my new design;

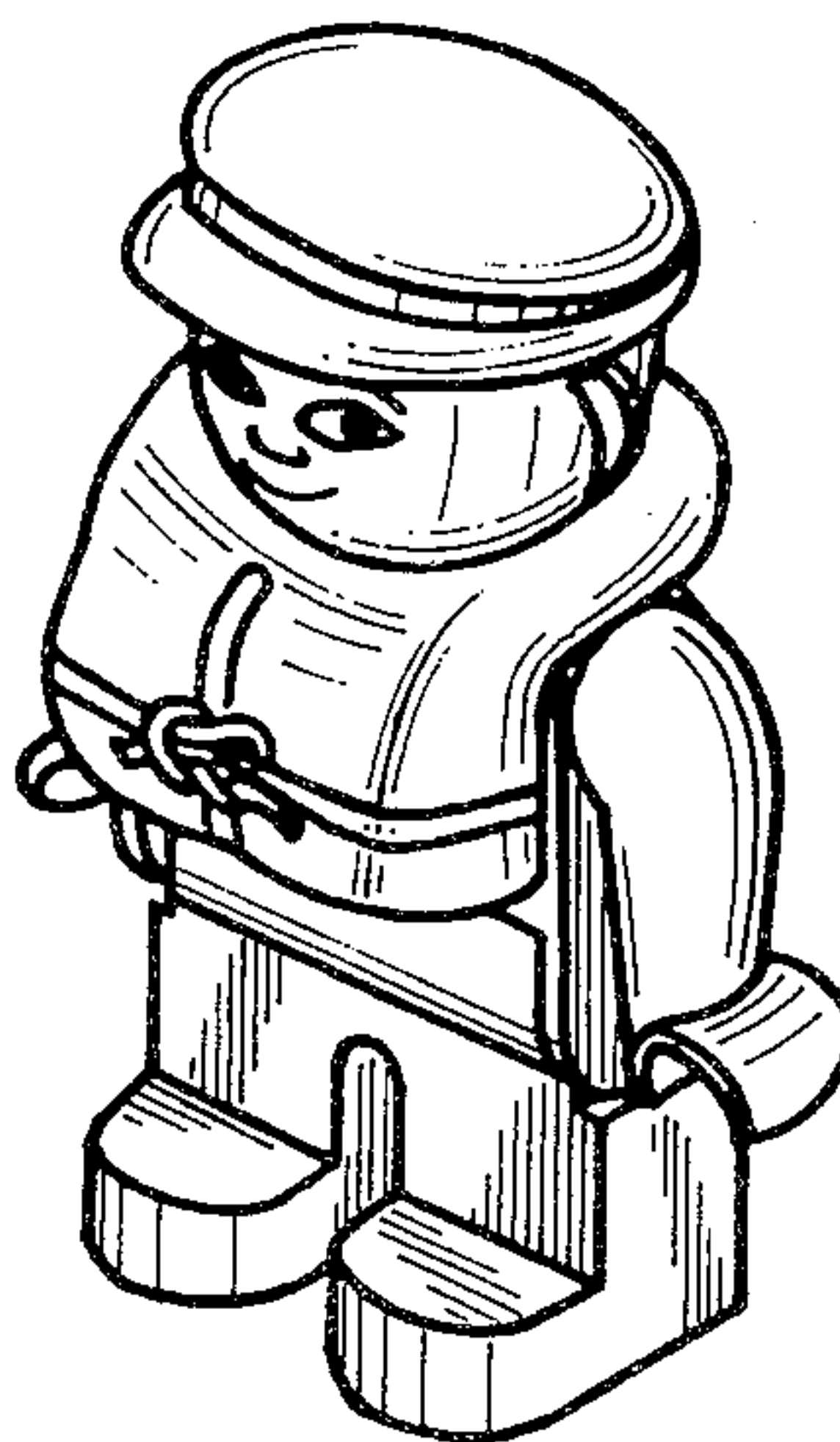
FIG. 2 is a rear view;

FIG. 6 is a bottom view.



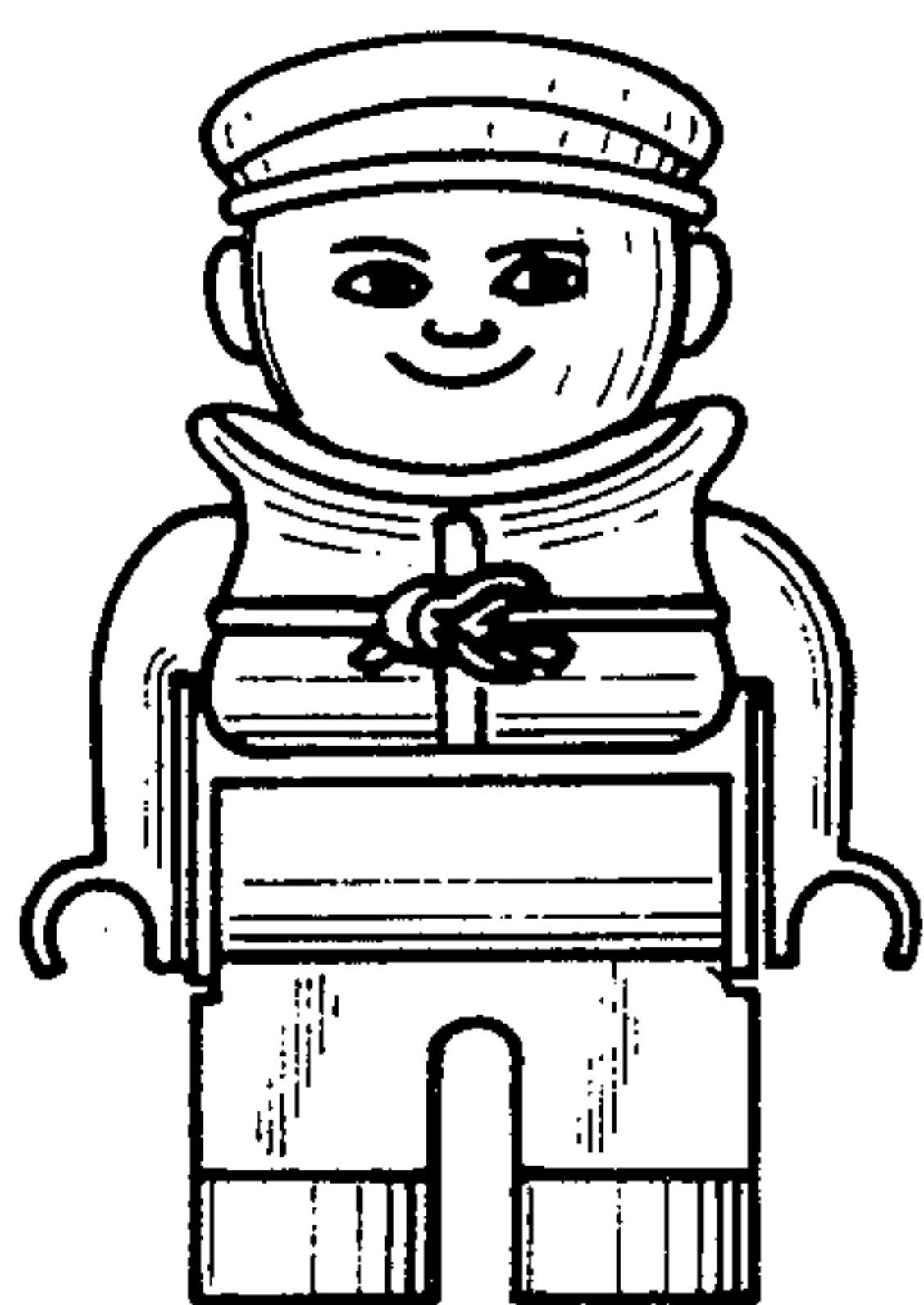

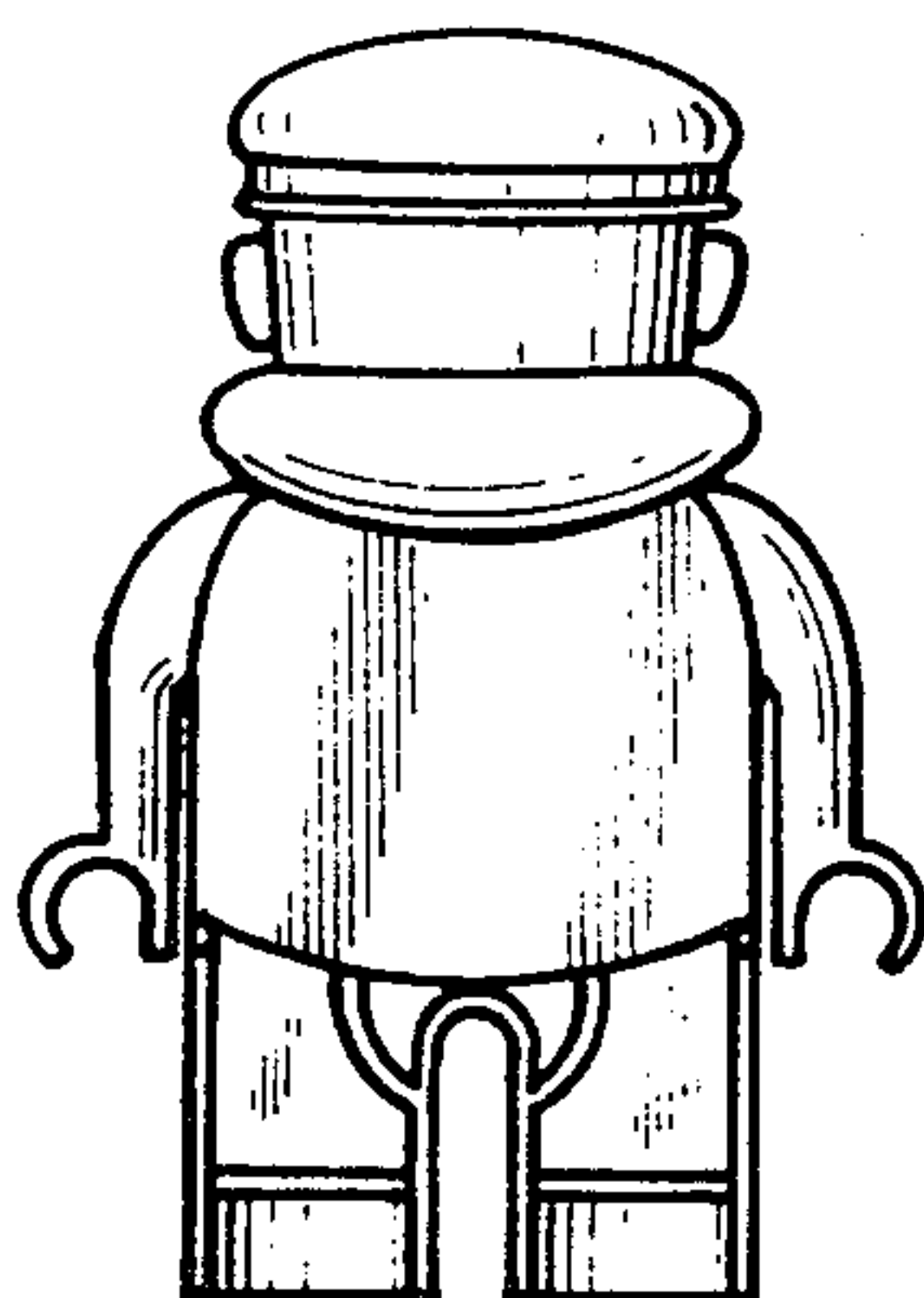

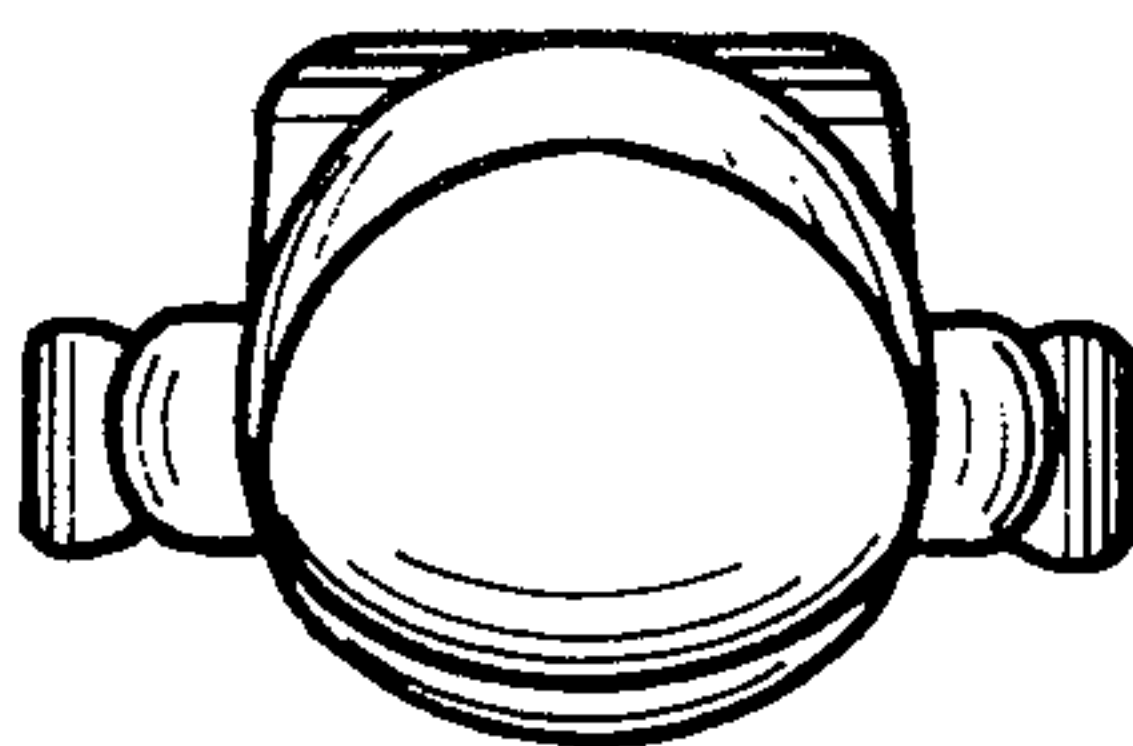

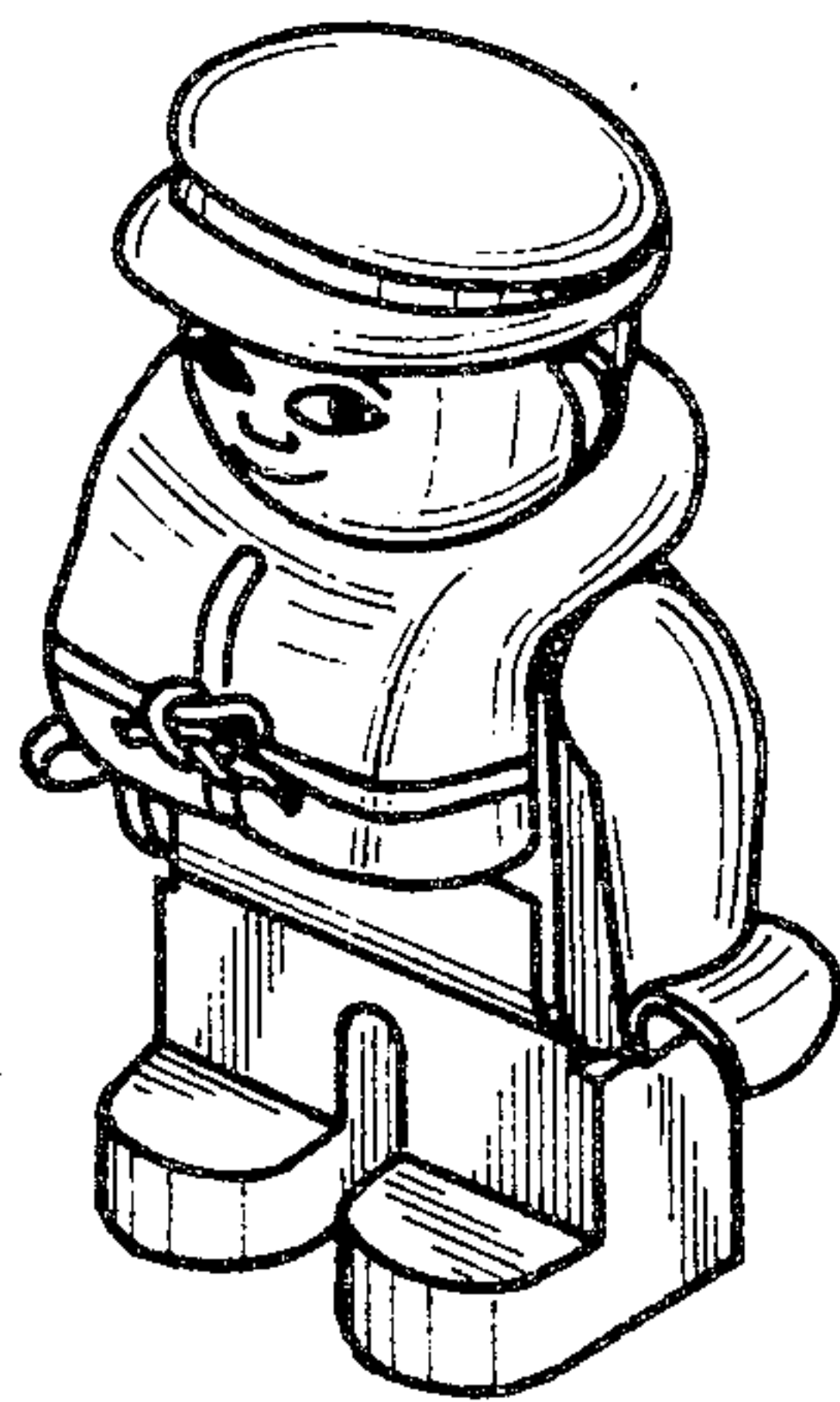

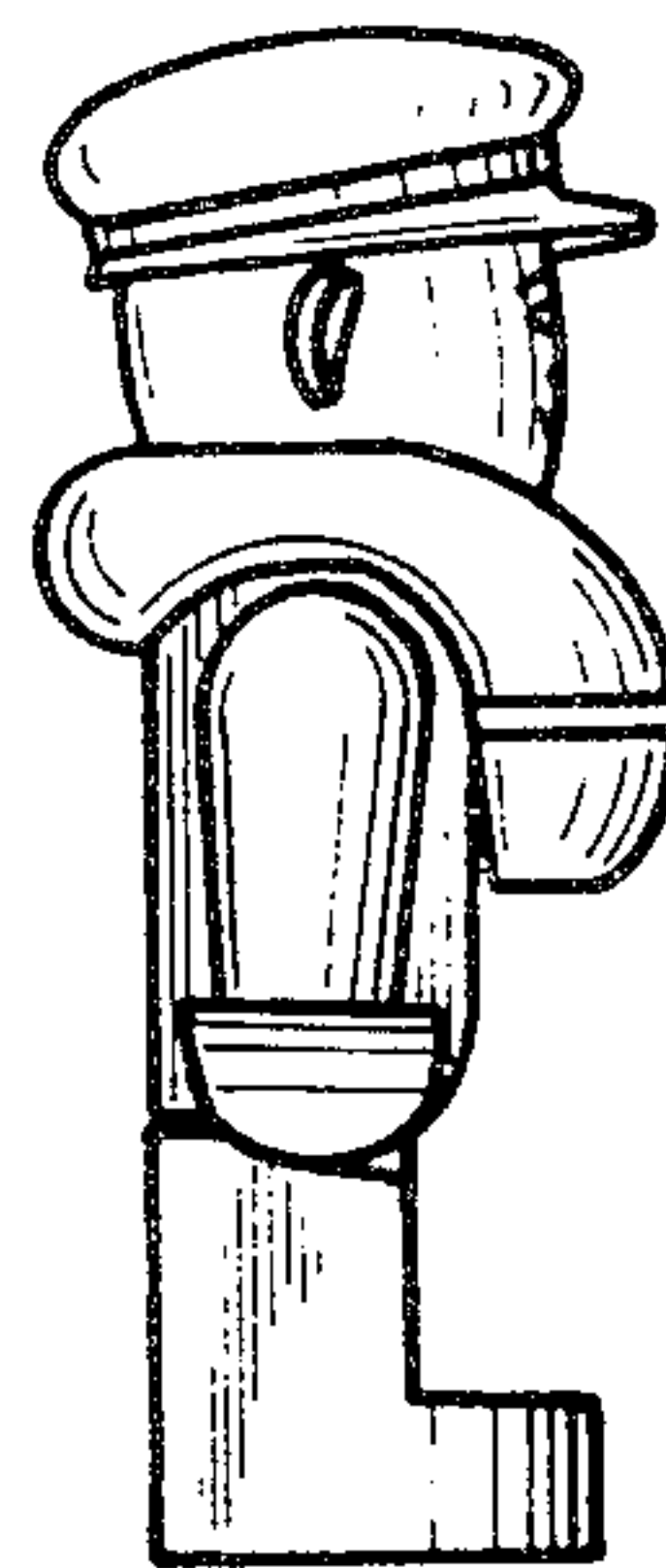

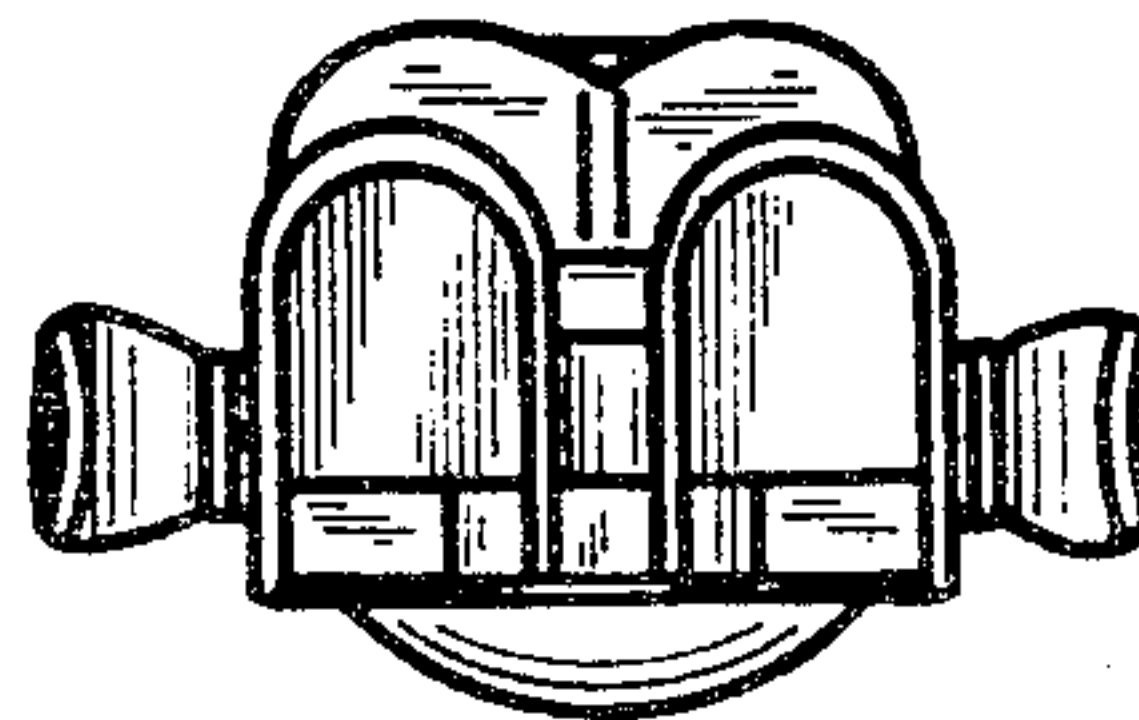
