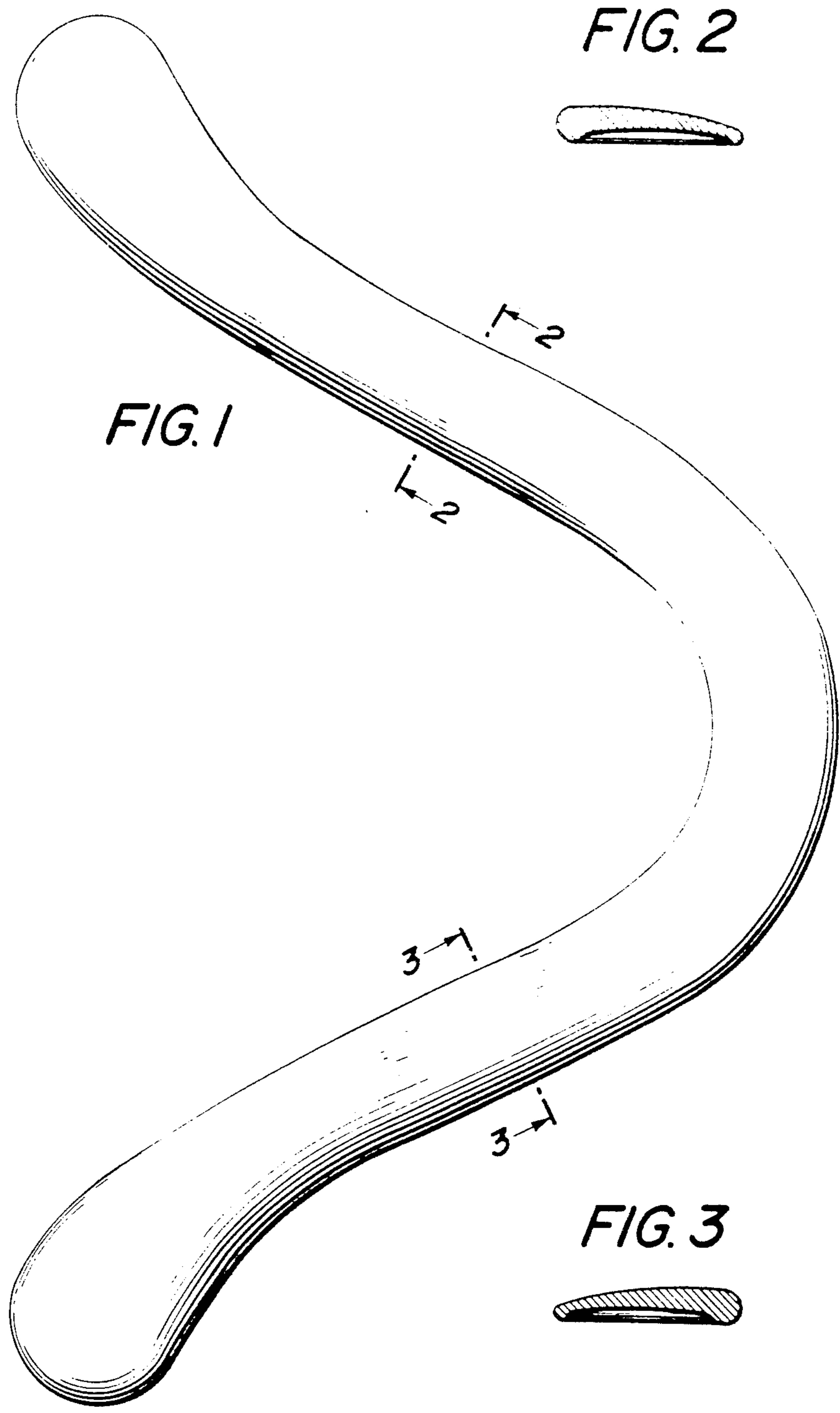
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a boomerang, showing our new design;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.





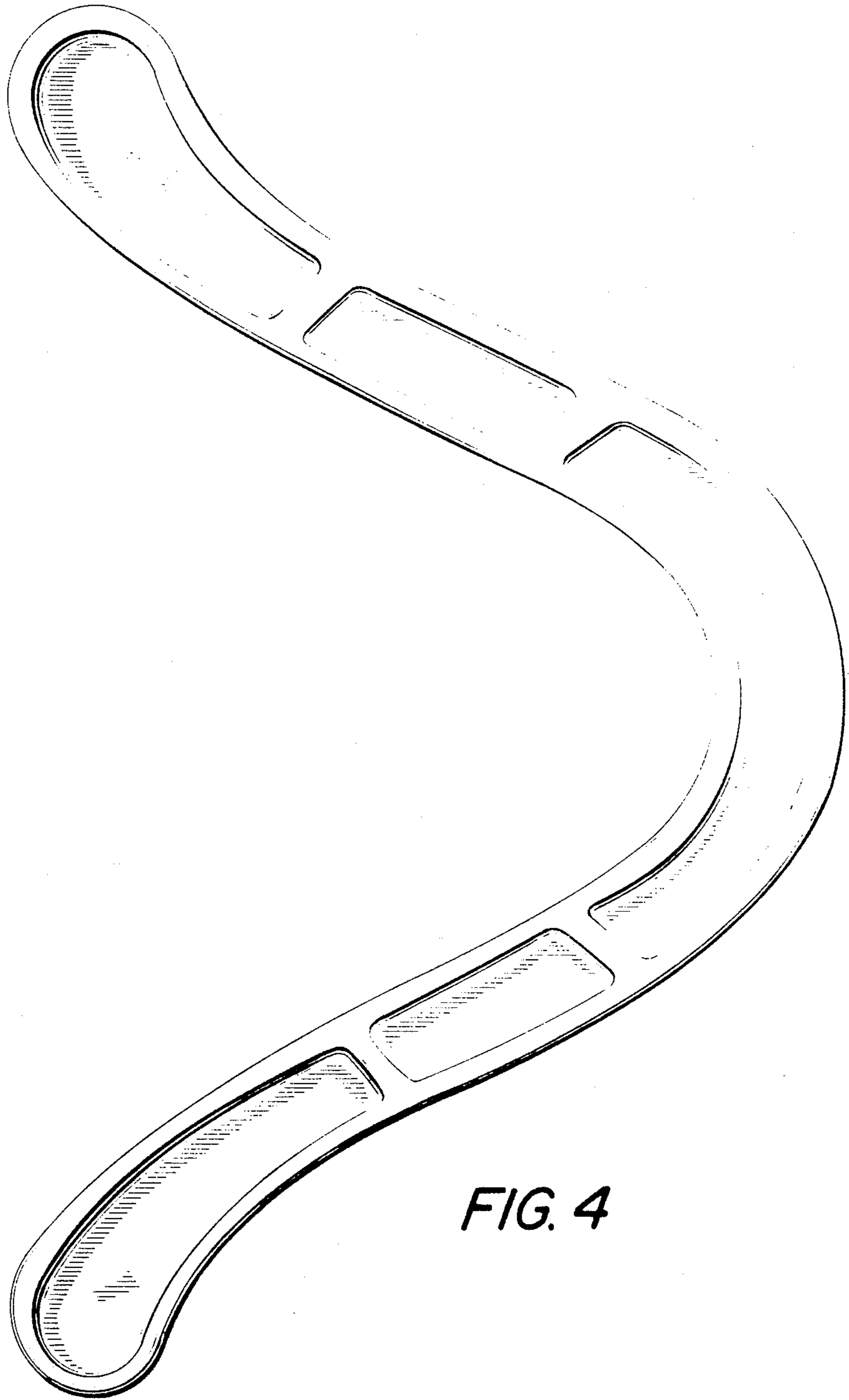
