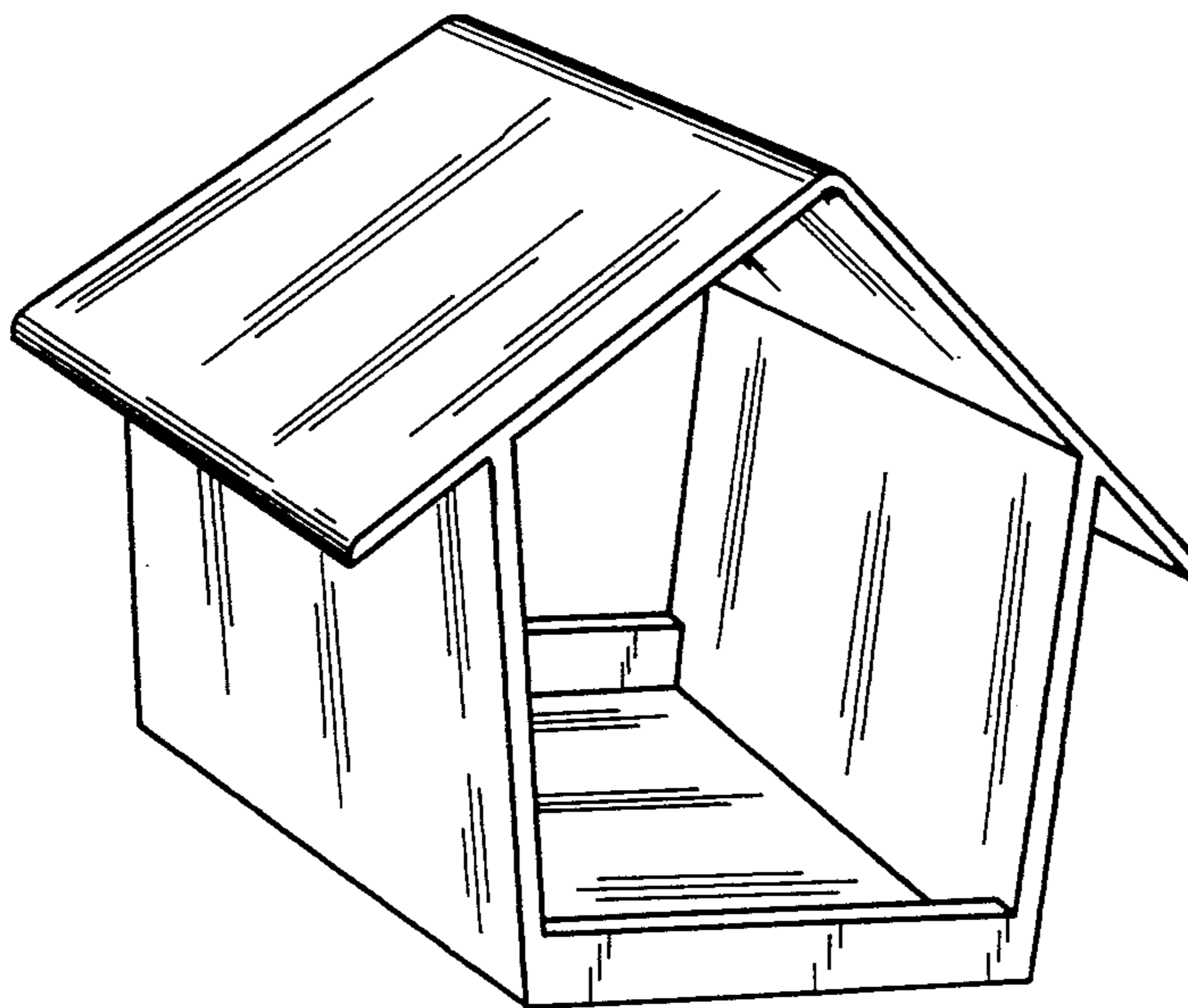

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a desk receptacle for paperclips and sundries, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a desk receptacle for paperclips and sundries showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view, the rear view being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.



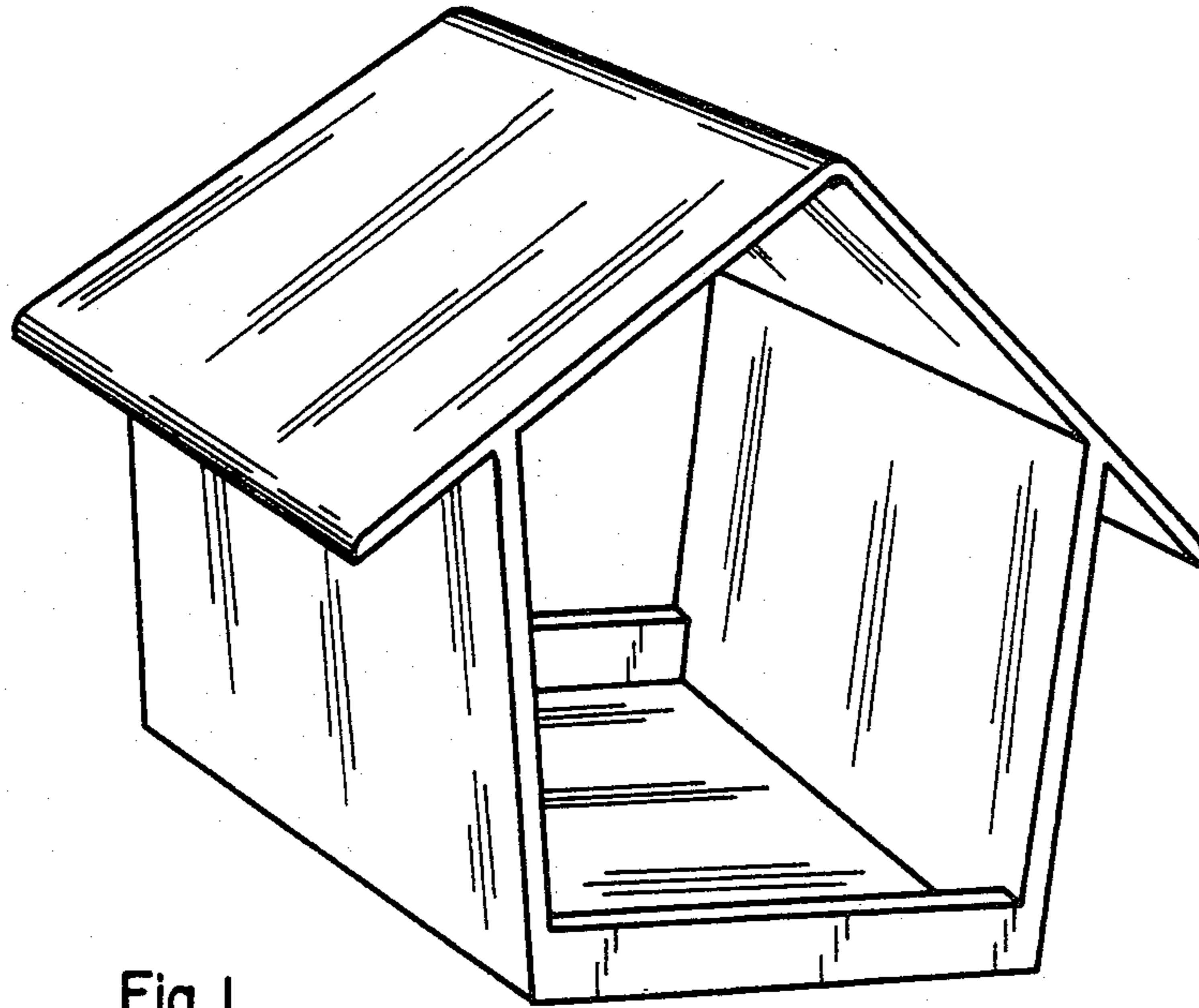

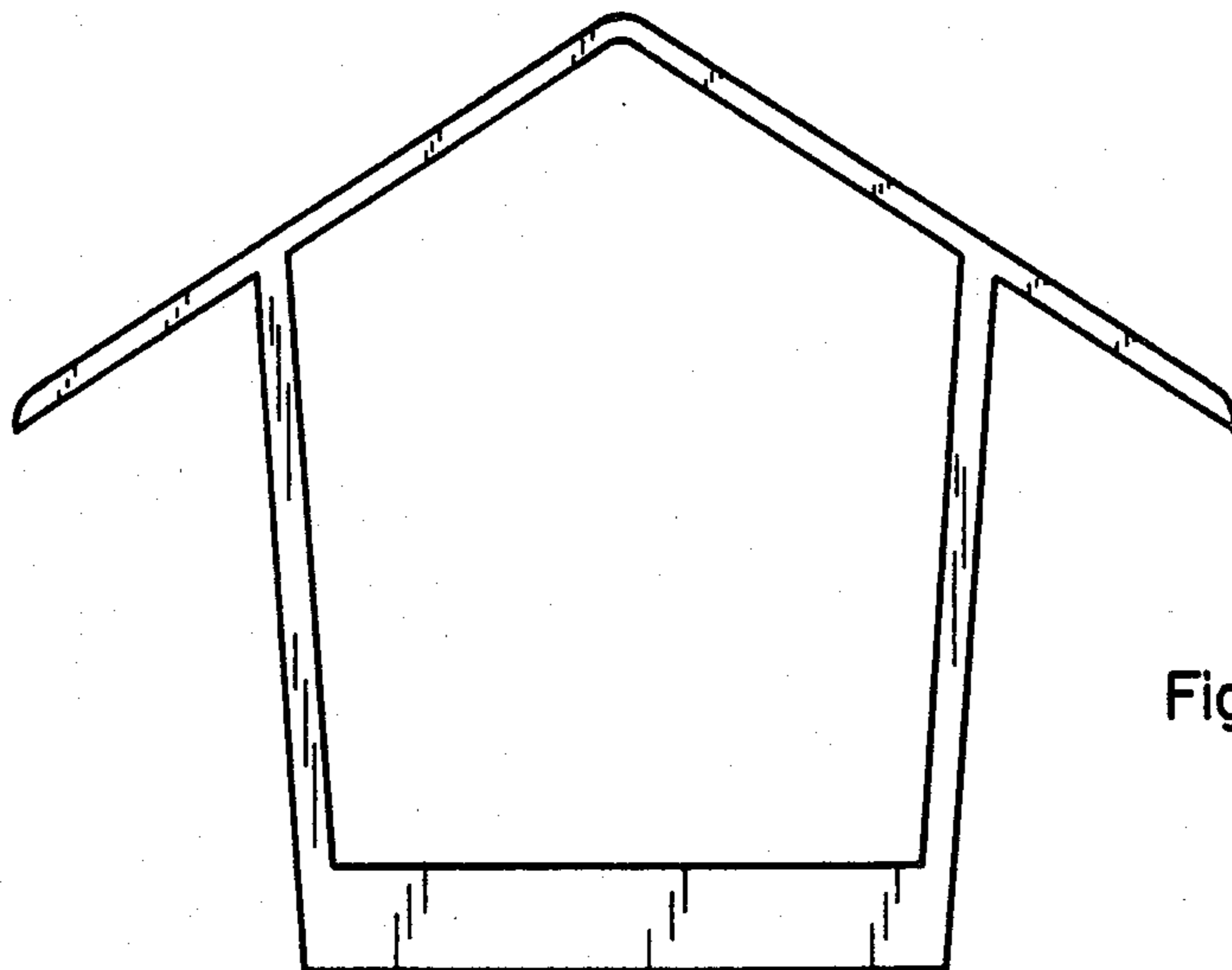

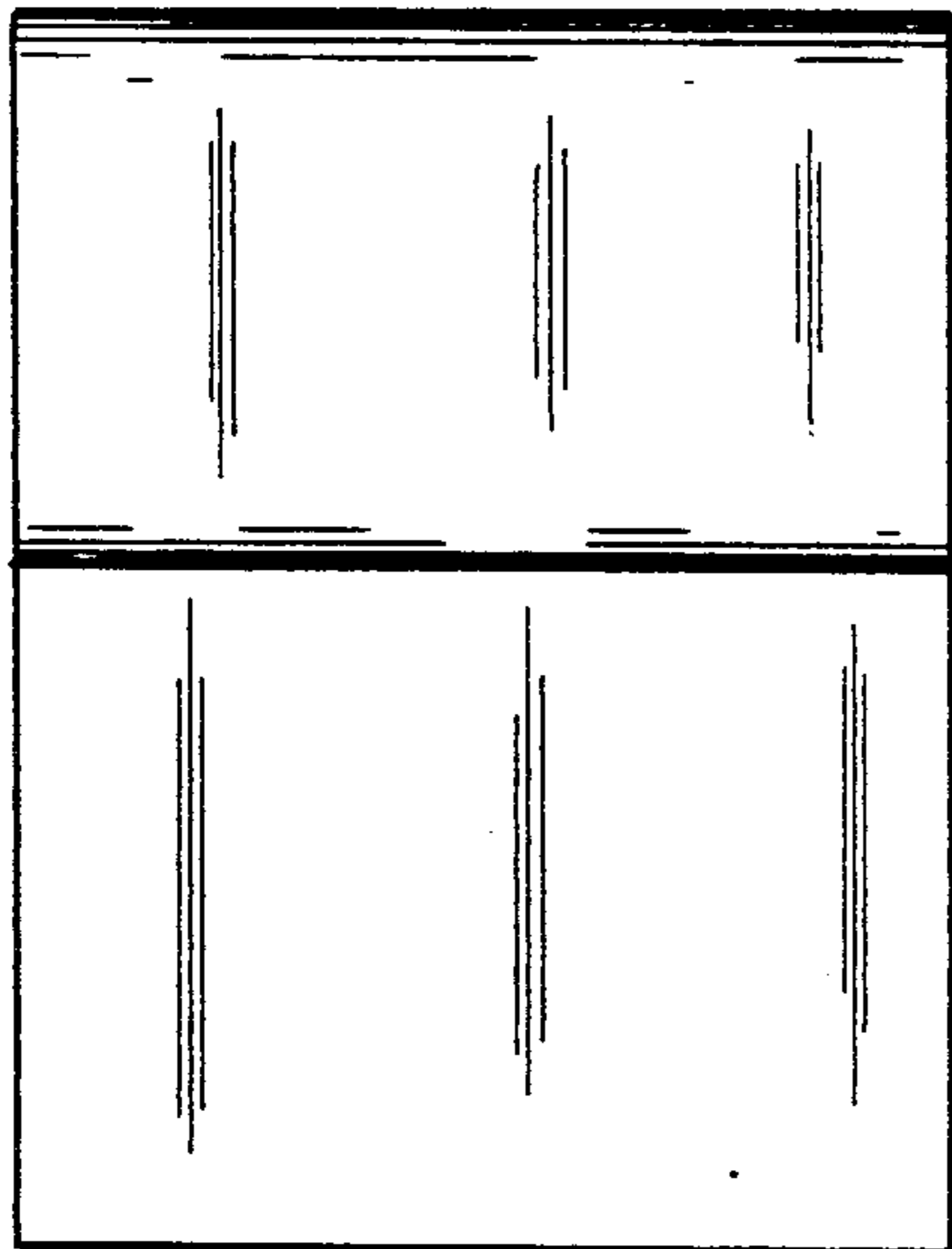

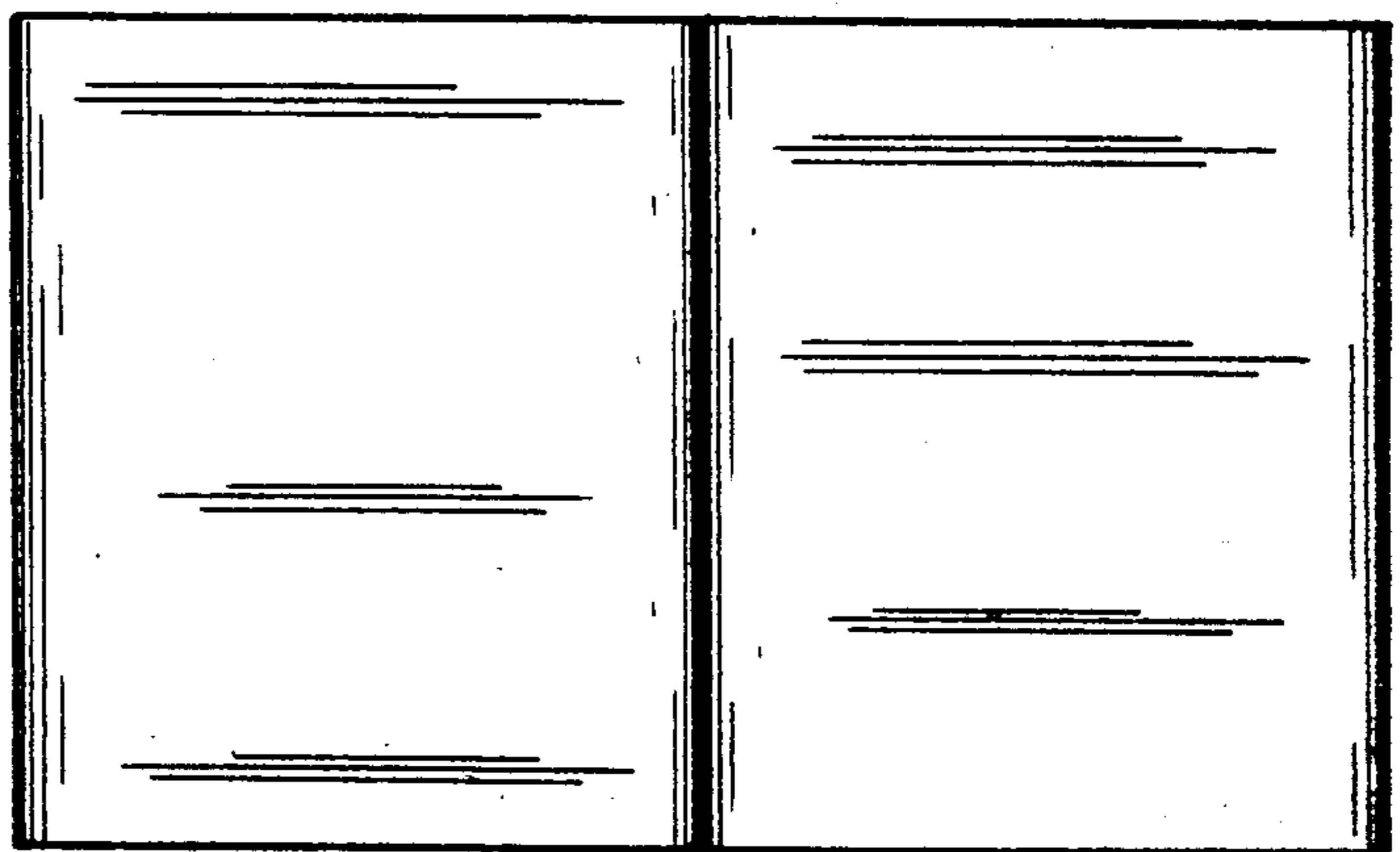

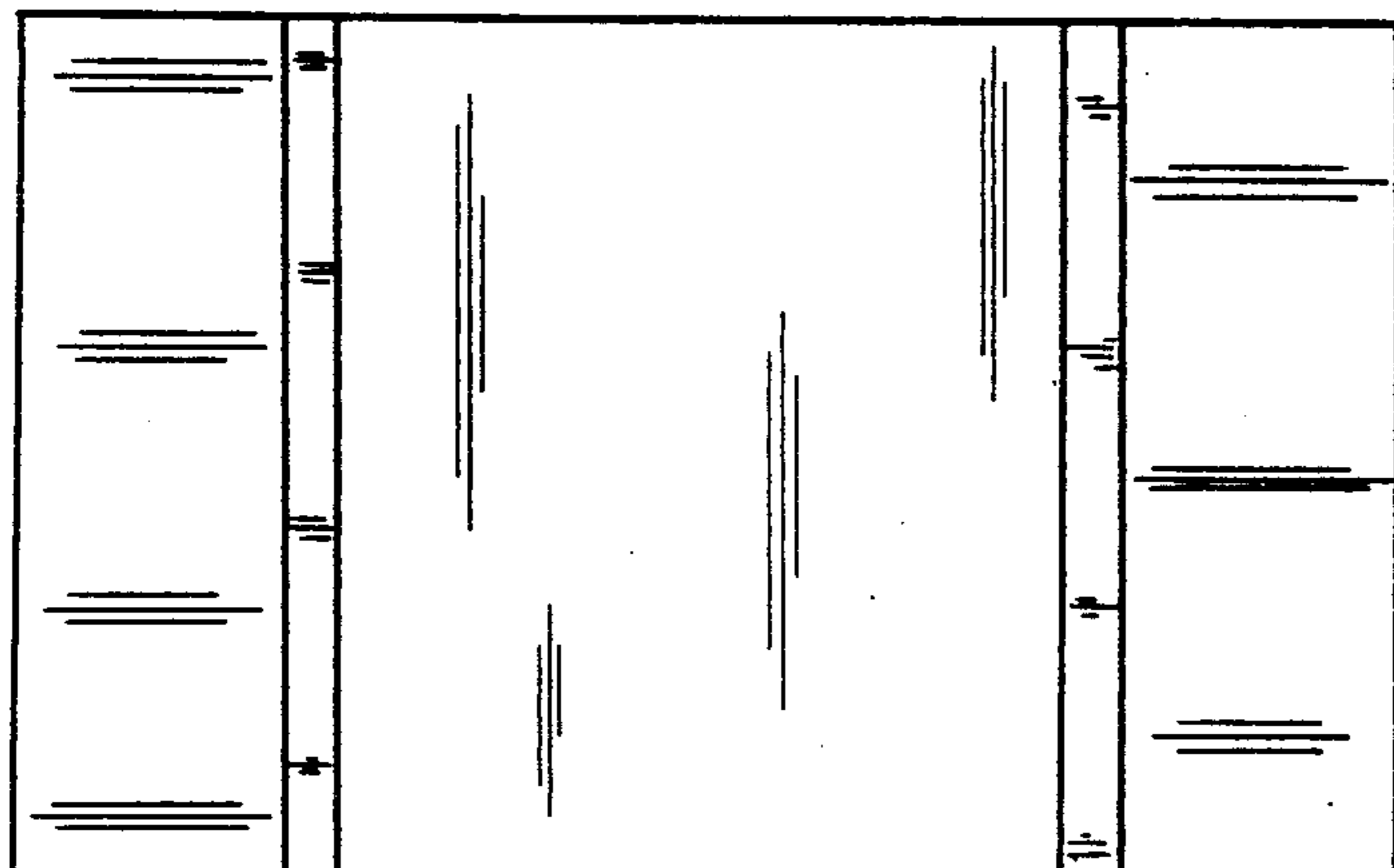
