The ornamental design for a pedal pad for automotive vehicles, as shown and described.


DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pedal pad for automotive vehicles showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a front elevation view thereof to an enlarged scale, it being understood that the rear is a mirror image of the front shown.









