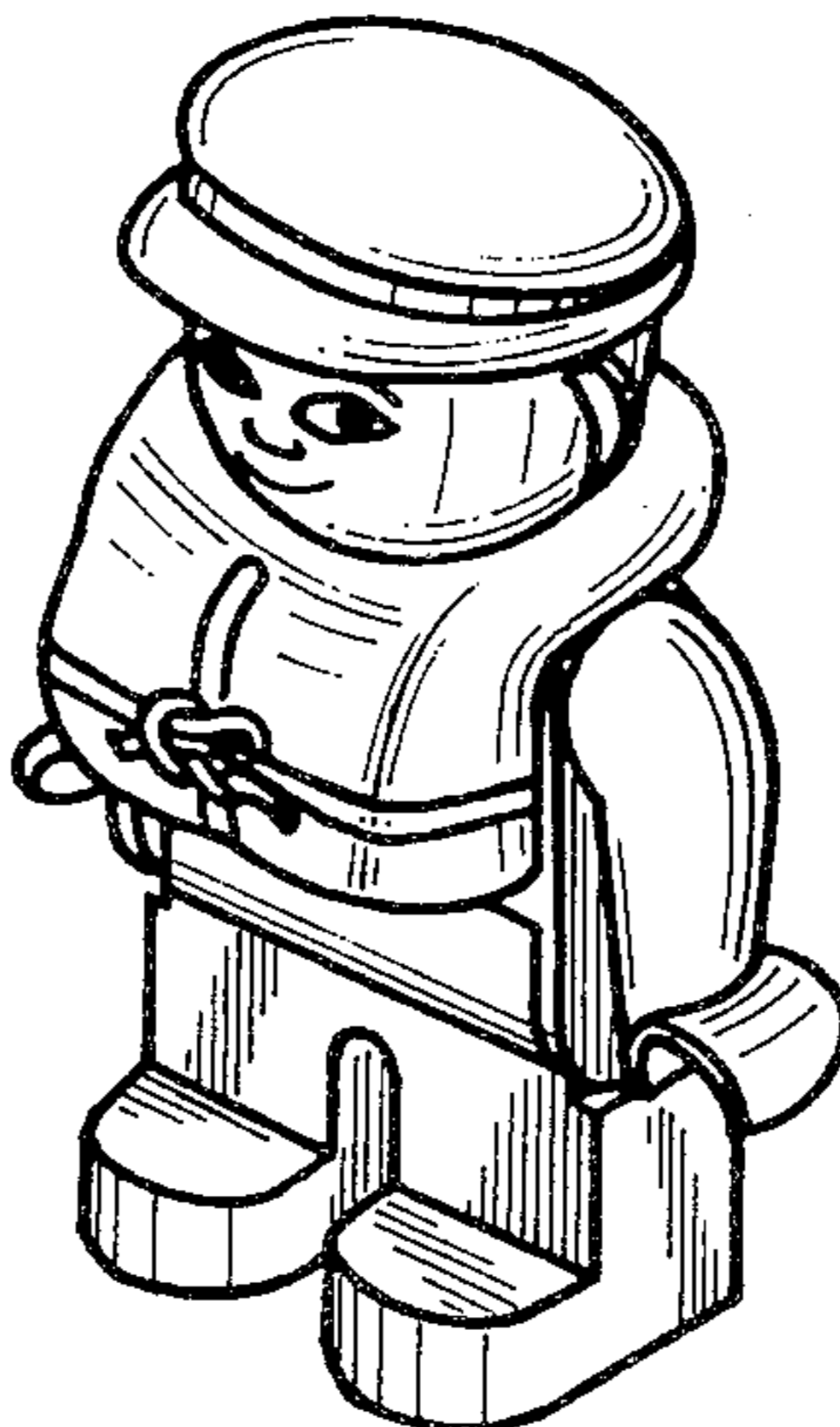

FIG. 6 is a bottom view.



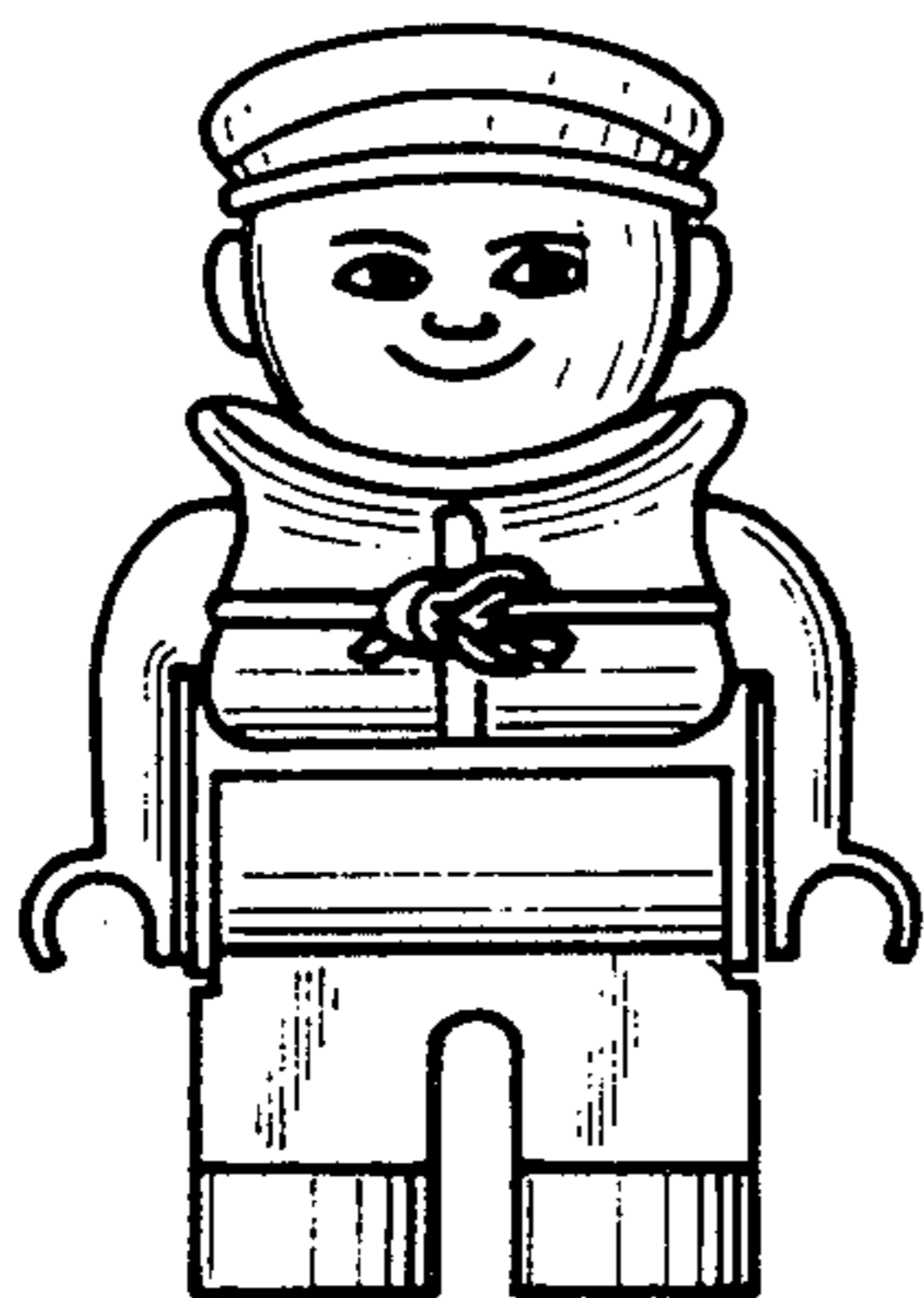

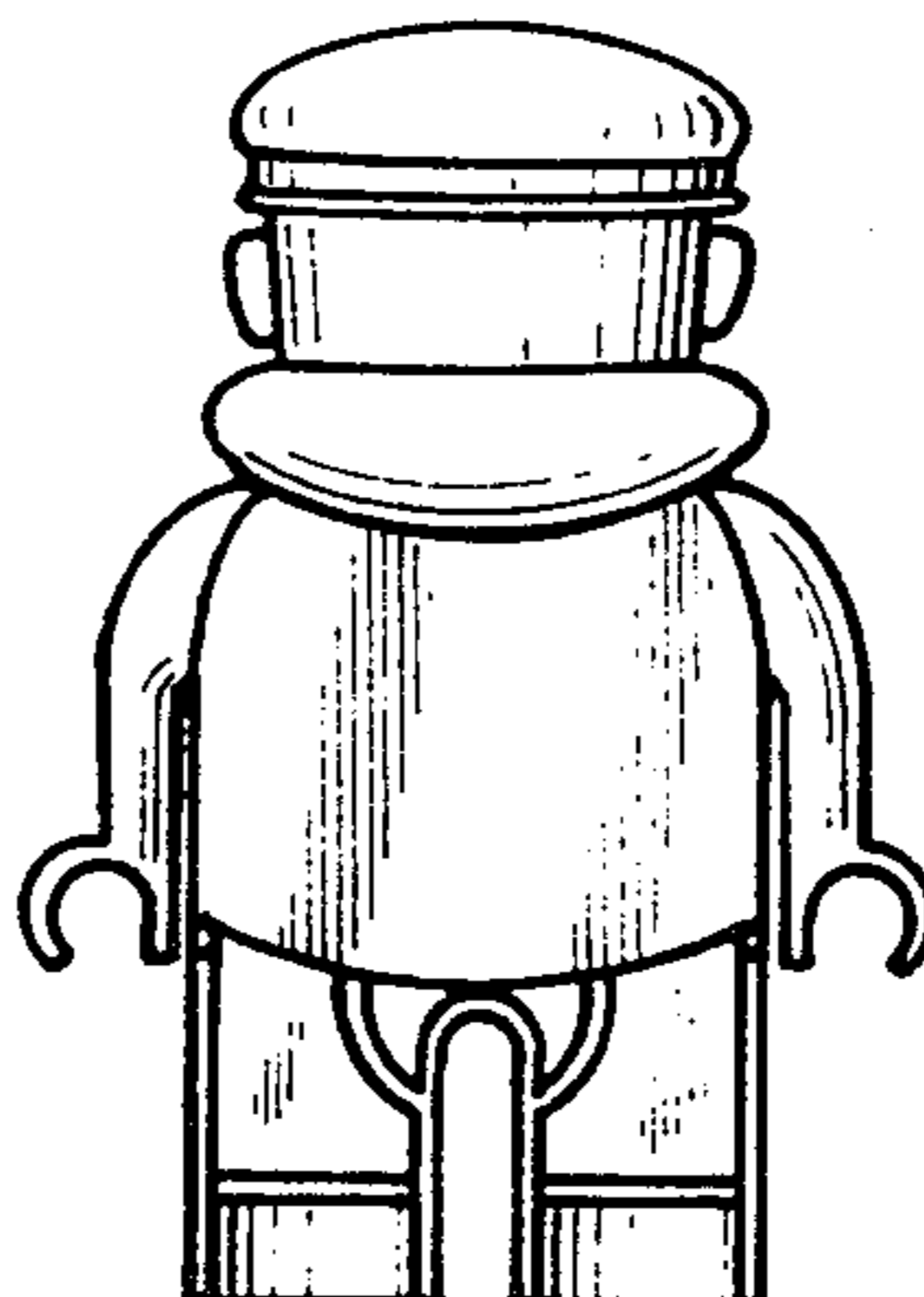

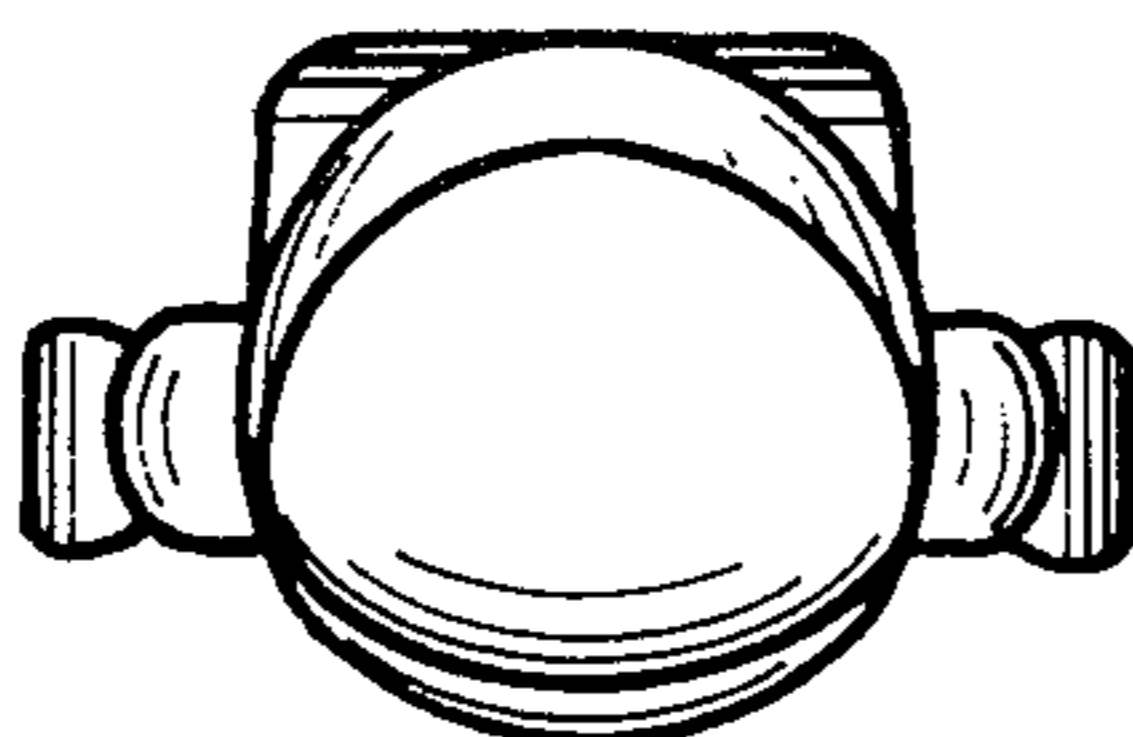

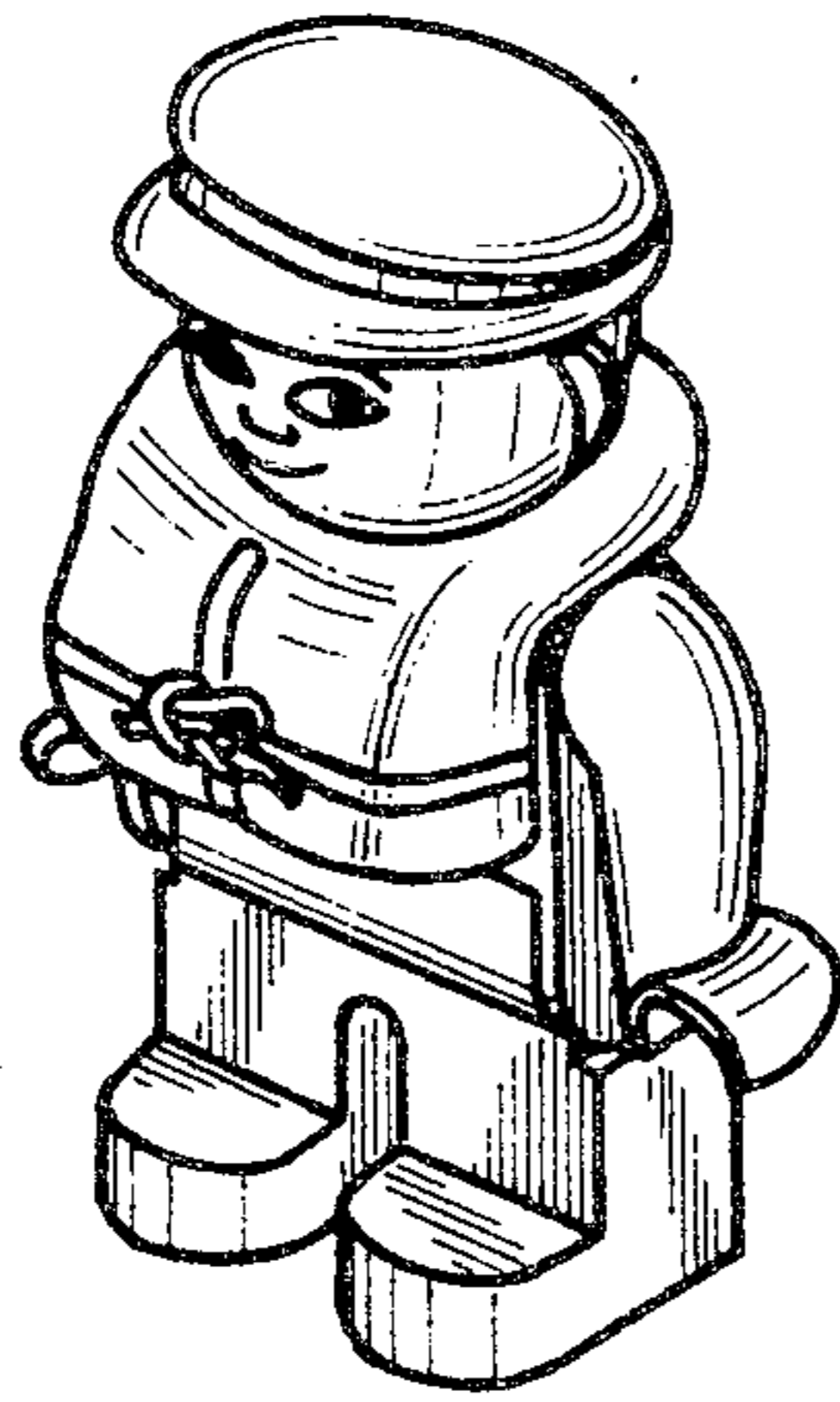

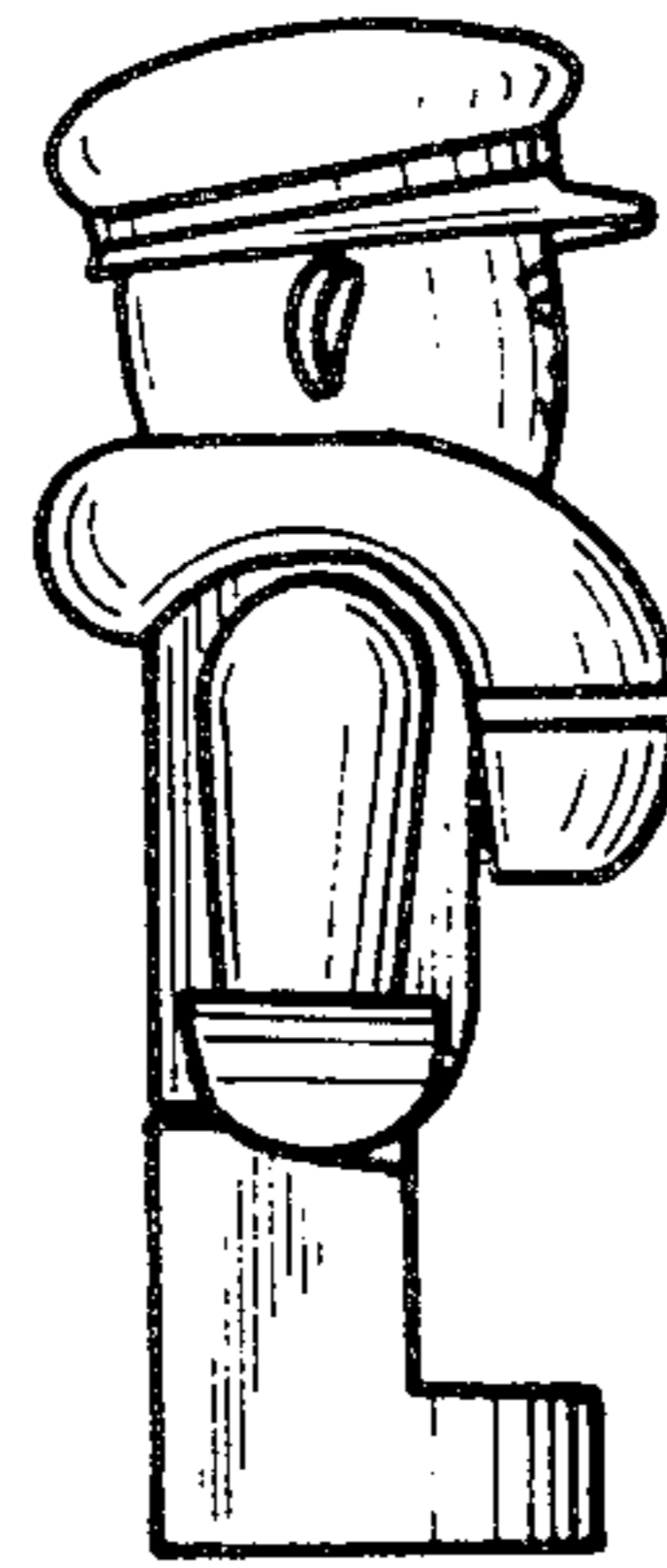

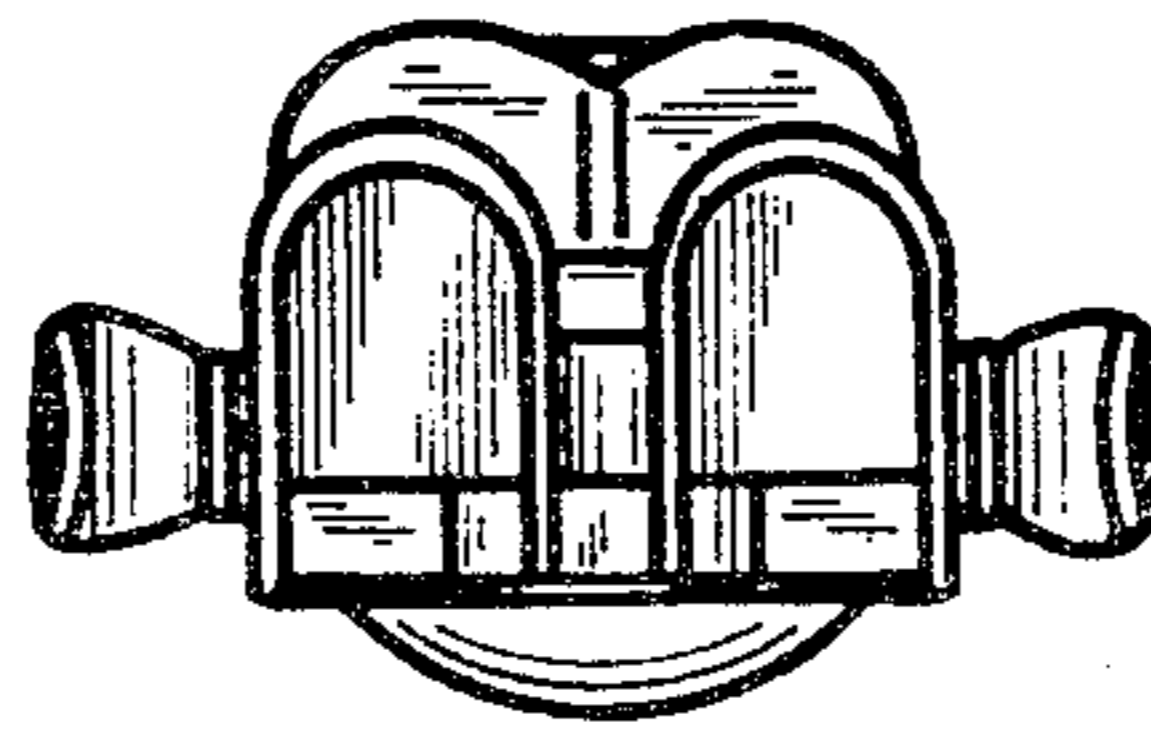
