FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the opposite side thereof.

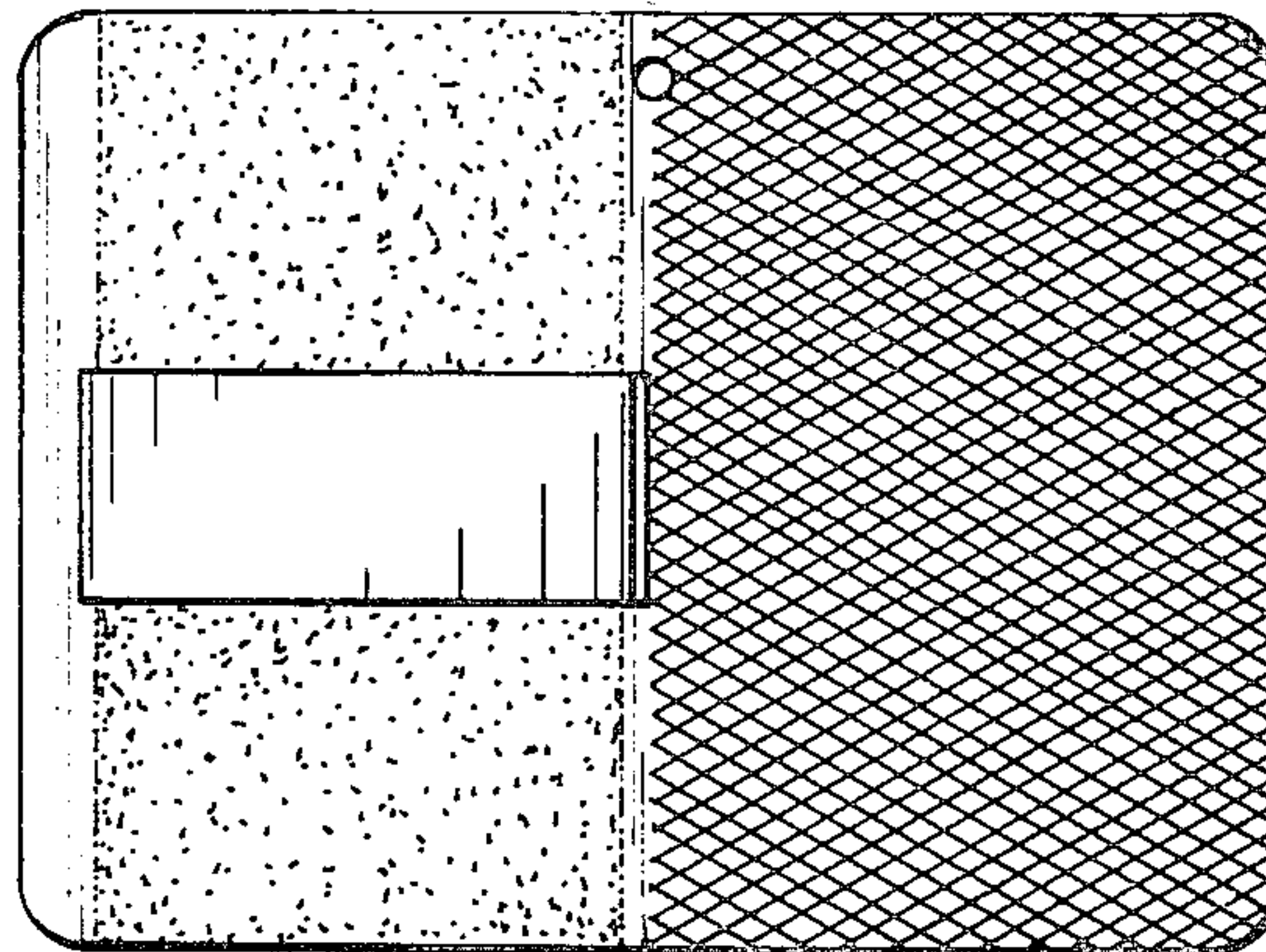
FIG. 5 is an elevational view of one end thereof.

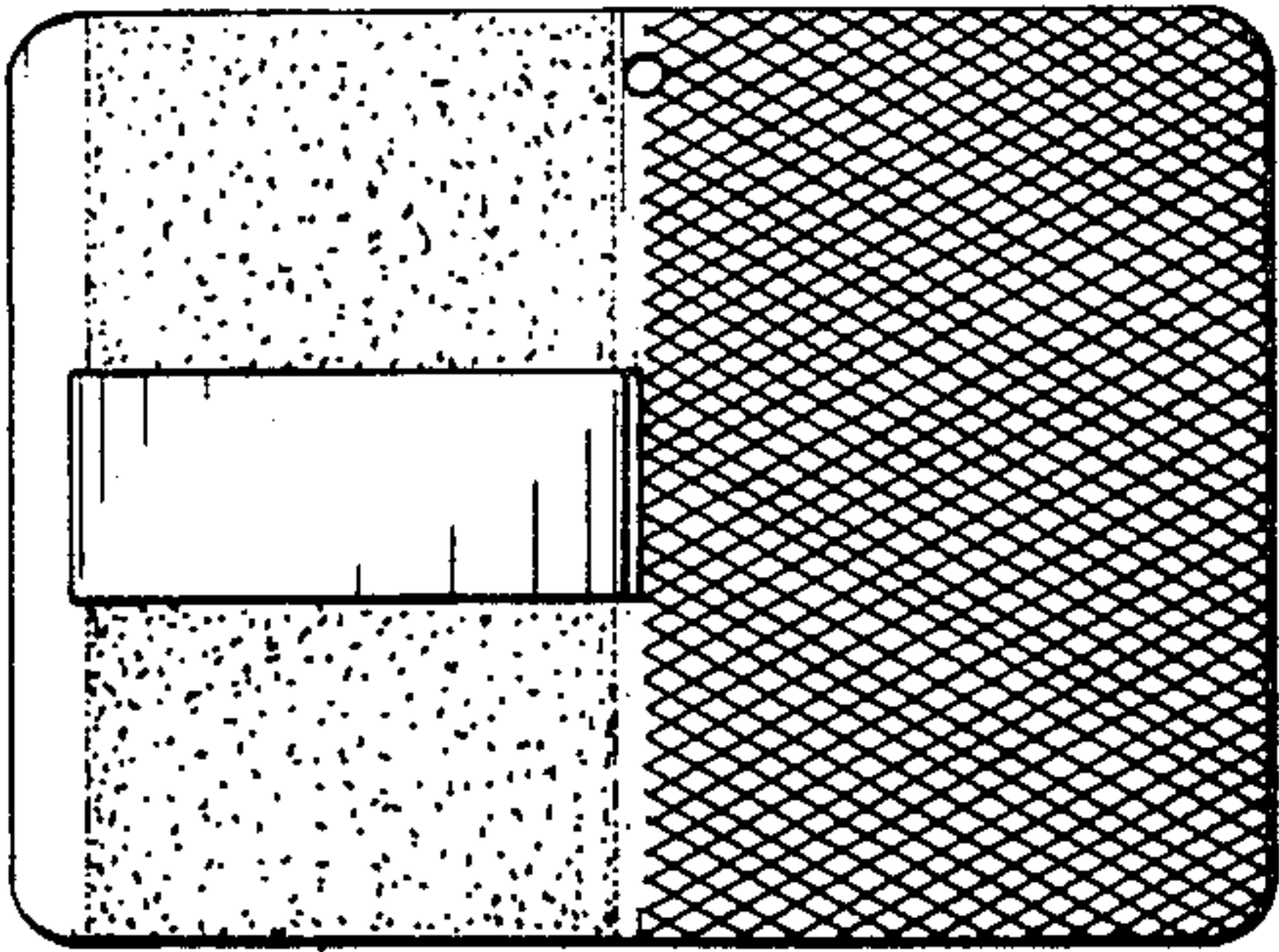

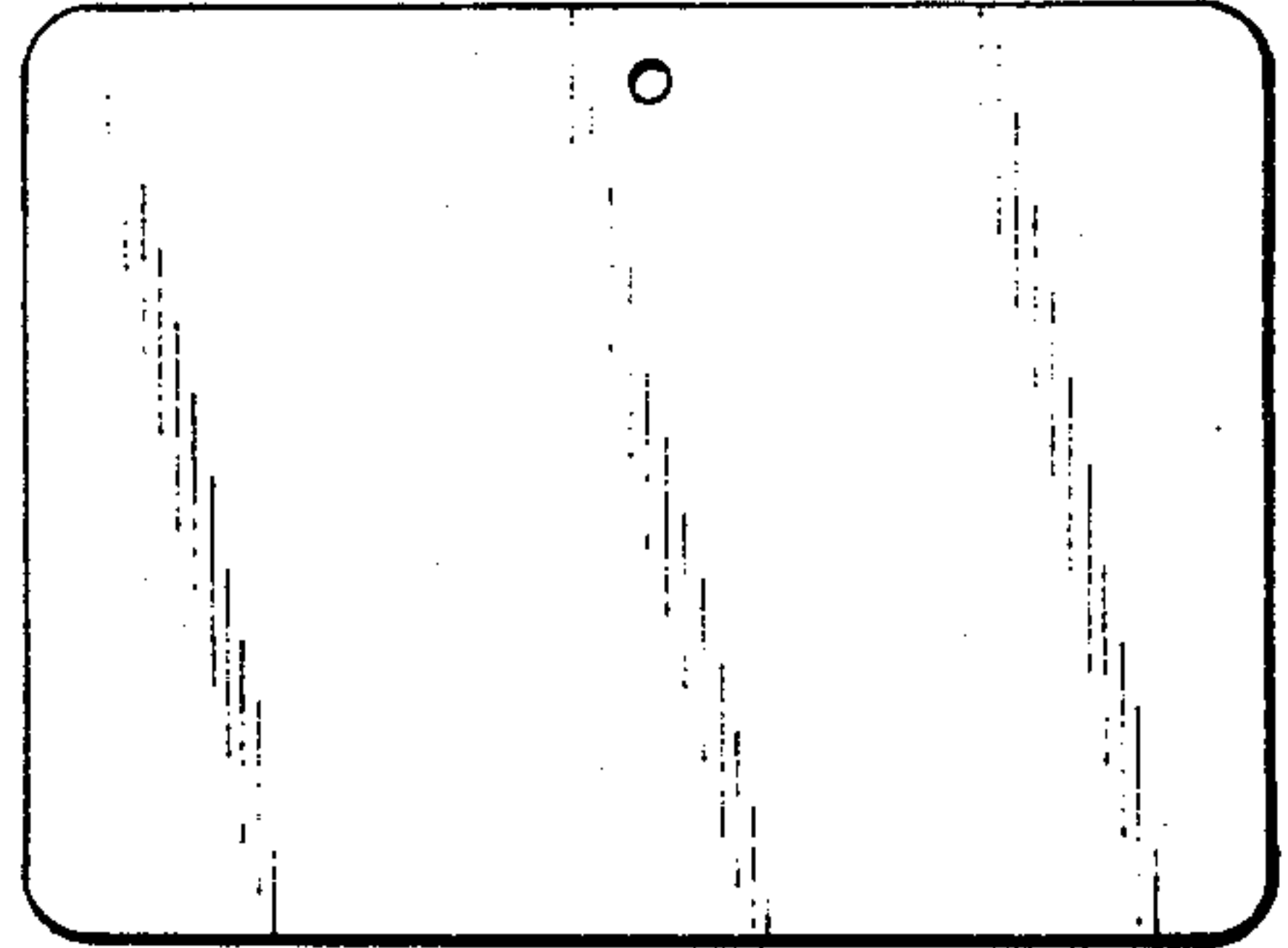

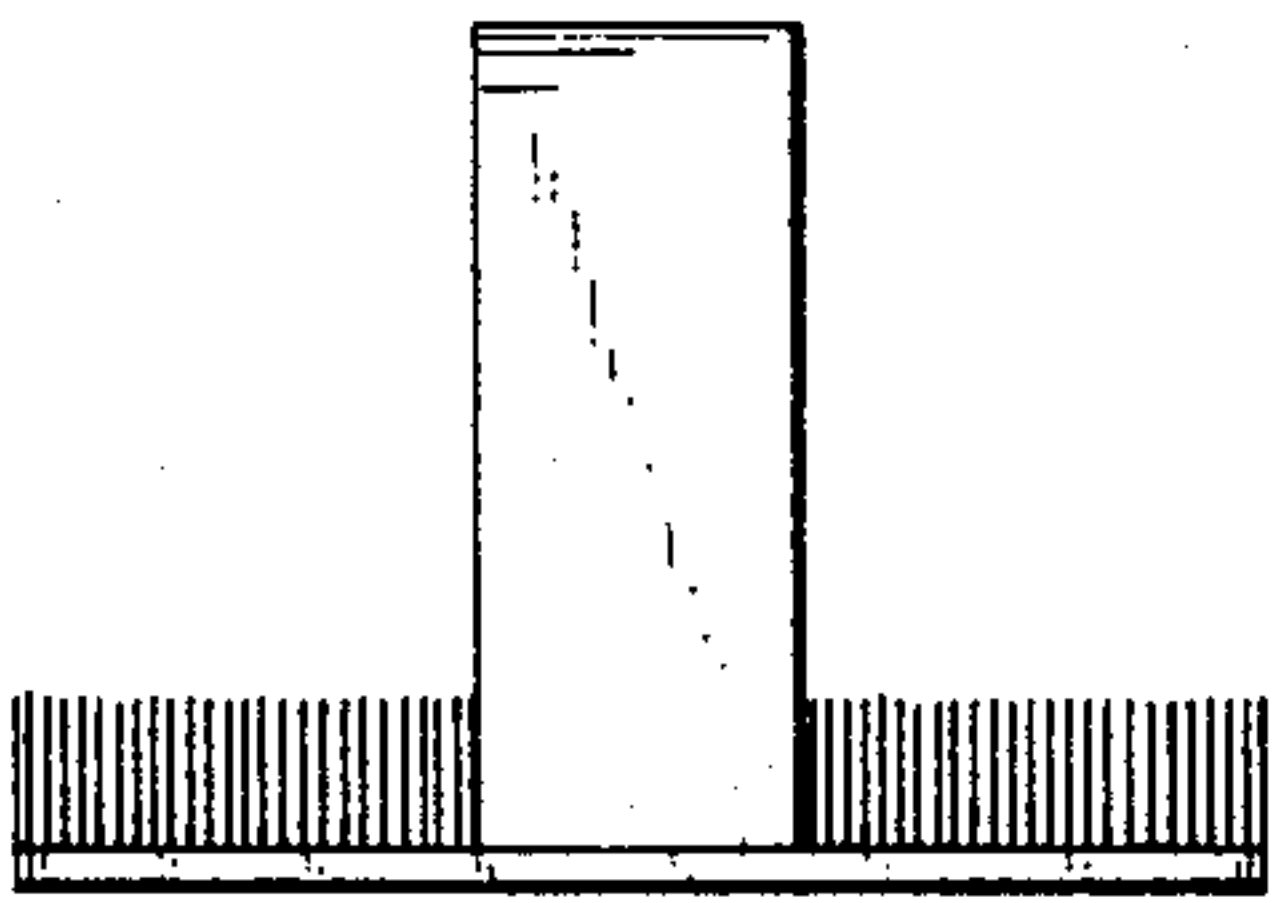

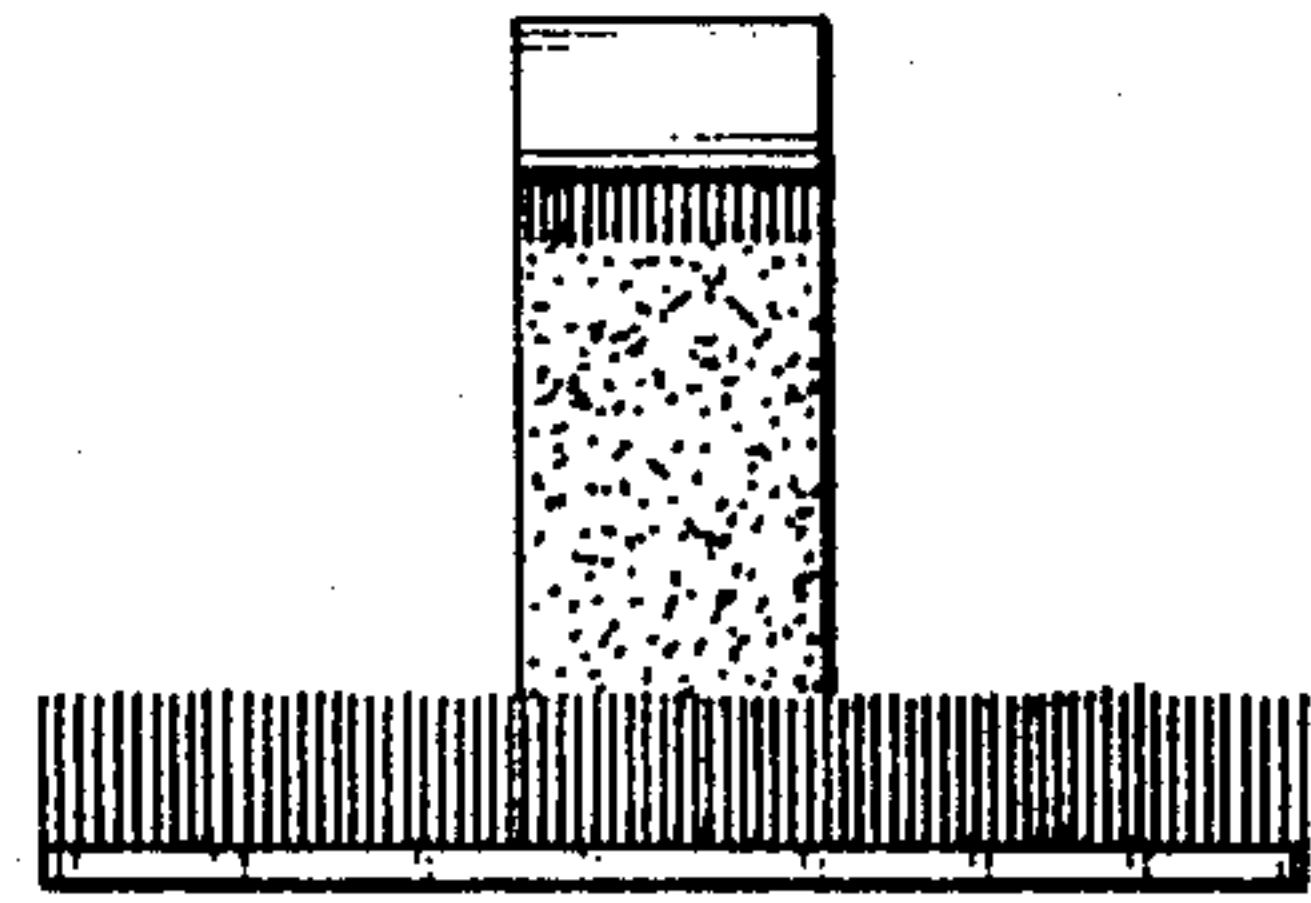

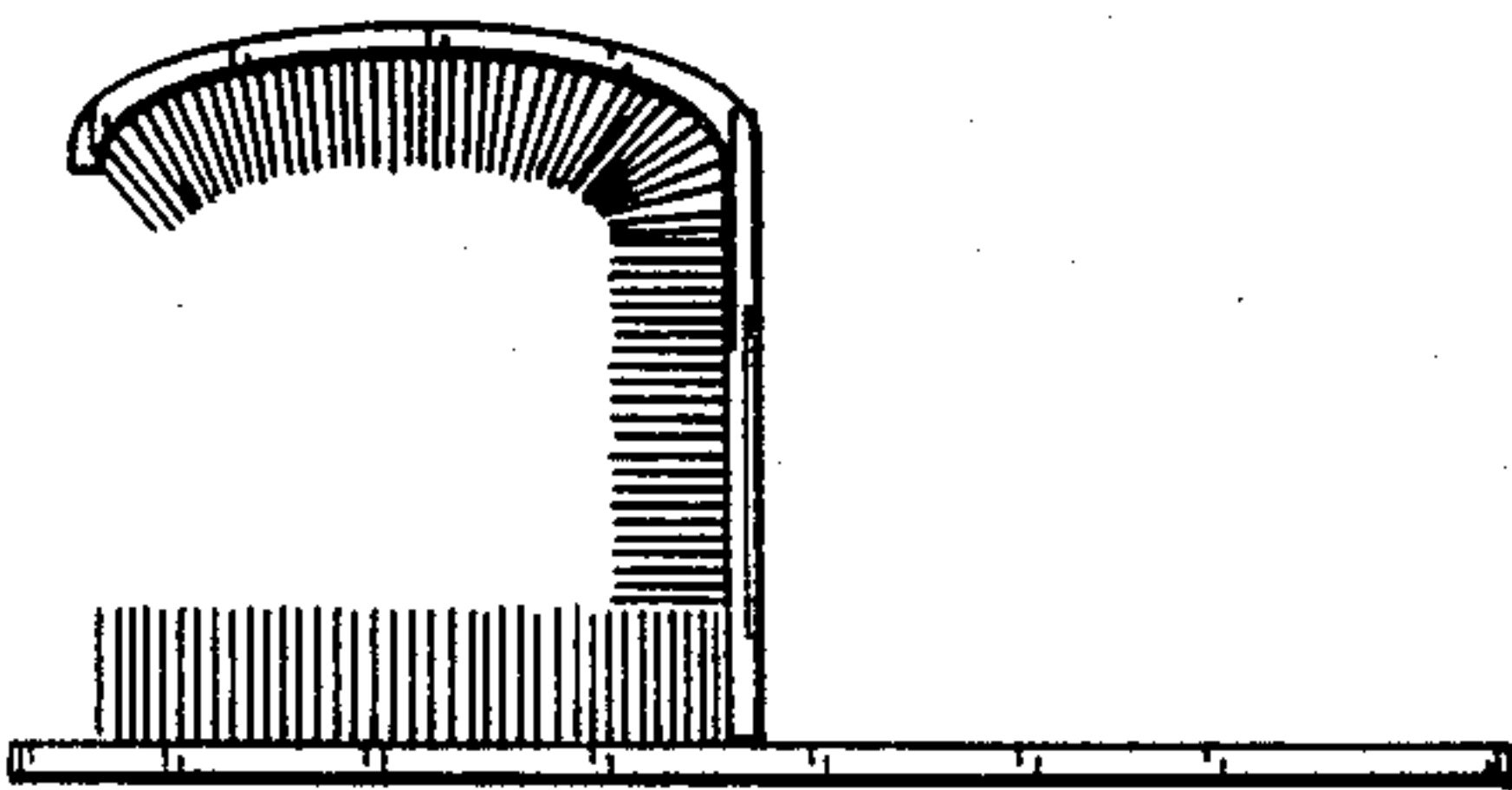

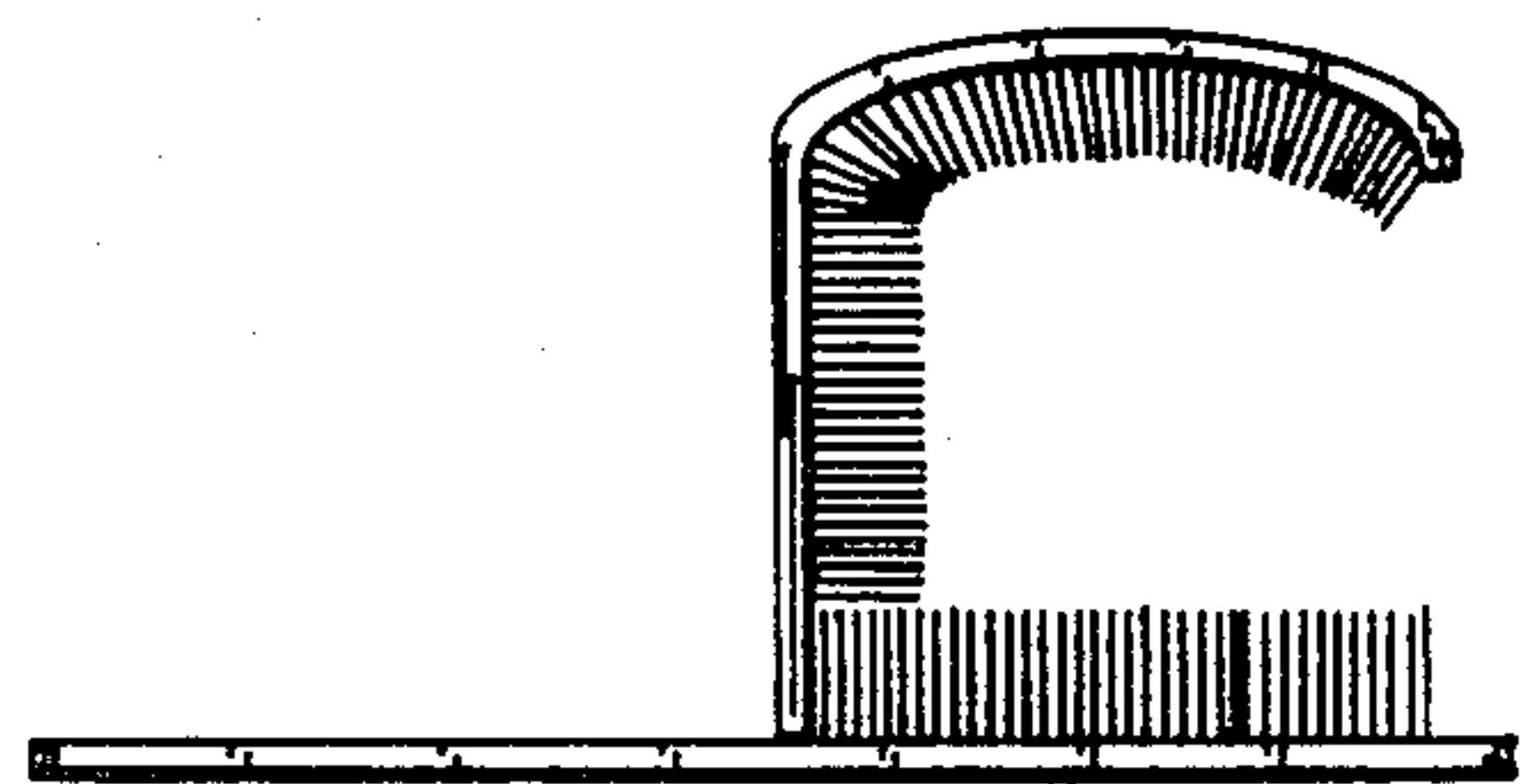
