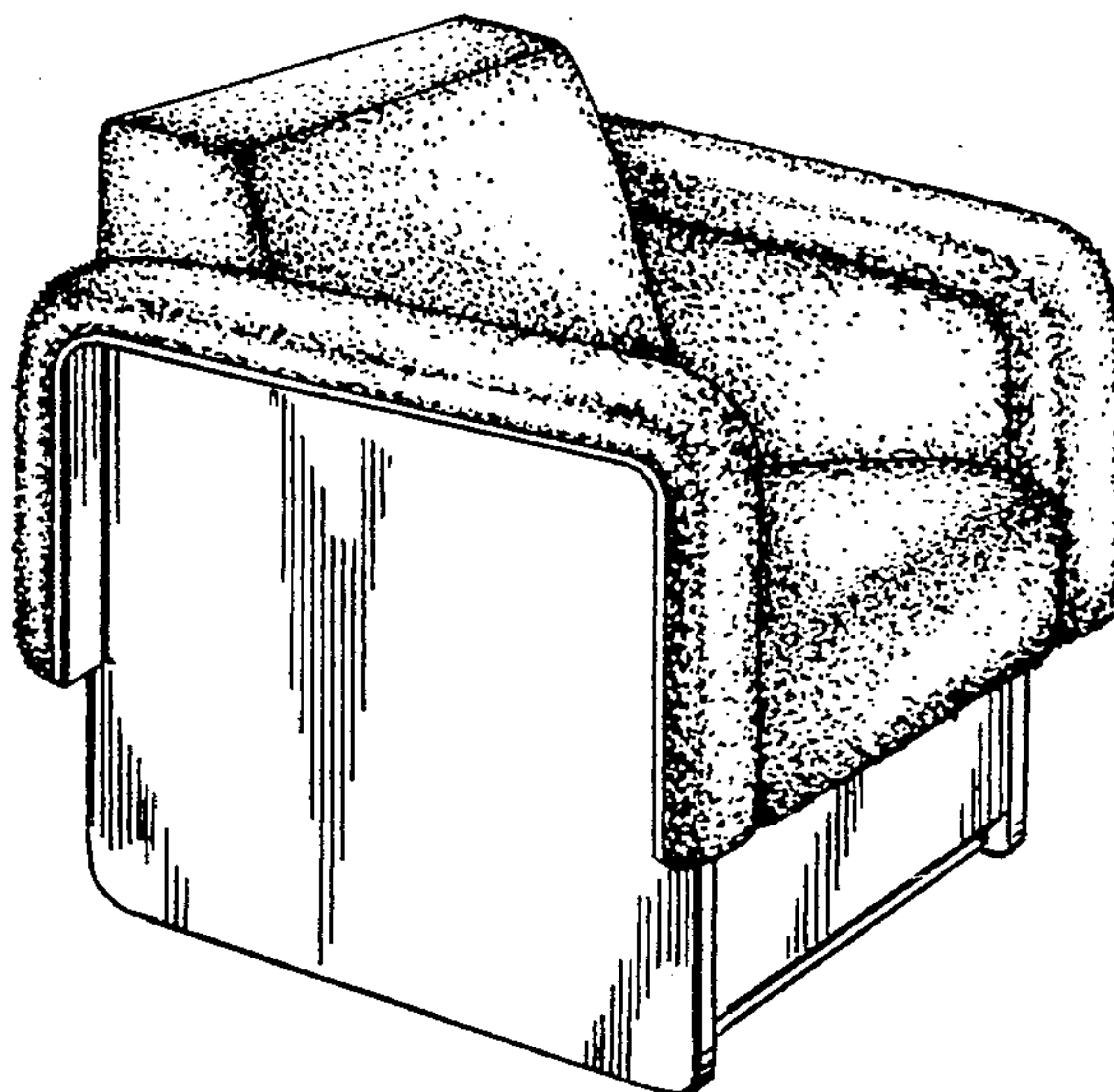

The ornamental design for a seat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a seat showing my design in the form of an armchair;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being identical in all respects thereto;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of my design for a seat shown as a sofa;
FIG. 7 is a rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a front perspective view of a third embodiment of my design for a seat shown as a sofa;
FIG. 9 is a rear perspective view of a fourth embodiment of my design for a seat shown as a sofa;

FIG. 12 is a sixth embodiment of my design for a seat shown as a sofa.



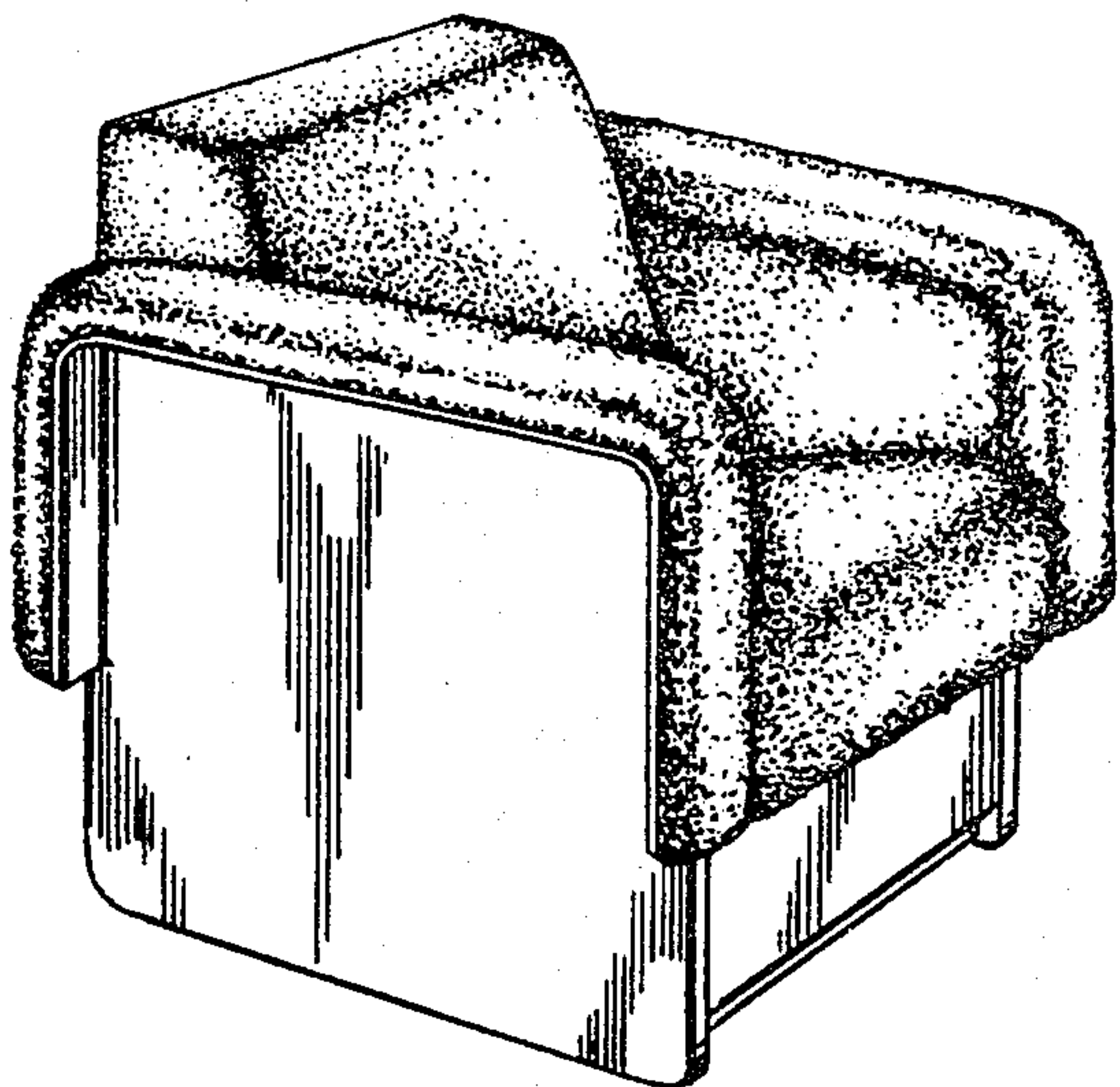

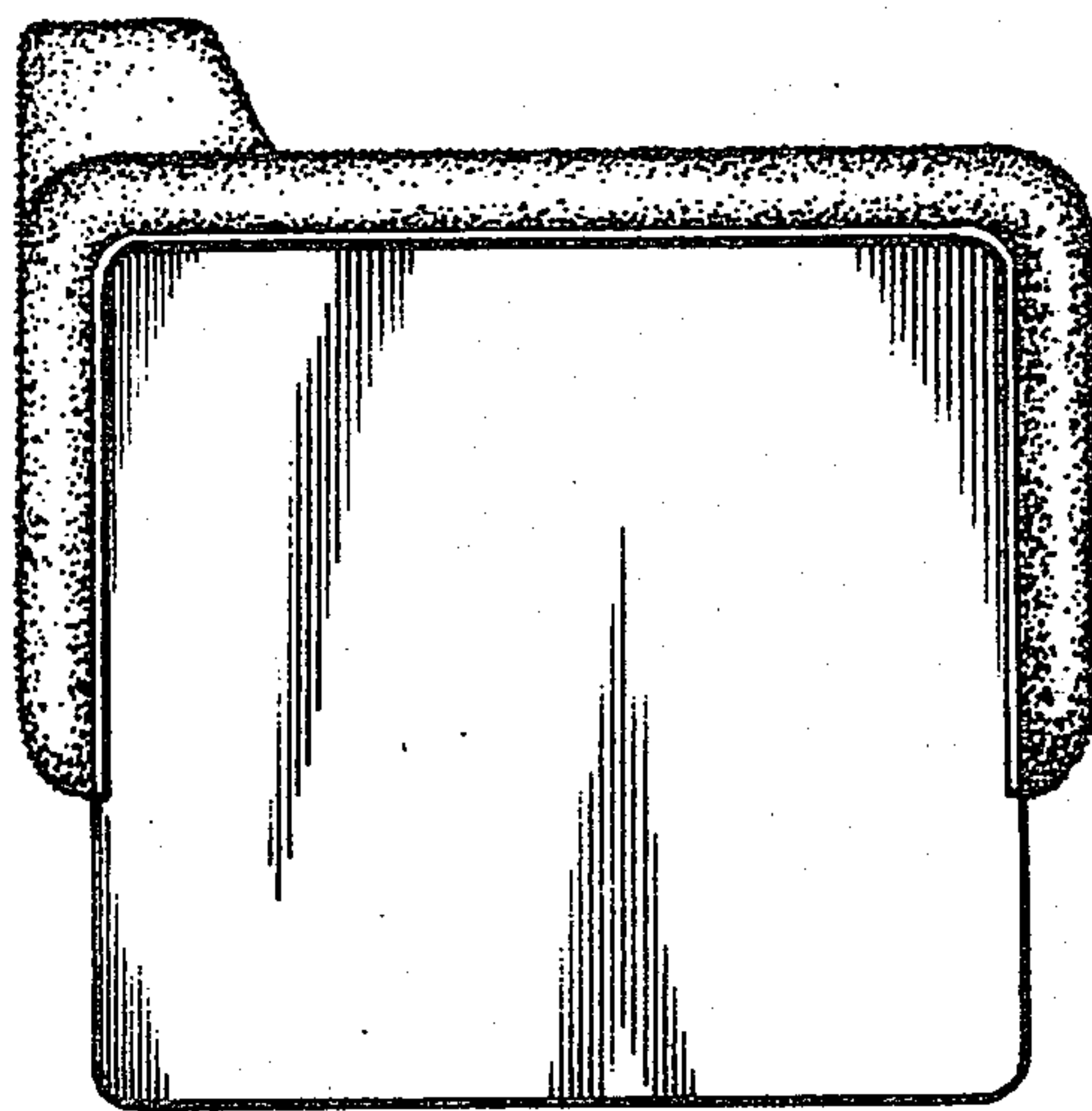

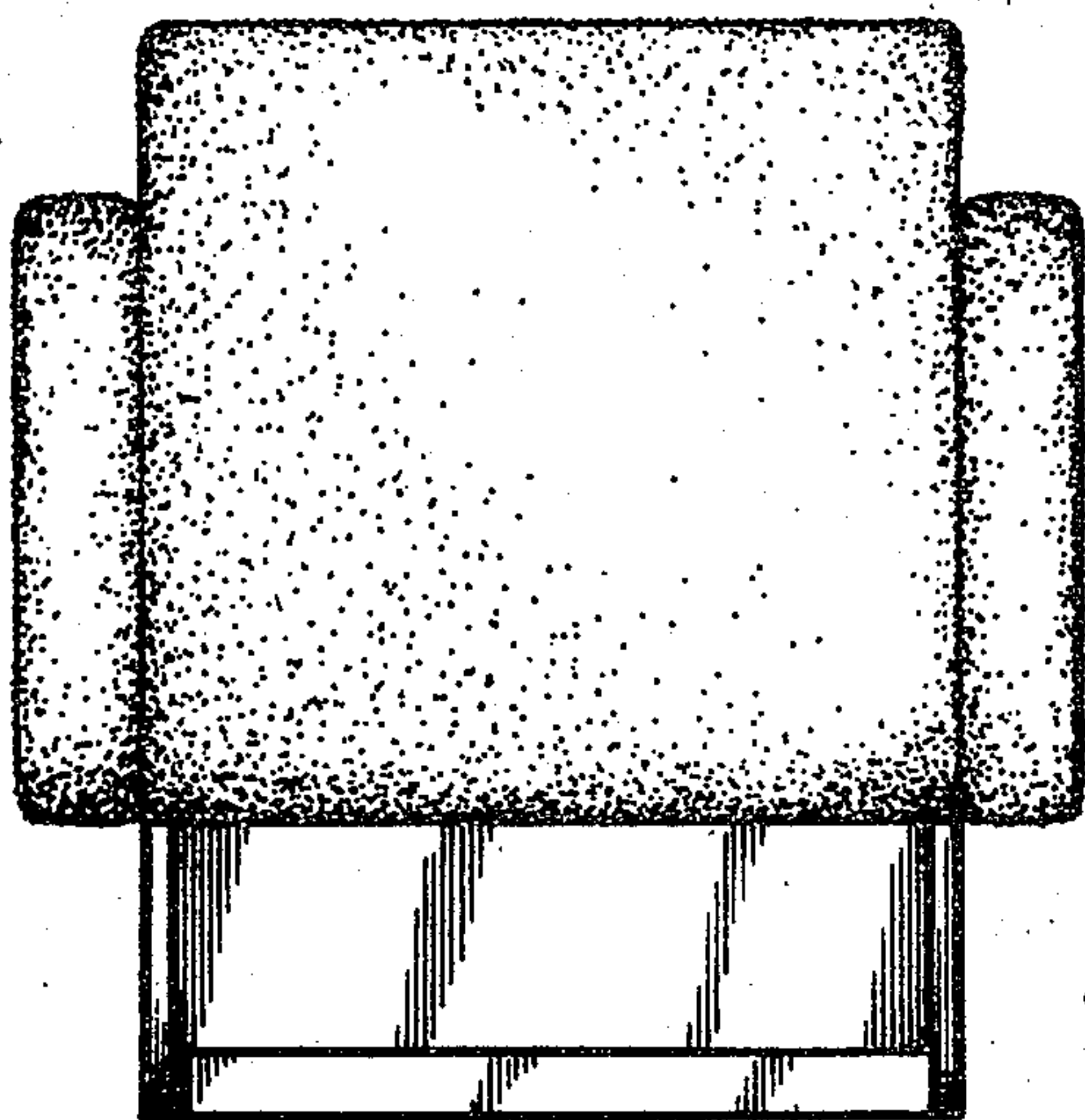

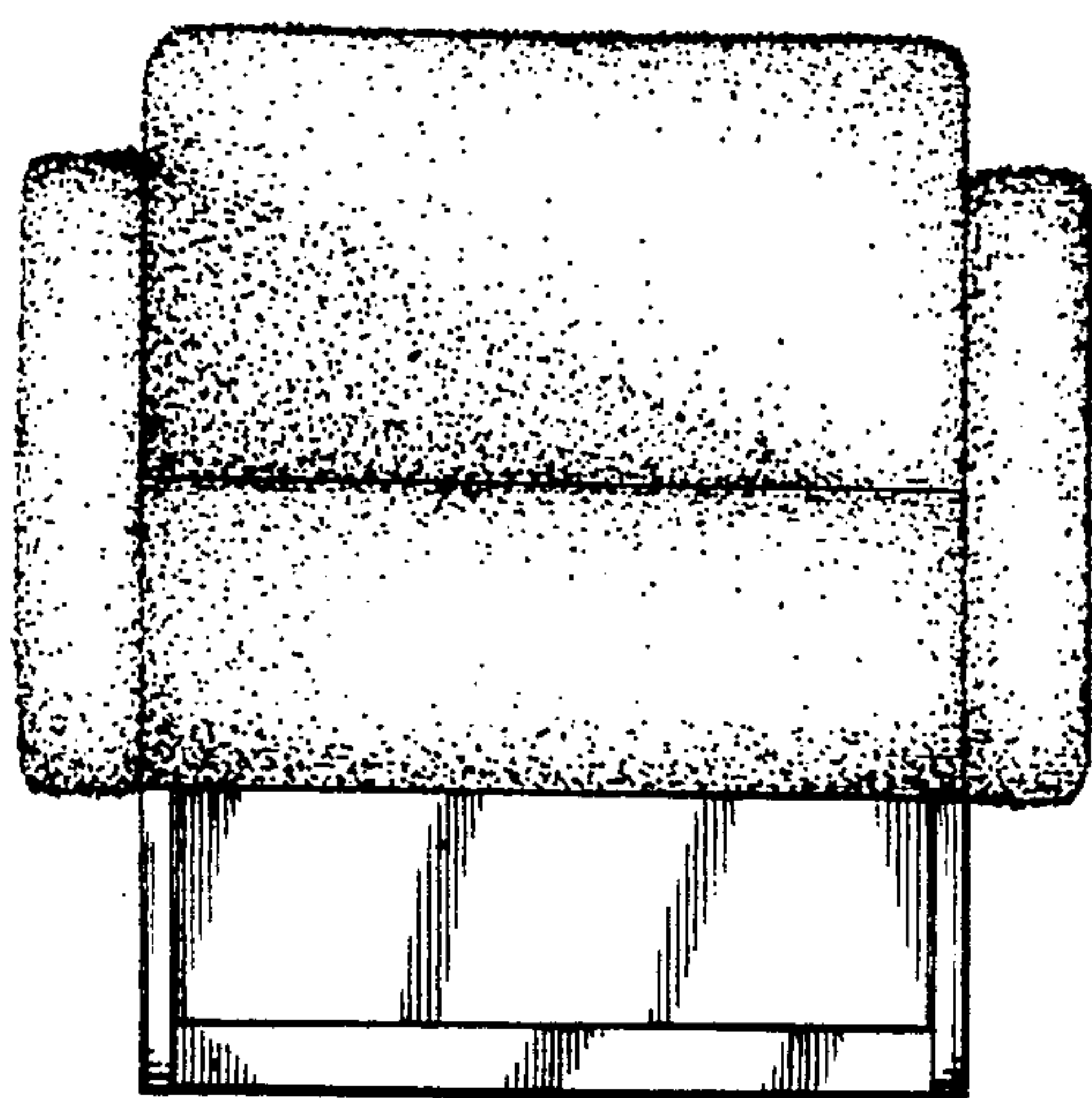

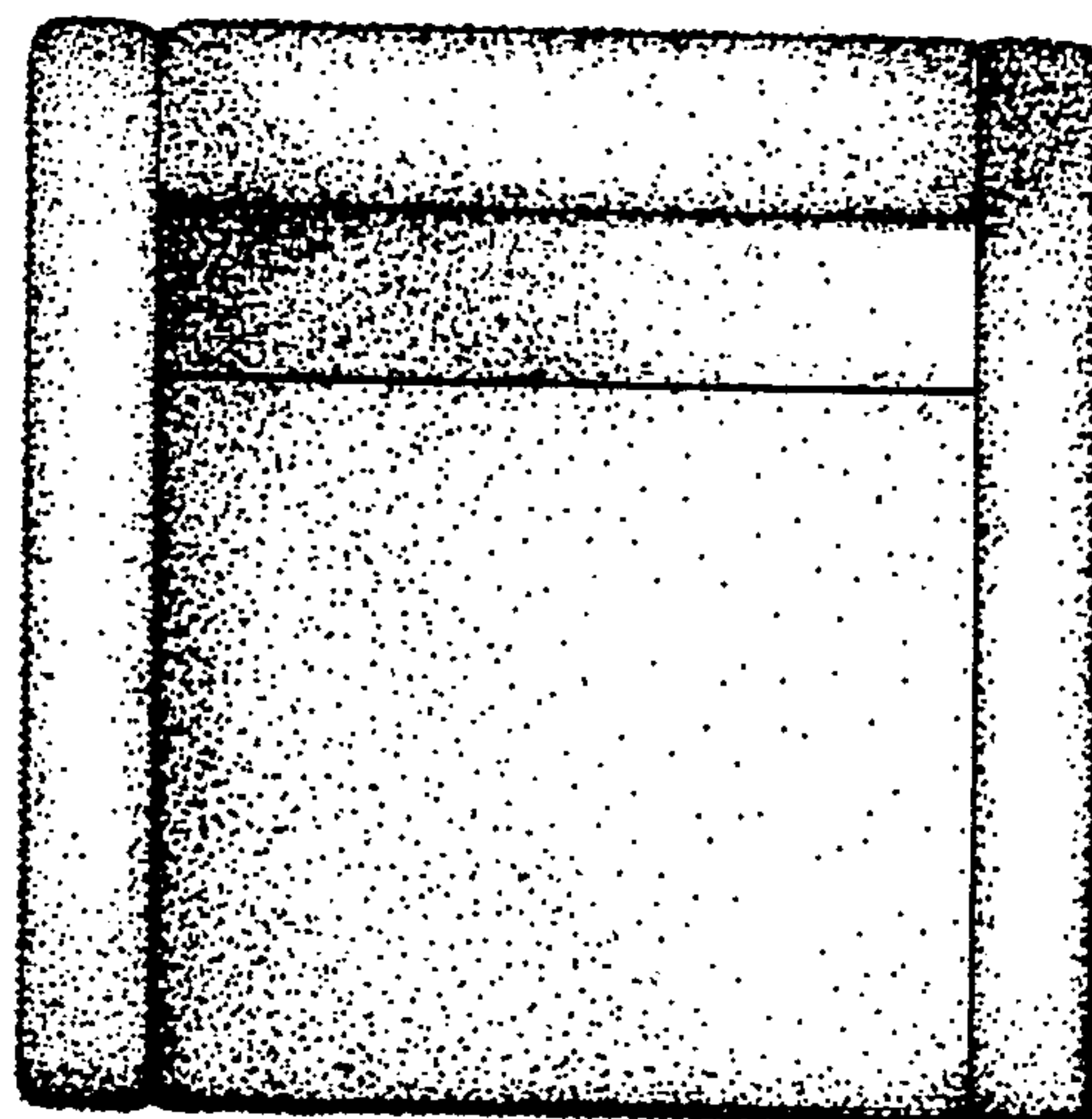

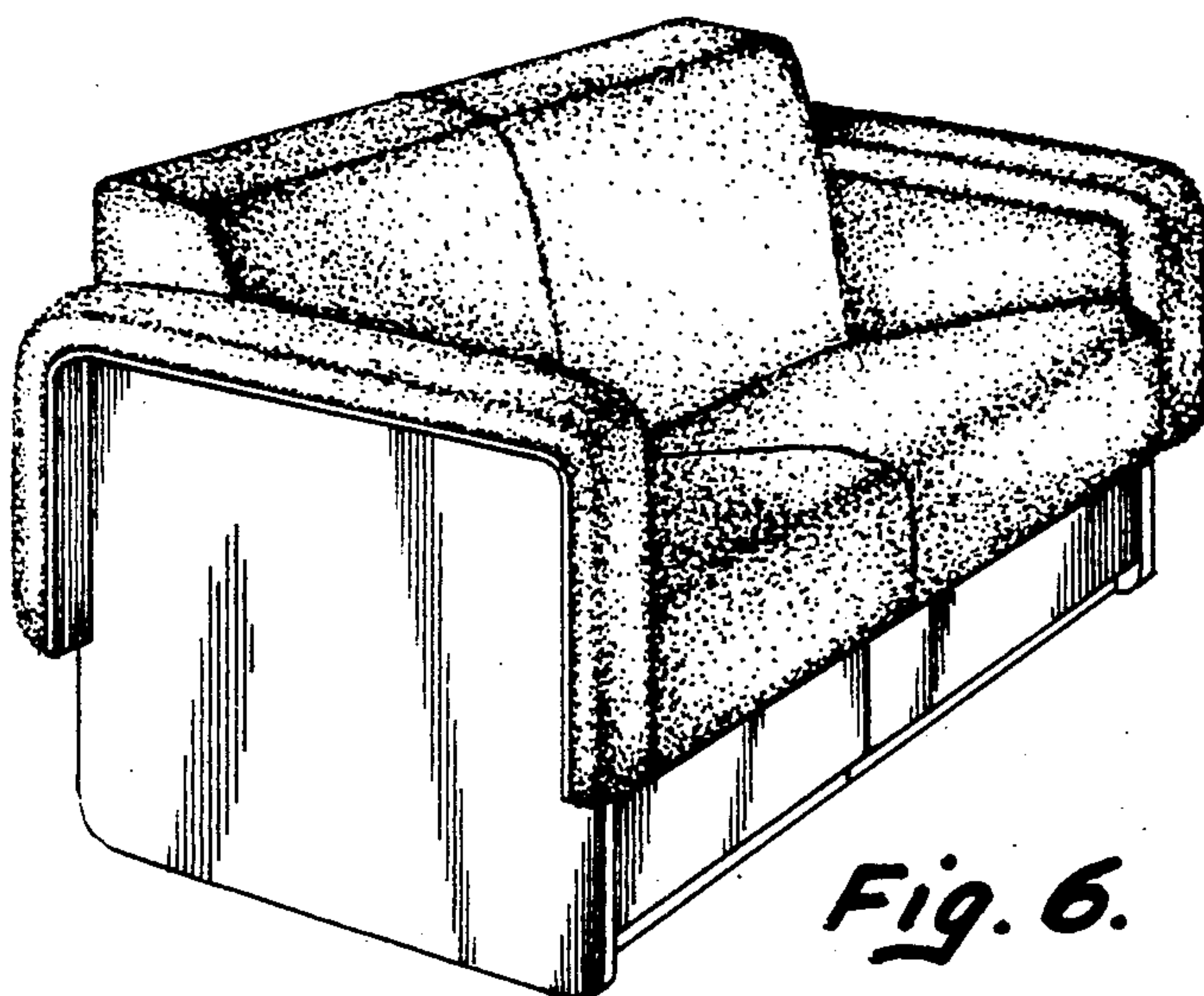

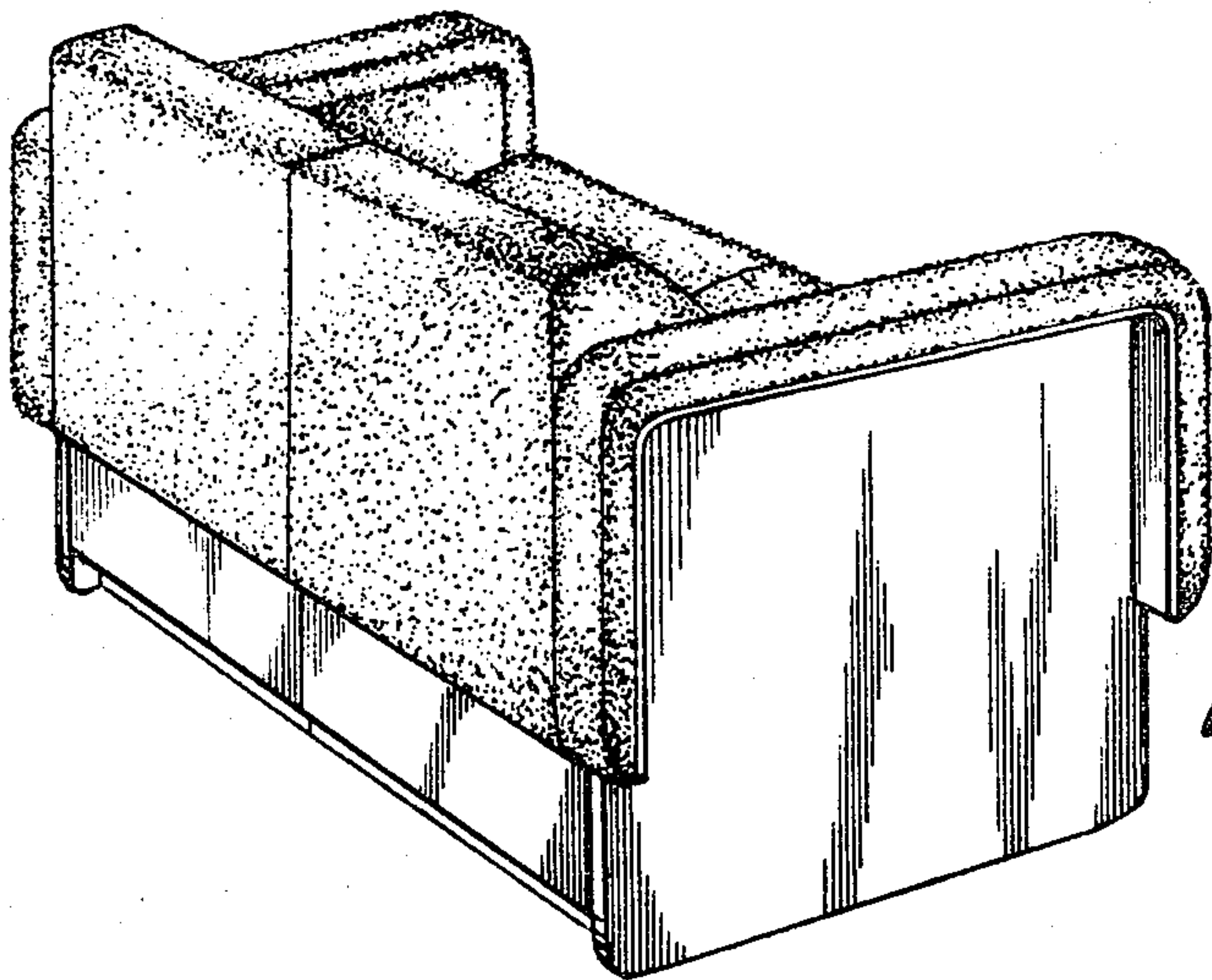

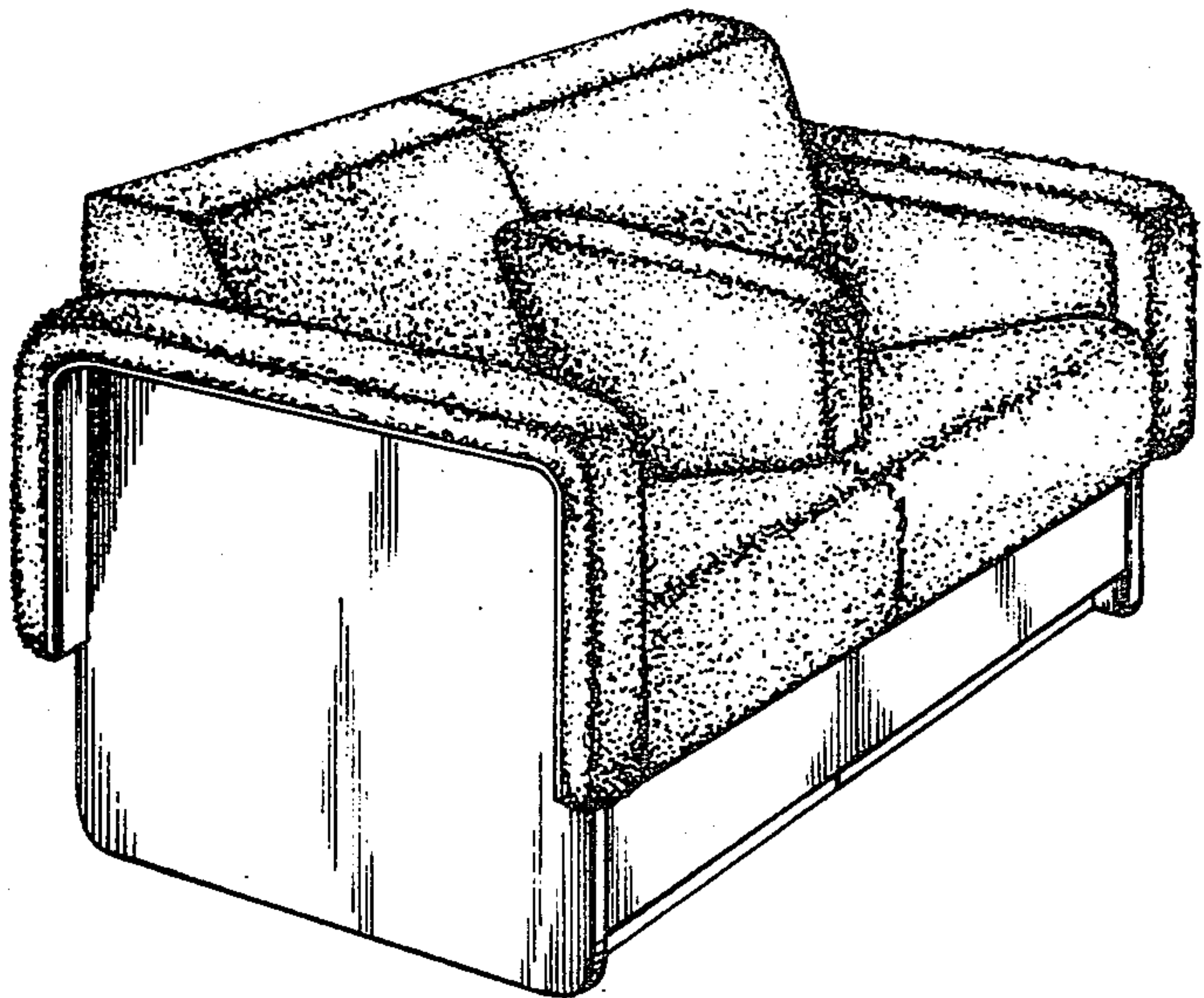

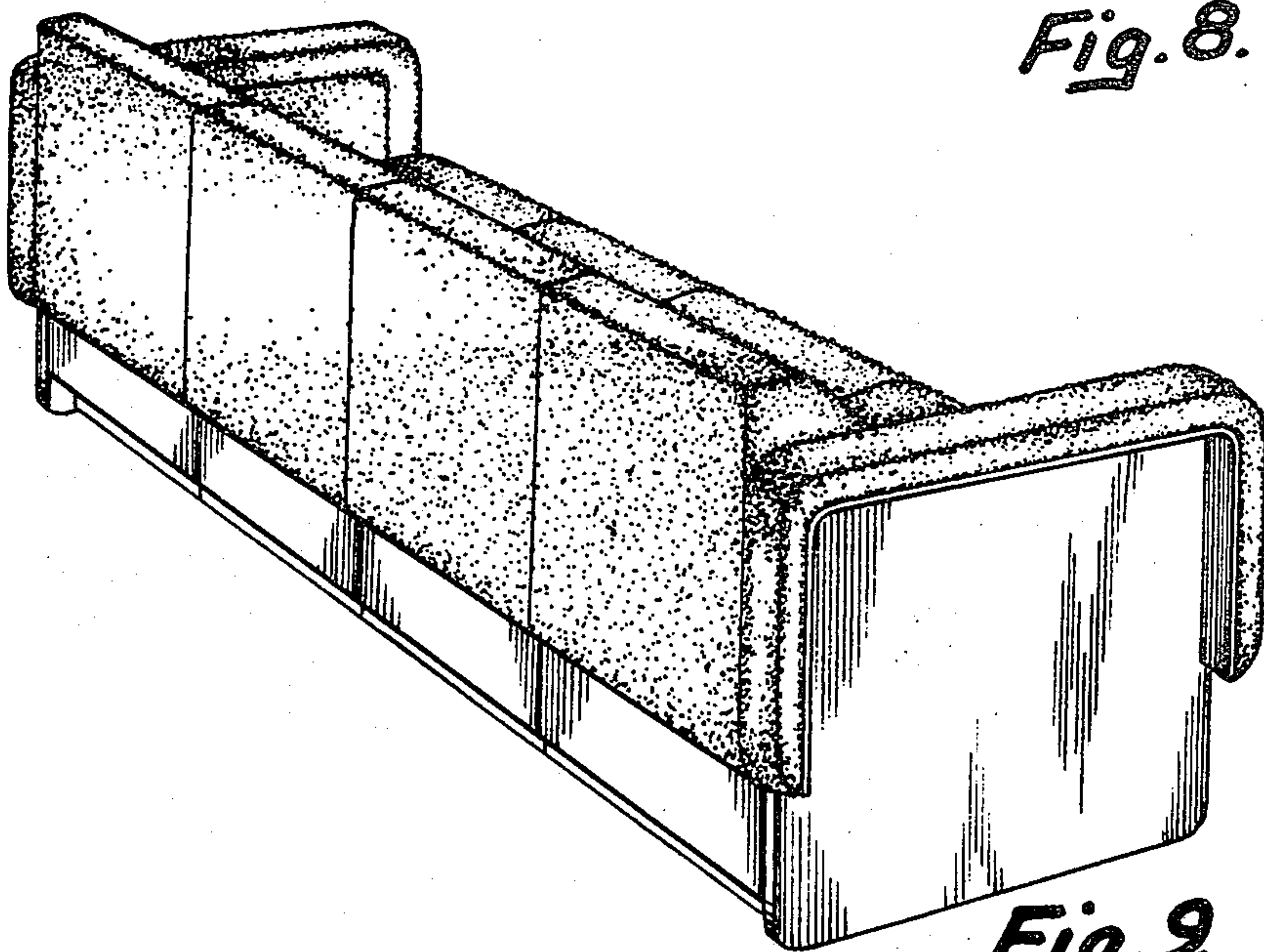

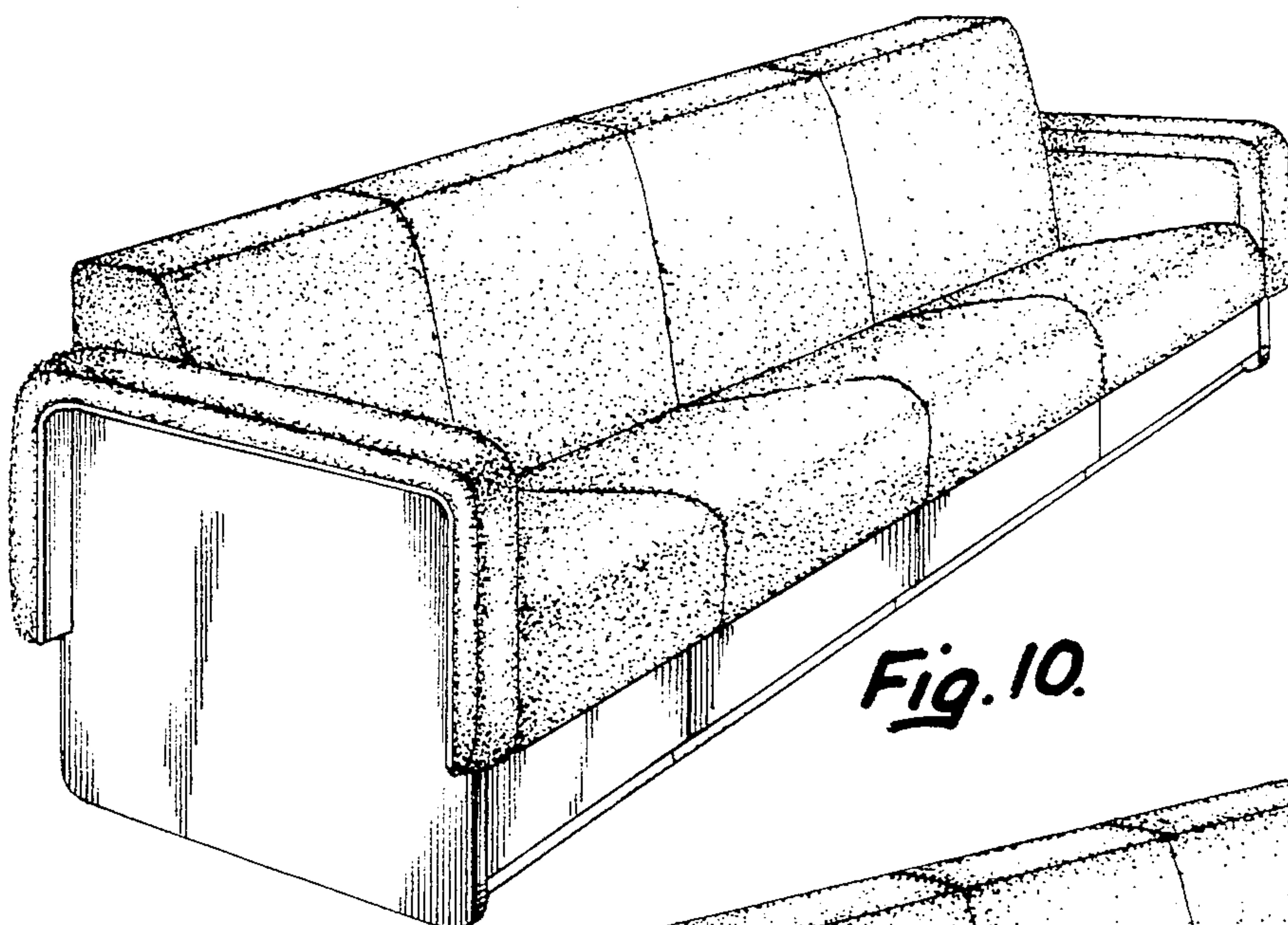

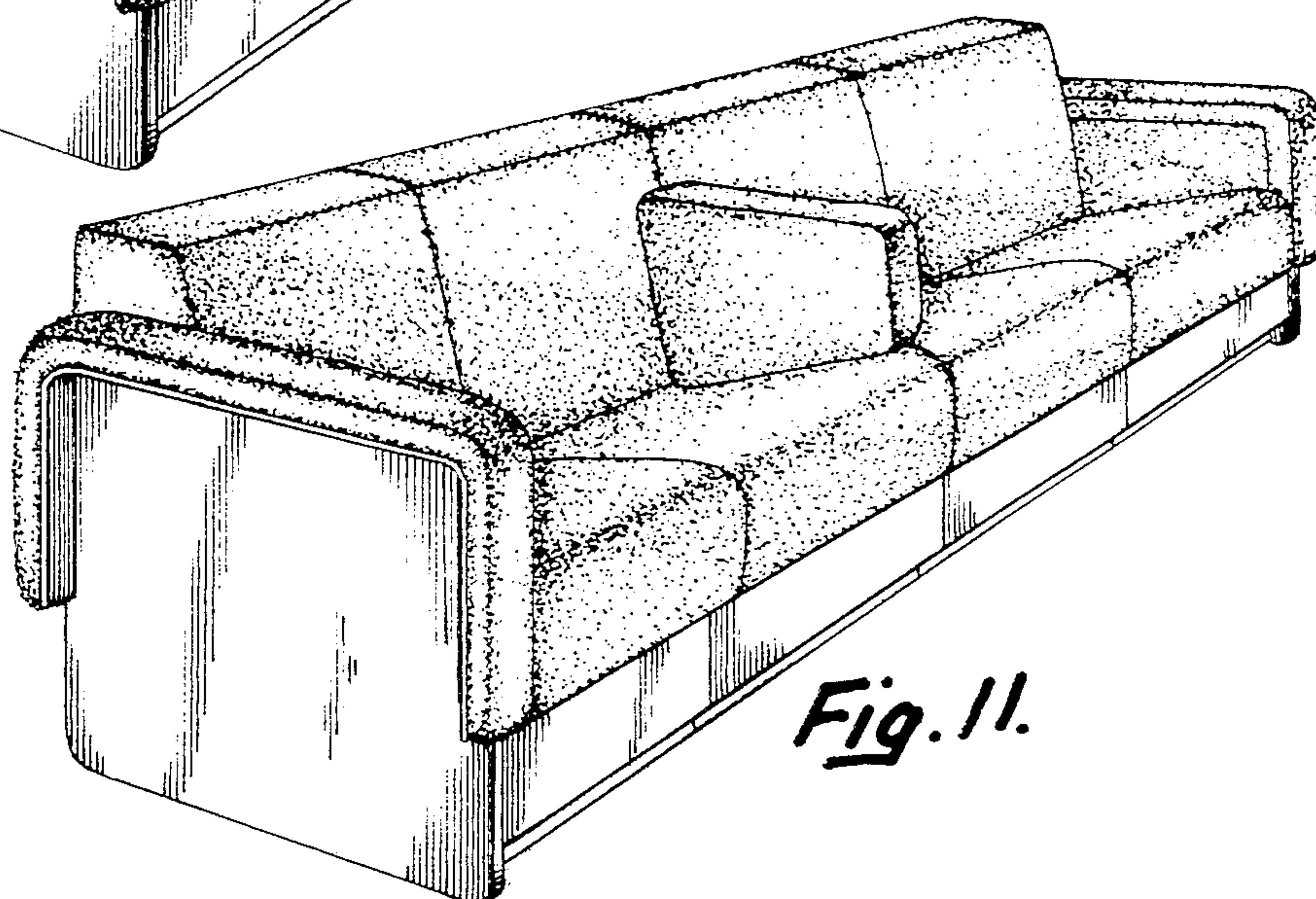

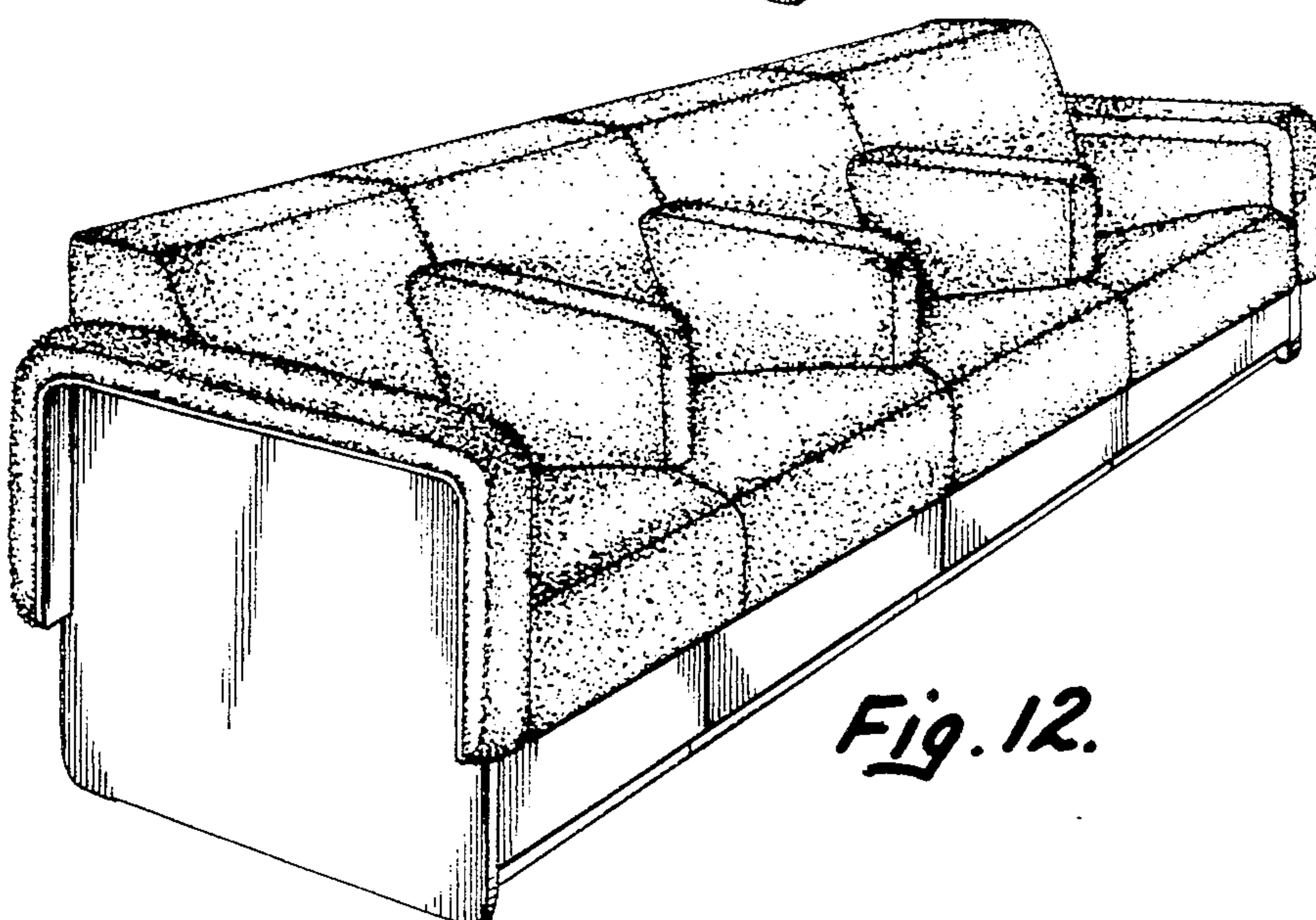
