[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a novelty headband or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a novelty headband showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 1, the left side being a mirror image thereof.

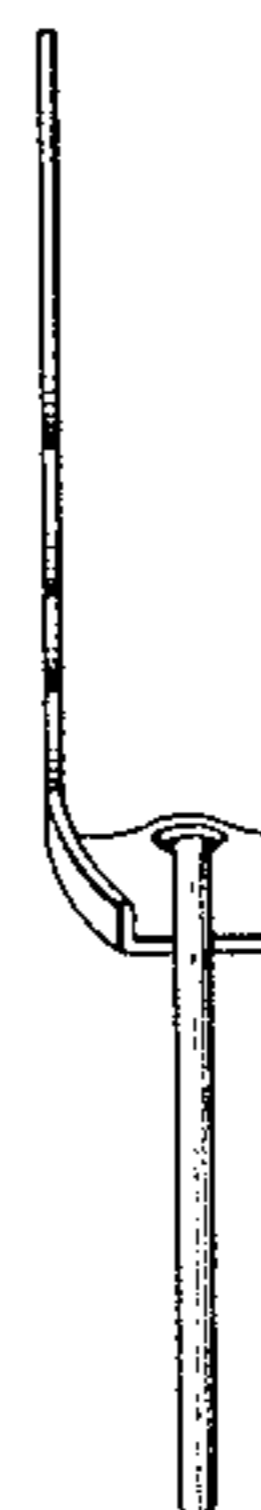
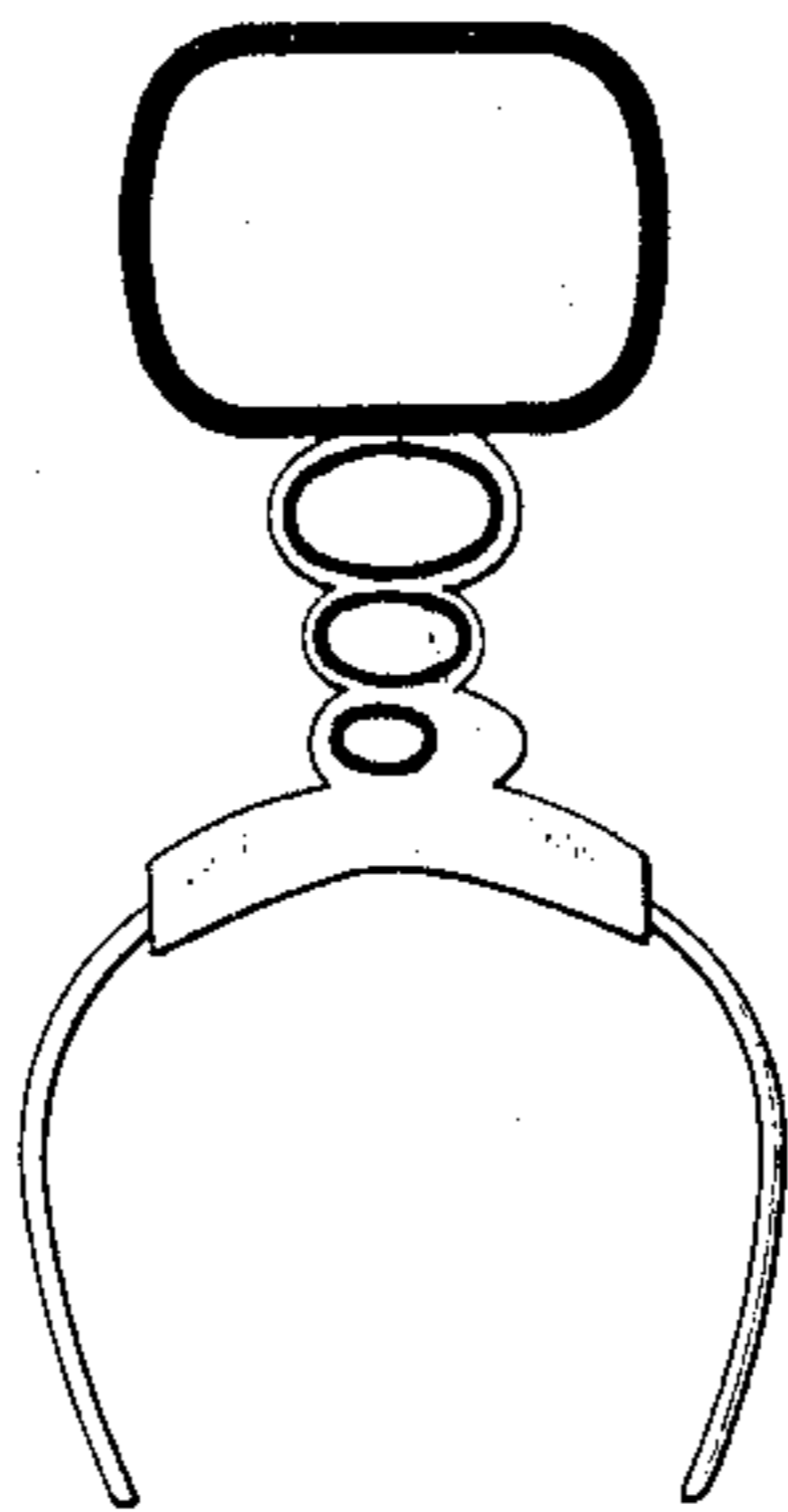

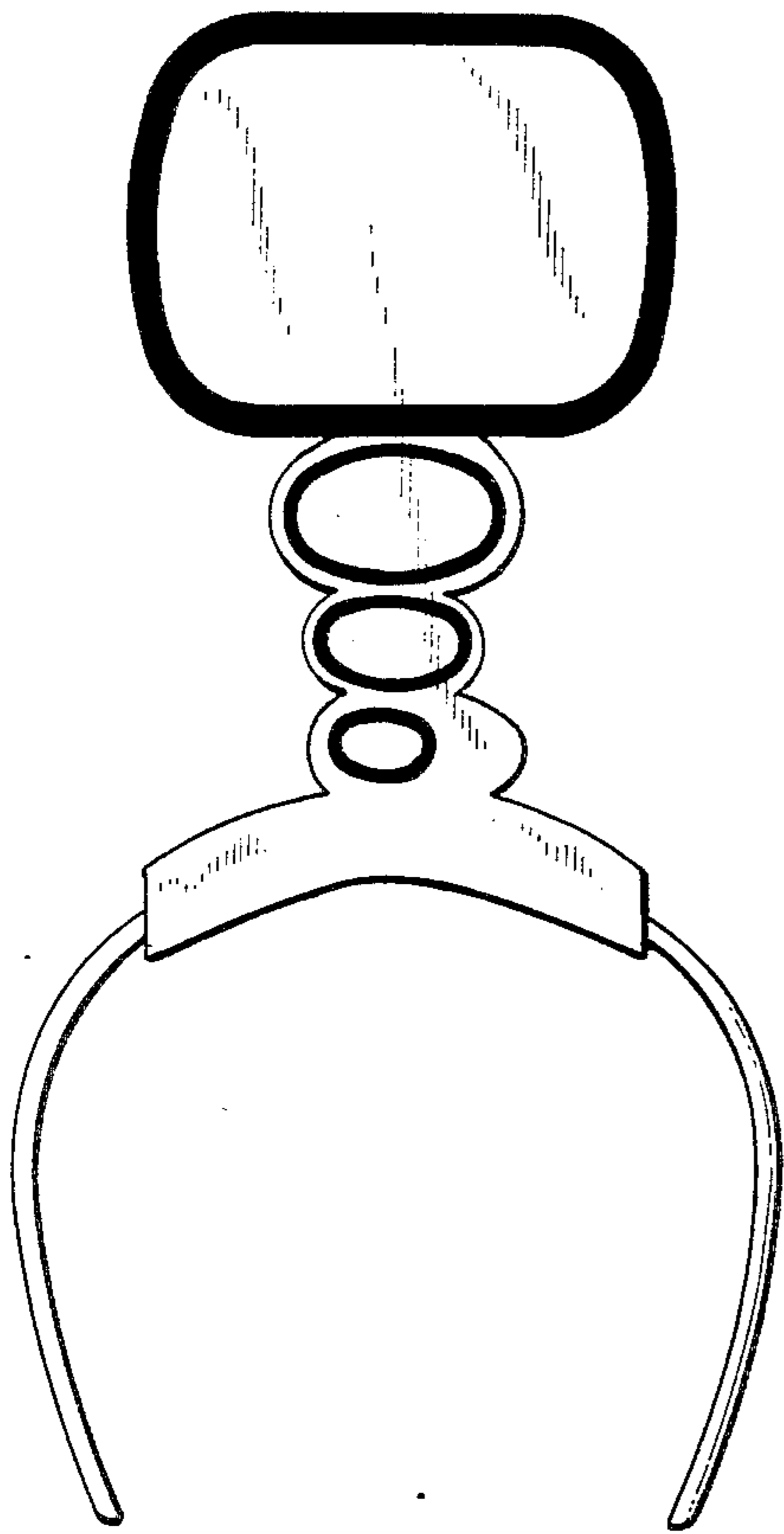

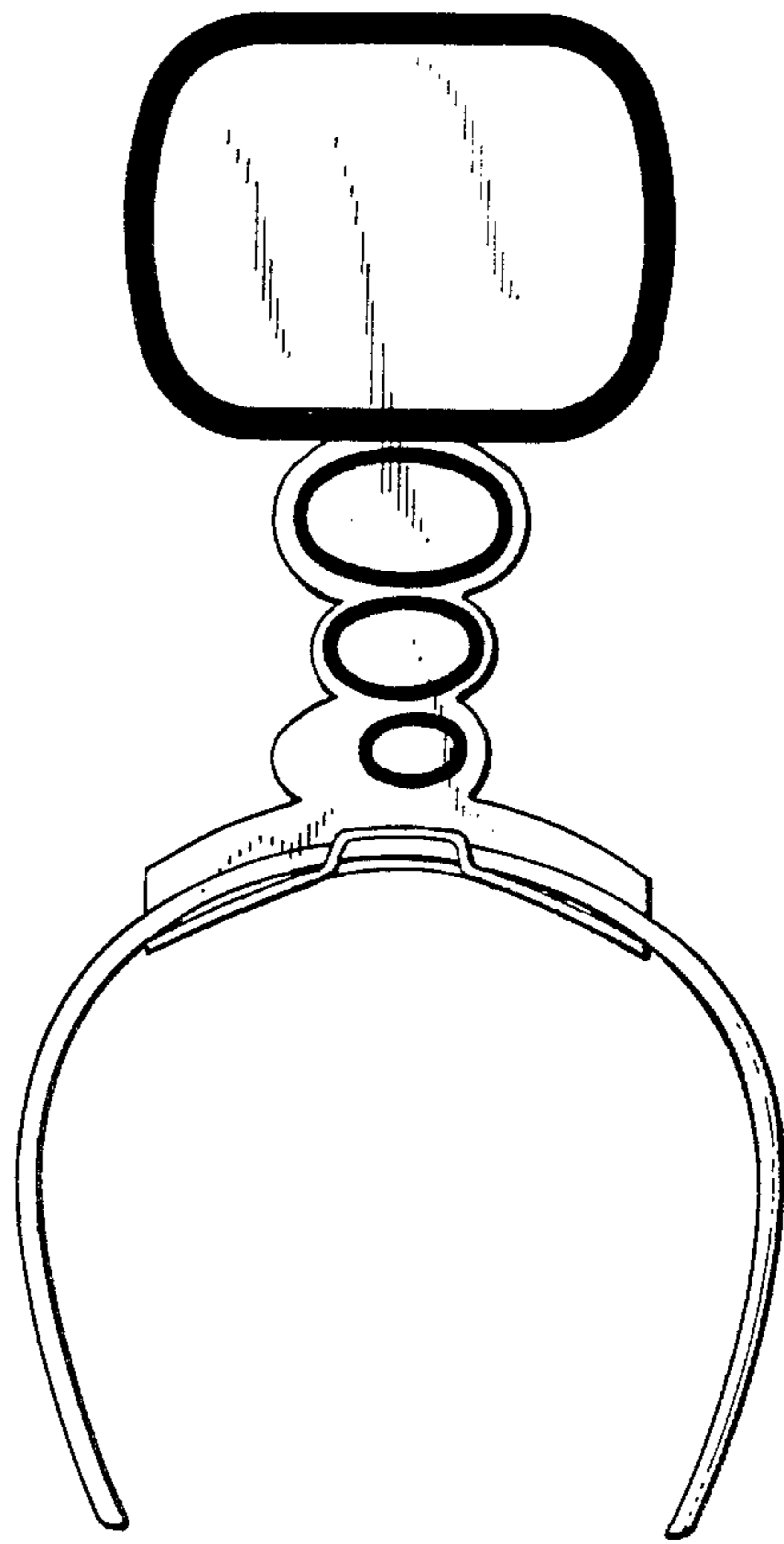

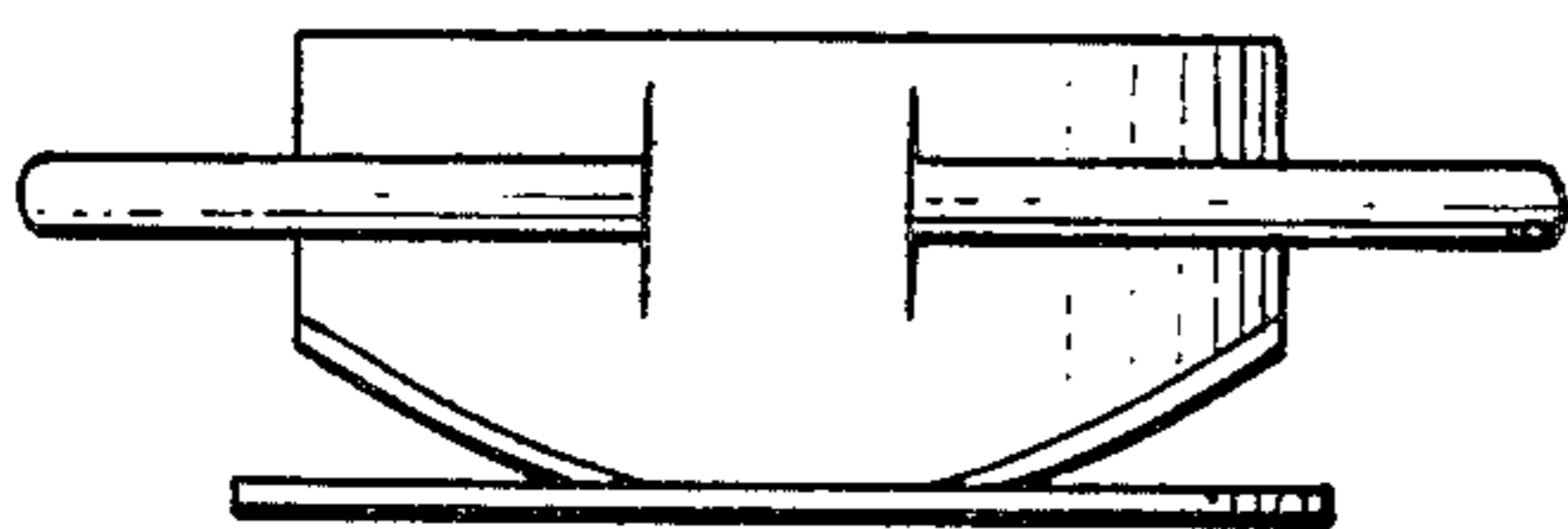

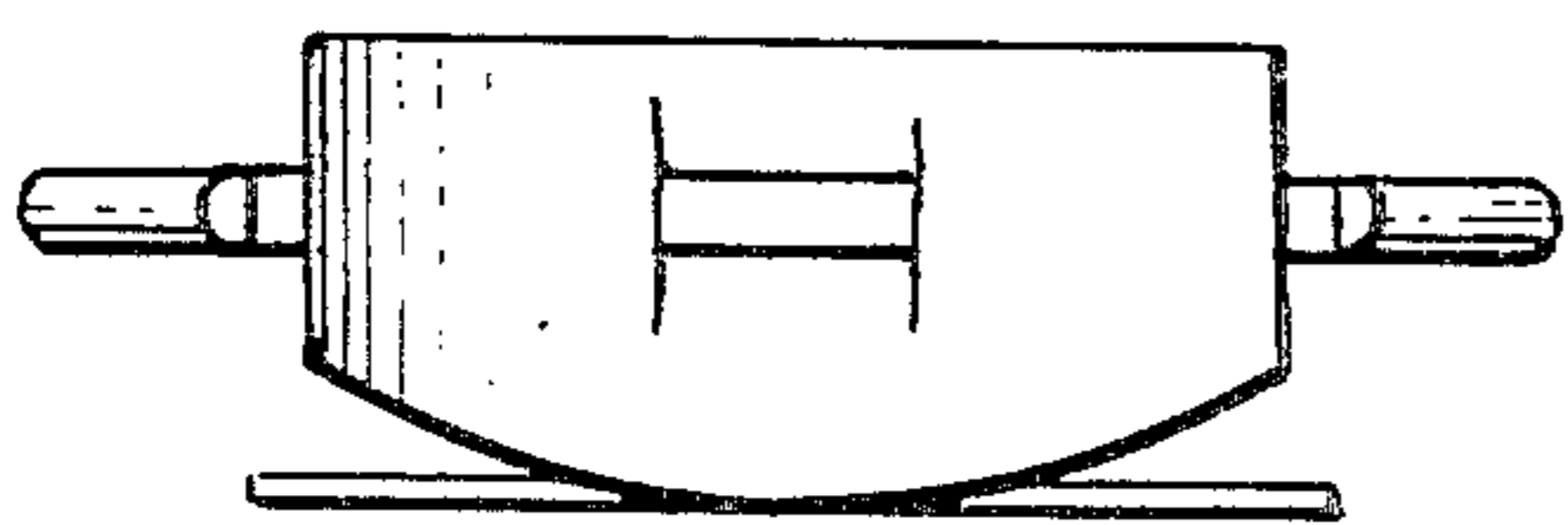
