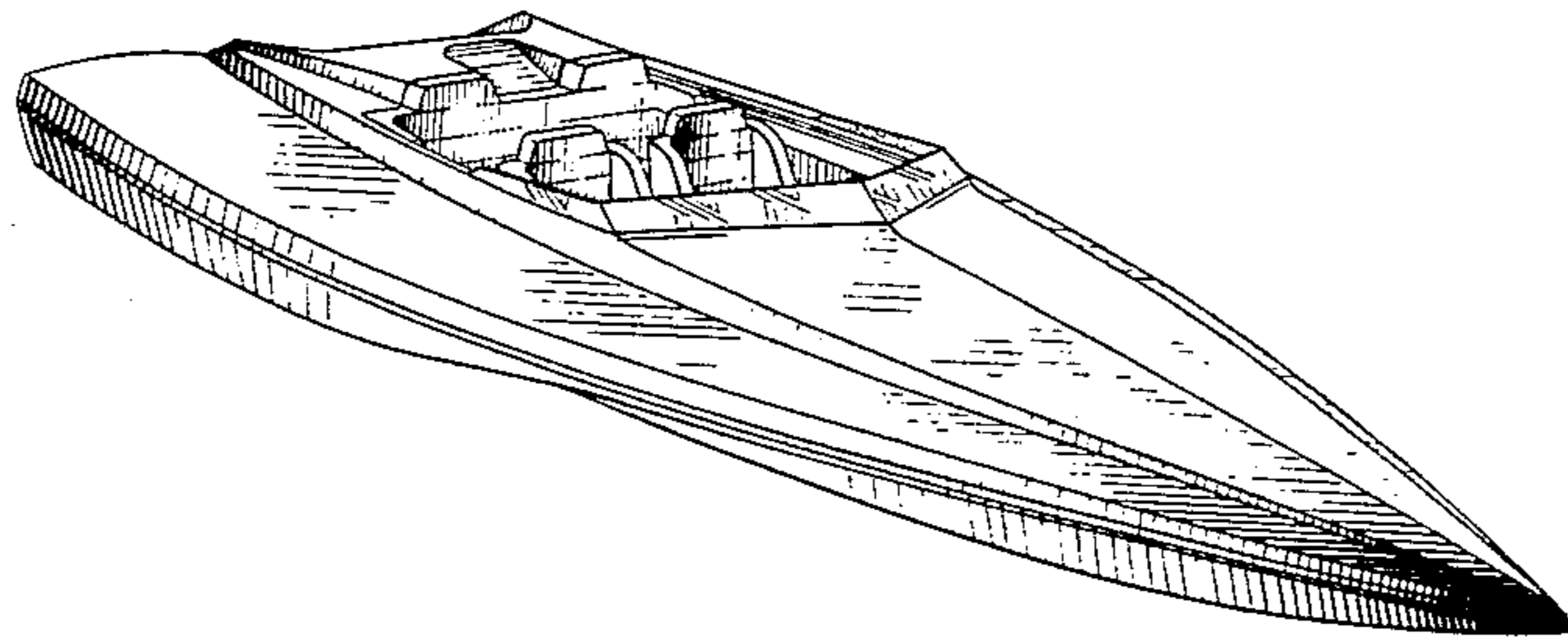

FIG. 6 is a perspective view showing the boat hull bottom.



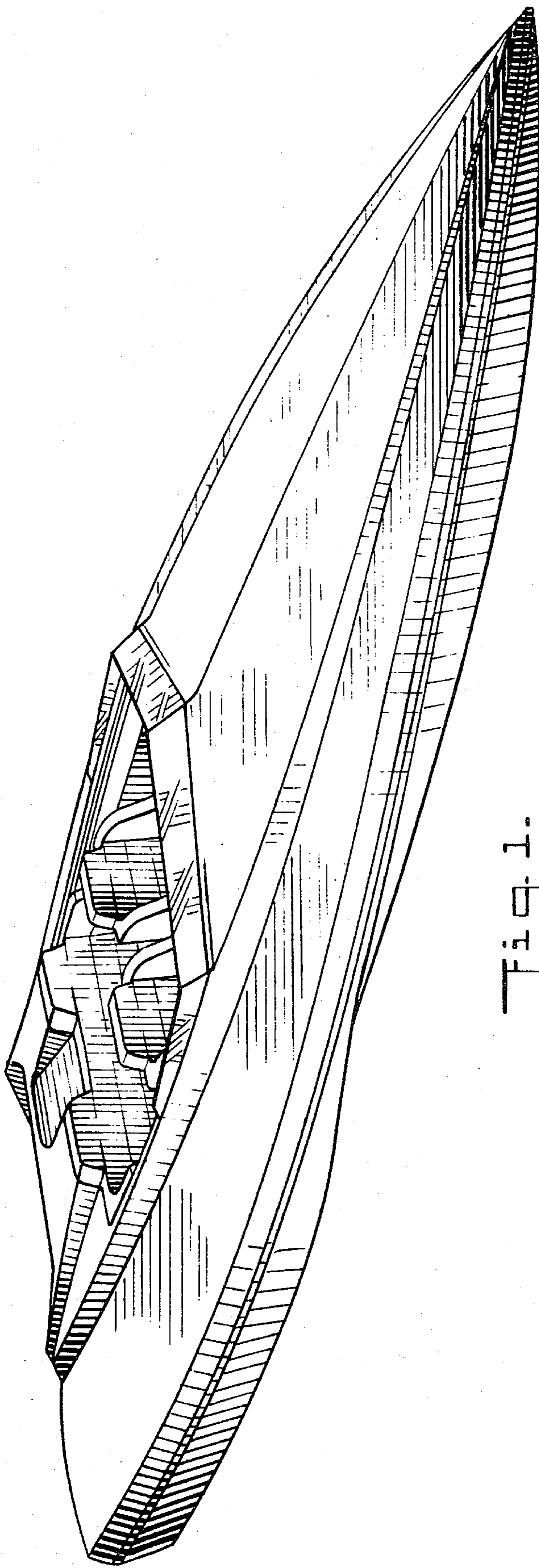

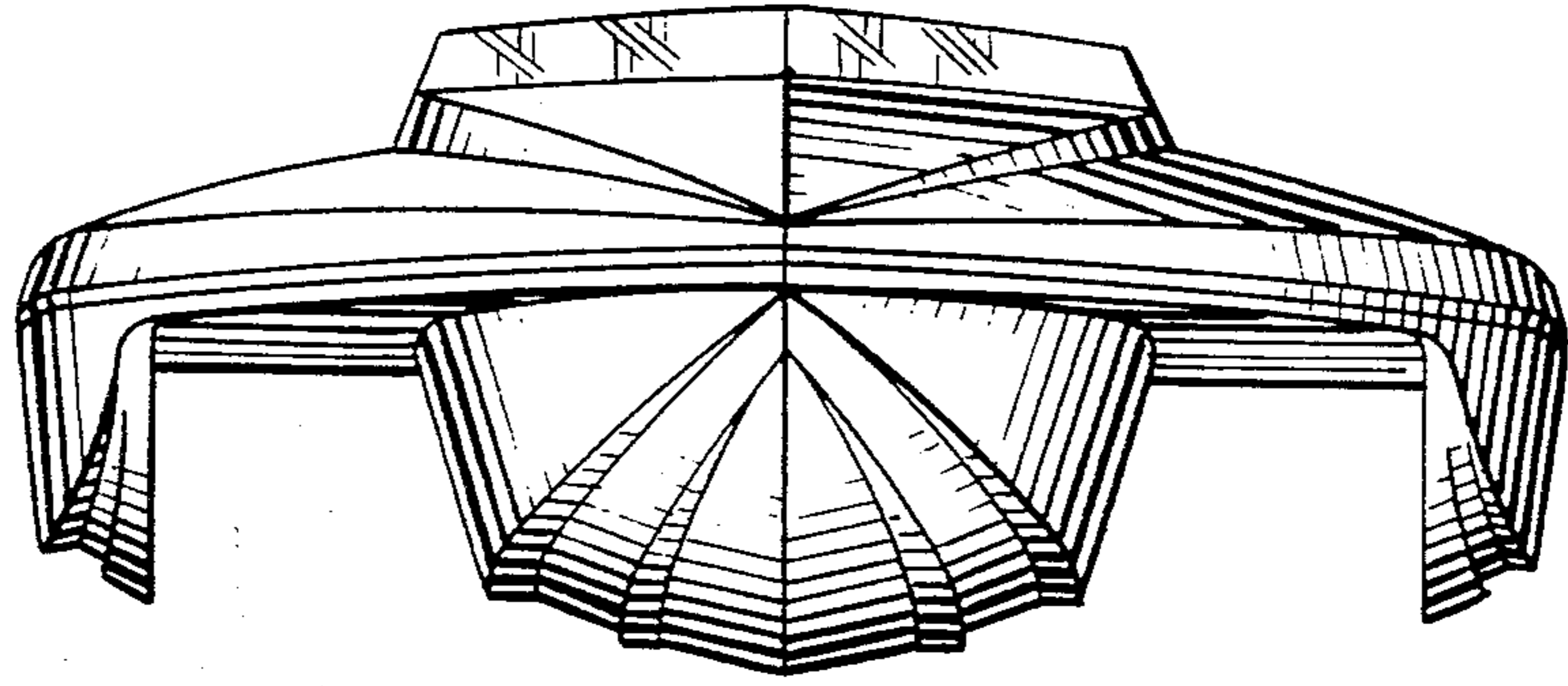

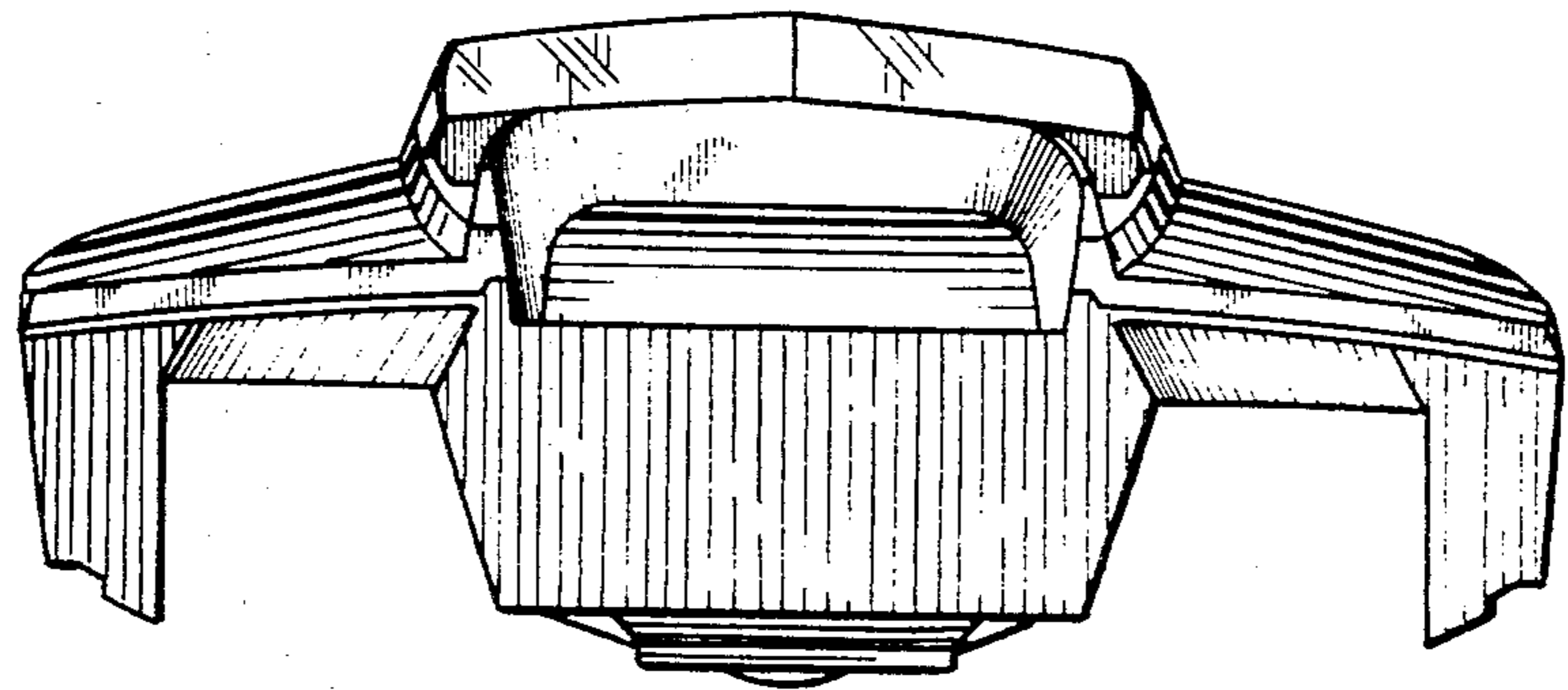

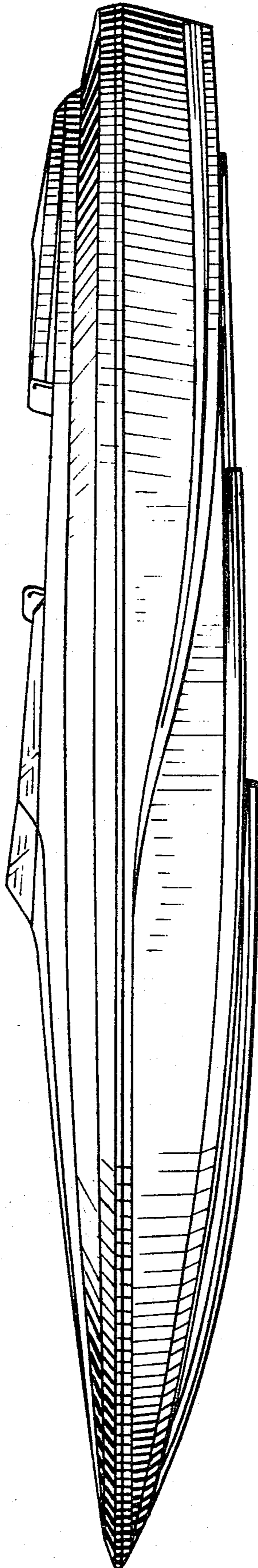
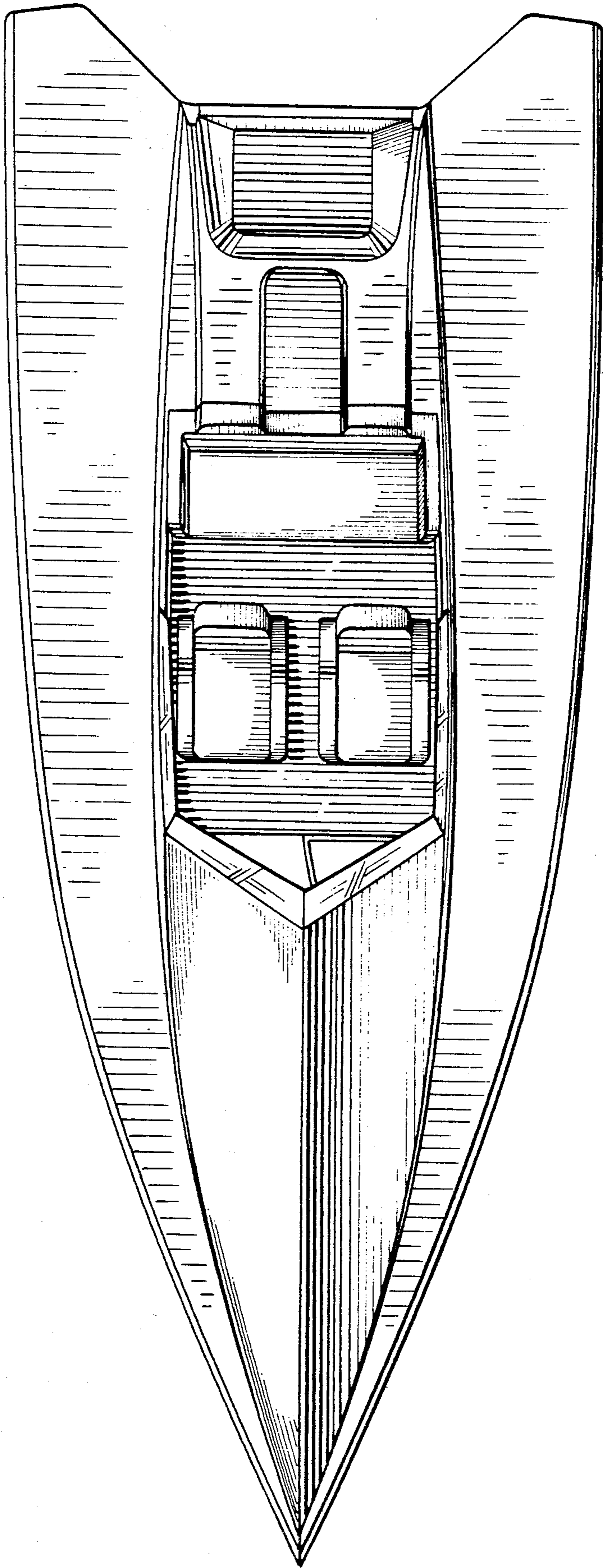

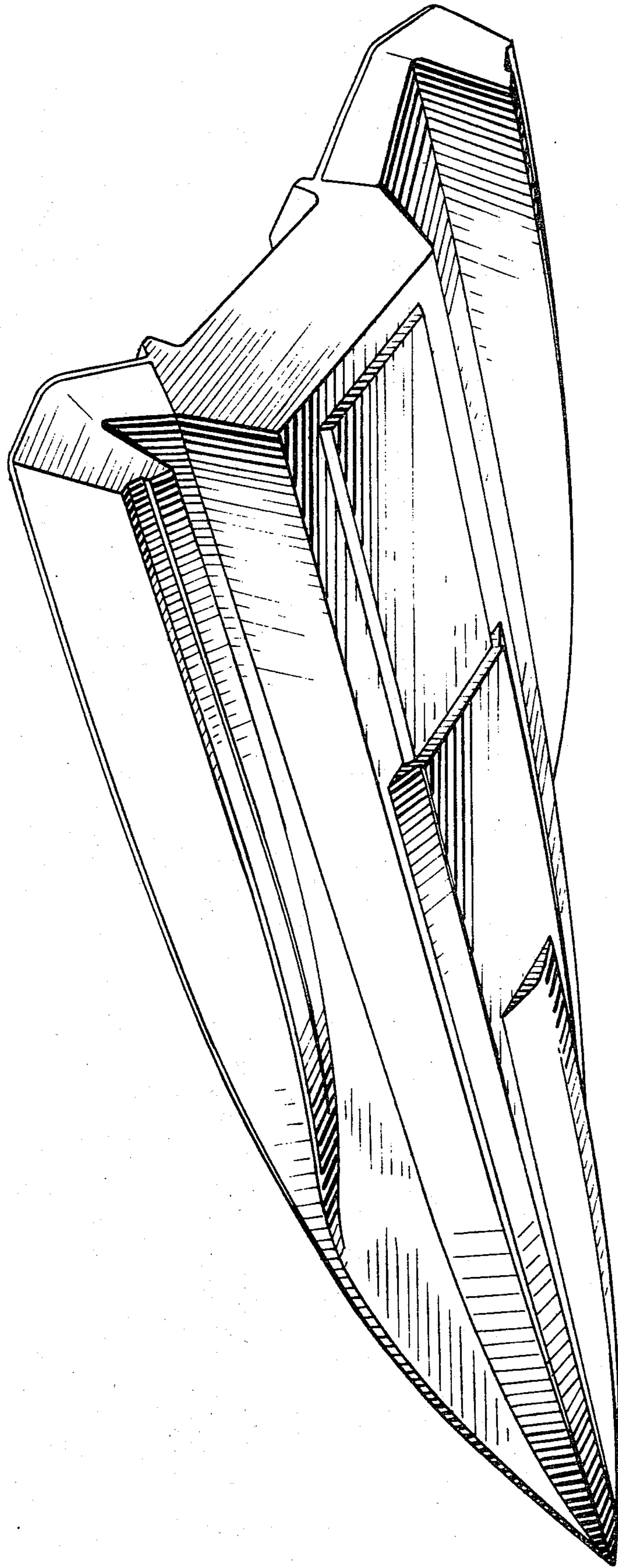
