[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a spoon or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a spoon showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 4 is an enlarged section taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is an enlarged section taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 1; and
 FIG. 6 is an enlarged section taken on line 6—6 of FIG. 1.
 The characteristic feature of my design resides in the handle portion.

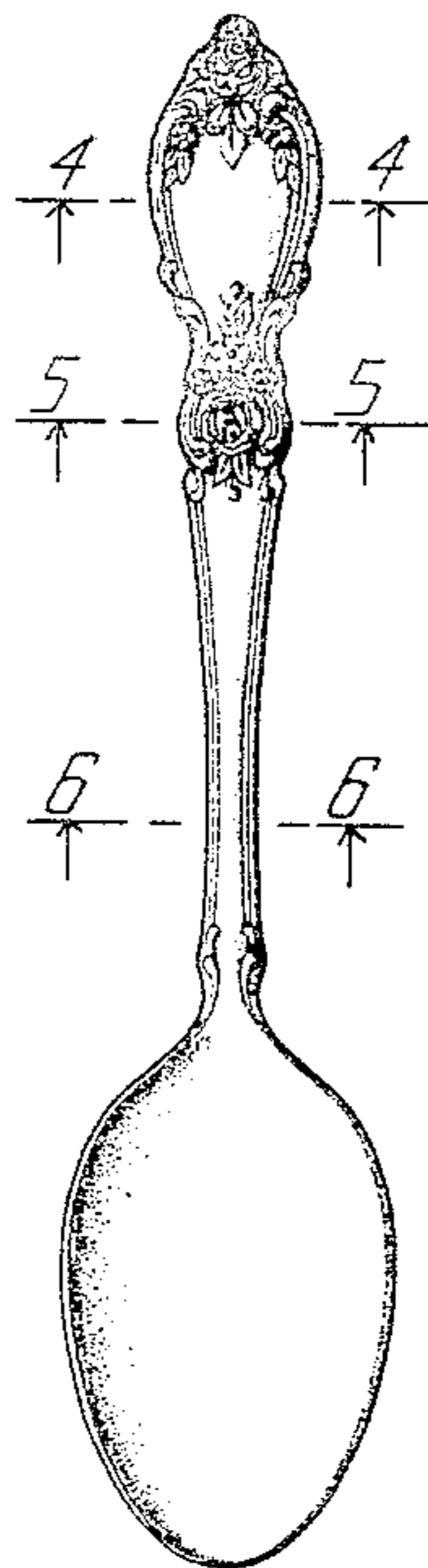

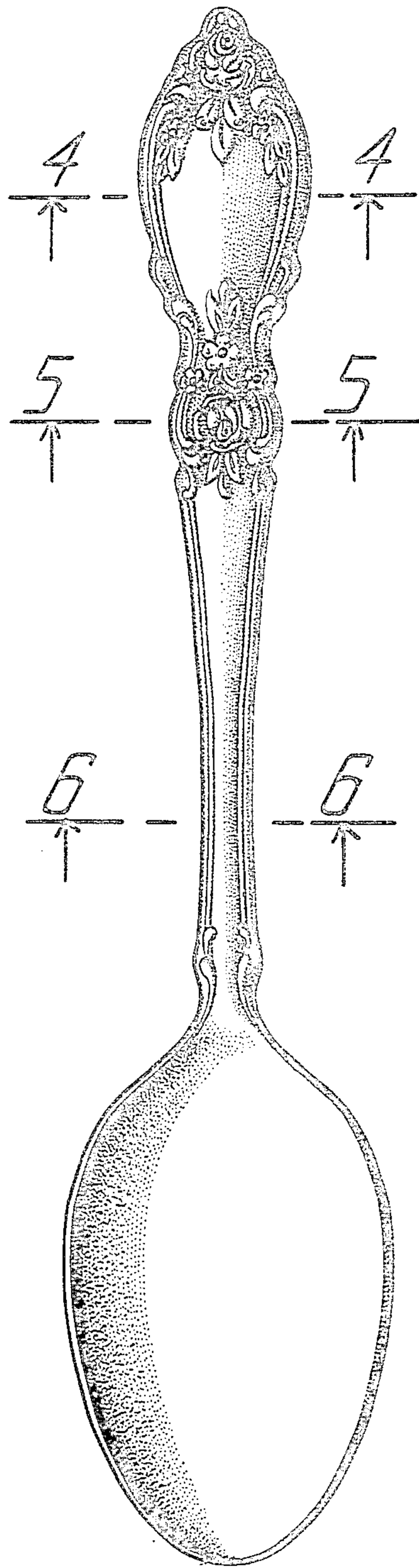

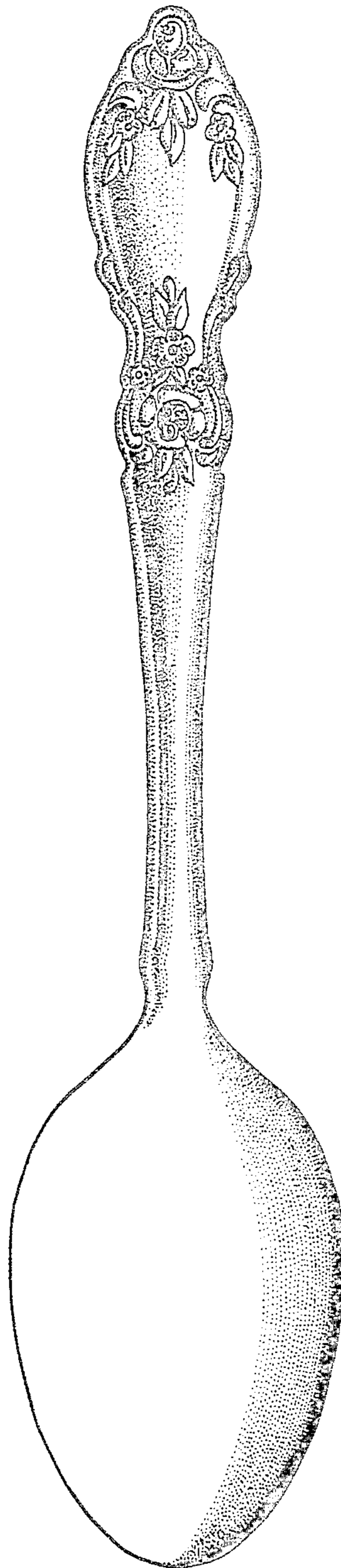

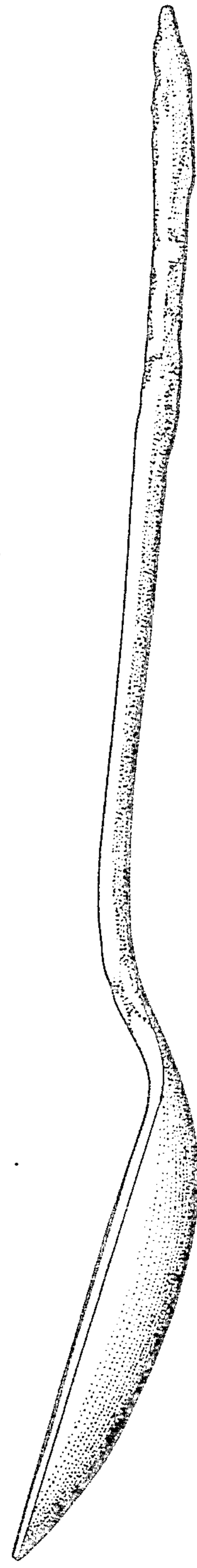

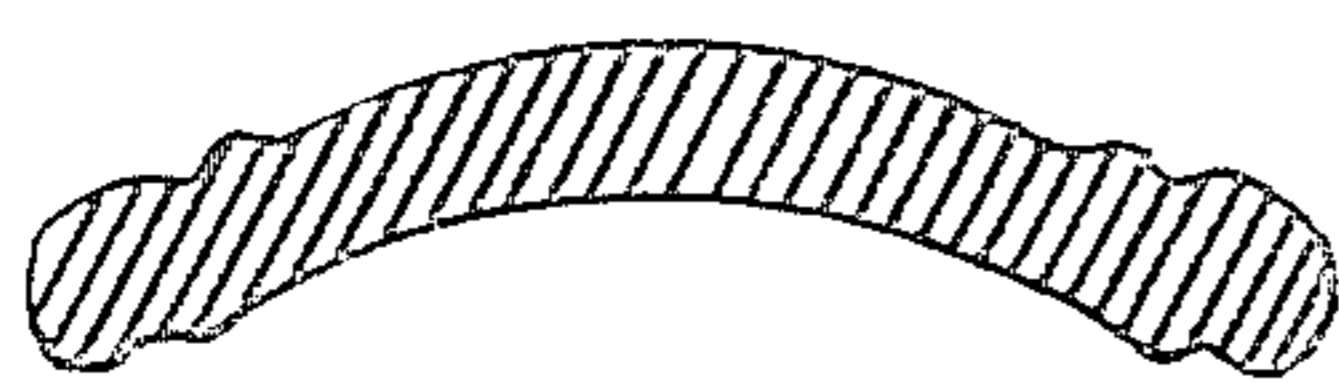
