[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a tape cassette holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tape cassette holder showing my new design with the access door in the open position;

FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof with the door in the closed position;

FIG. 3 is a top rear perspective view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right end elevational view thereof, the environmental structure shown in dotted lines being for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof with the door open and illustrating a leaf spring at the inner end of each tape cassette receiving compartment.

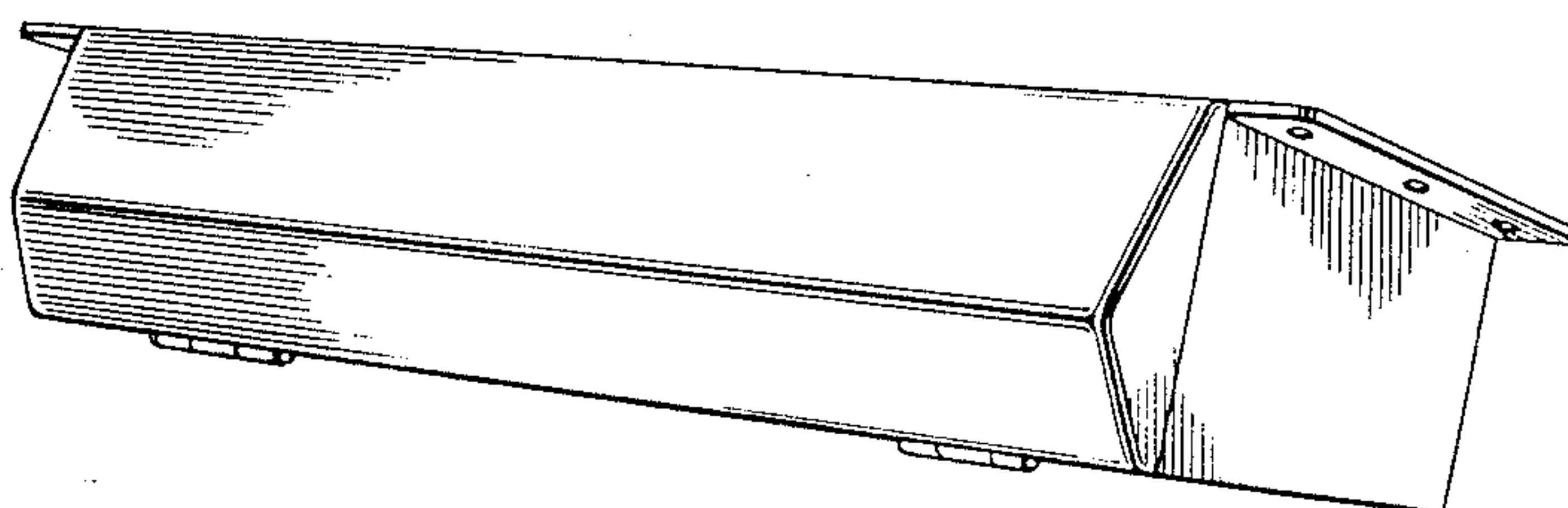
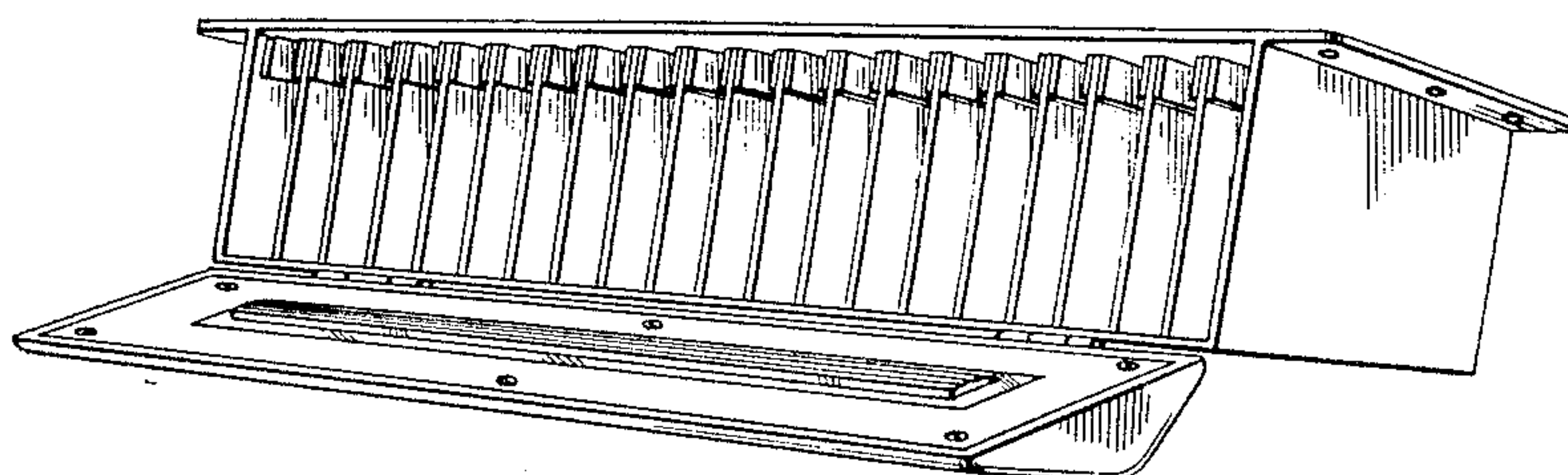

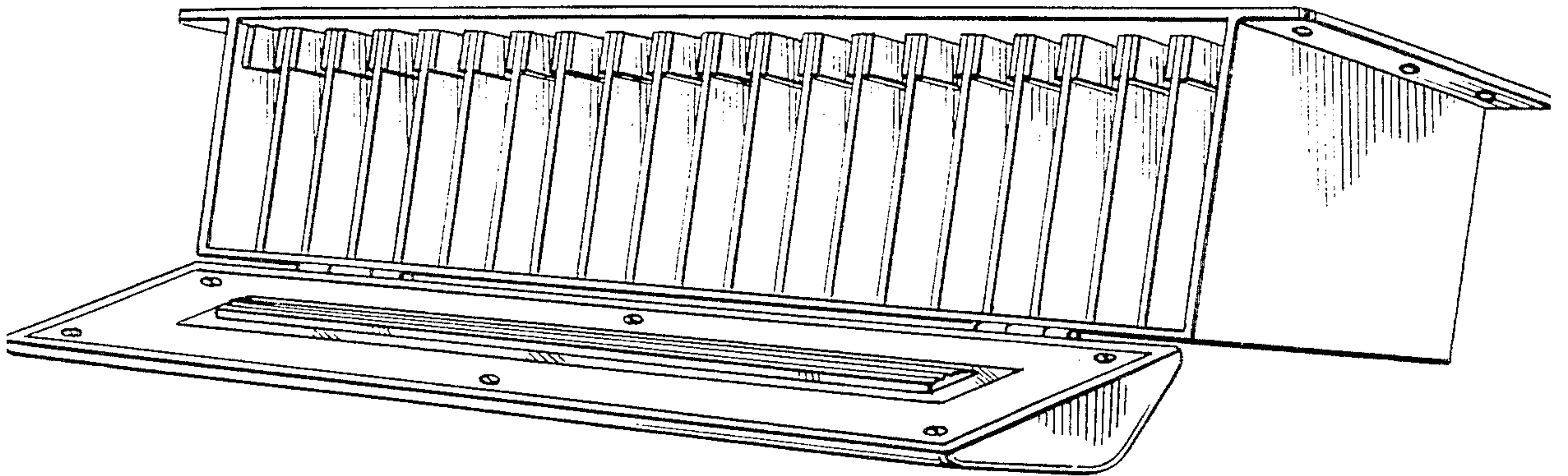

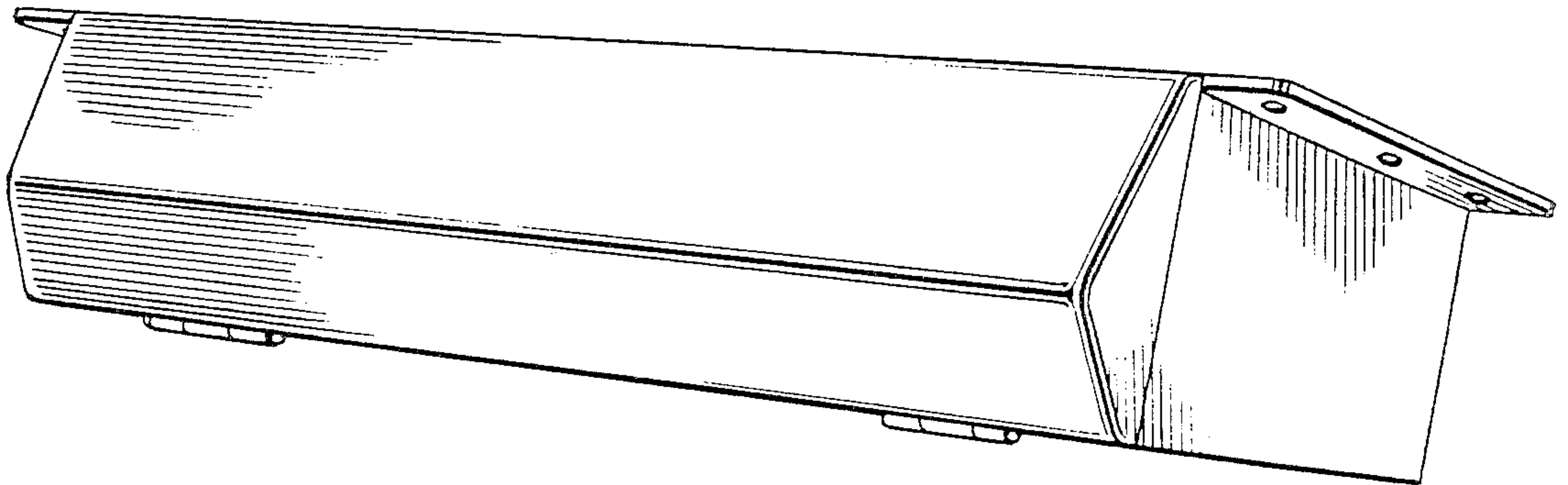

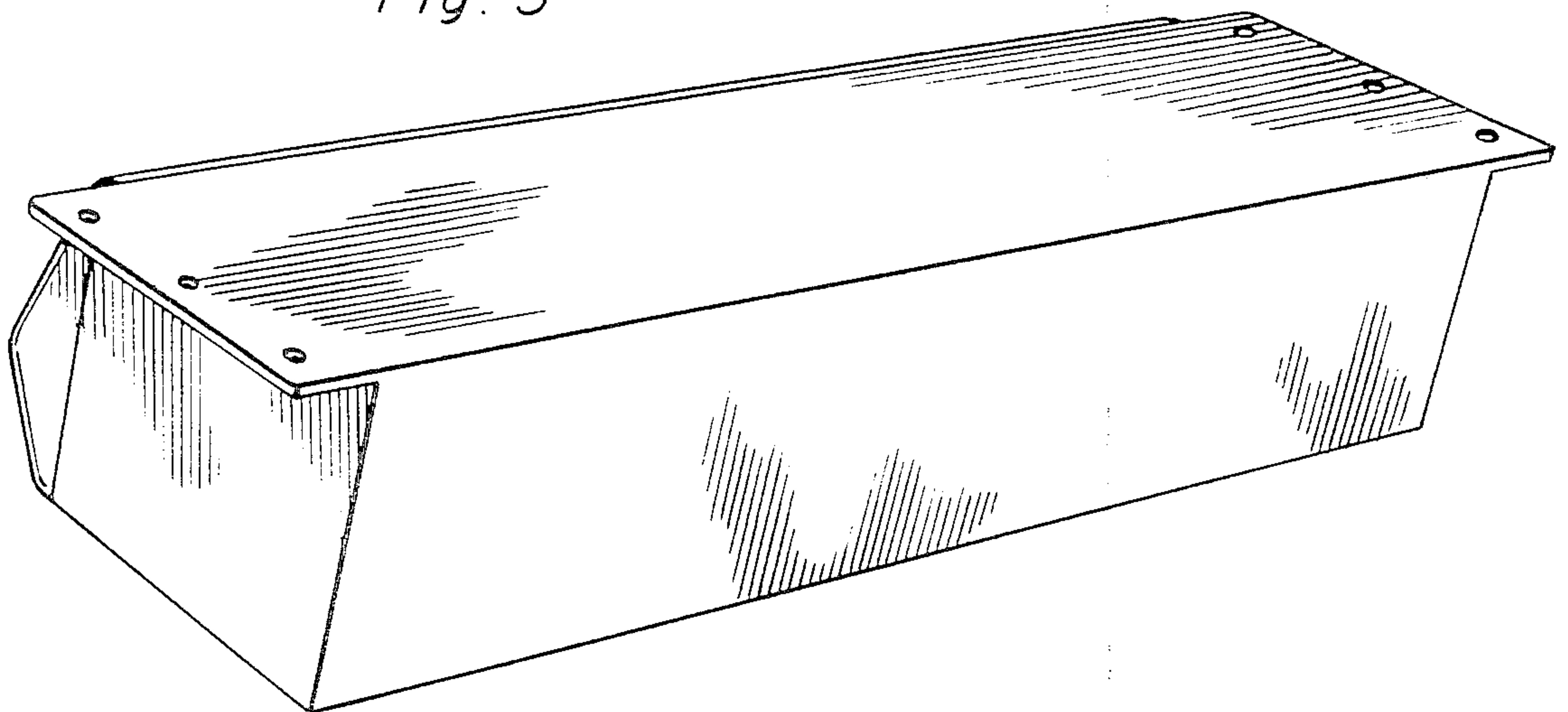

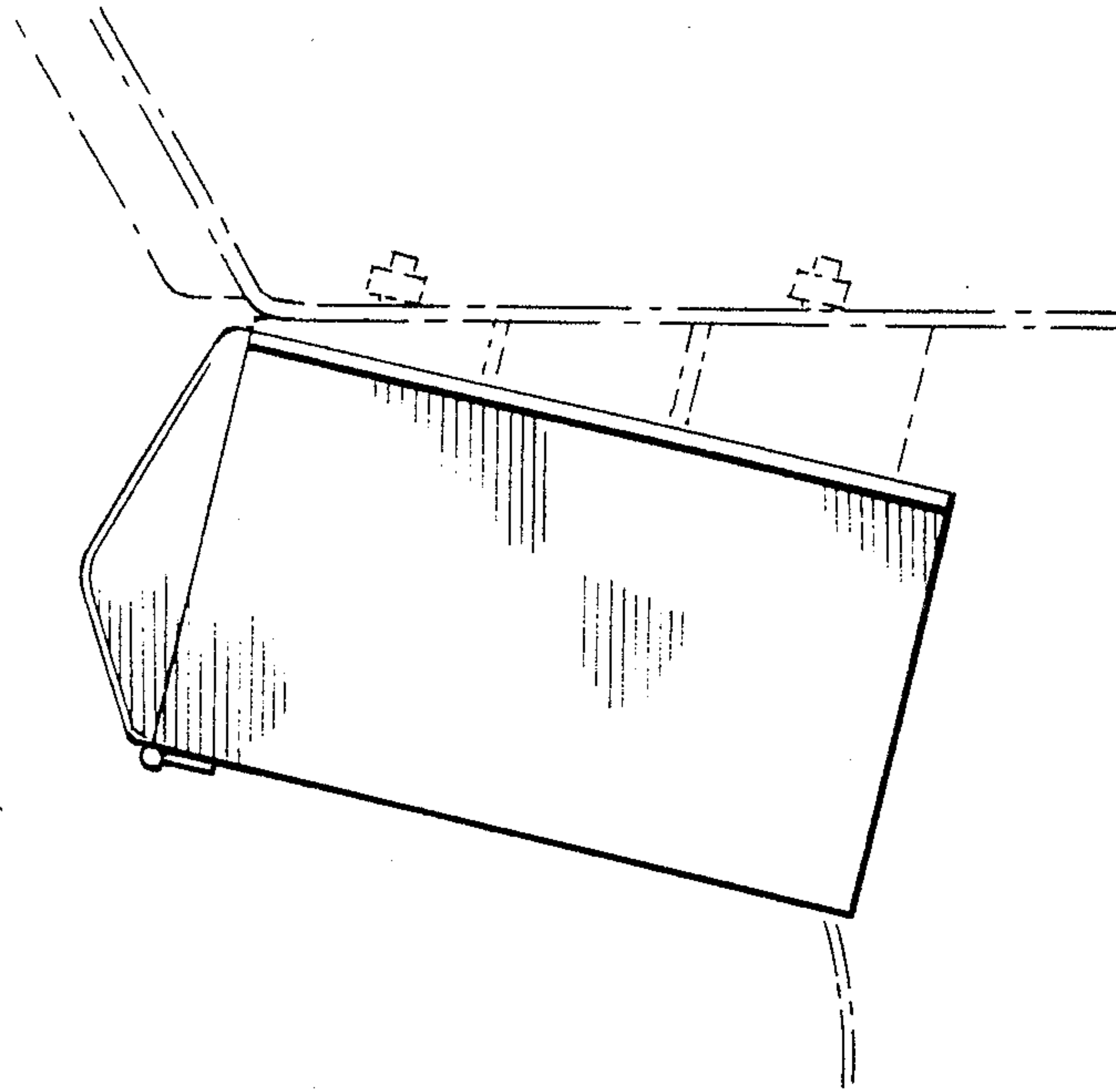

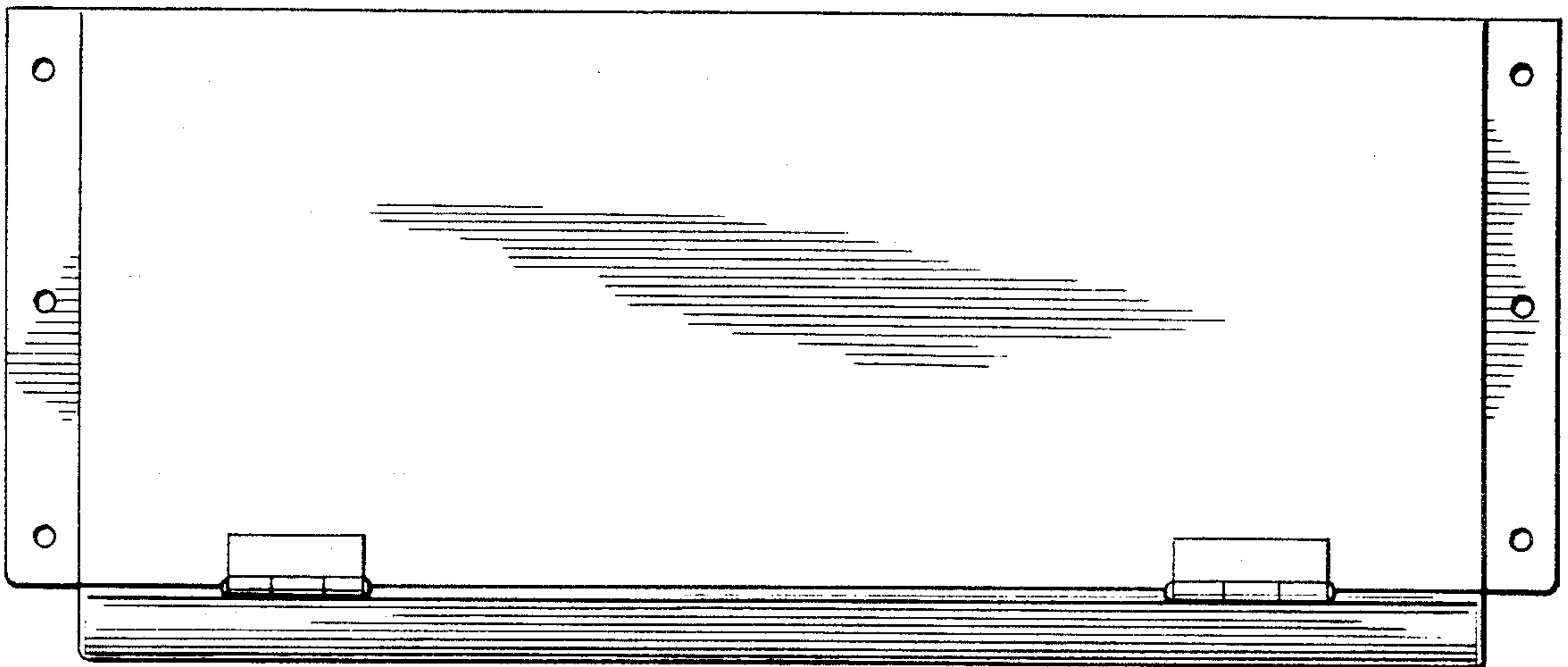
