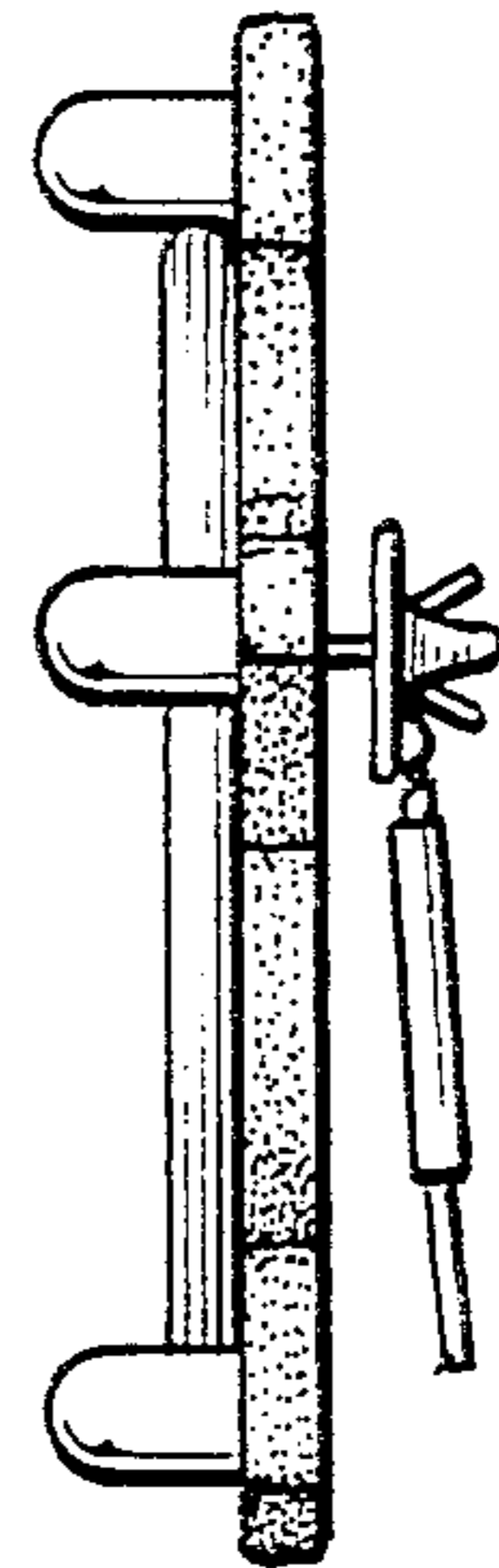
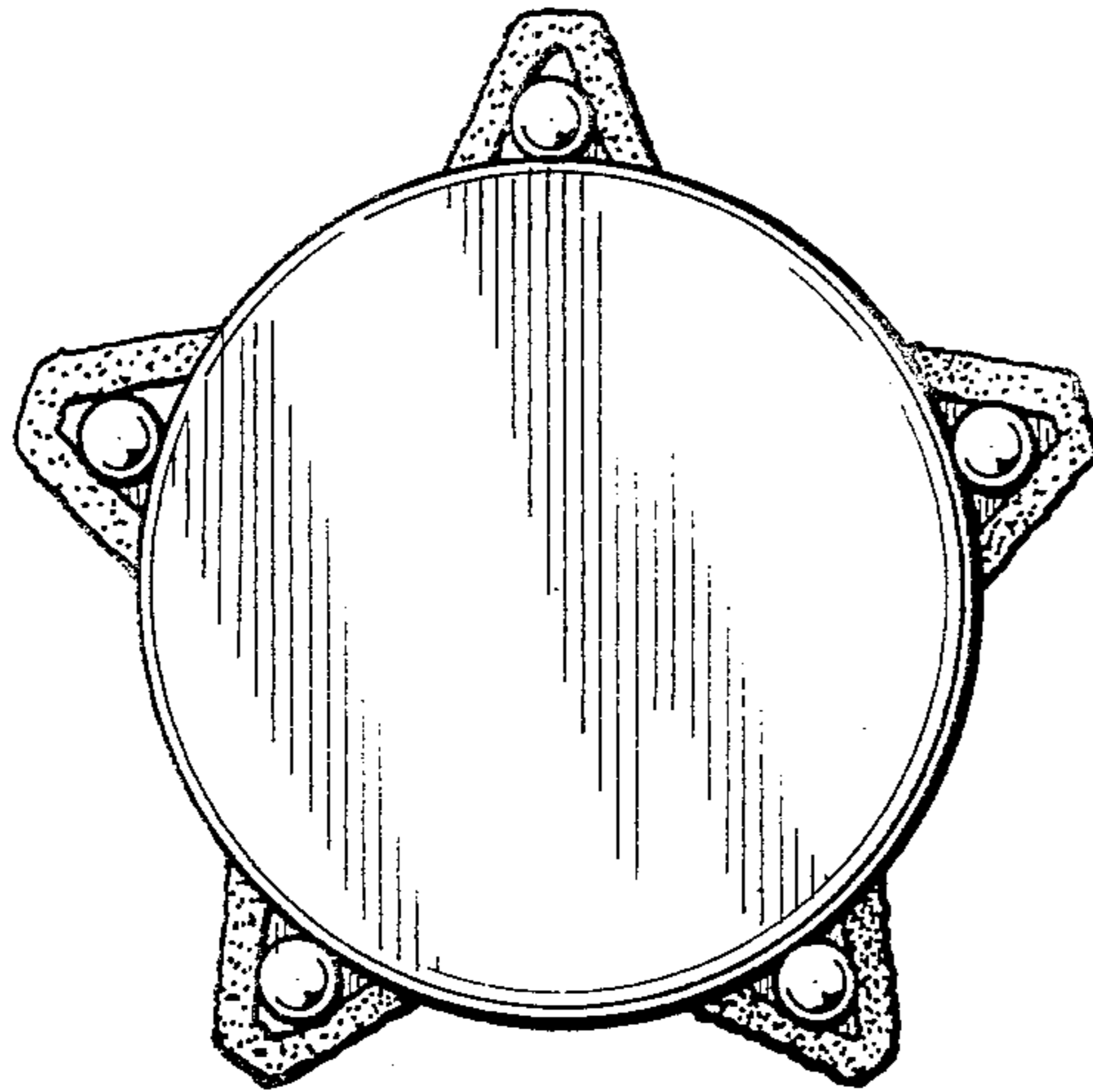

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a lighted button, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a lighted button showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view constituting a mirror image;
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and,
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.
 The electric cords have been omitted from FIGS. 4 and 5 for clarity of illustration.



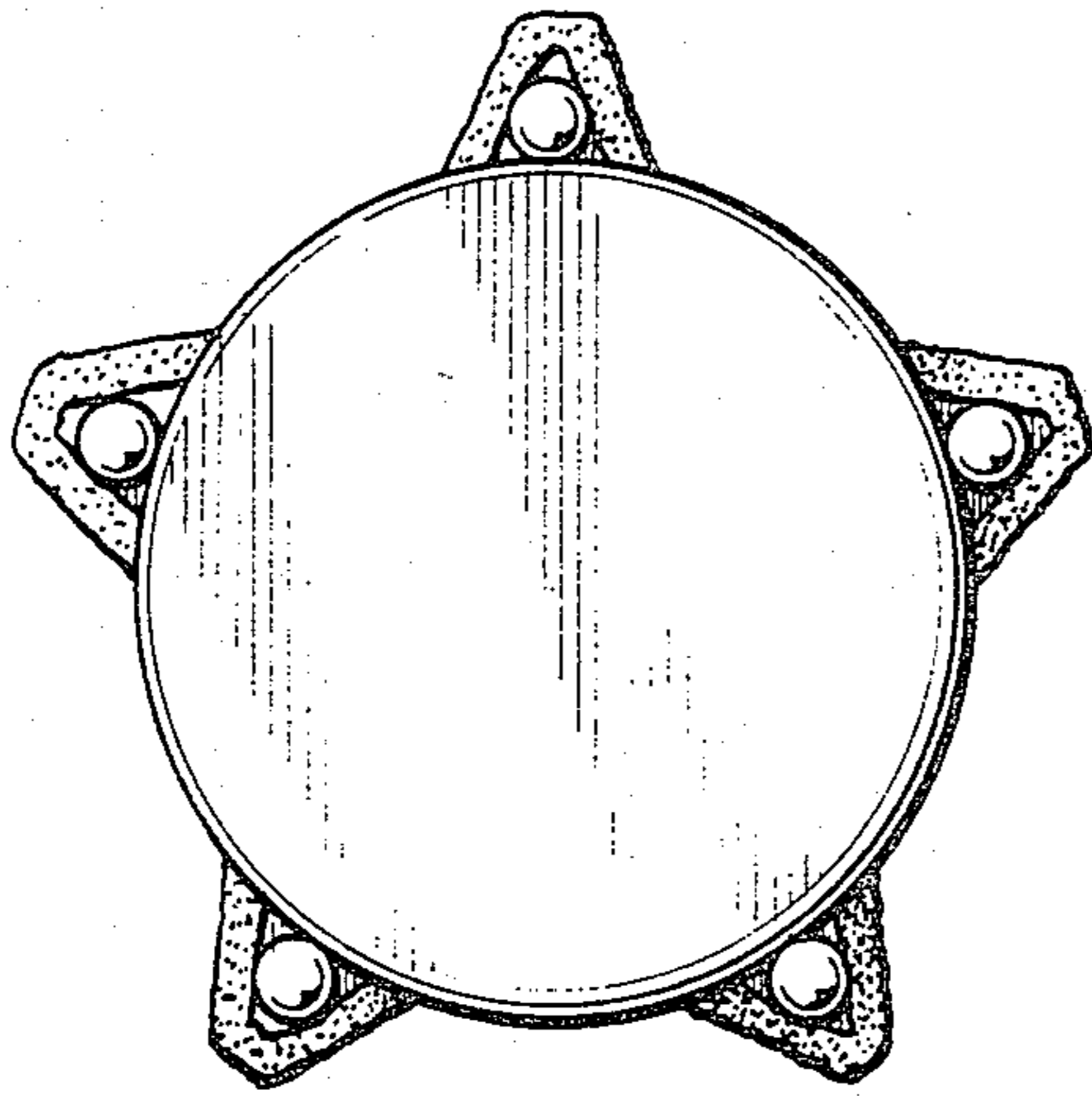

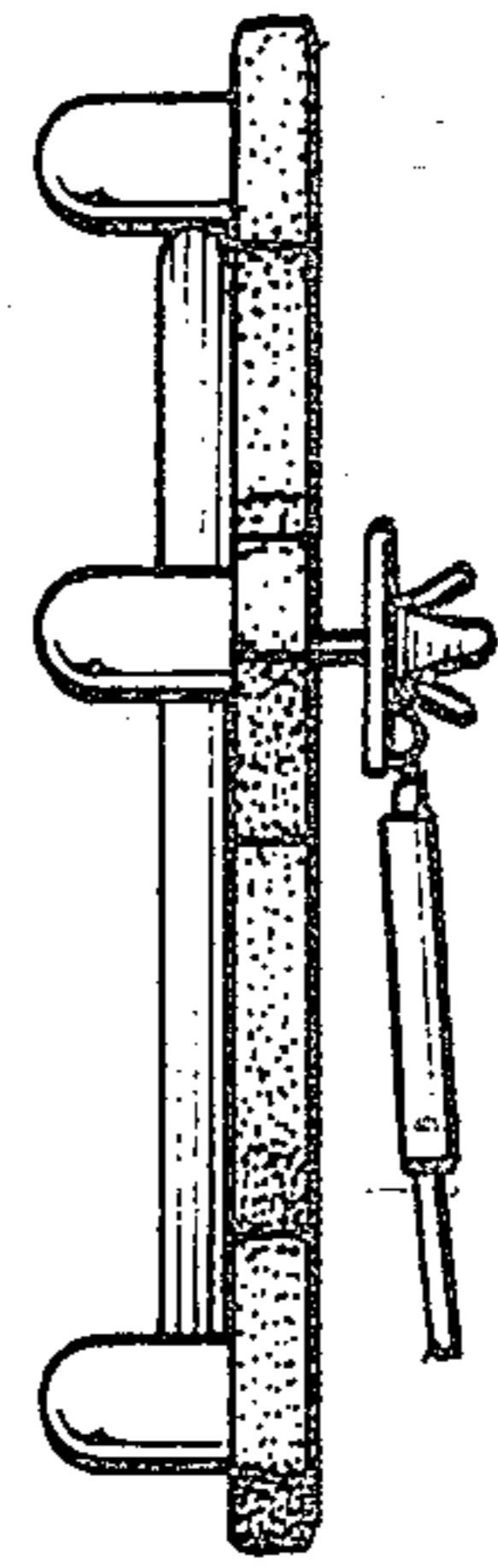

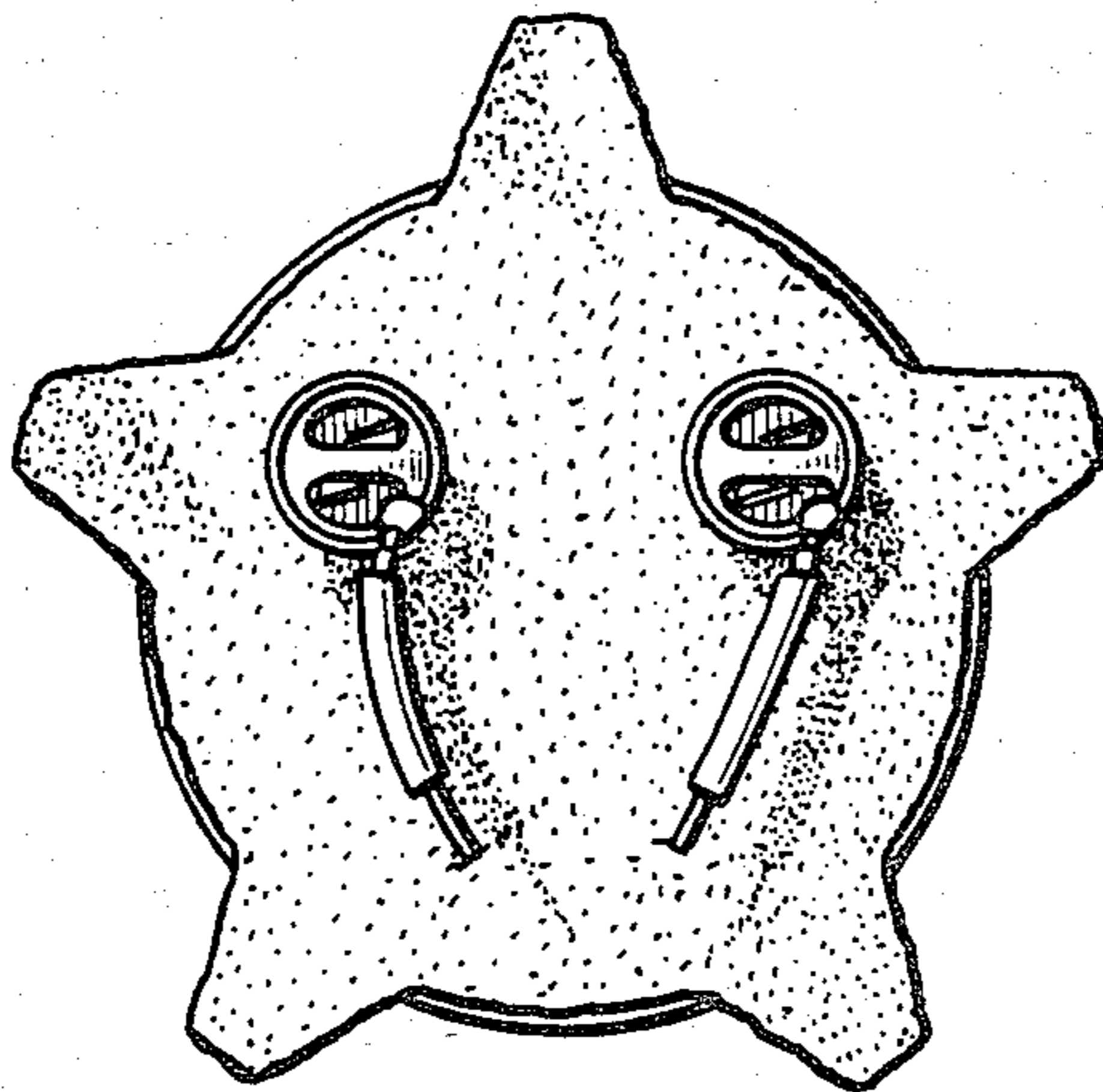

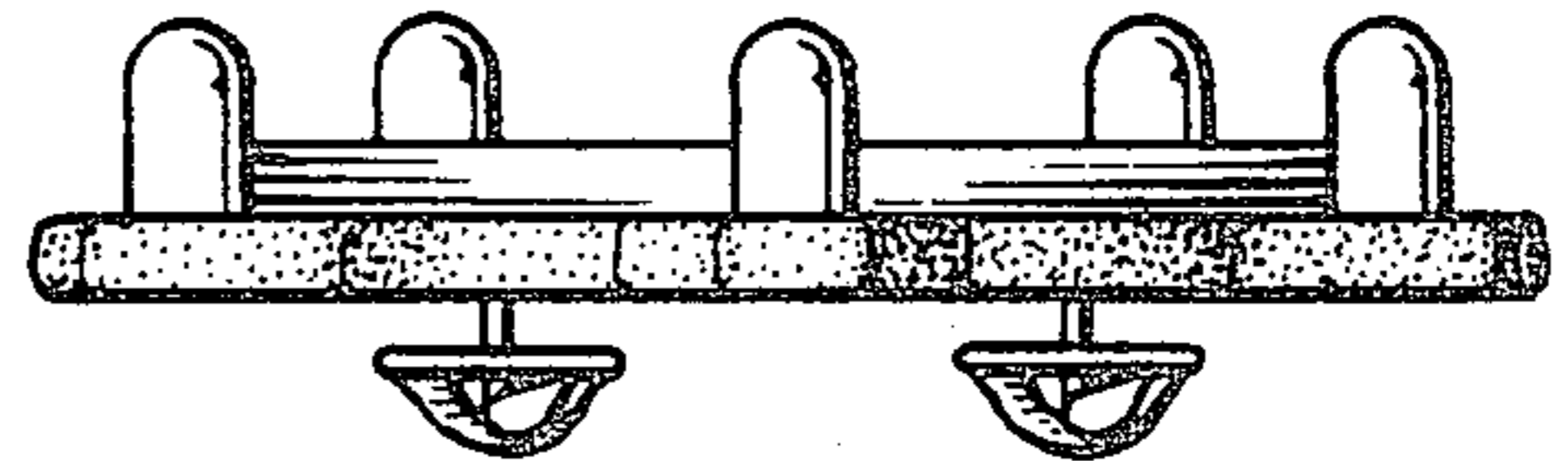

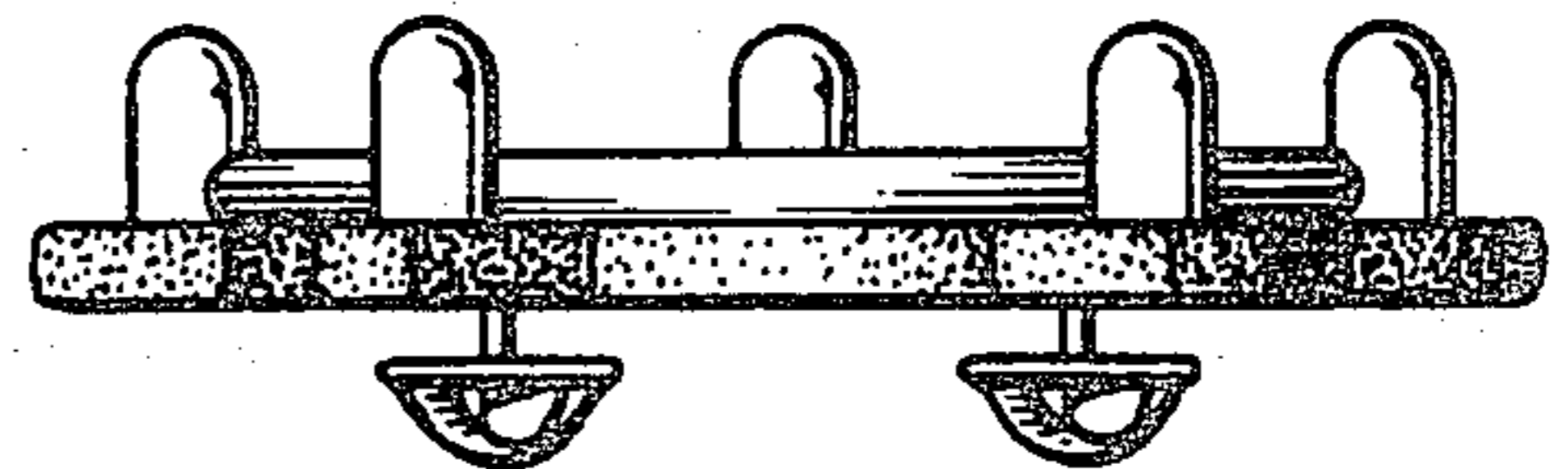
