[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toy suspension bar for baby's playpen, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a toy suspension bar for baby's playpen, showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side elevational view being substantially a mirror image, thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view, thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view; and, FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.
