The ornamental design for an emblem for jewelry, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an emblem for jewelry showing my new design, the rear being unornamented.

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a top end view of FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a bottom end view of FIG. 1.

The broken line showing of an eyelet is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

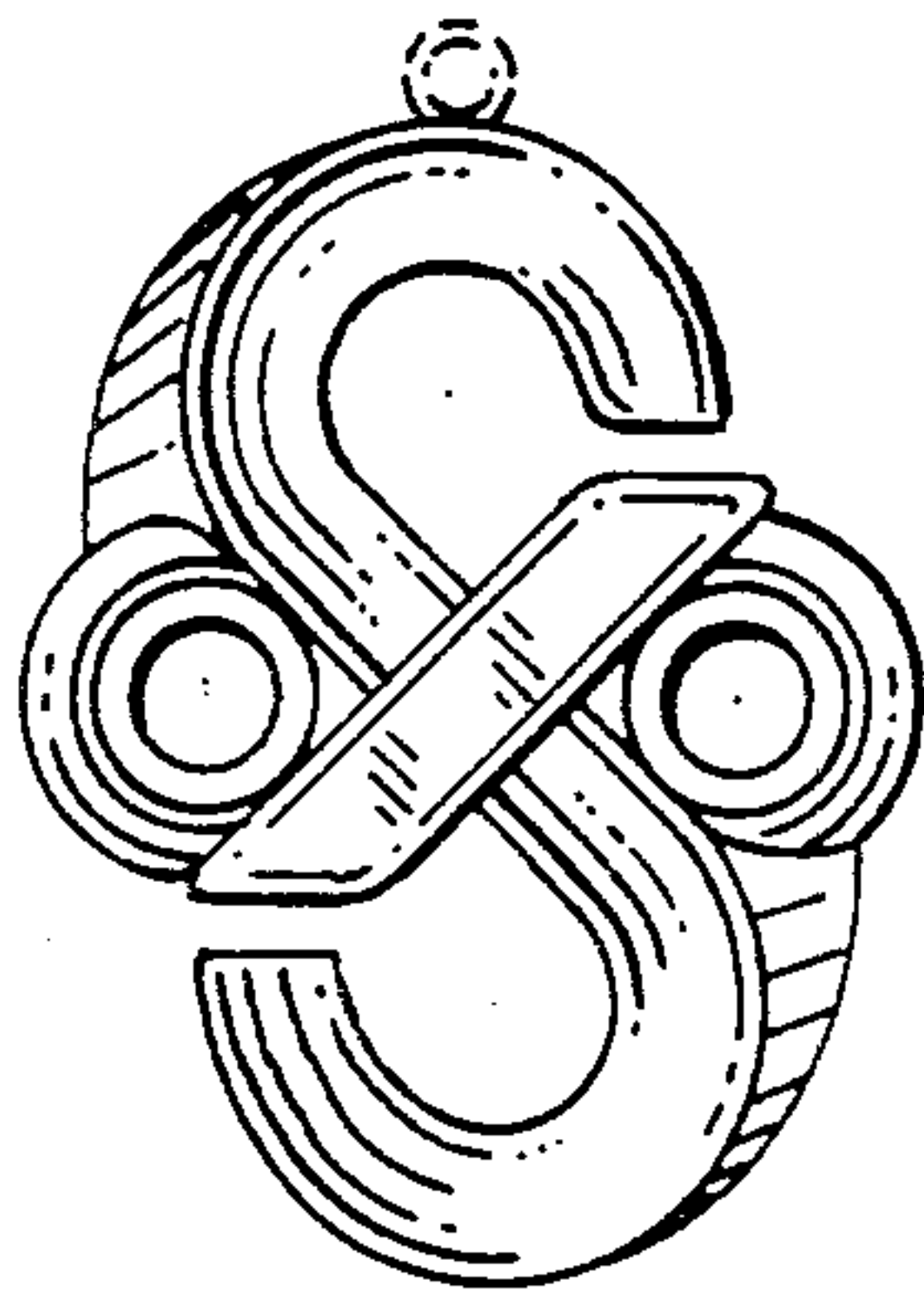

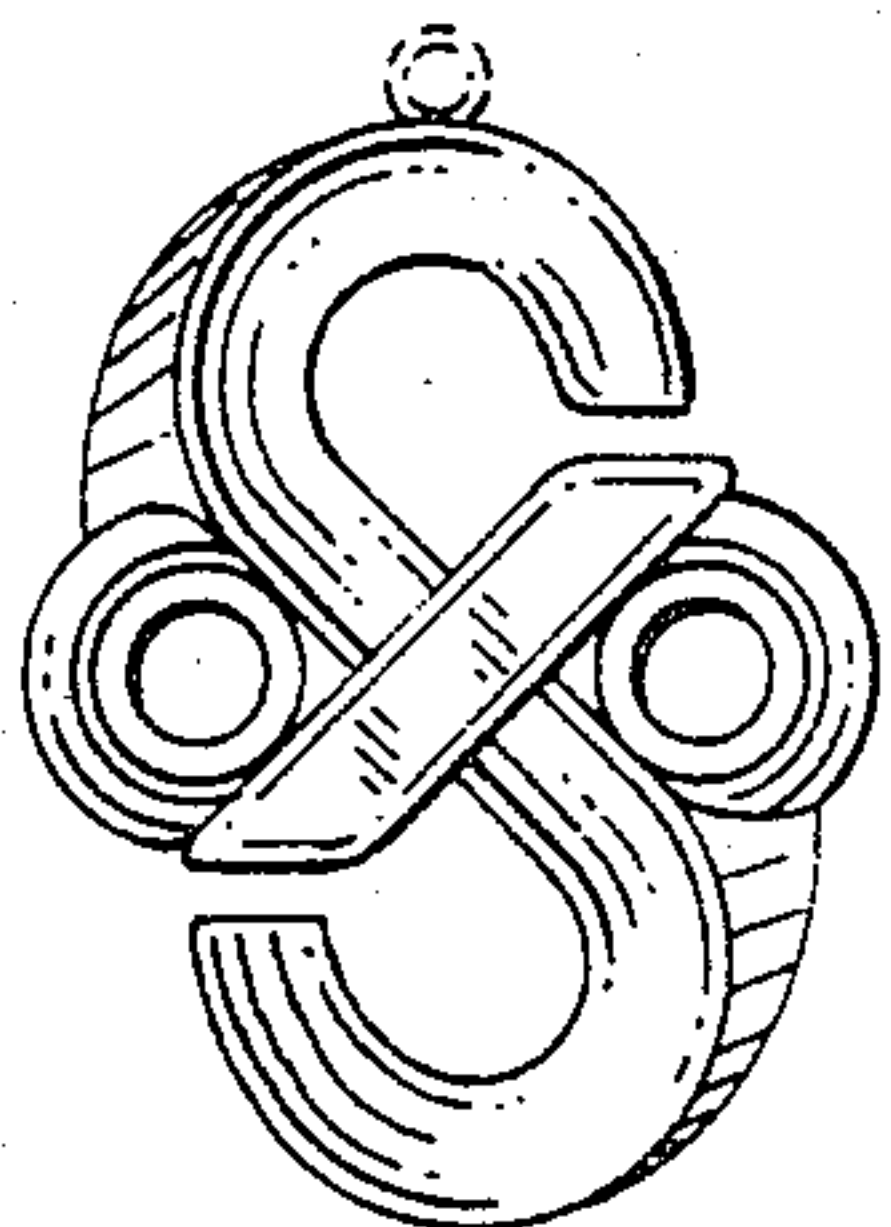

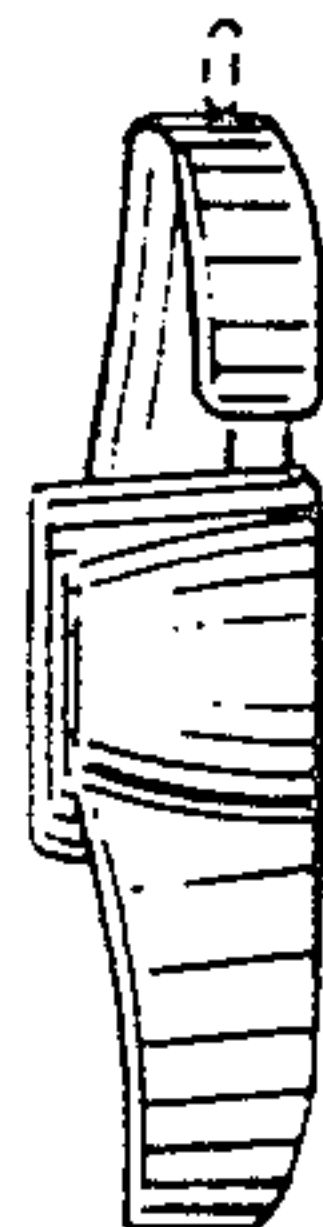
