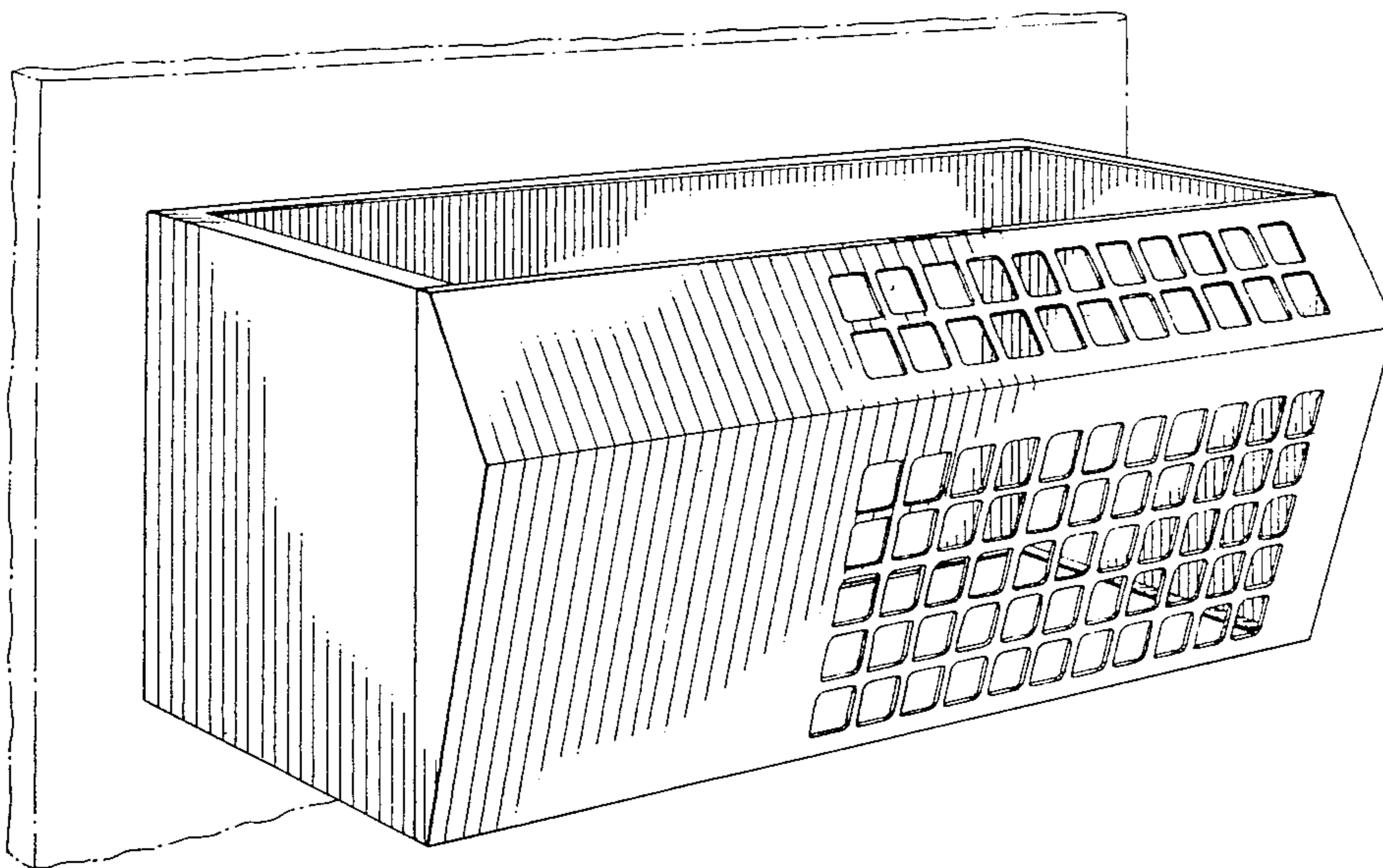
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a cover for a transport refrigeration unit, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cover for a transport refrigeration unit showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.

The fragmentary broken line representation of a portion of a truck body in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only.



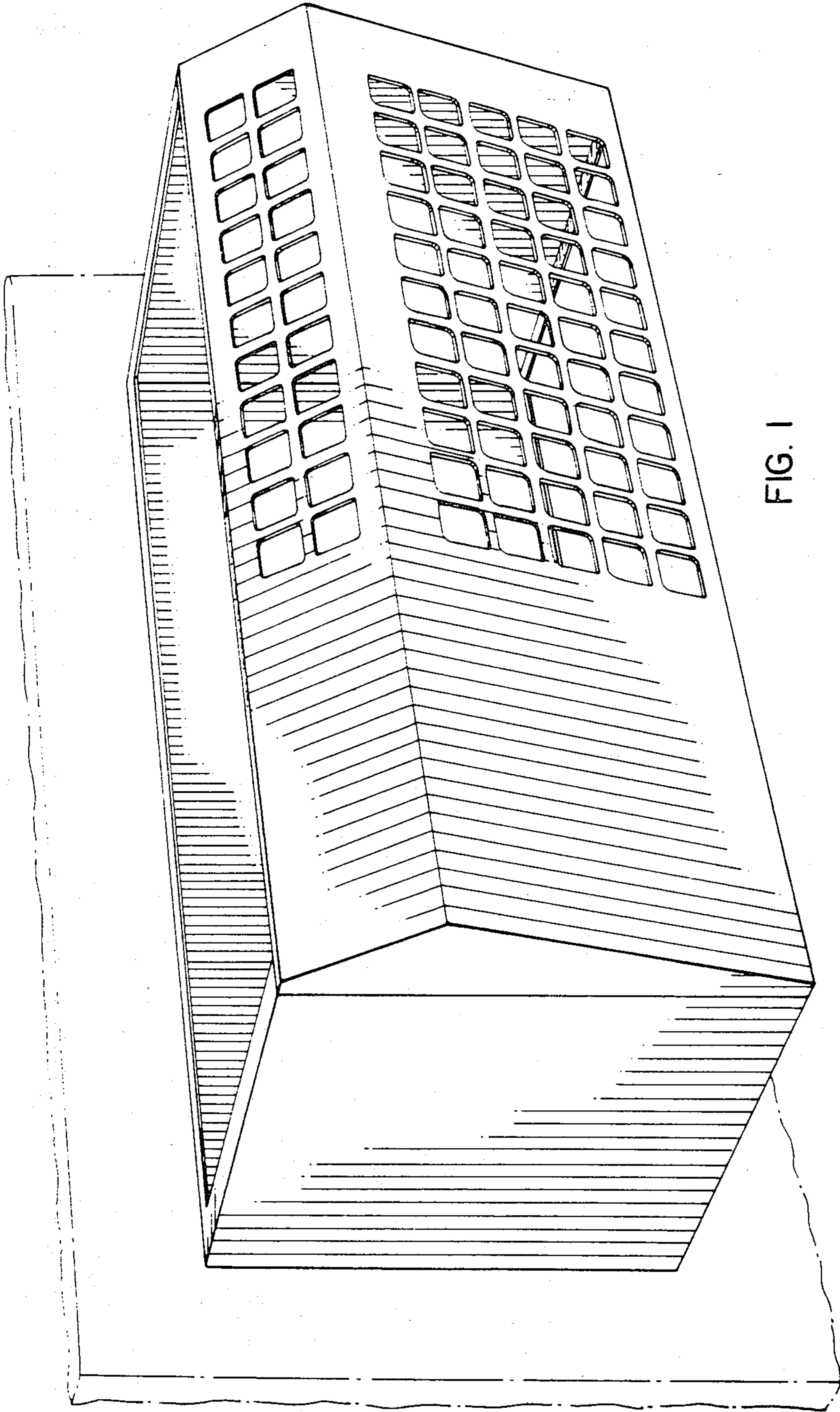

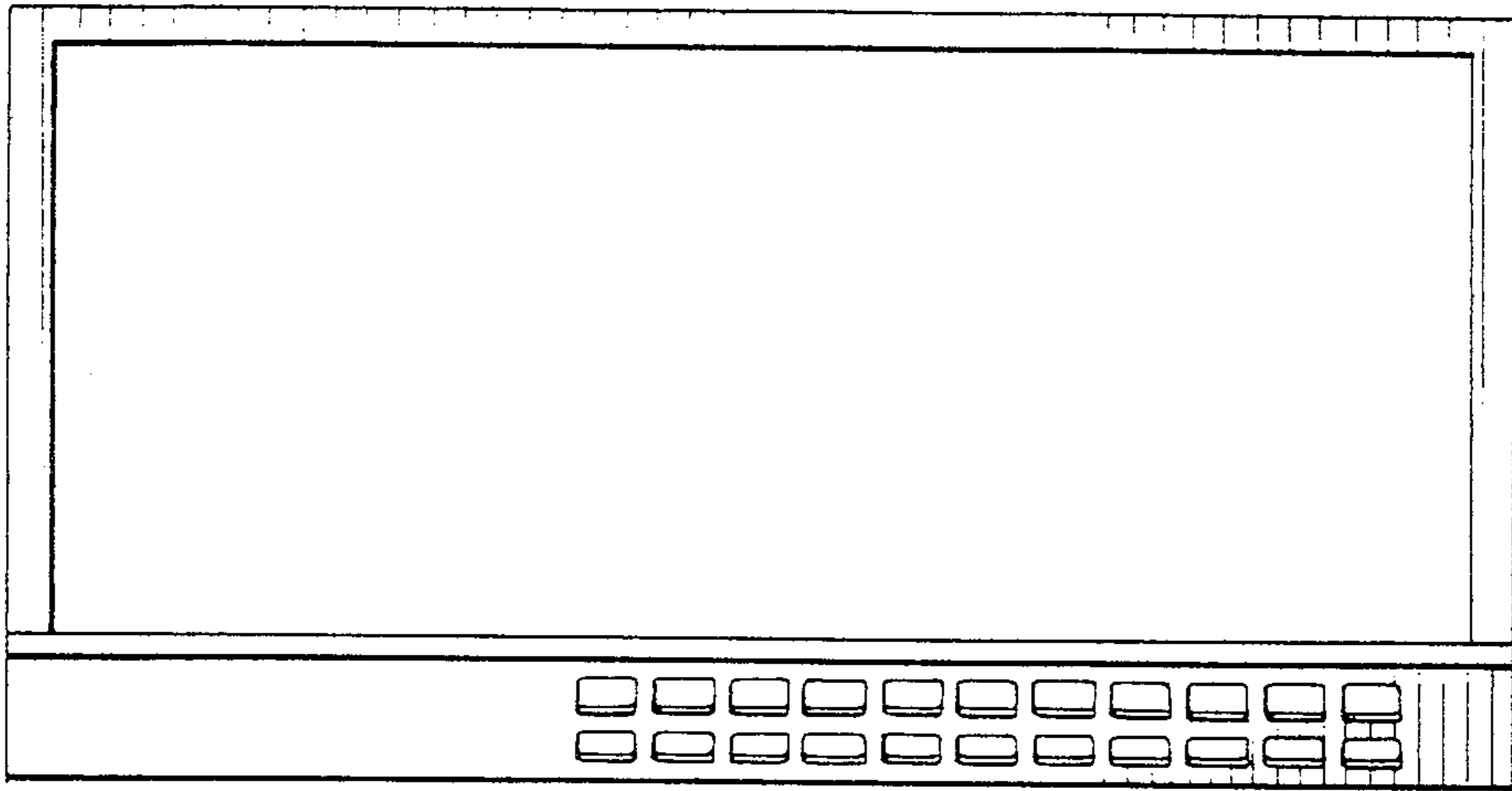

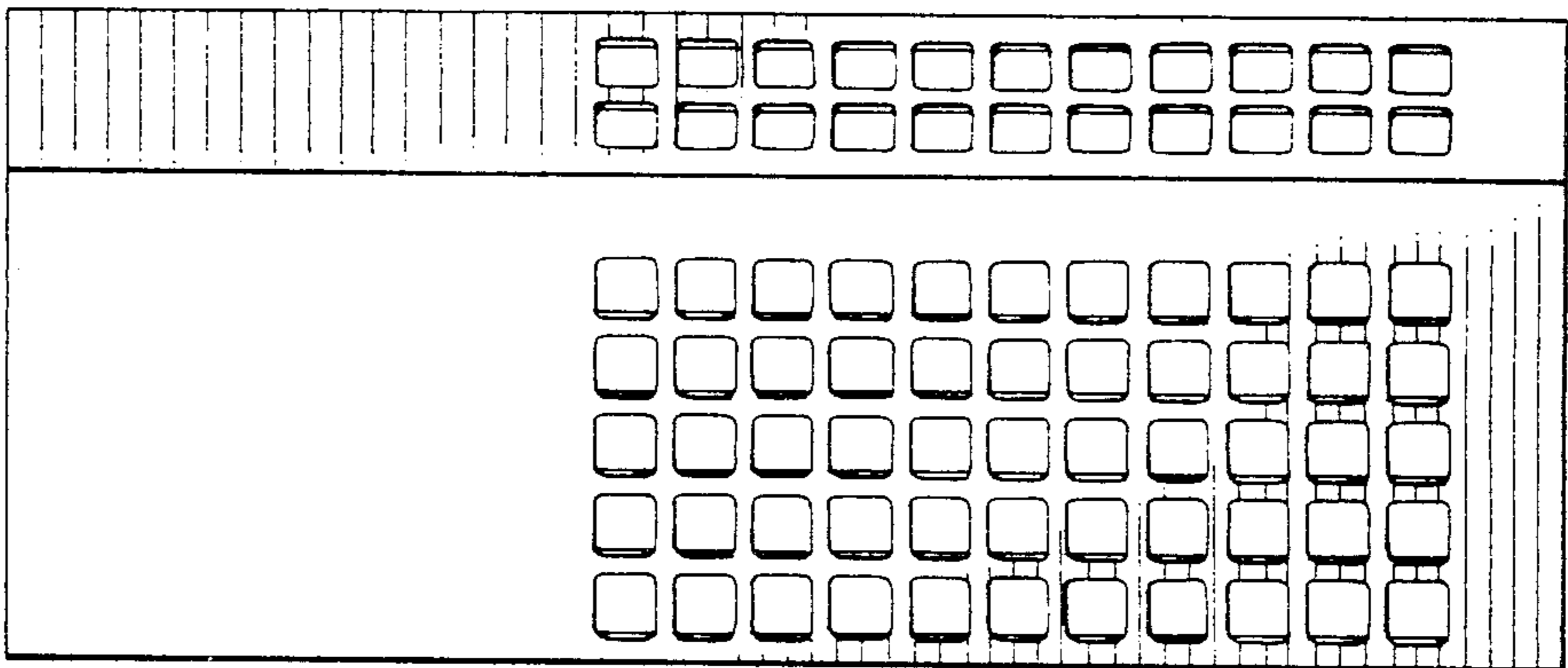

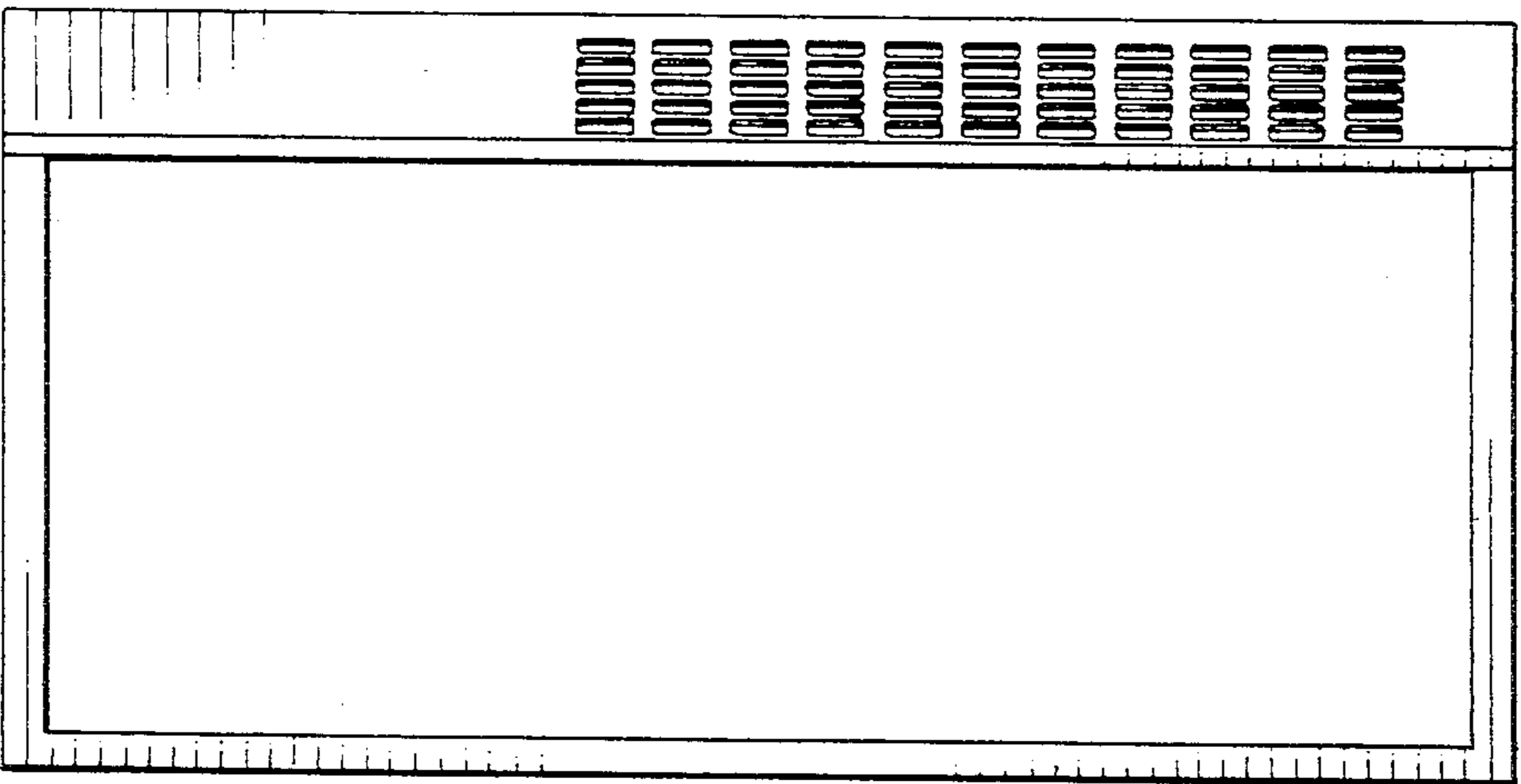

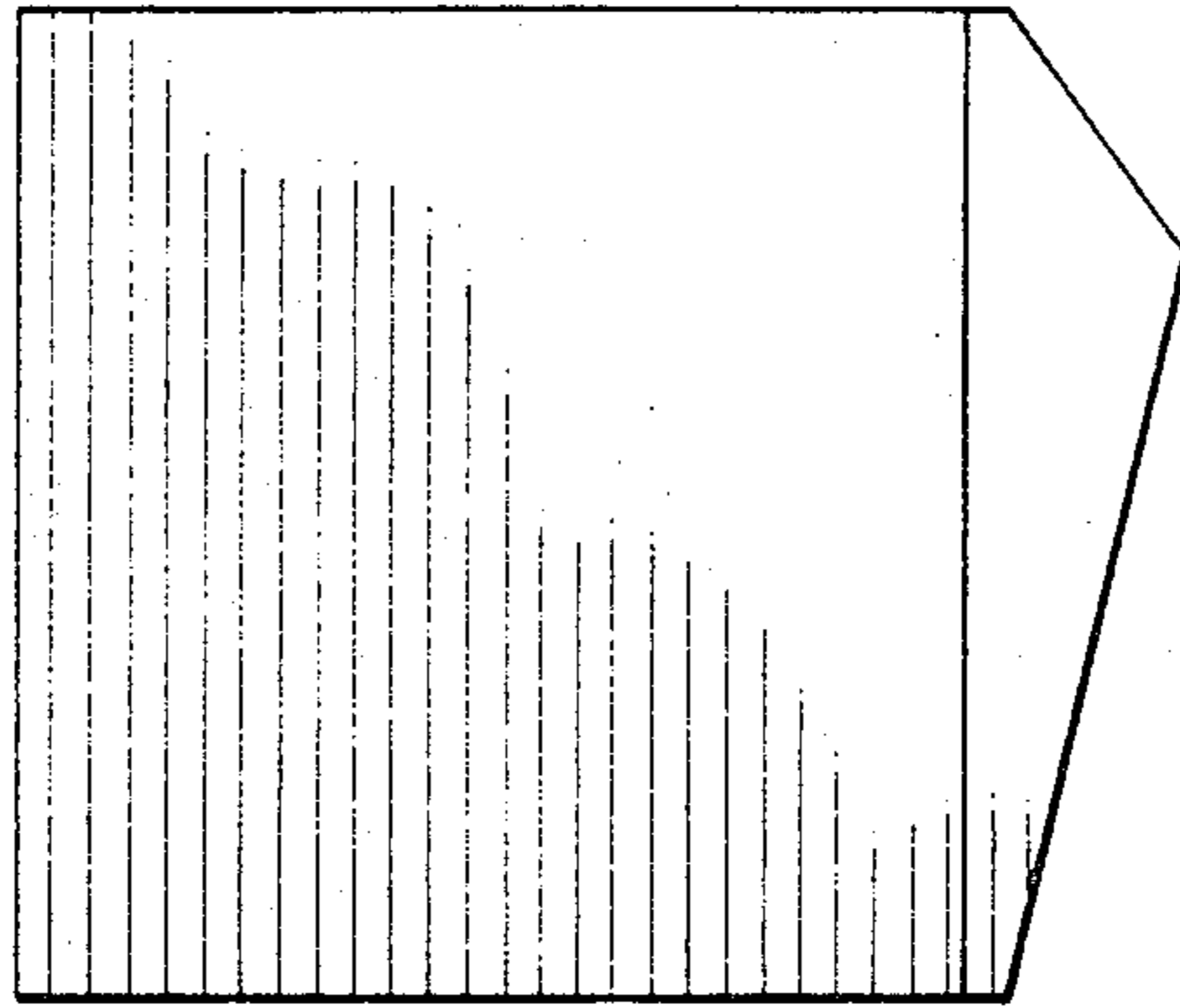

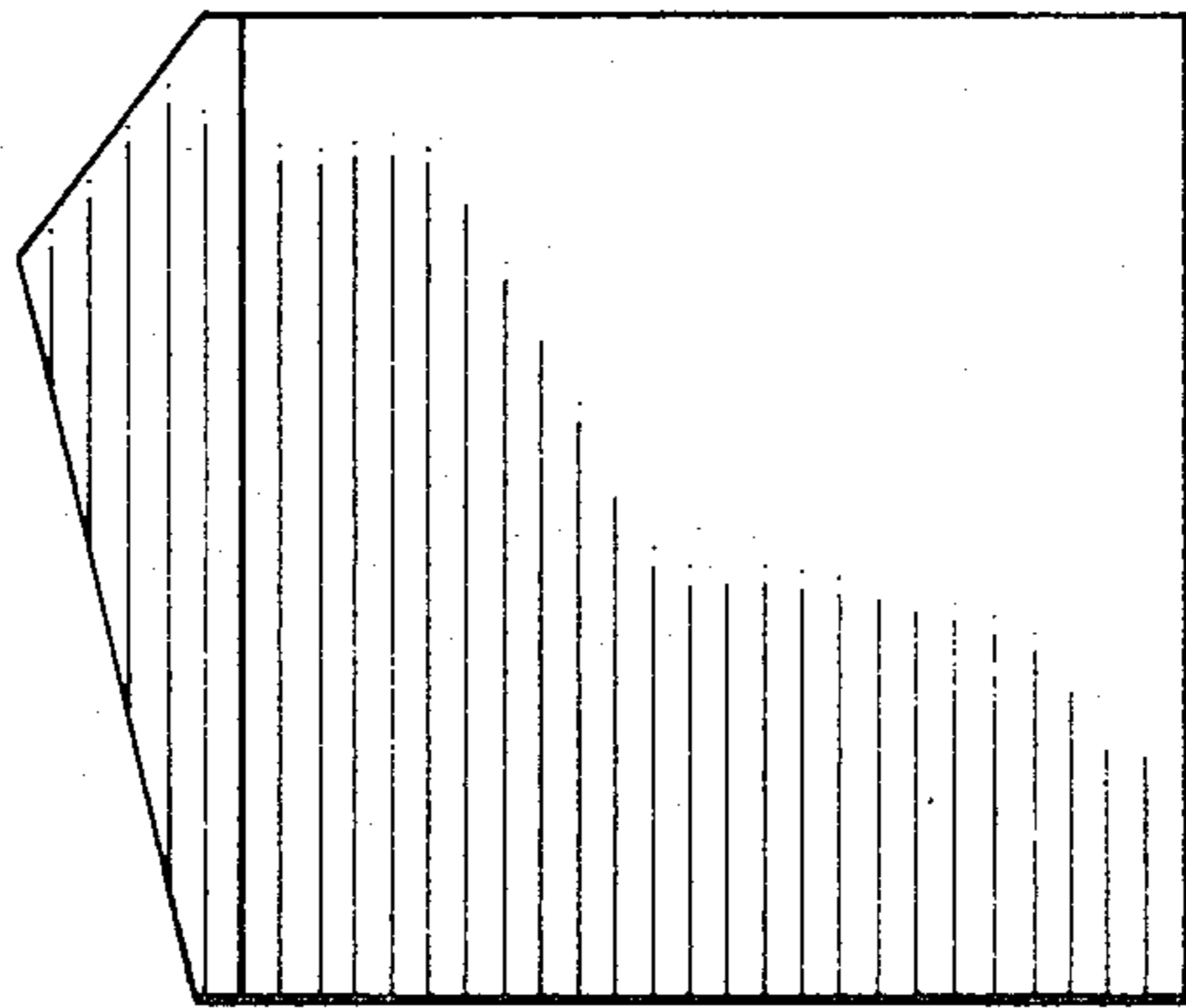
