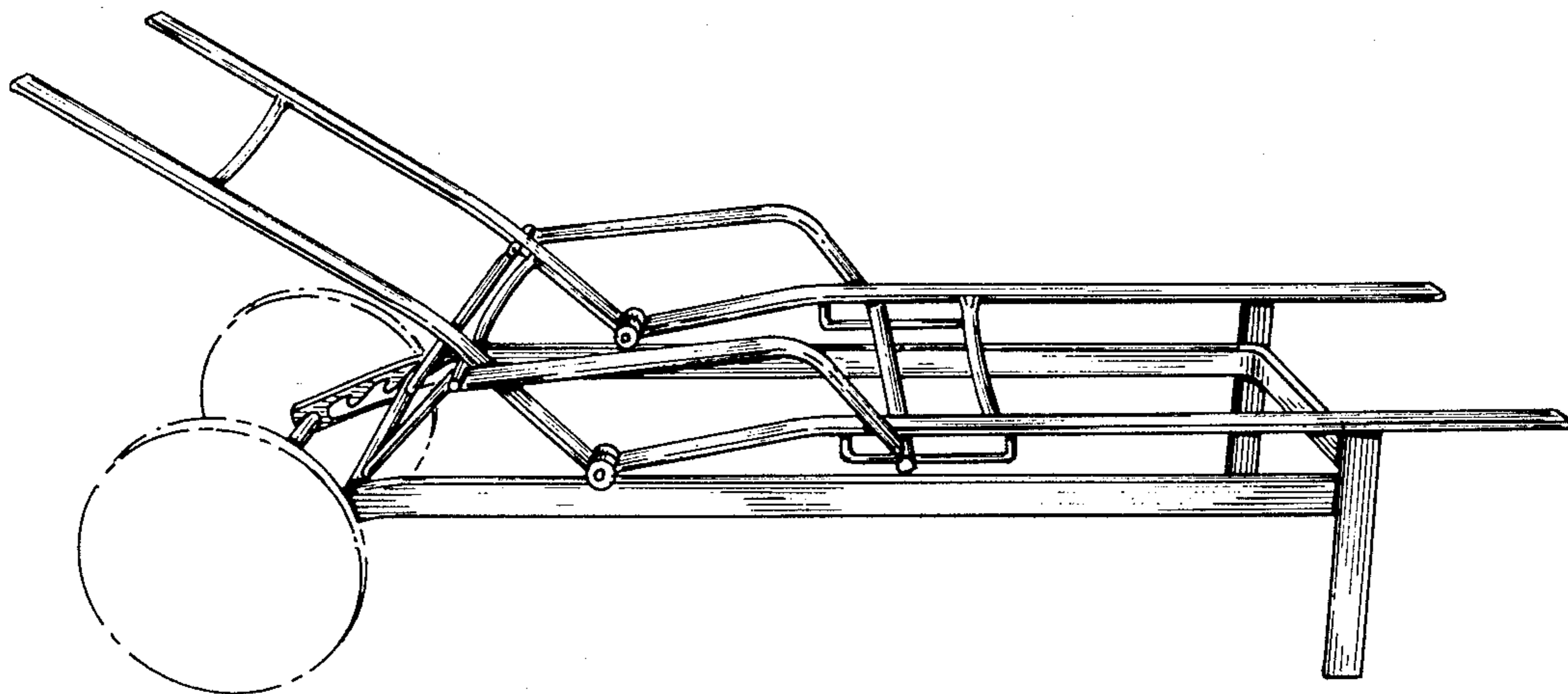

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a chaise frame, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the chaise frame showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the chaise frame (the opposite side being a mirror image thereof);
FIG. 3 is a plan view of the chaise frame; and
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the chaise frame. The wheels shown by means of broken lines are for illustrative purposes only.



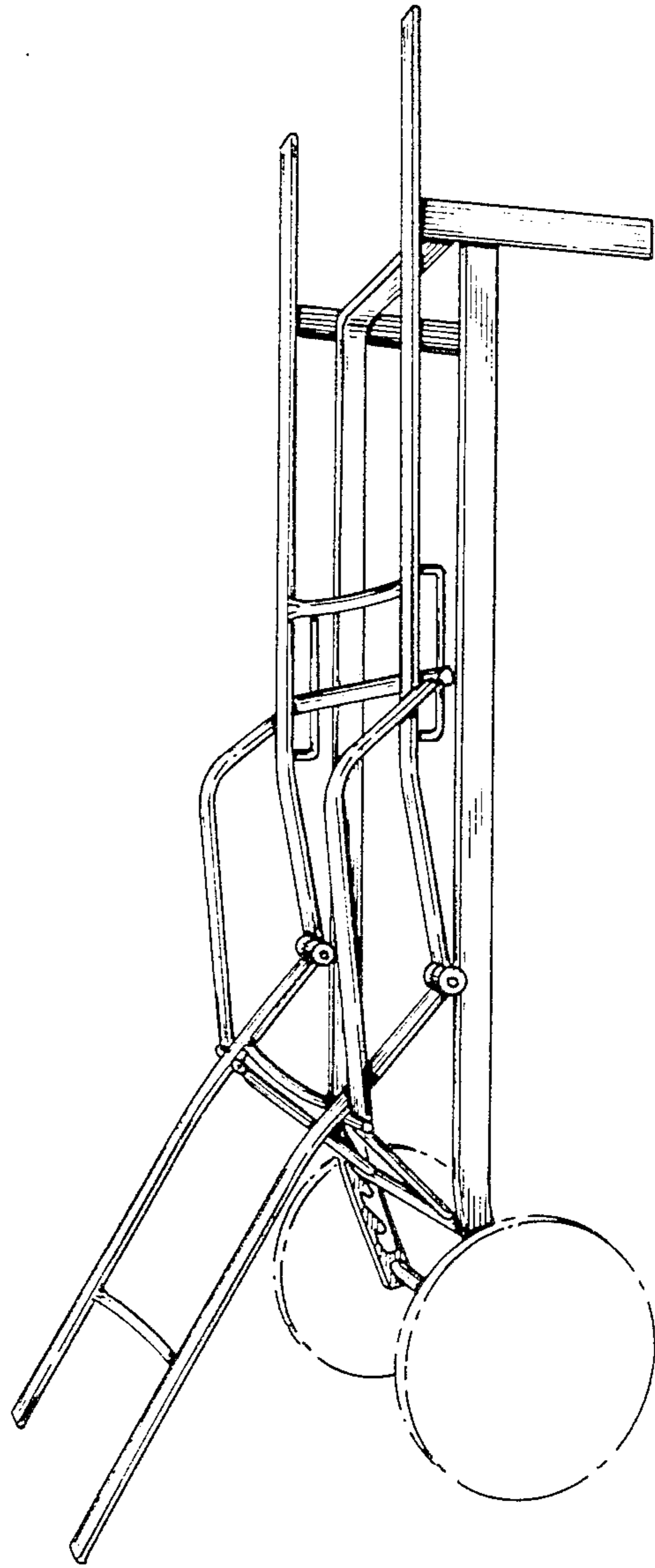

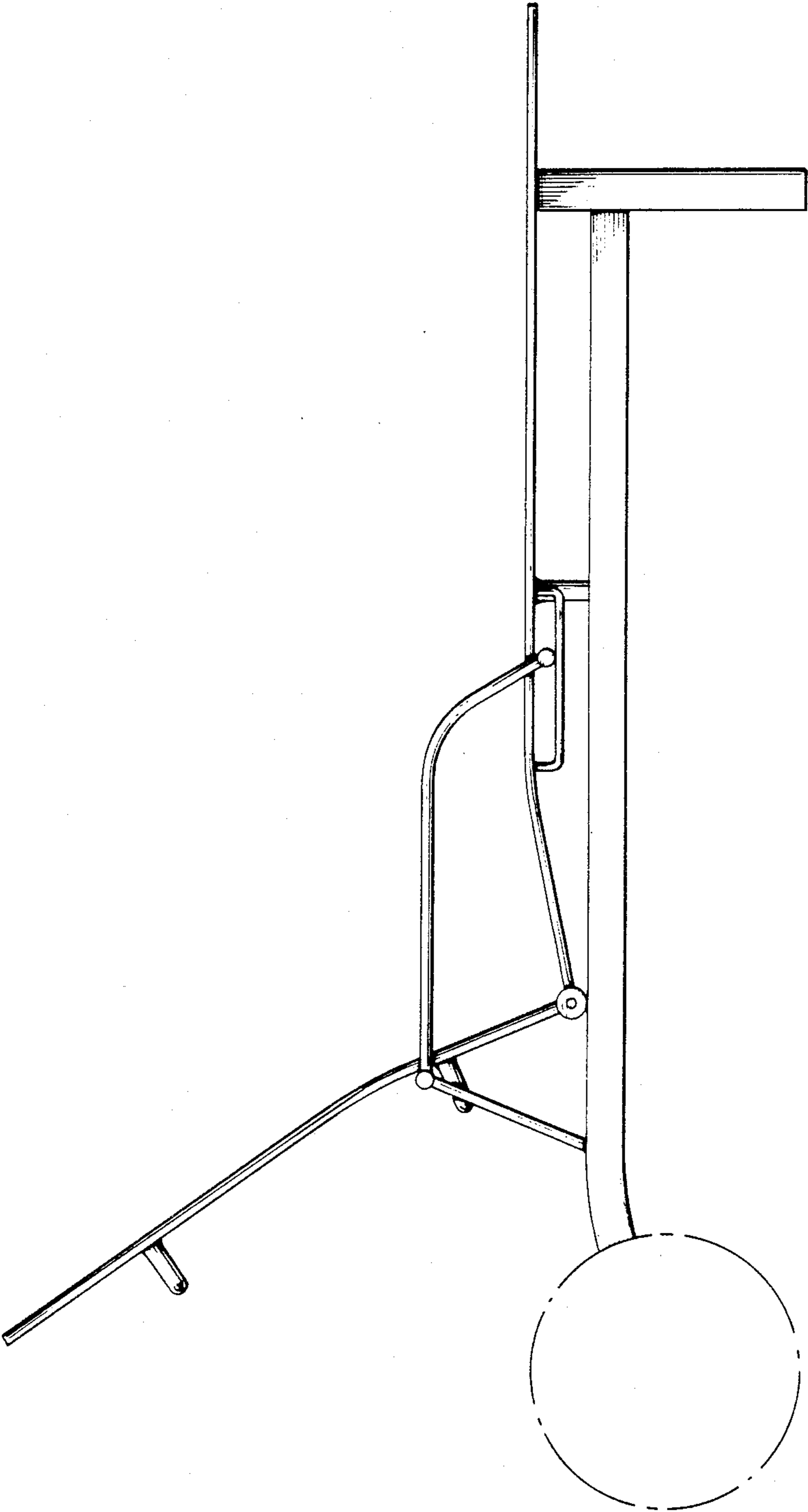

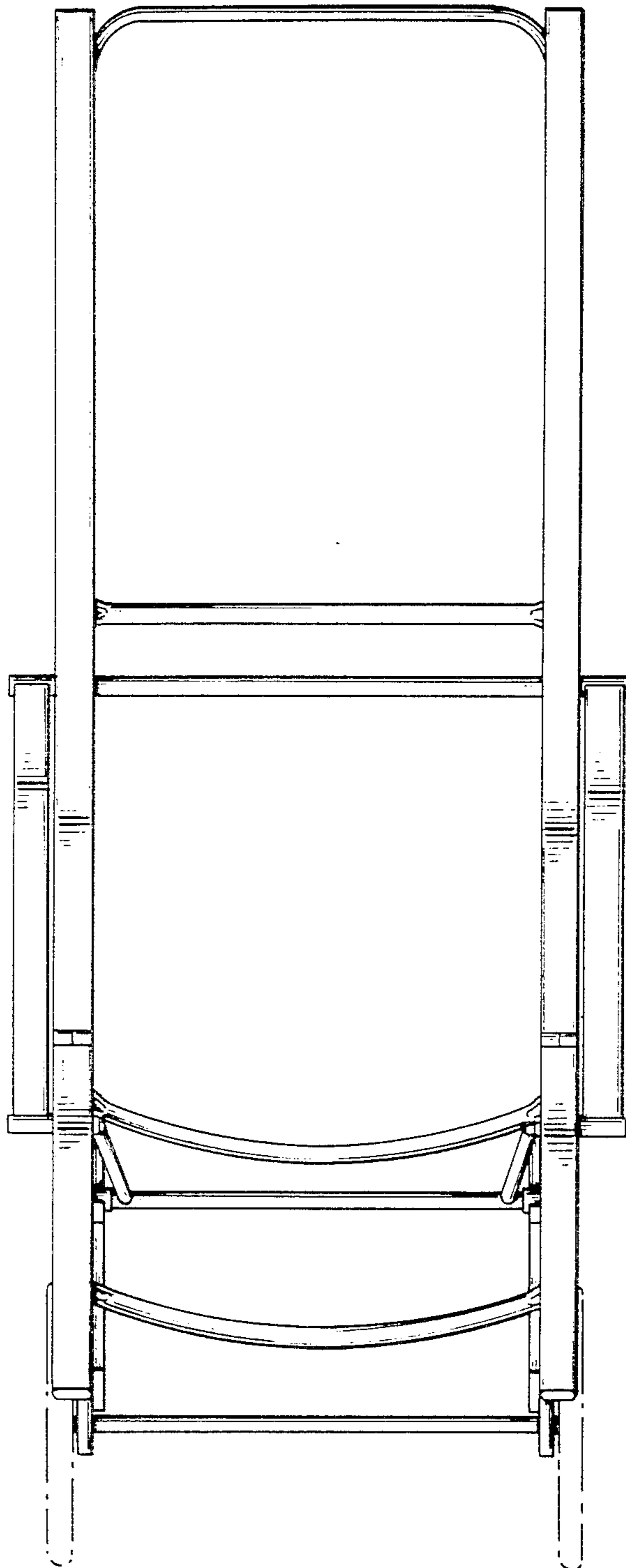

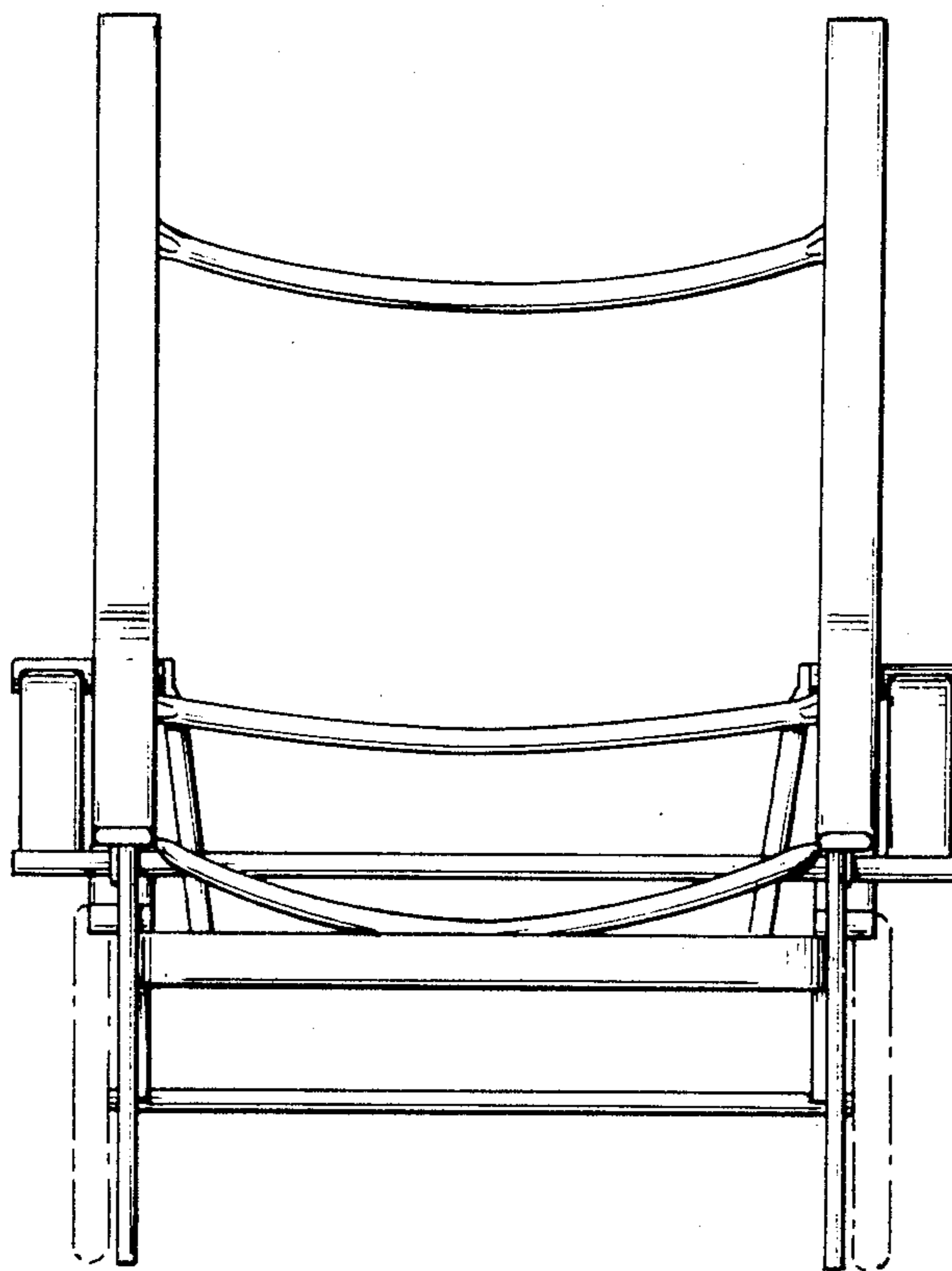
