The ornamental design for a simulative toy balloon substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a simulative toy balloon showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, as viewed from the right in FIG. 1; and
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, as viewed from the left in FIG. 1.

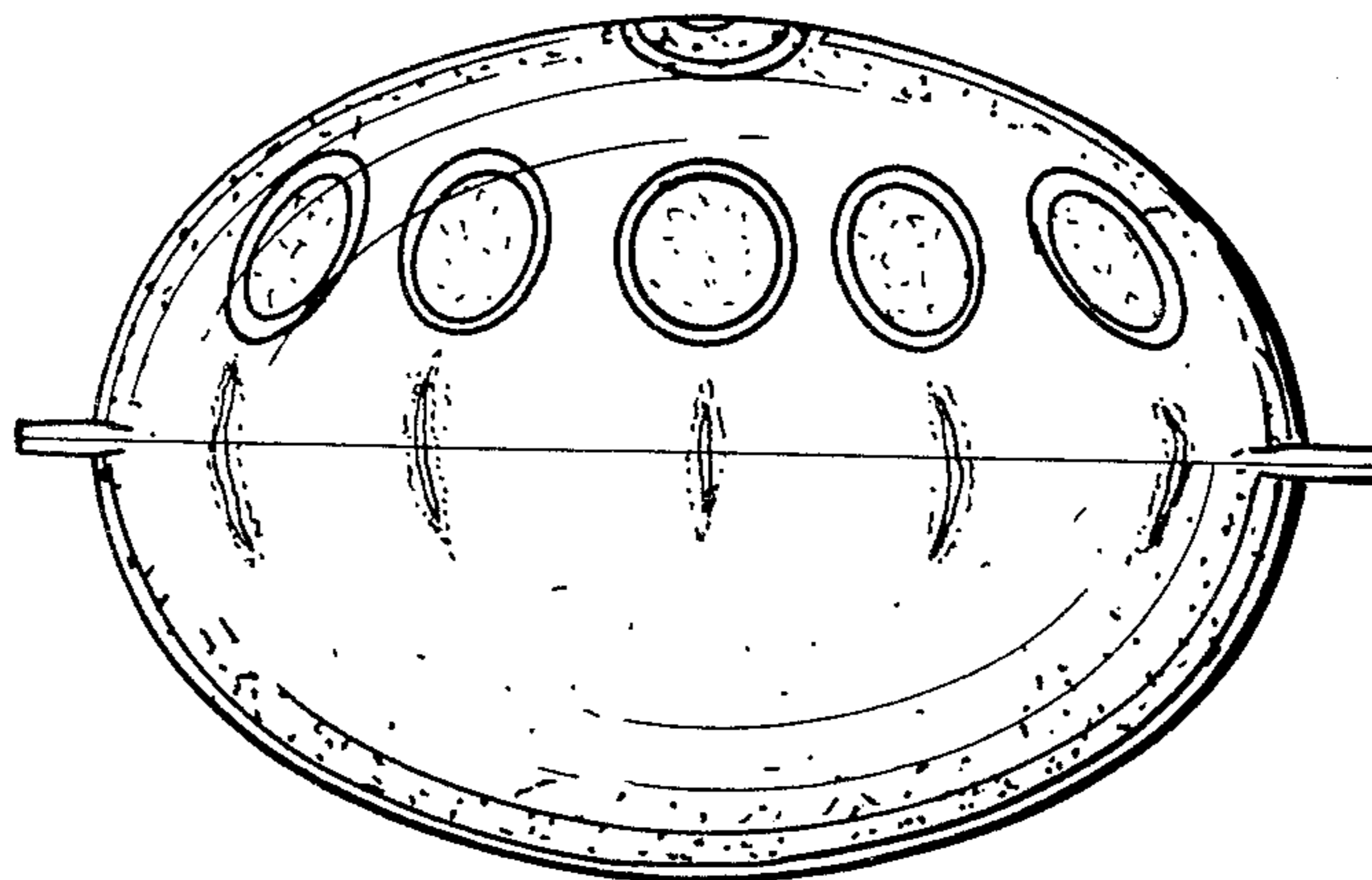

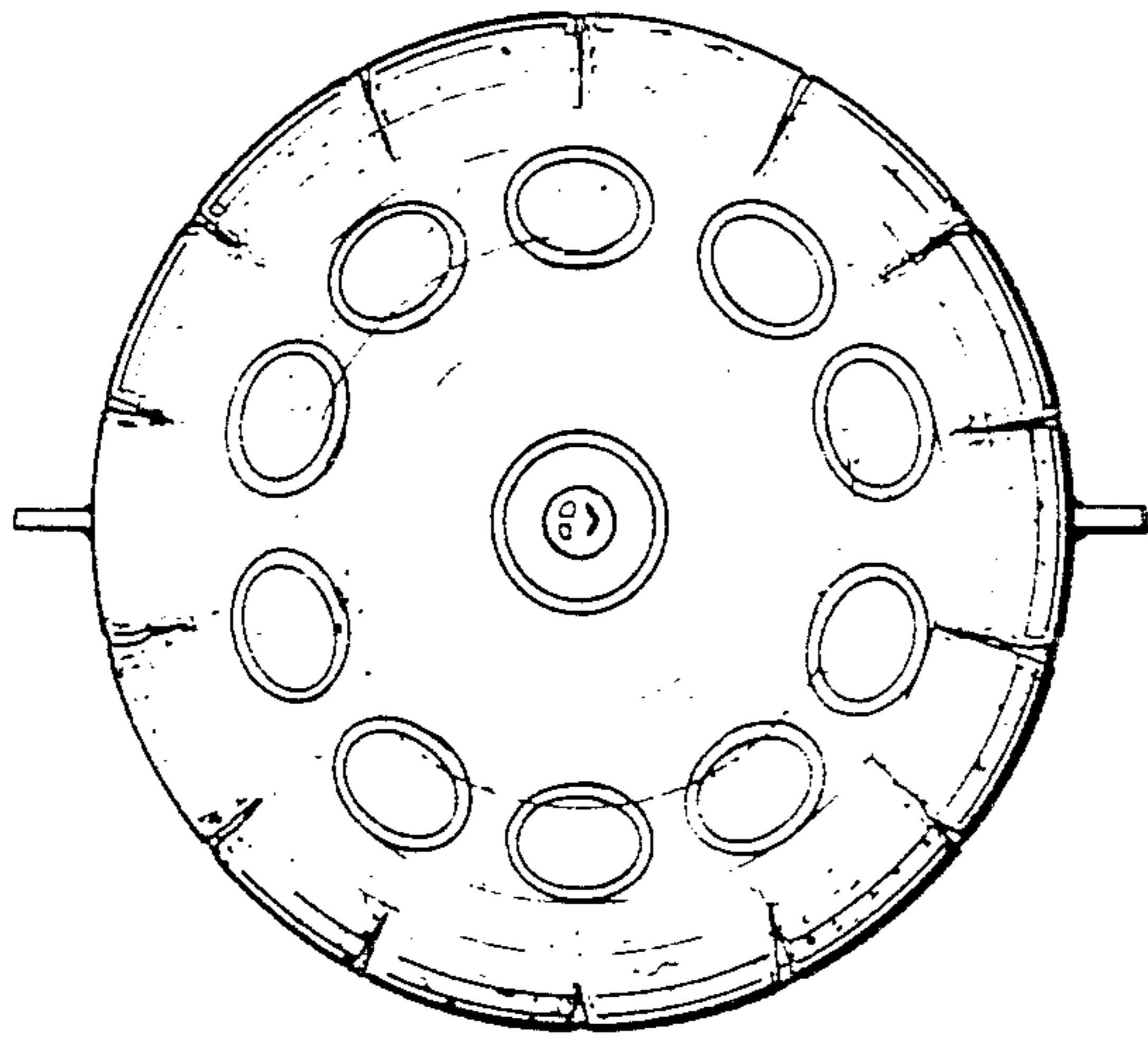

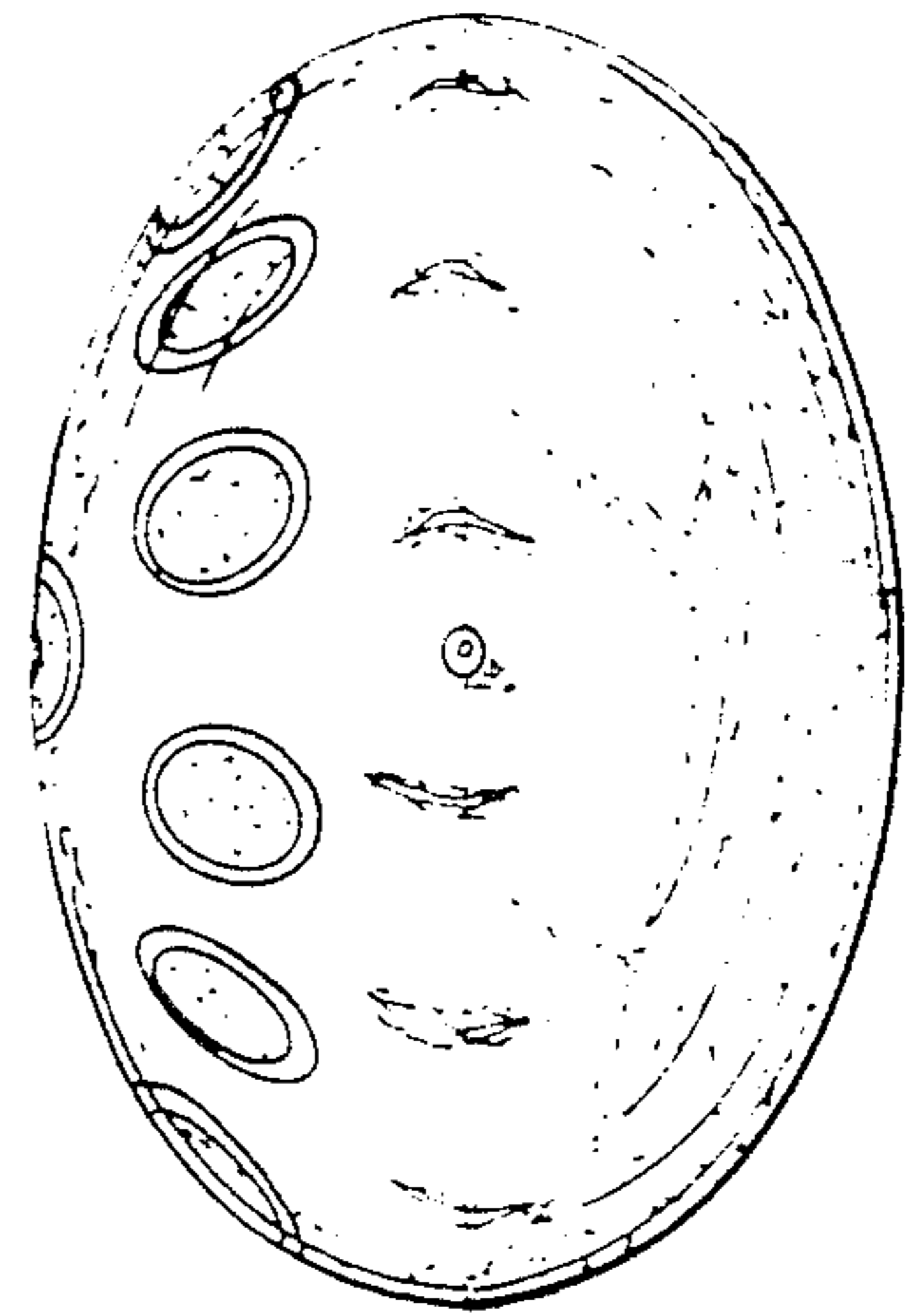

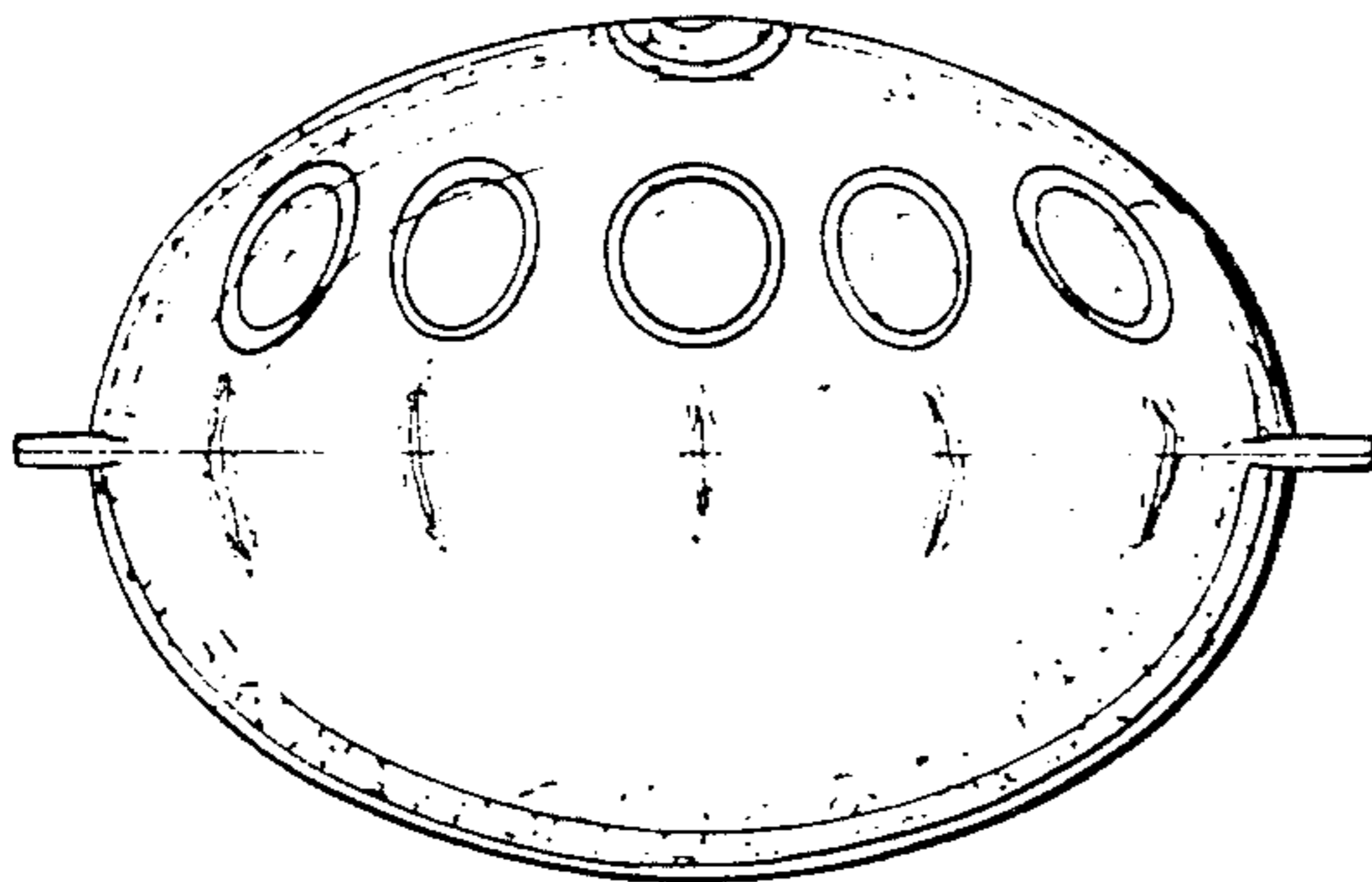

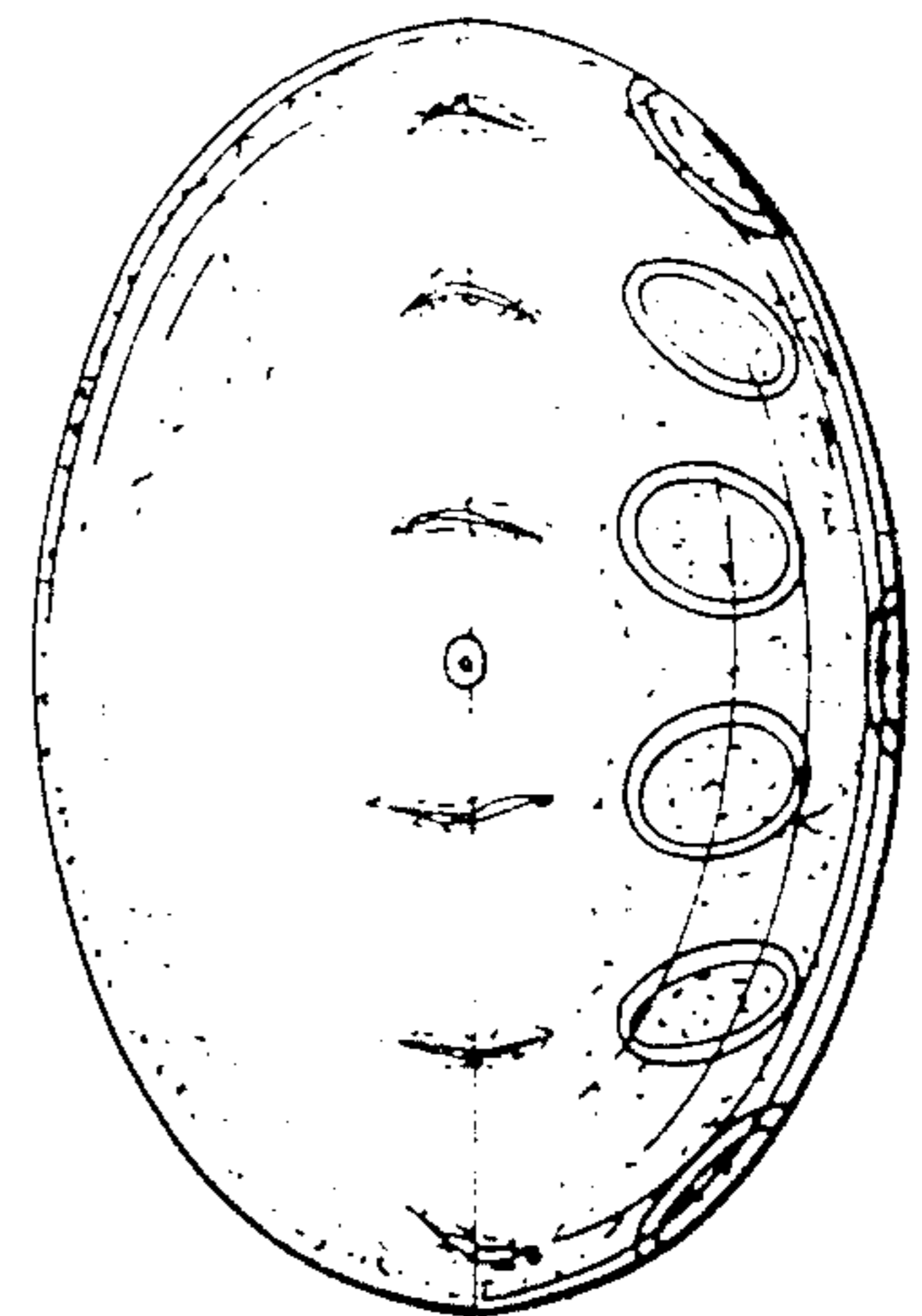
