The ornamental design for a tape applicator or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tape applicator or similar article showing our new design, the environmental structure shown in dotted lines being for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof taken from the right hand side of FIG. 3.

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof taken from the left hand side of FIG. 3; and

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

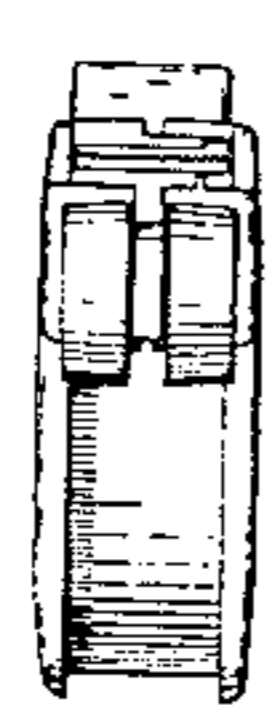
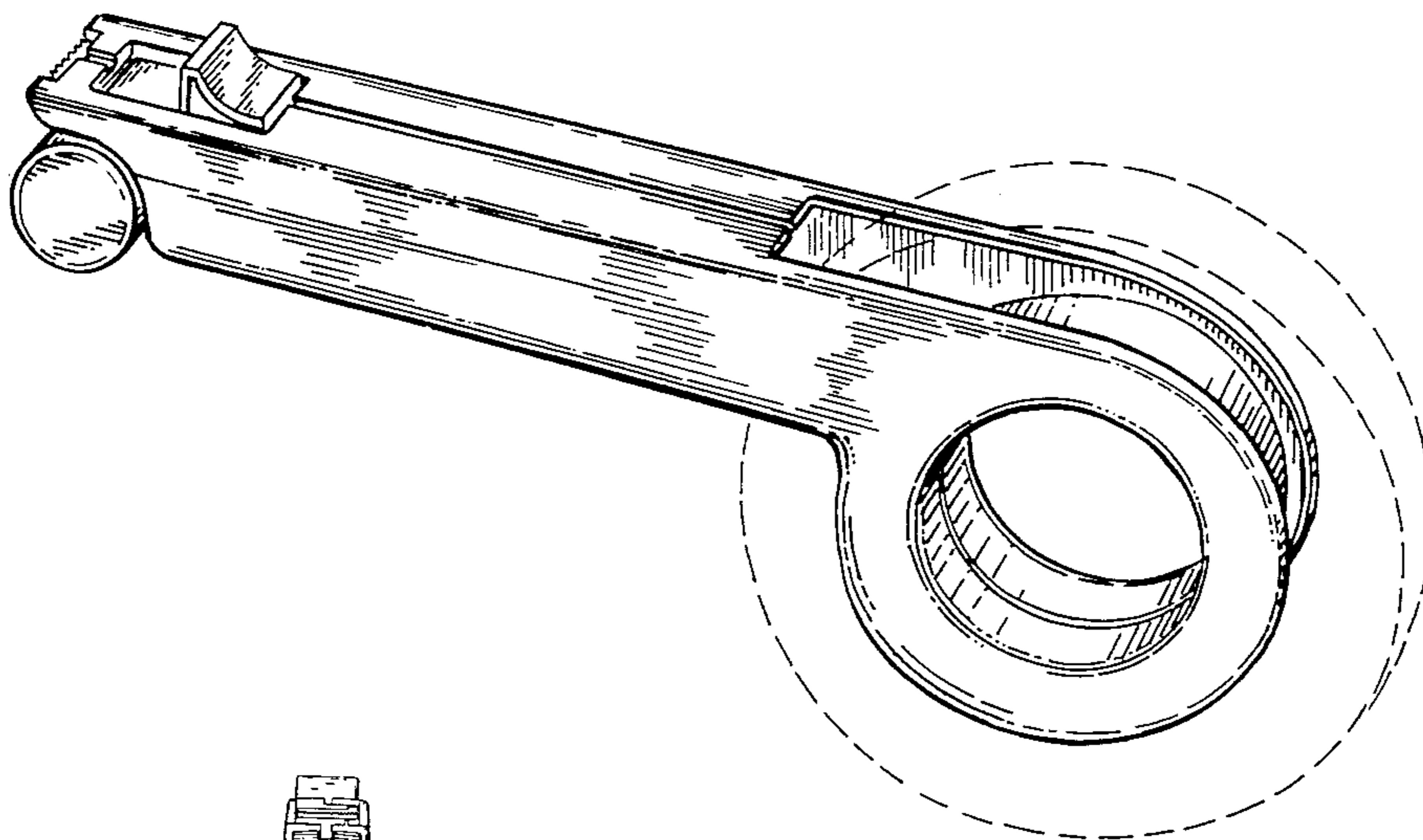

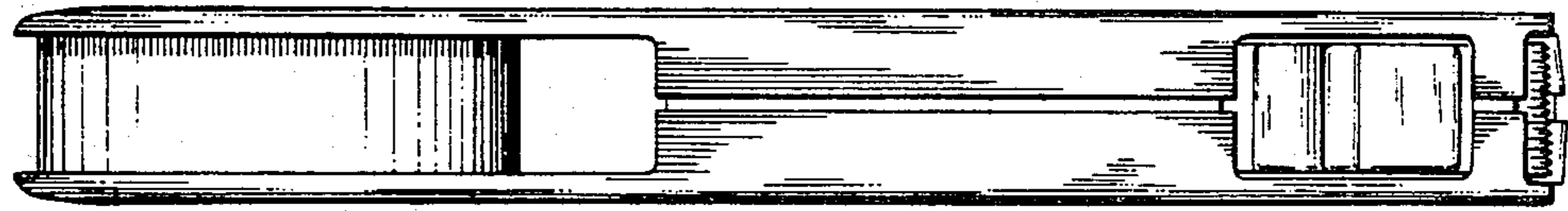
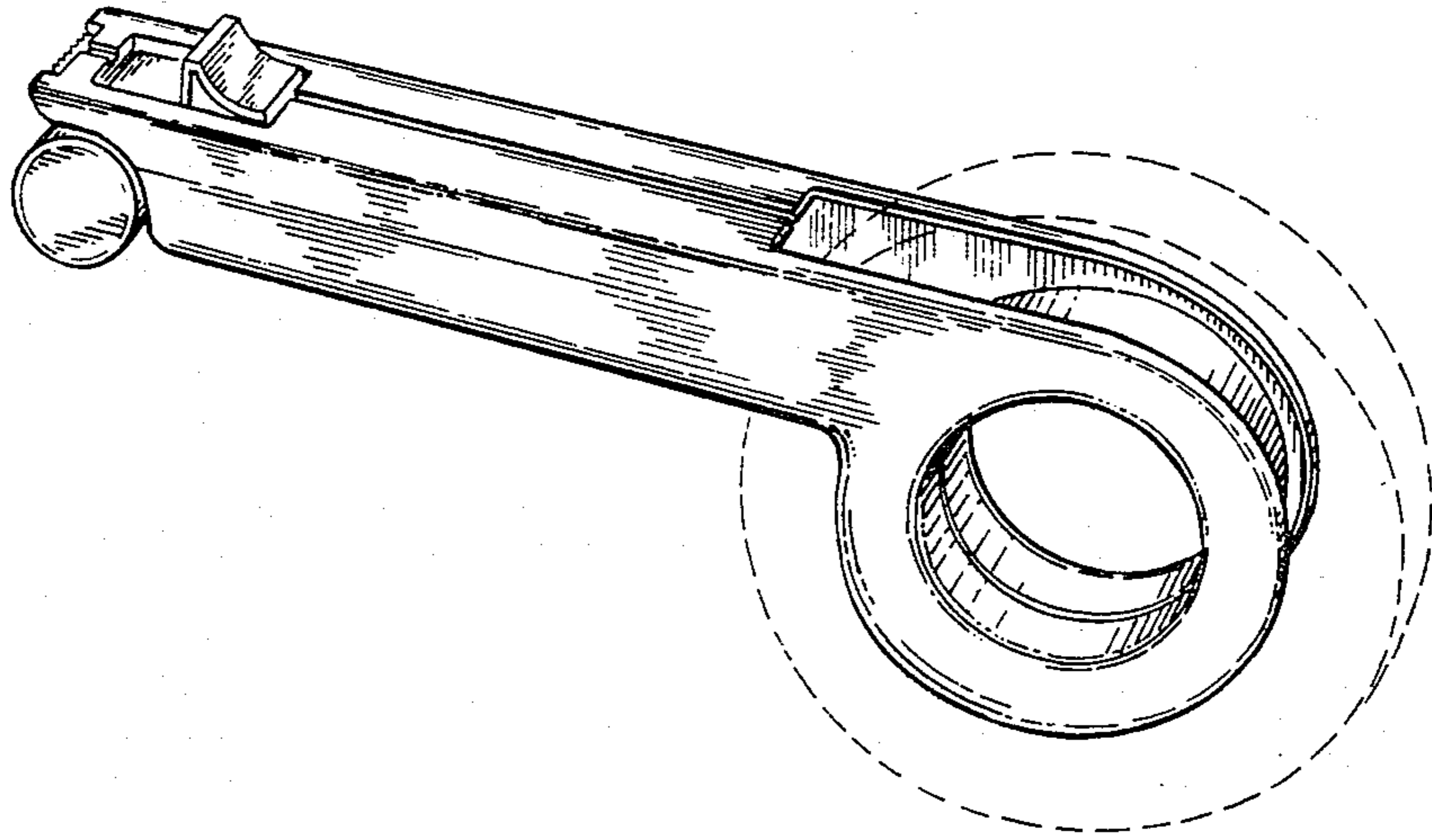

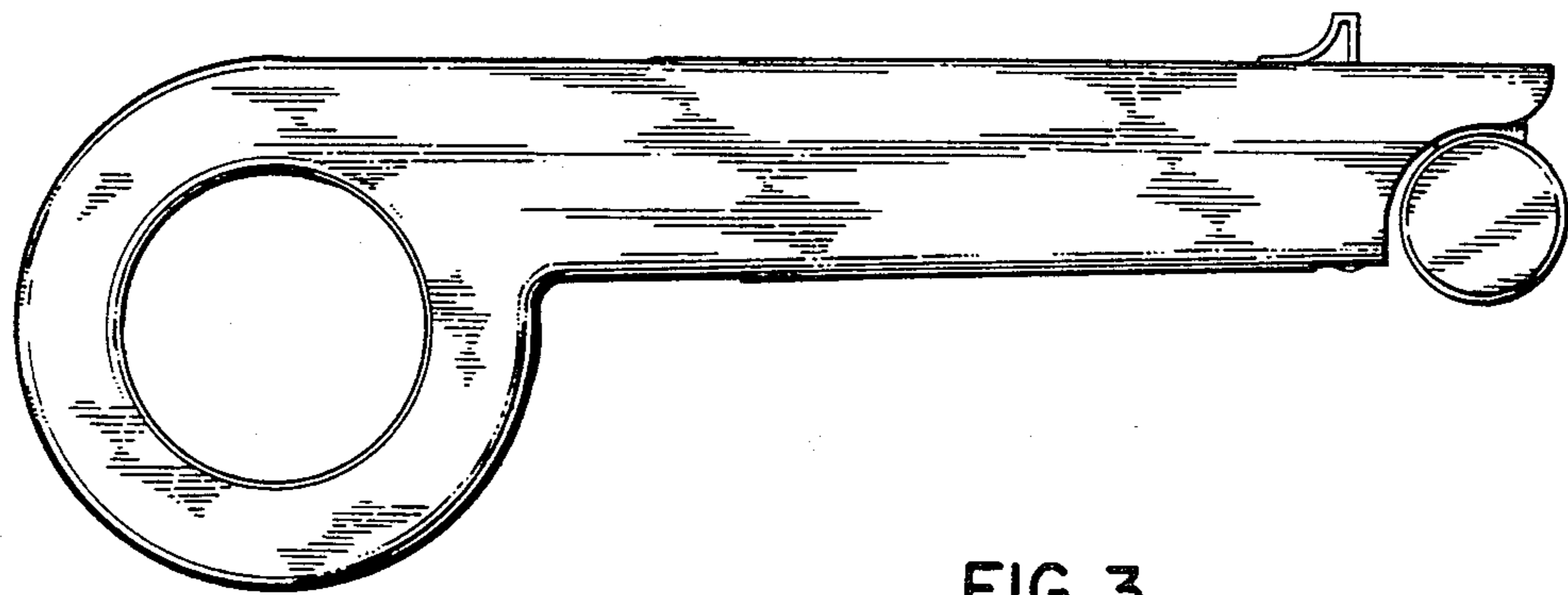

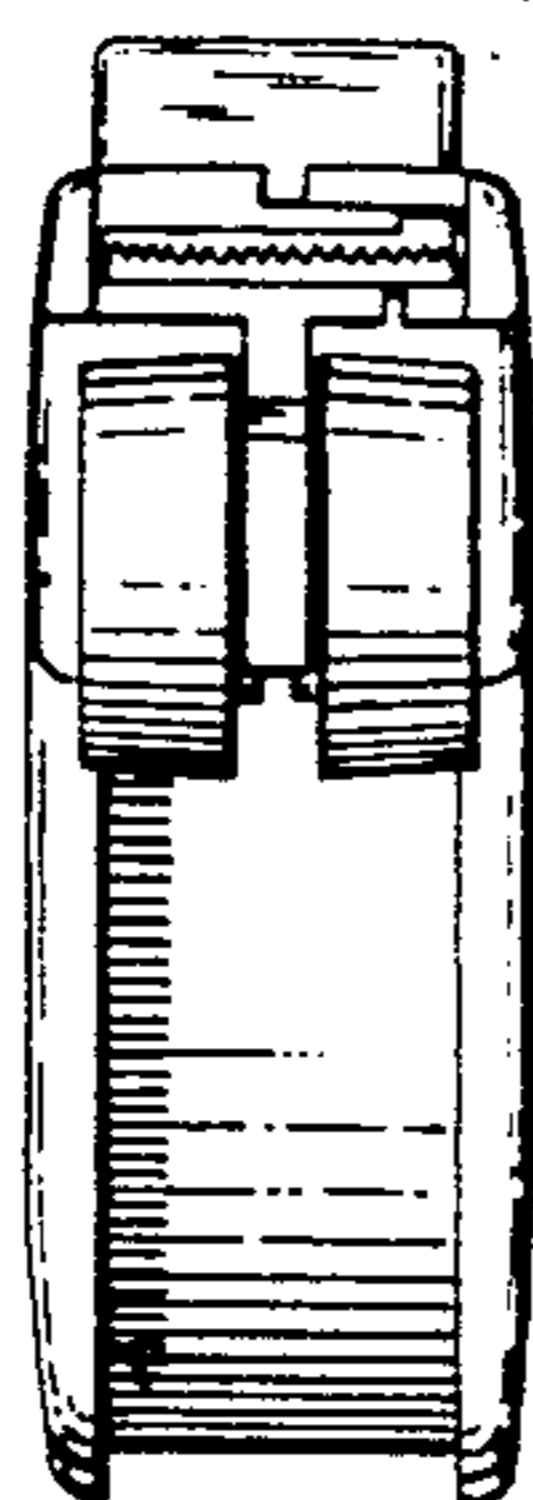

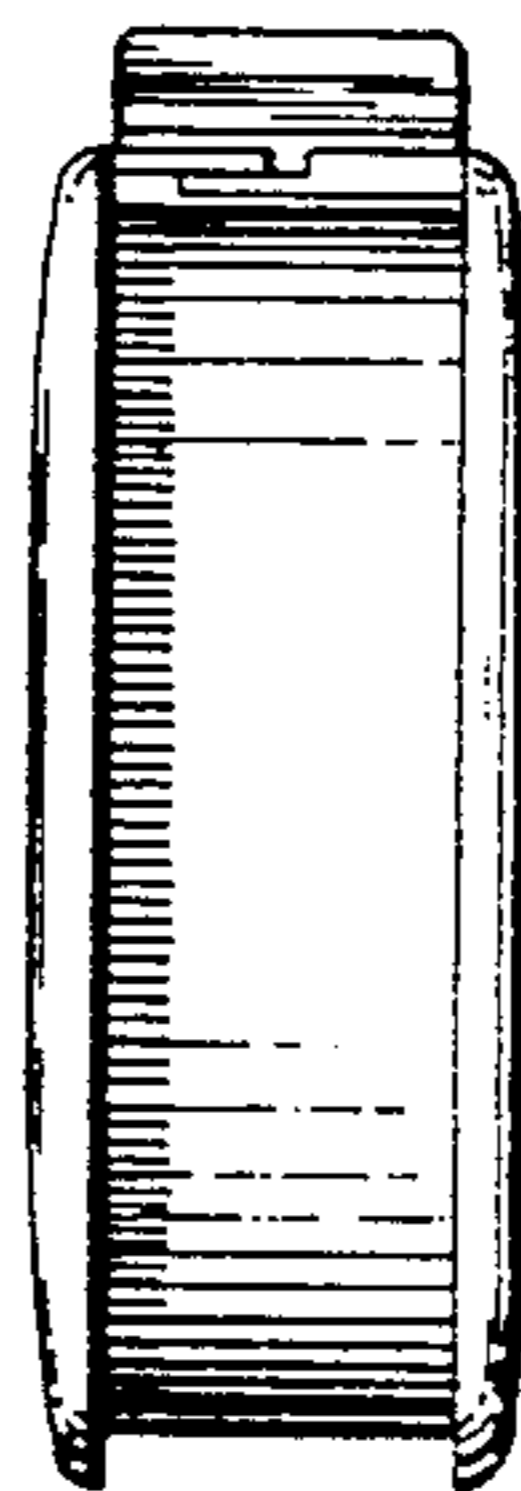

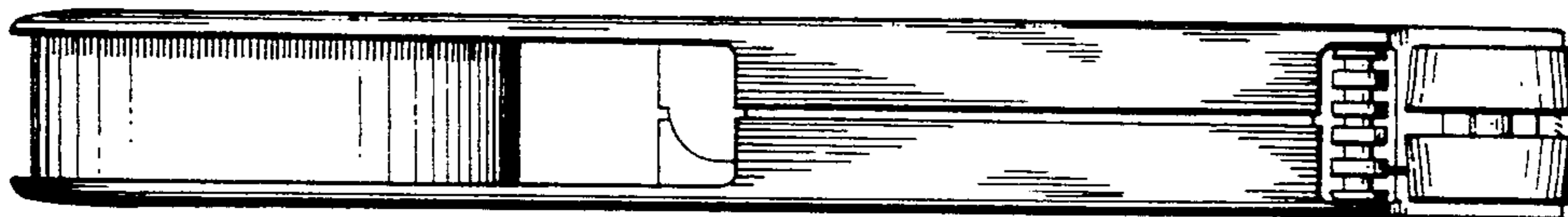
