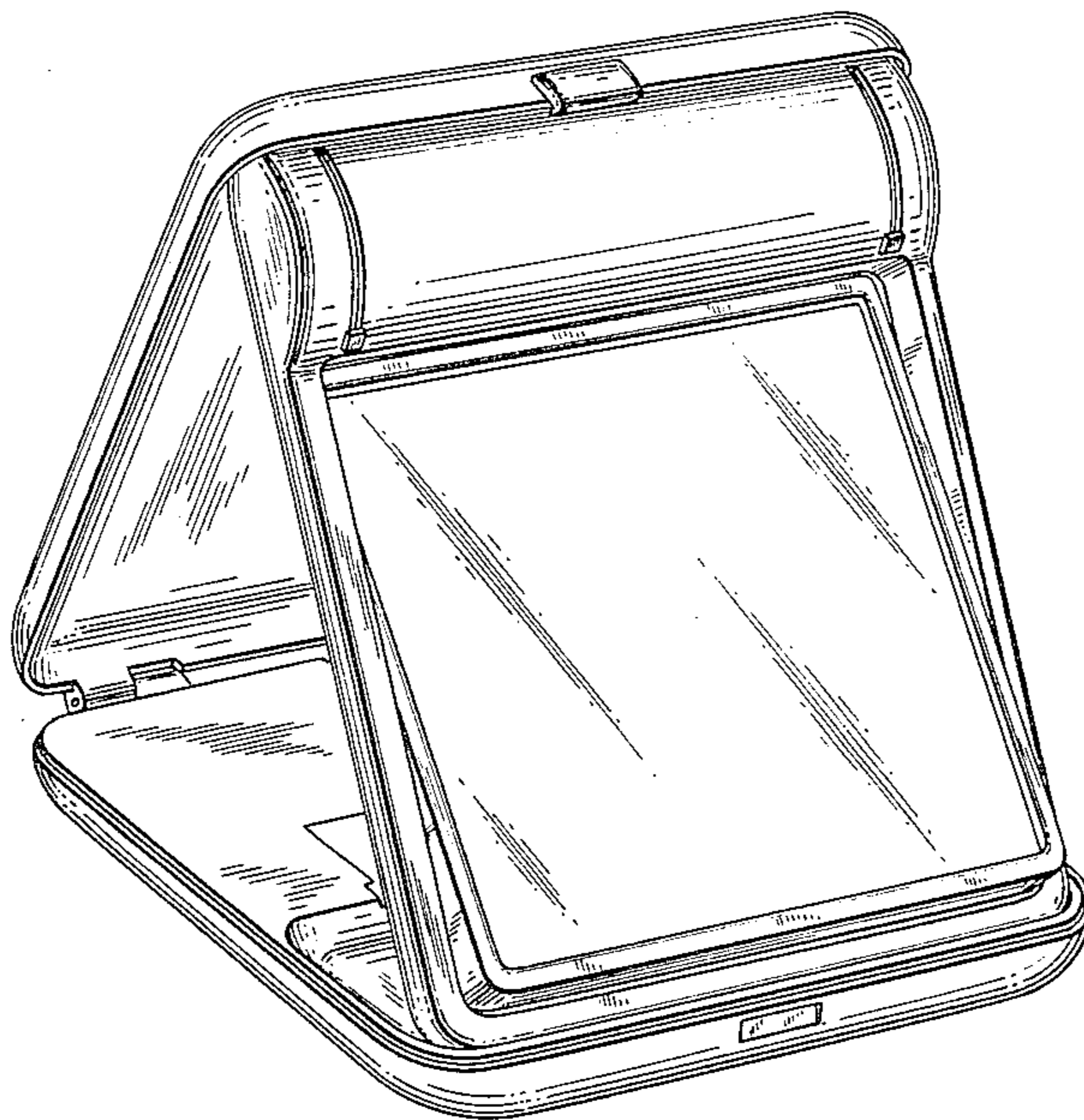

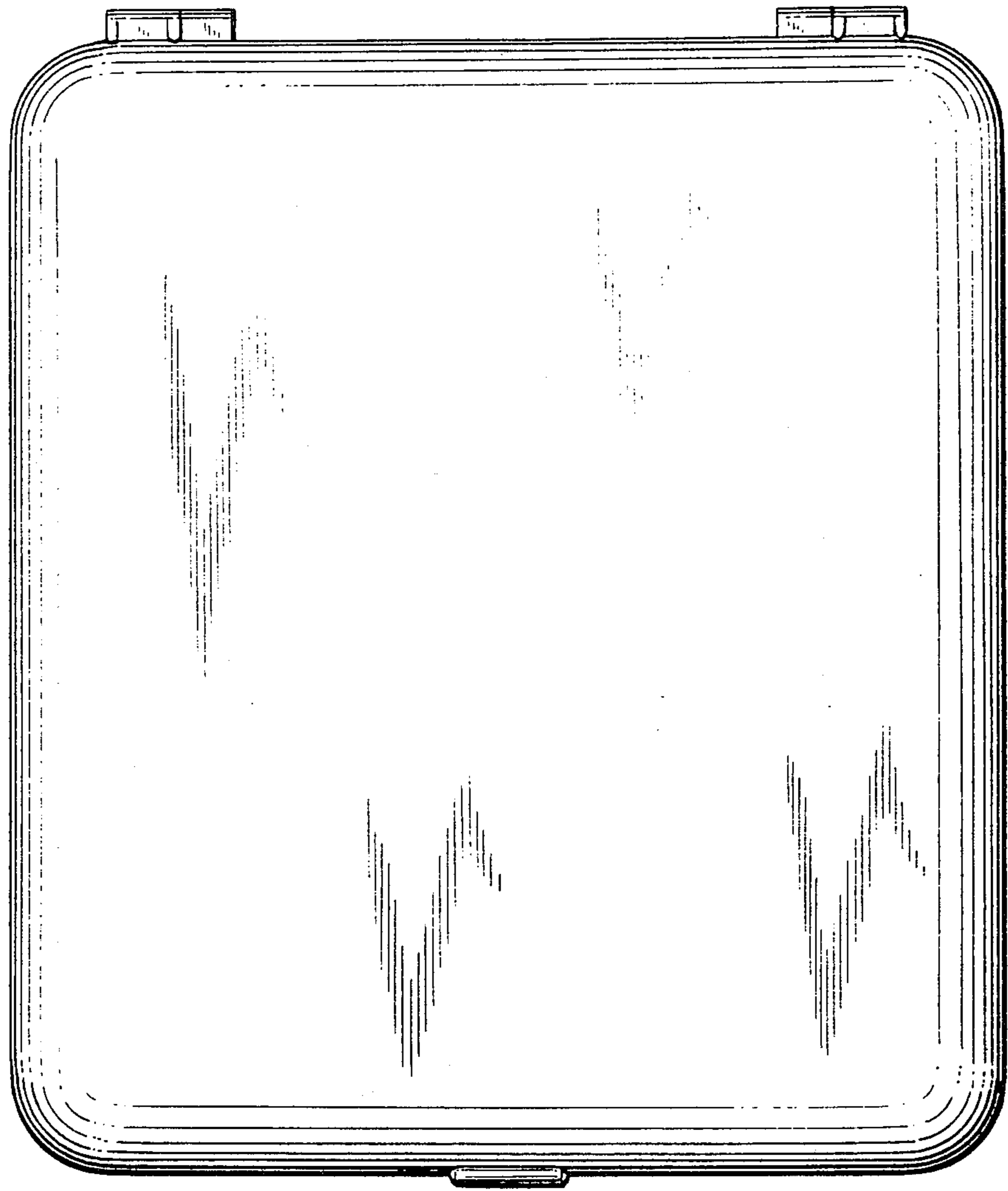
The ornamental design for a lighted mirror, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a lighted mirror showing my new design in closed condition;  
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 6 is a front left perspective view of the mirror in open condition; and  
 FIG. 7 is a rear right perspective view in open condition.

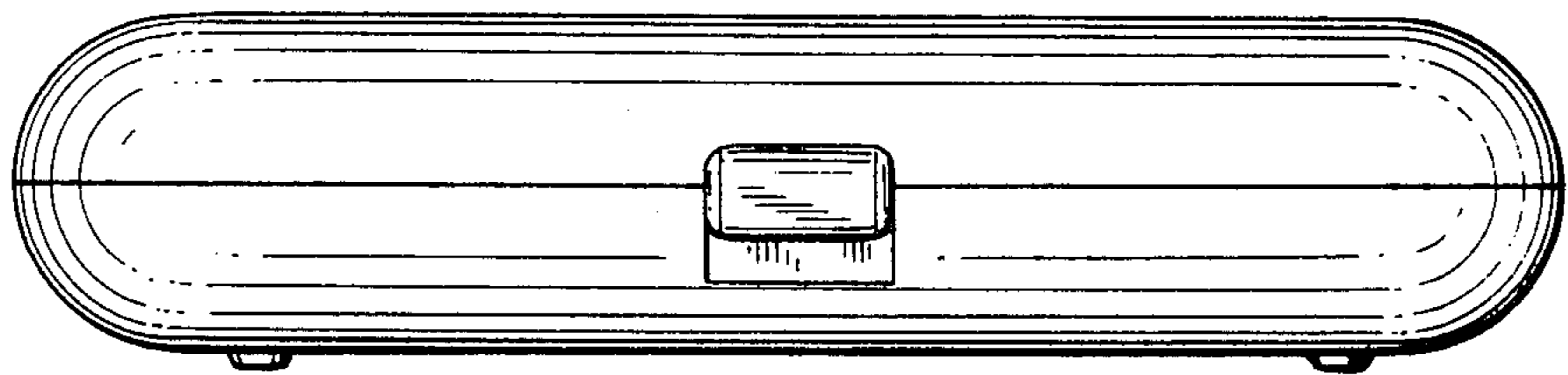

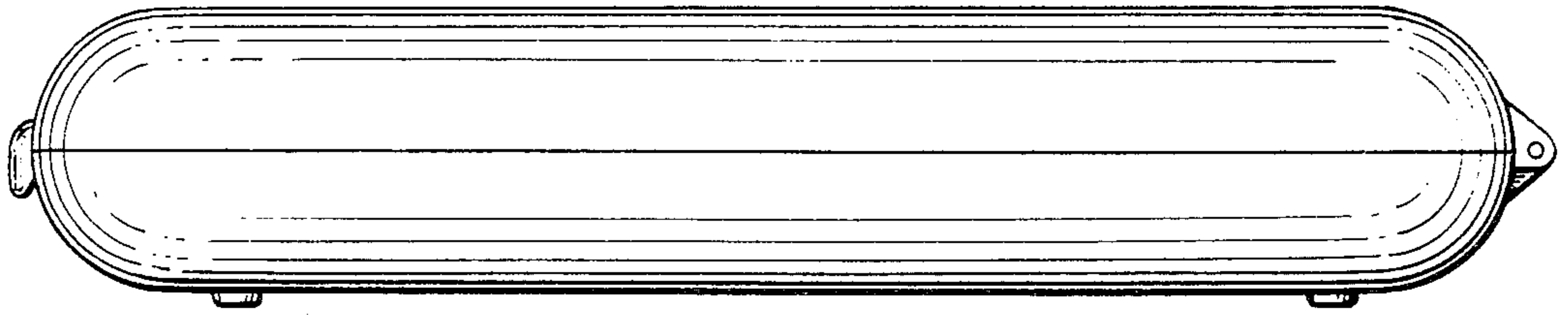

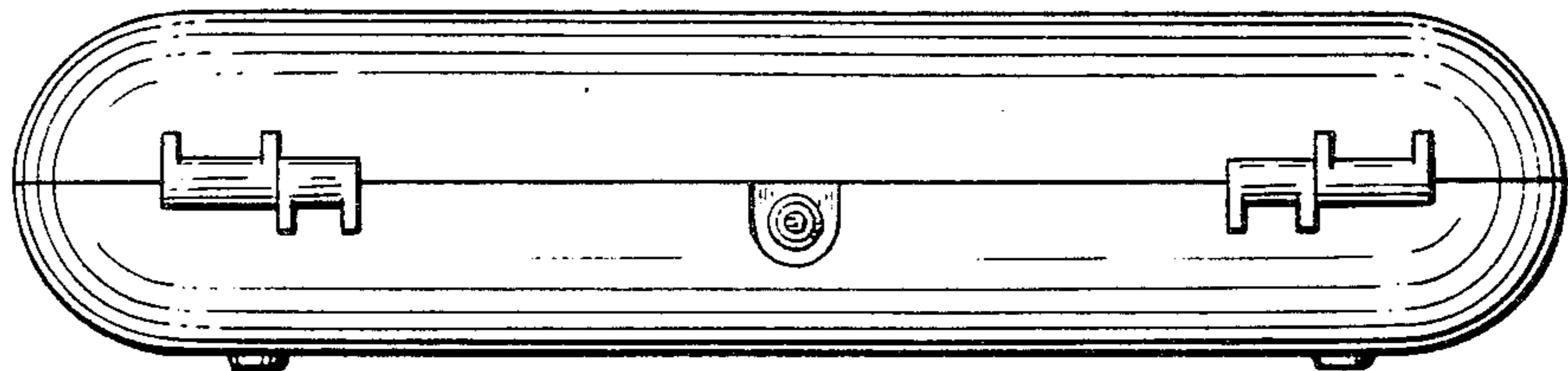

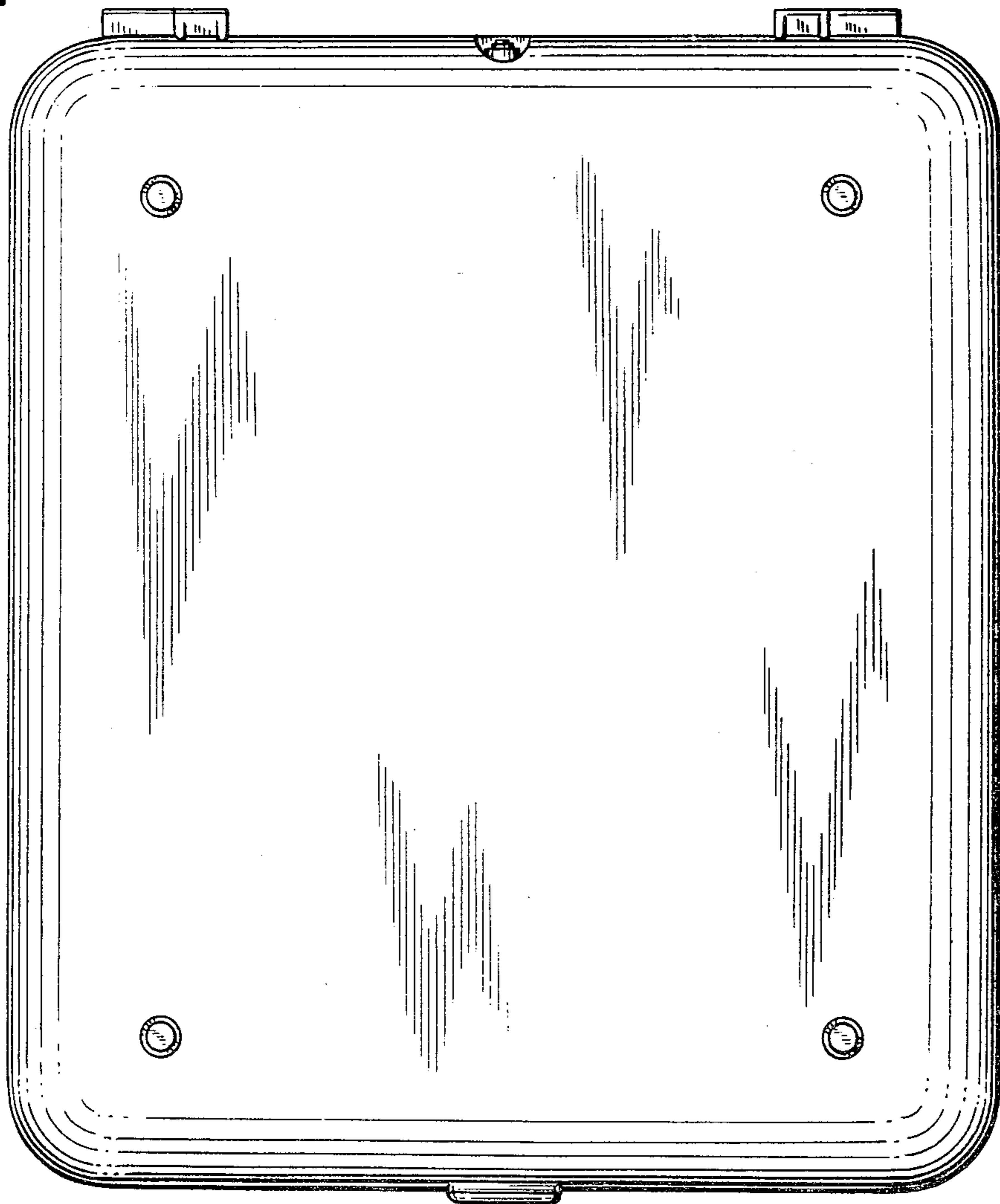
