FIG. 6 is a front view; and

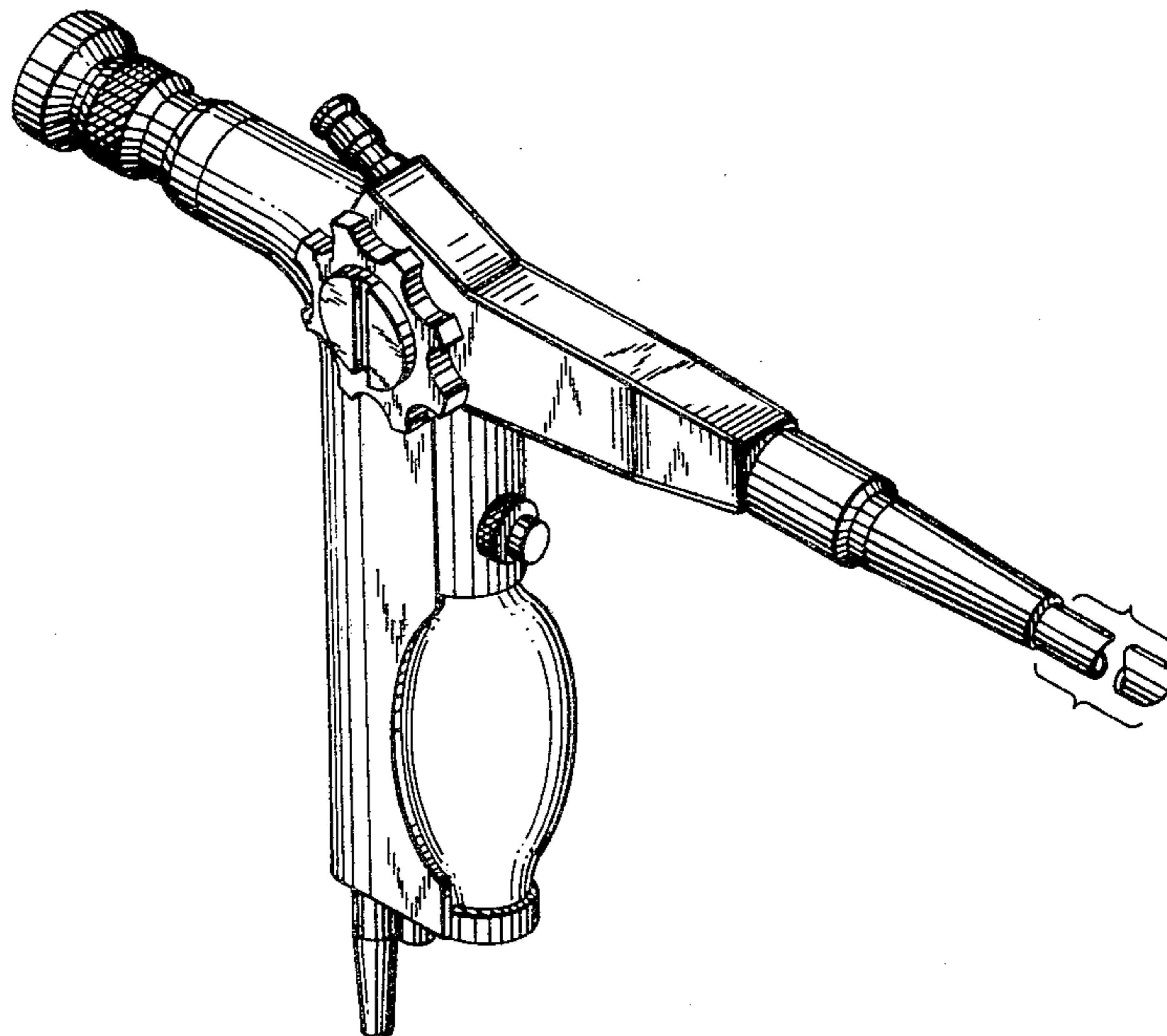
FIG. 7 is a bottom view.

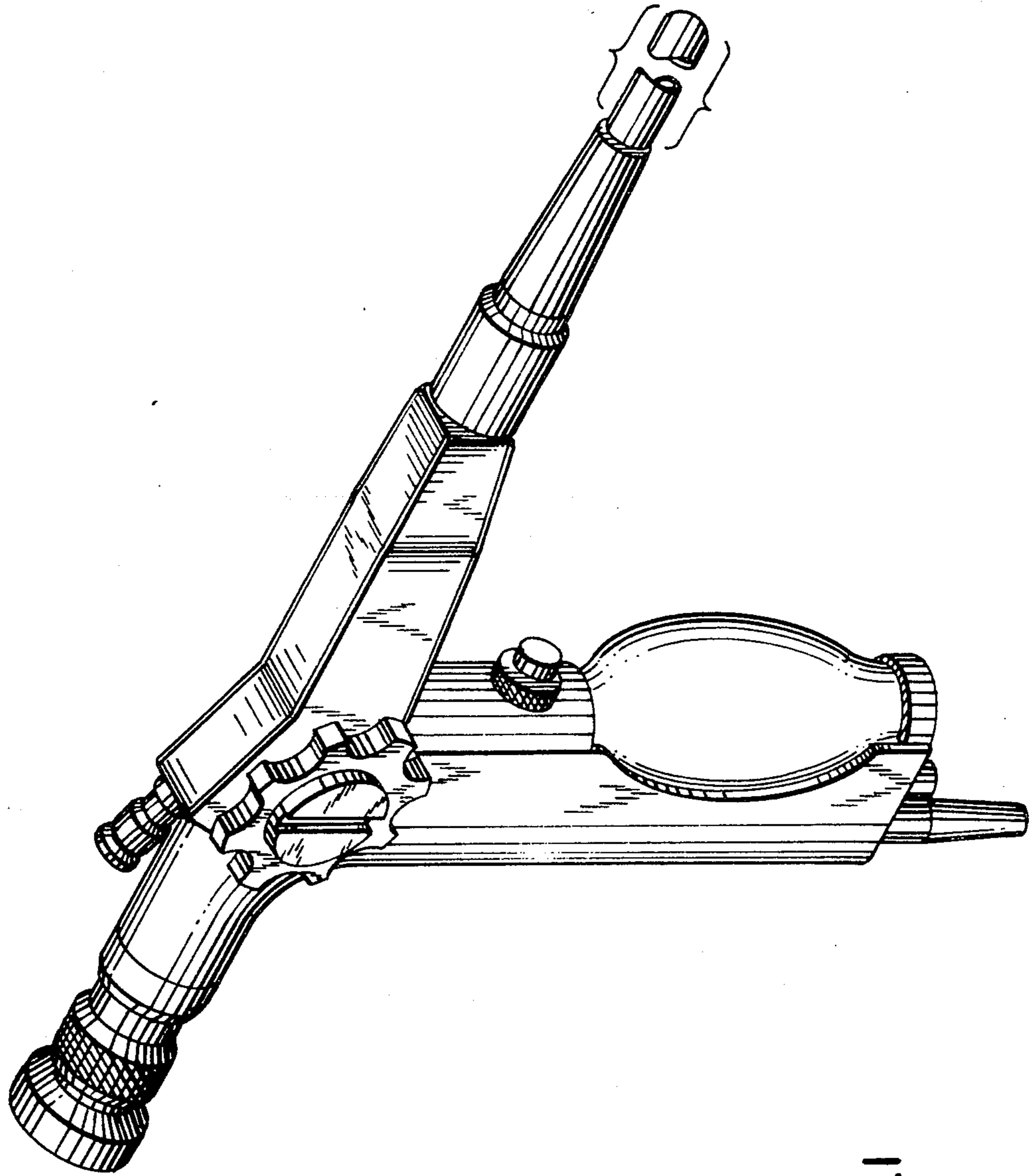

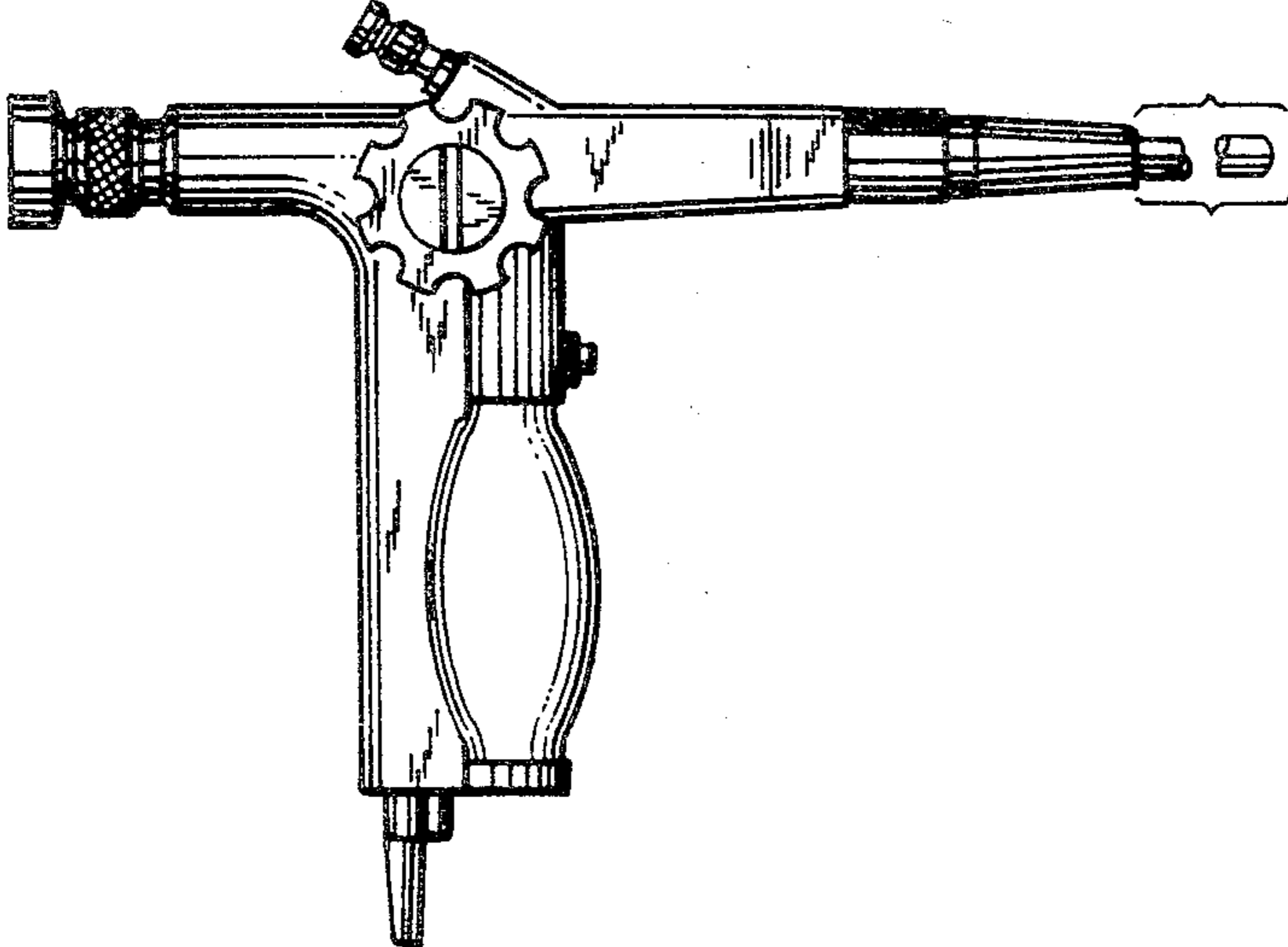

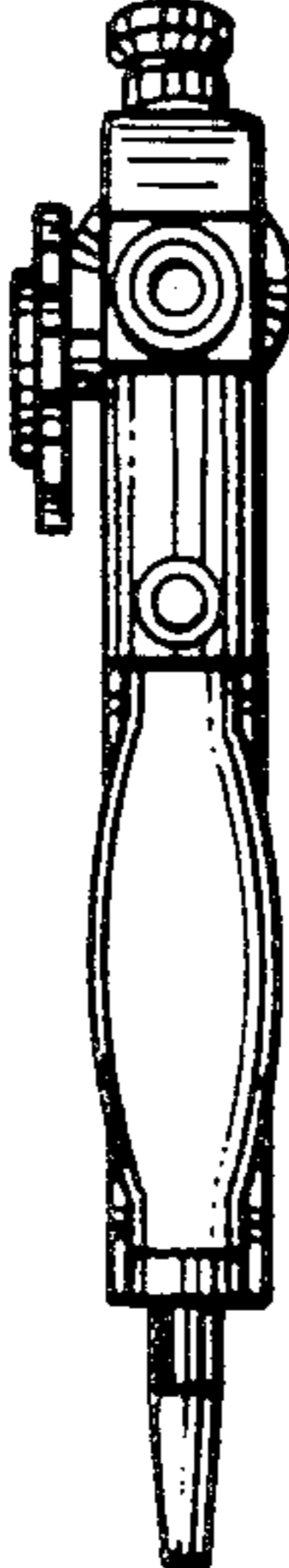

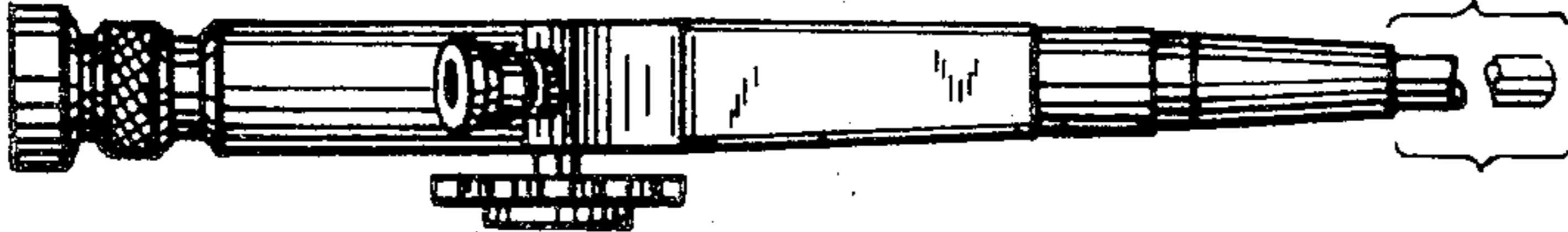

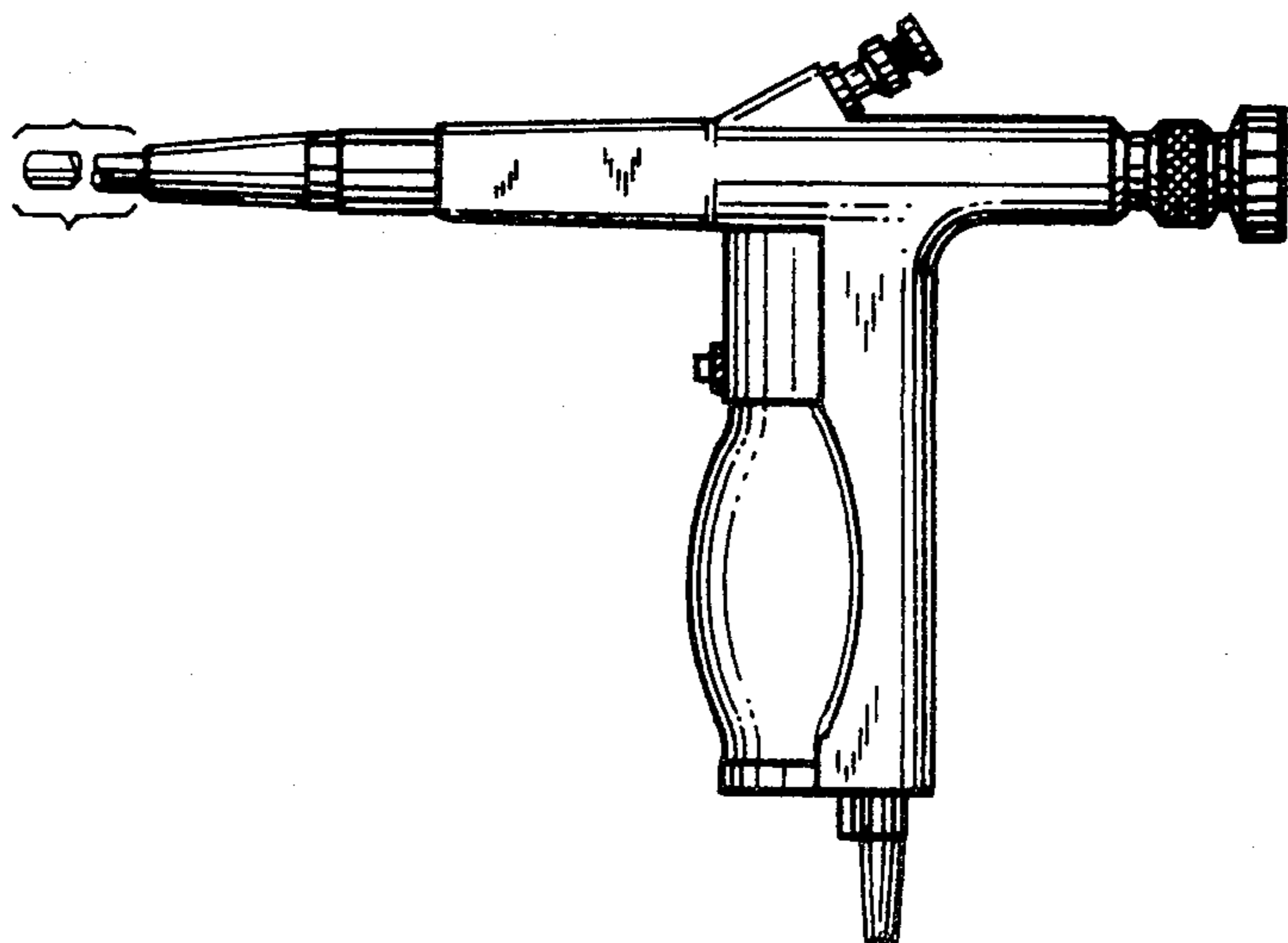
