The ornamental design for a fabric, as shown and described.

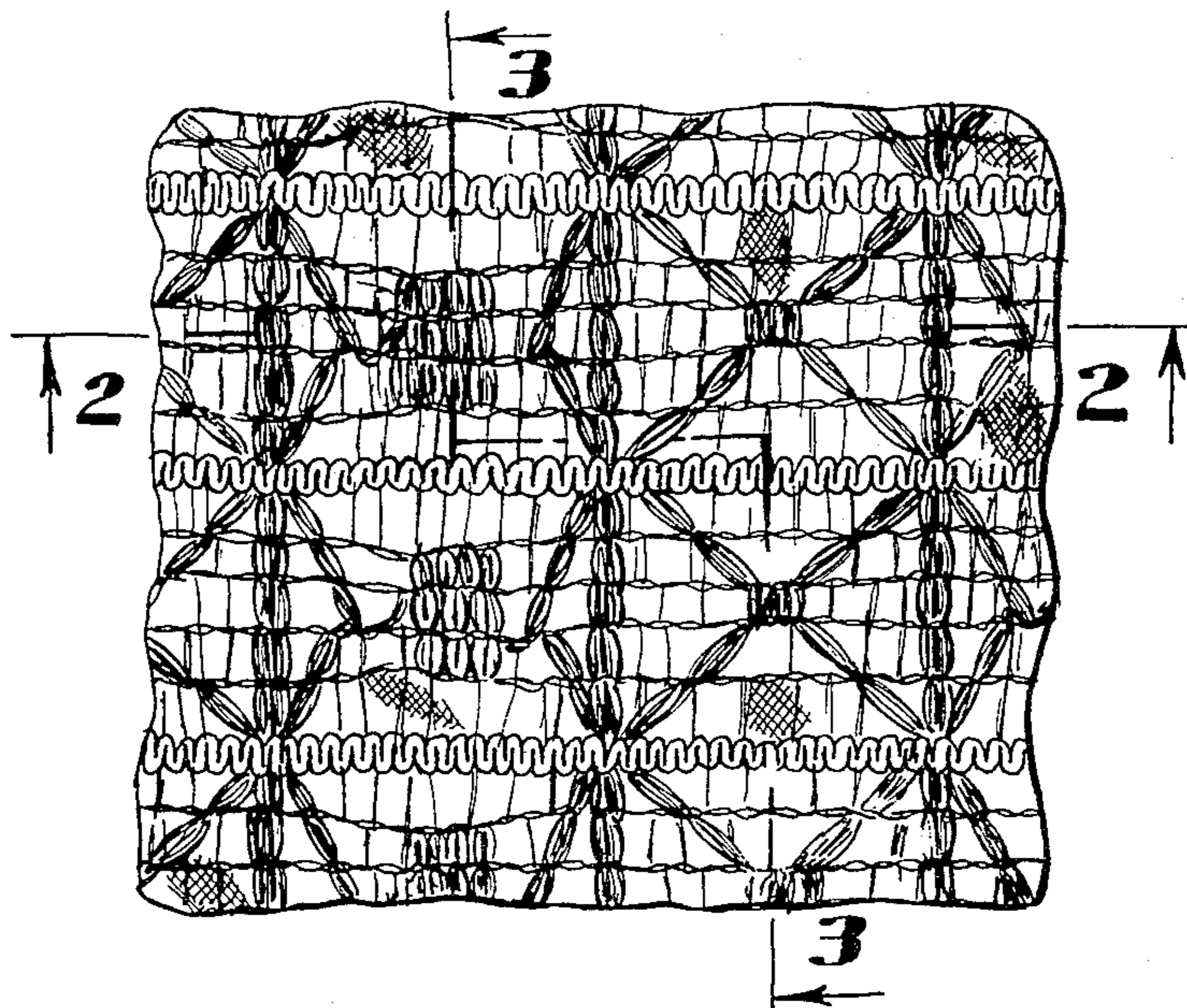
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a fabric showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a section view thereof taken along line 2—2 of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 3 is a section view thereof taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 1.

The pattern uniformly continues throughout the length and width of the fabric and is shown fragmentally for convenience of illustration.



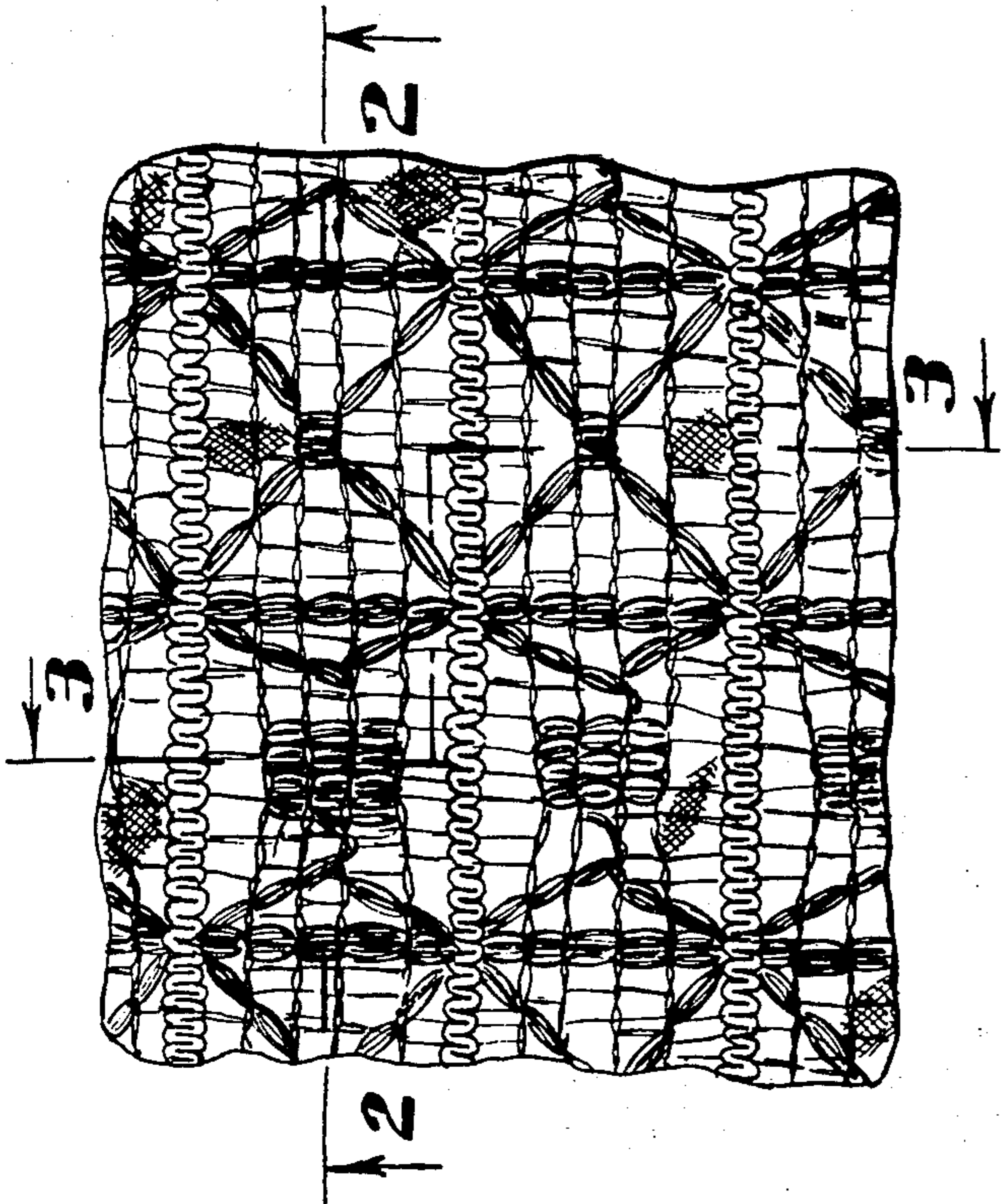
