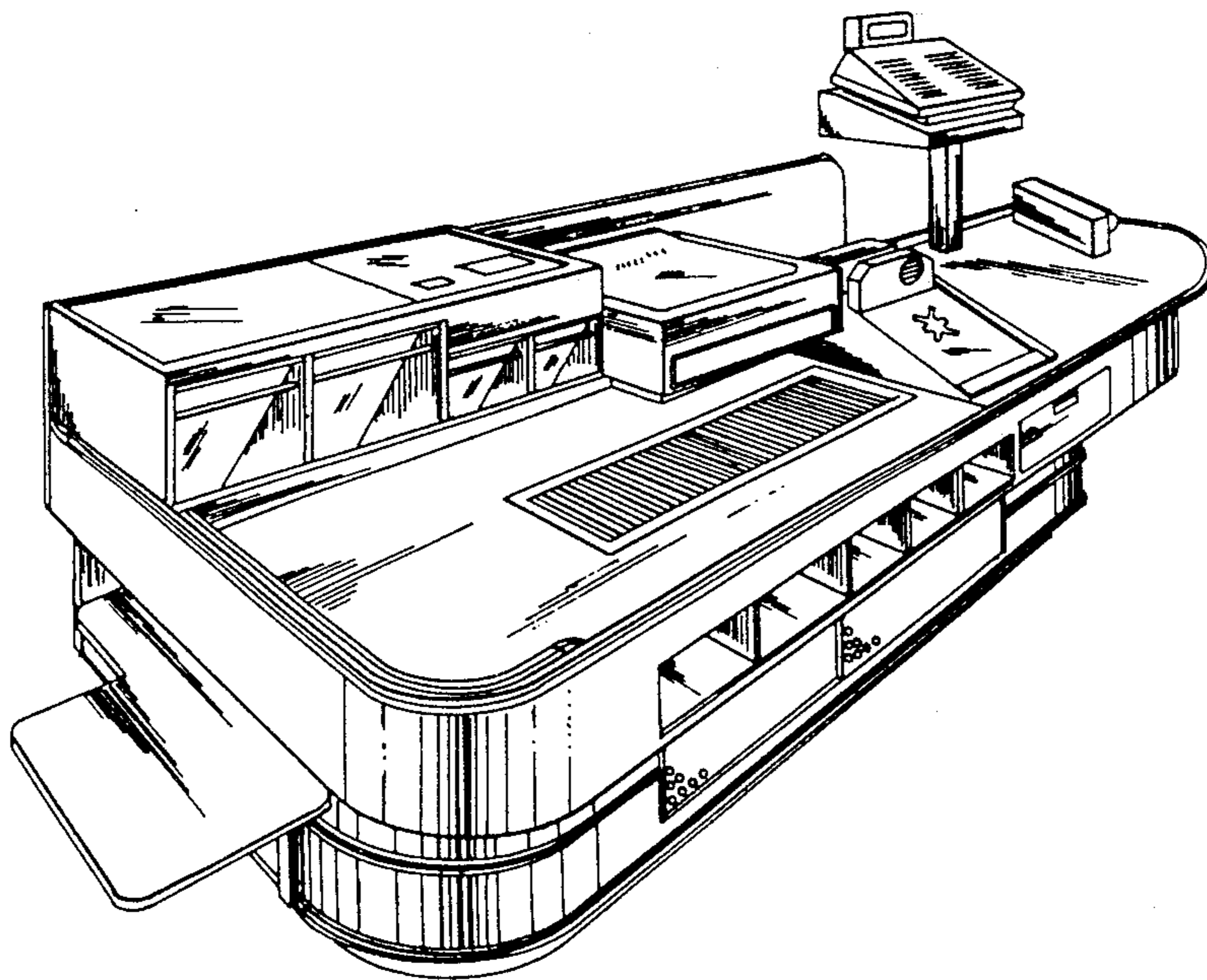

The ornamental design for a checkout counter, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a checkout counter showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is an enlarged front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is an enlarged rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is an enlarged right end elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is an enlarged left end elevational view thereof.  
The partial showing of the circular apertures in FIGS. 1, 3 and 5 are understood to repeat uniformly throughout the defined areas.



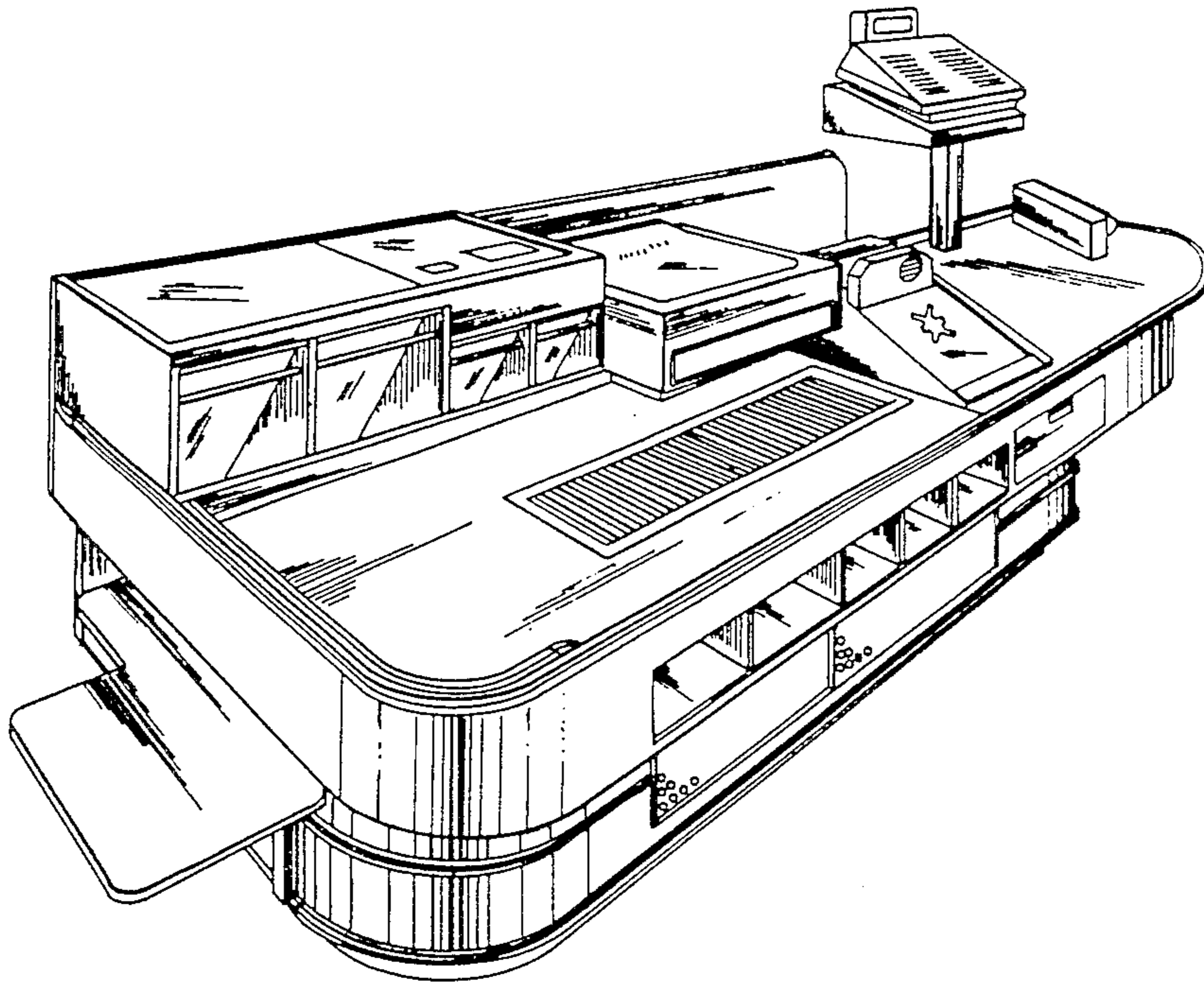

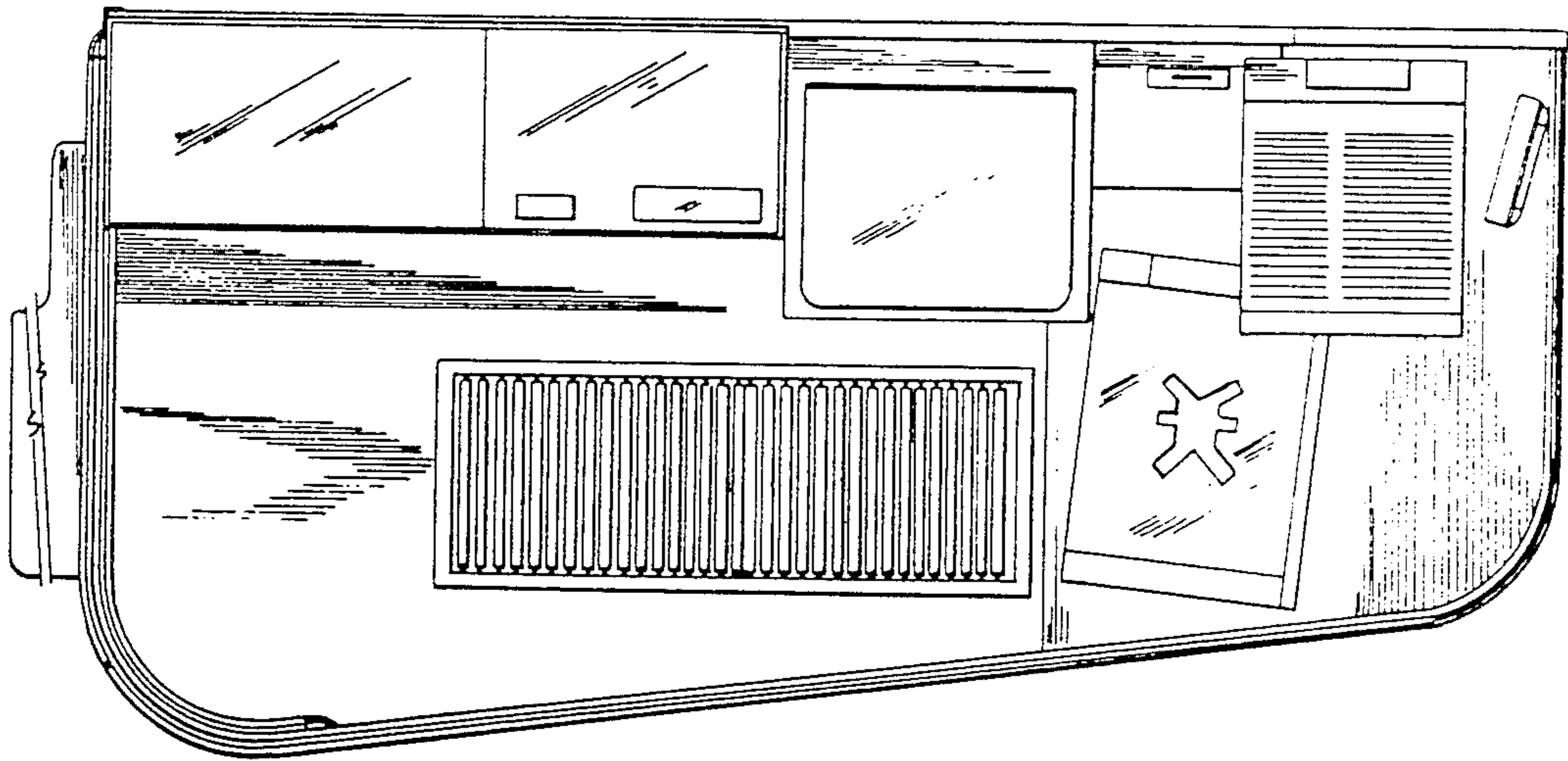

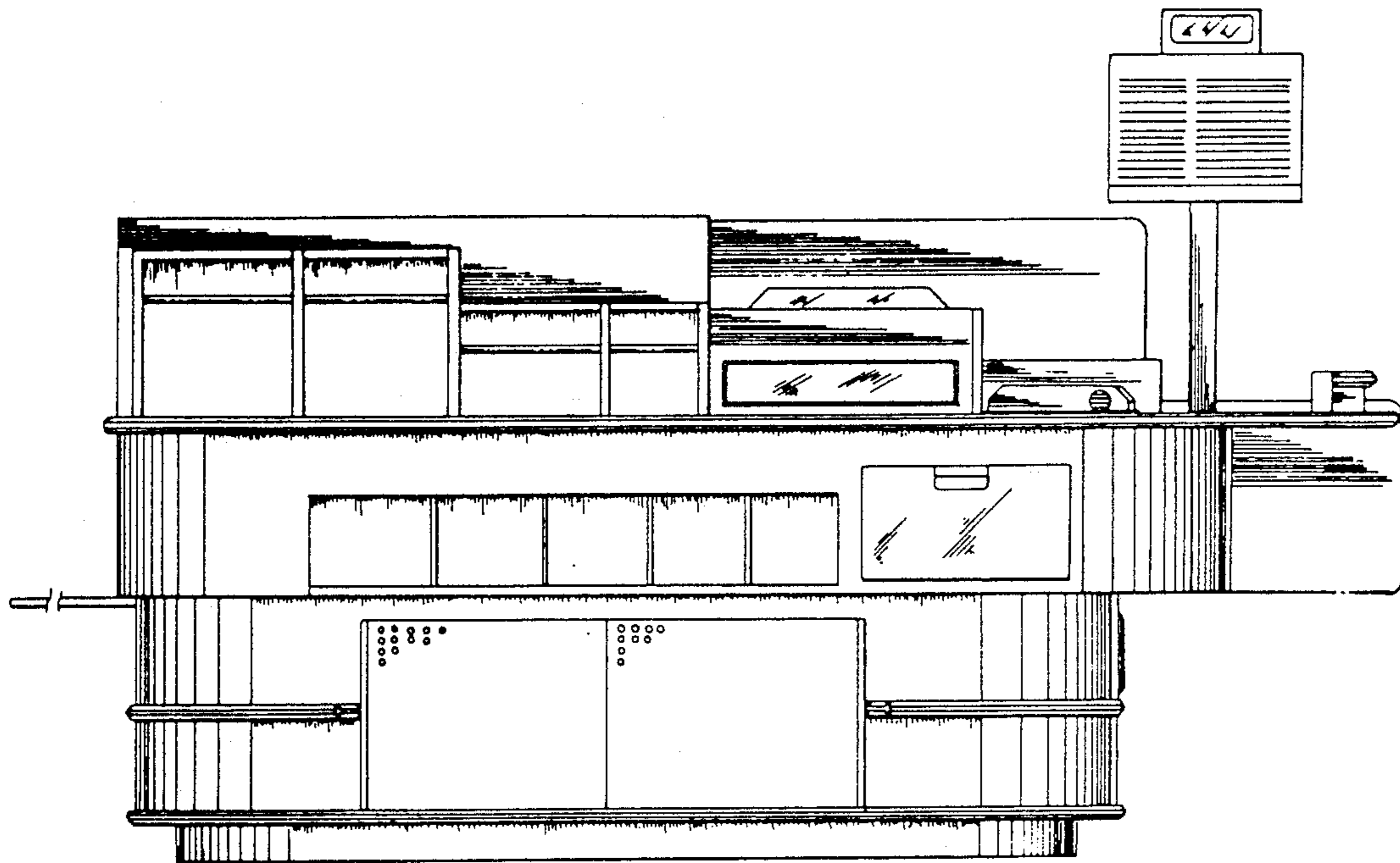

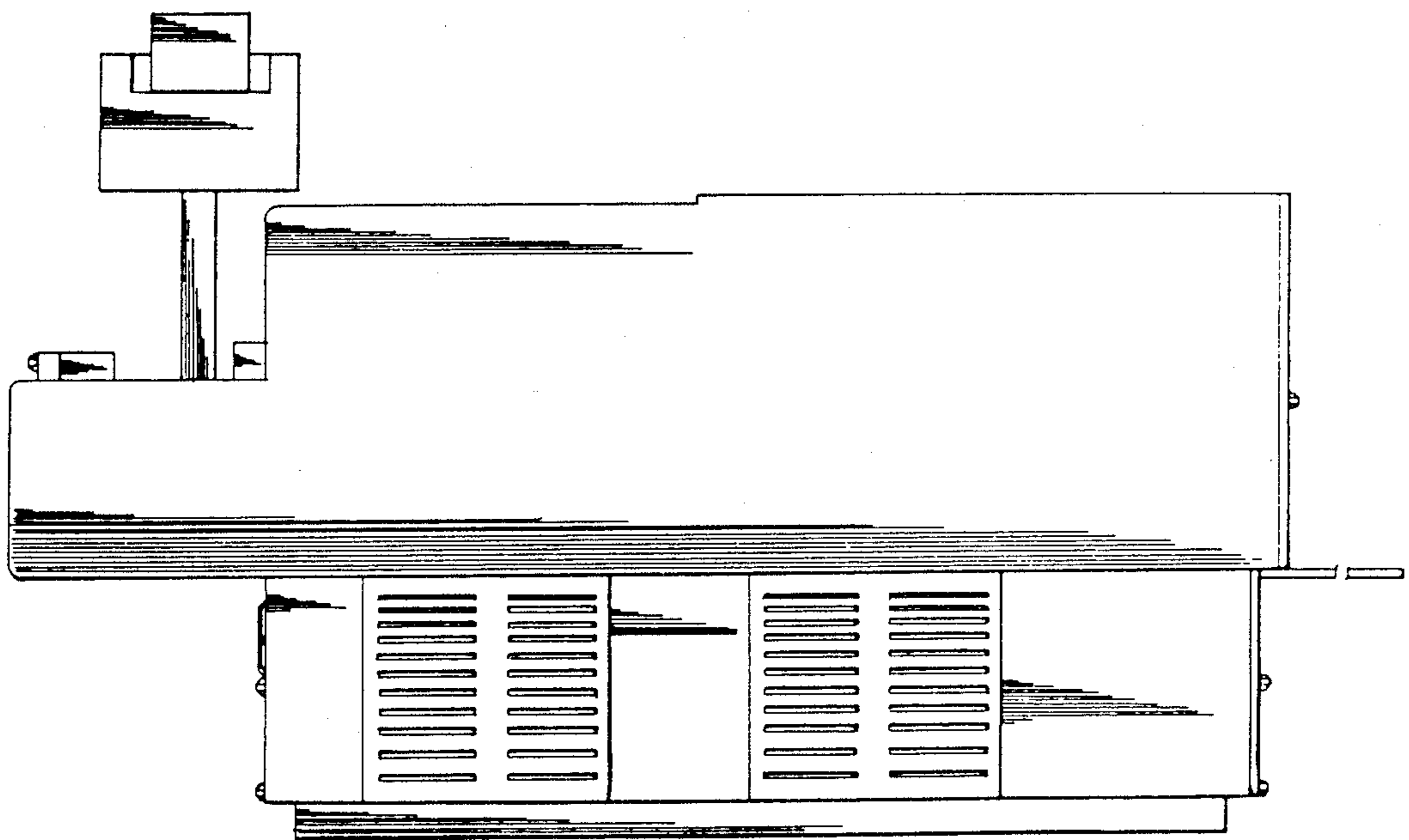

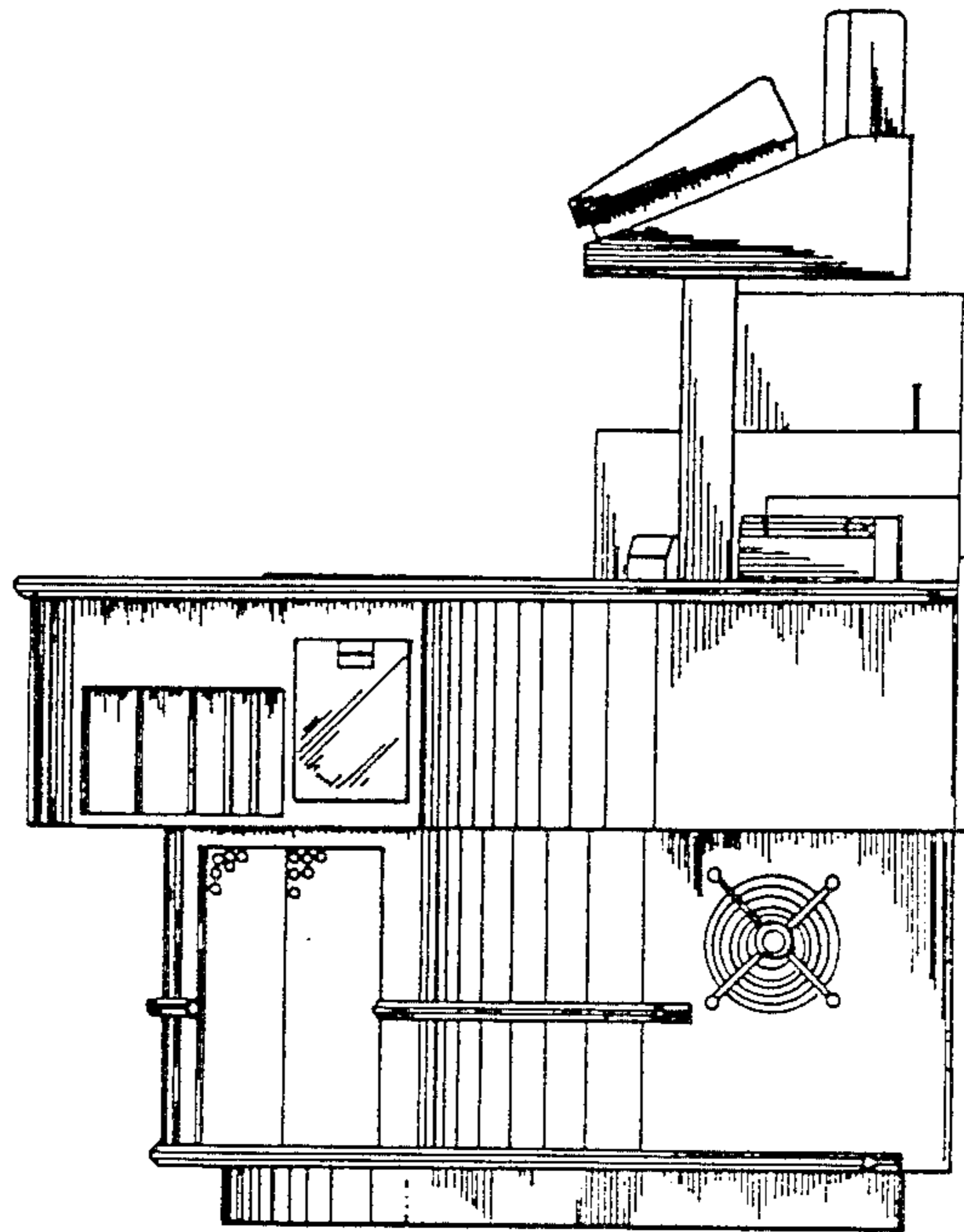

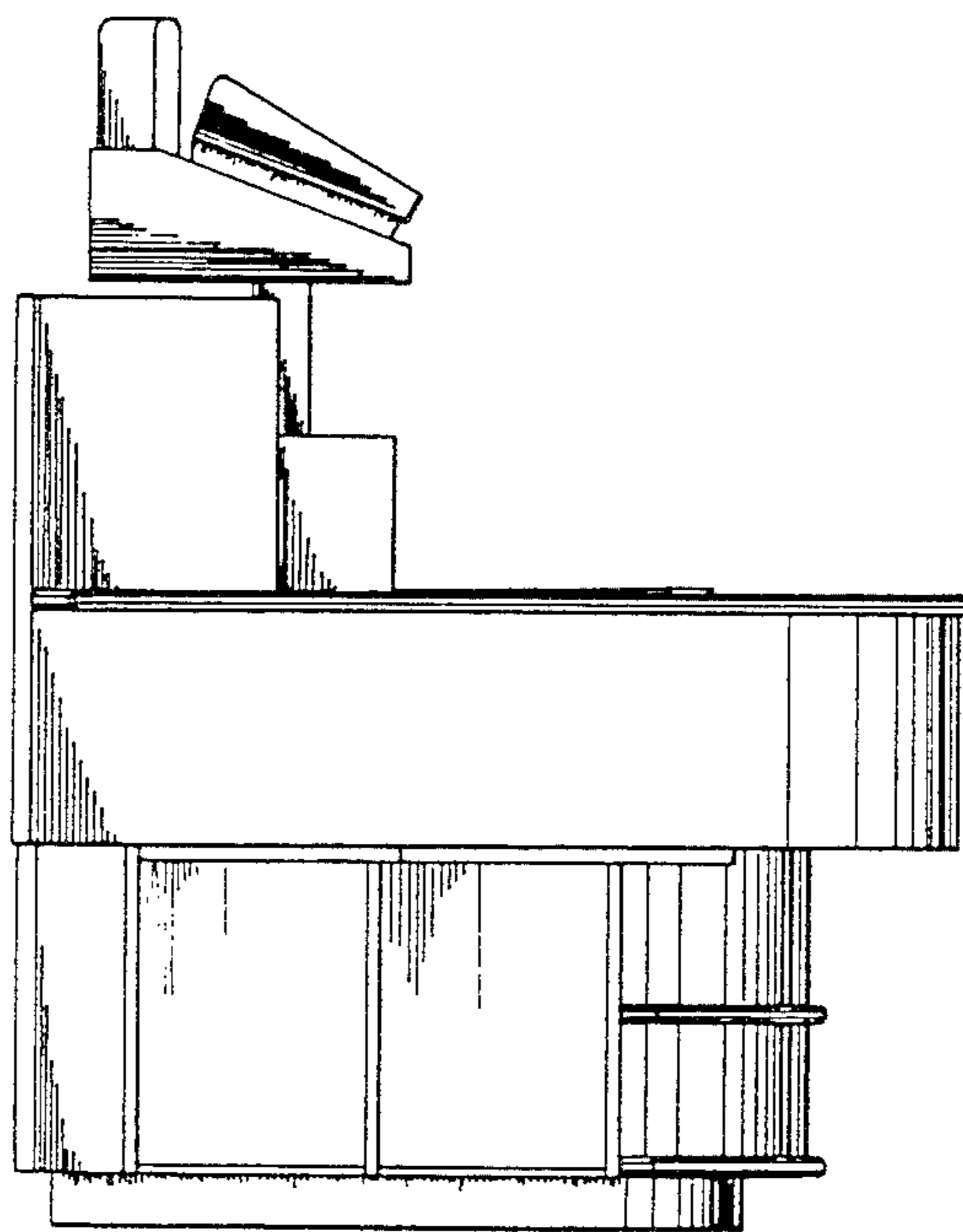
