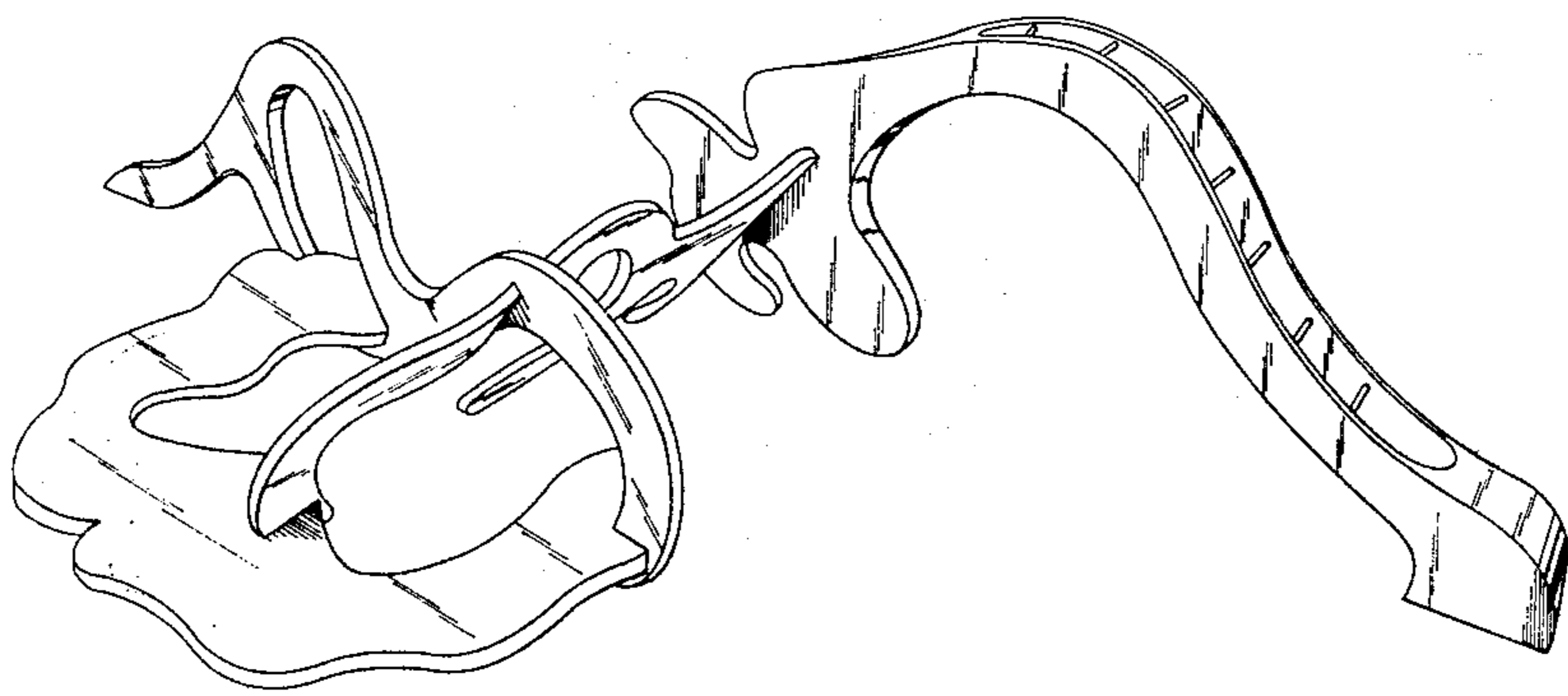

FIG. 5 is a right end perspective view thereof.



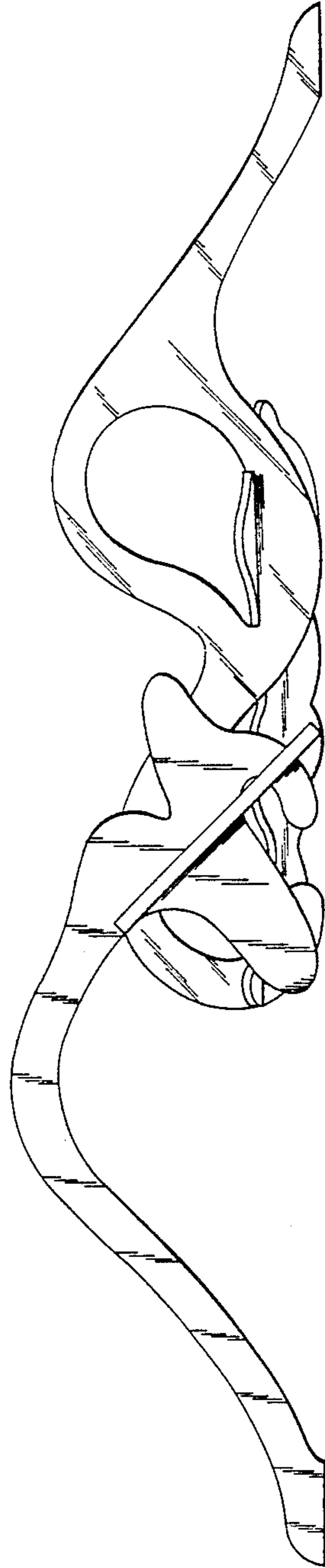

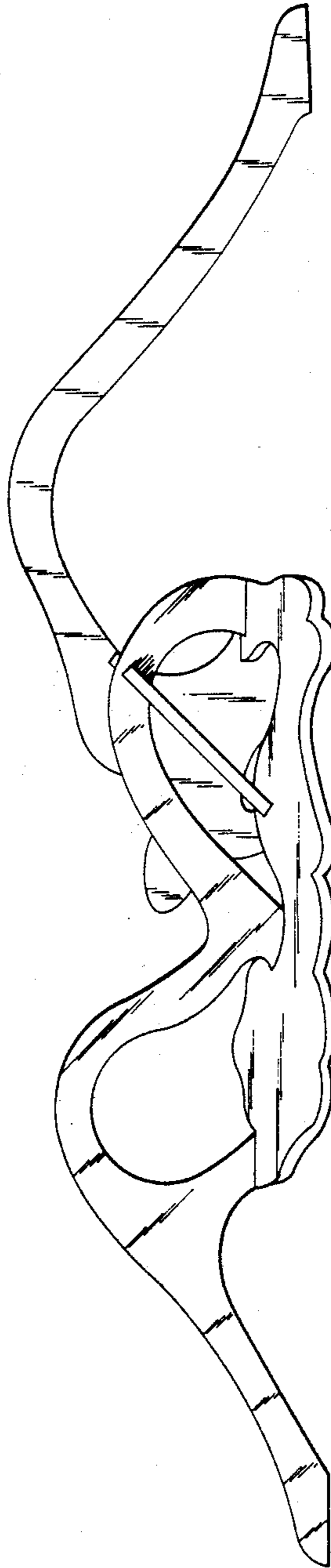

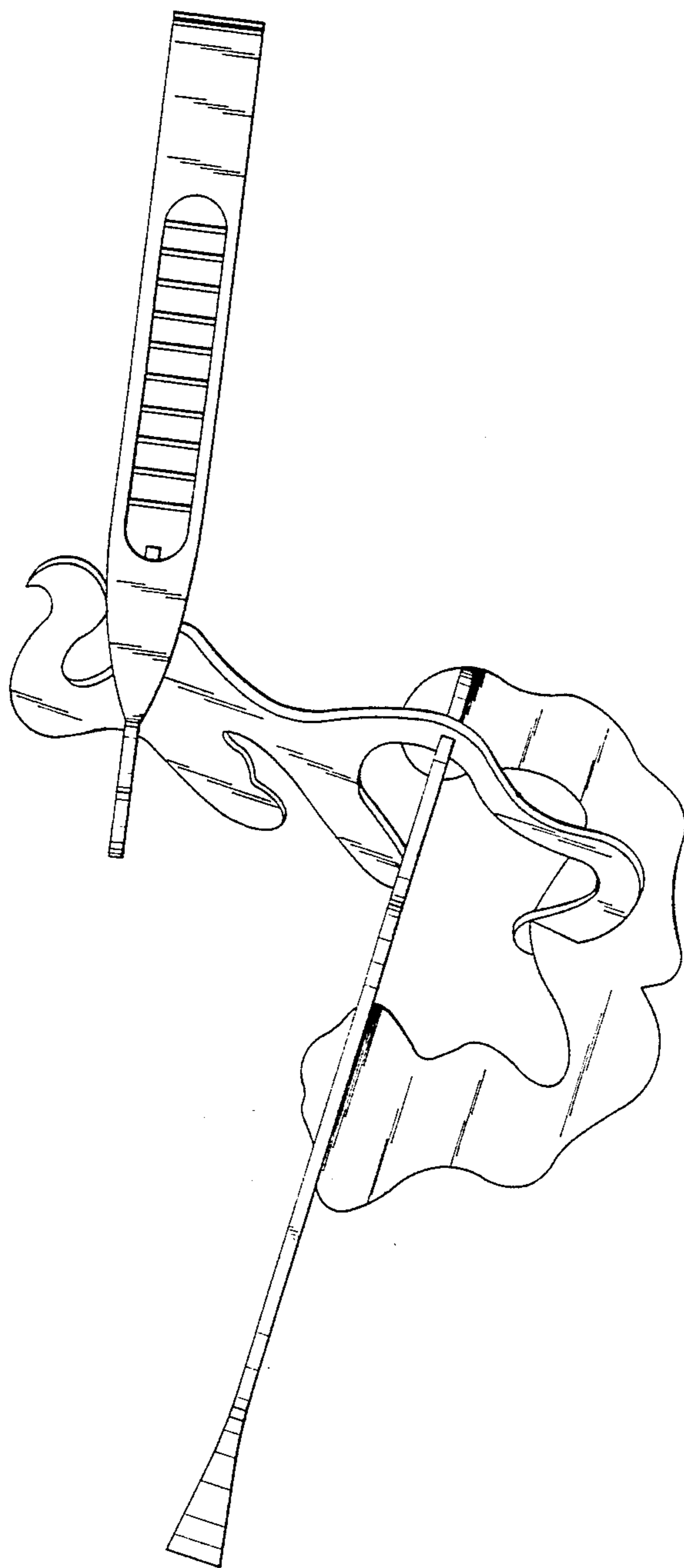

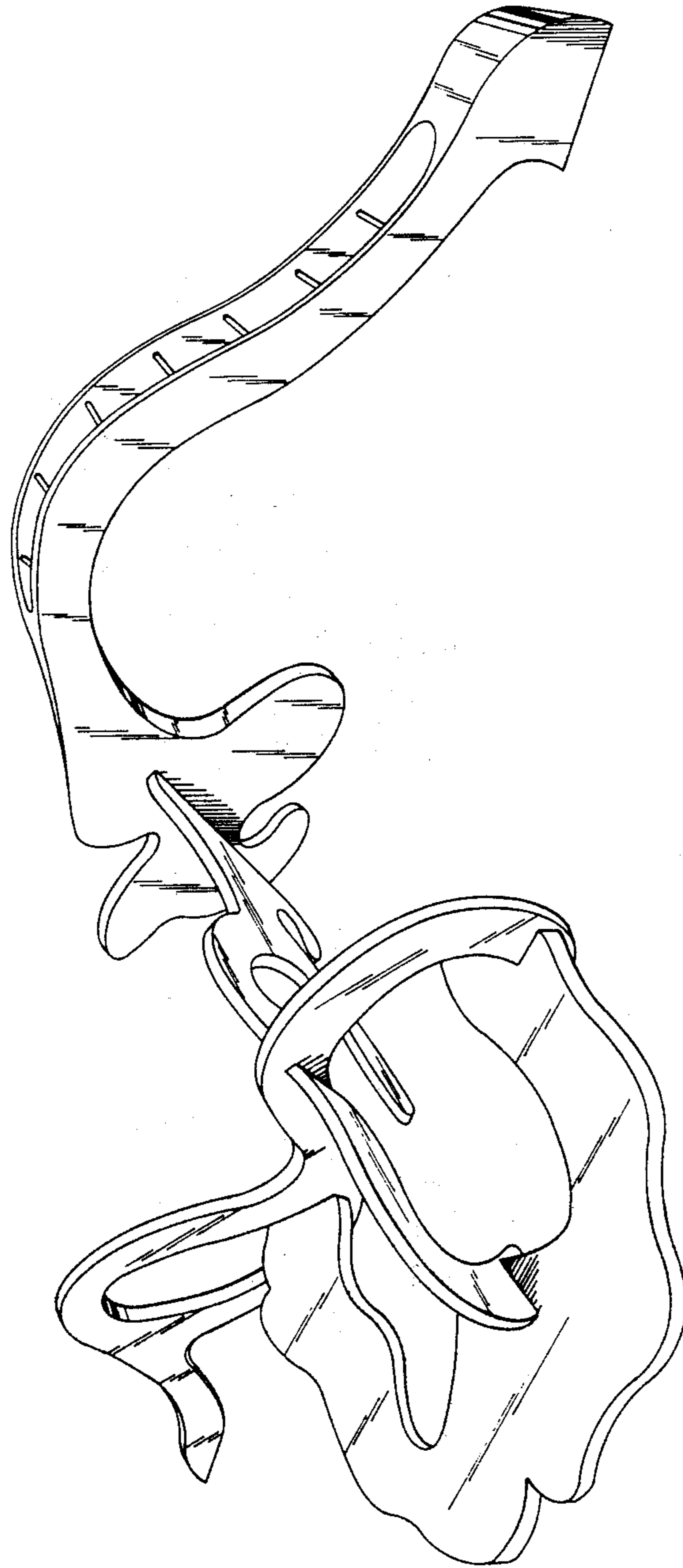

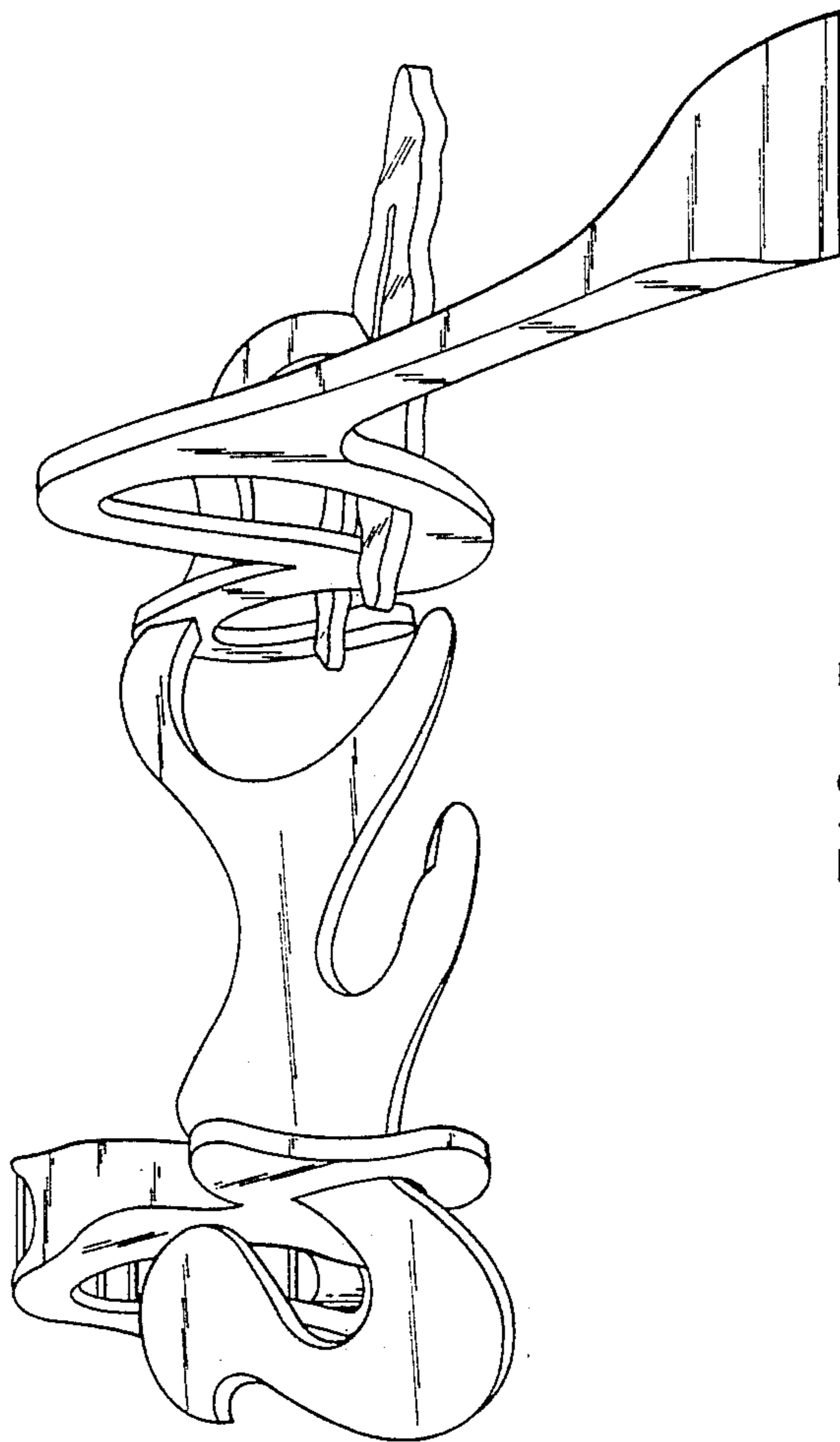
