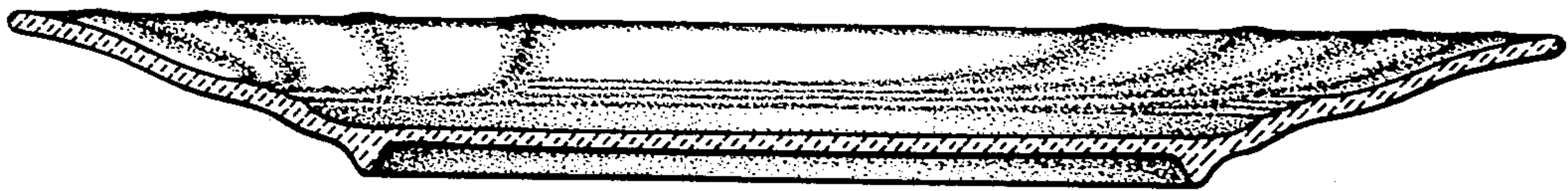
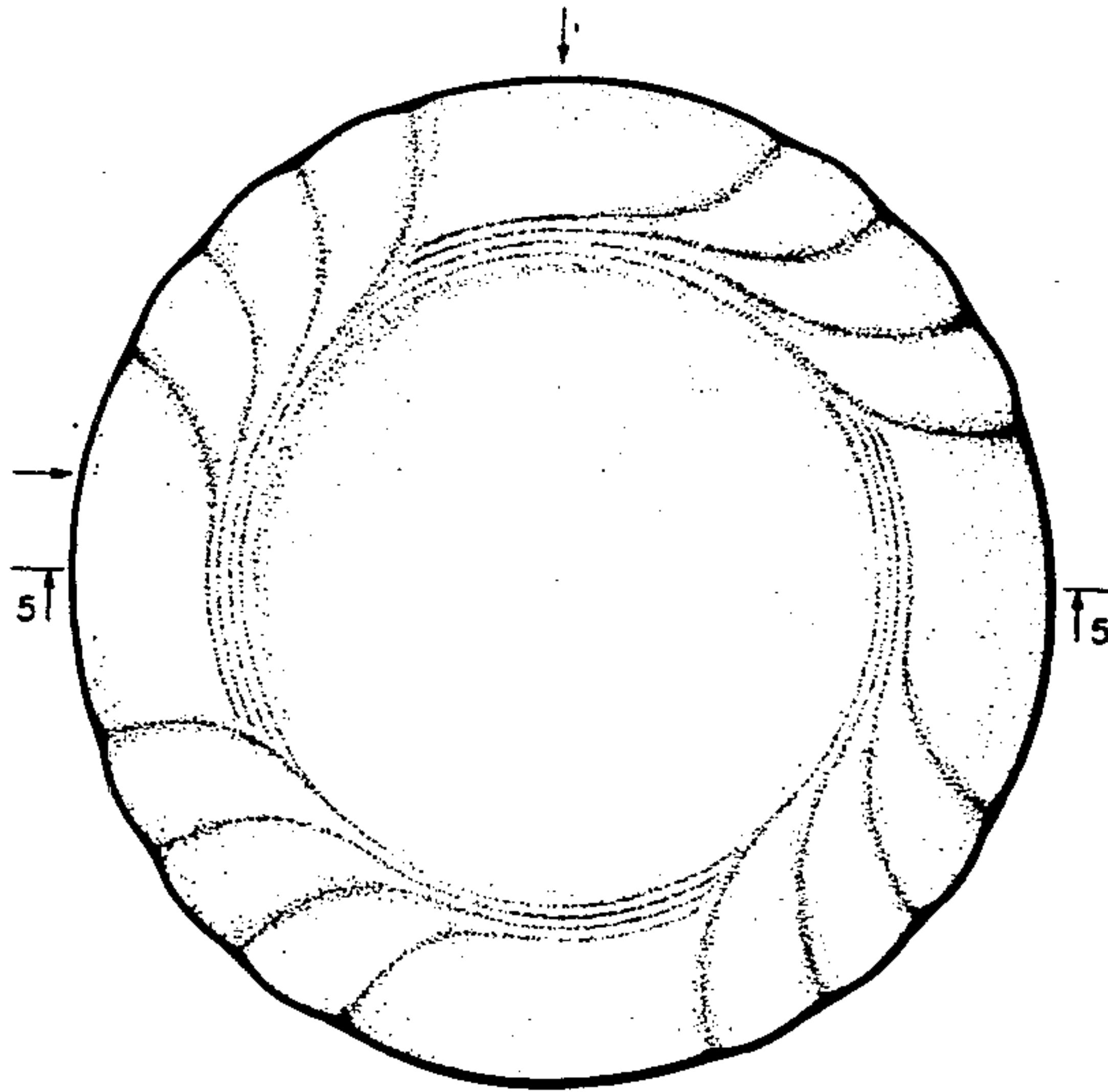

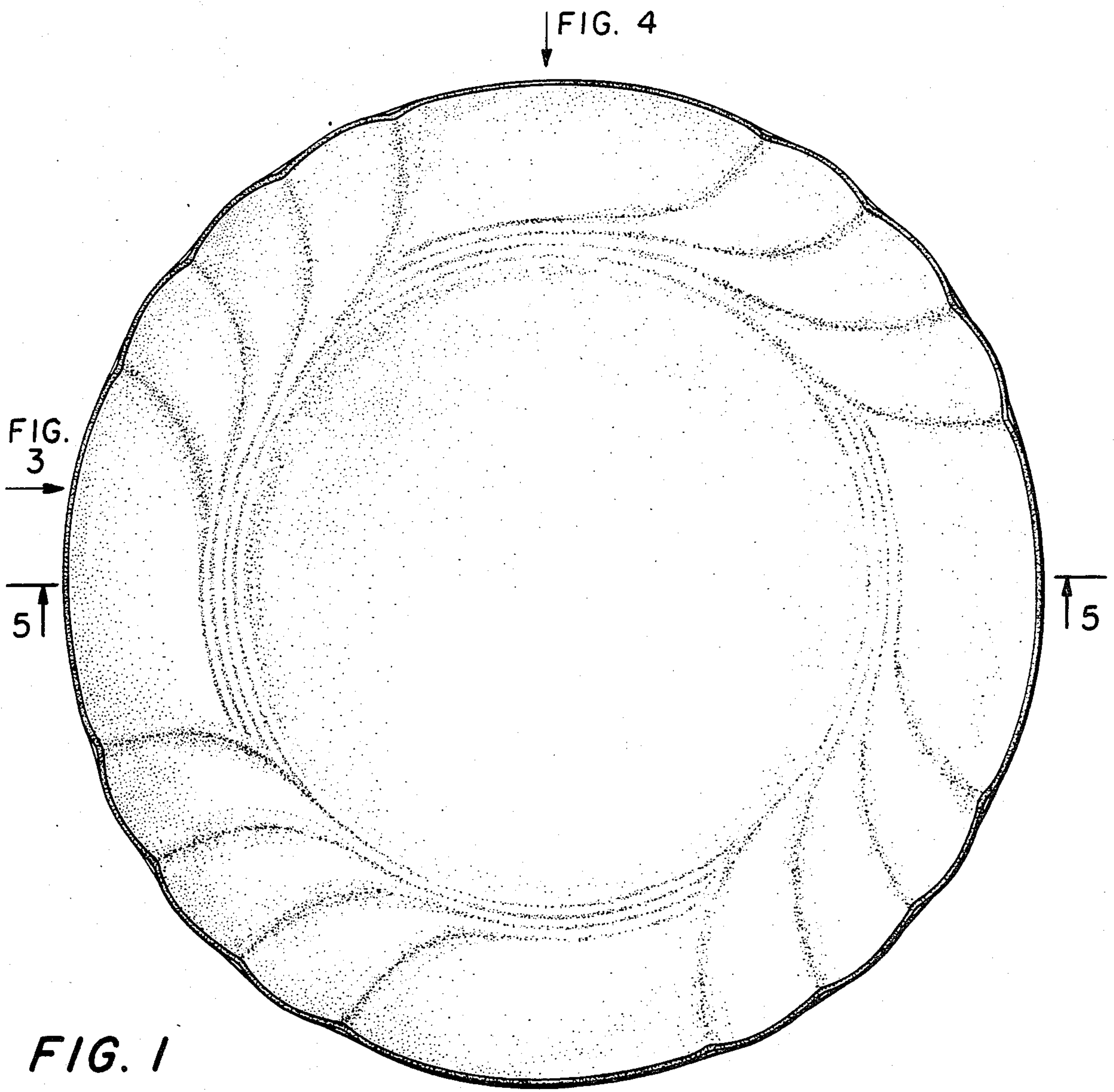

described.

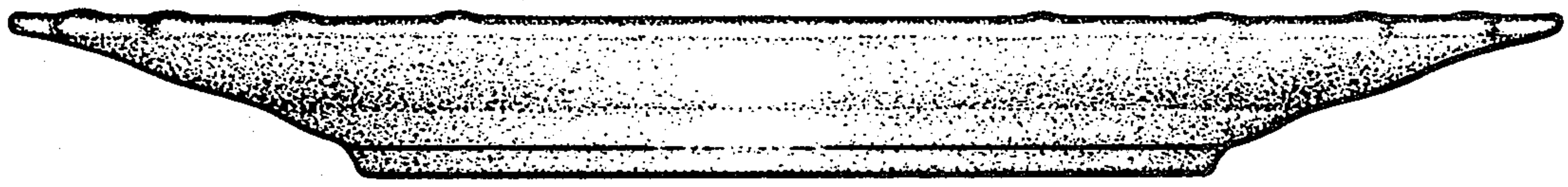
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a dinner plate showing my  
new design;  
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof as taken in the  
direction of arrow 3 on FIG. 1;  
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof as taken in the  
direction of arrow 4 on FIG. 1; and

FIG. 1.

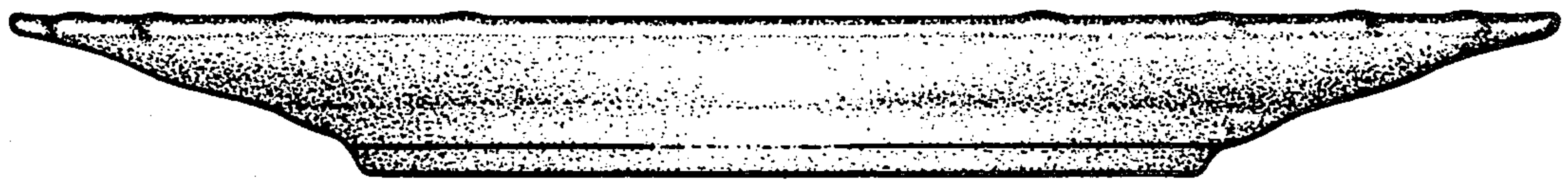

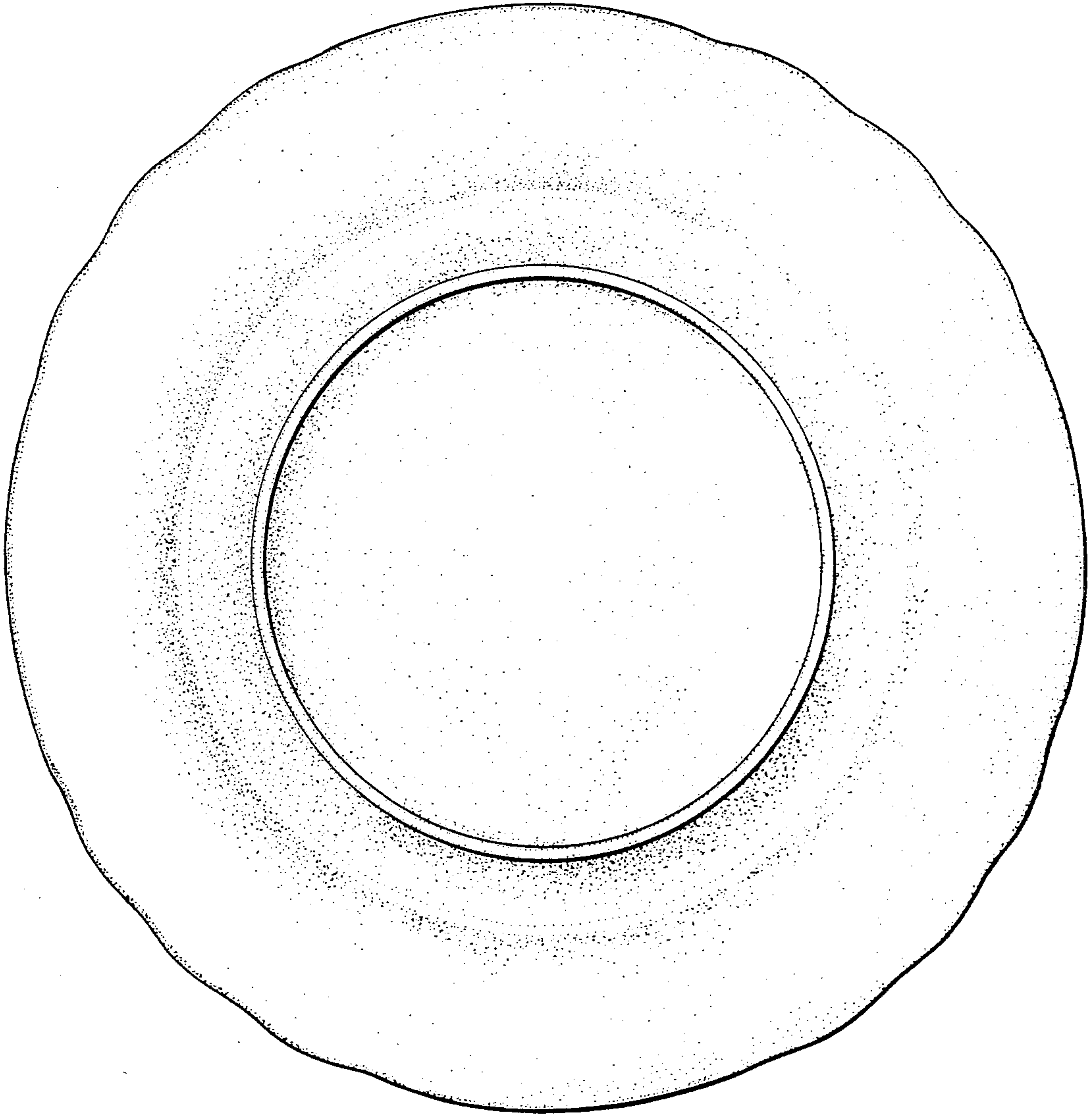

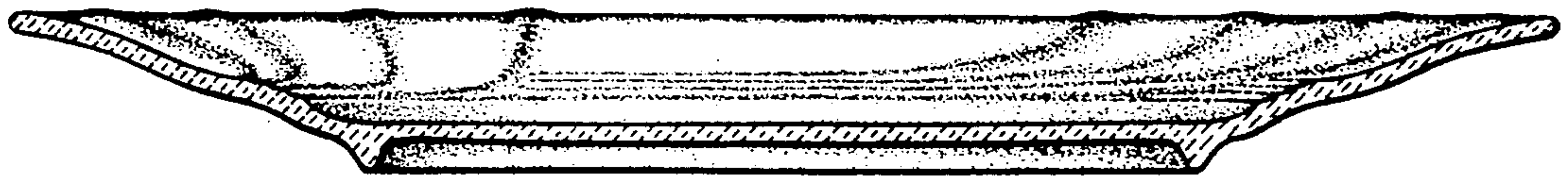
