The ornamental design for a toilet seat for infants, as shown and described.

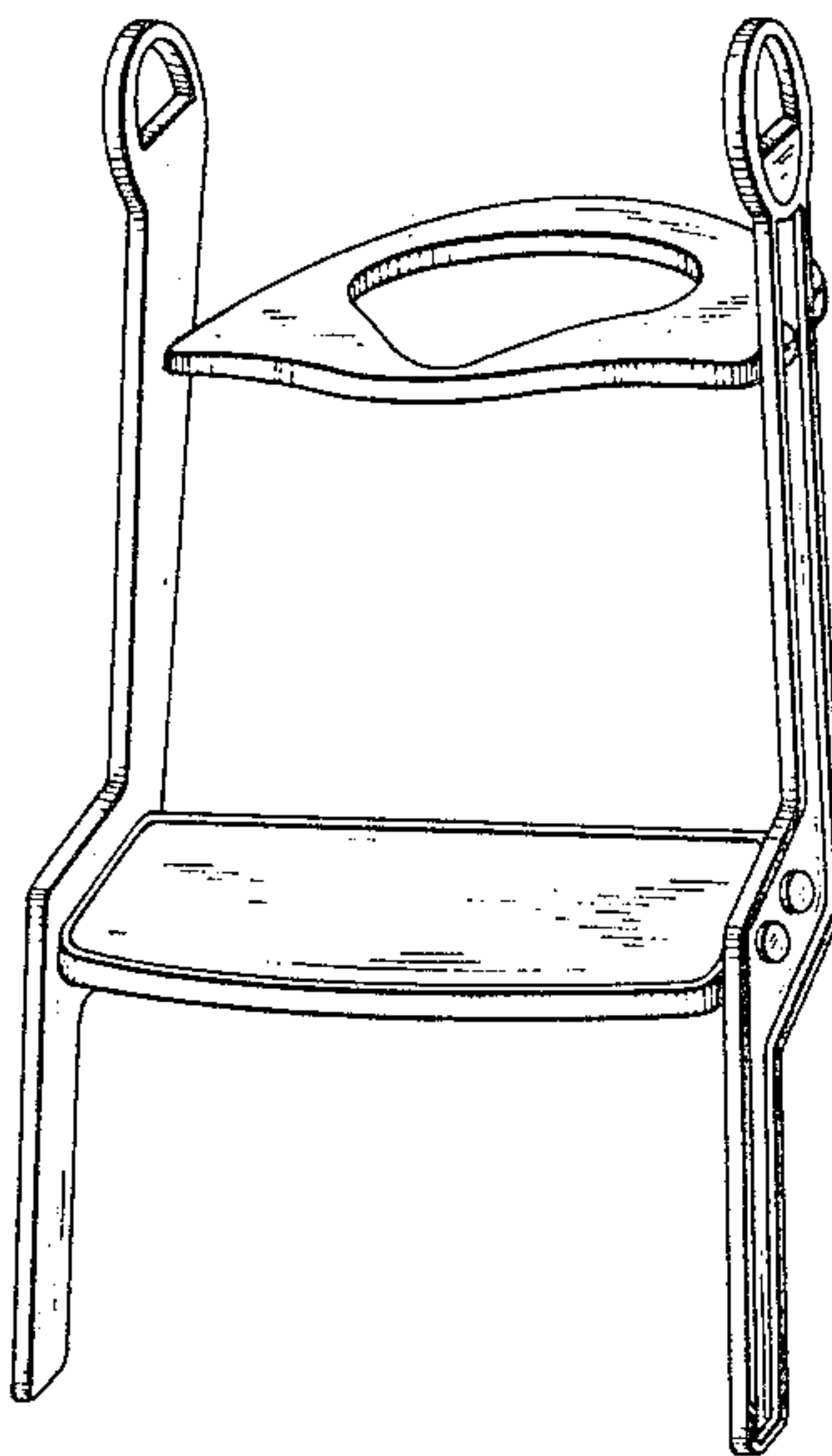
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a rear view of the toilet seat for infants of FIG. 1.



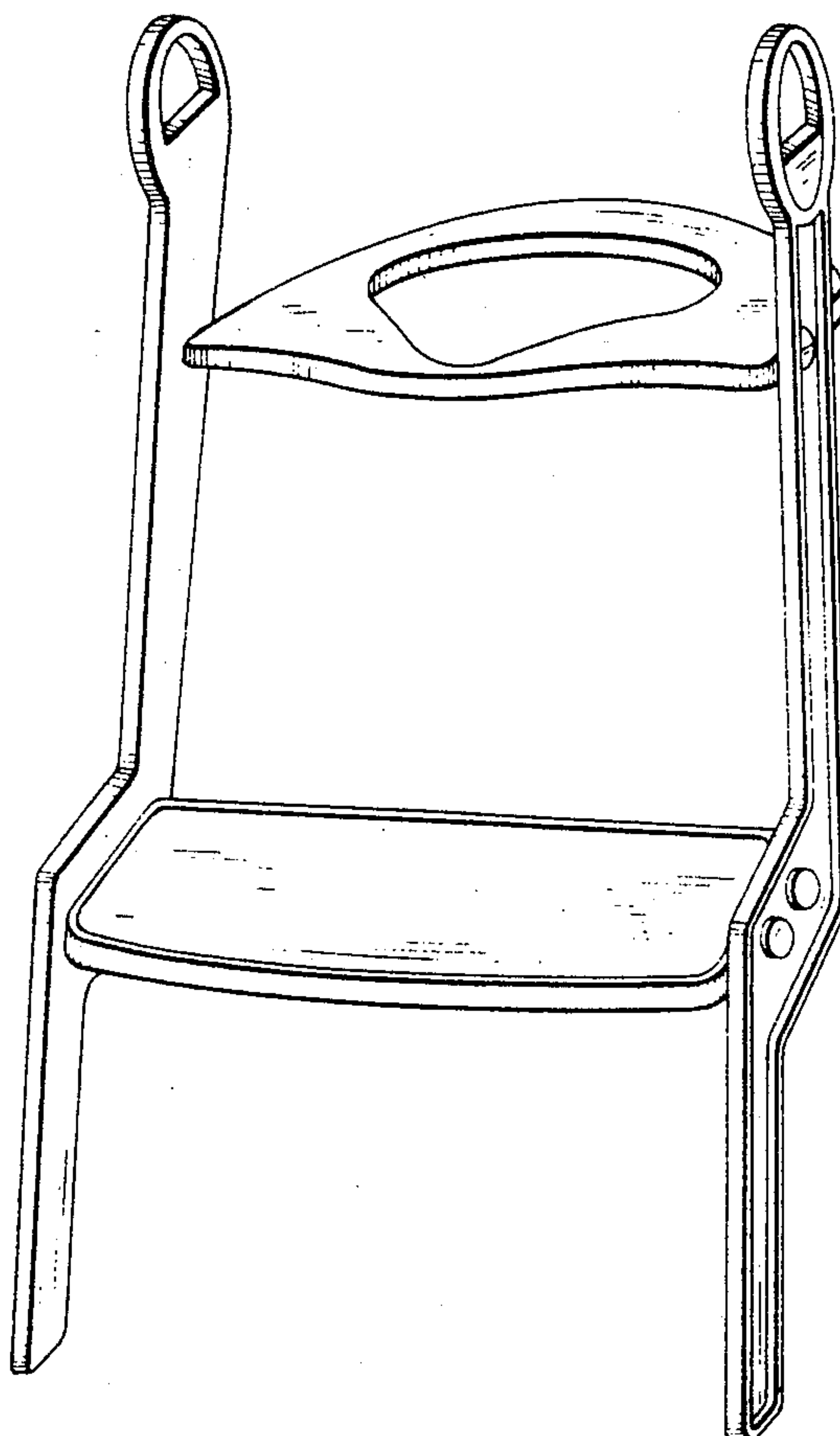

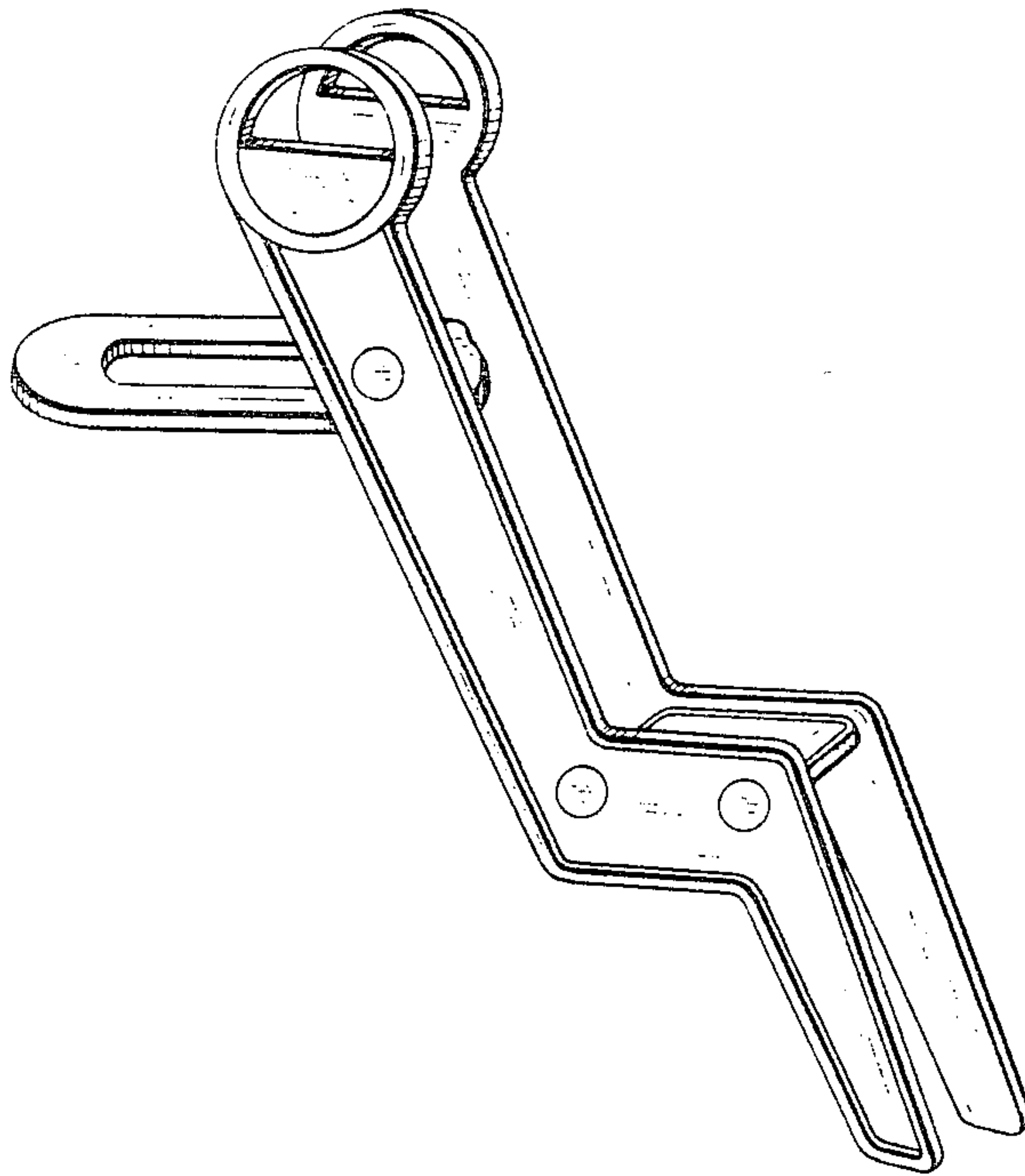

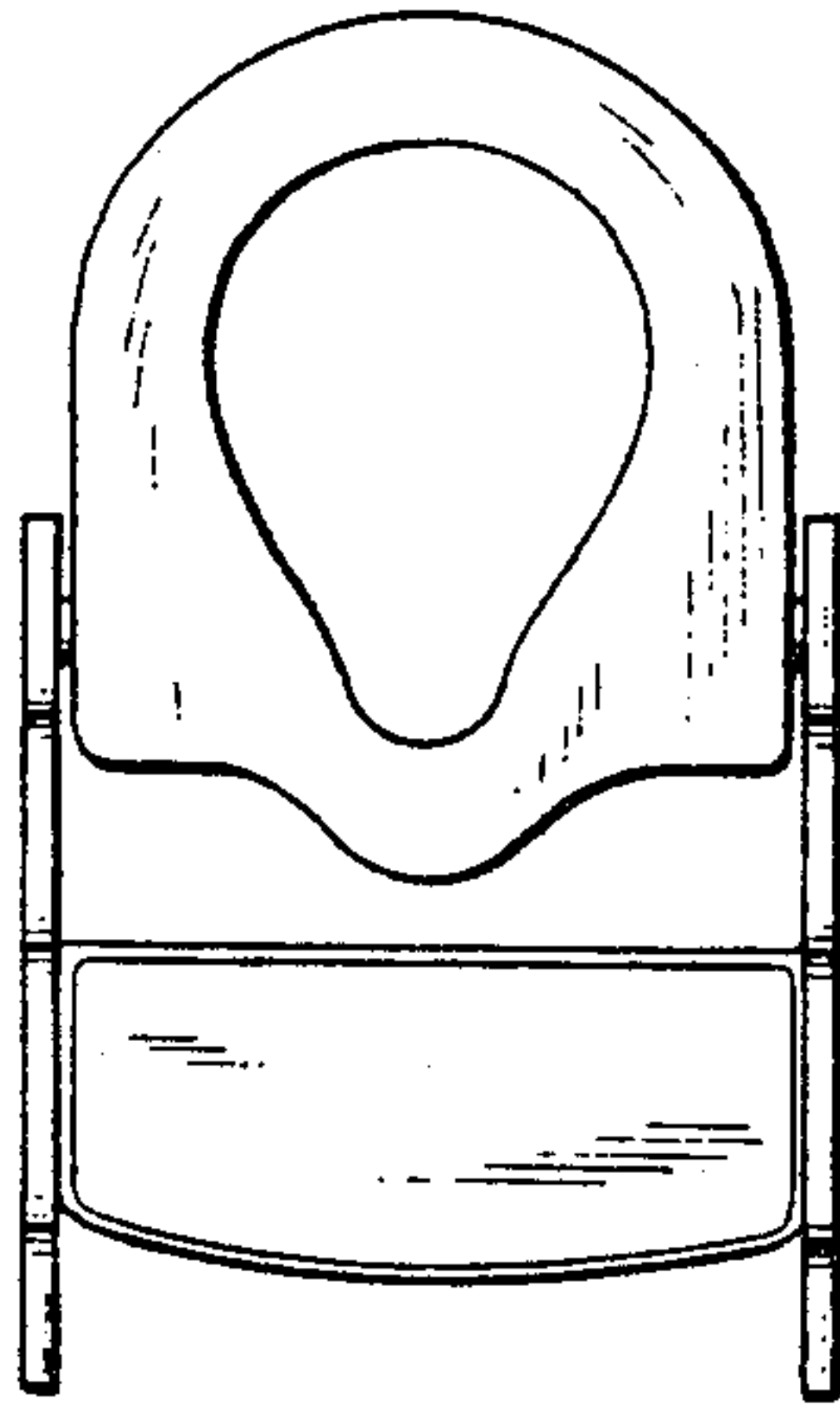

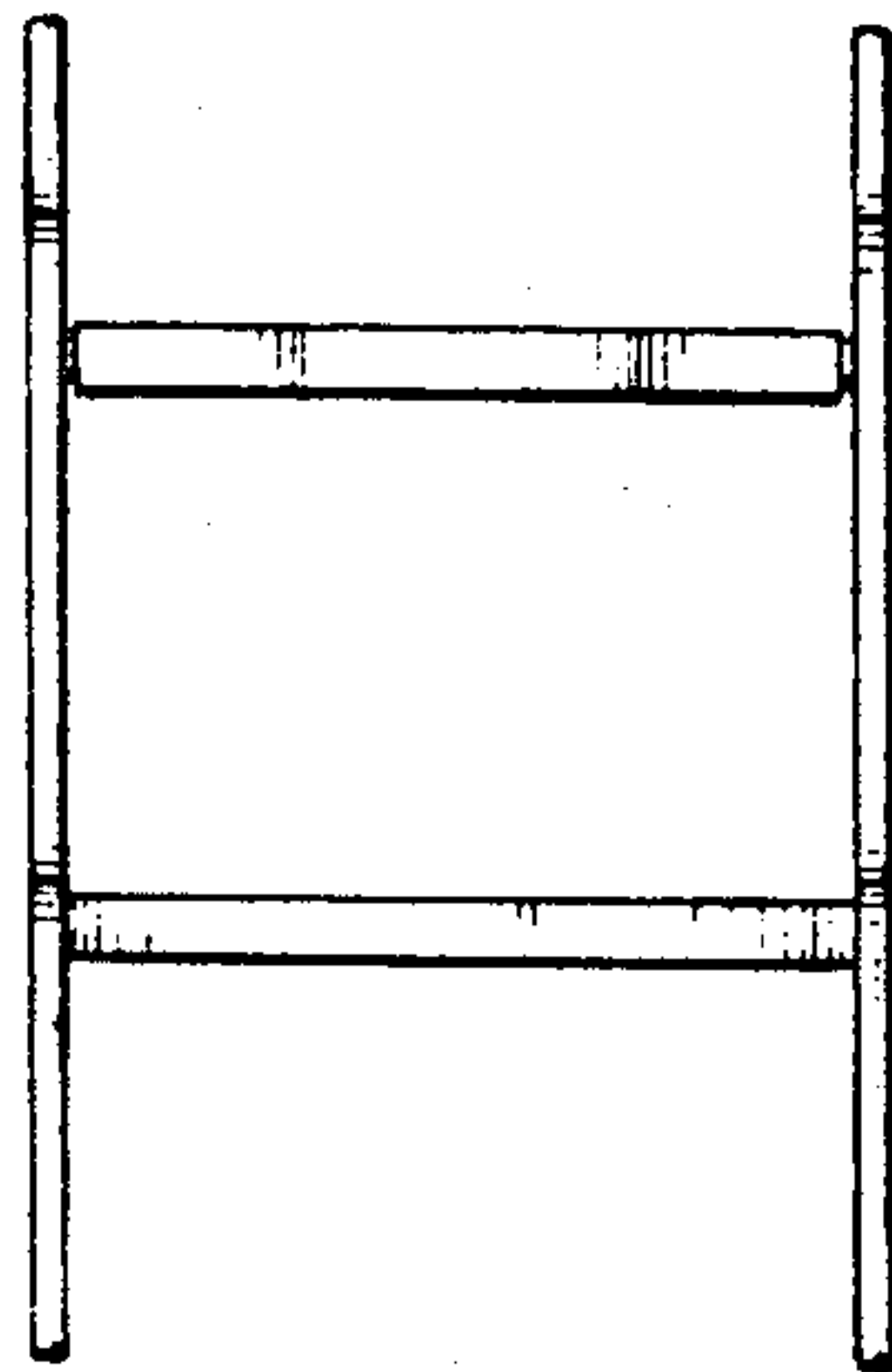
