The ornamental design for stadium cushion, as shown.

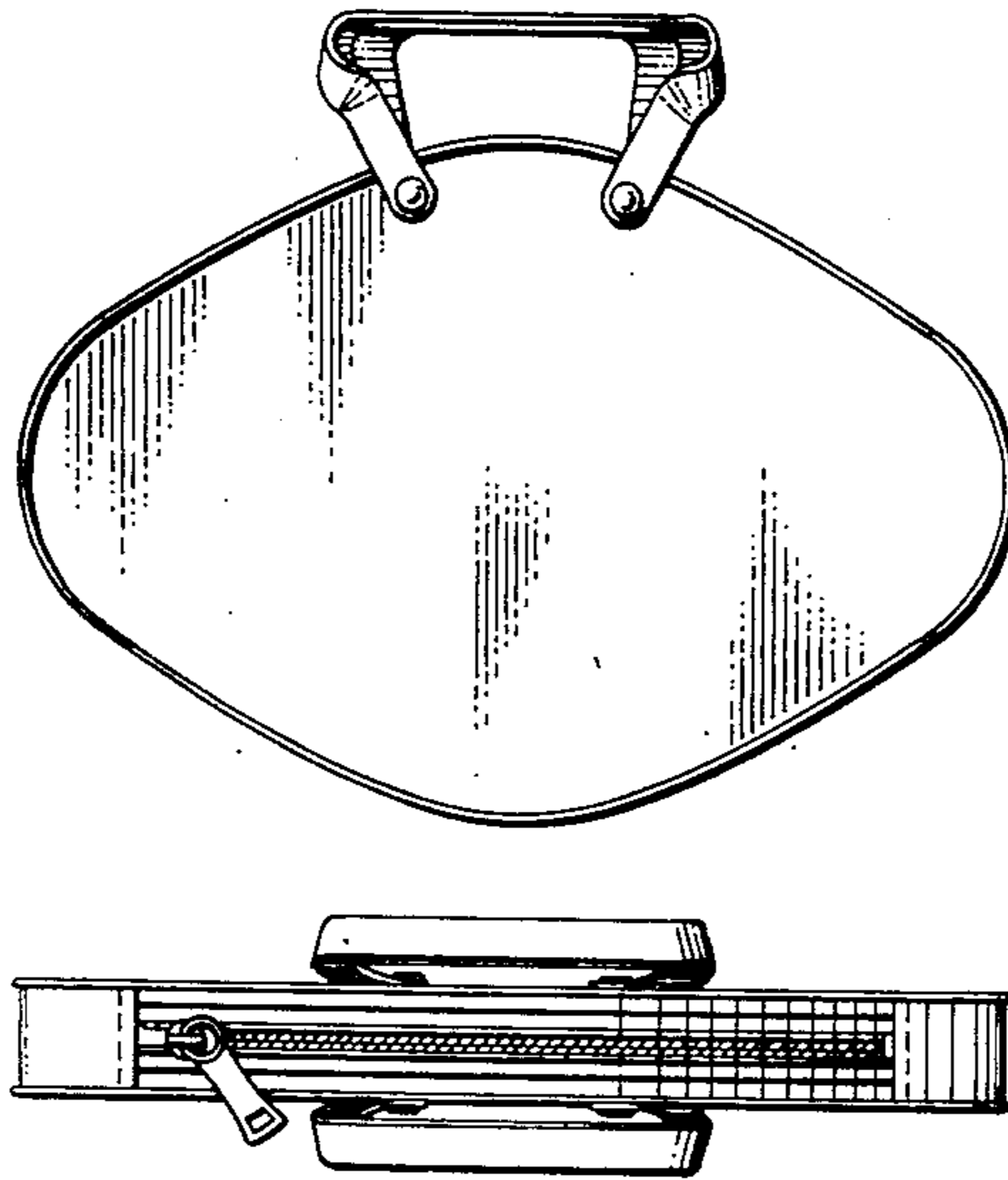
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof.



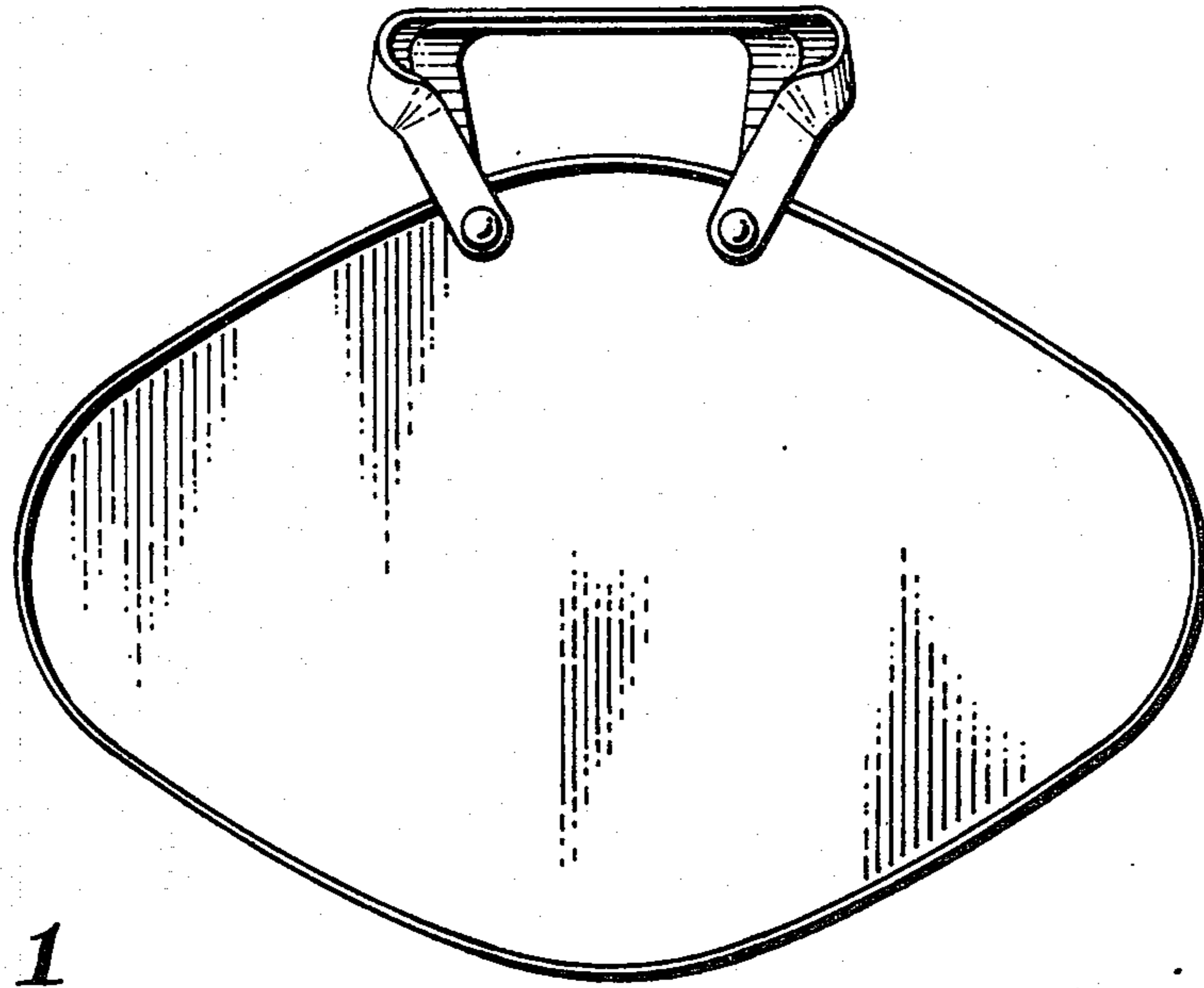

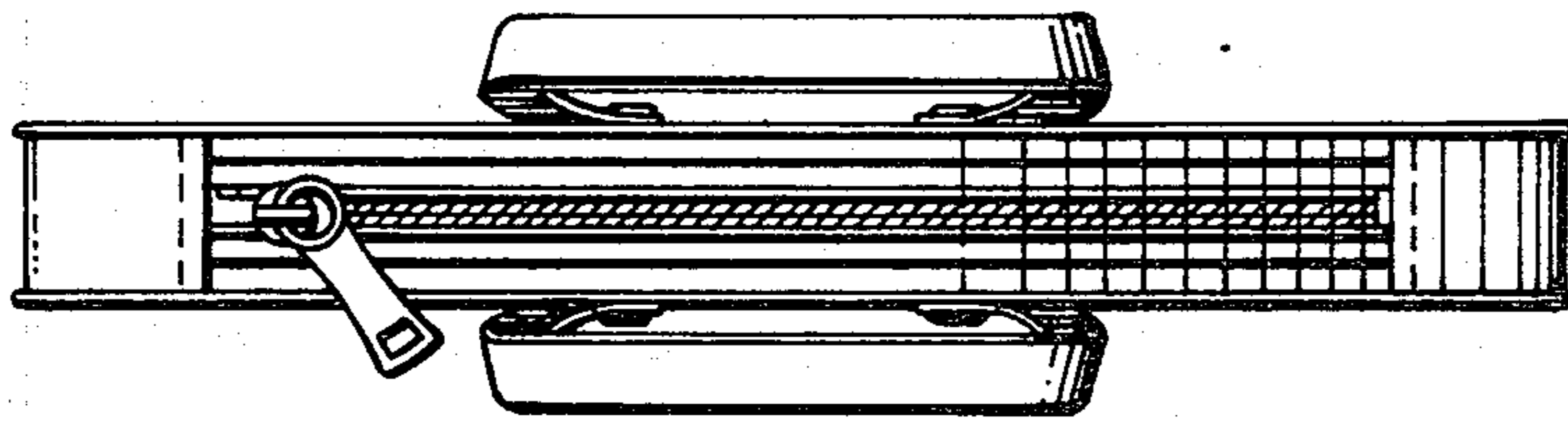

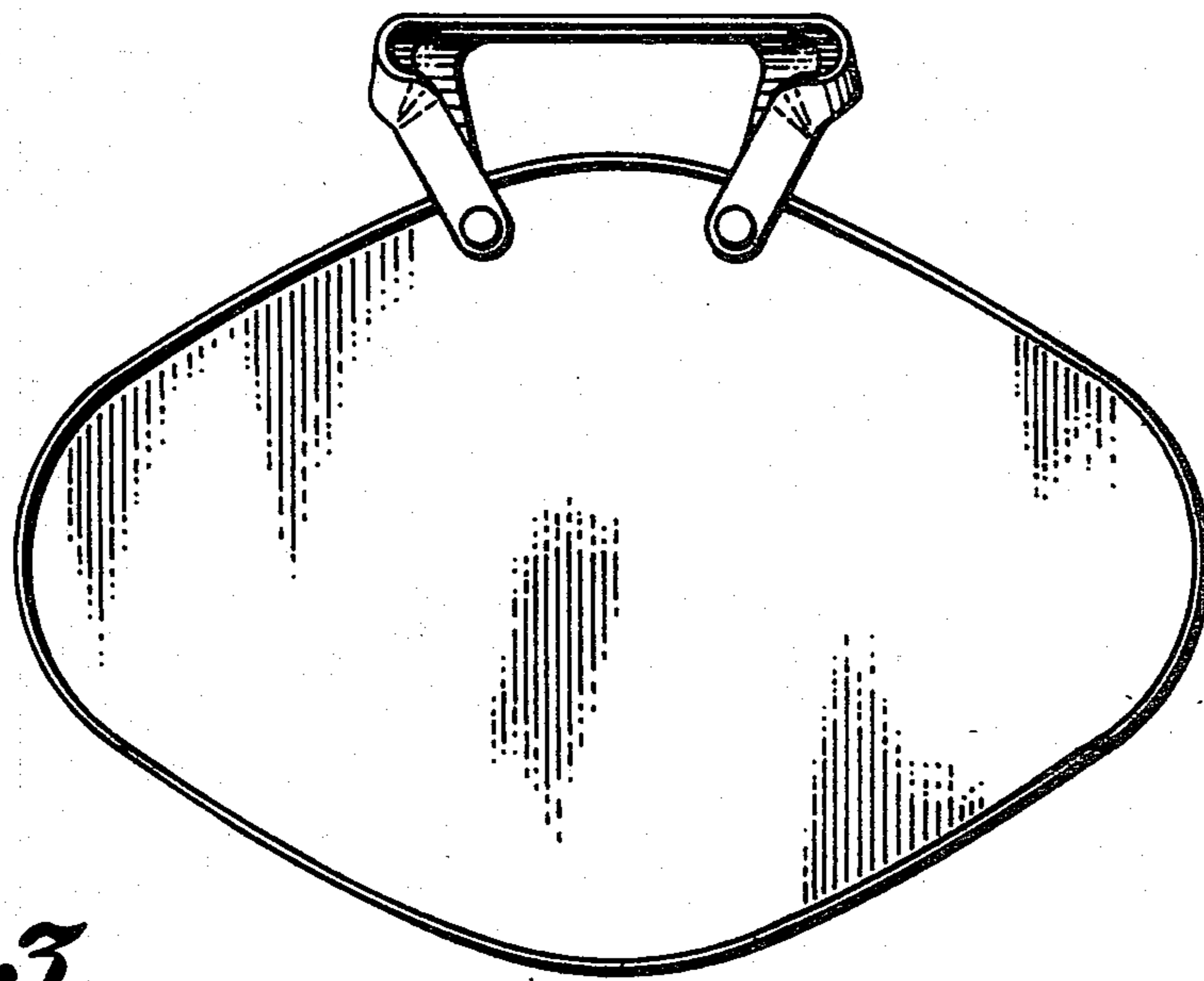

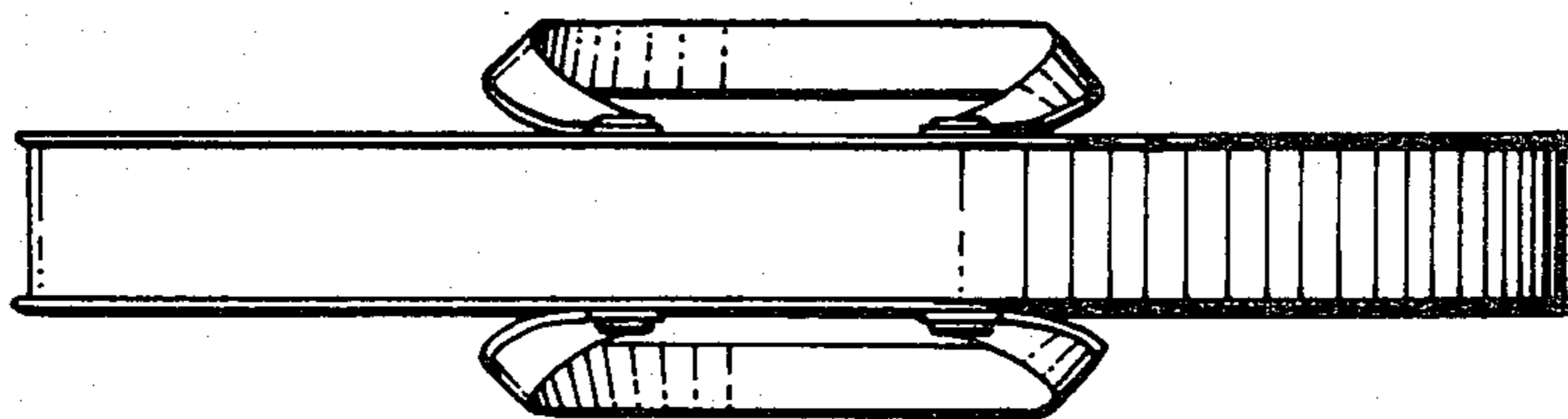
