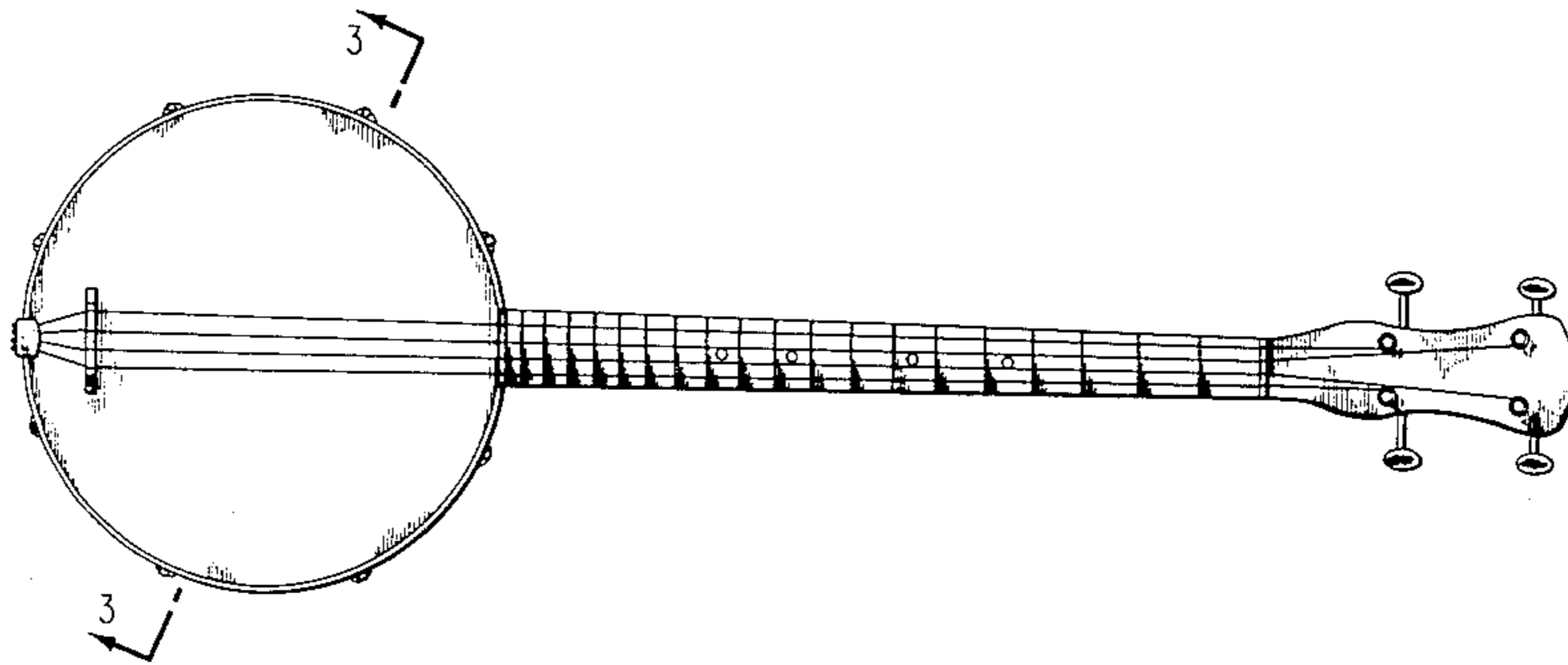

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a banjo, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a banjo showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a fragmentary rear elevational view; and
FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary front elevational view of a hook slot in the head ring.



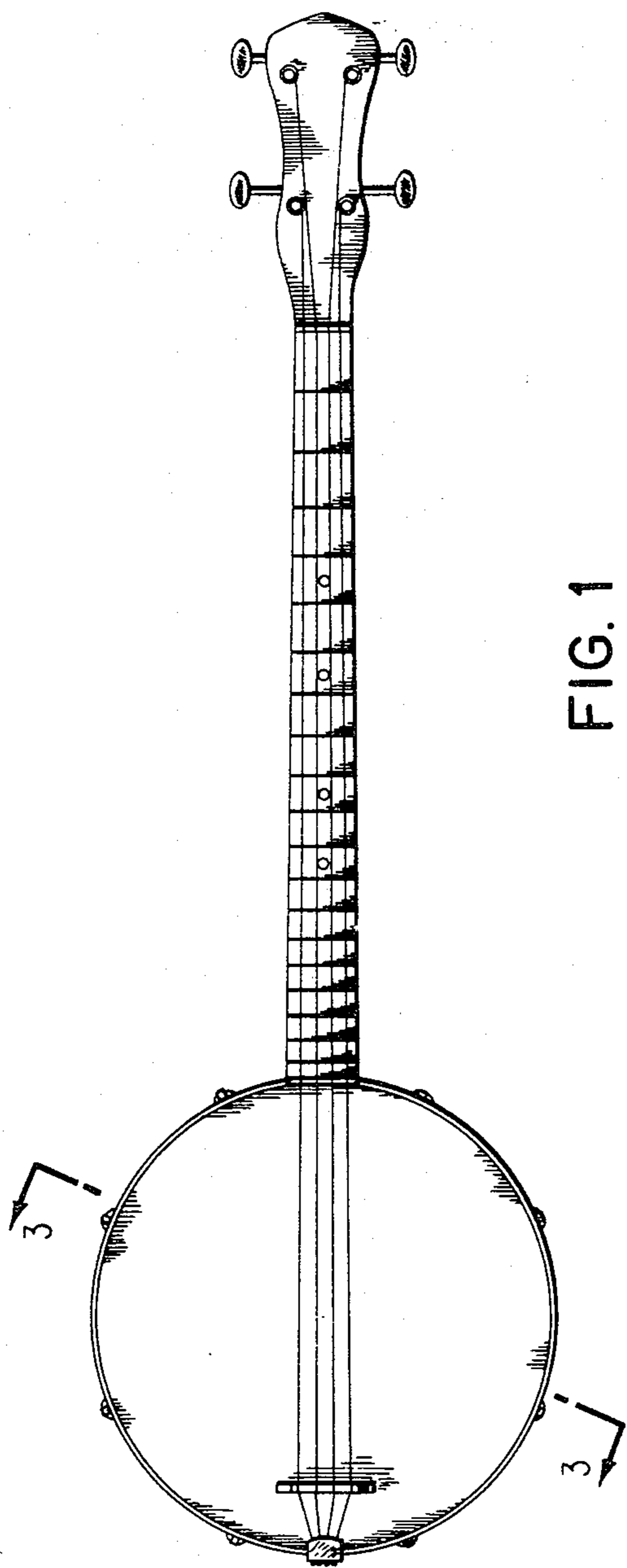

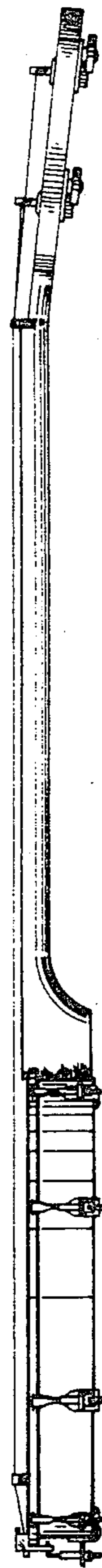

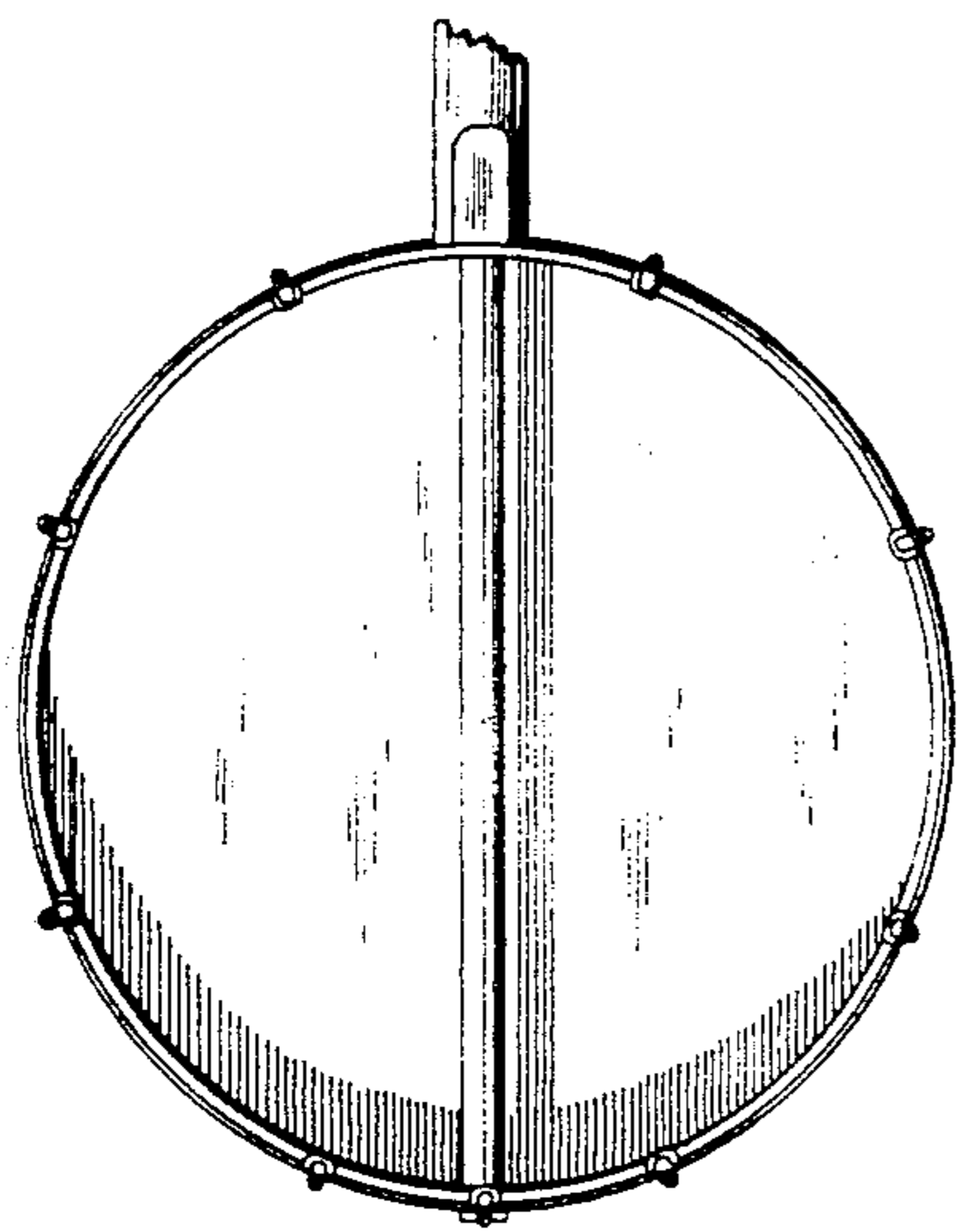

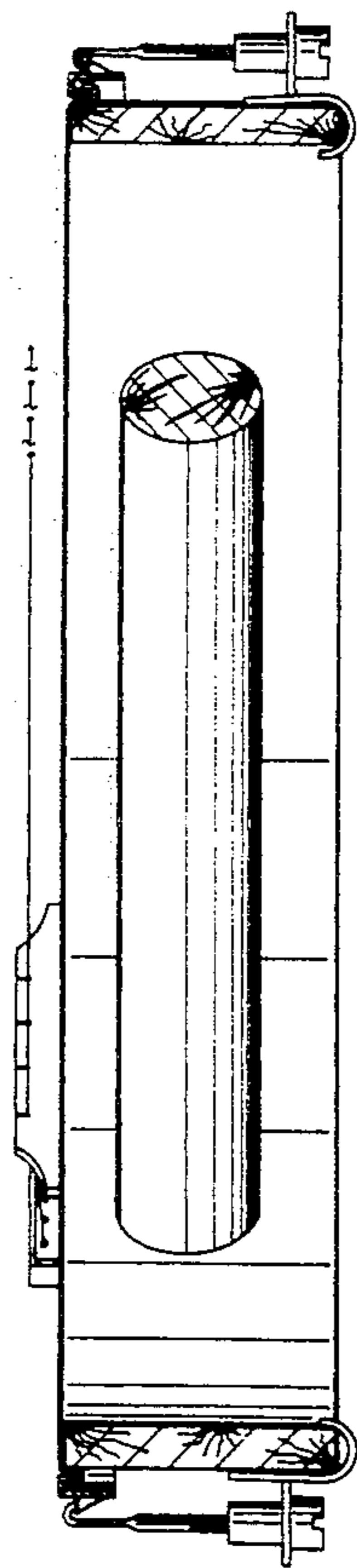

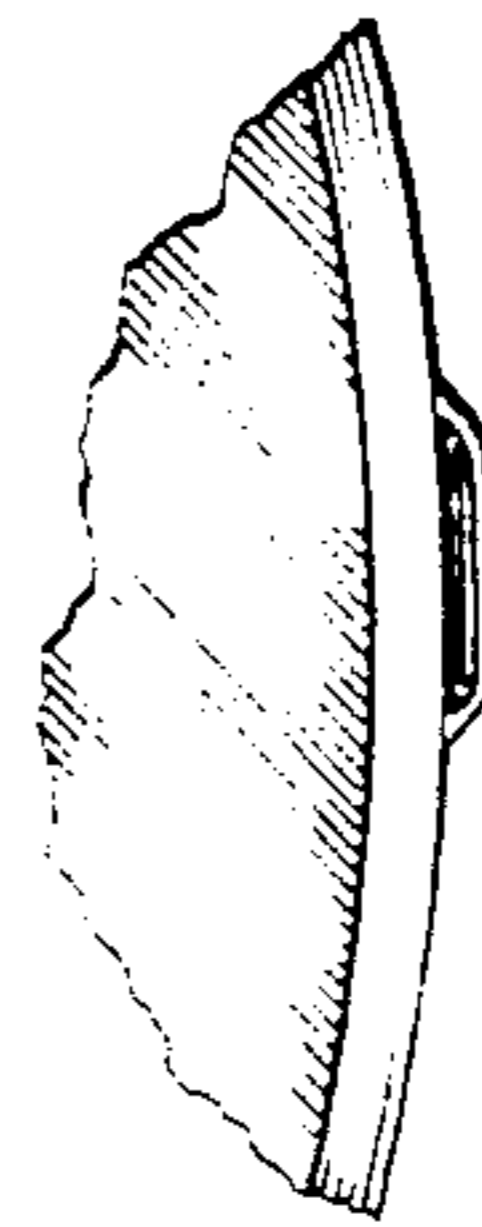
