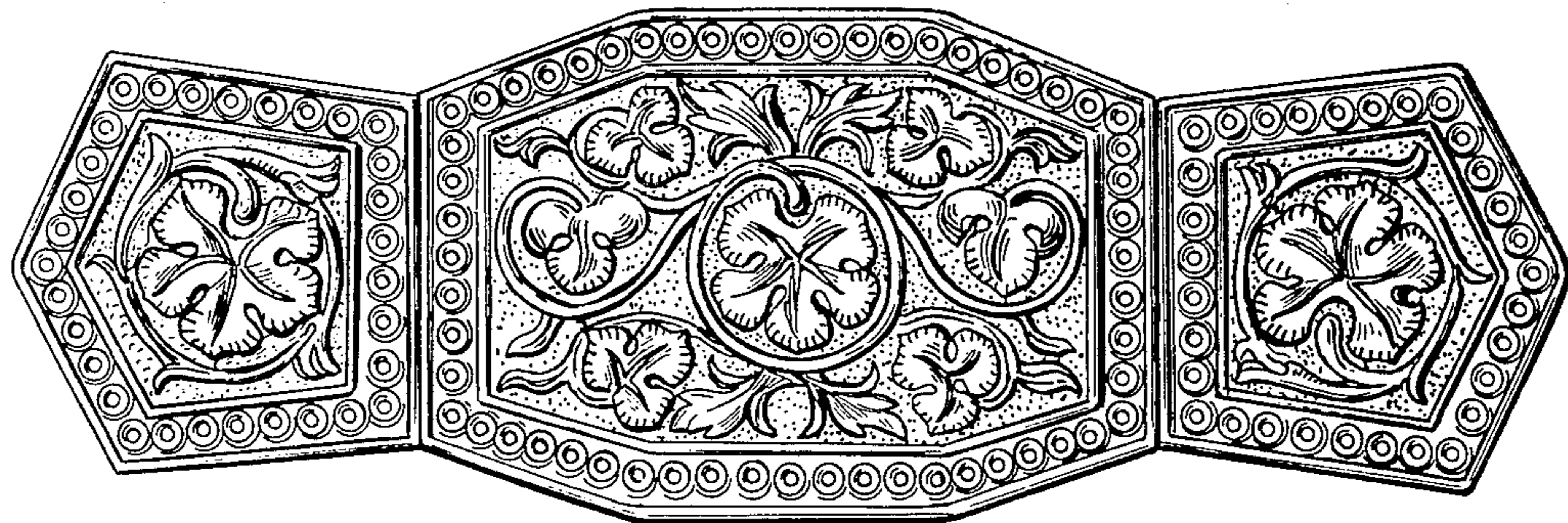

The ornamental design for belt buckle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the belt buckle embodying my new design, the bottom plan view being a mirror image;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof, the right side view being similar; and
FIG. 5 is a fragmentary front elevation showing the belt buckle in an open condition.



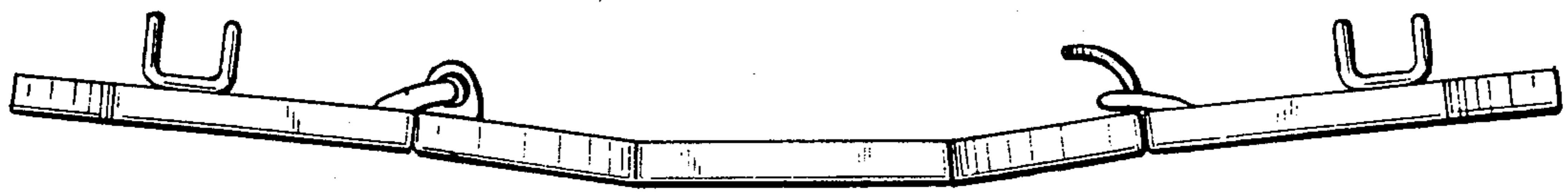

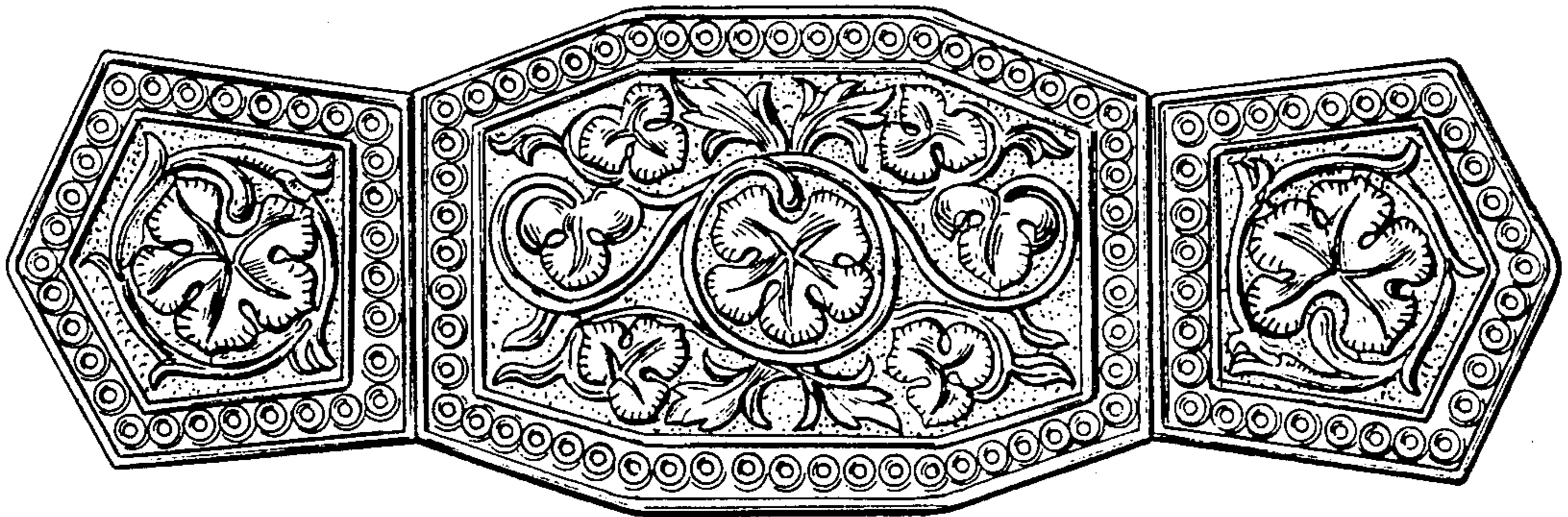

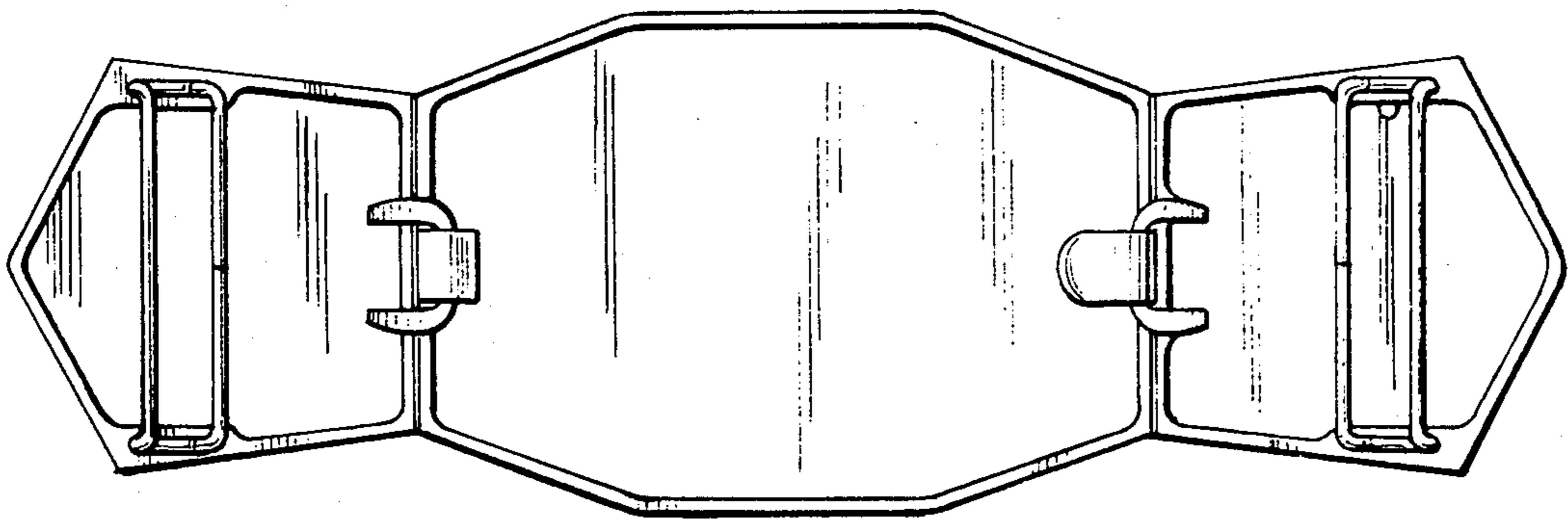

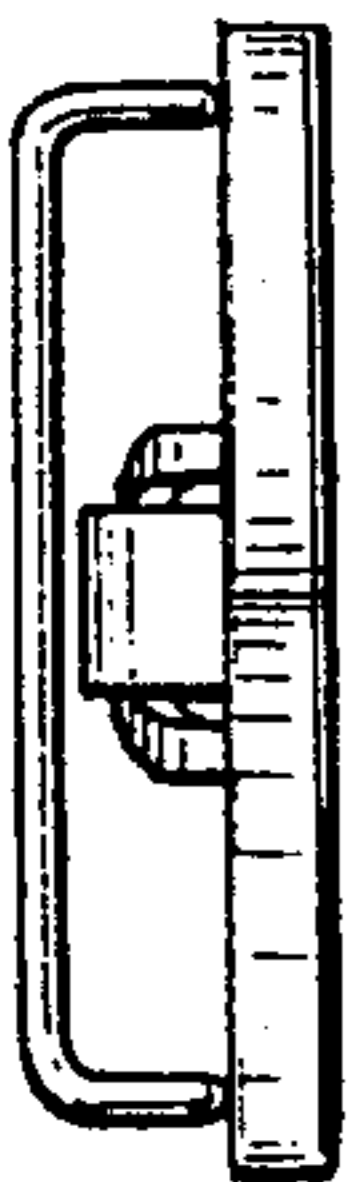

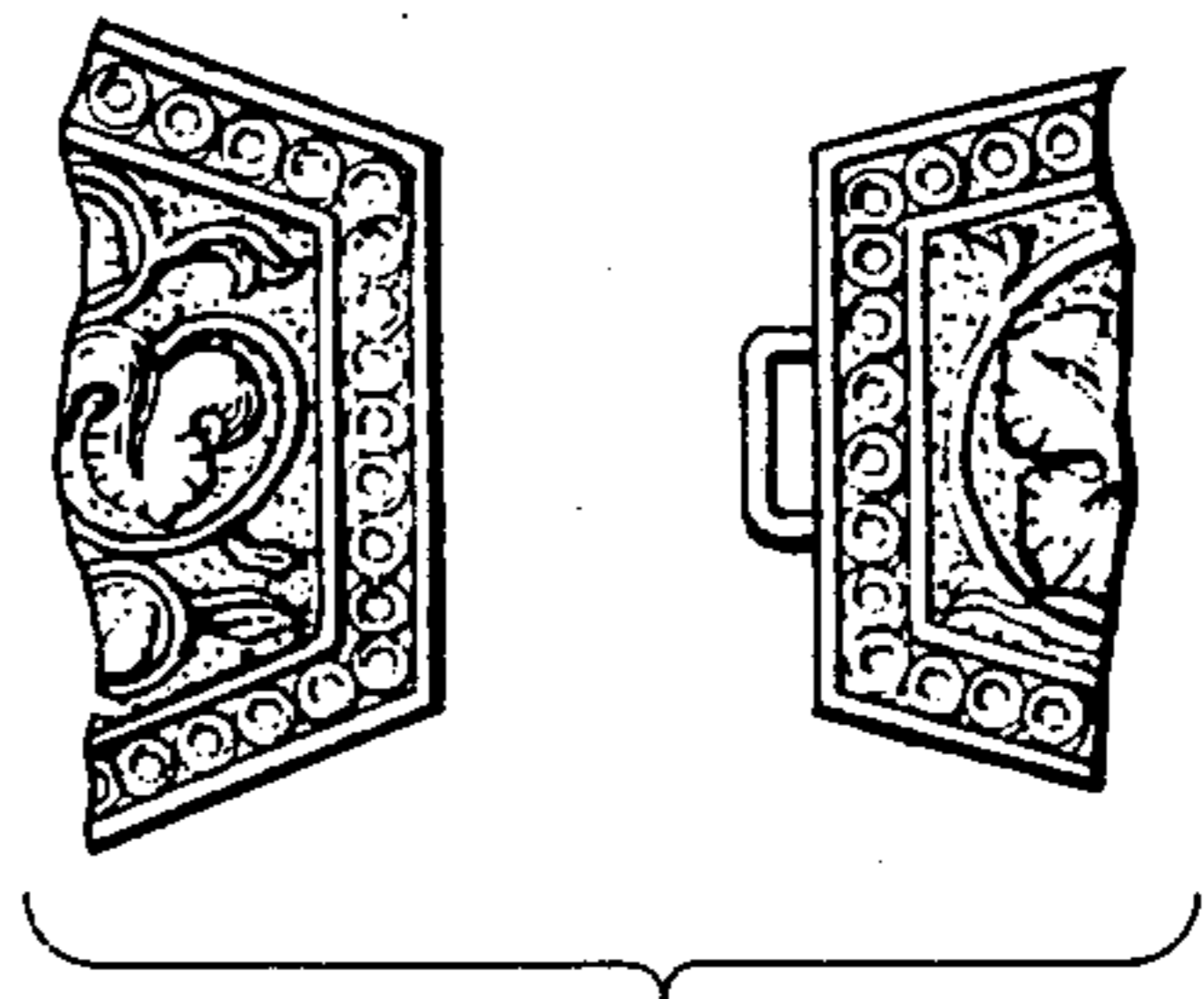
