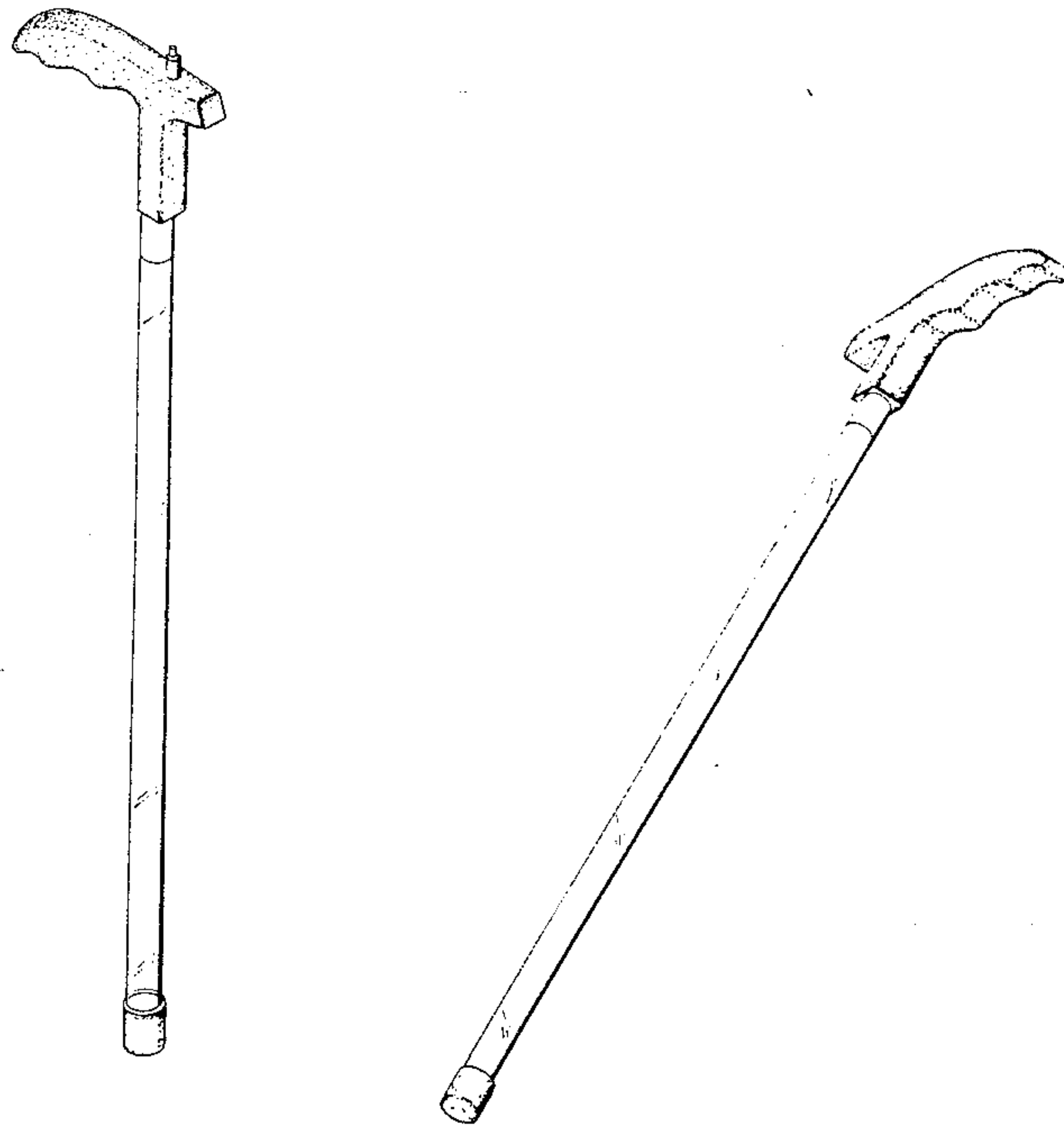

**FIG. 1** is a top, front right side perspective view of a transparent glow cane showing my new design; and **FIG. 2** is a bottom, rear perspective view thereof.



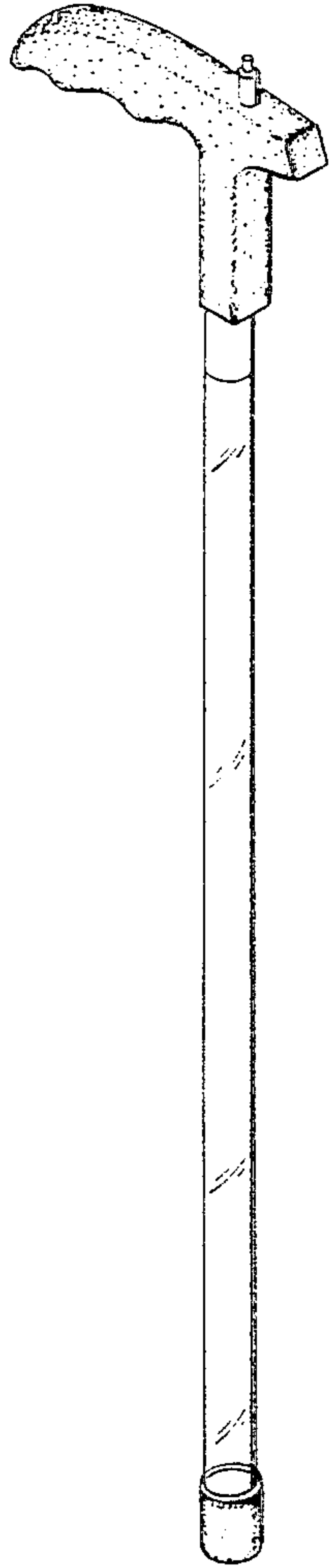

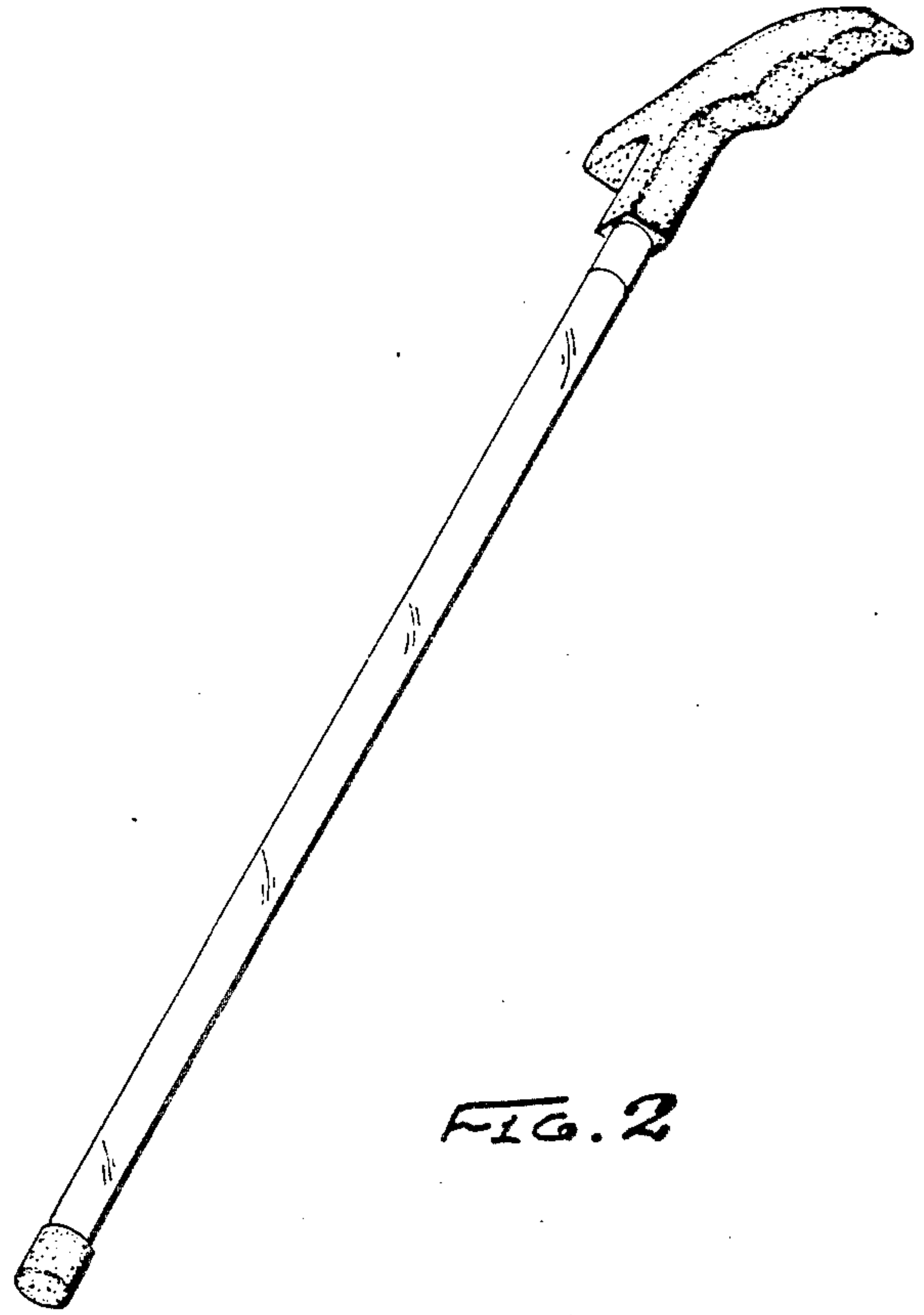
