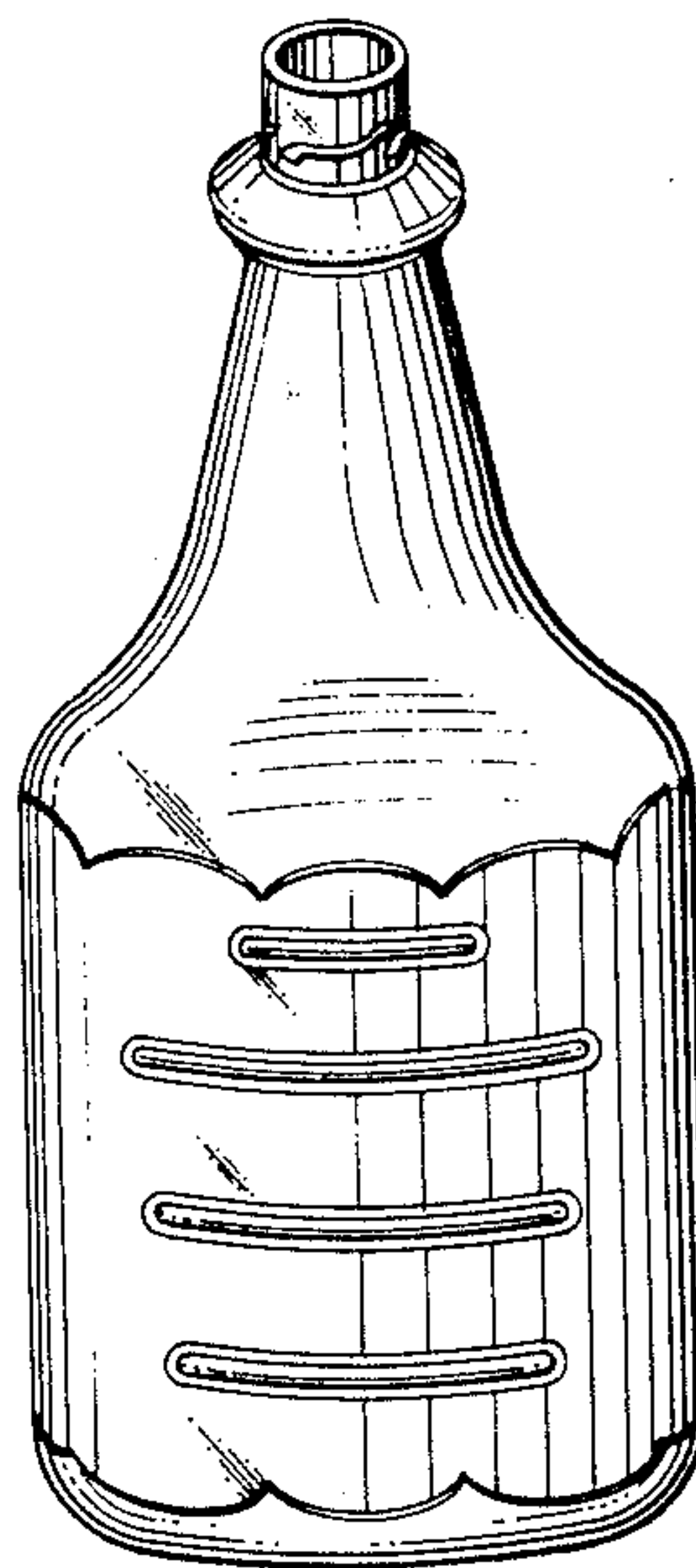

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bottle showing my new design, the opposite side being the same in appearance;
 FIG. 2 is an elevational view looking from the right of FIG. 1, the opposite side being the same in appearance;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view; and
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view.



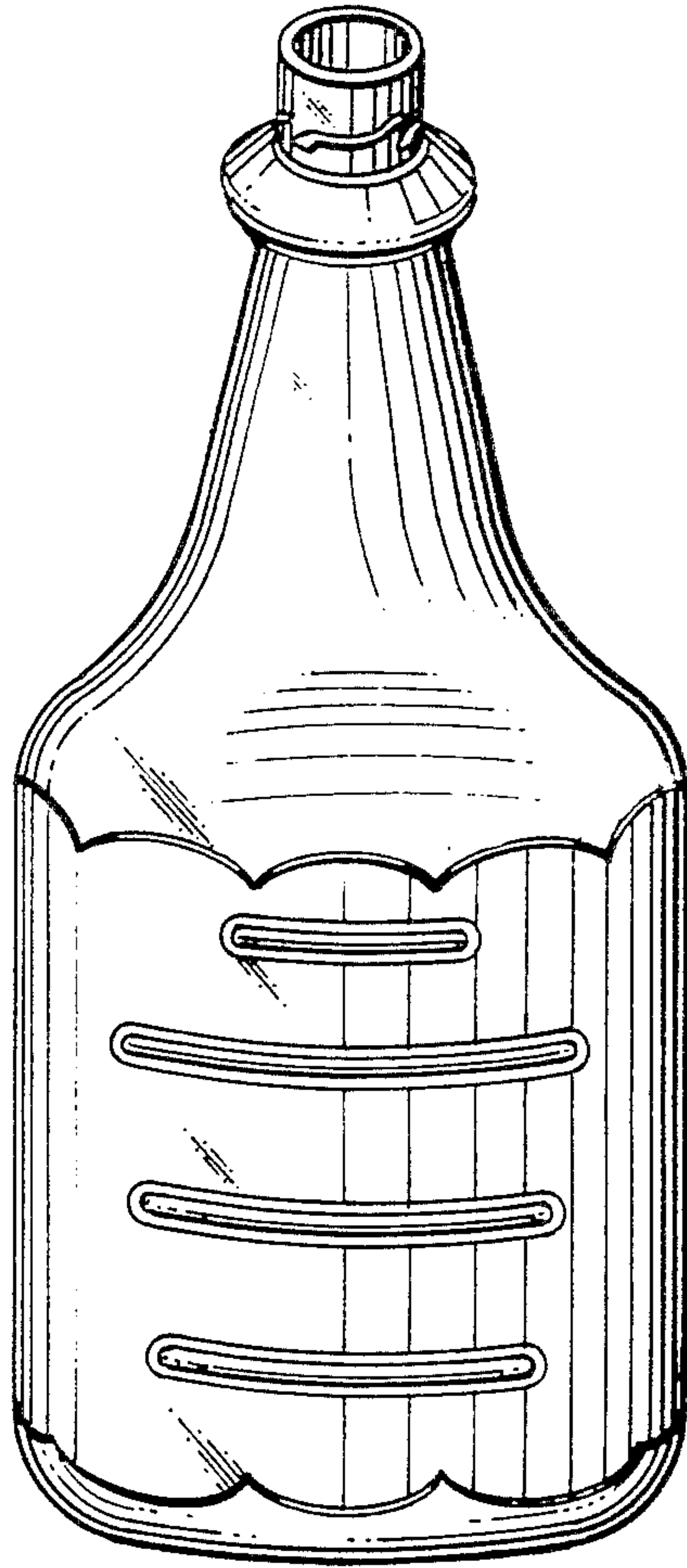

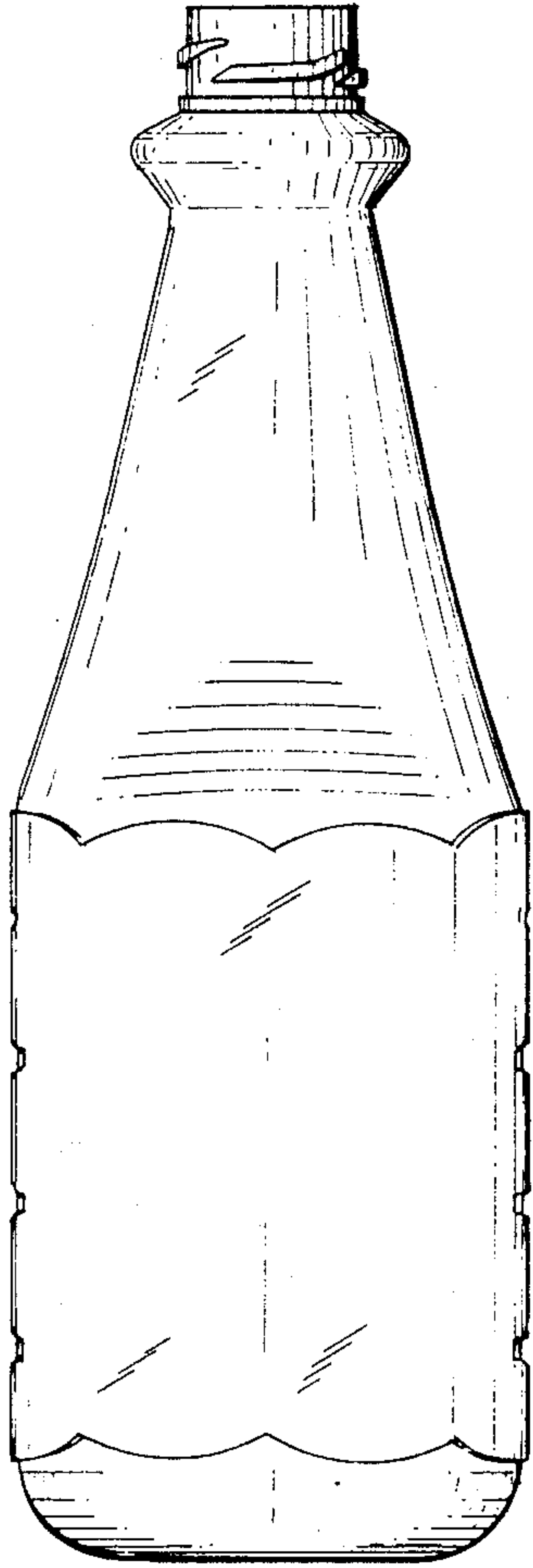

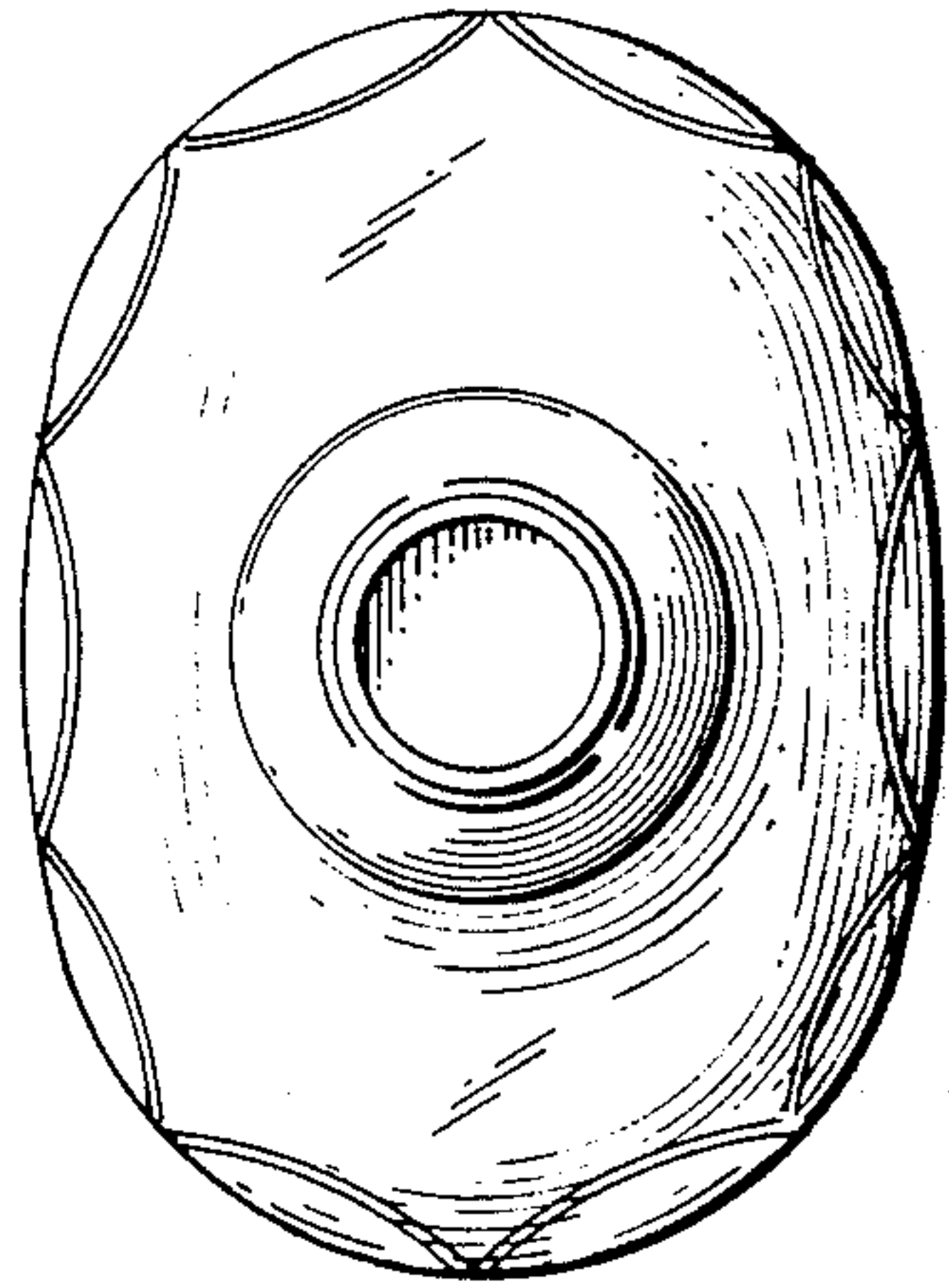

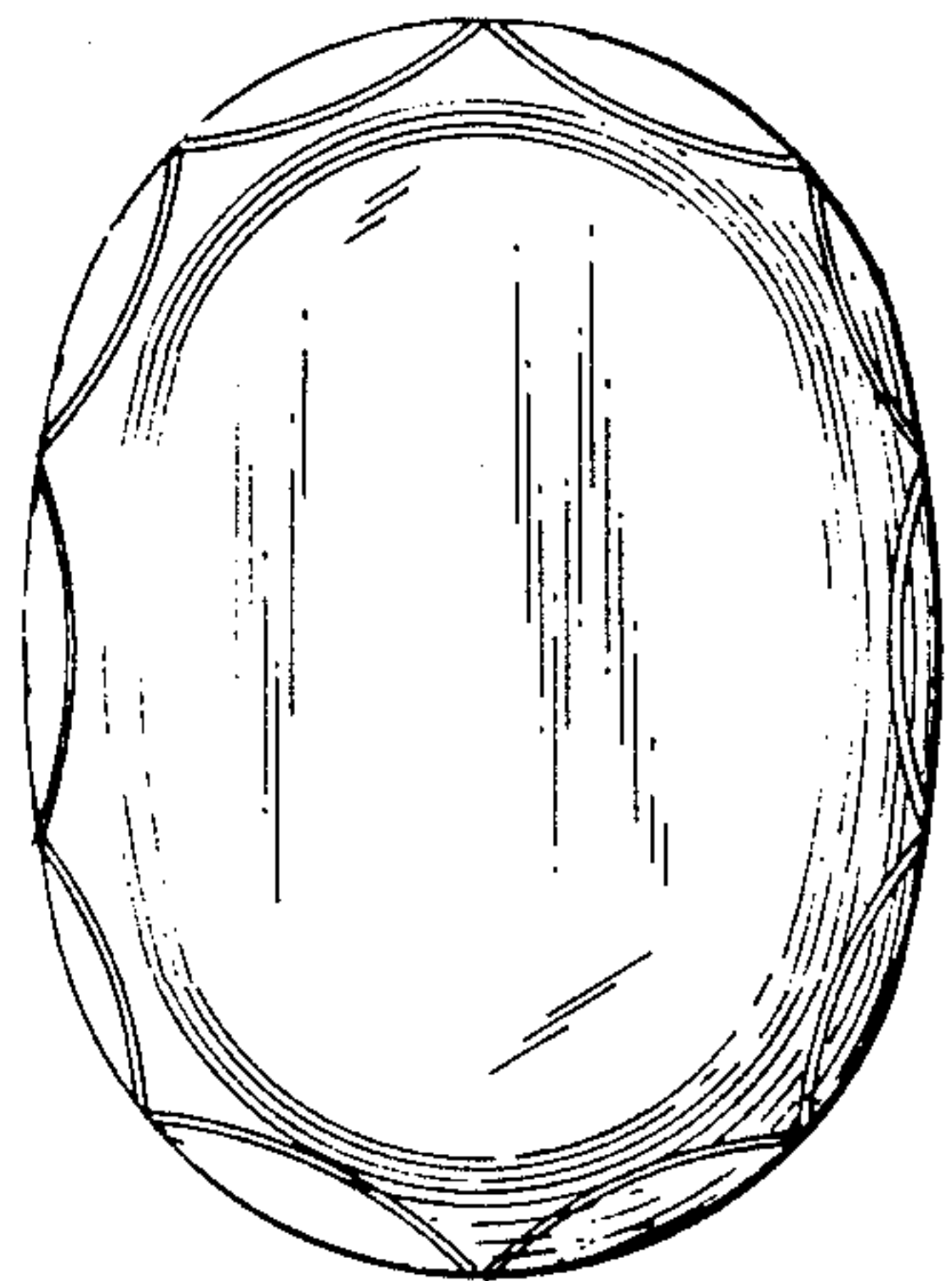
