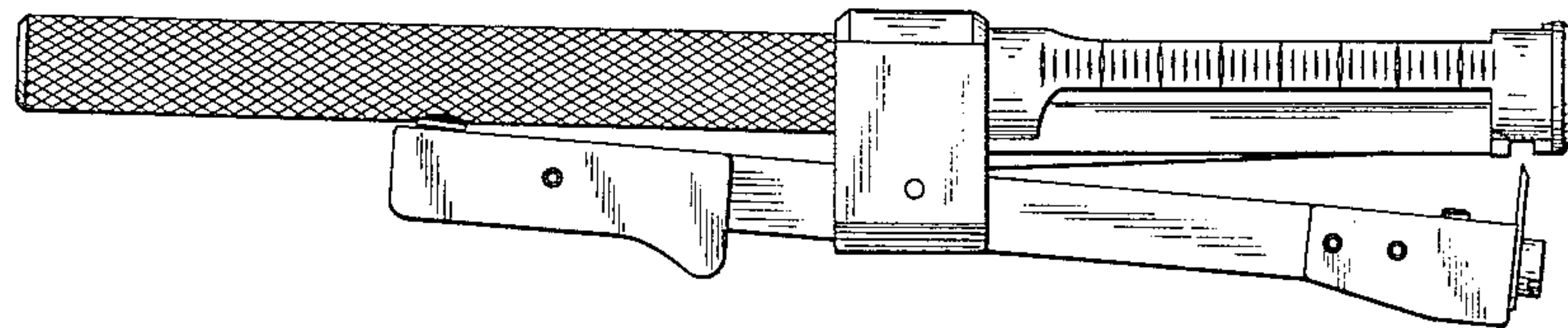

The ornamental design of a wire stripper, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a wire stripper showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is an opposite end elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 7 is an opposite side elevational view thereof with the stripper shown in the open position.



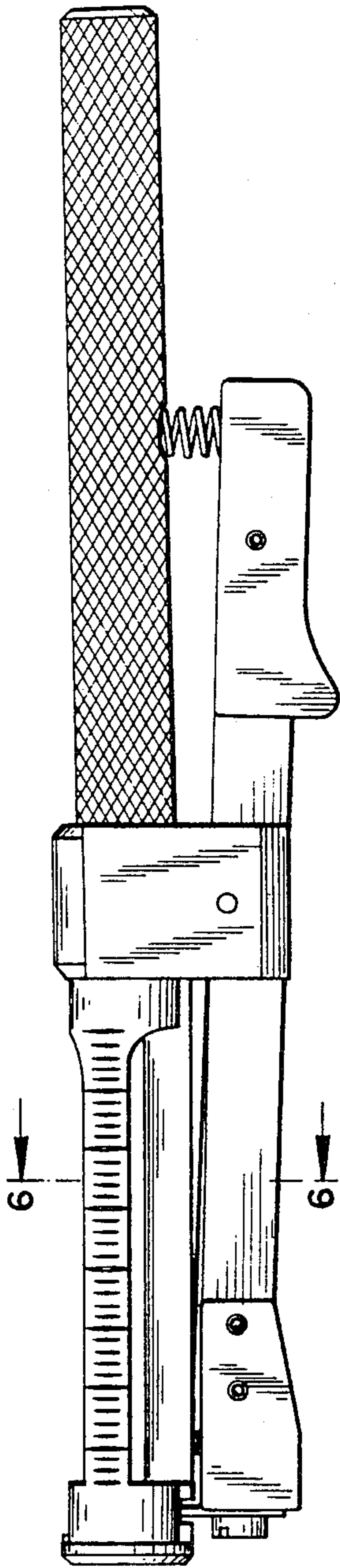

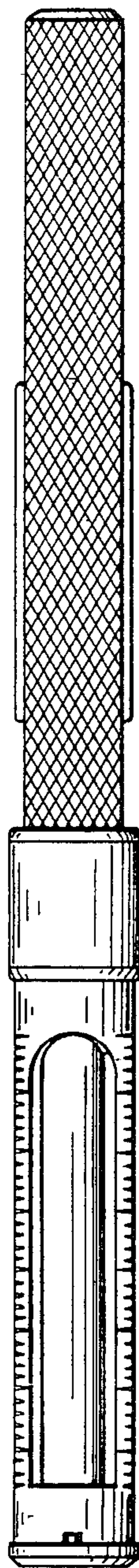

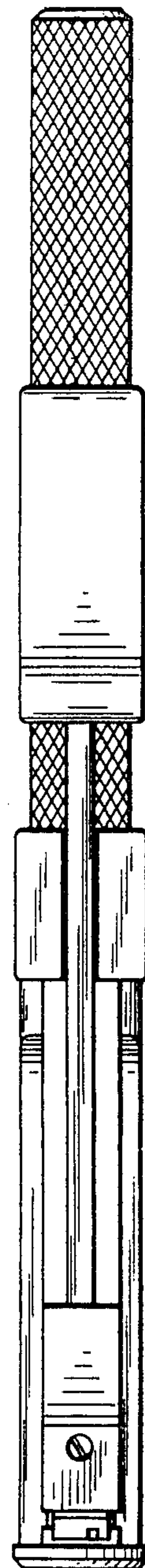

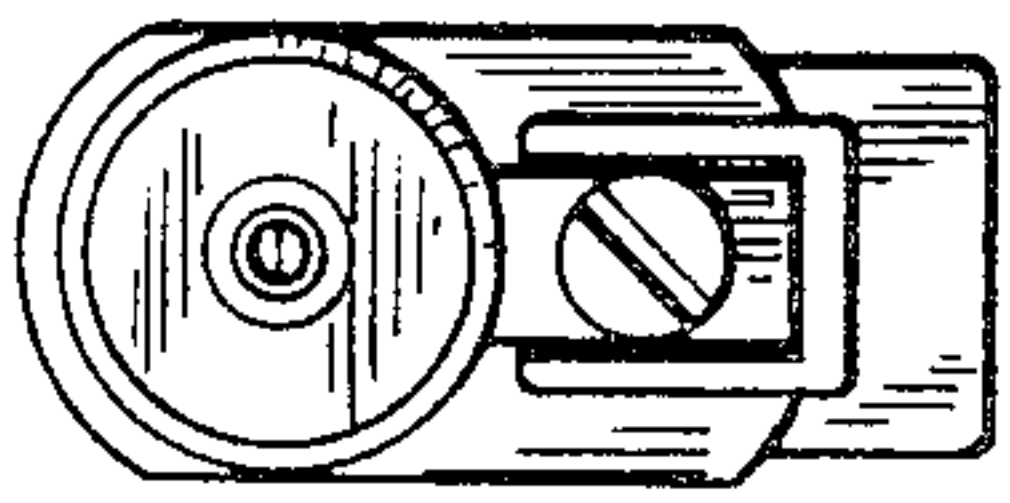

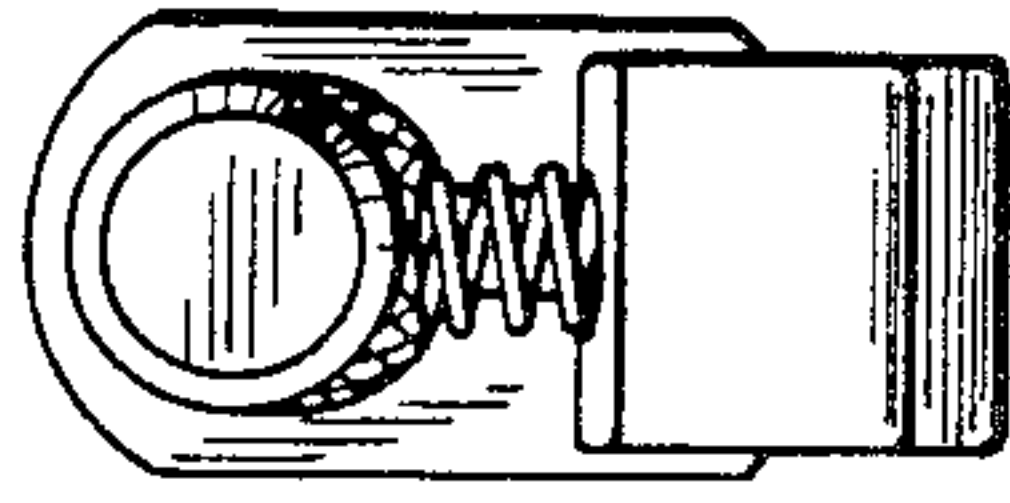

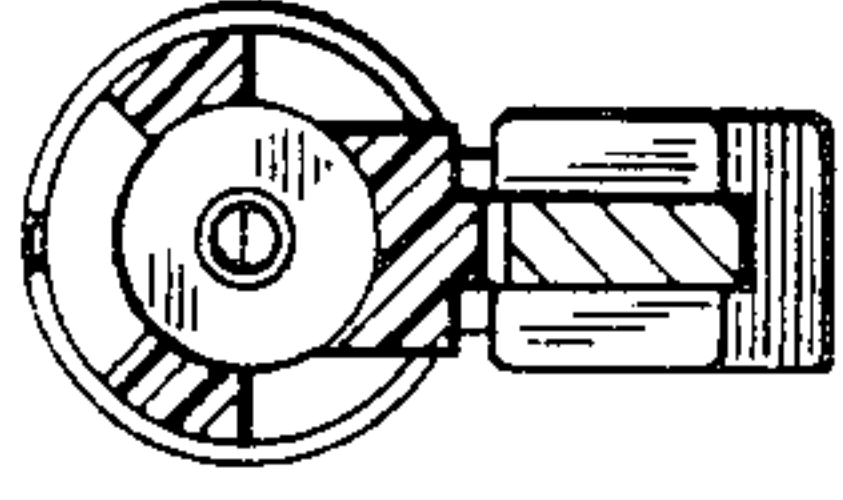

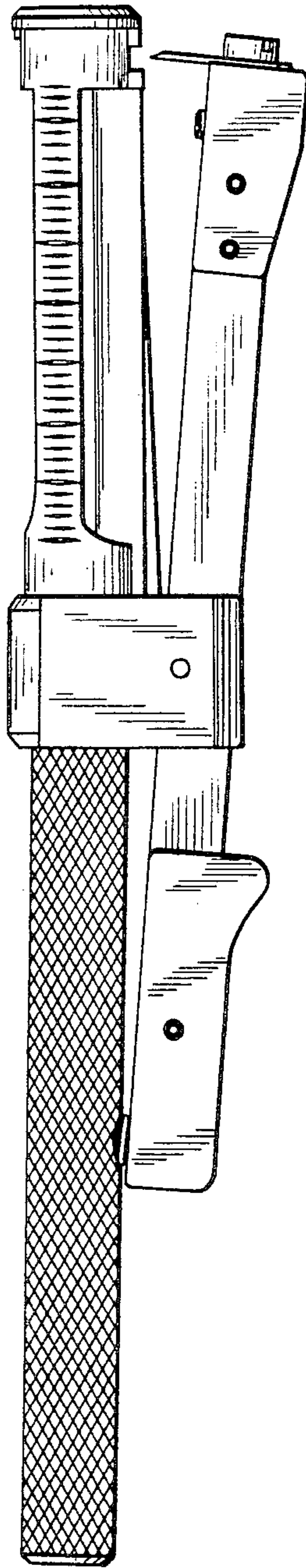
