FIG. 4 is a right/or left side elevation view thereof in inverted condition.

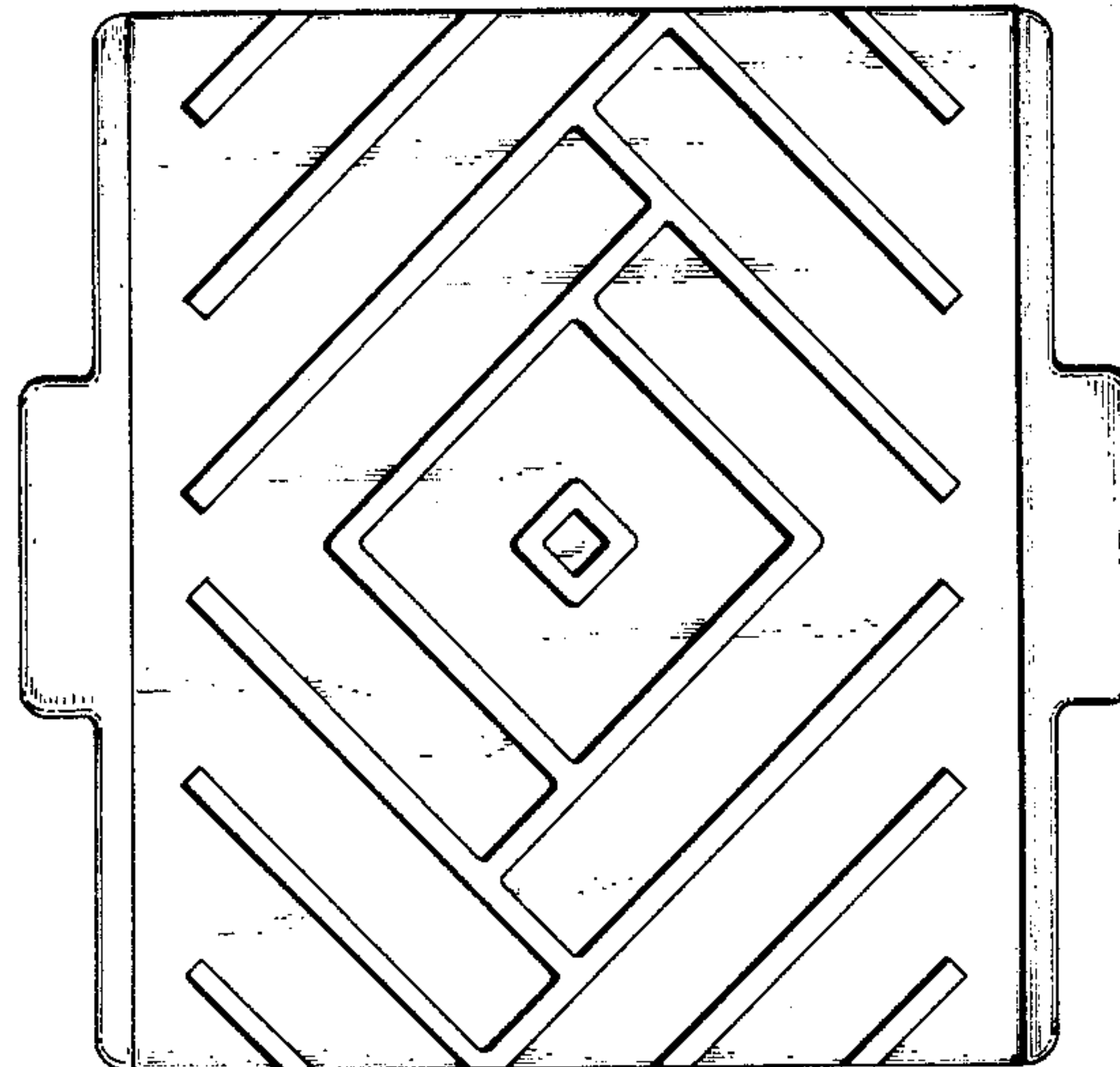

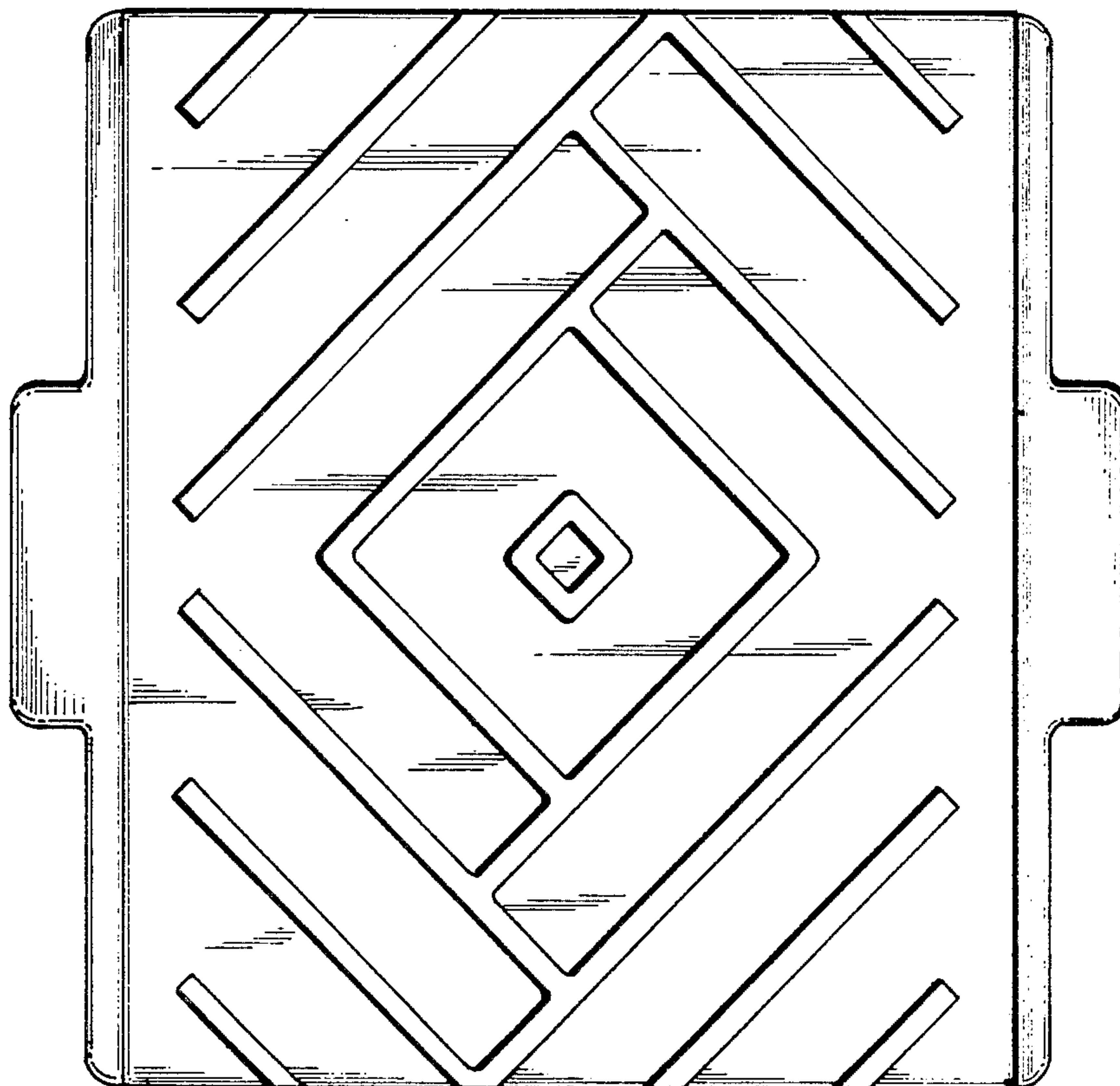

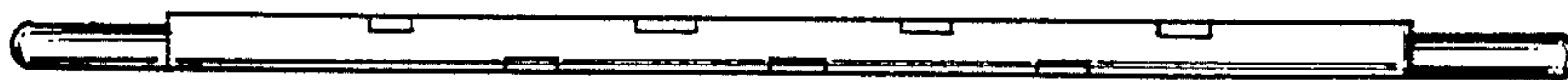

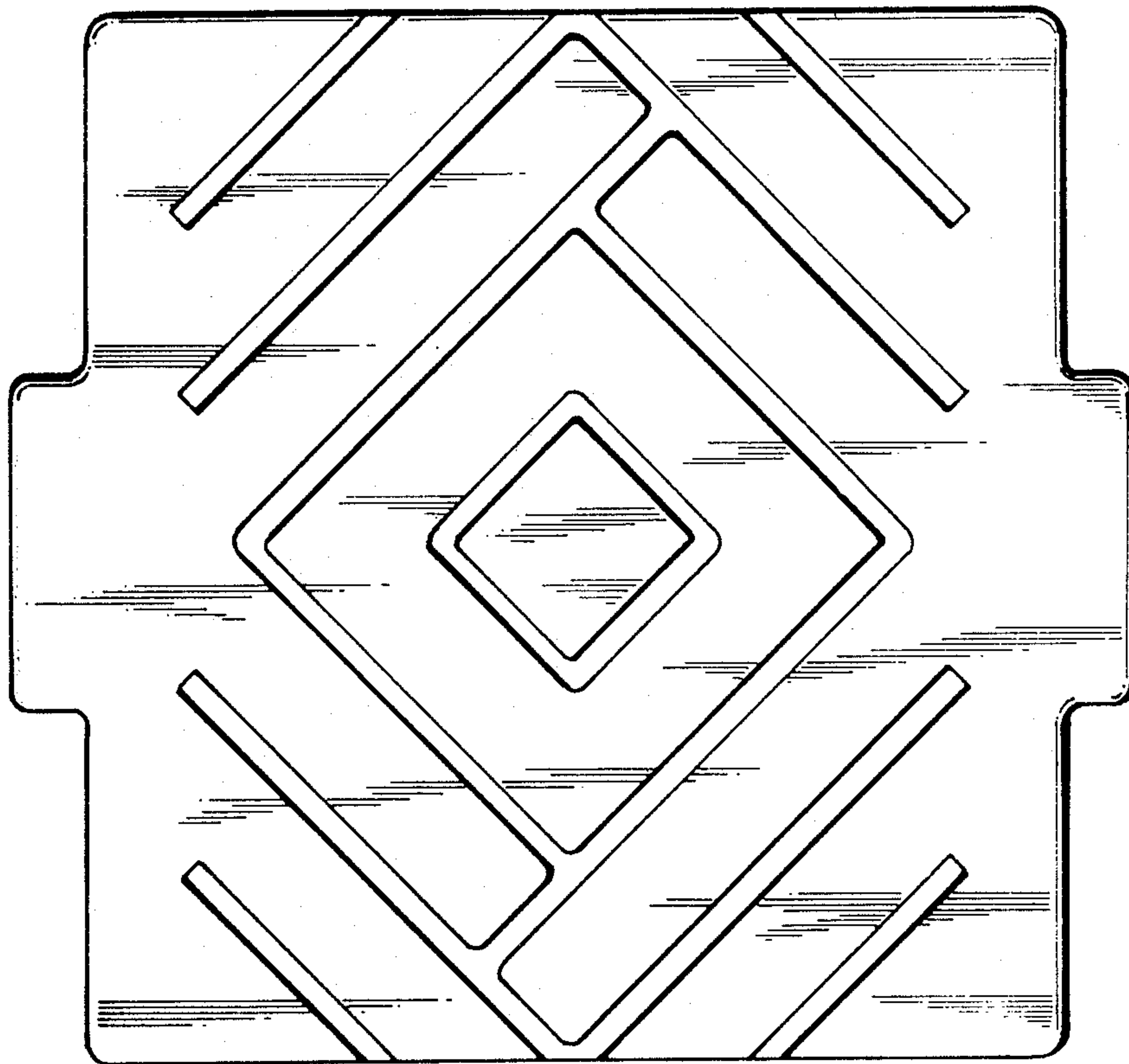
