of FIG. 3.

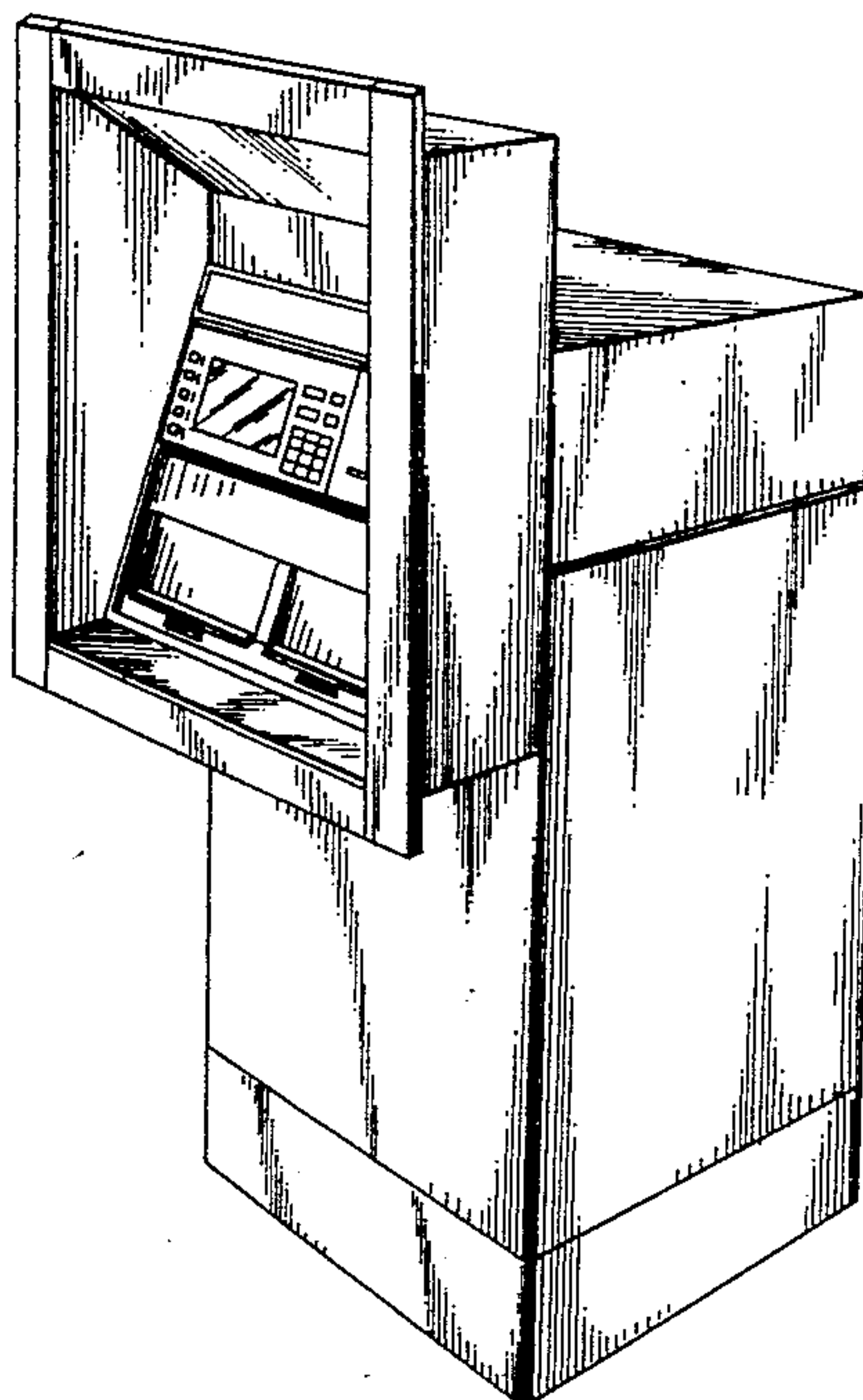

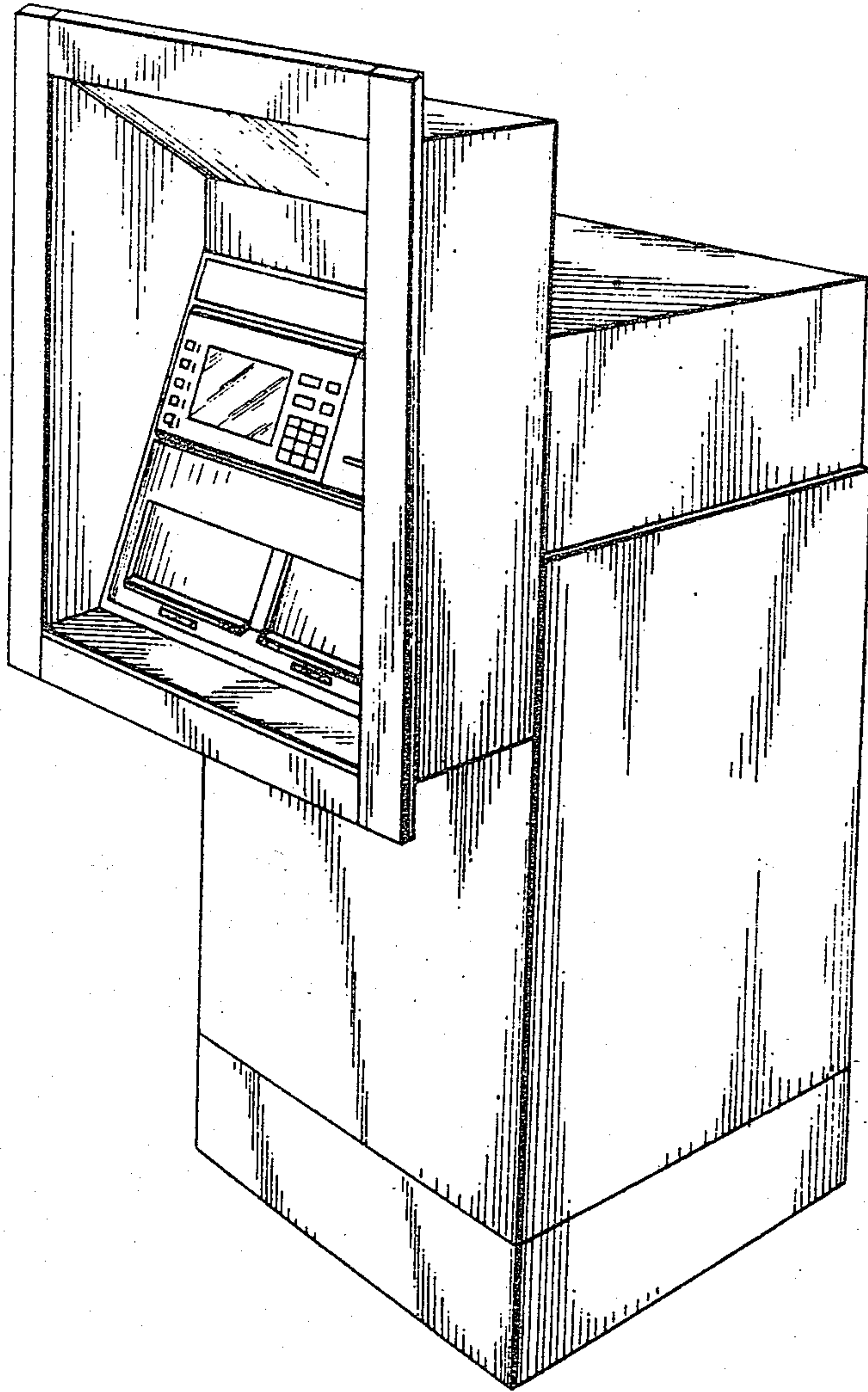

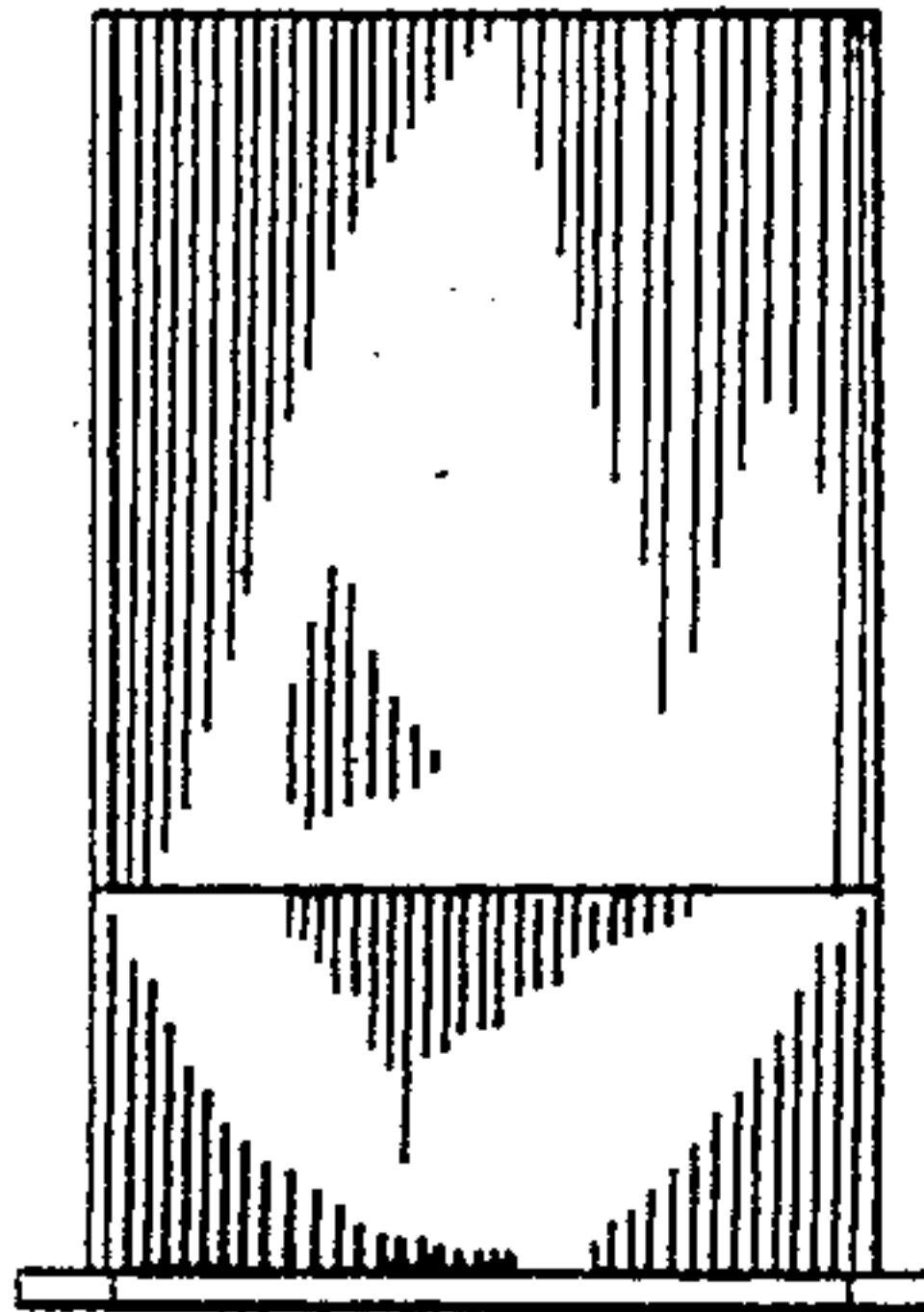
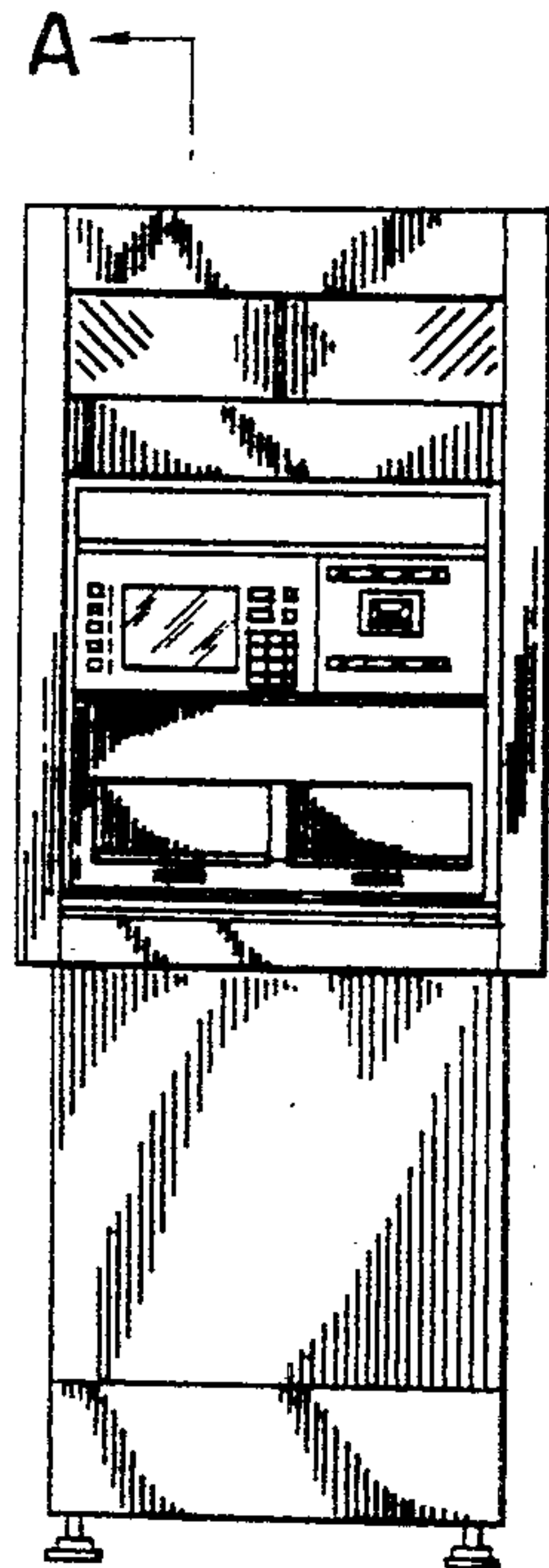

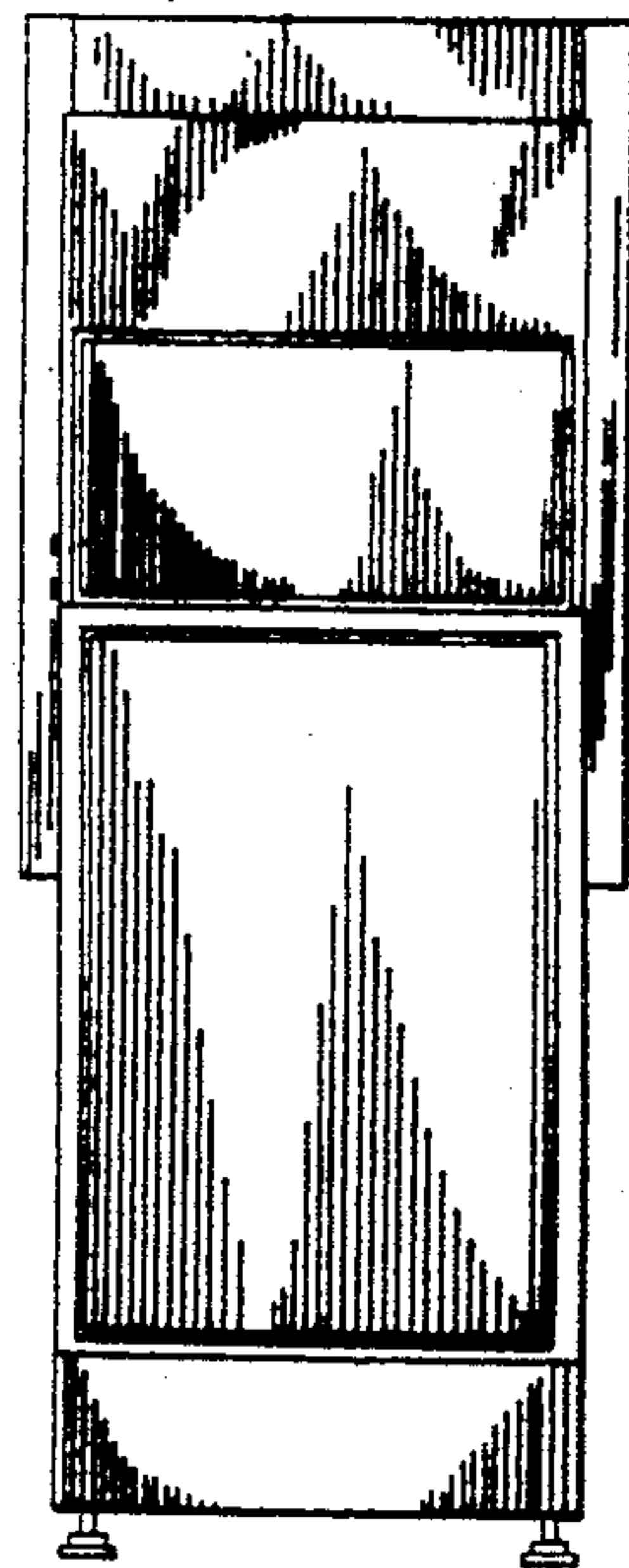

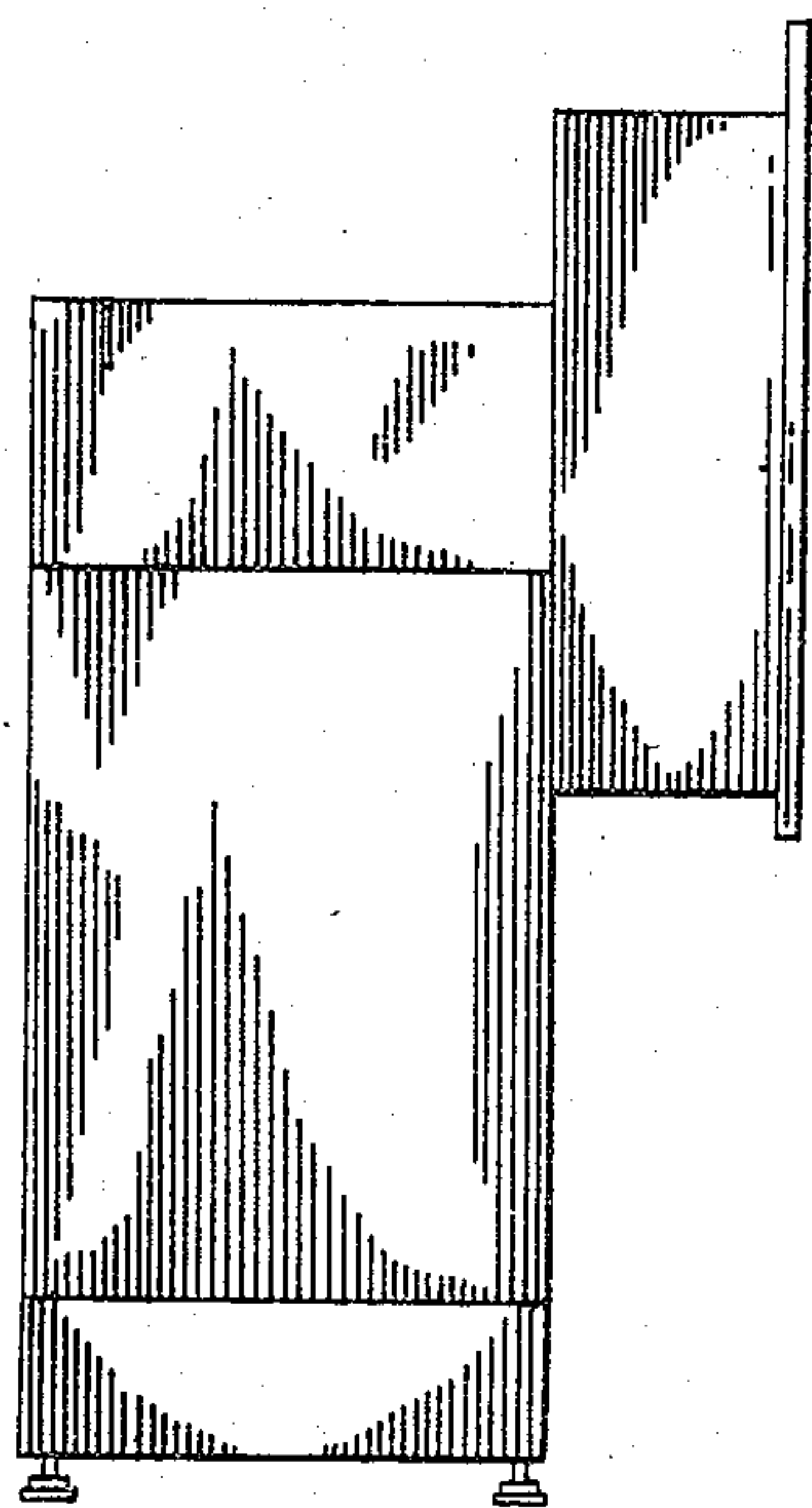

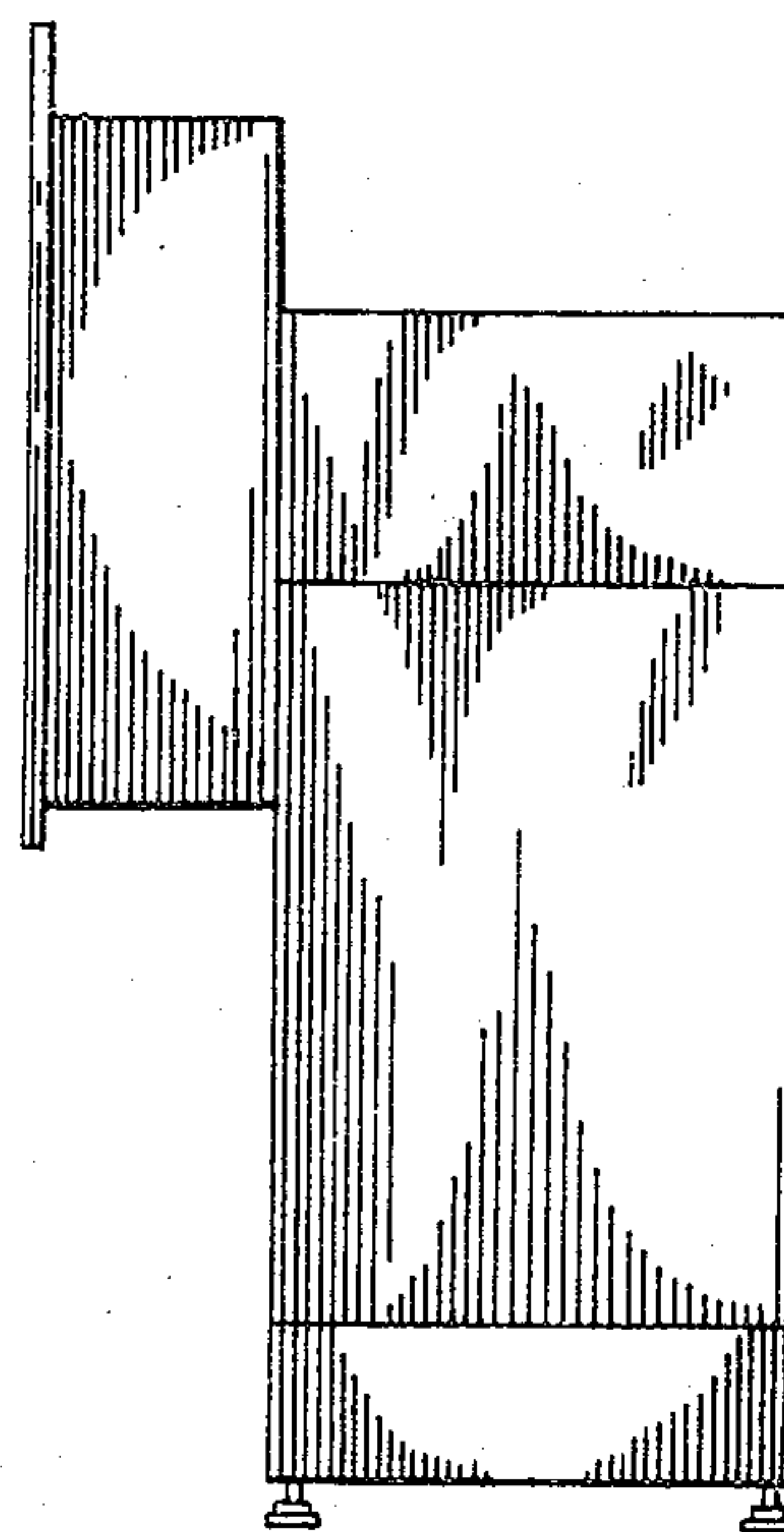

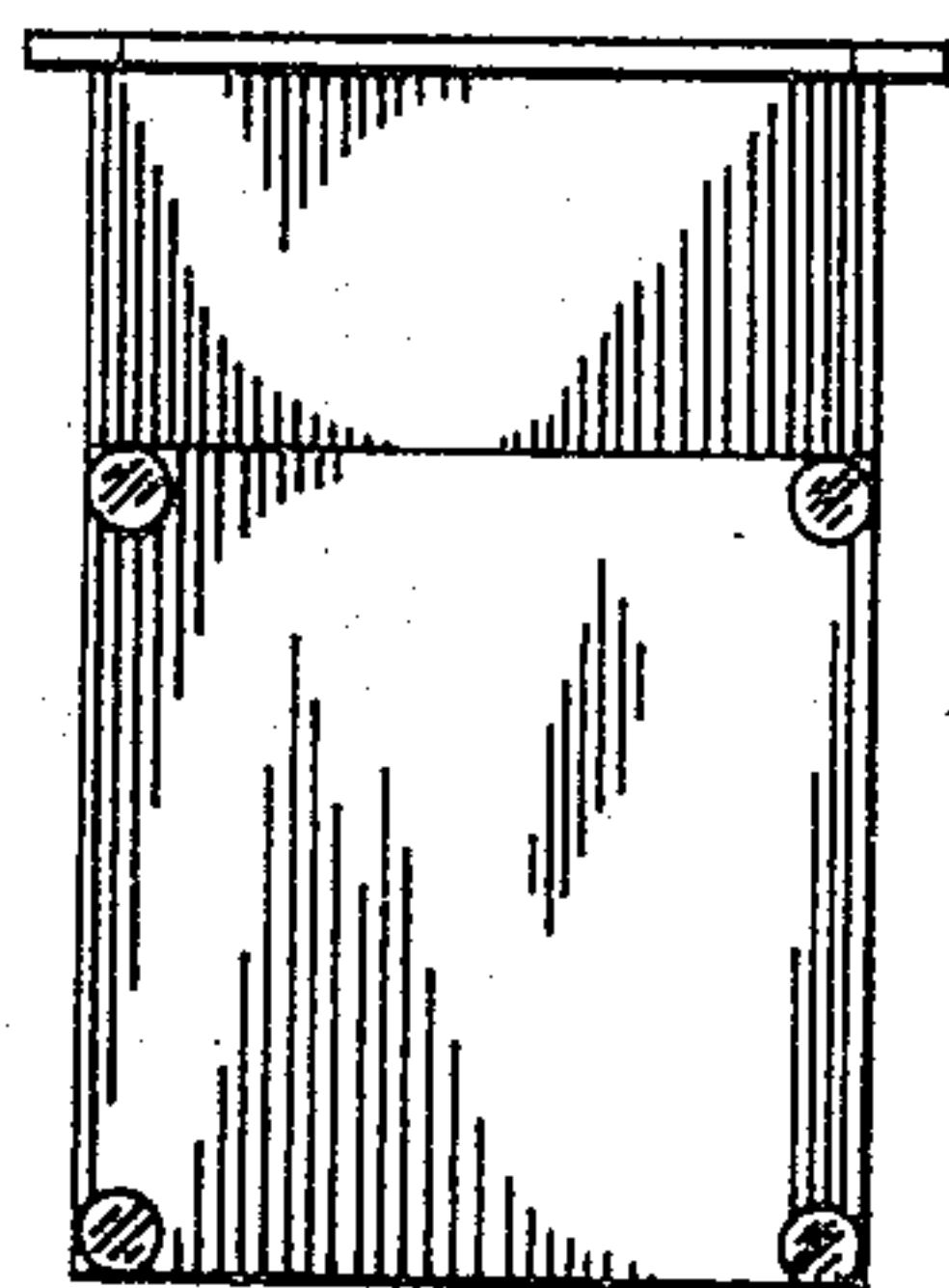
