FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a chair for use primarily by a draftsman in accordance with the invention;

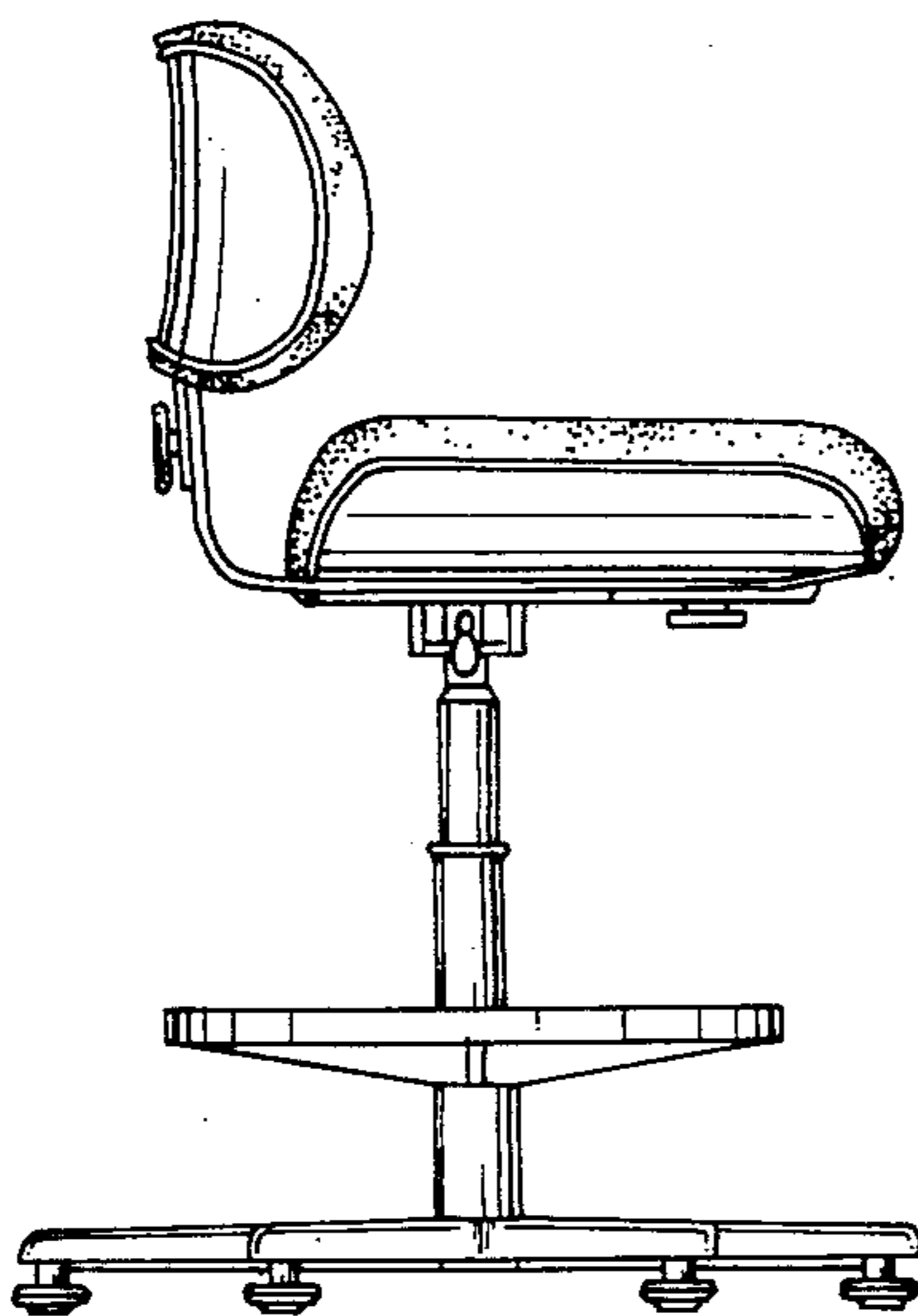
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



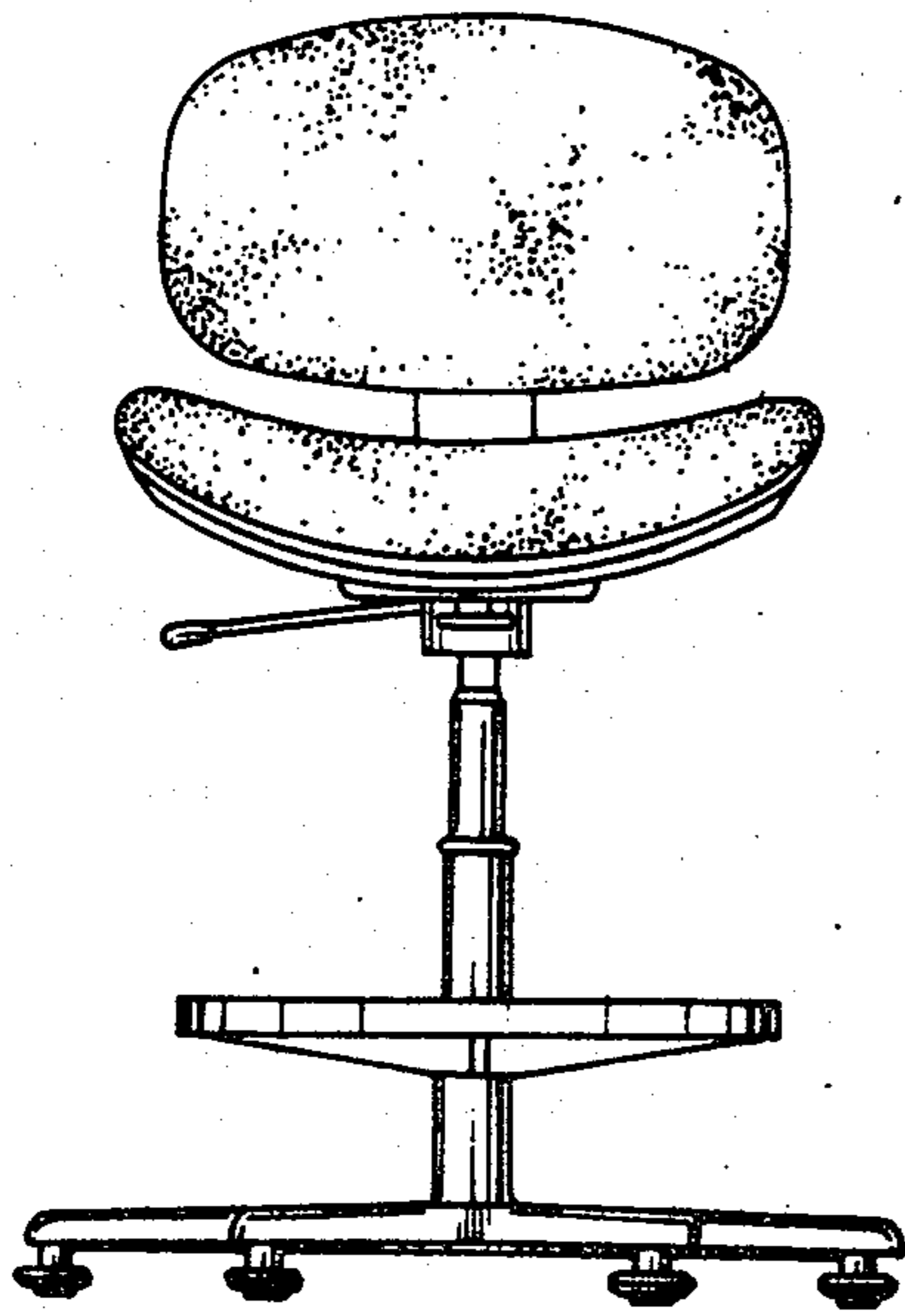

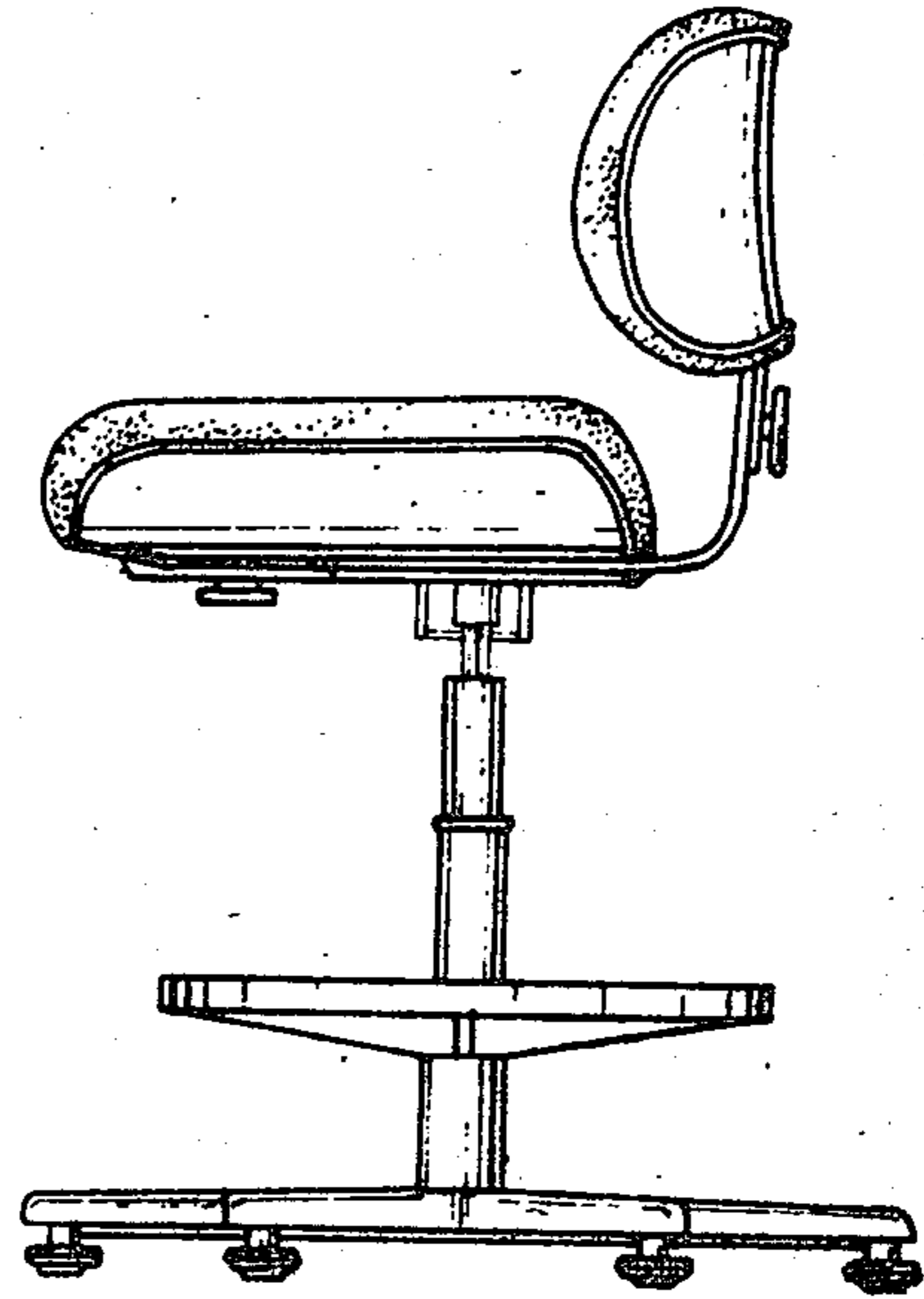

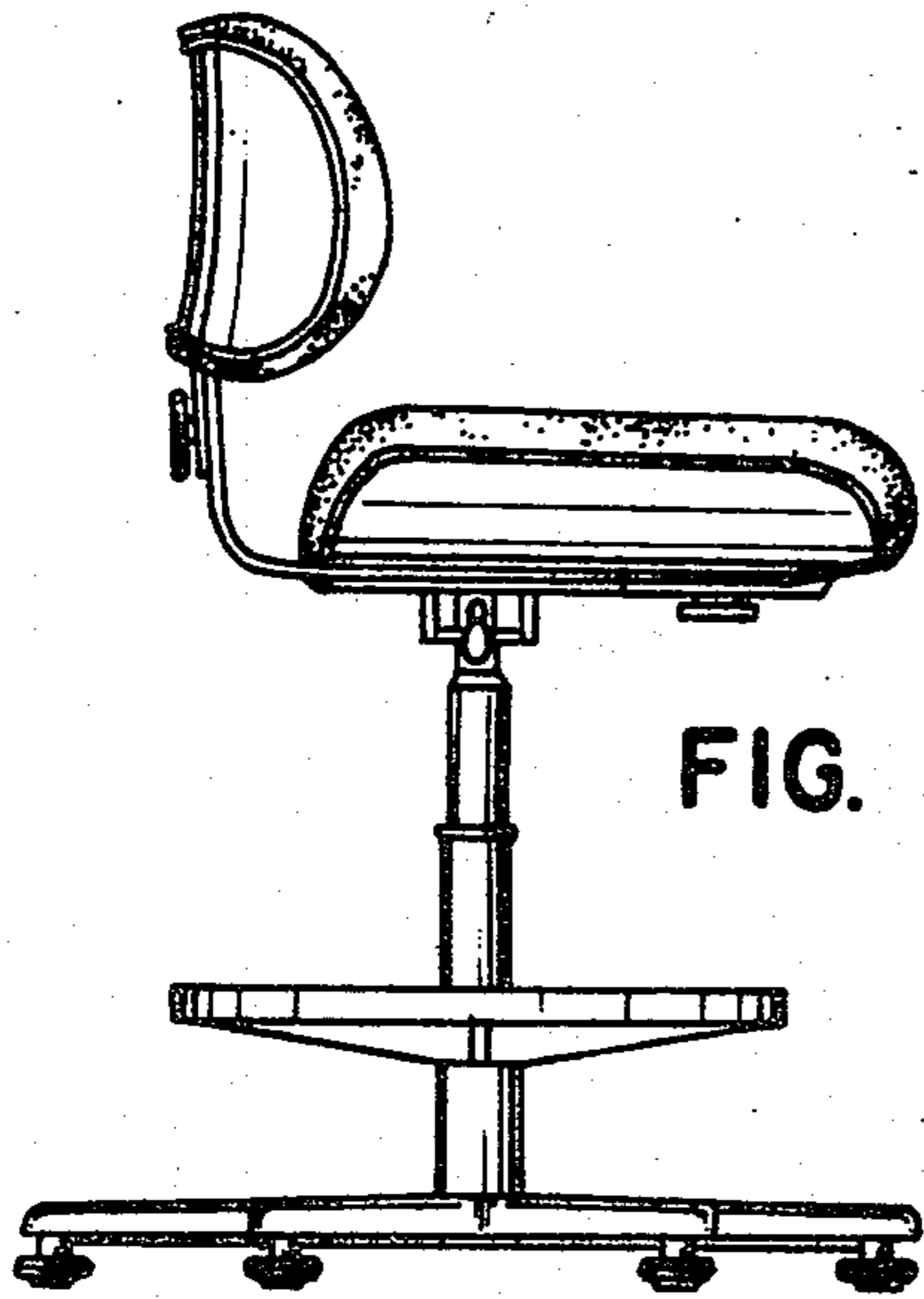

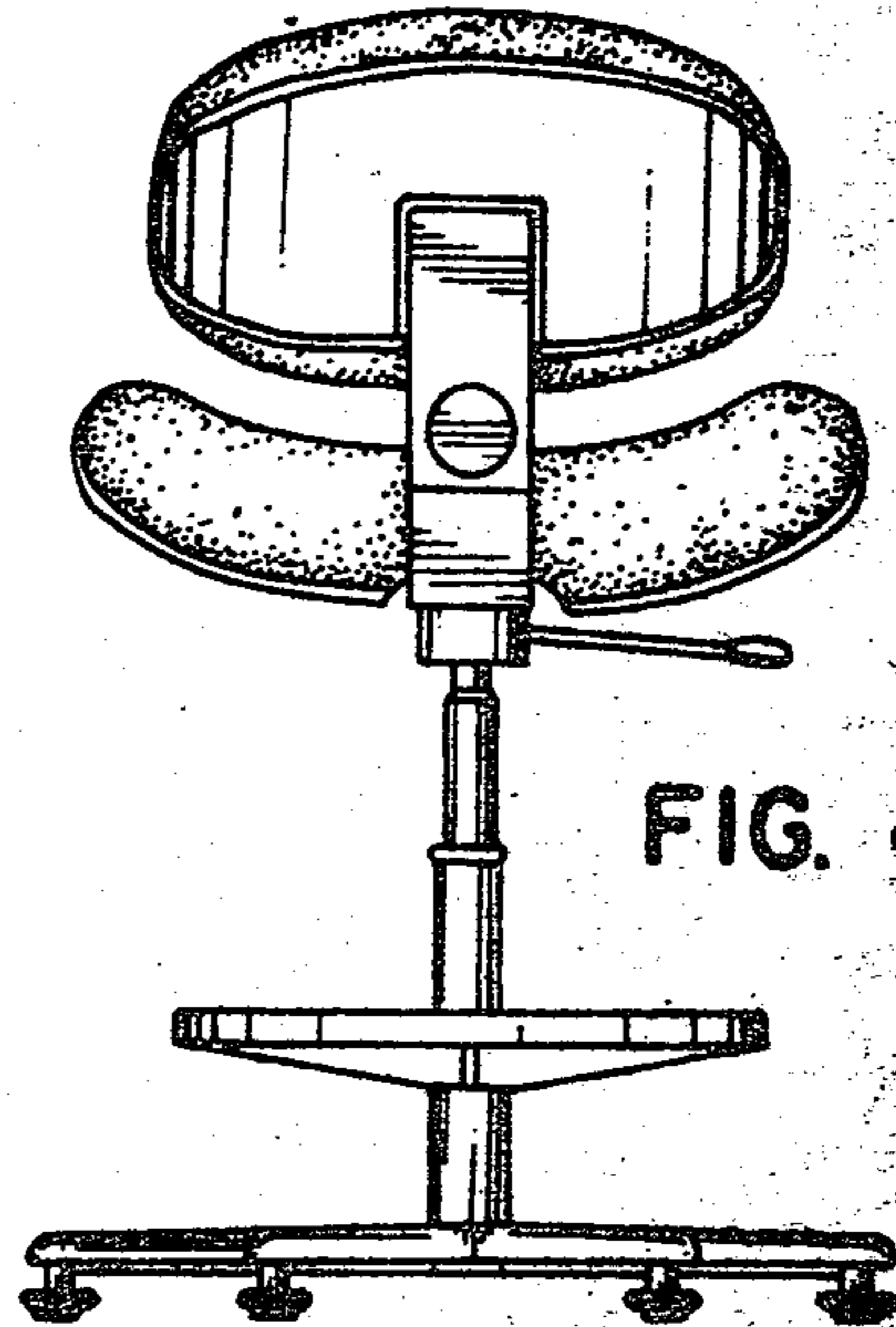

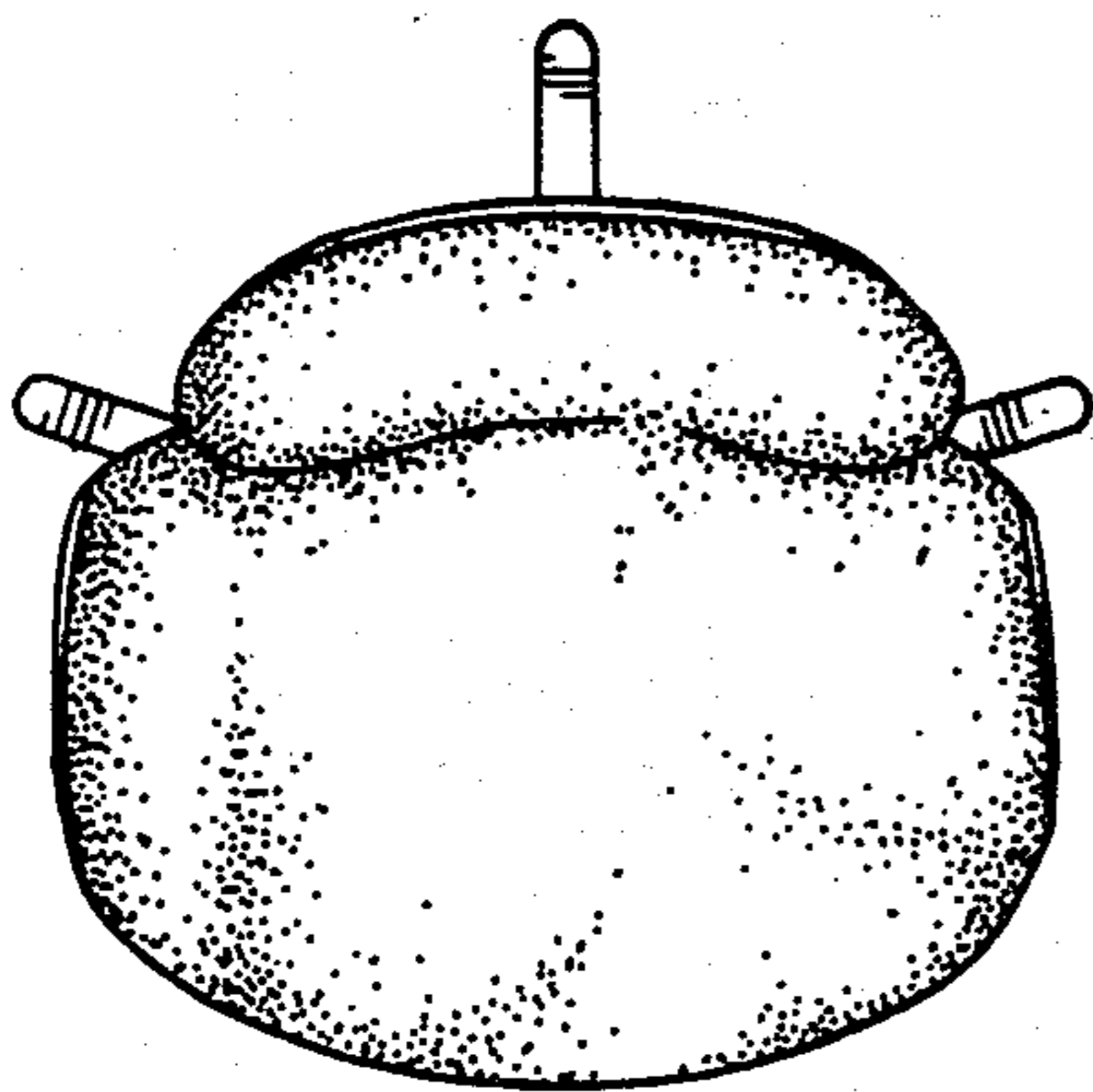

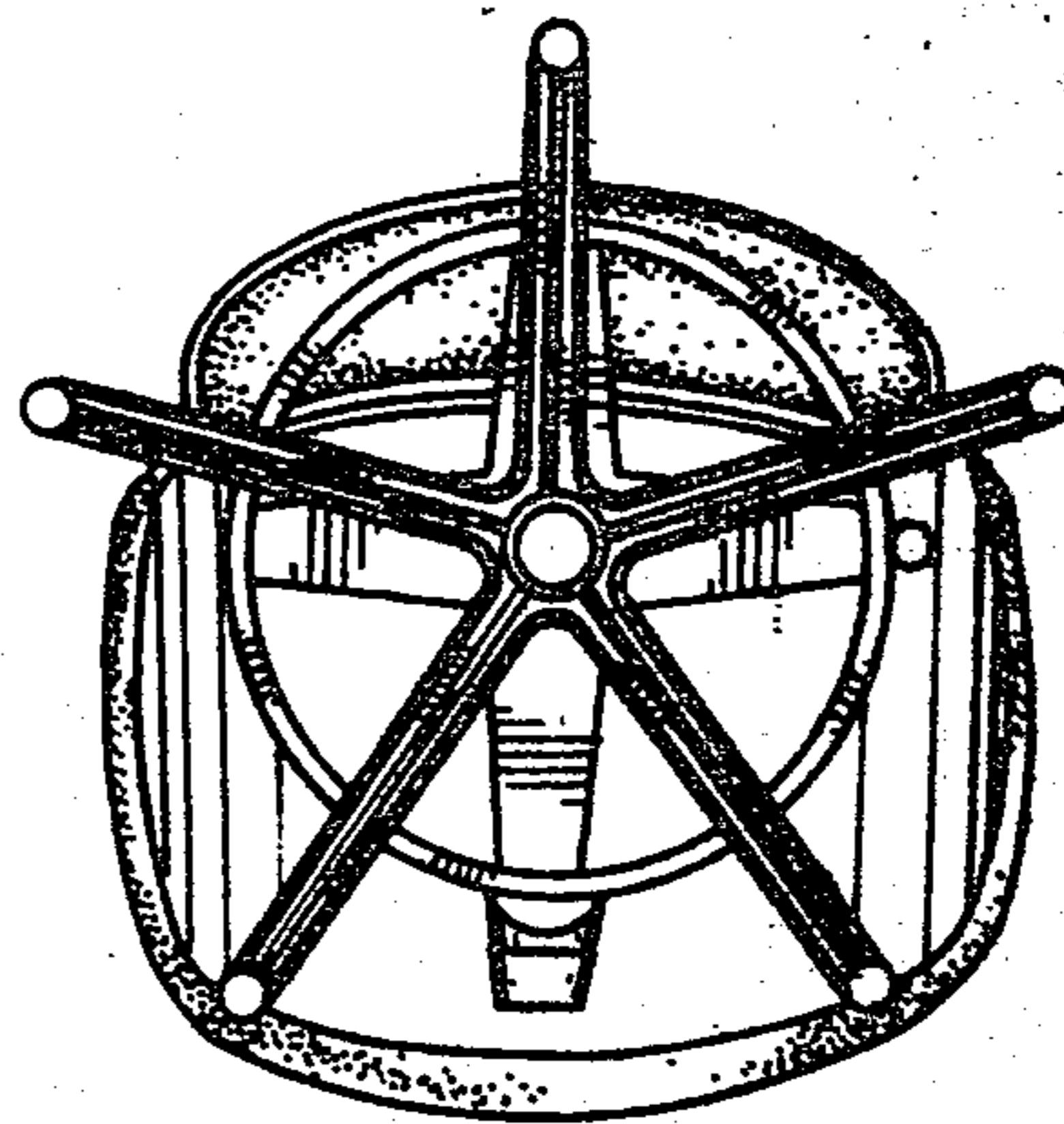
