The ornamental design for an intravenous bottle, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

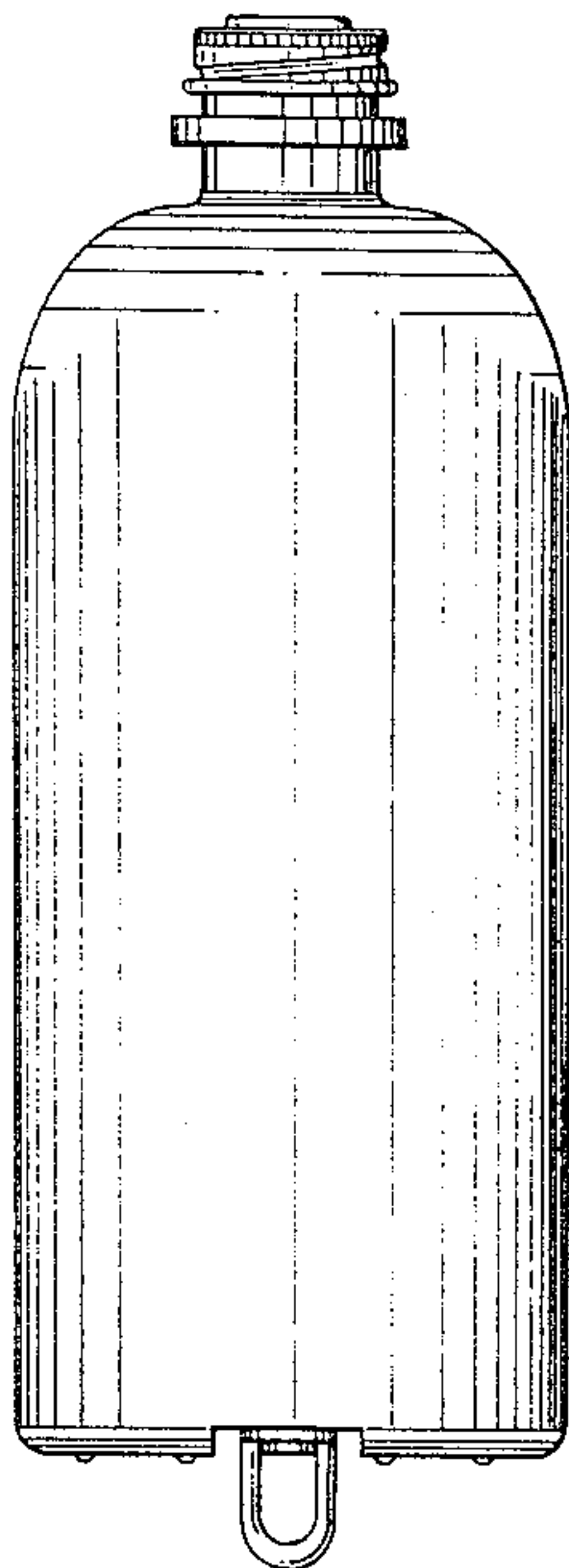
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an intravenous bottle with an integral hanger in its operative position, the undisclosed rear being identical in appearance;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the undisclosed side being identical in appearance;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof, with the integral hanger shown closed and the undisclosed rear being identical in appearance;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



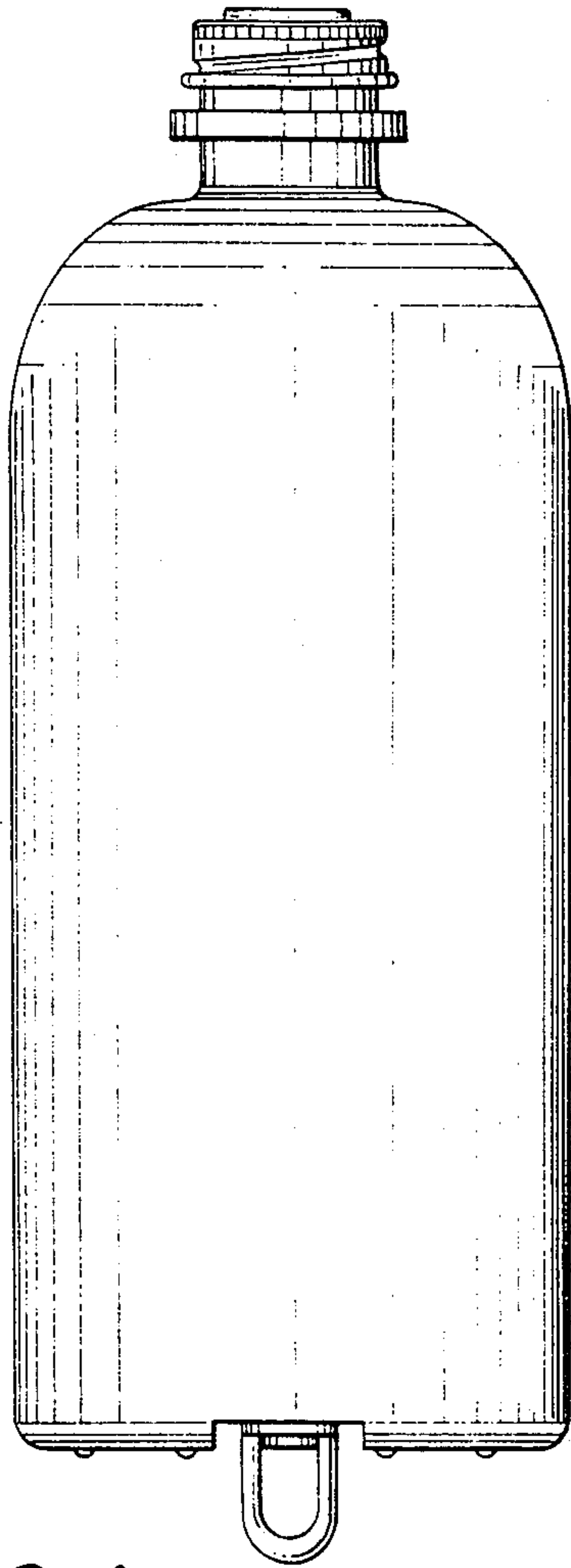

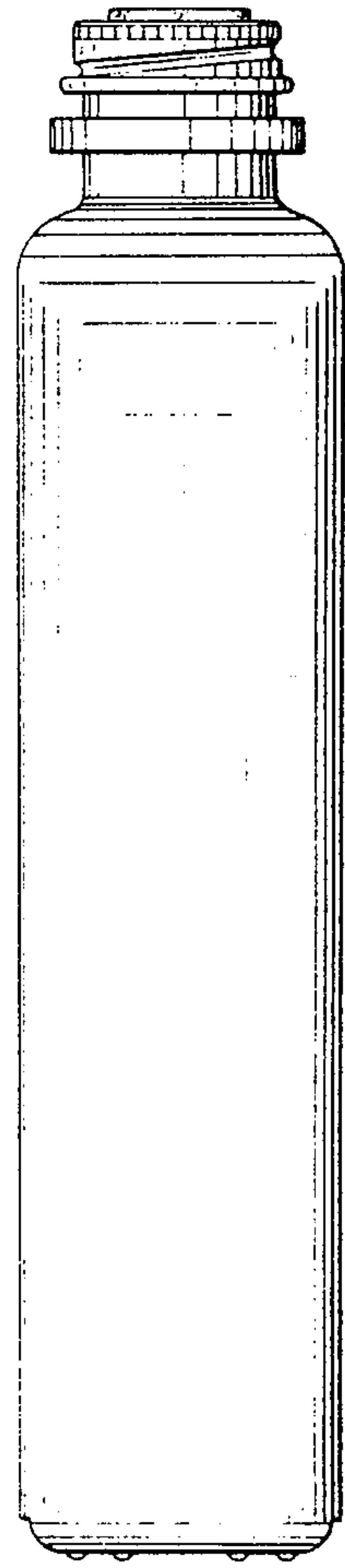

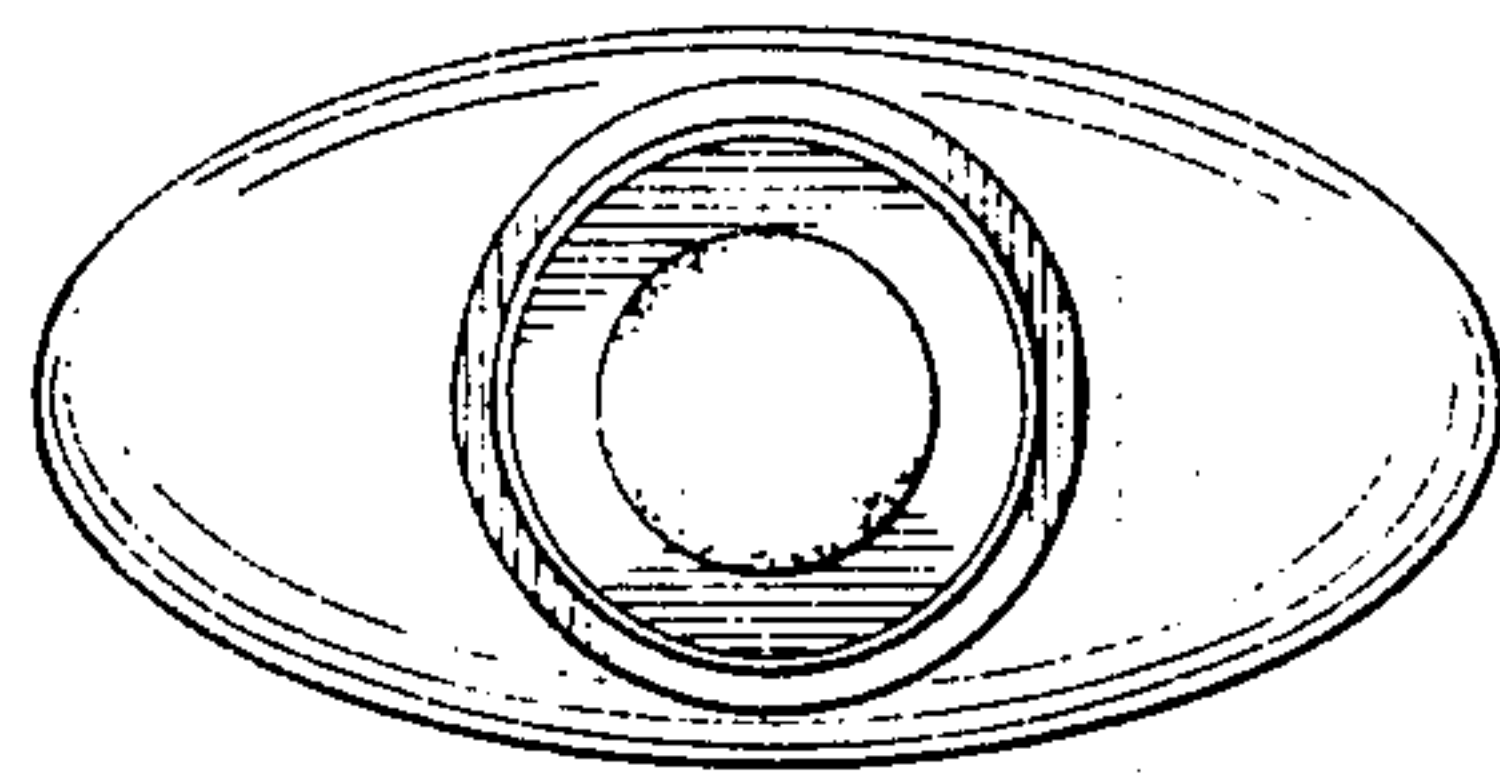

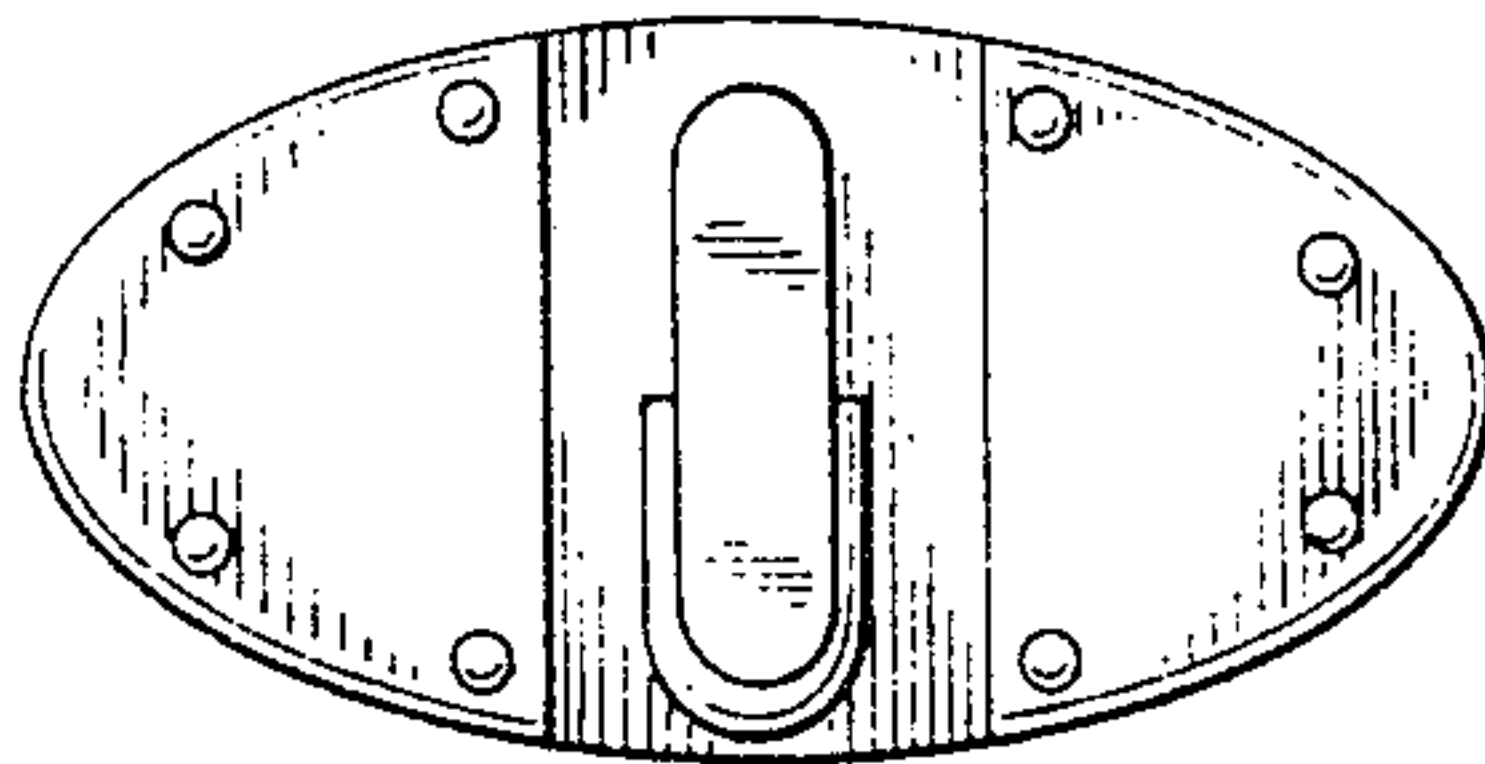
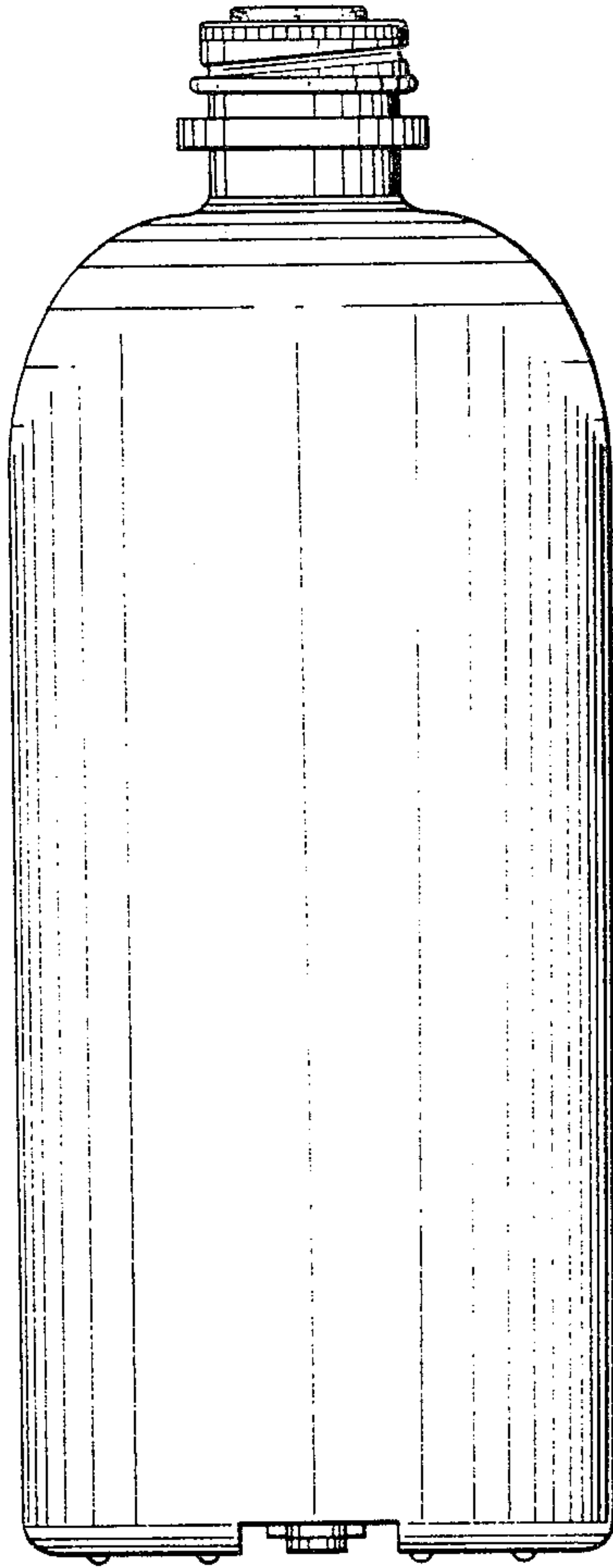
