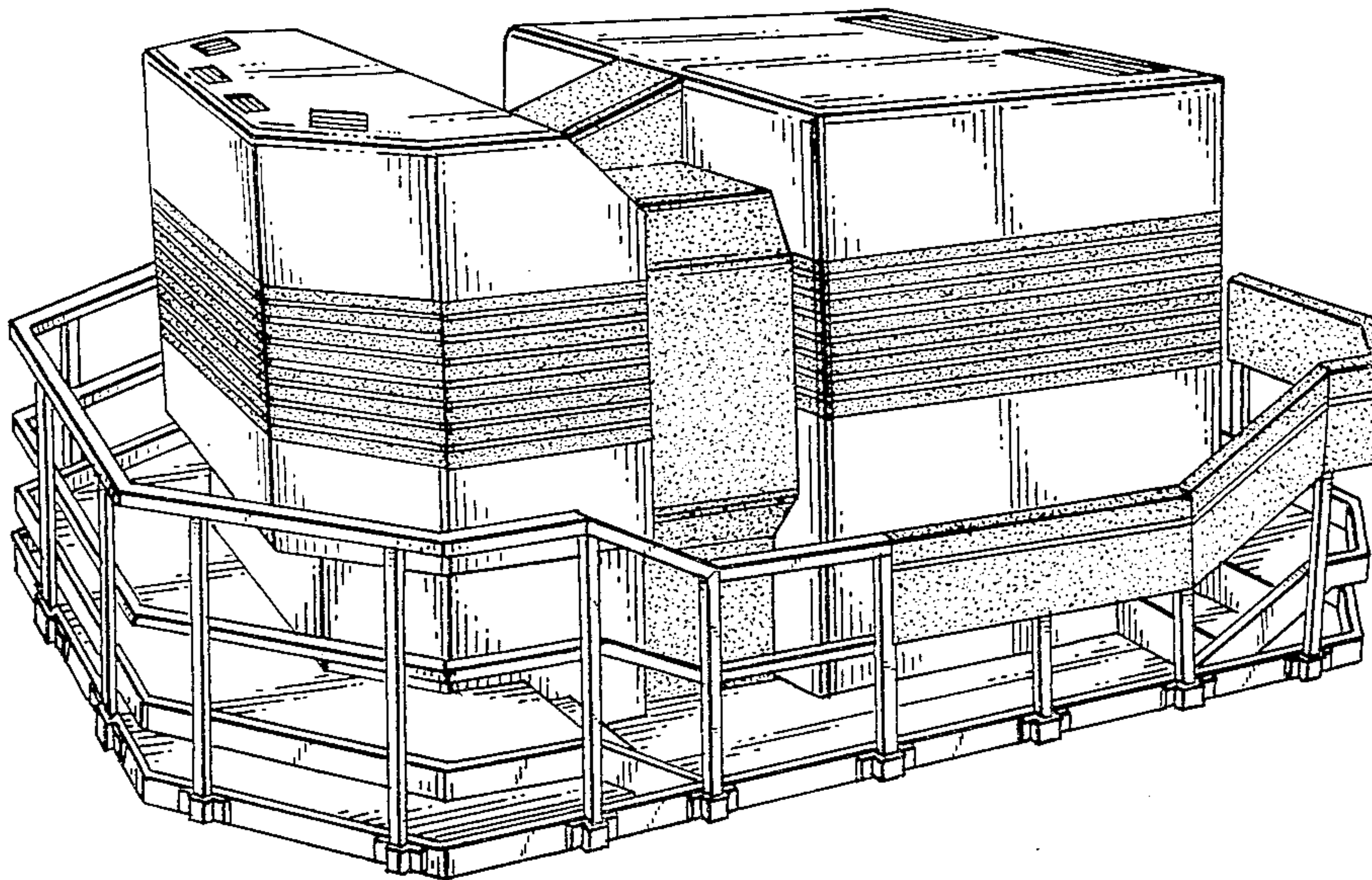

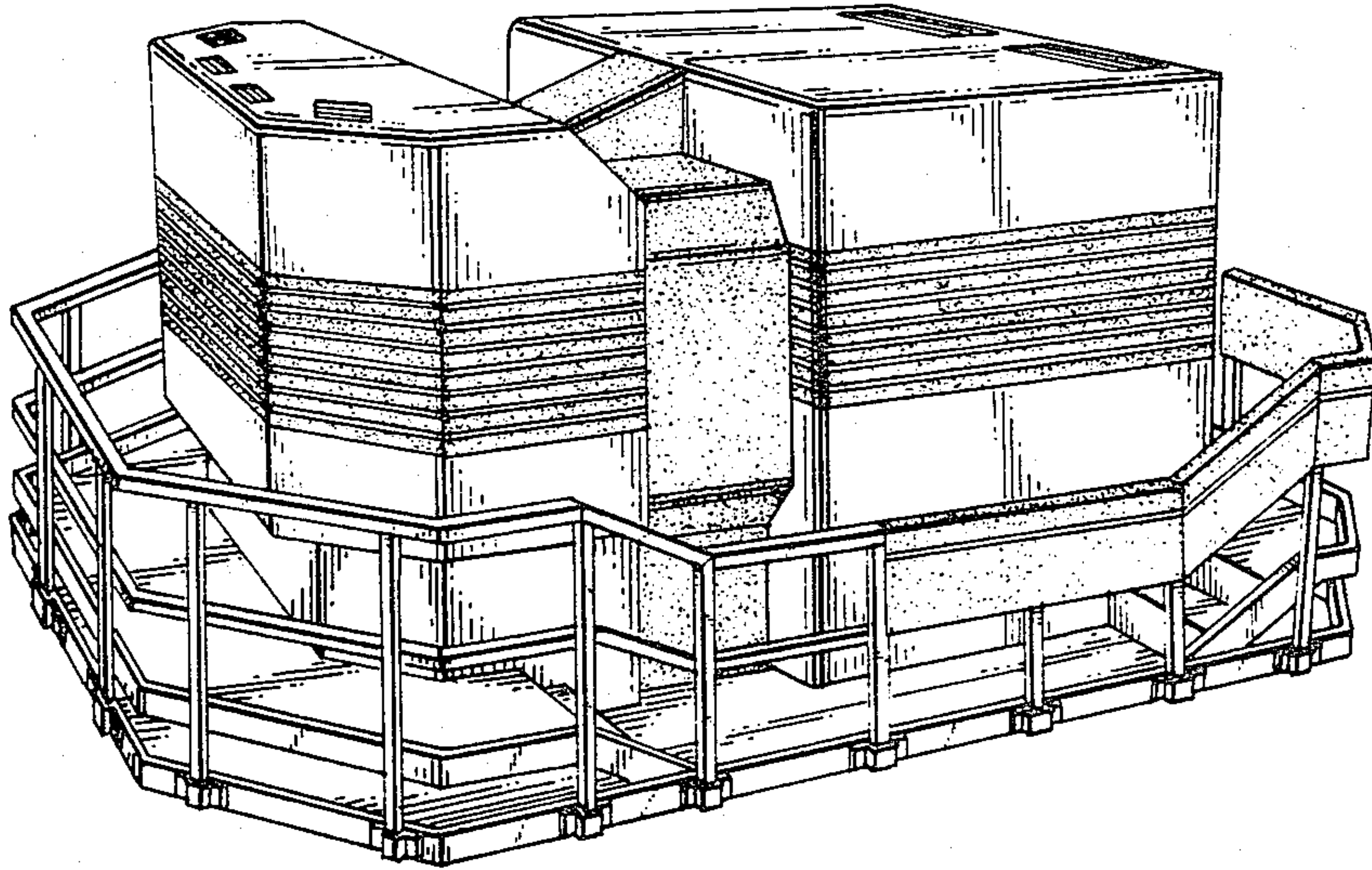
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a simulator enclosure or similar article, as shown and described.

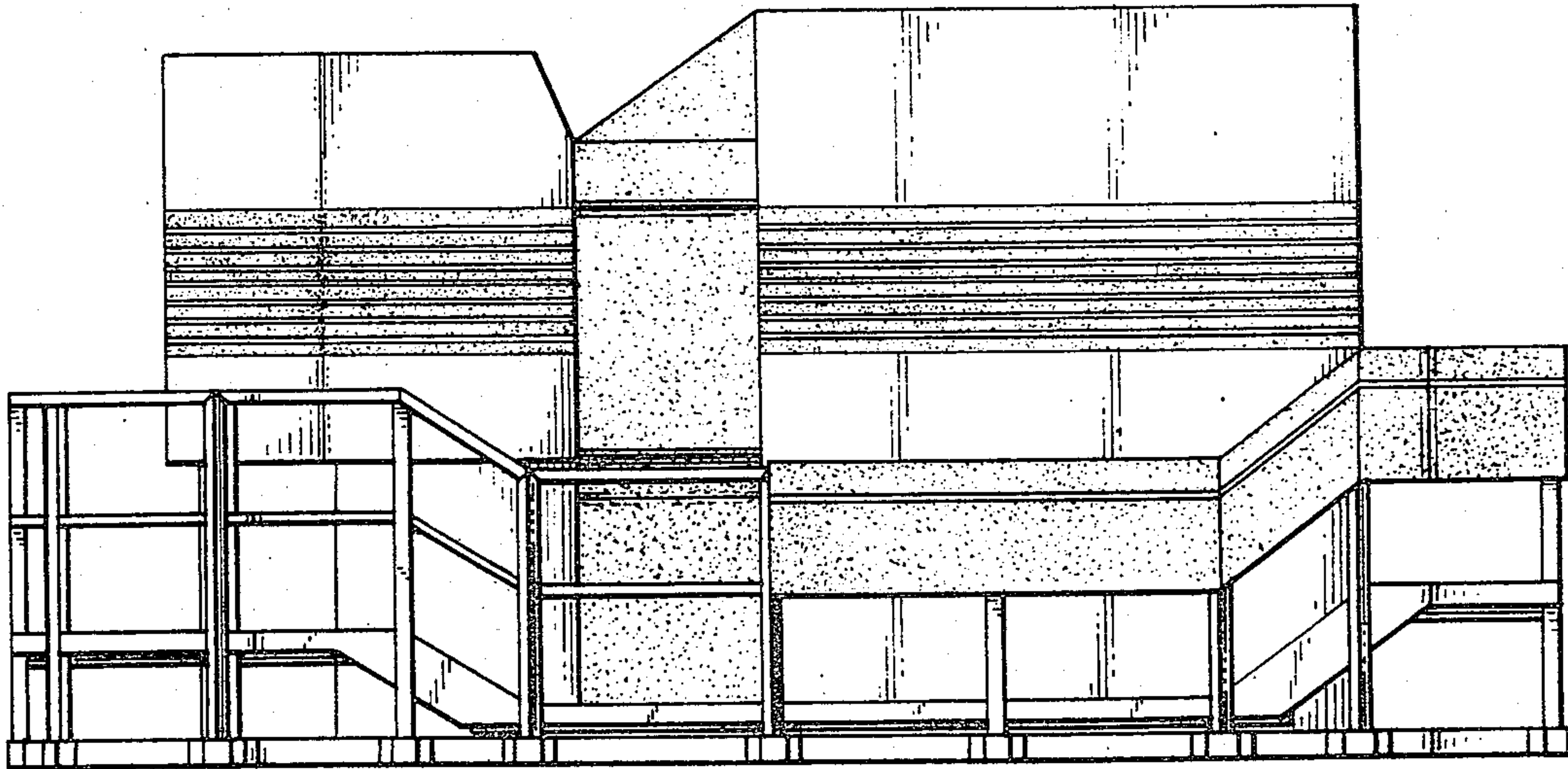
DESCRIPTION

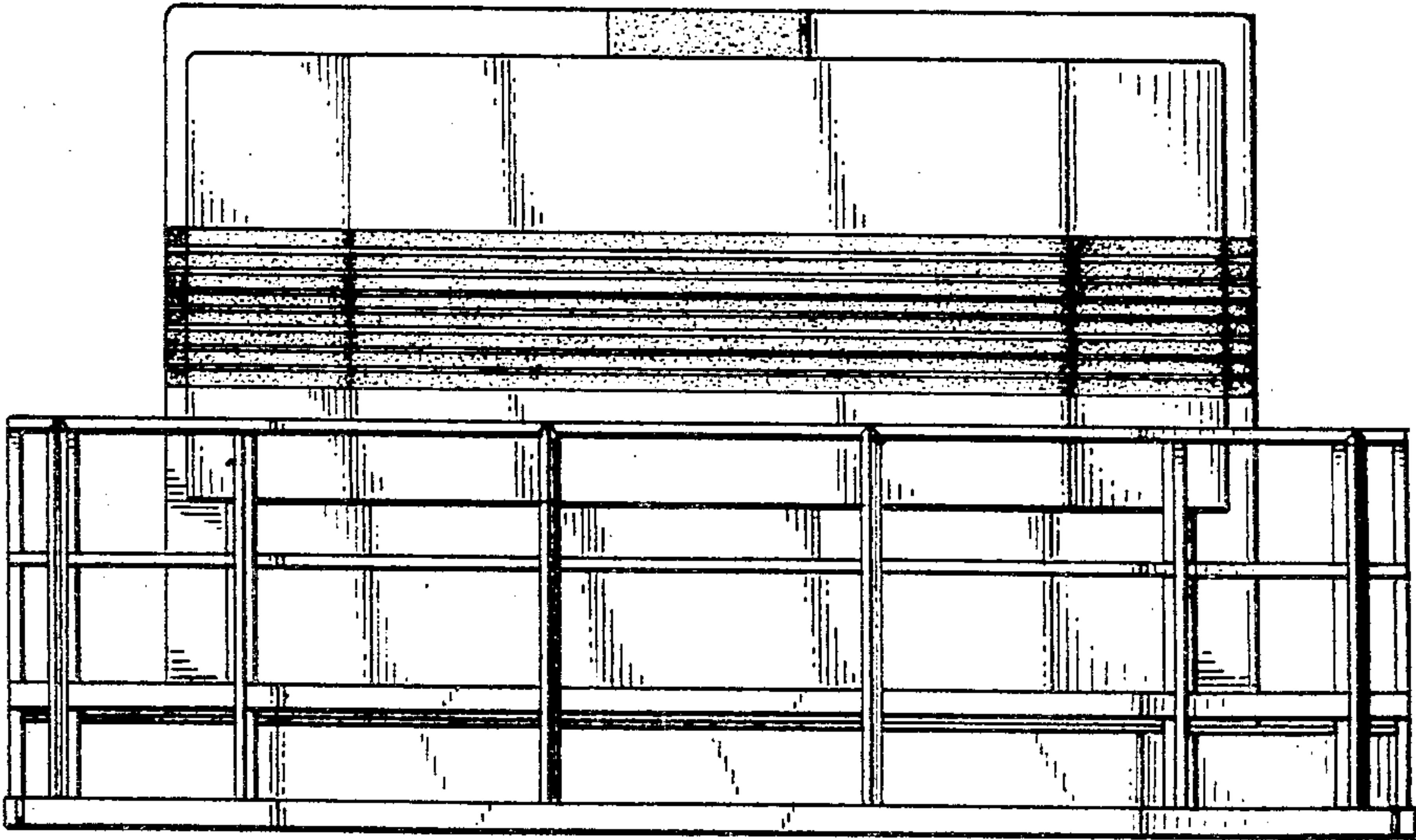

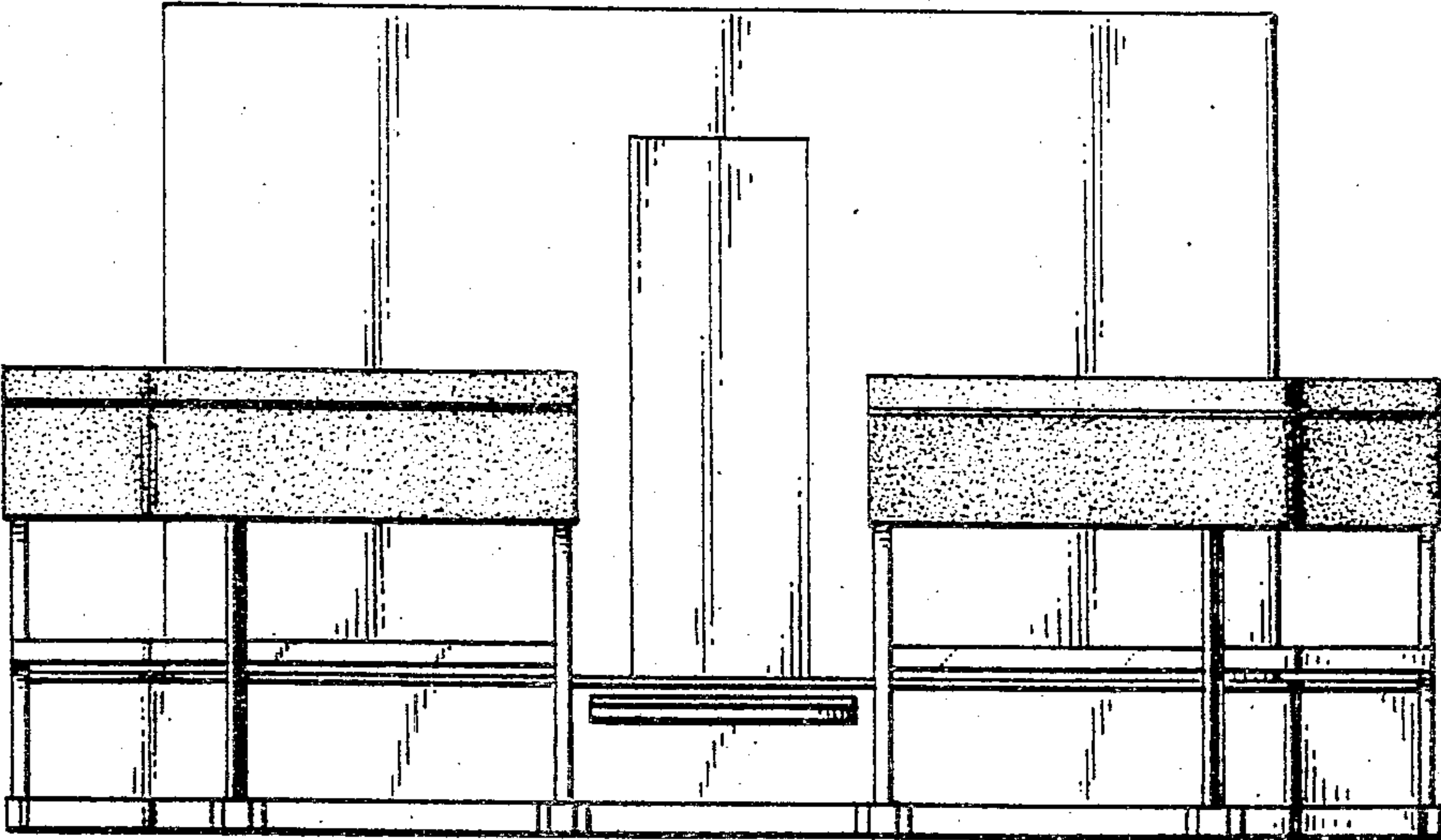

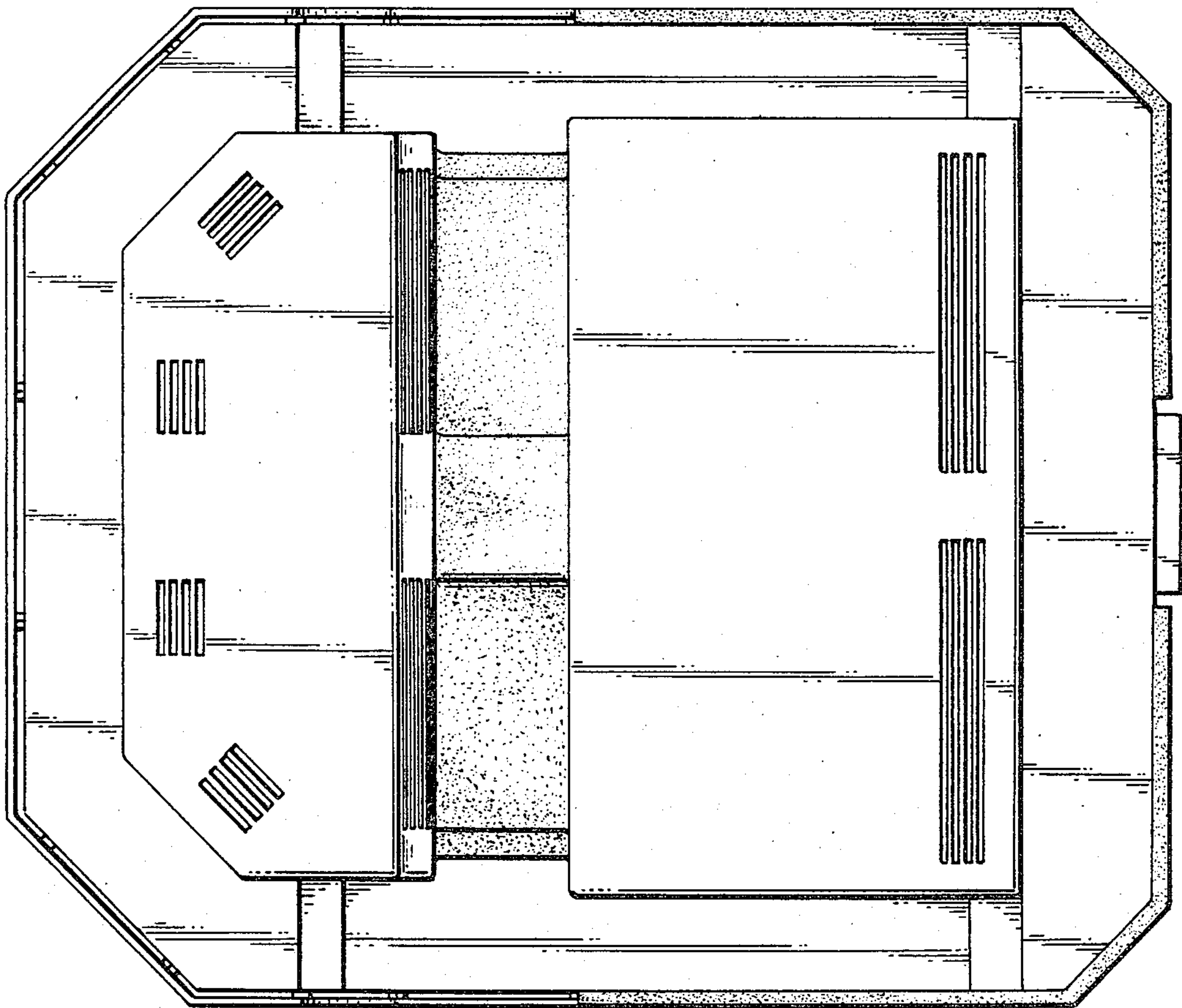
